[57] **CLAIM**

A new, original and ornamental design for a mop head, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a mop head showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view of a mop head of which the left side is a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a mop head of which the rear elevation view is a mirror image;

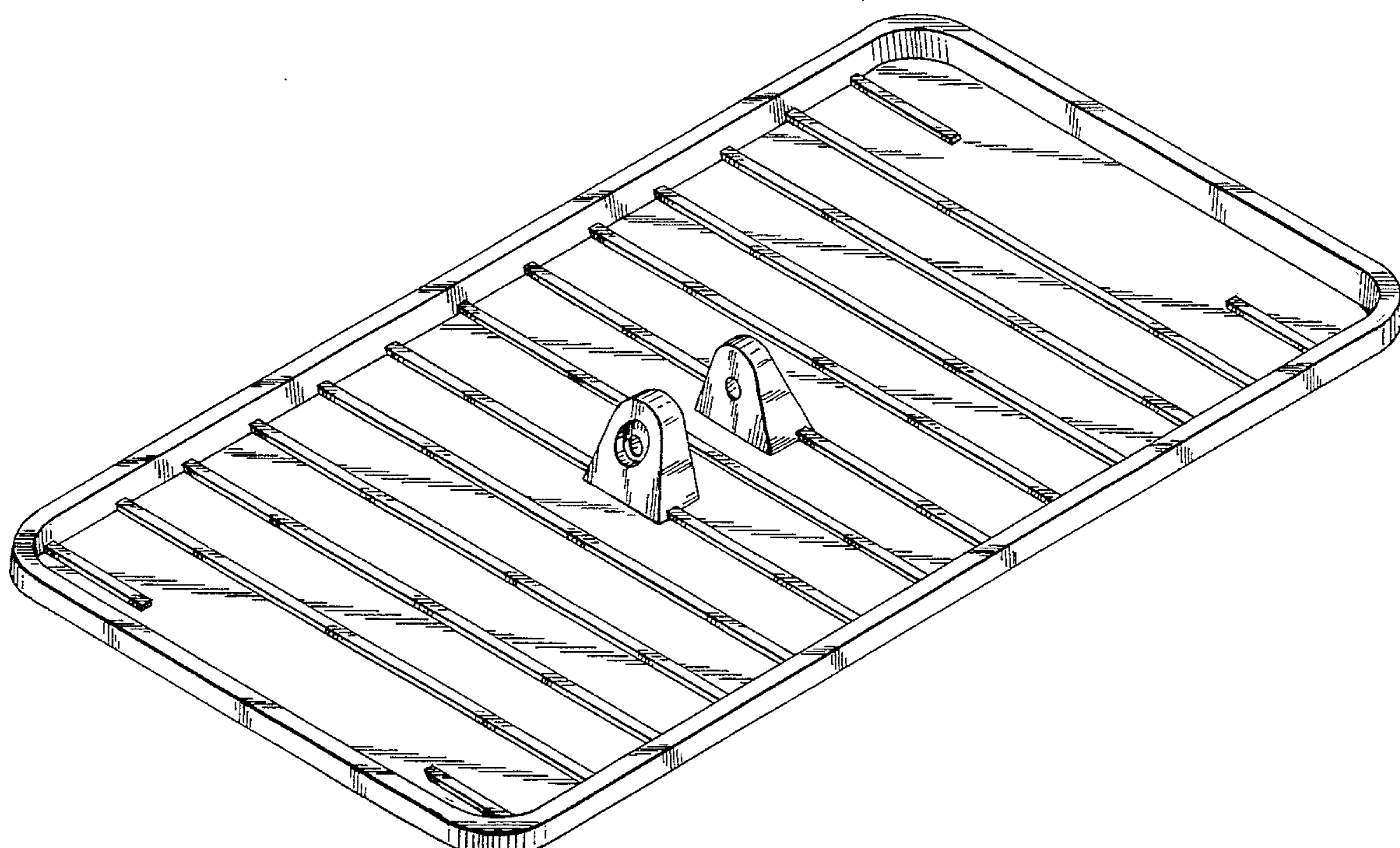
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of a cross-sectional portion of the mop head;

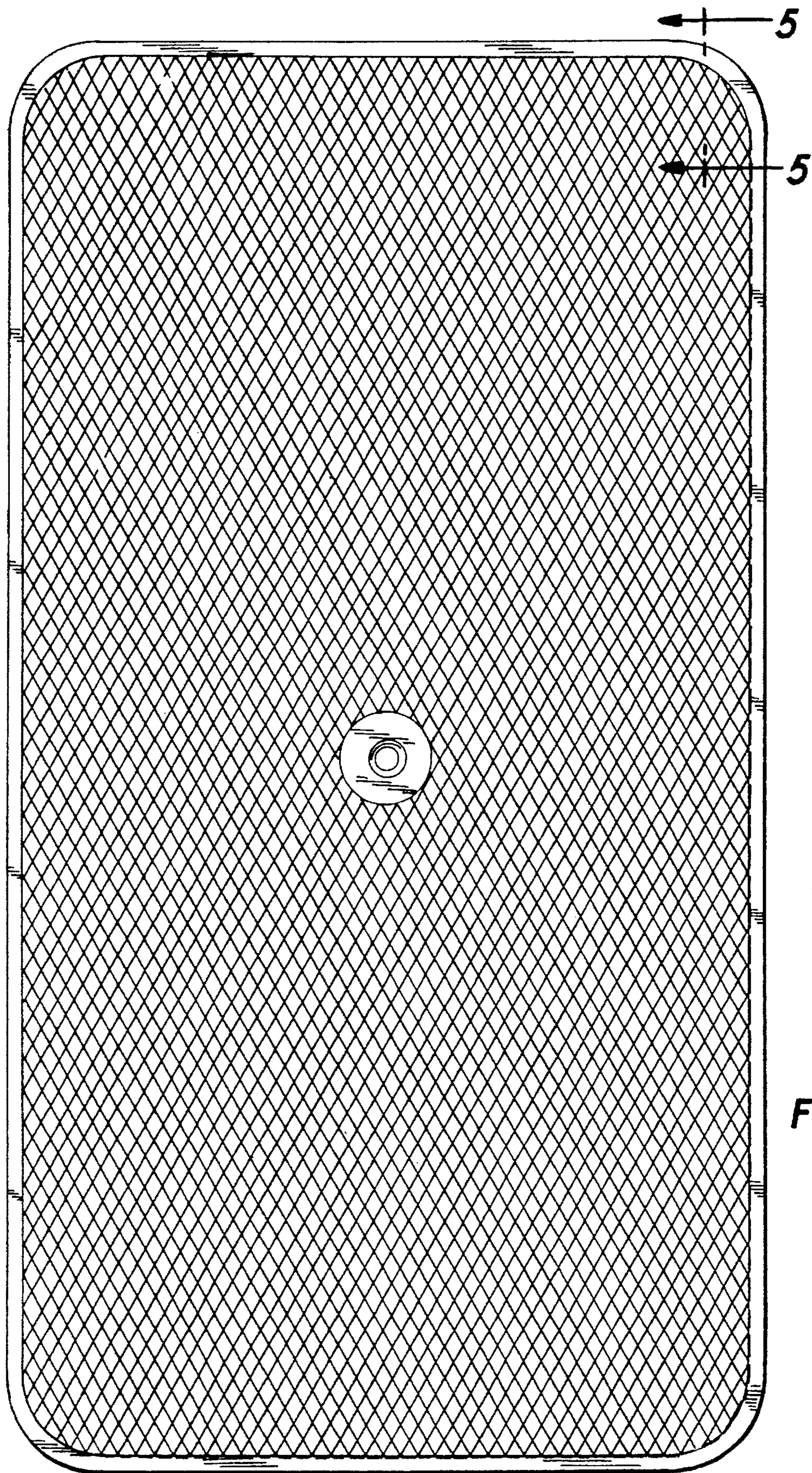
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the mop head; and,

FIG. 7 is an enlarged view of a portion of the gridwork pattern illustrated in FIG. 1.

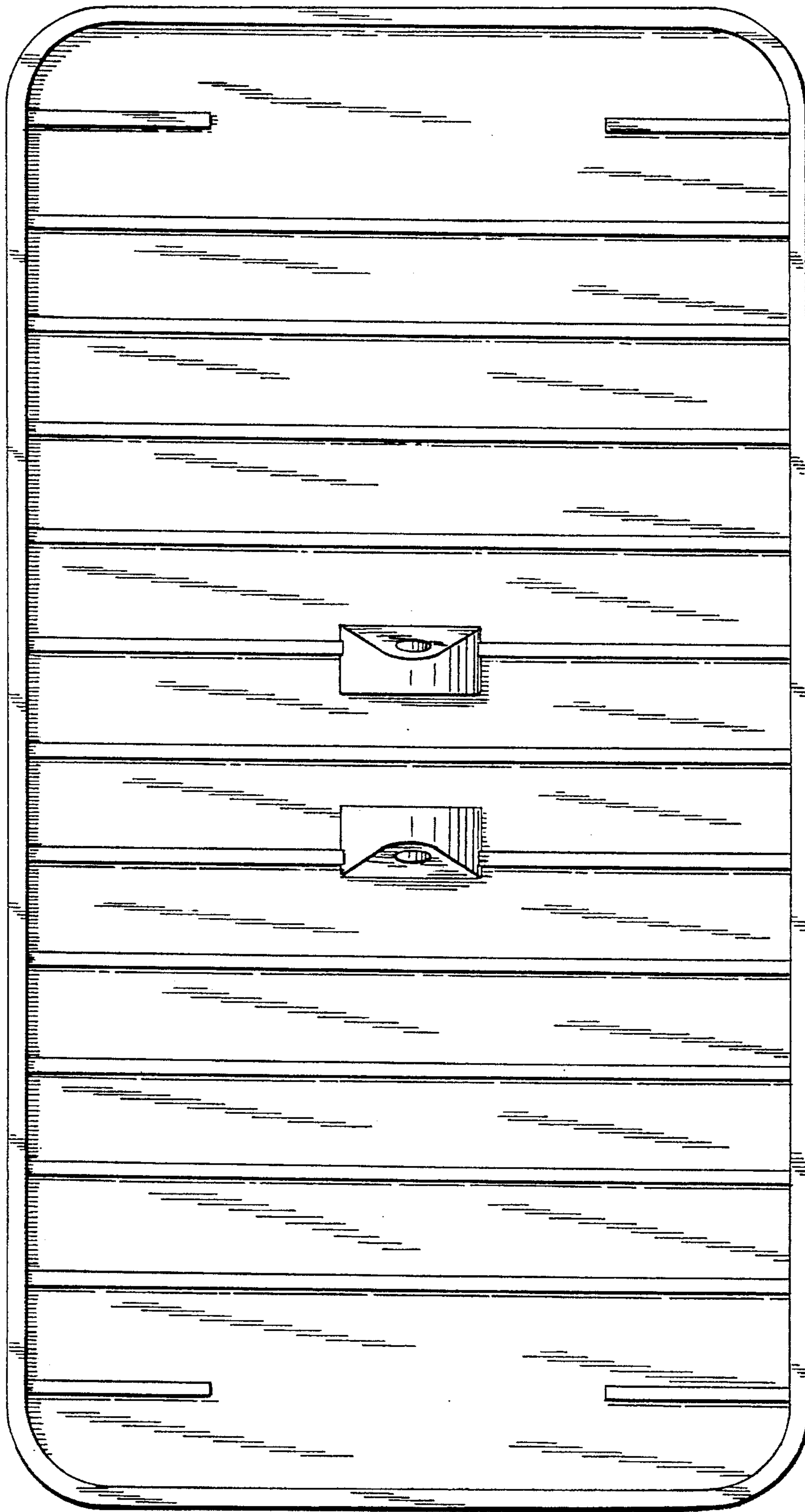

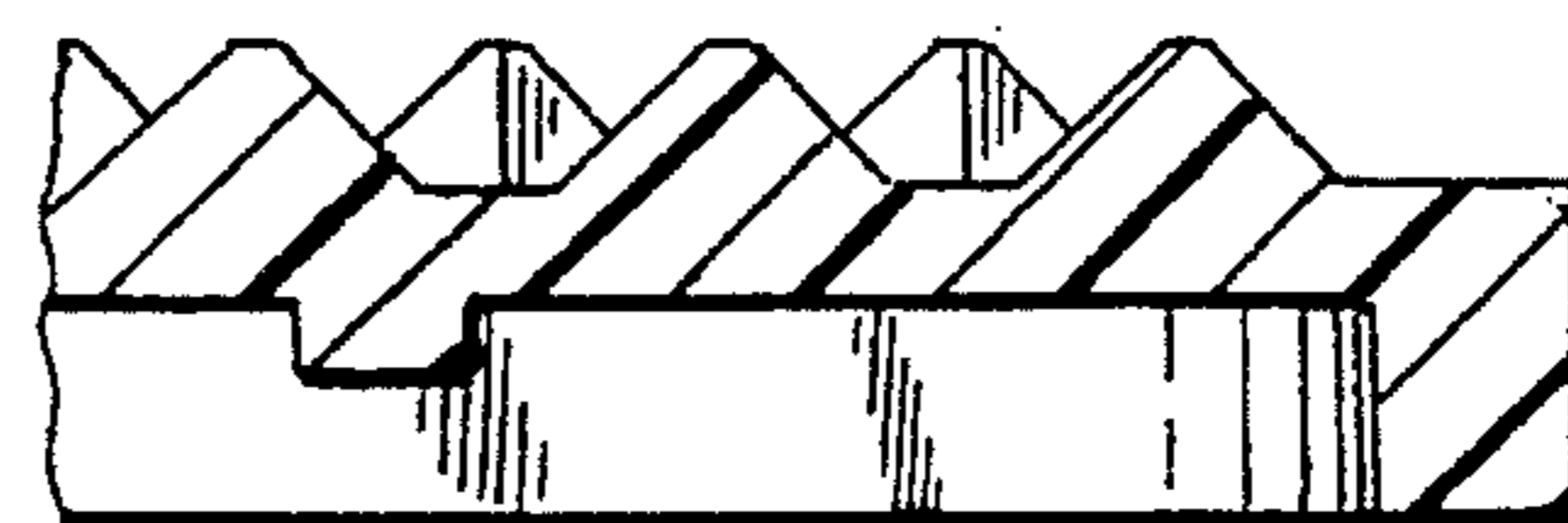
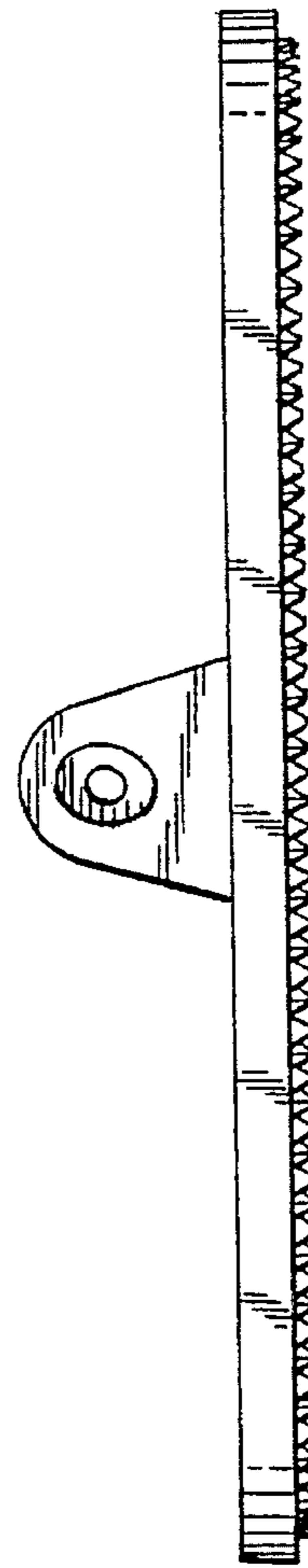
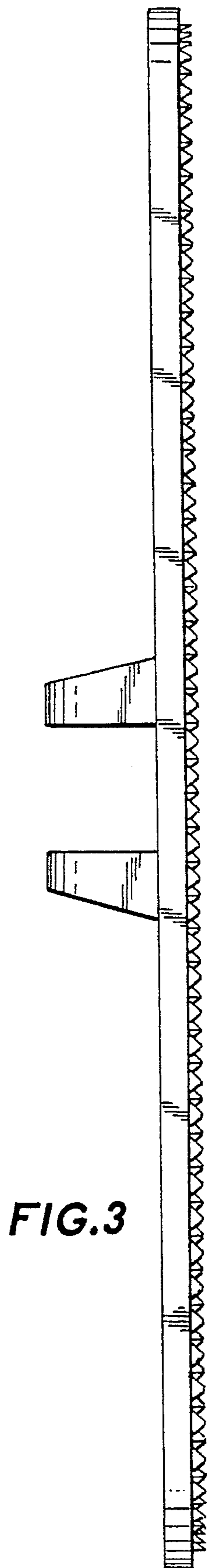

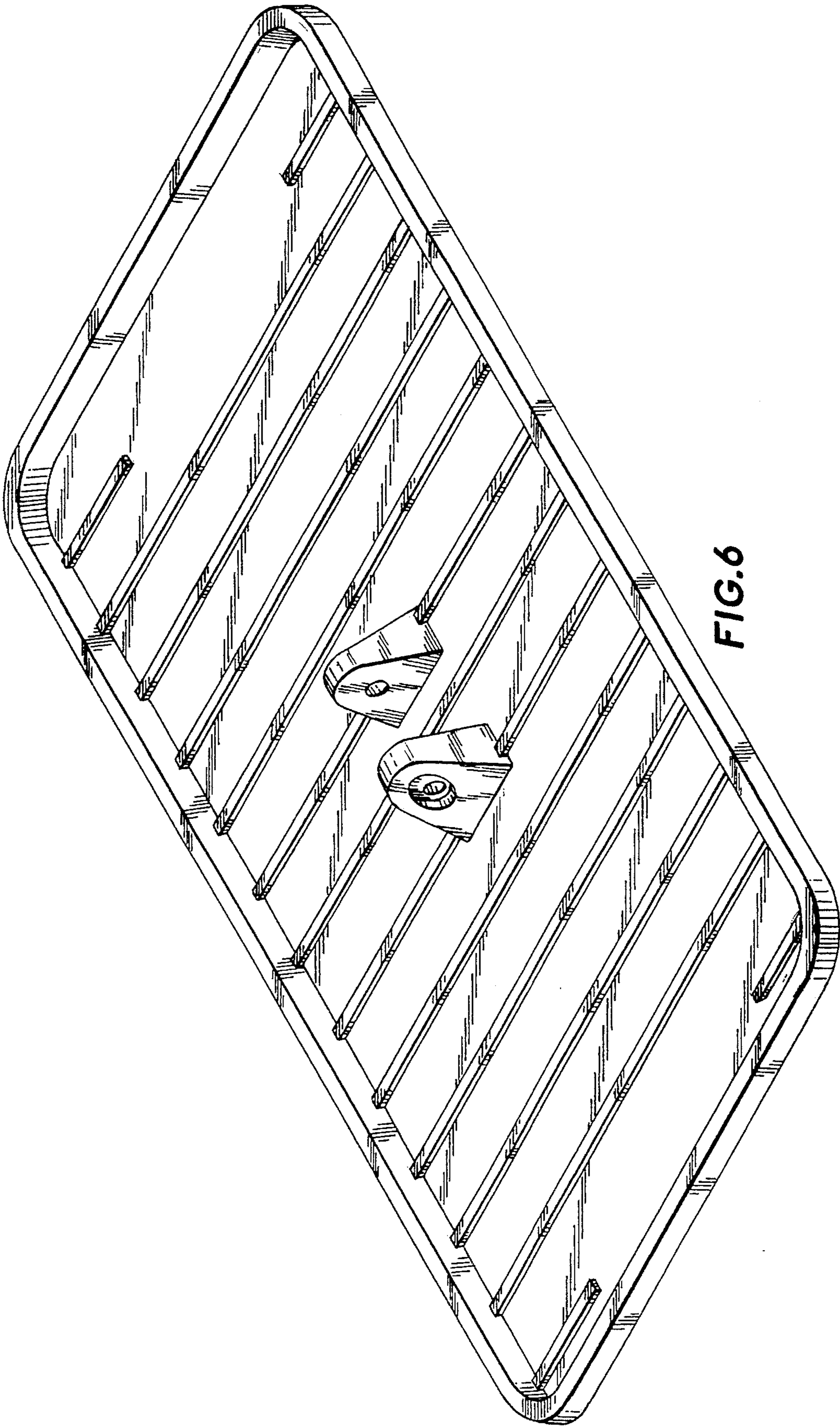
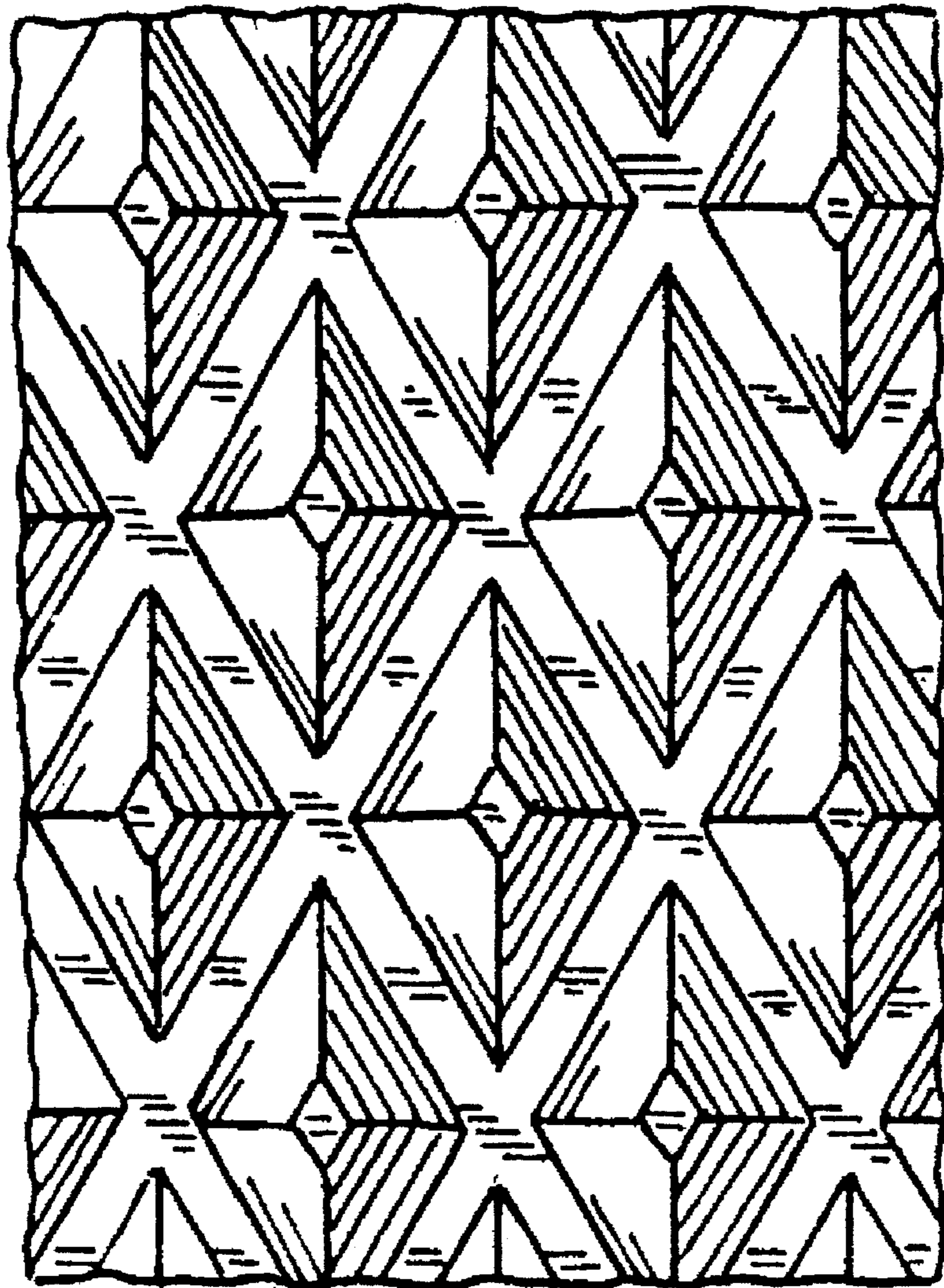
