[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a product display unit with upper cooler shelf for merchandising cold products, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the present product with upper cooler shelf for display unit merchandising cold products showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

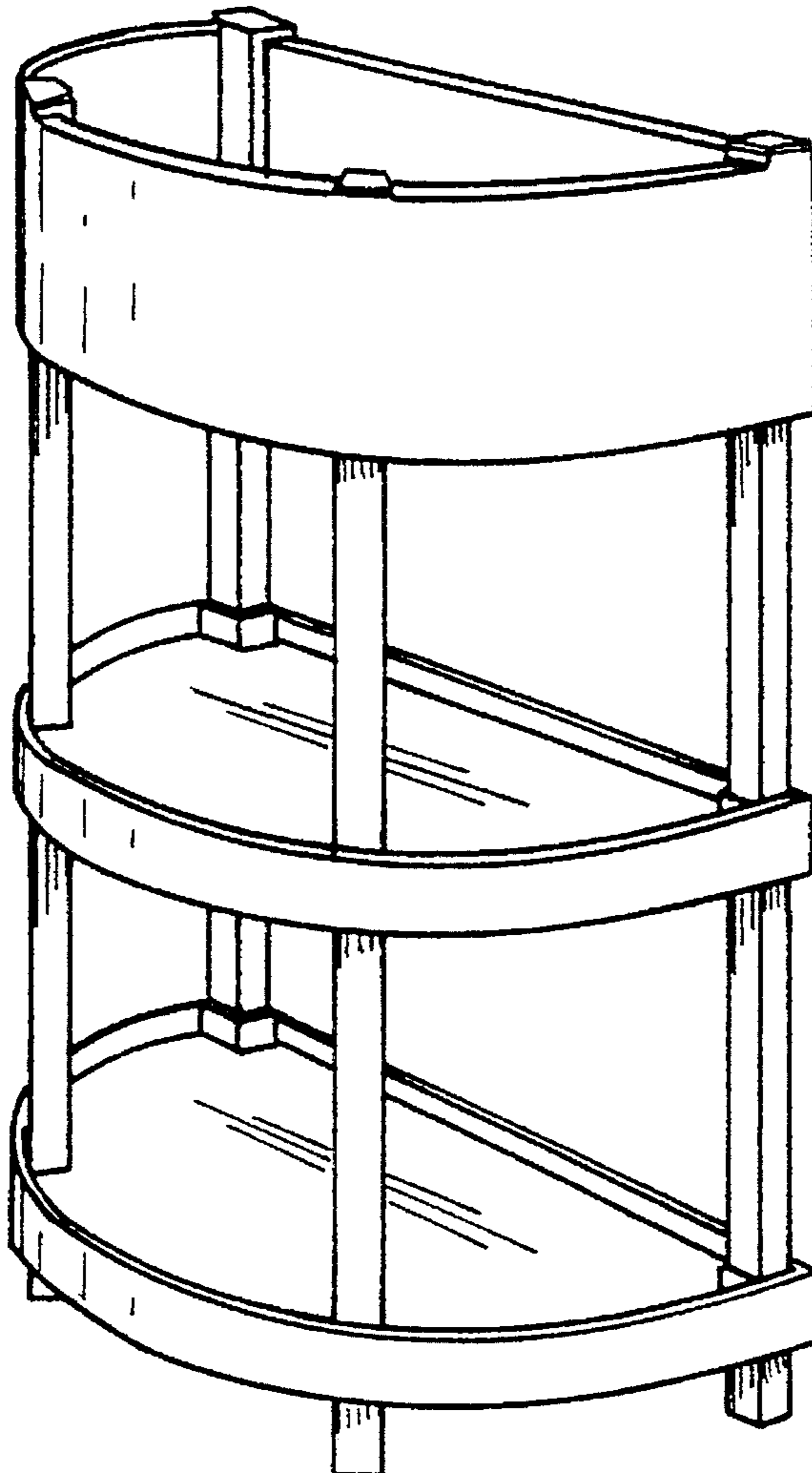
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

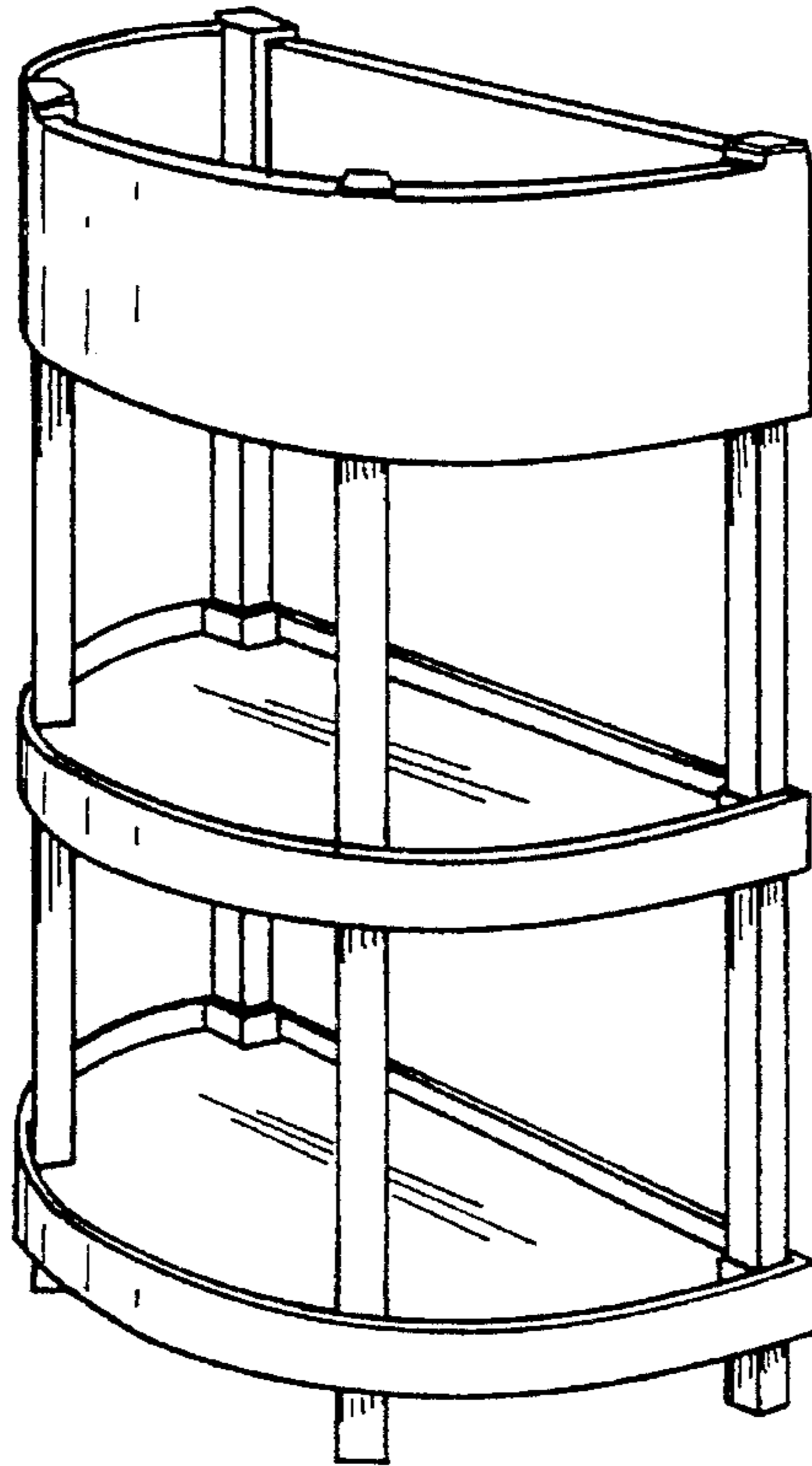

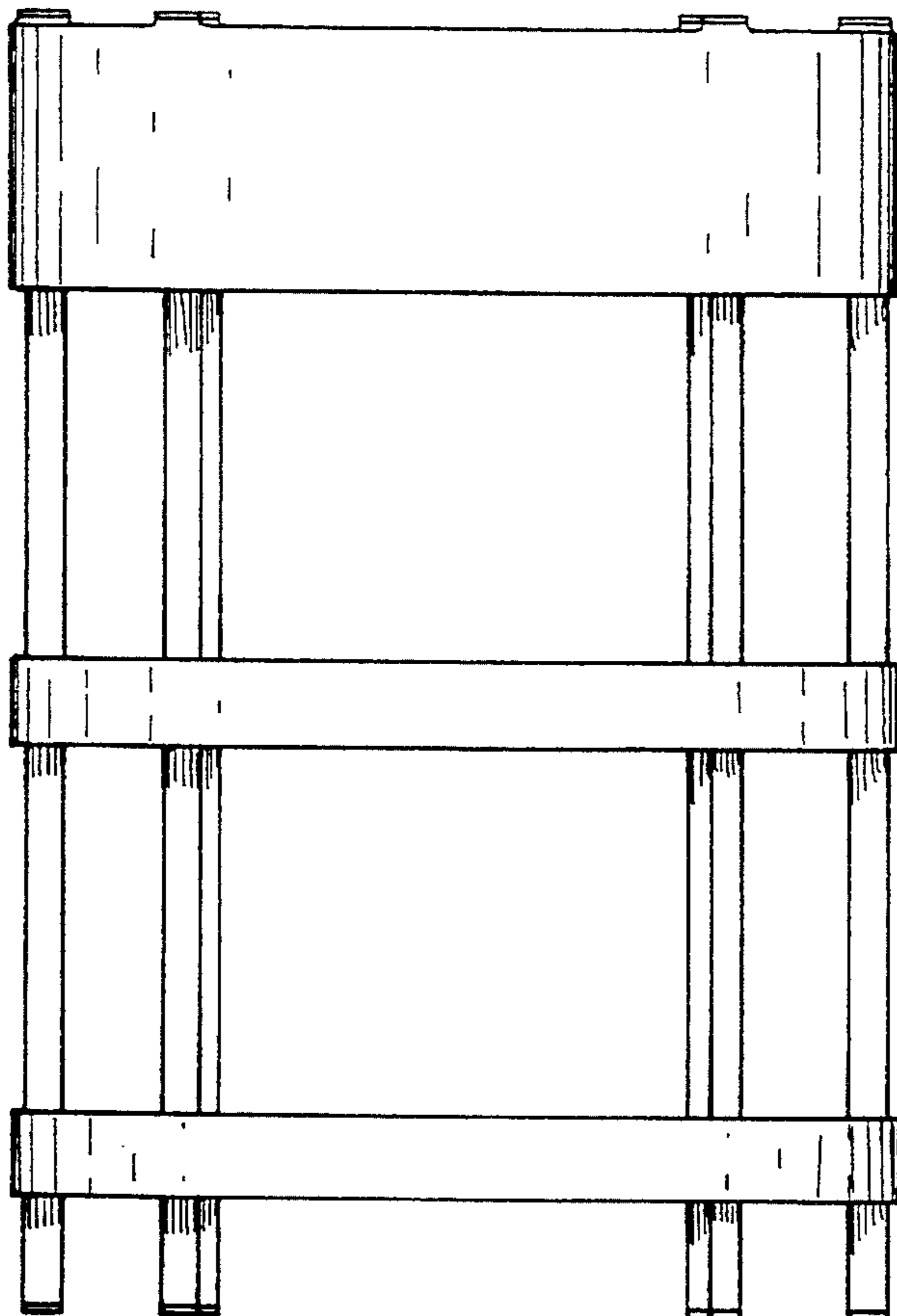

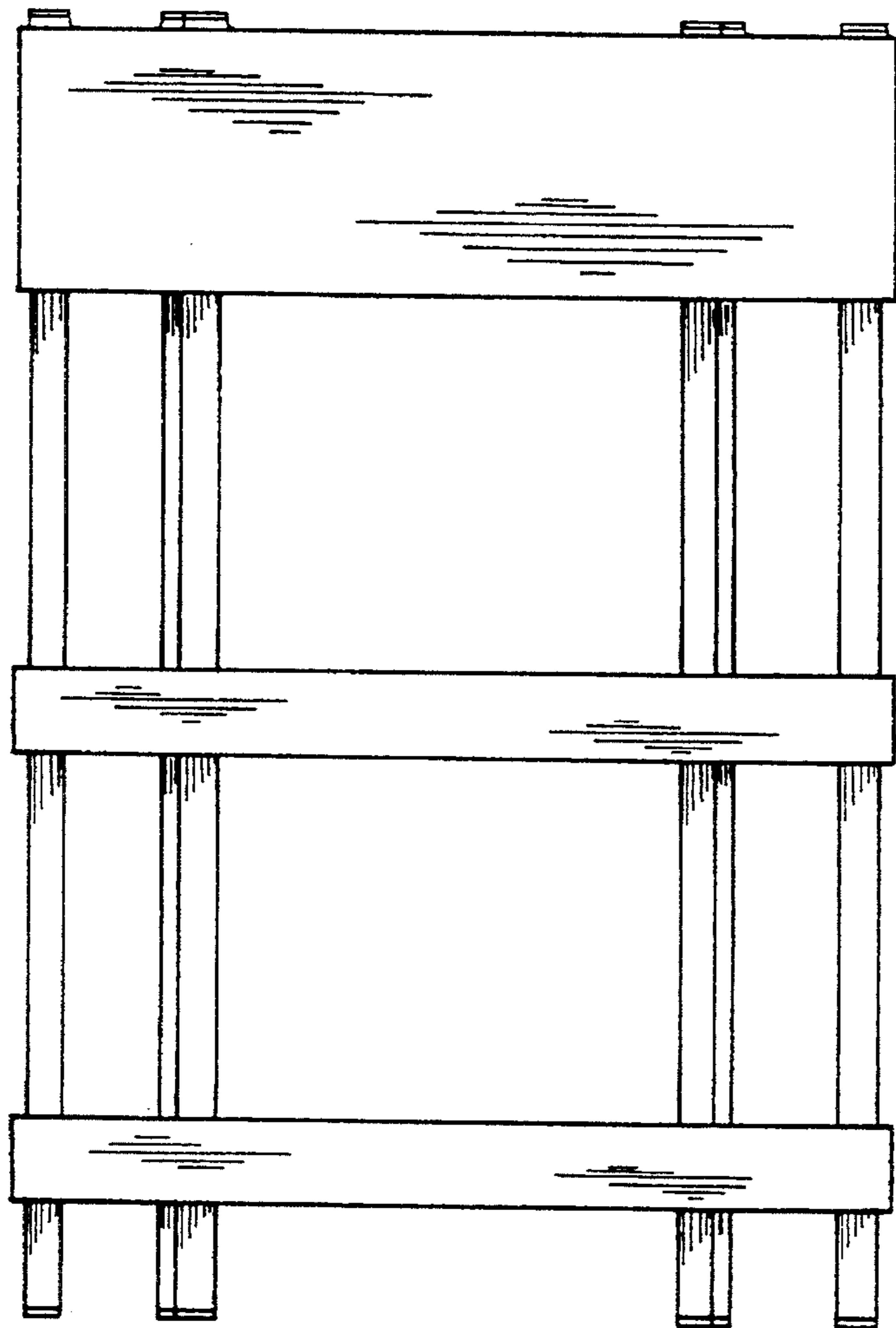

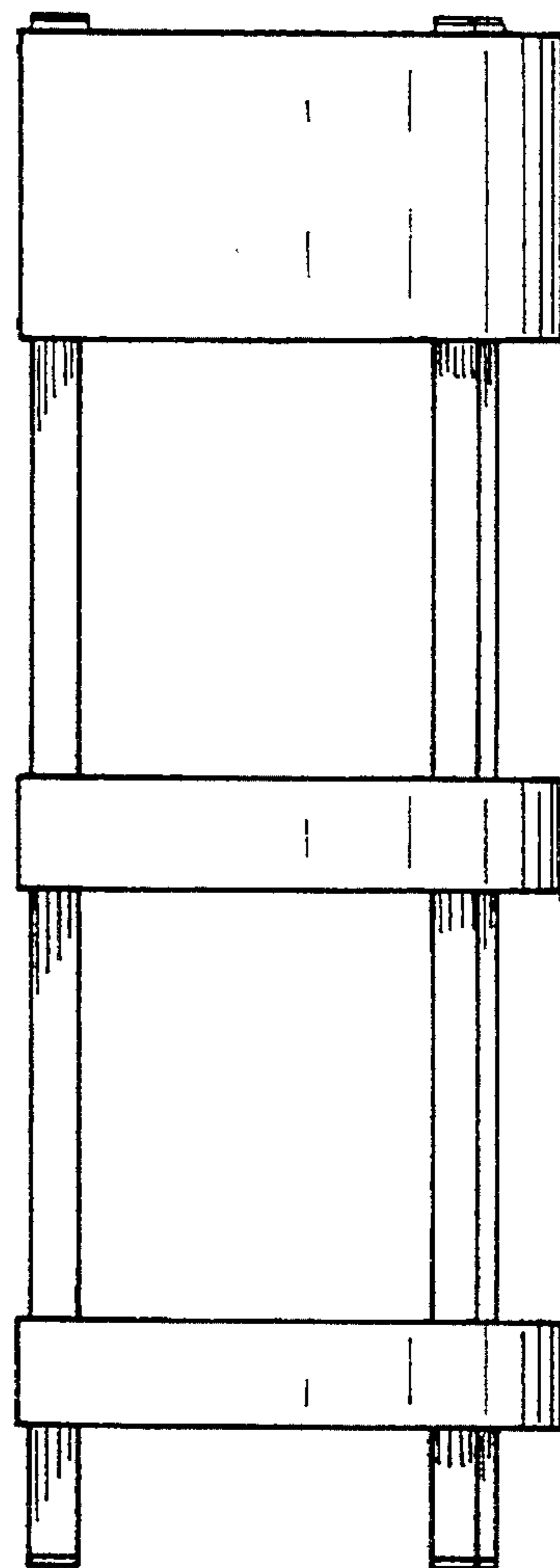

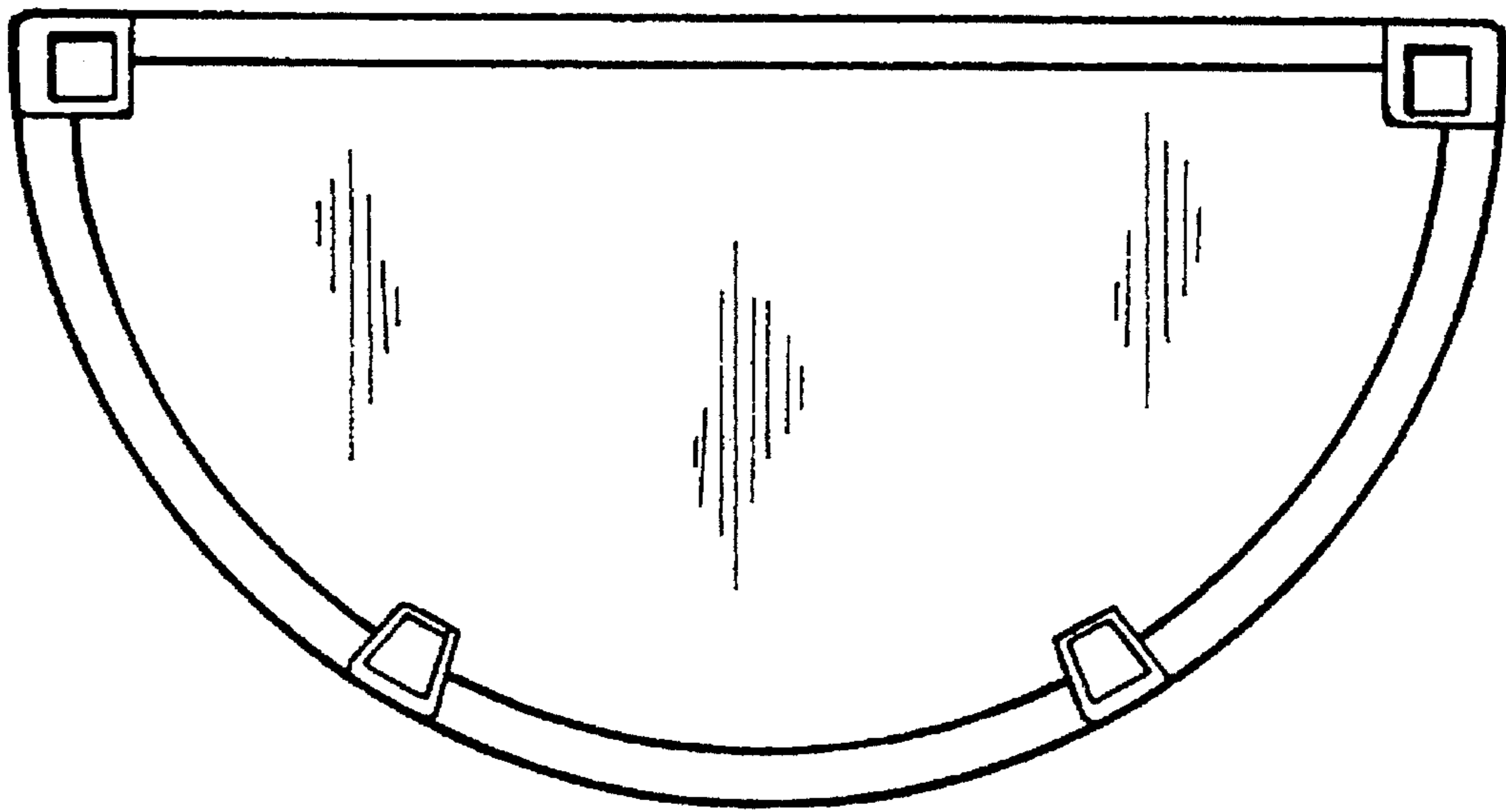

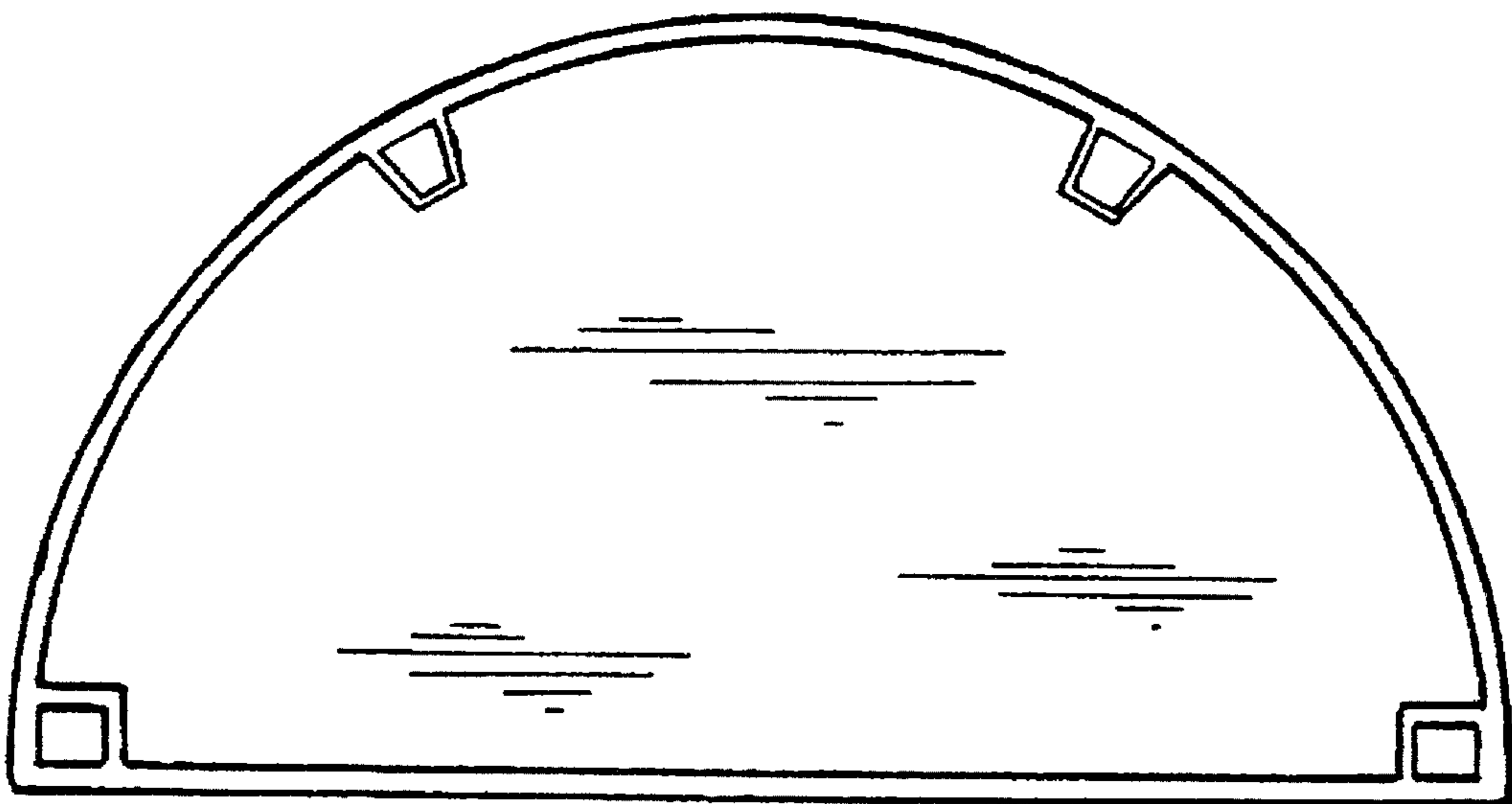
