FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the design of the paint can holder shown in FIG. 1;

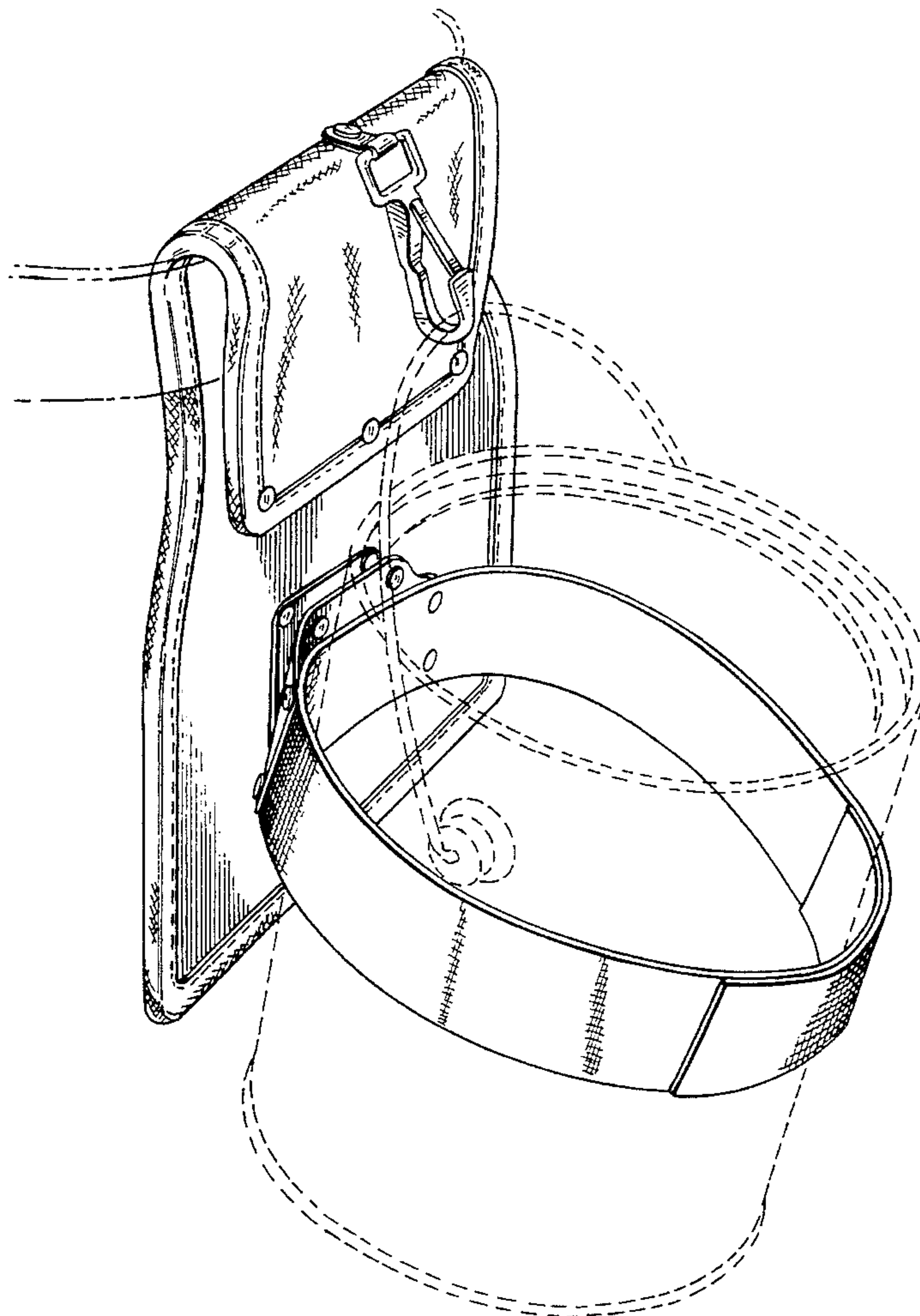
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the design of the paint can holder shown in FIG. 1; and,

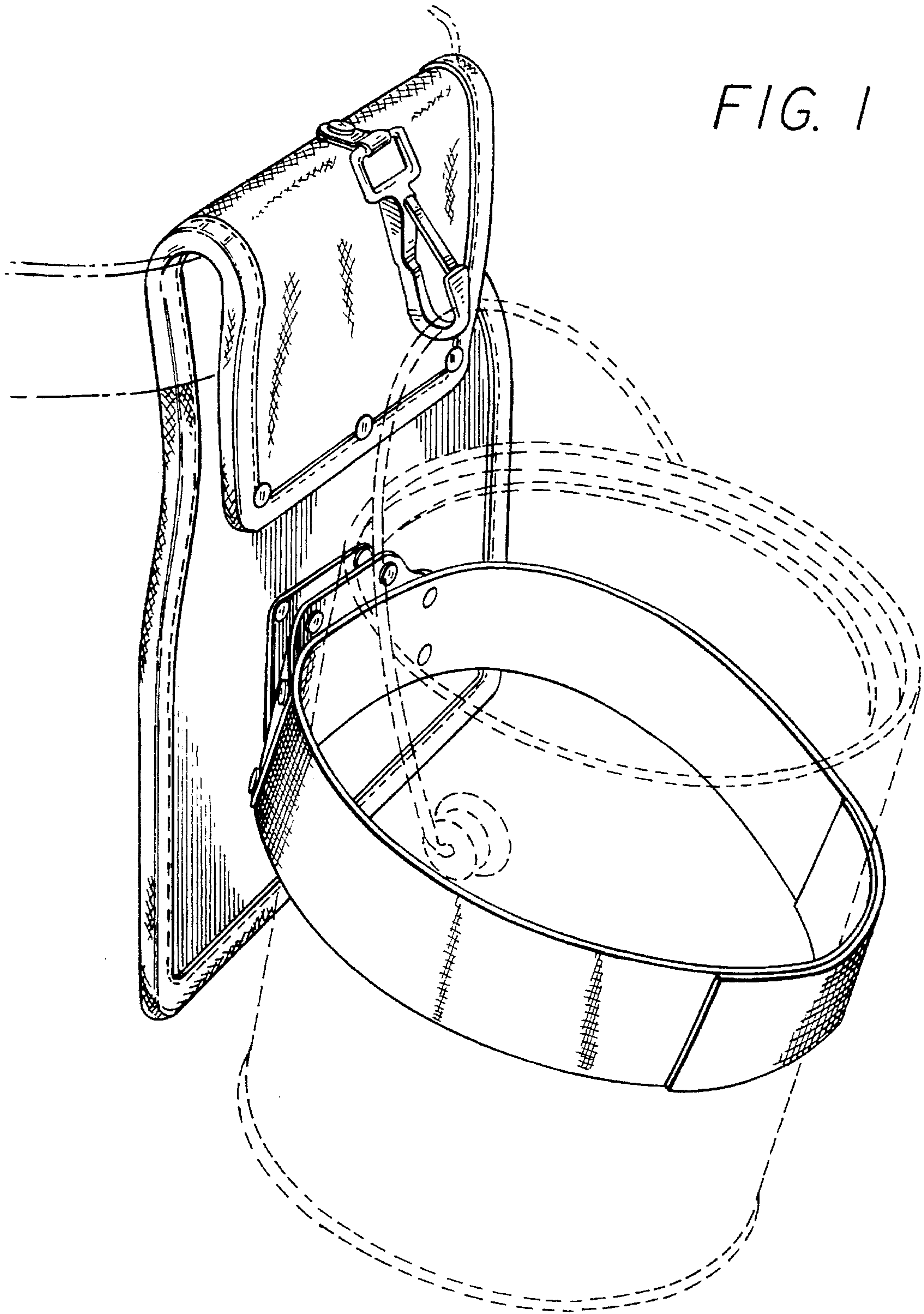

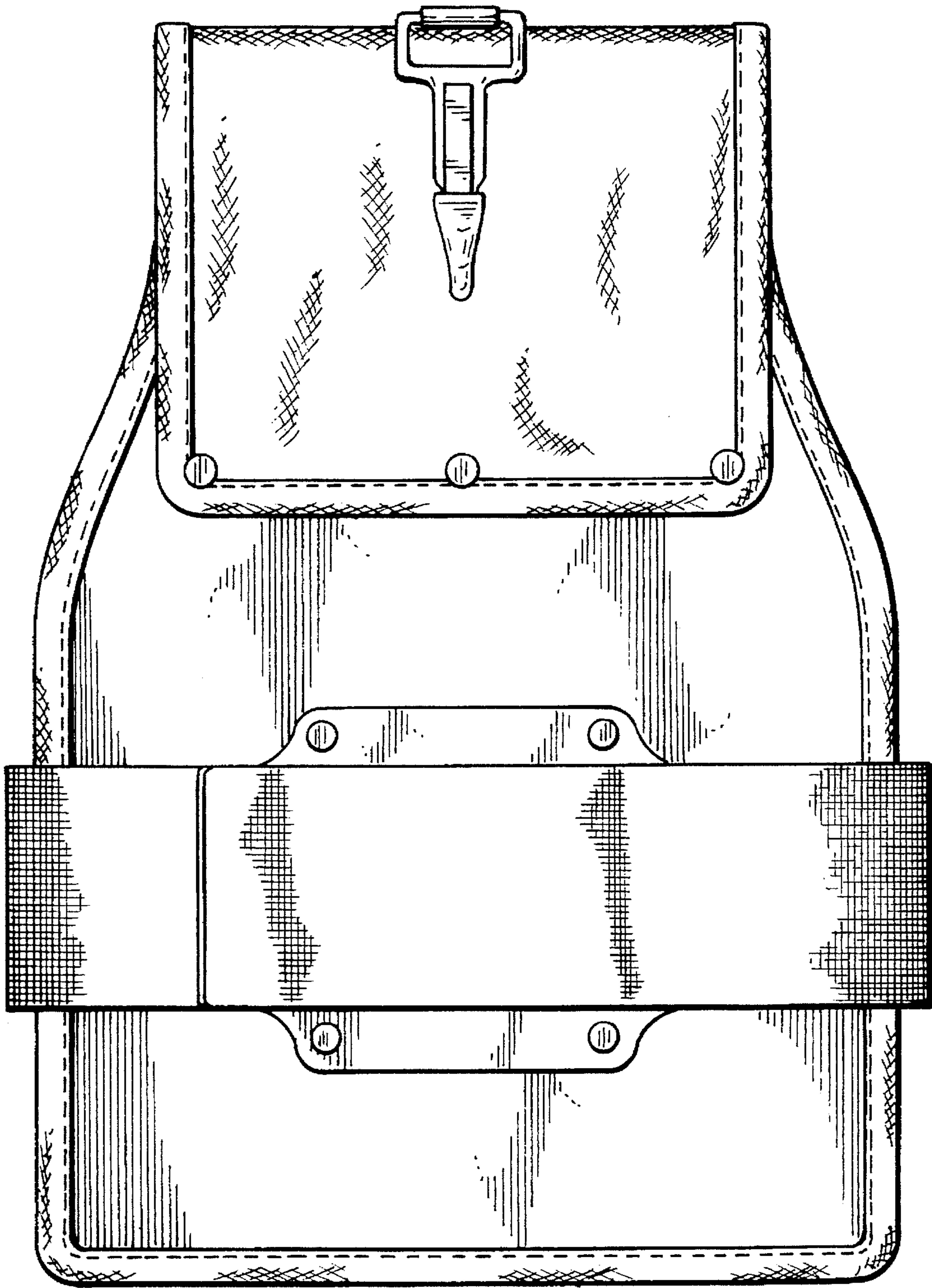

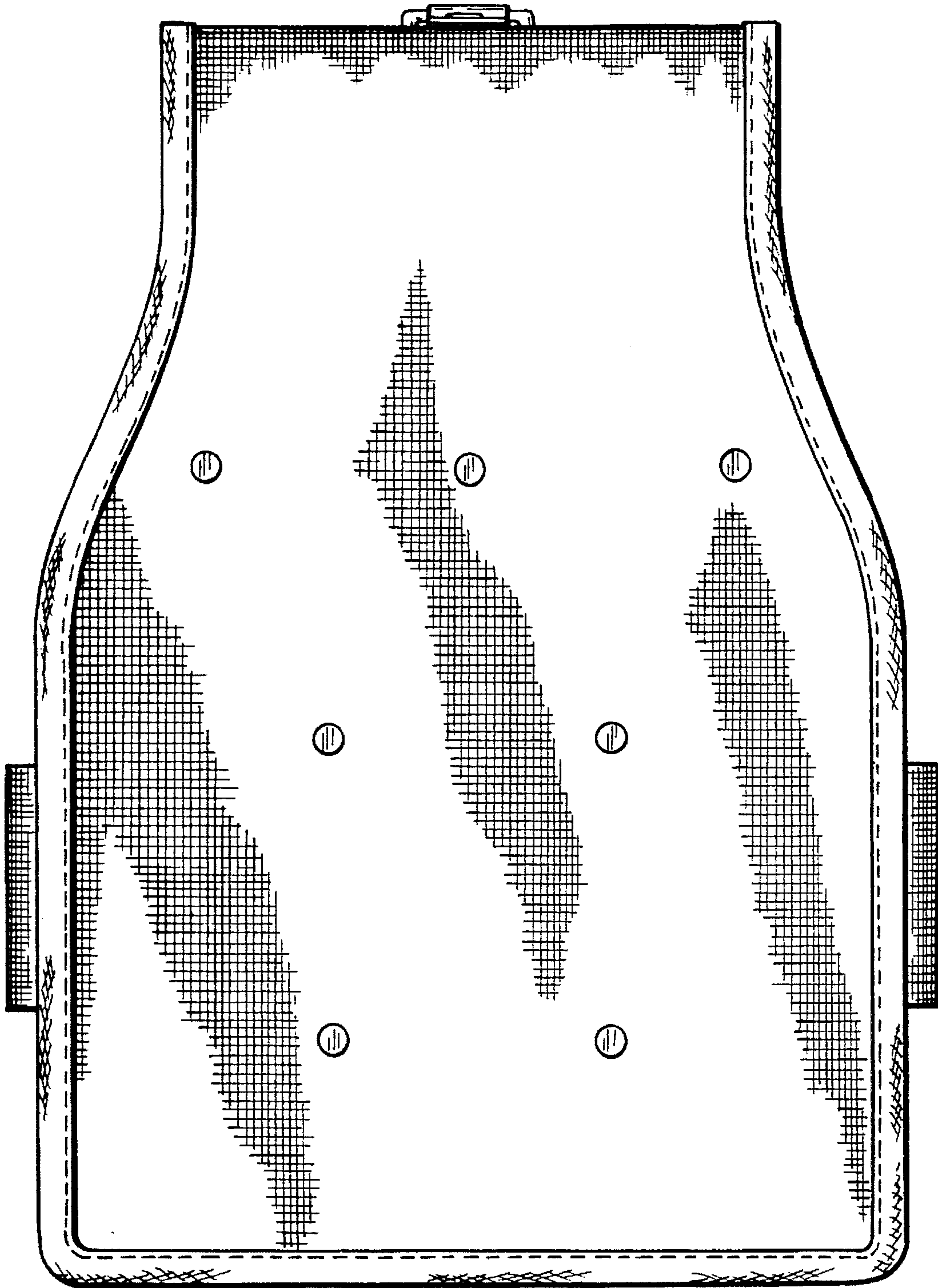

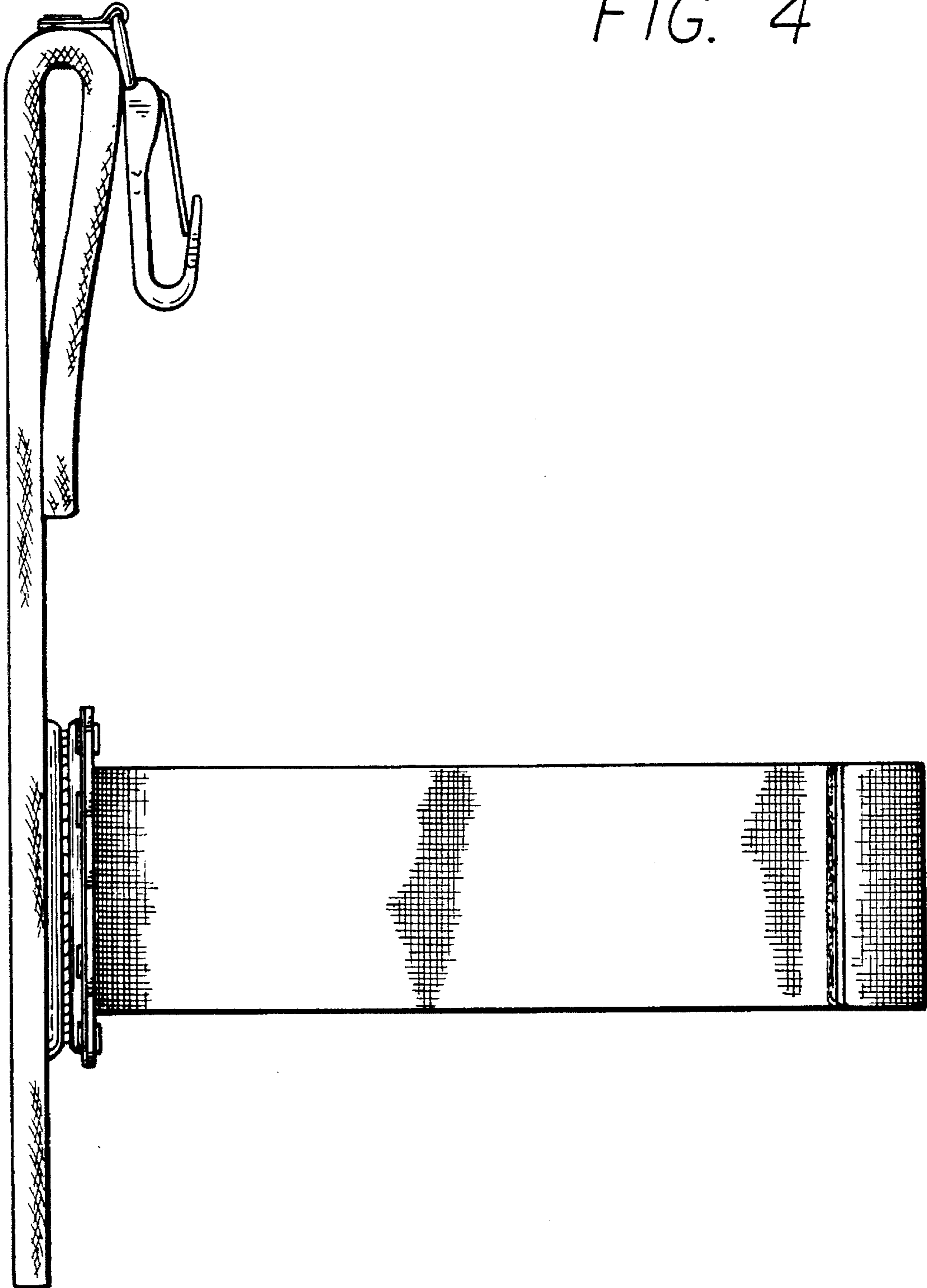
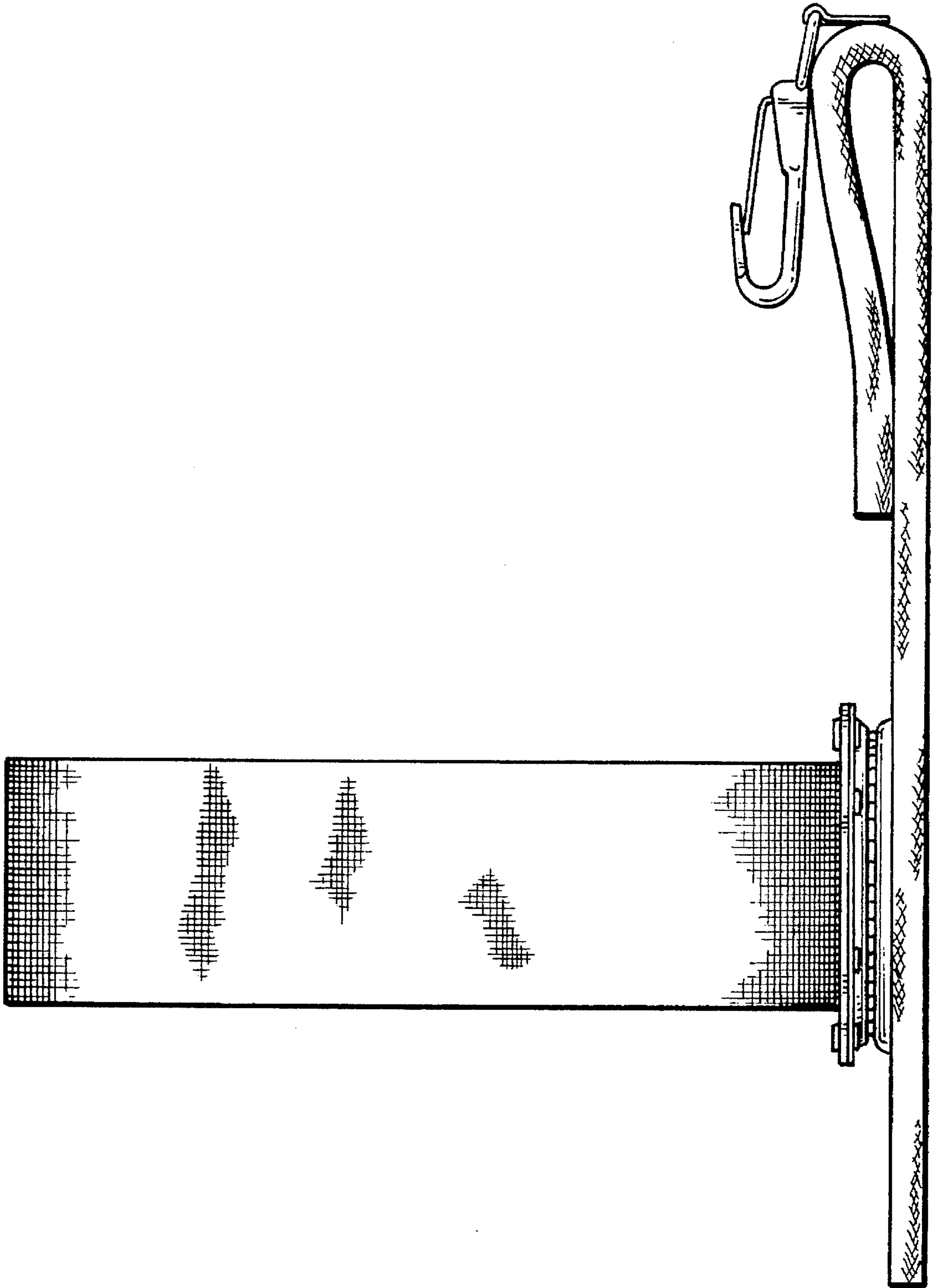

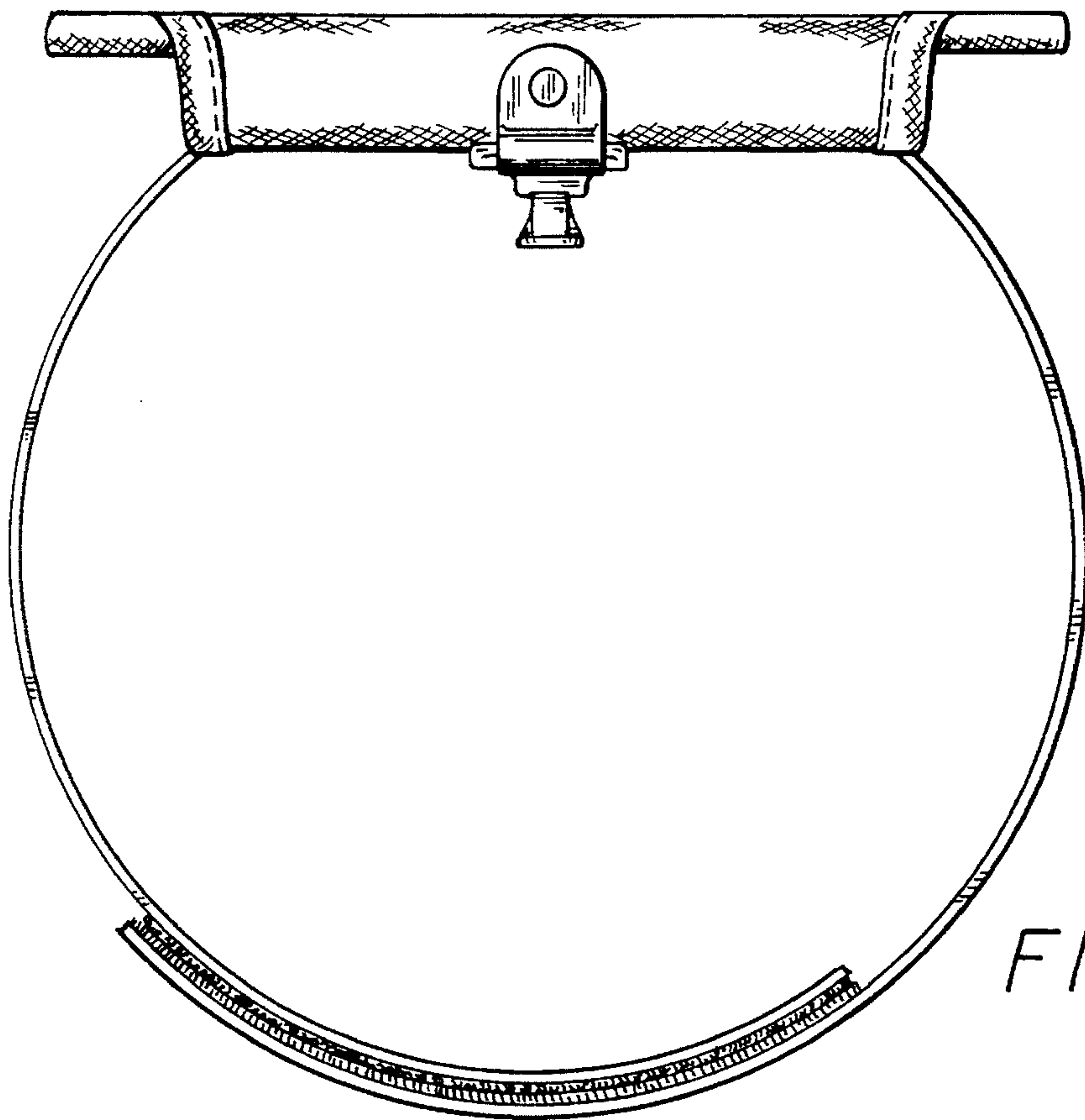
