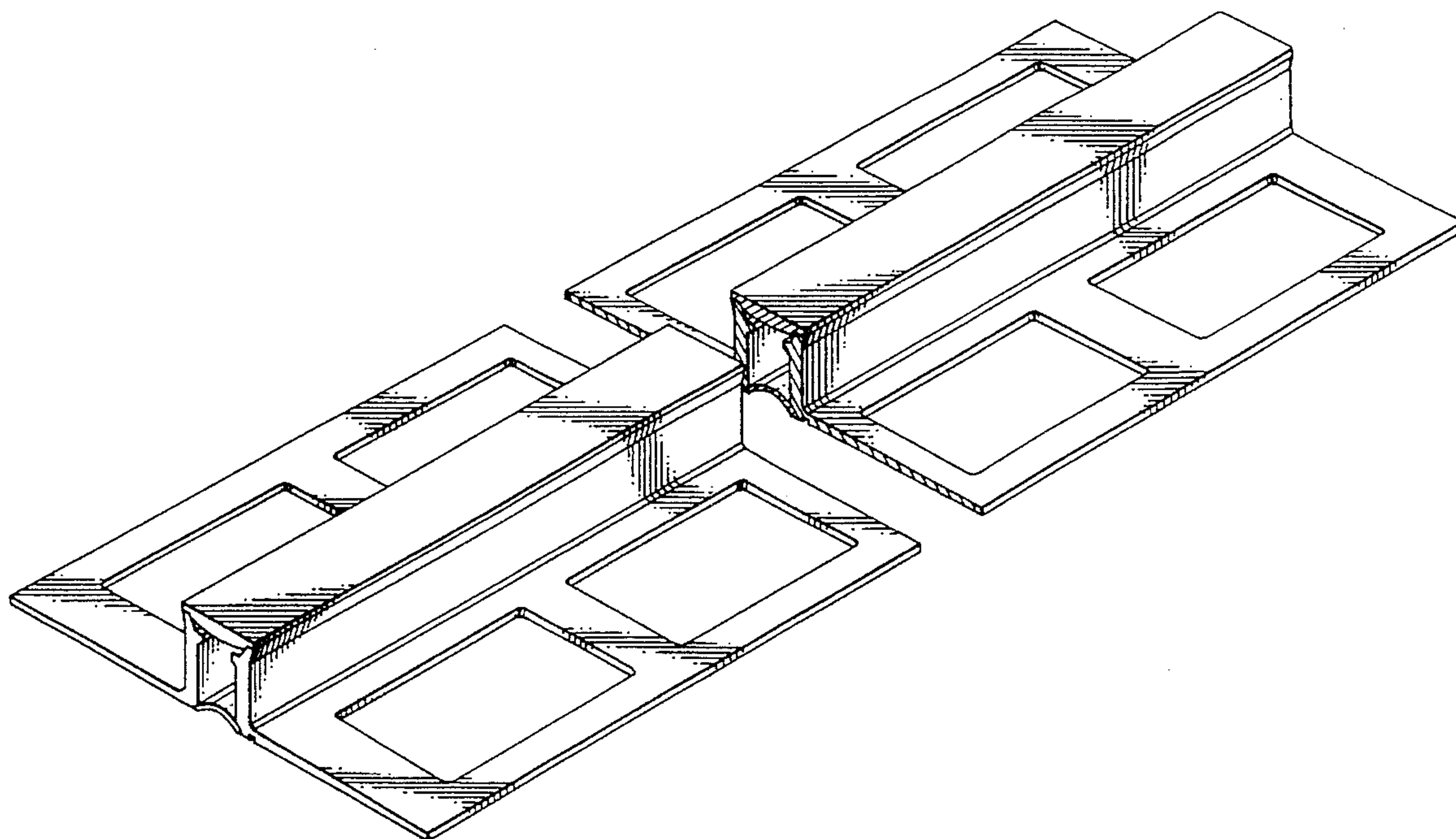
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an expansion strip for tiled surfaces, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from one end of the expansion strip for tiled surfaces which is broken in the center to indicate indeterminate length, and the pattern of the openings is repeated throughout the length thereof; and, FIG. 2 is an enlarged view of the other end.

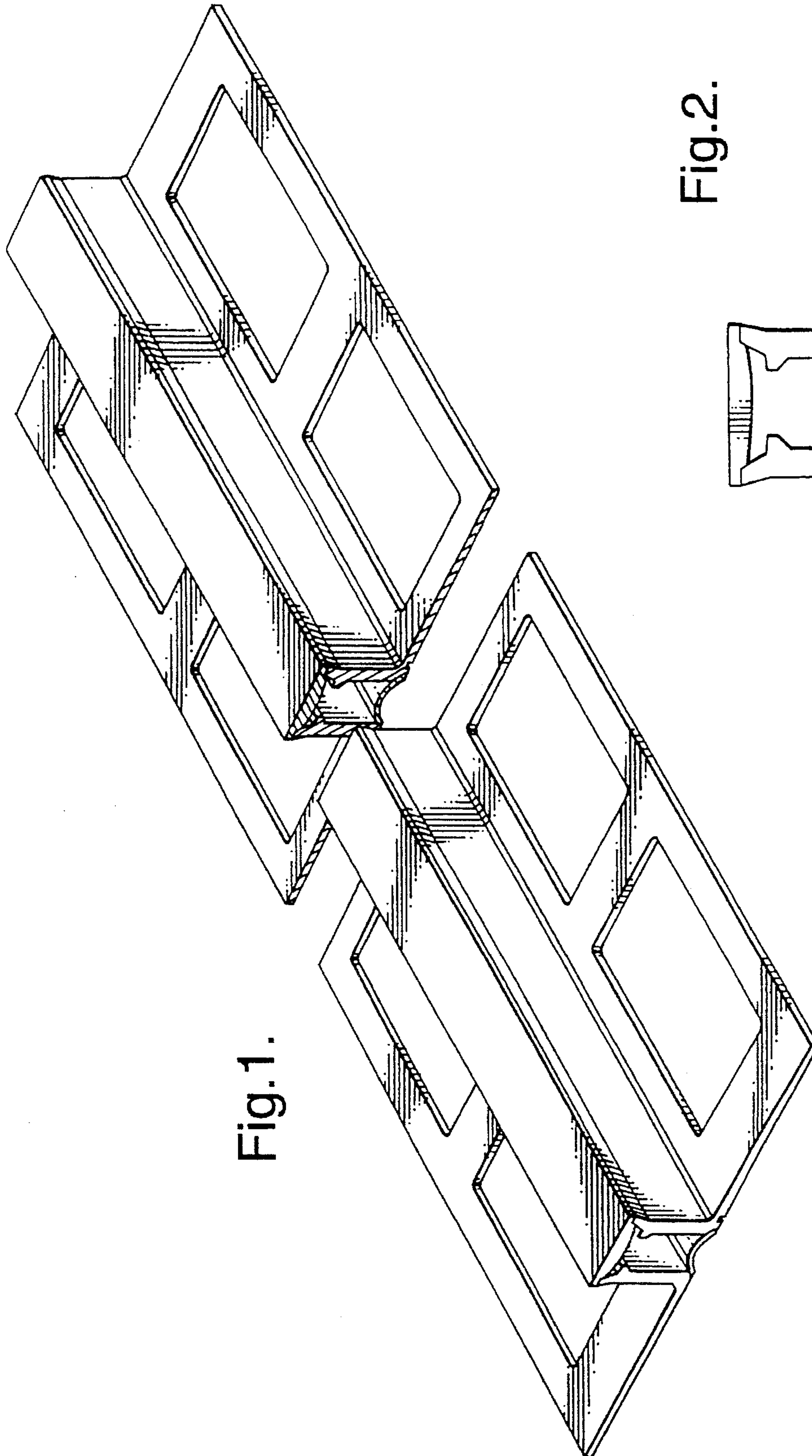
