FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the doll of the present invention;

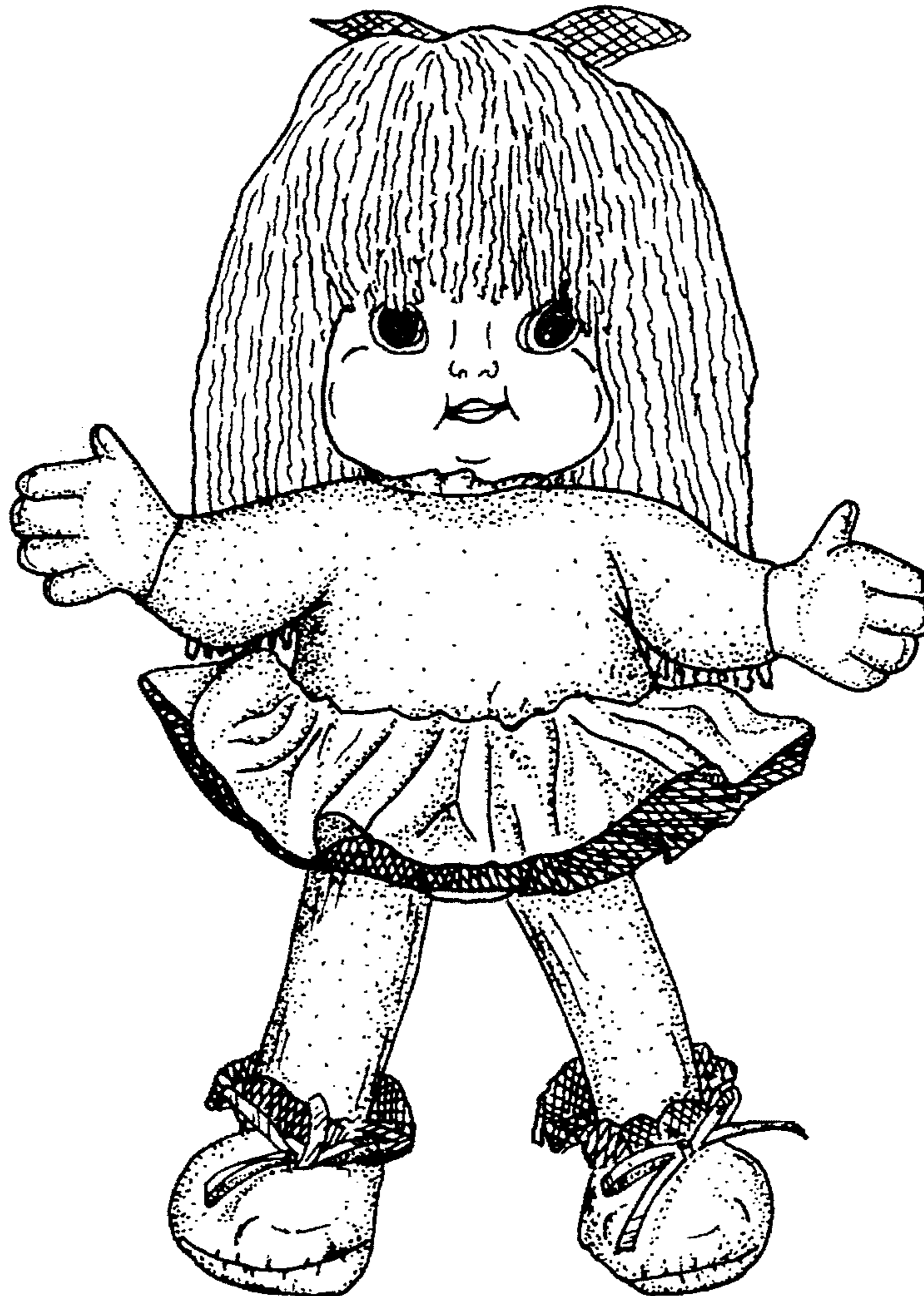
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view which is substantially a mirror image of the left side elevational view;

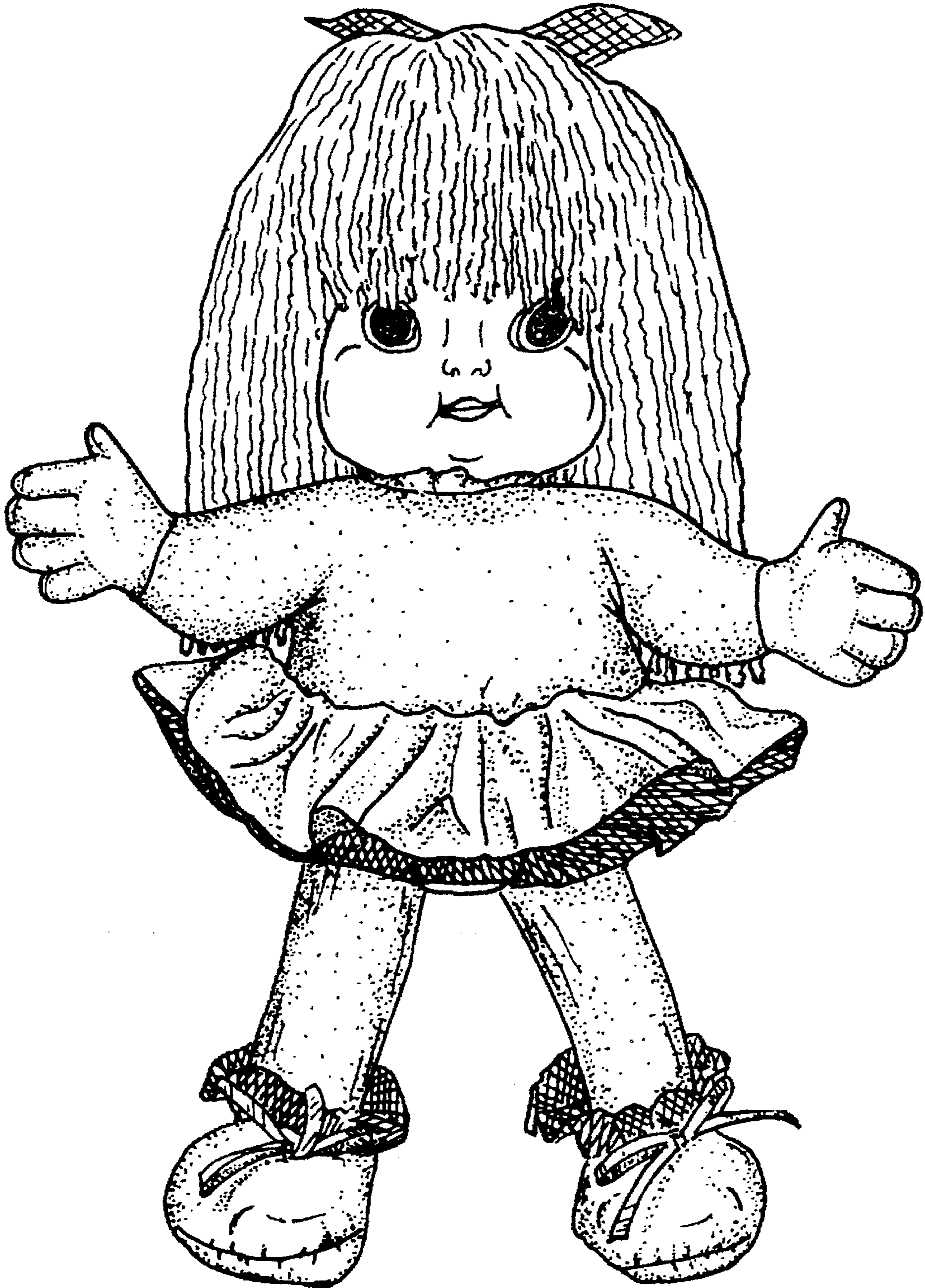

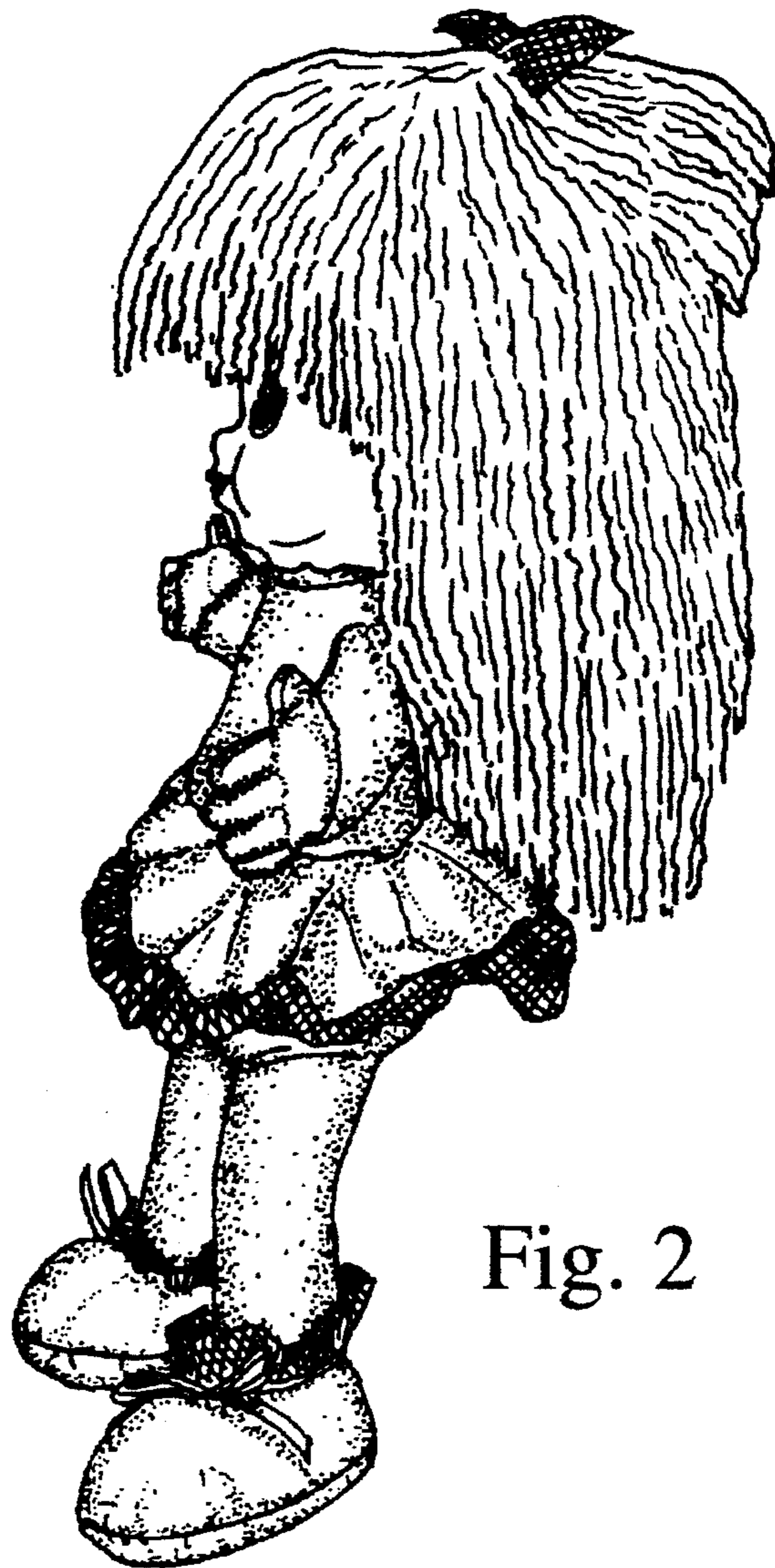

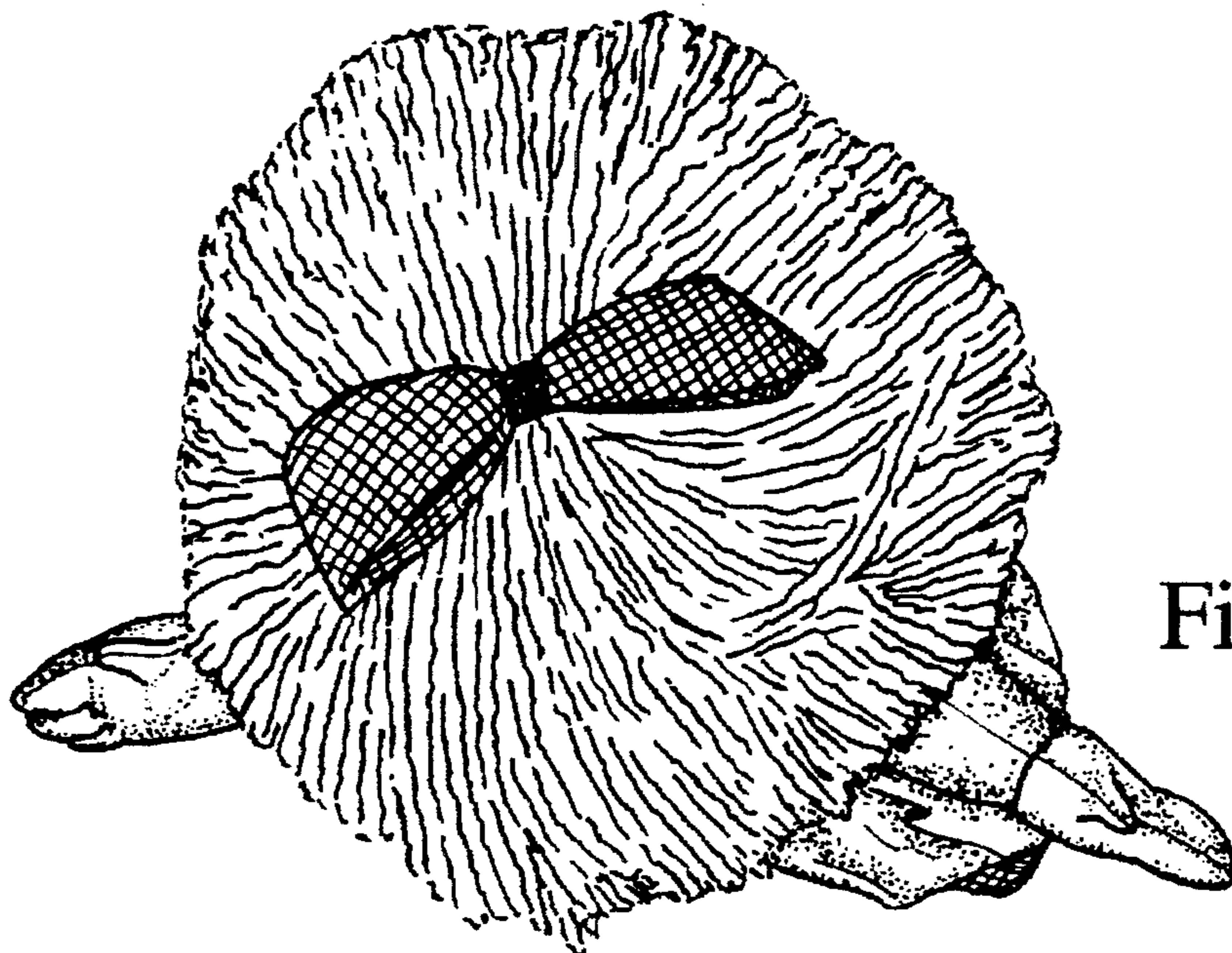

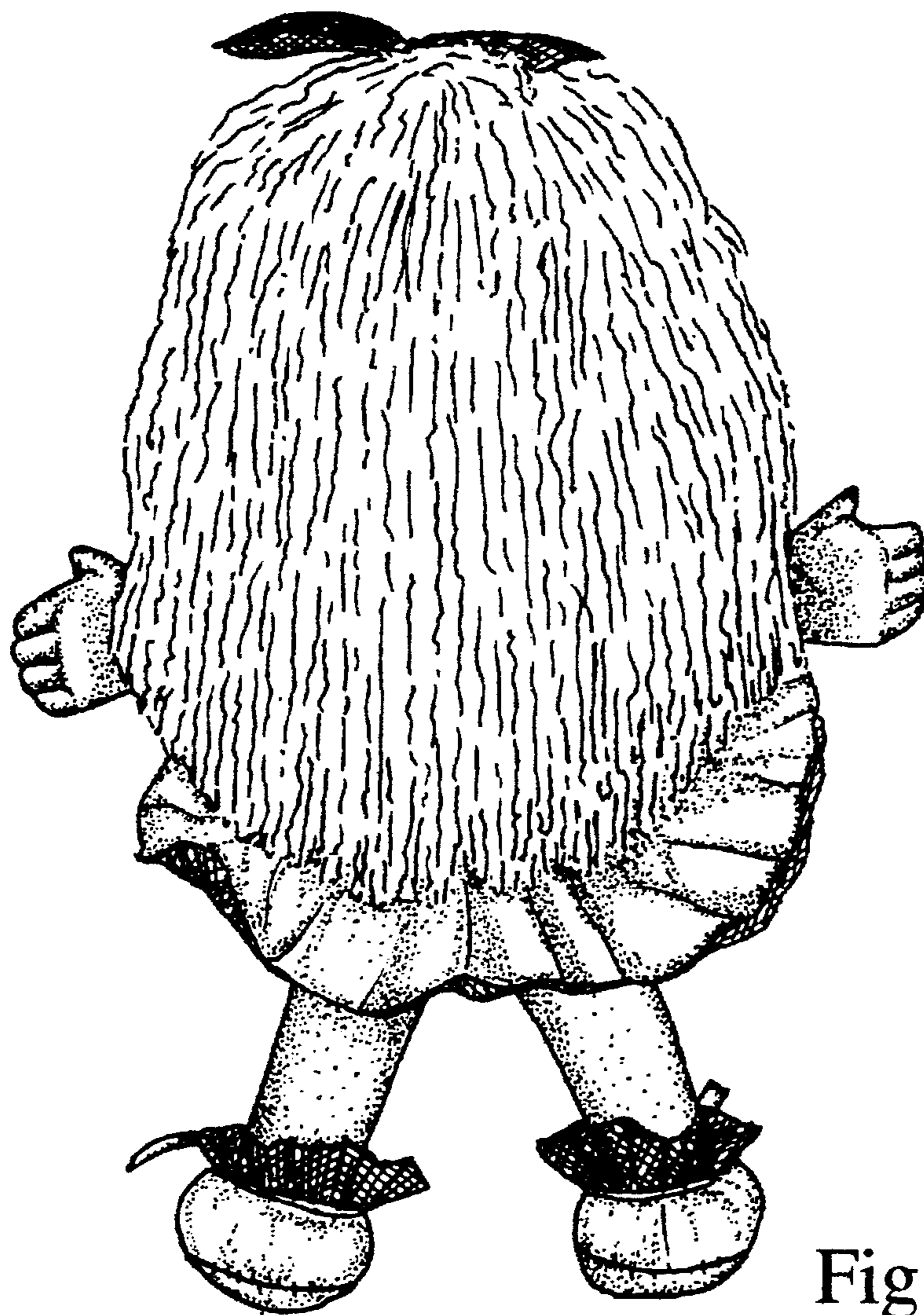

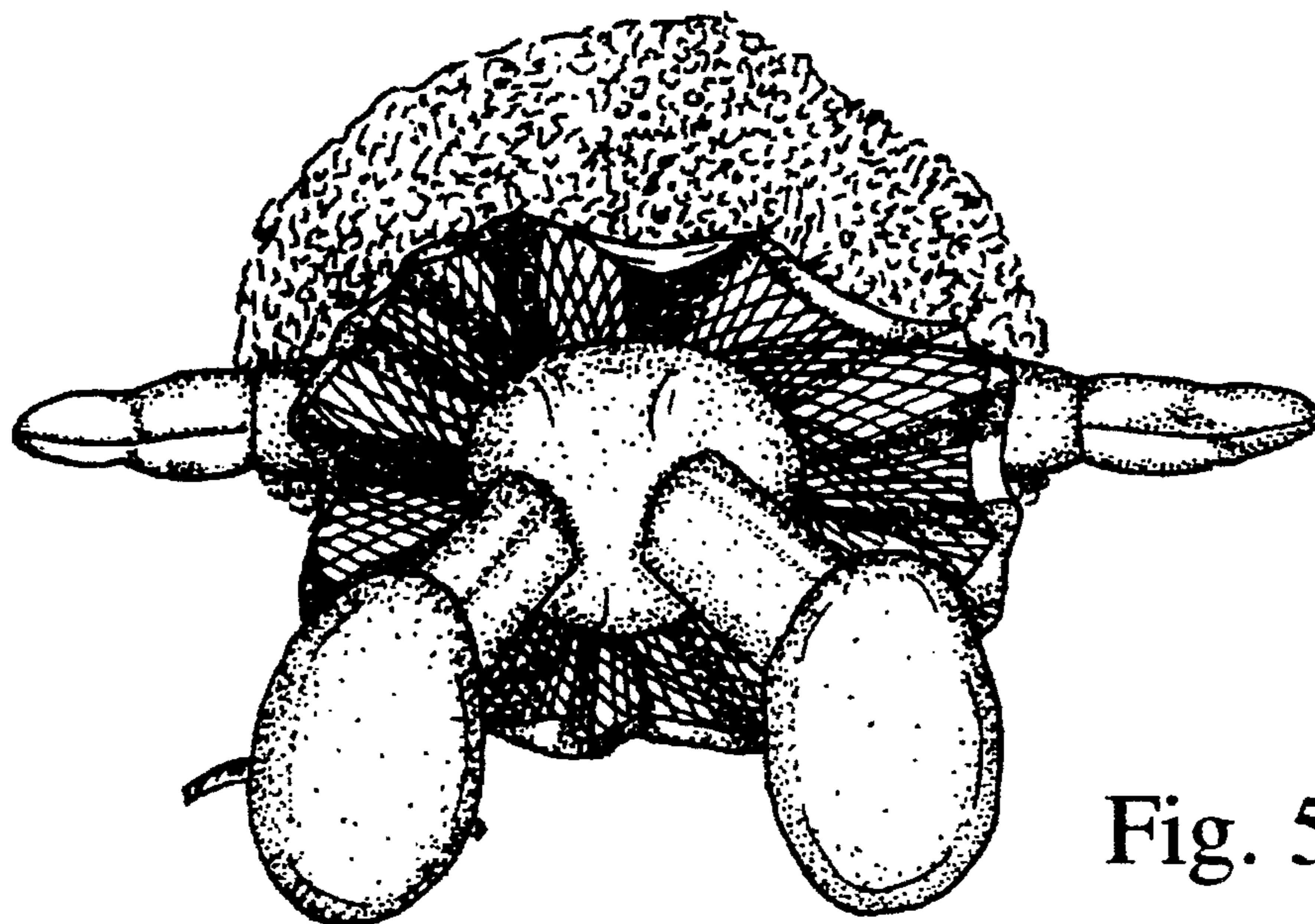
