[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The bottom of the seat is plain and unornamented. The broken line illustration of legs is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
