[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a neck brace, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a neck brace, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged cross-sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, in use condition.

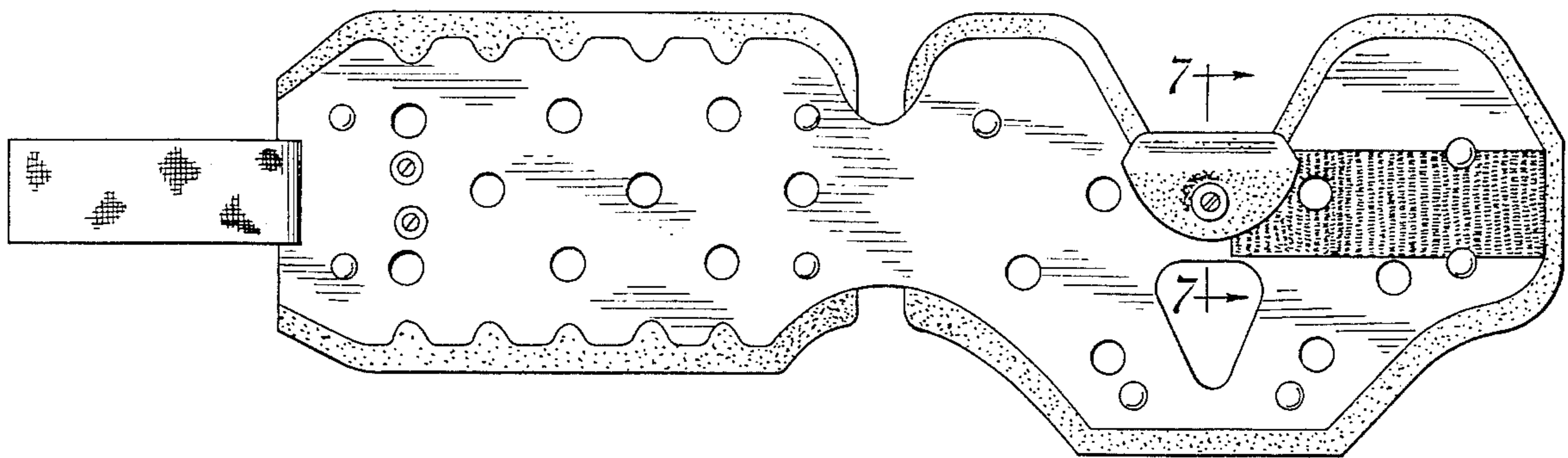

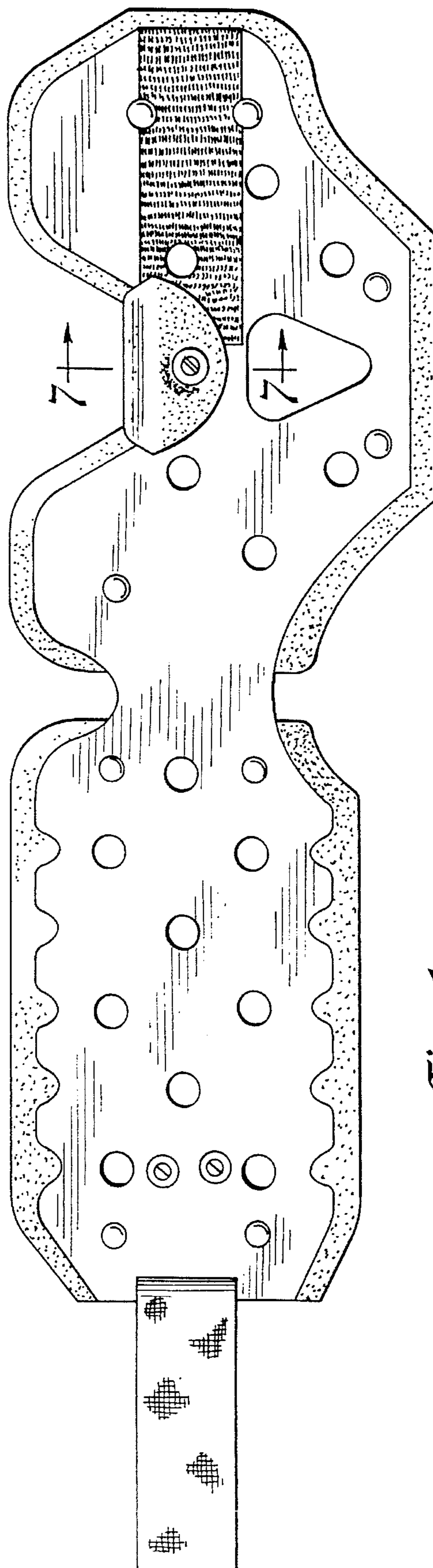
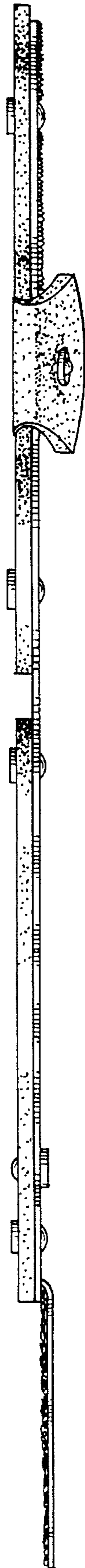
