[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a head for a flashlight, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the front, top, and right side of a head for a flashlight showing my new design, the portion shown in phantom is illustrative of a flexible core to which my new design may be attached;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

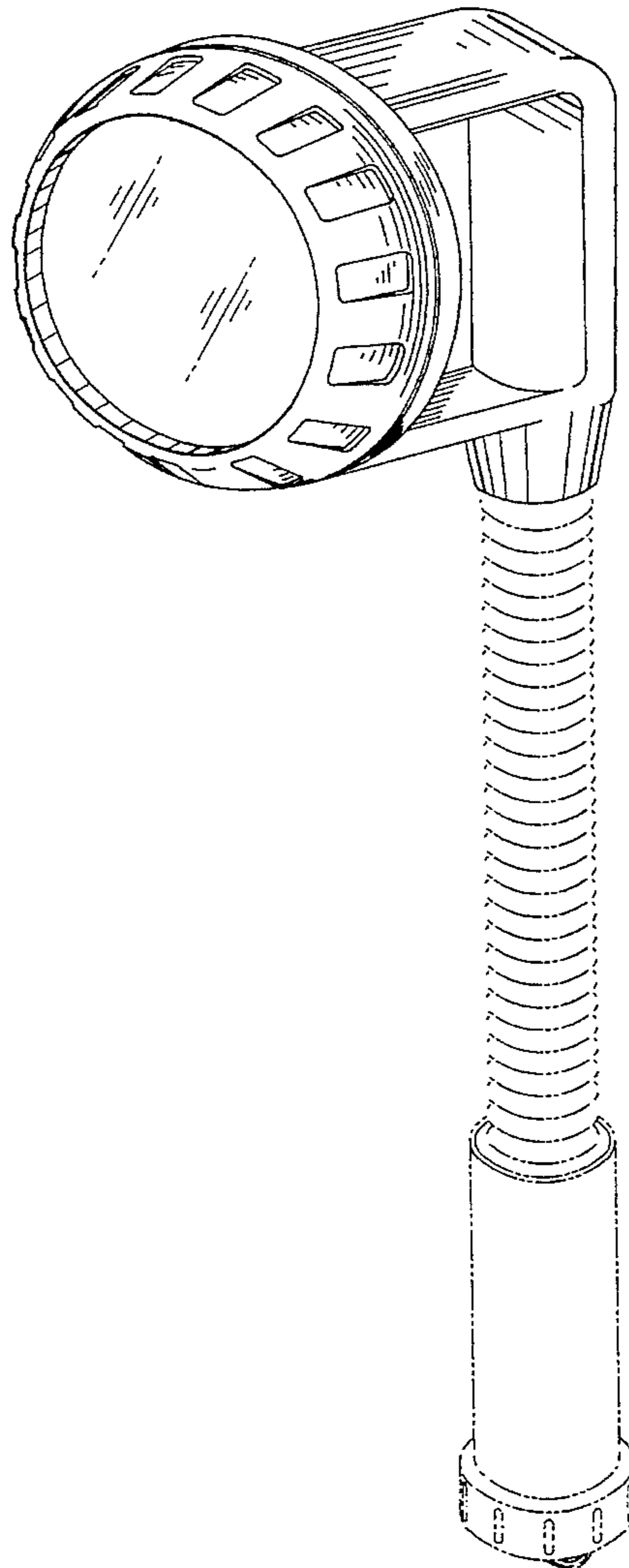

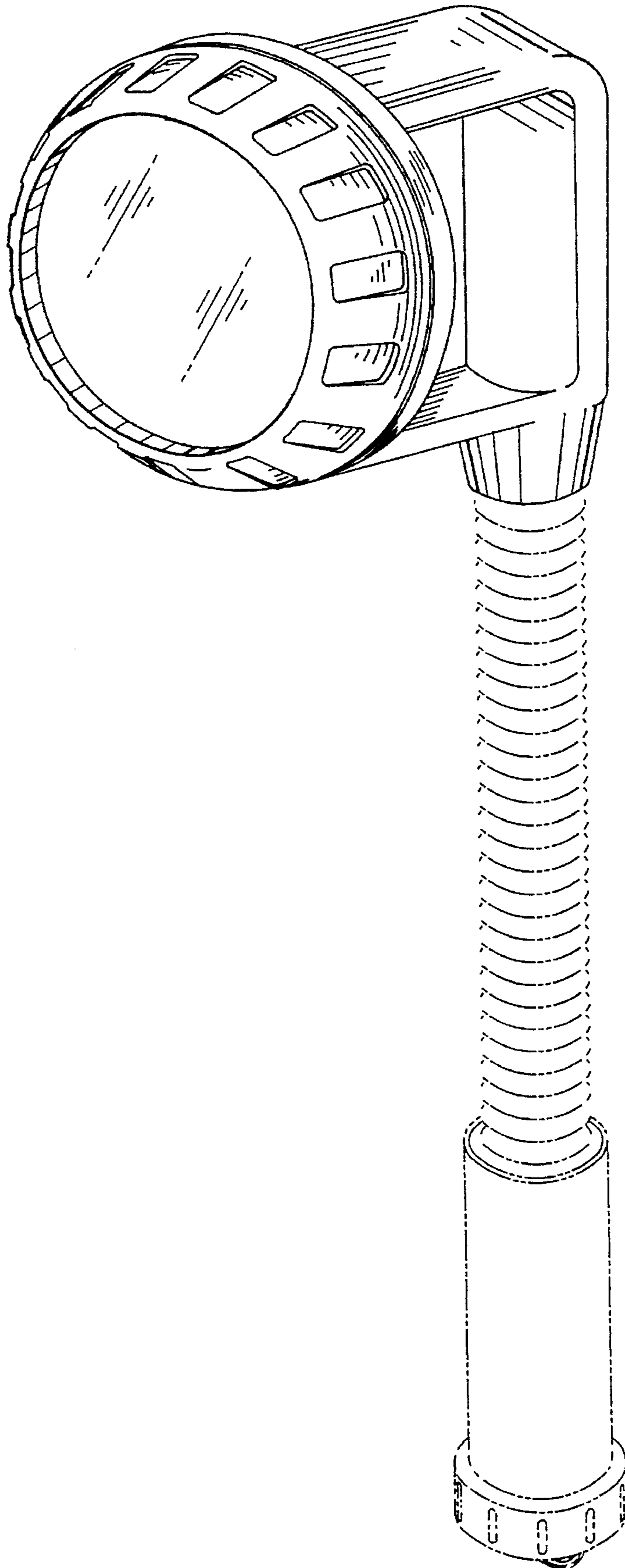

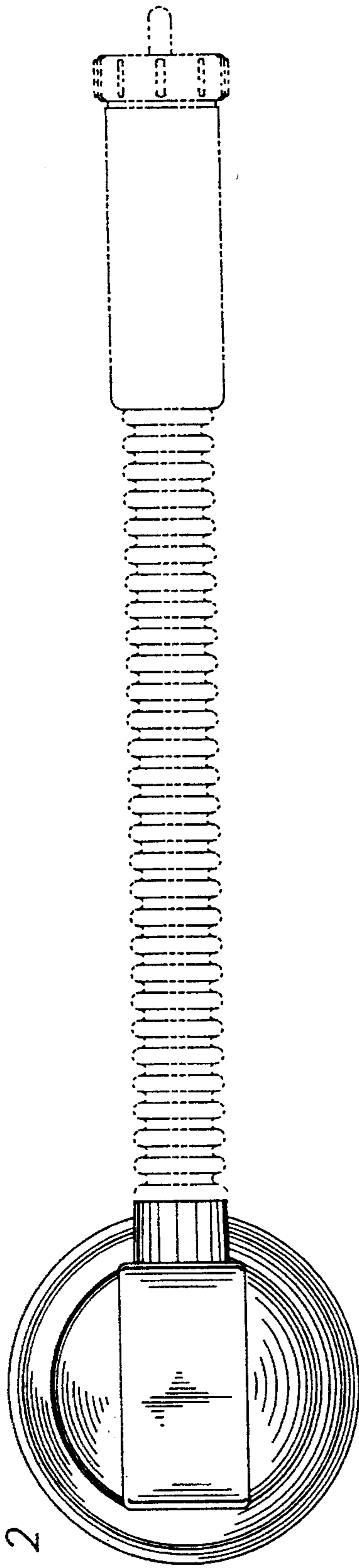

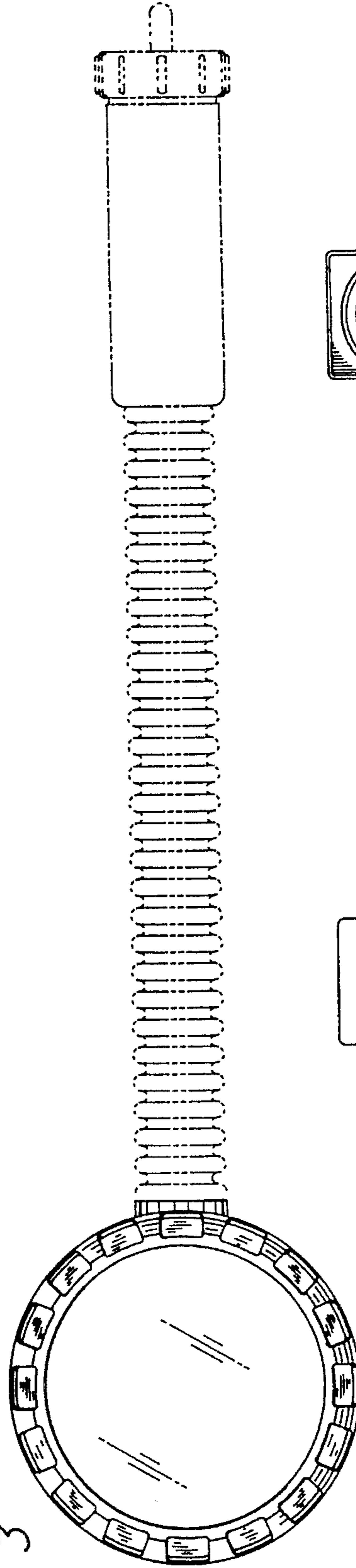

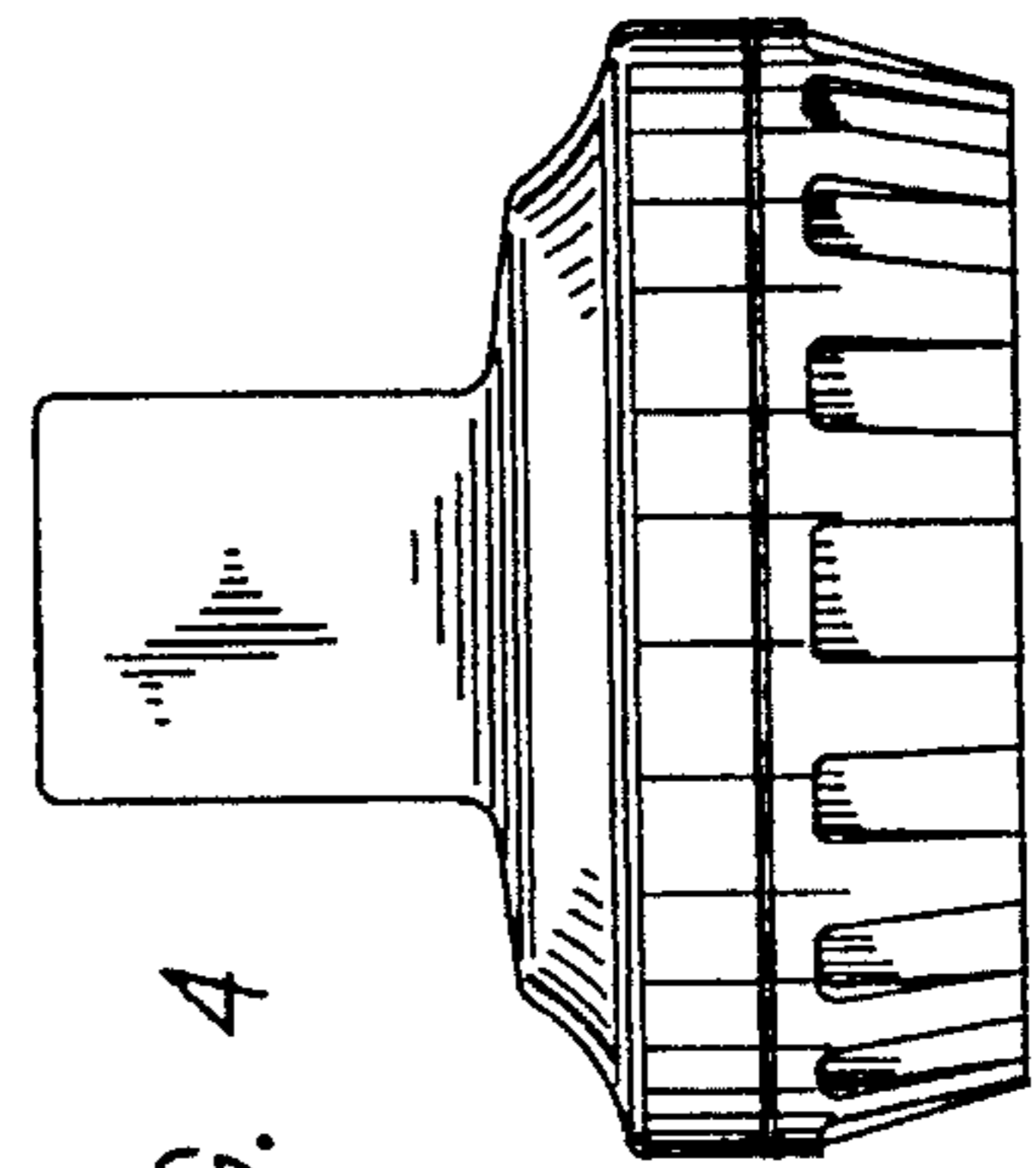
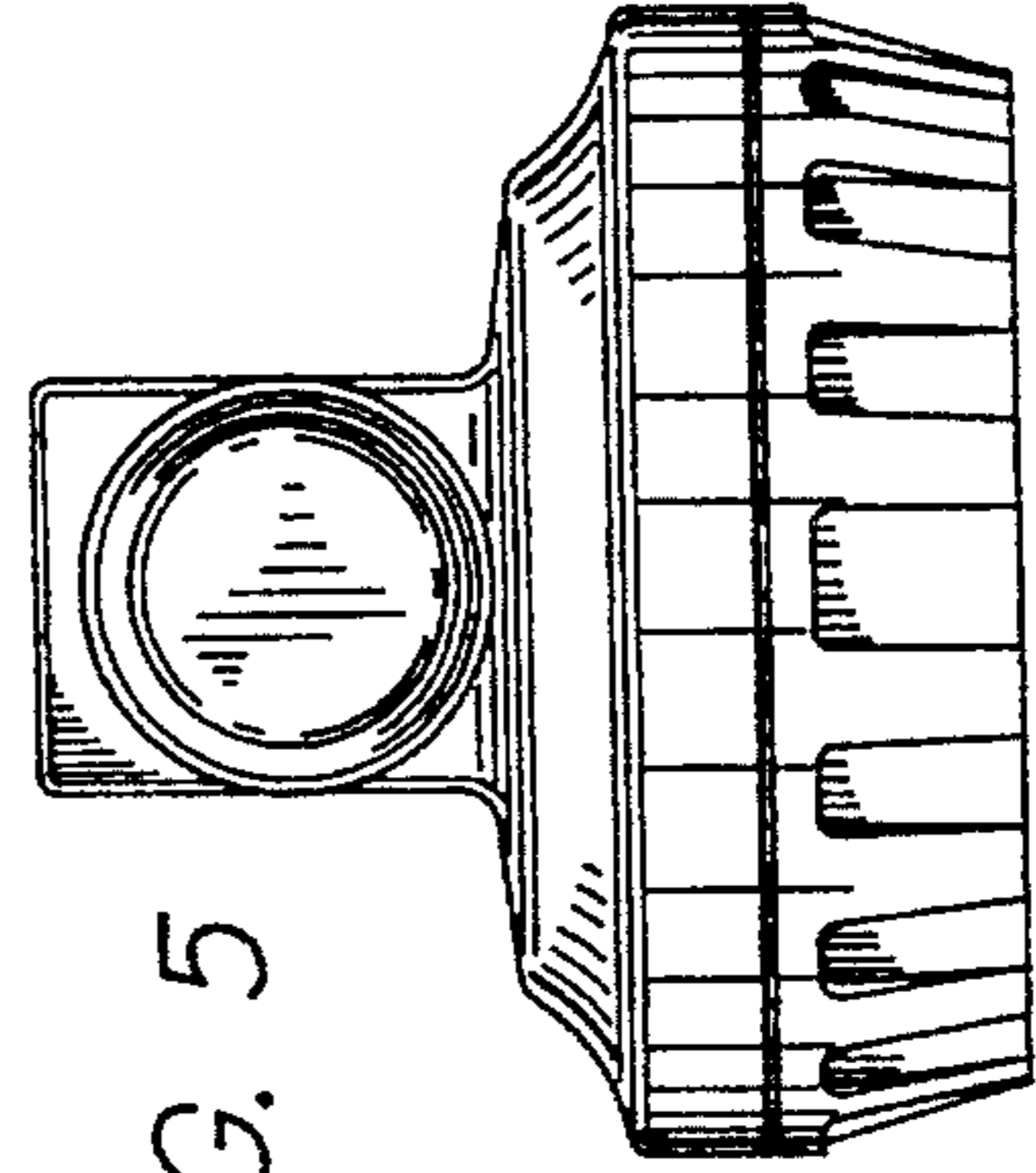

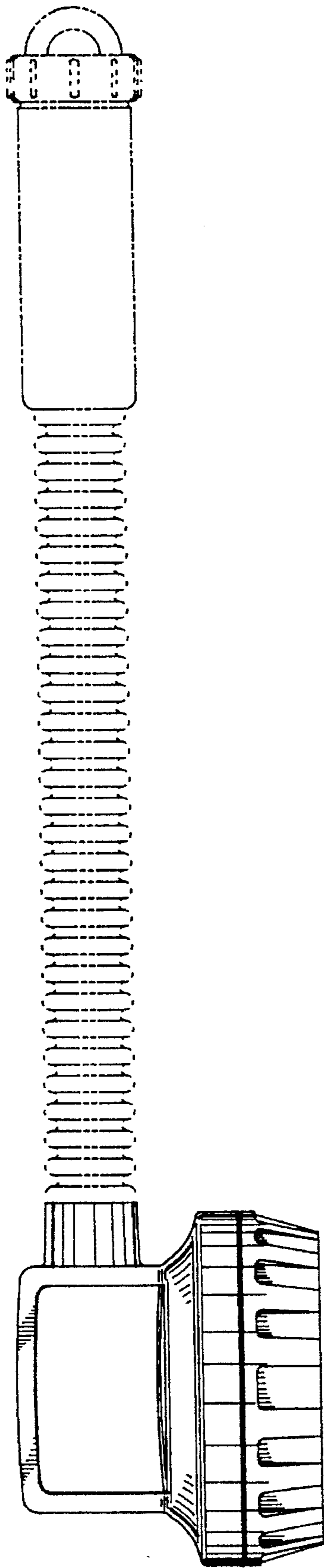

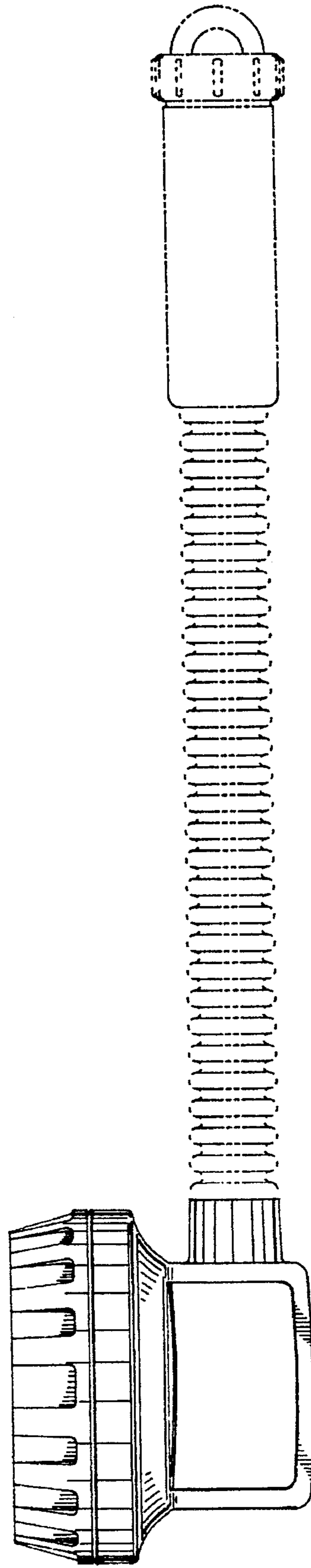
