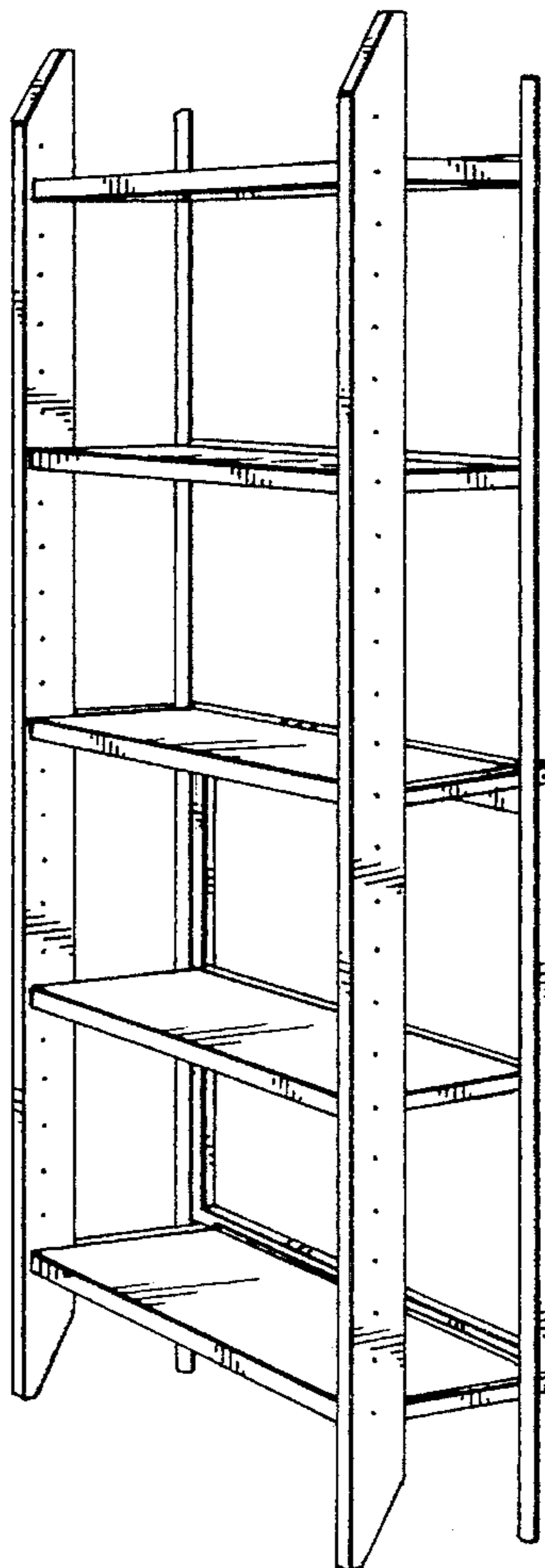
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the self standing shelving unit according to the present invention.

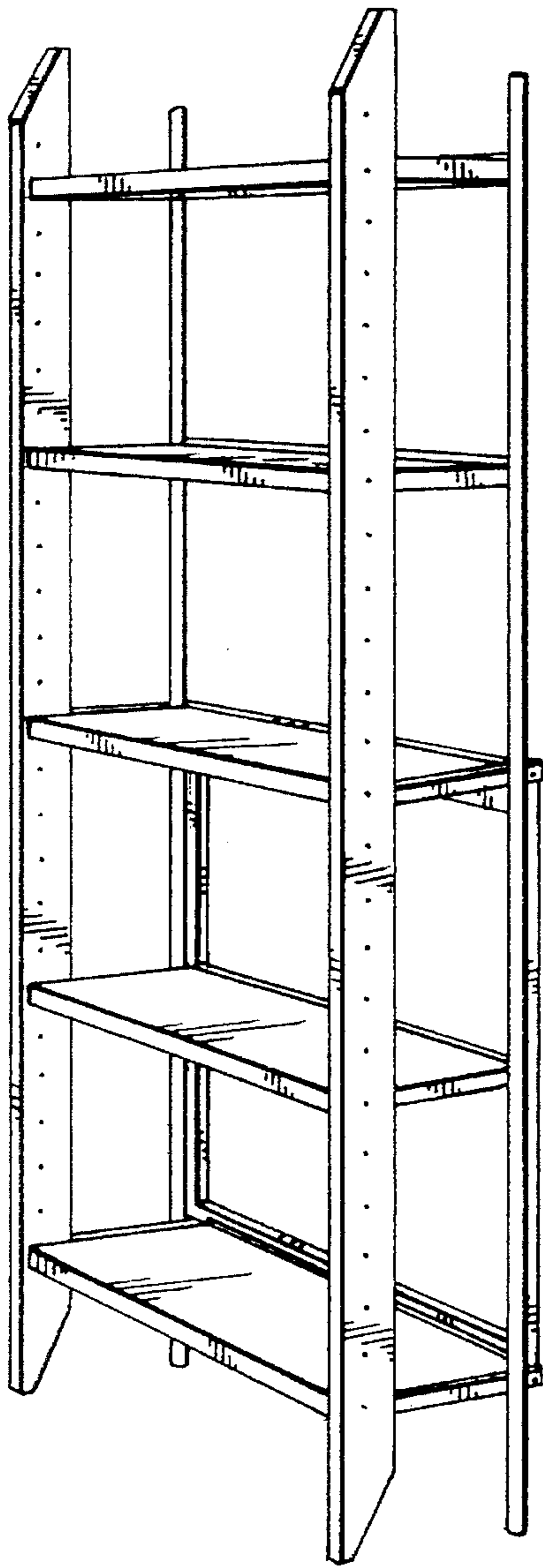

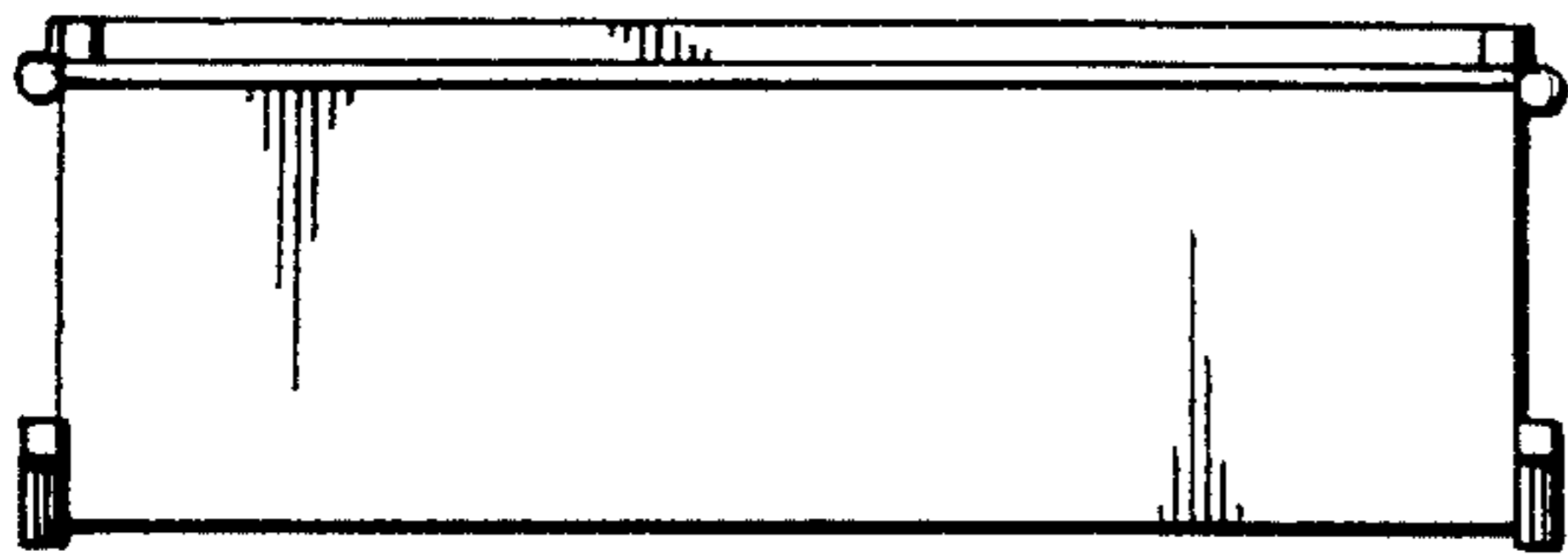
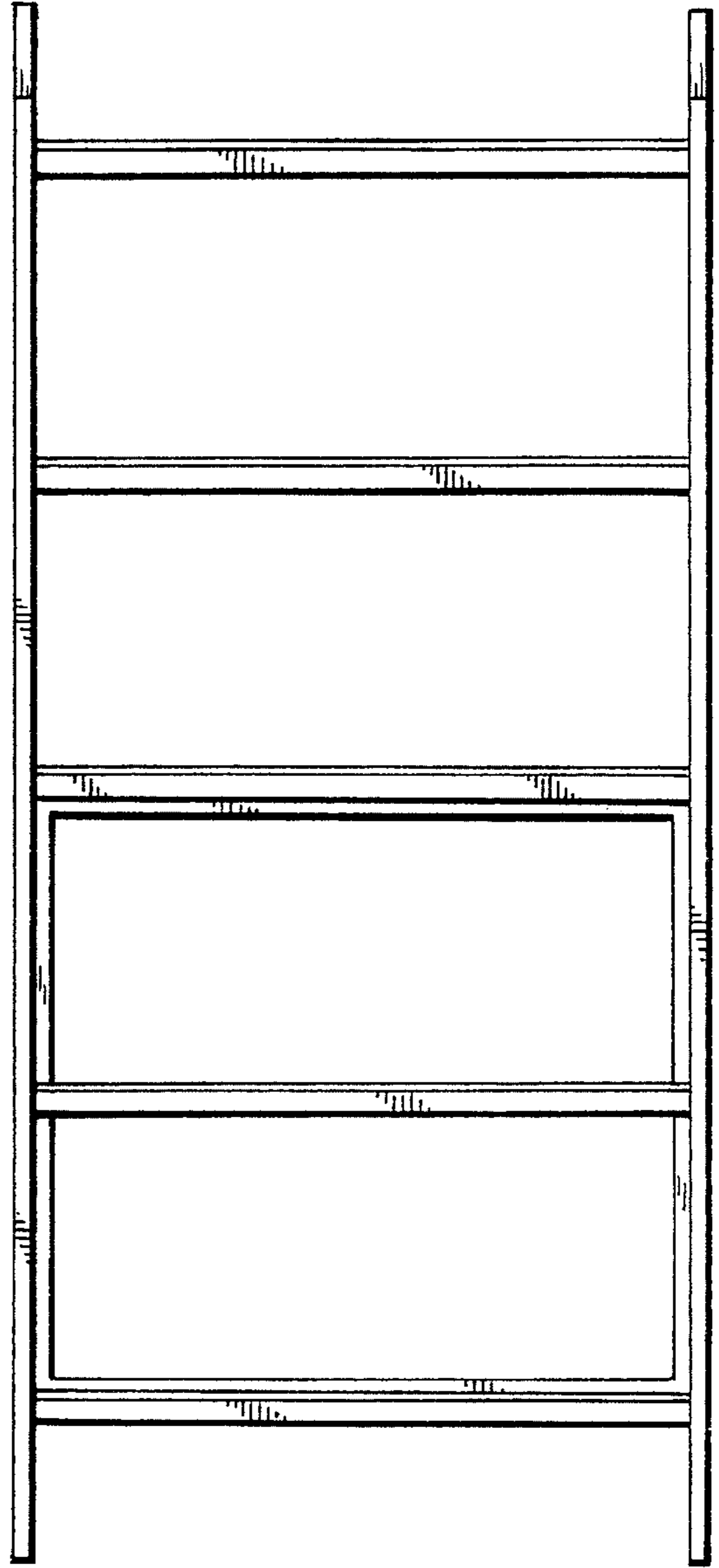

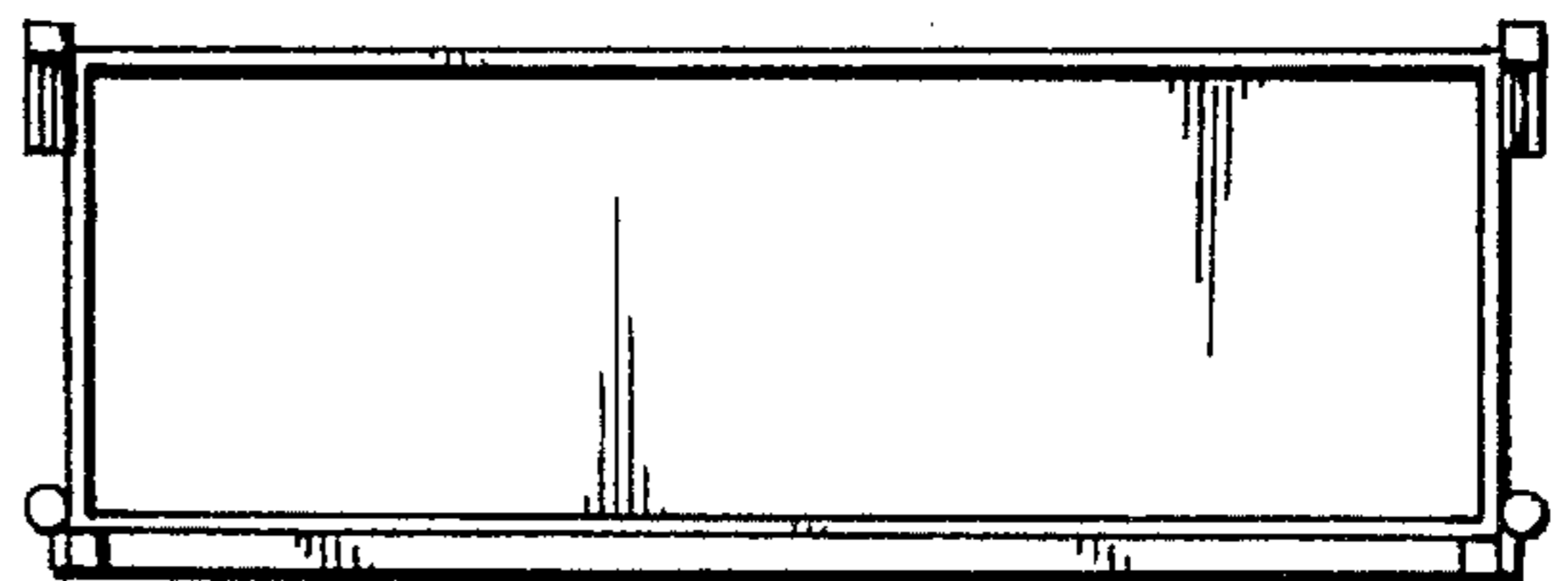

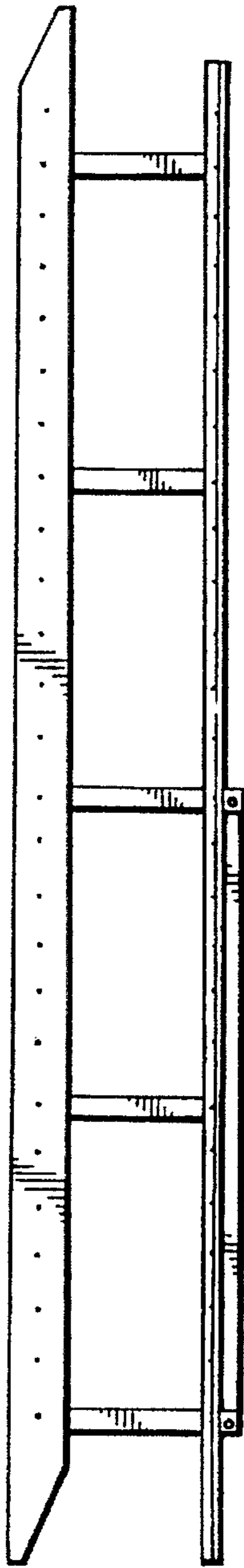
