[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an earring, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an earring showing my new

design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of an earring showing a second embodiment of my new design, the opposite side view being a mirror image except for the overlapping wire earloop; a front elevational view, a rear elevational view, a top plan view, and a bottom plan view are the same as shown in FIGS. 4, 5, 6, and 7 respectively, without the end loop thereof;

FIG. 9 is a fragmentary perspective view showing a third embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of the third embodiment;

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view of third embodiment;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of the third embodiment;

FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of the third embodiment;

FIG. 14 is a top plan view of the third embodiment; and,

FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of the third embodiment.

The broken line showing of an ear, in FIGS. 1 and 9, is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines showing the flexible drop in FIGS. 1-7, and the broken line showing the fixed attachment in FIG. 8 are also for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

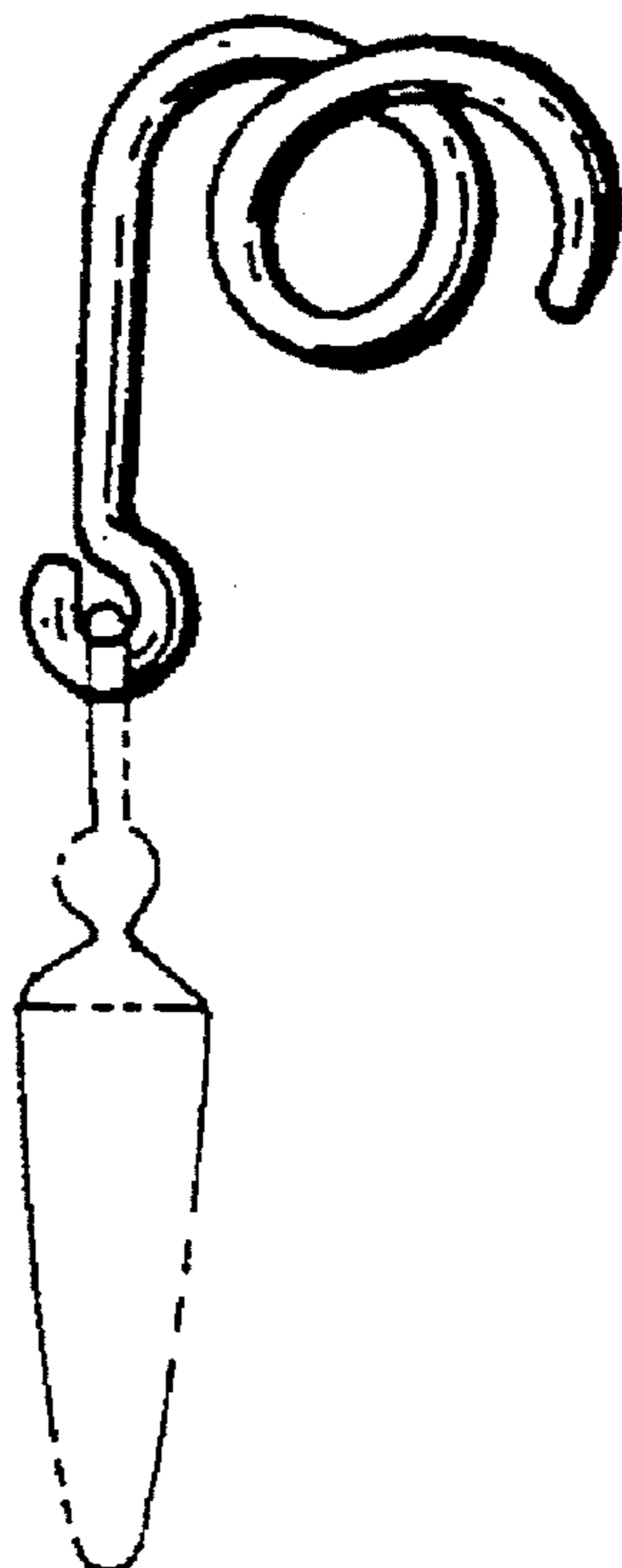

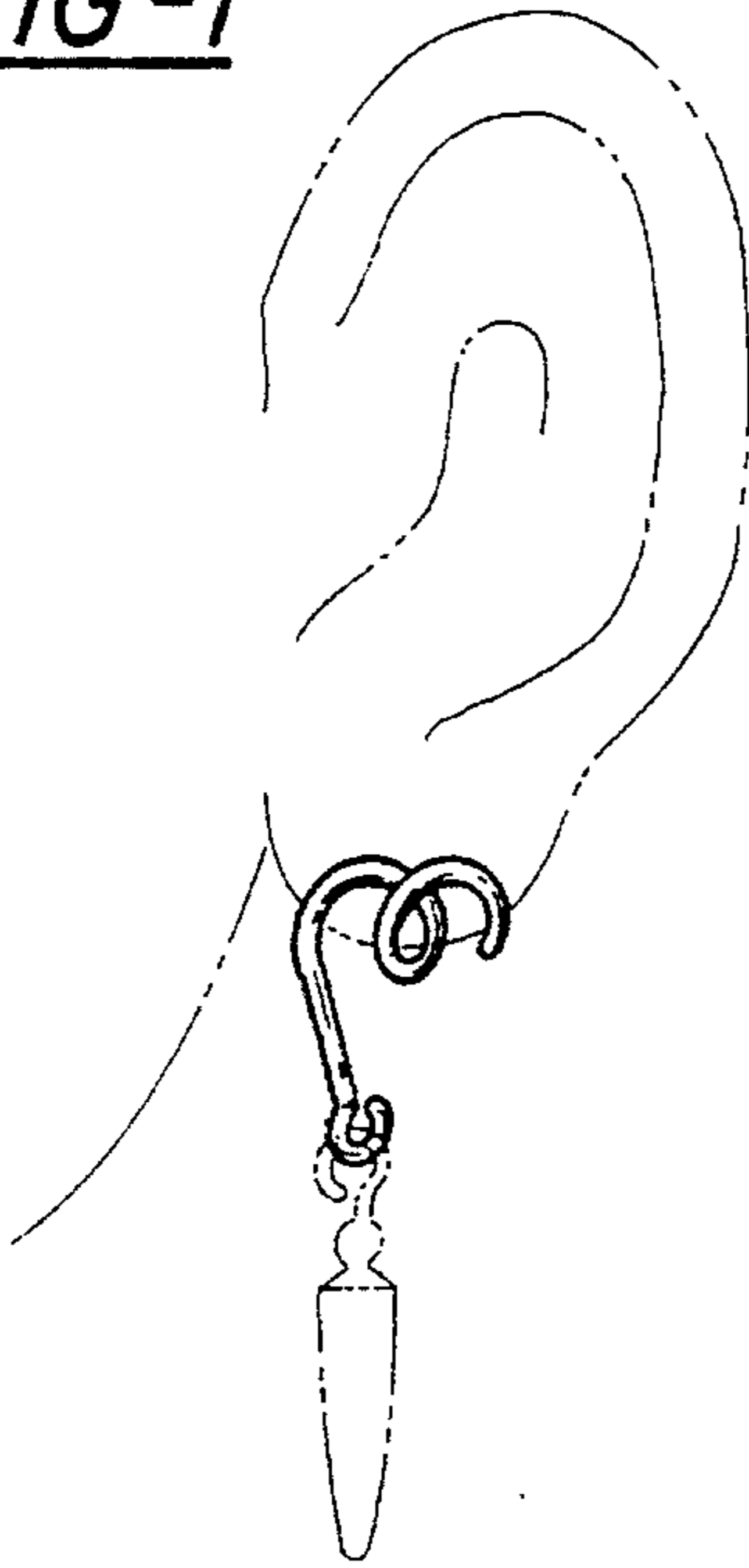

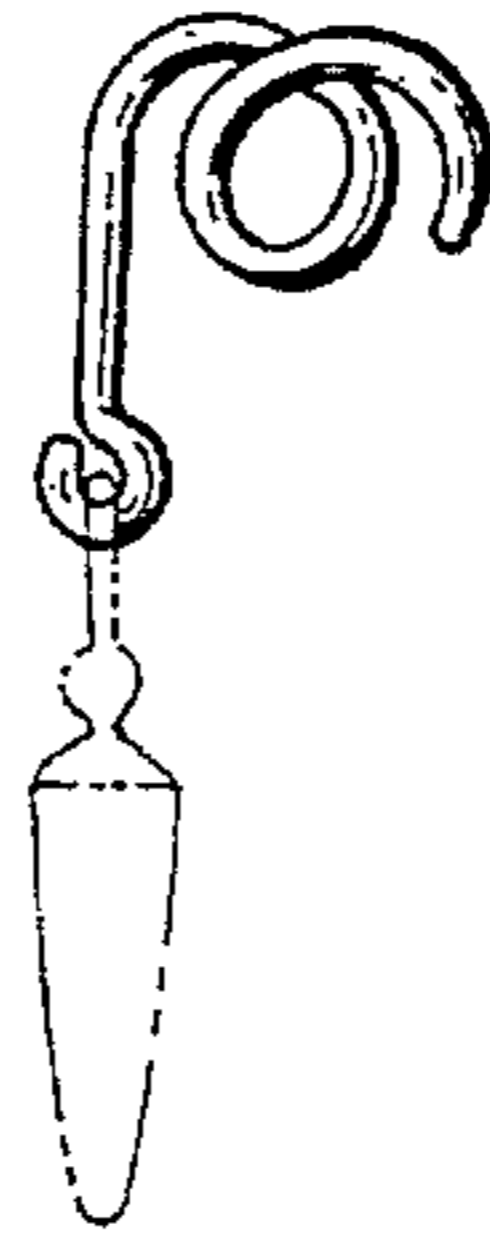

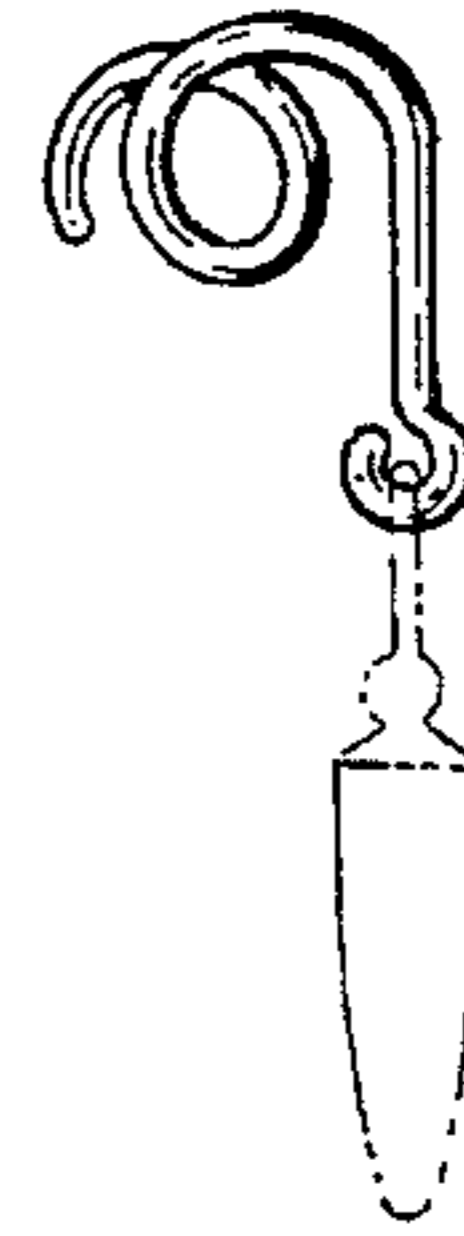

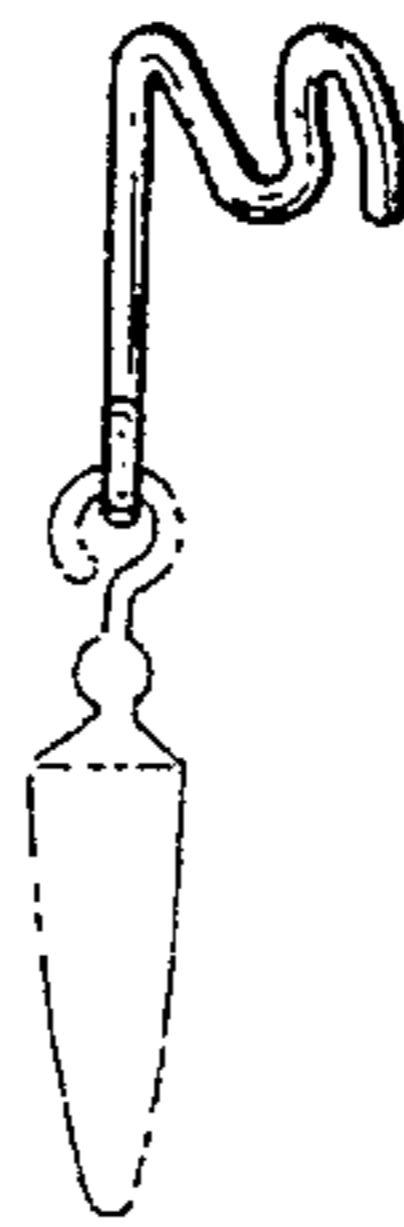

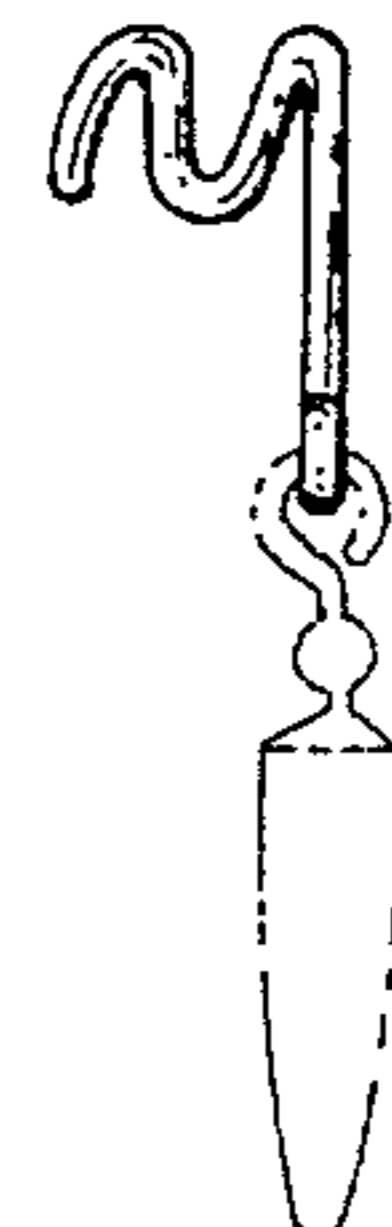

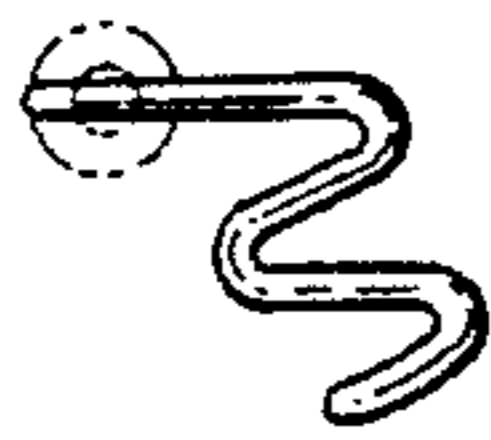

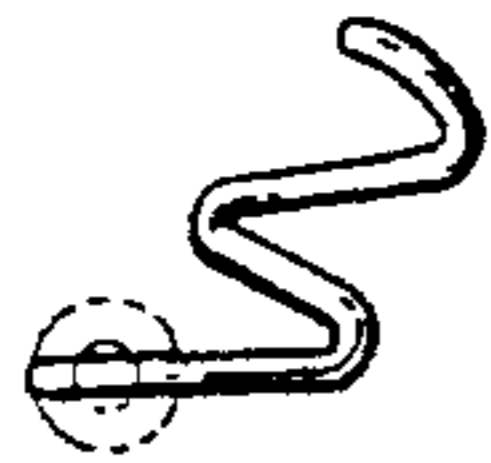

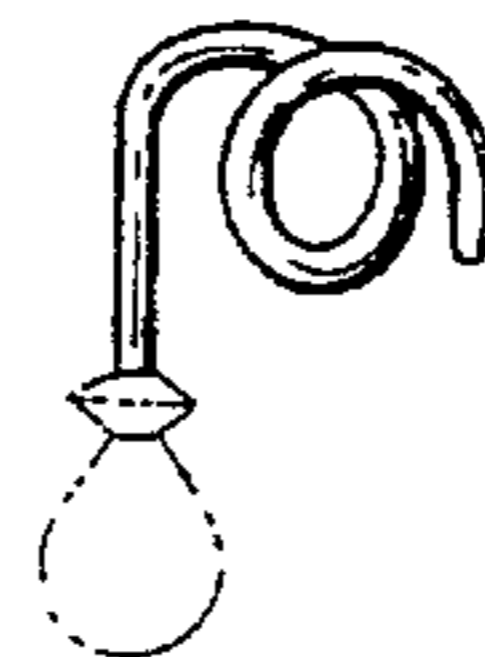

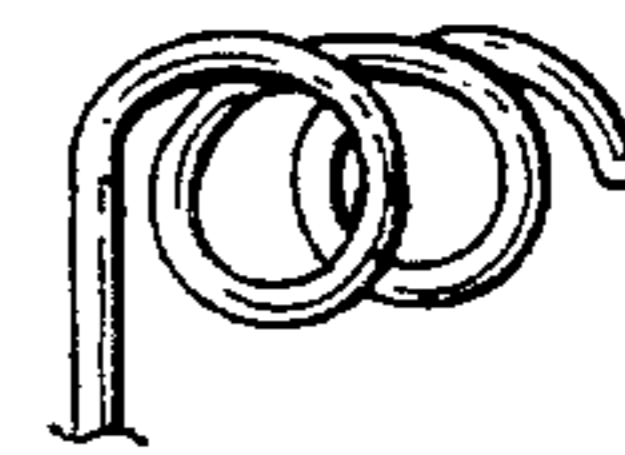

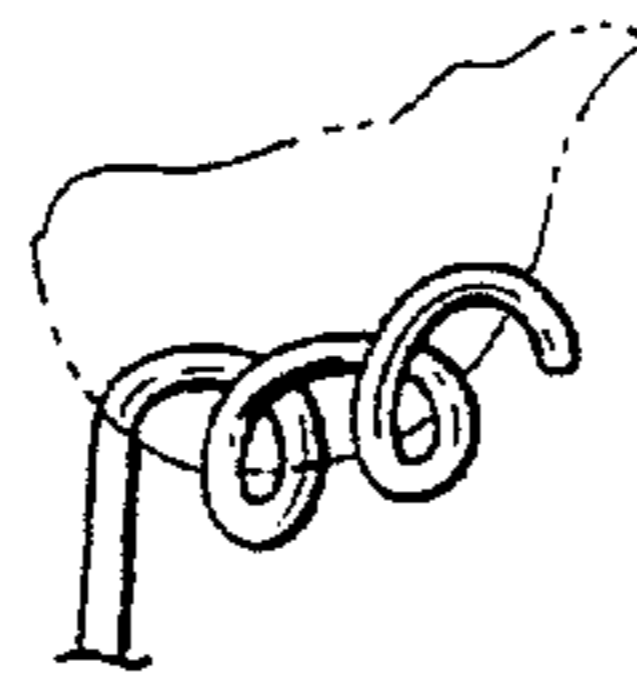
