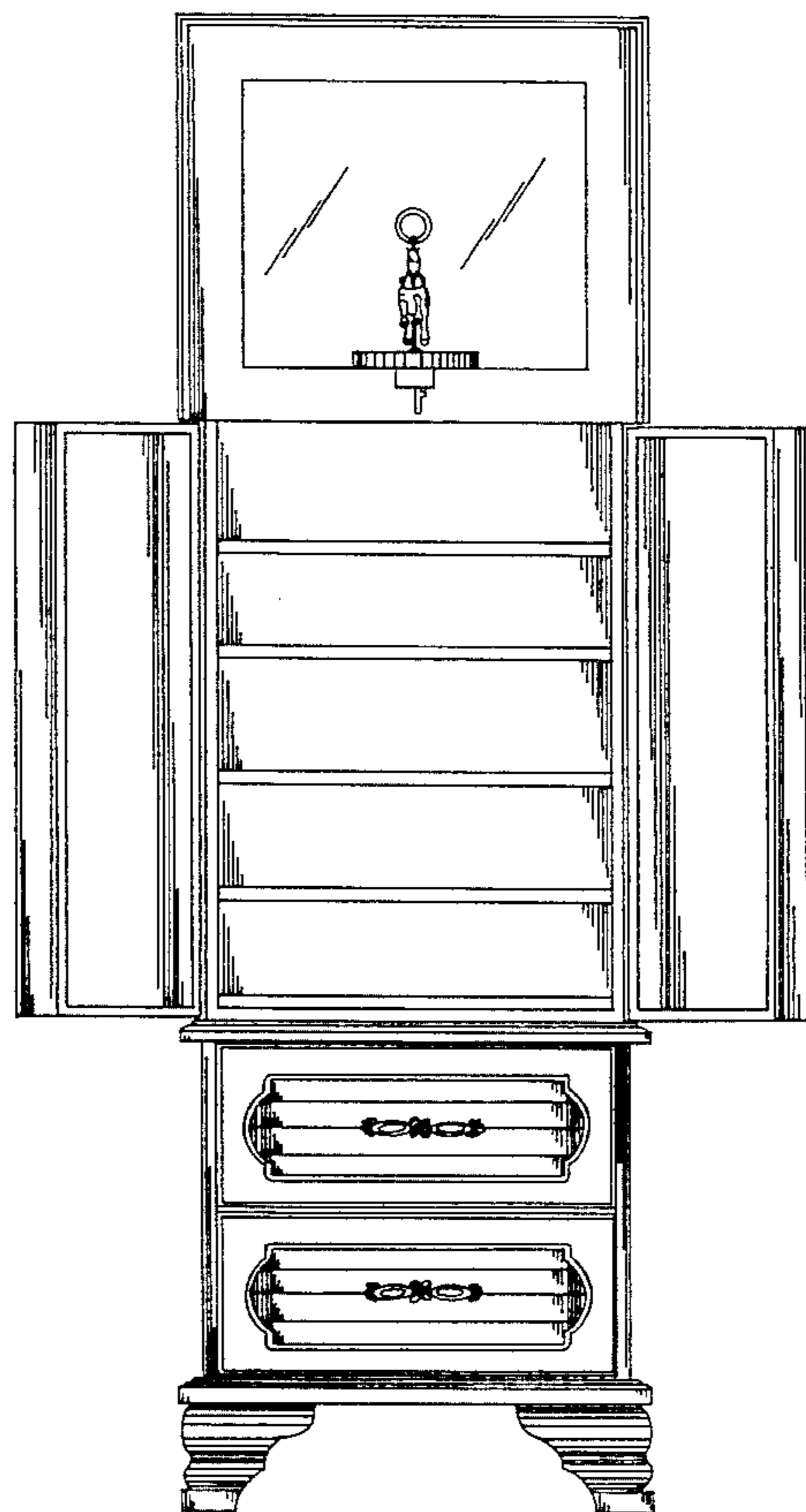
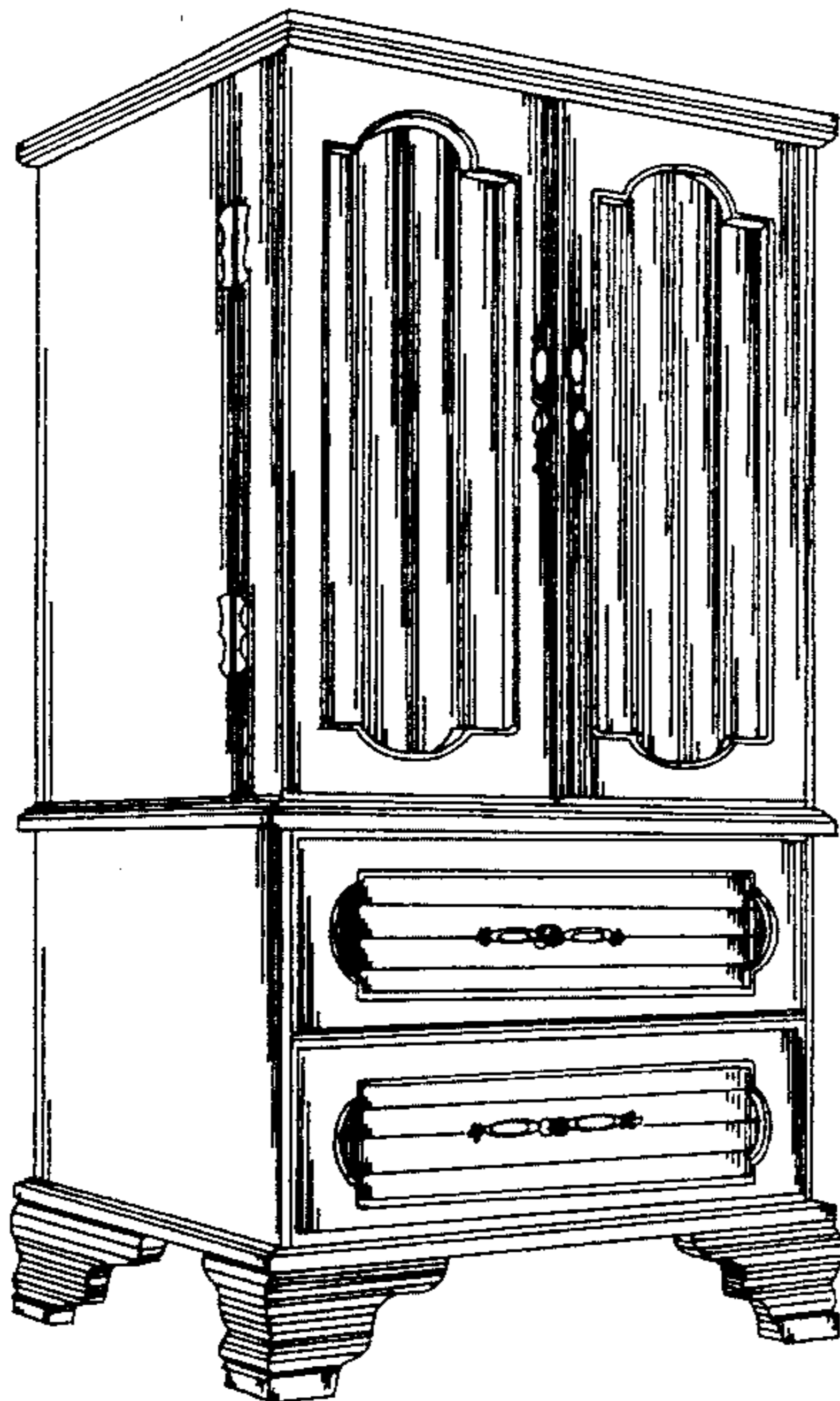
### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a musical jewelry armoire, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a musical jewelry armoire; FIG. 2 is a front view of the musical jewelry armoire; FIG. 3 is a right side view of the musical jewelry armoire, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a back view of the musical jewelry armoire; FIG. 5 is a top view of the musical jewelry armoire; FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the musical jewelry armoire; FIG. 7 is a front view of the musical jewelry armoire, showing the lid in an open position exposing the musical movement, the front doors also being opened; FIG. 8 is a right side view of the musical jewelry armoire with the lid and doors in their open position; FIG. 9 is a back view of the musical jewelry armoire with the lid in its open position; FIG. 10 is a top view of the musical jewelry armoire with the lid and doors in their open position; and, FIG. 11 is a bottom view of the musical jewelry armoire with the doors in their opened position.

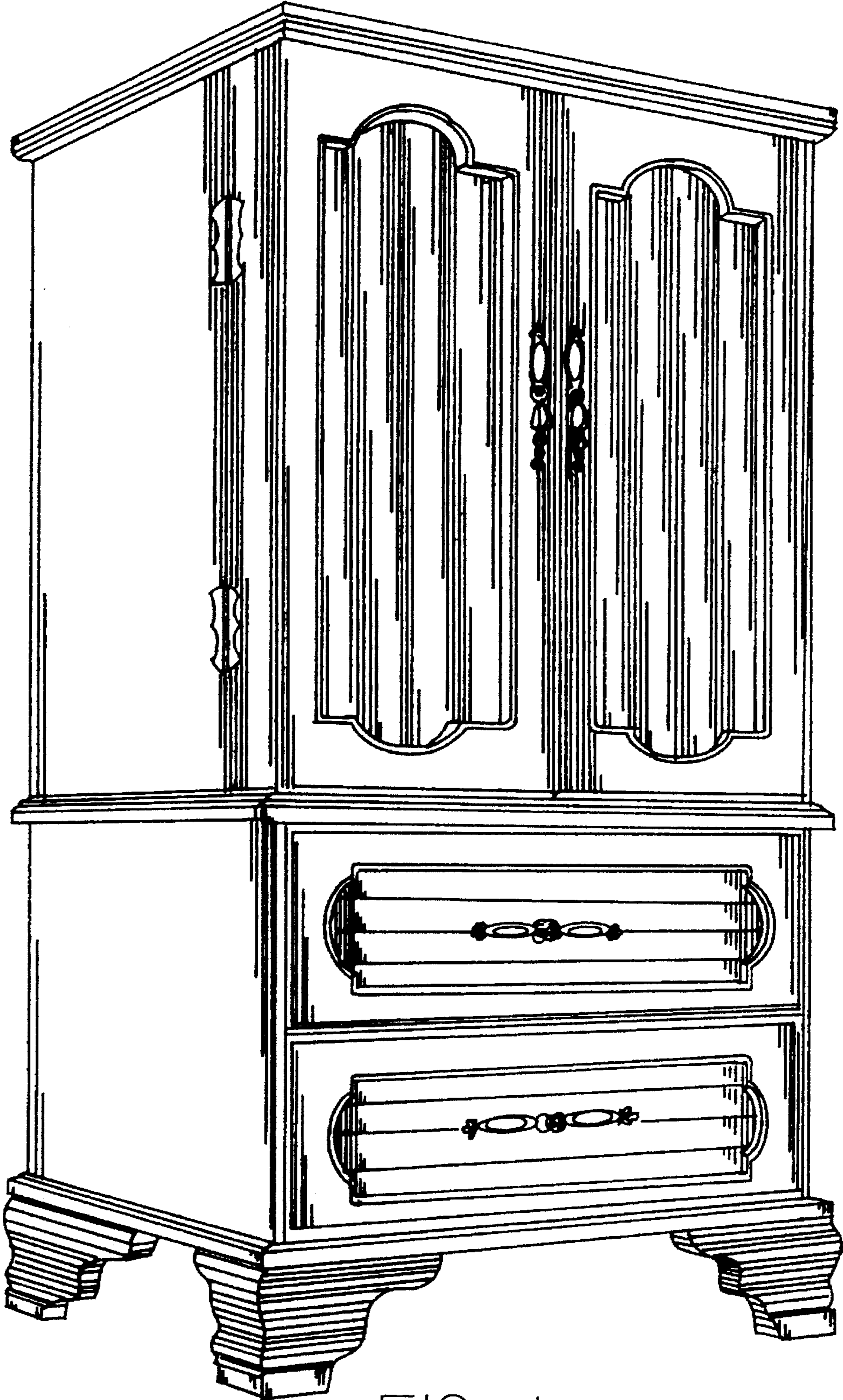

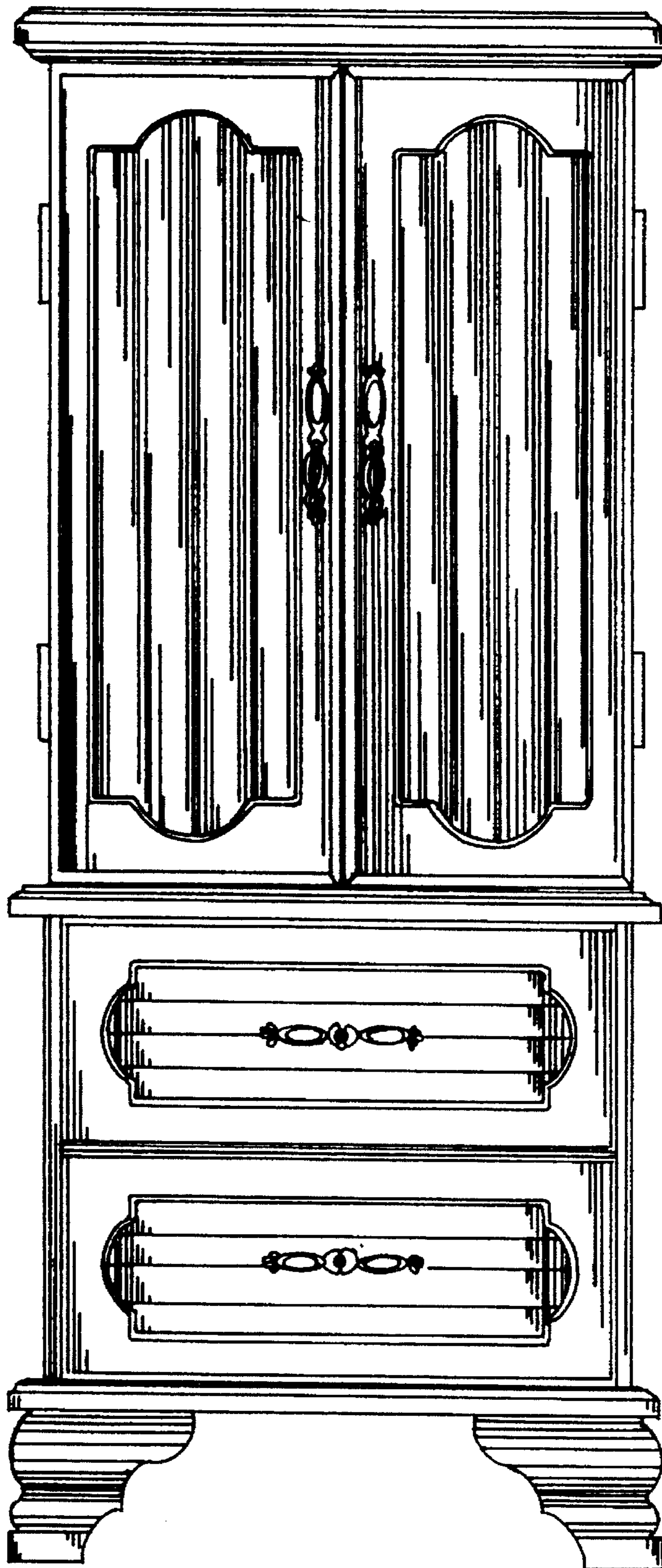

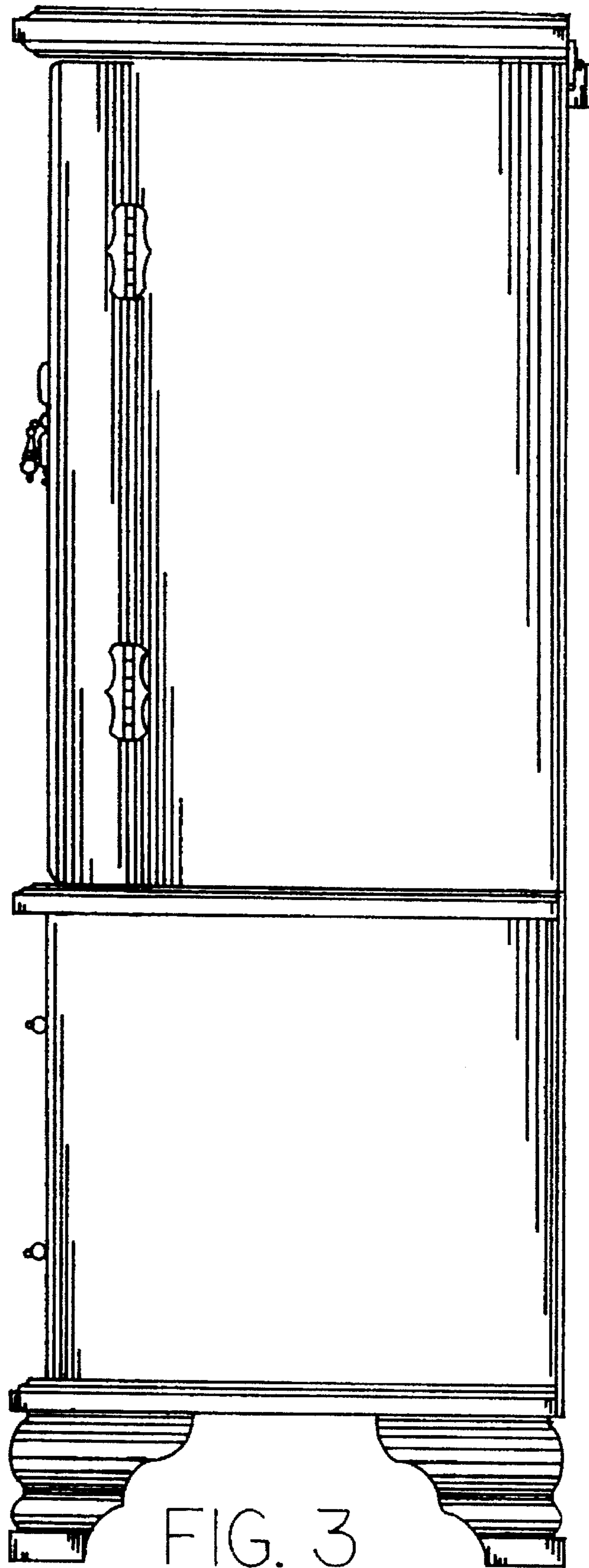

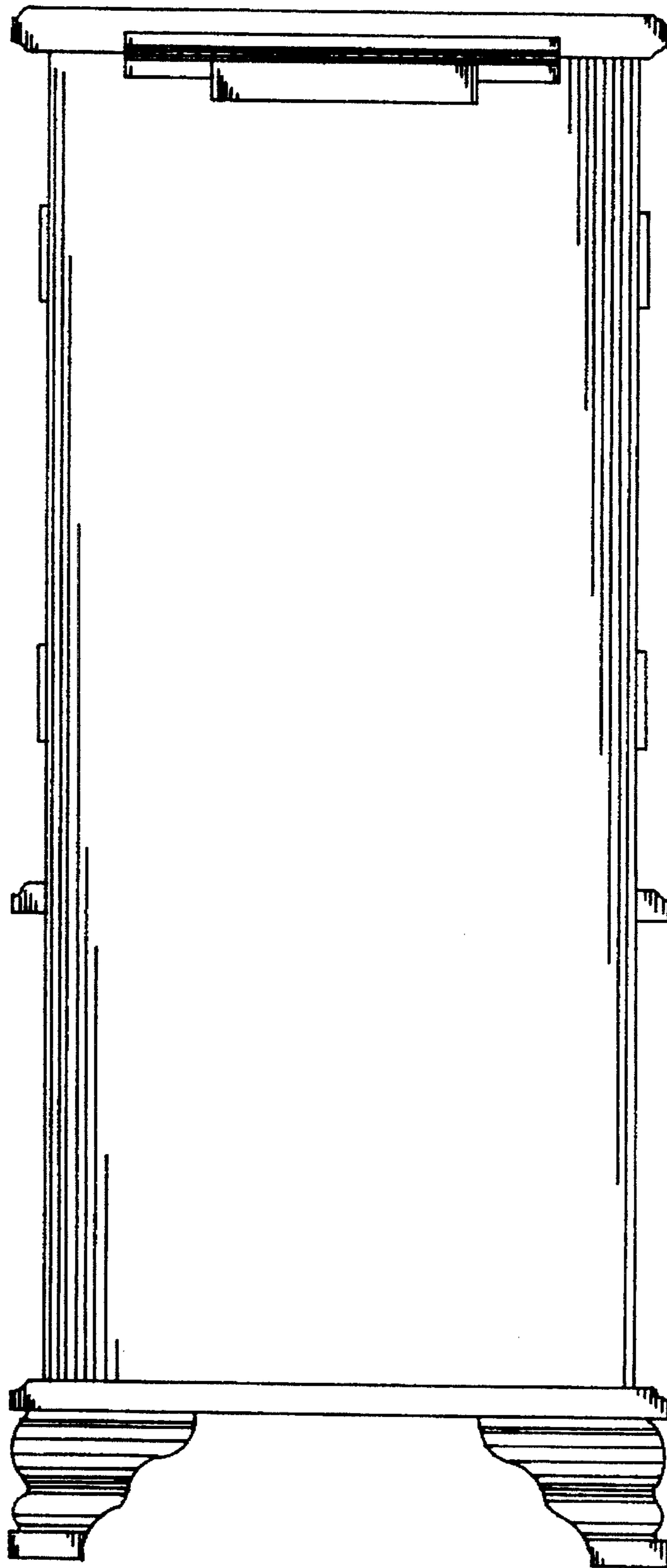

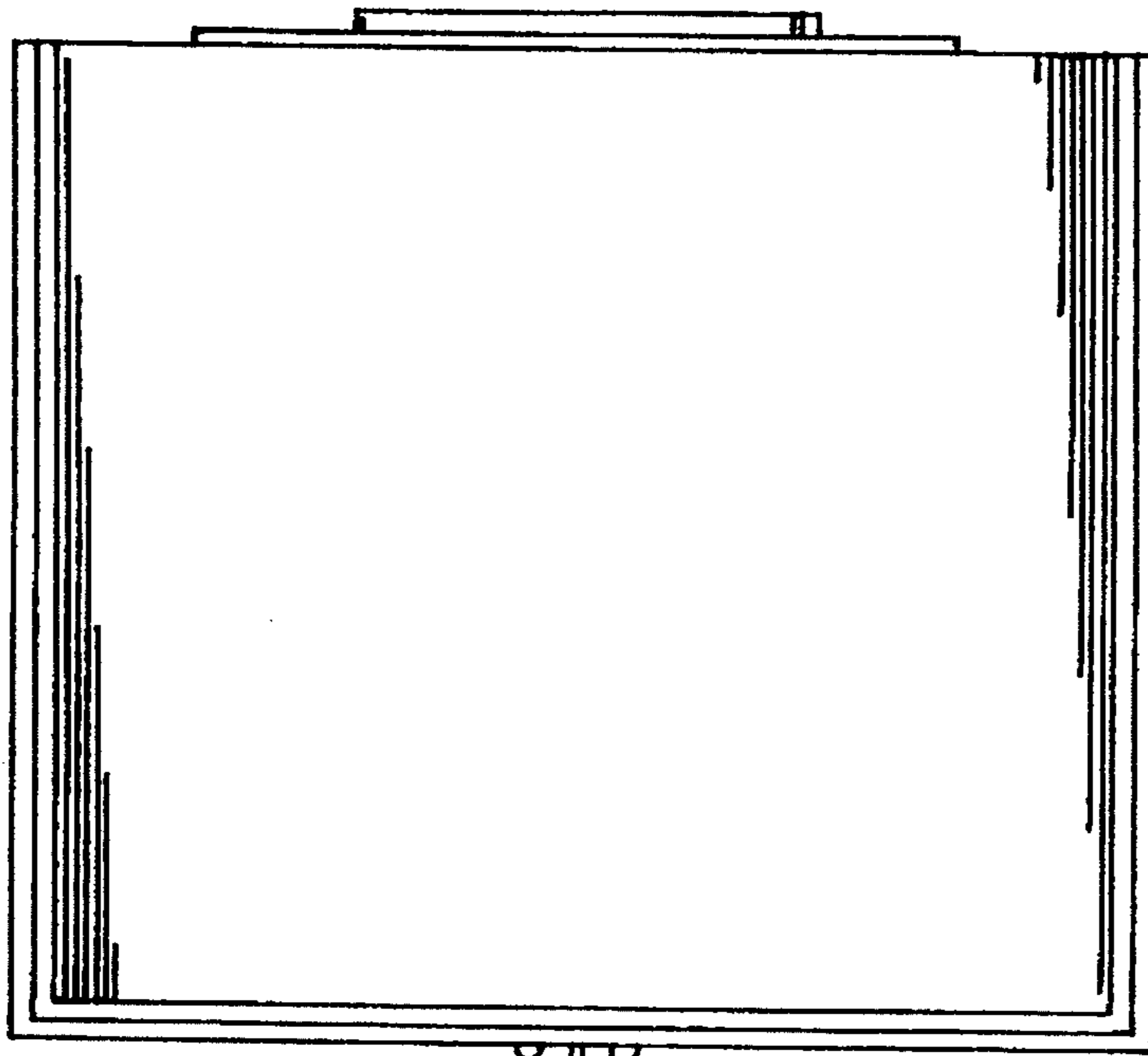

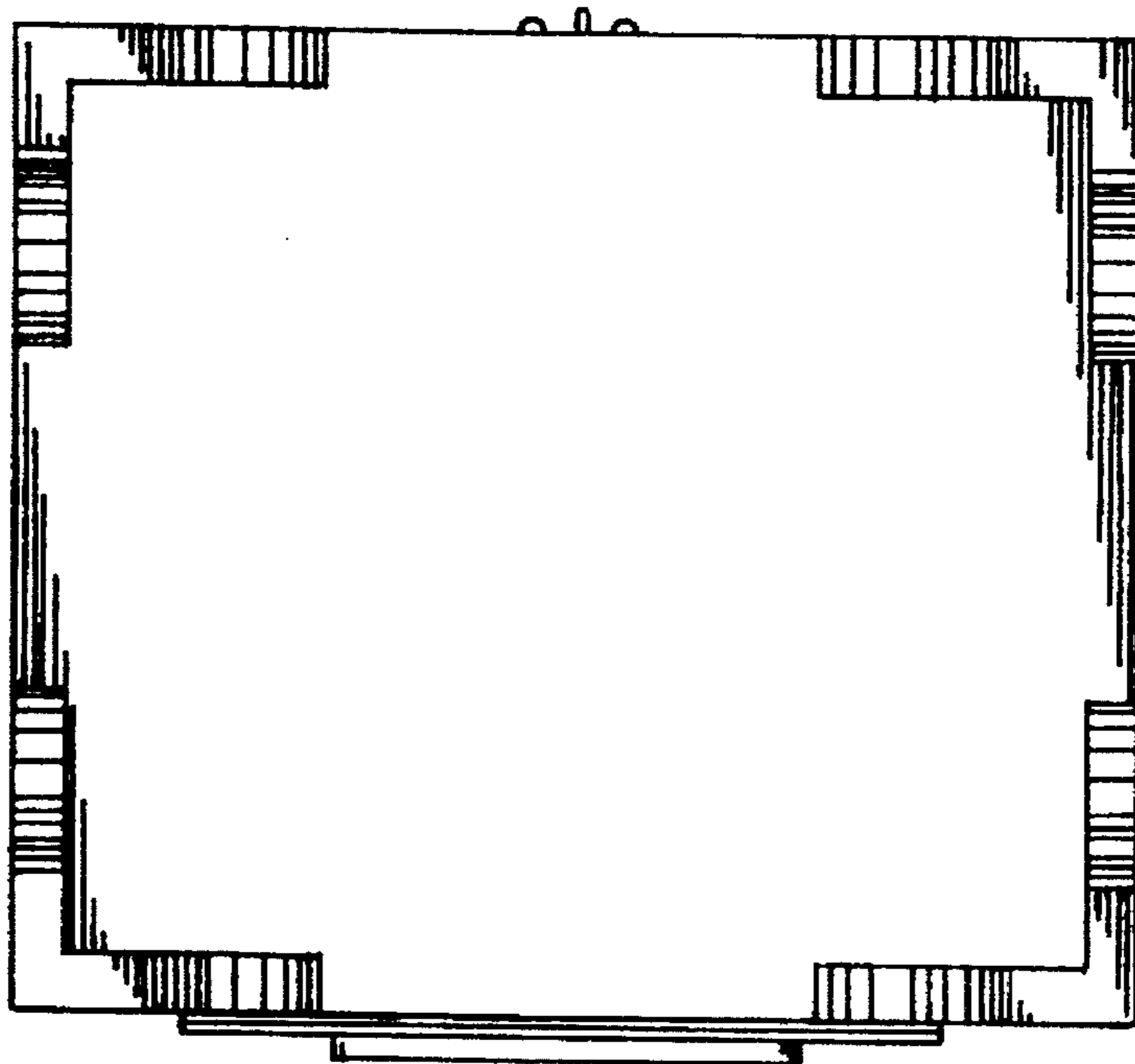

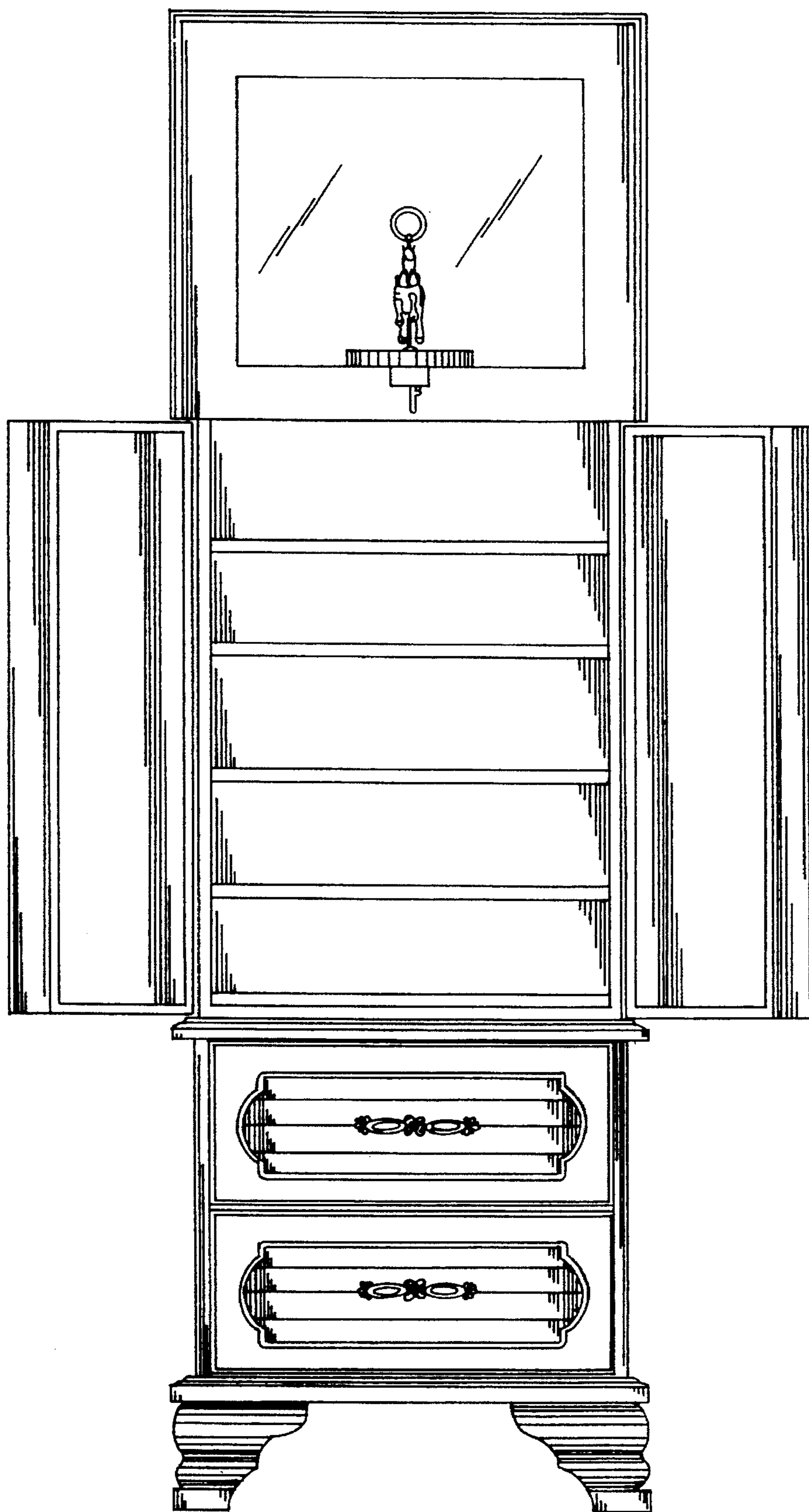

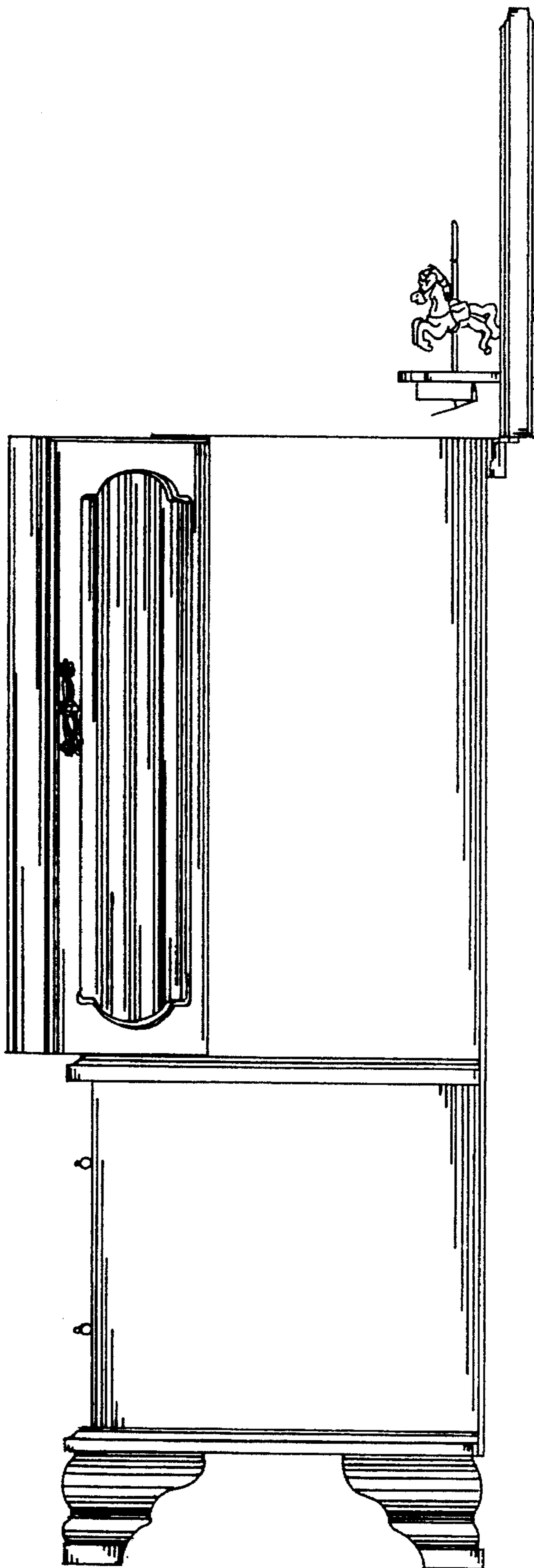

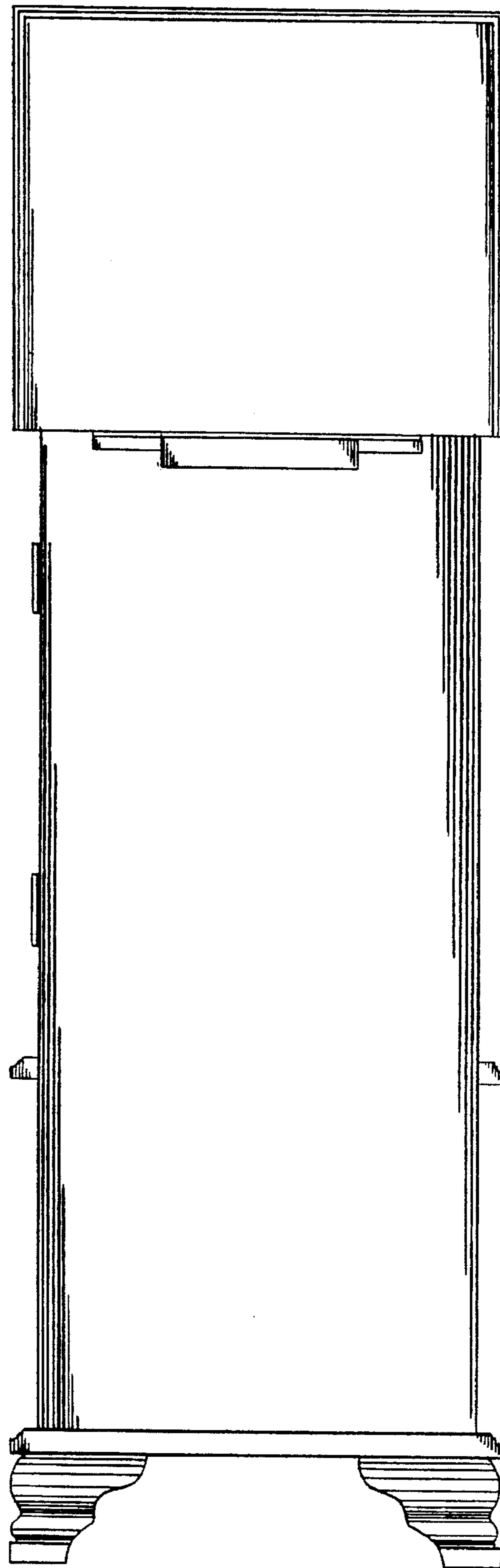

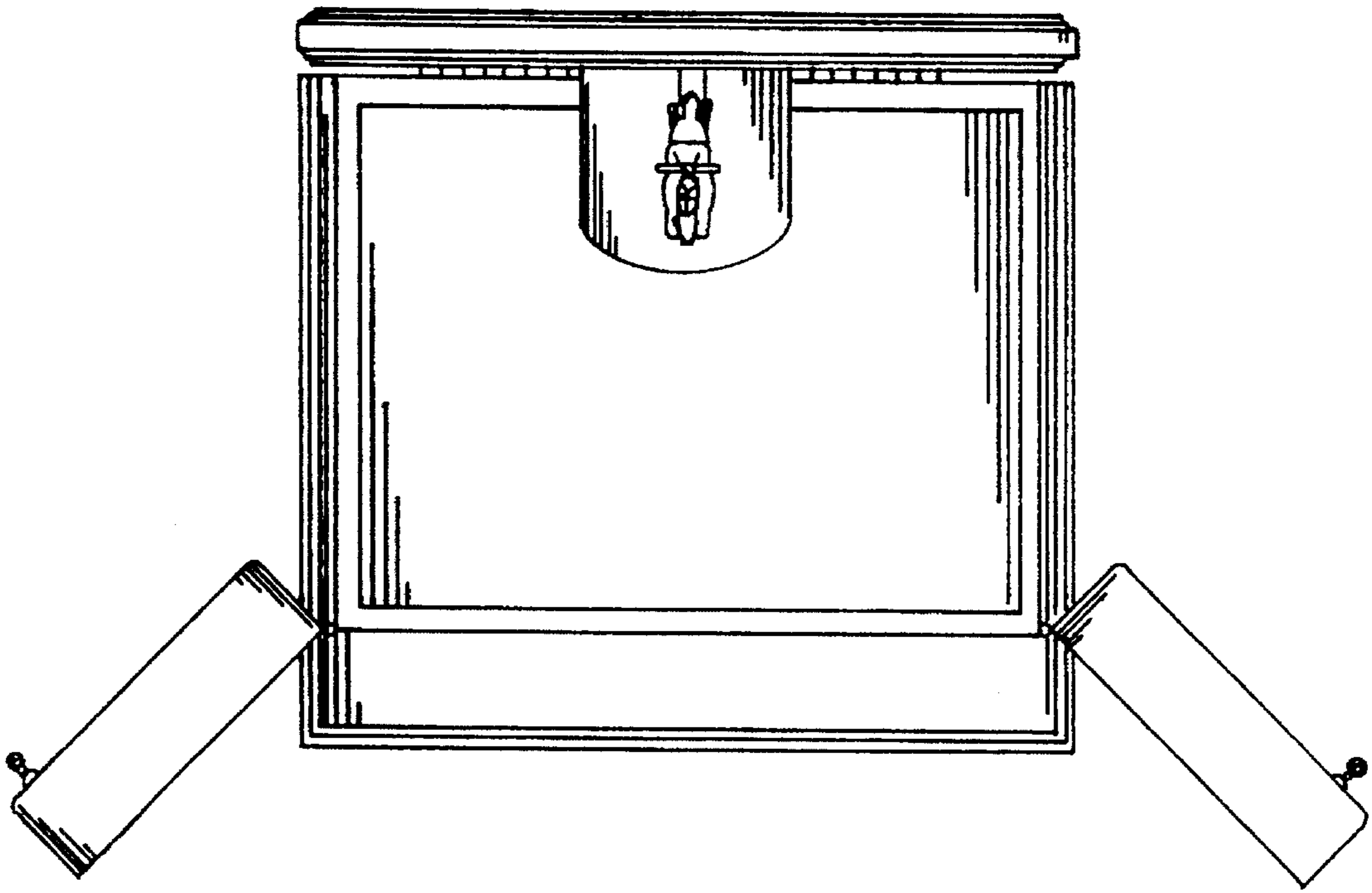

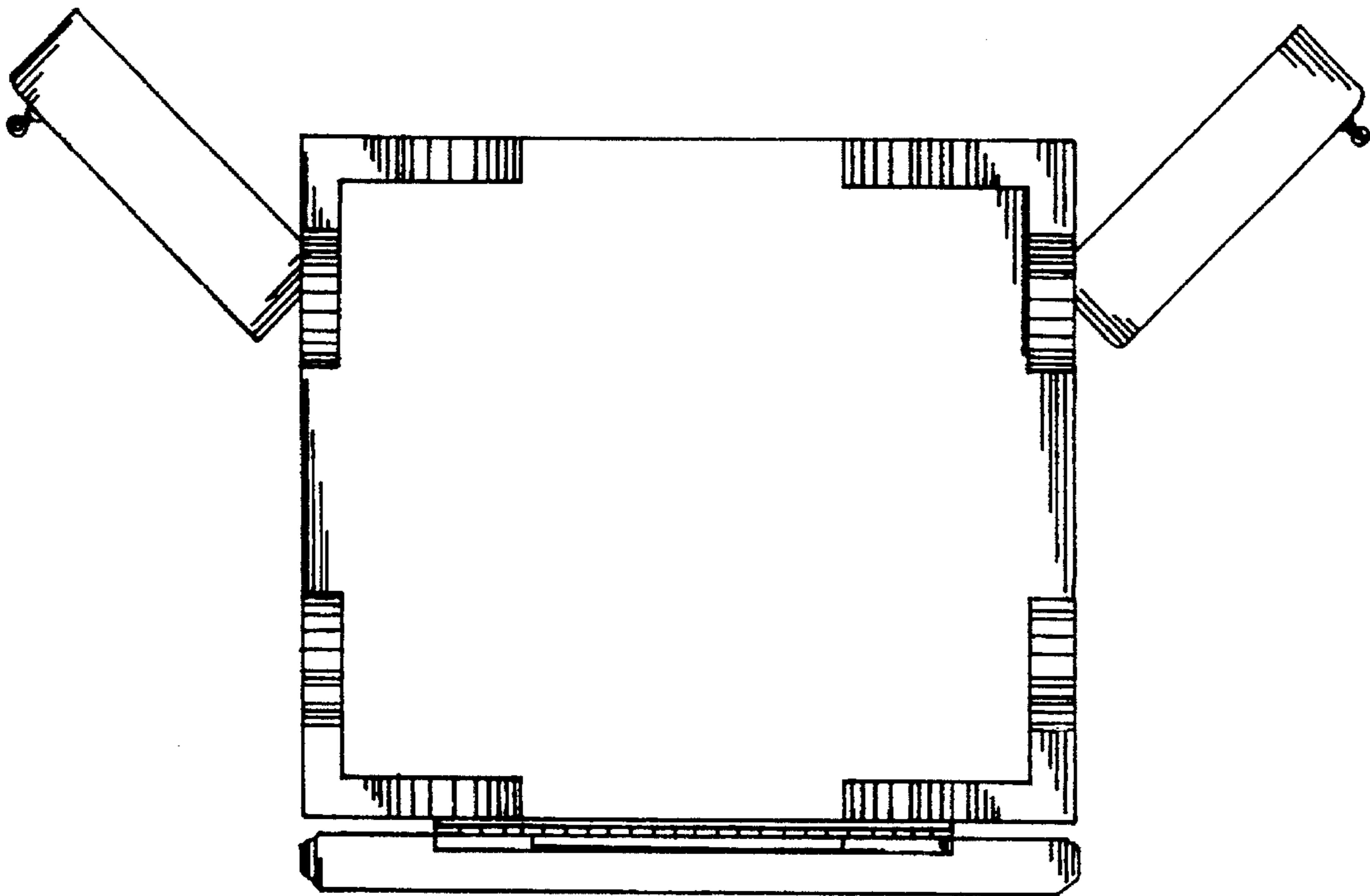
