[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the front section of a cabinet for a combined television and video cassette recorder/player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a front section of a cabinet for a combined television and video cassette recorder/player; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation view being a mirror image; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken lines showing the environmental structure of a rear section of a cabinet for a combined television and video cassette recorder/player in FIGS. 4 and 5 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

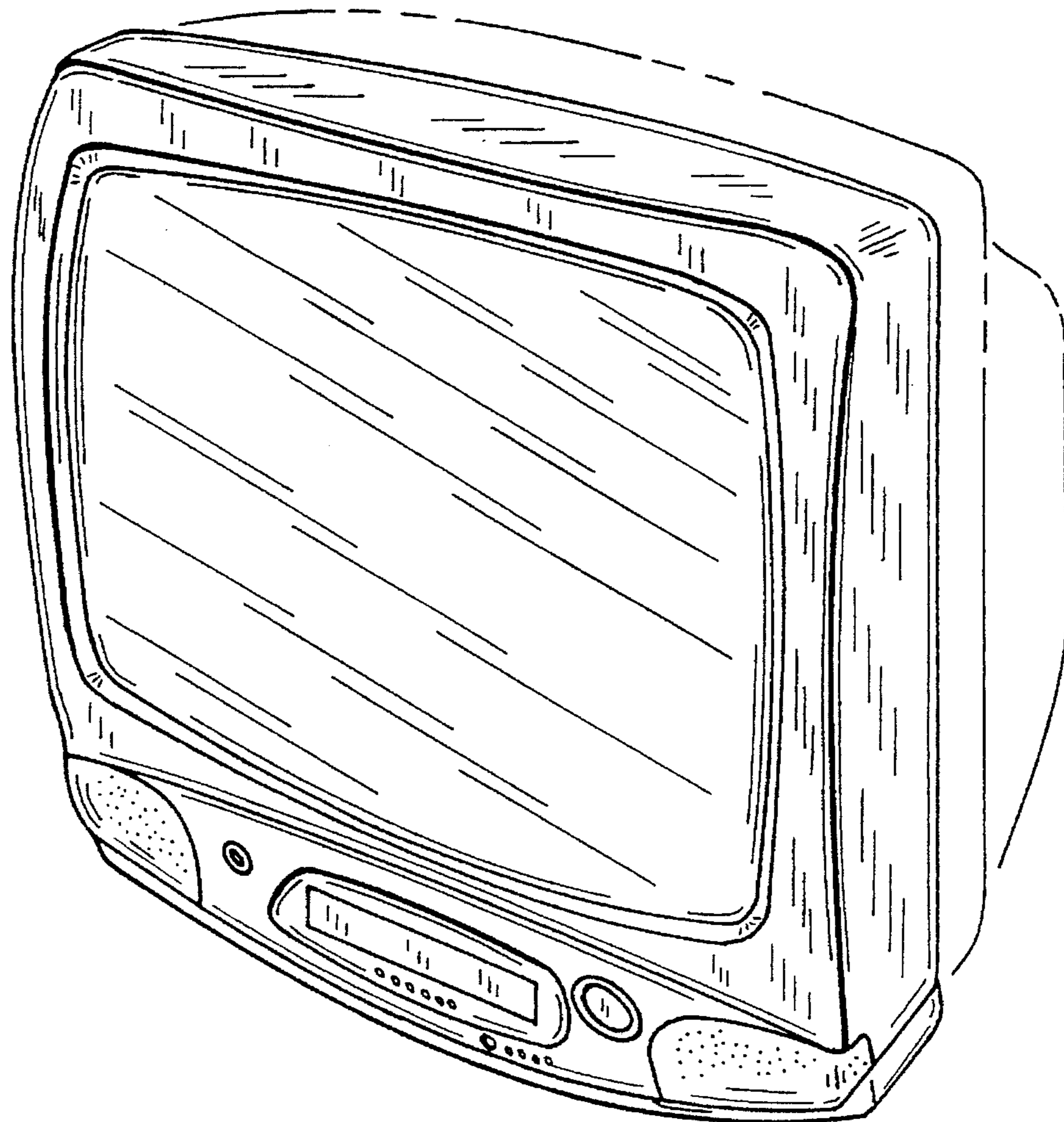

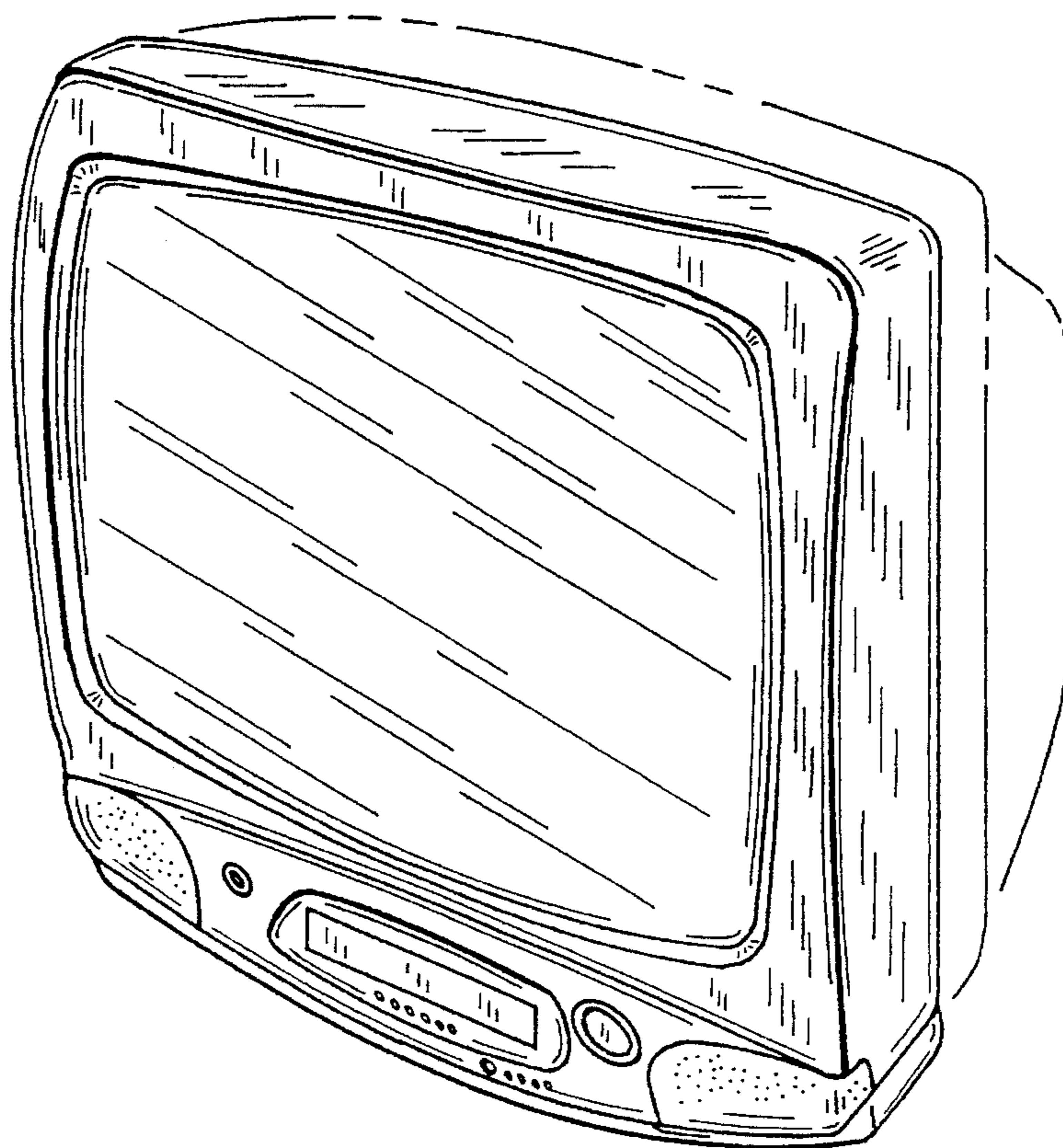

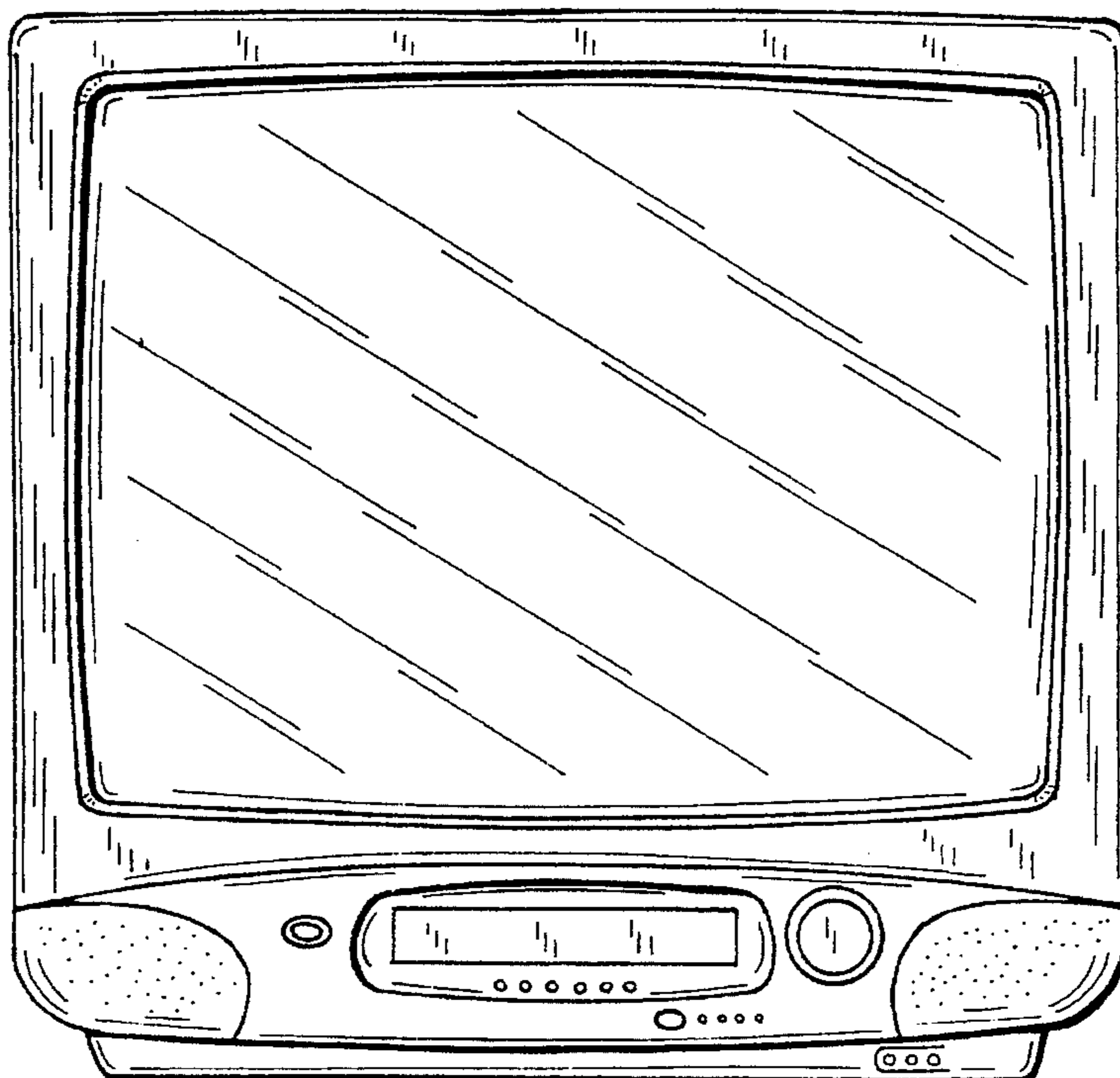

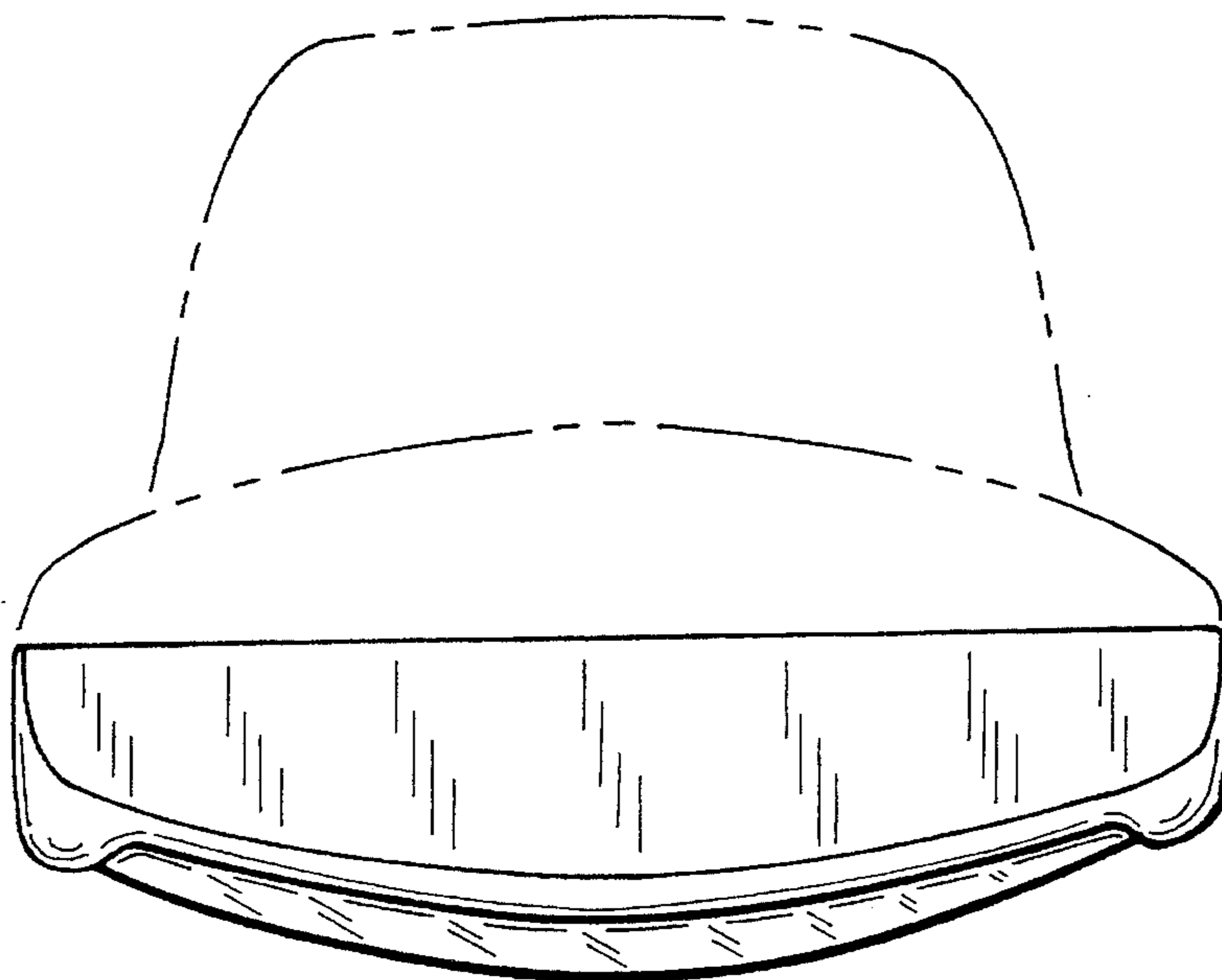

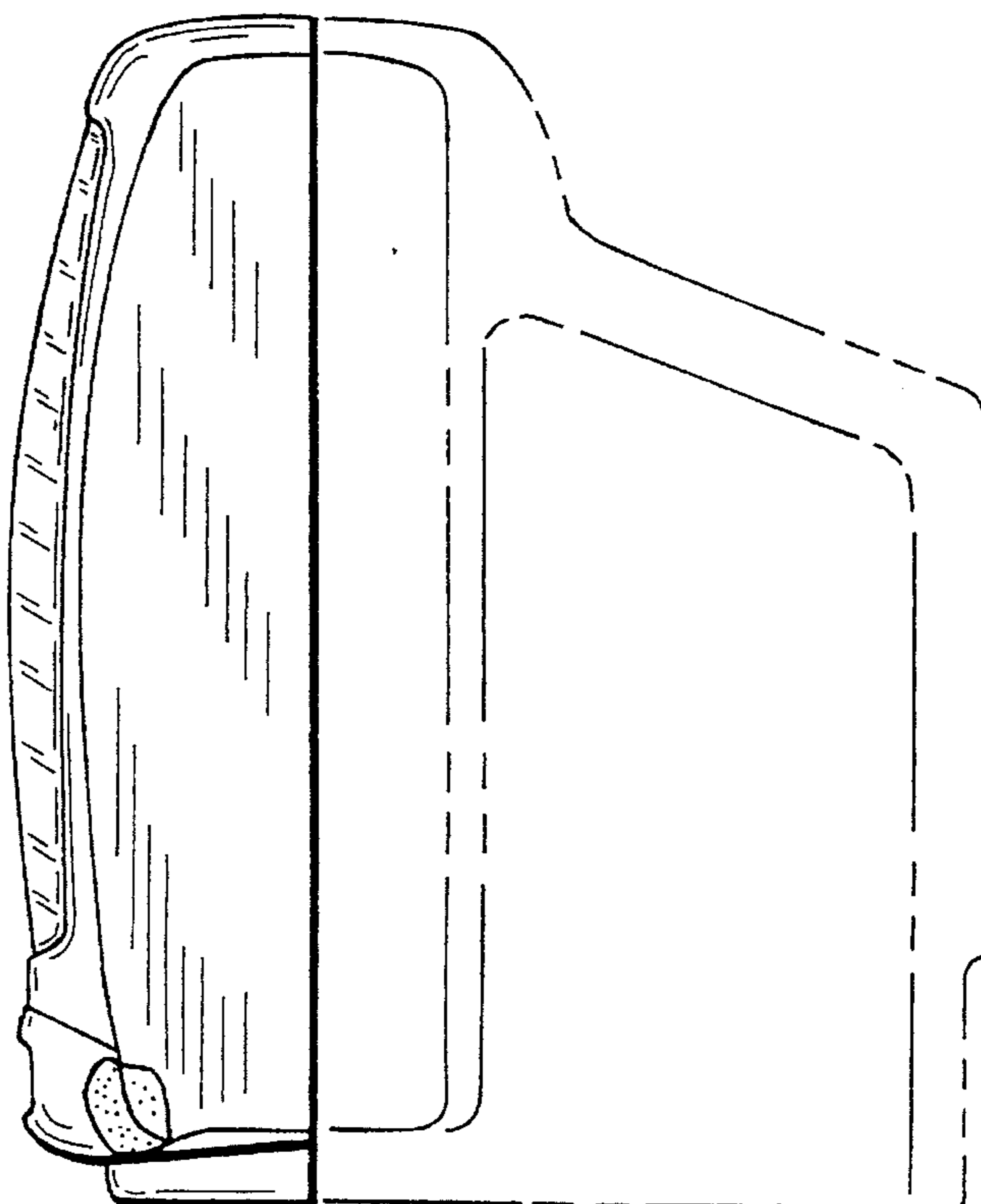
