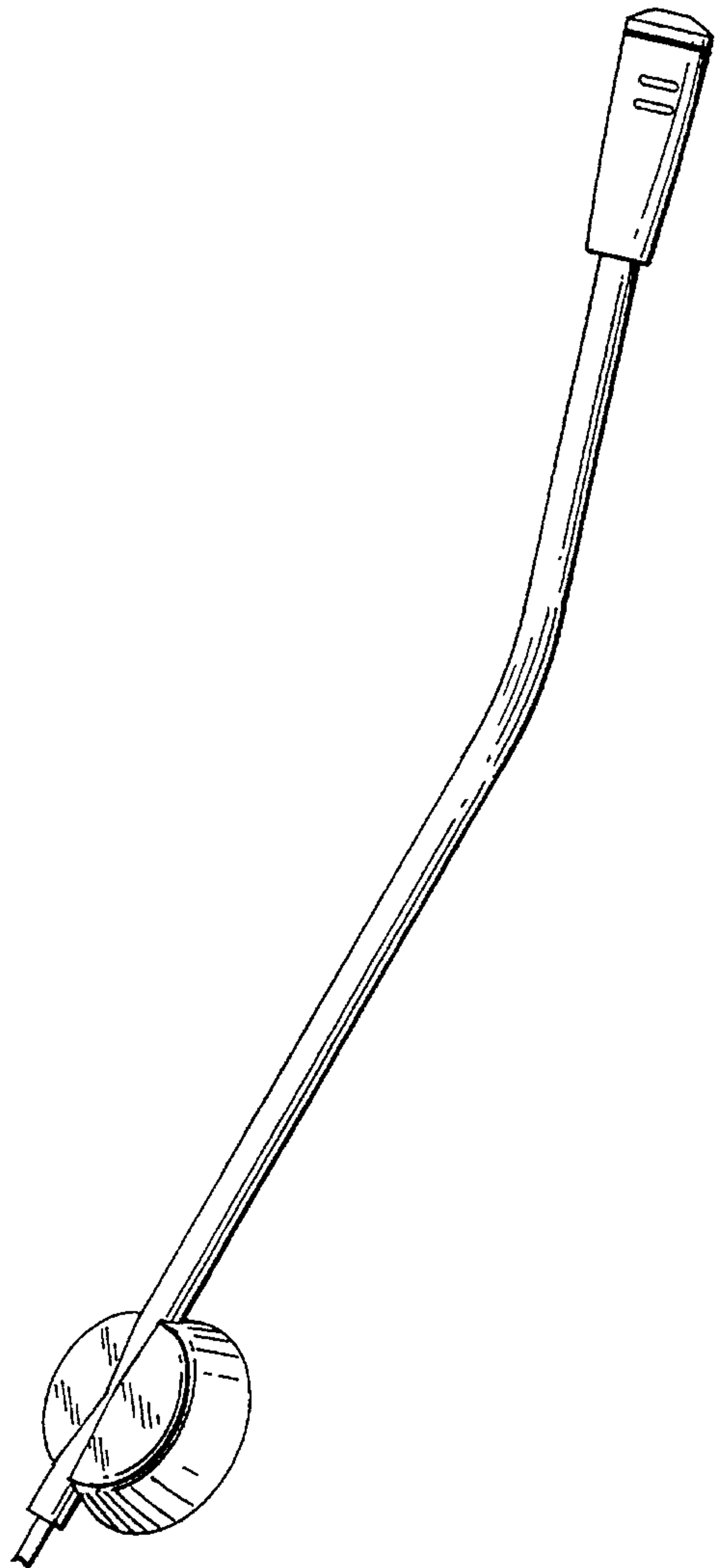

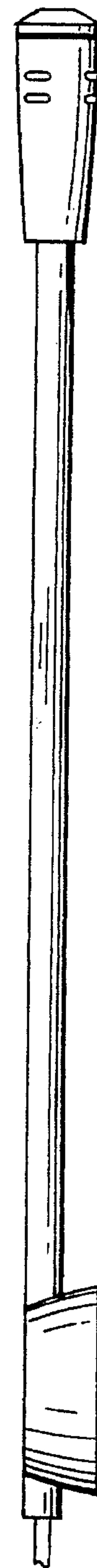
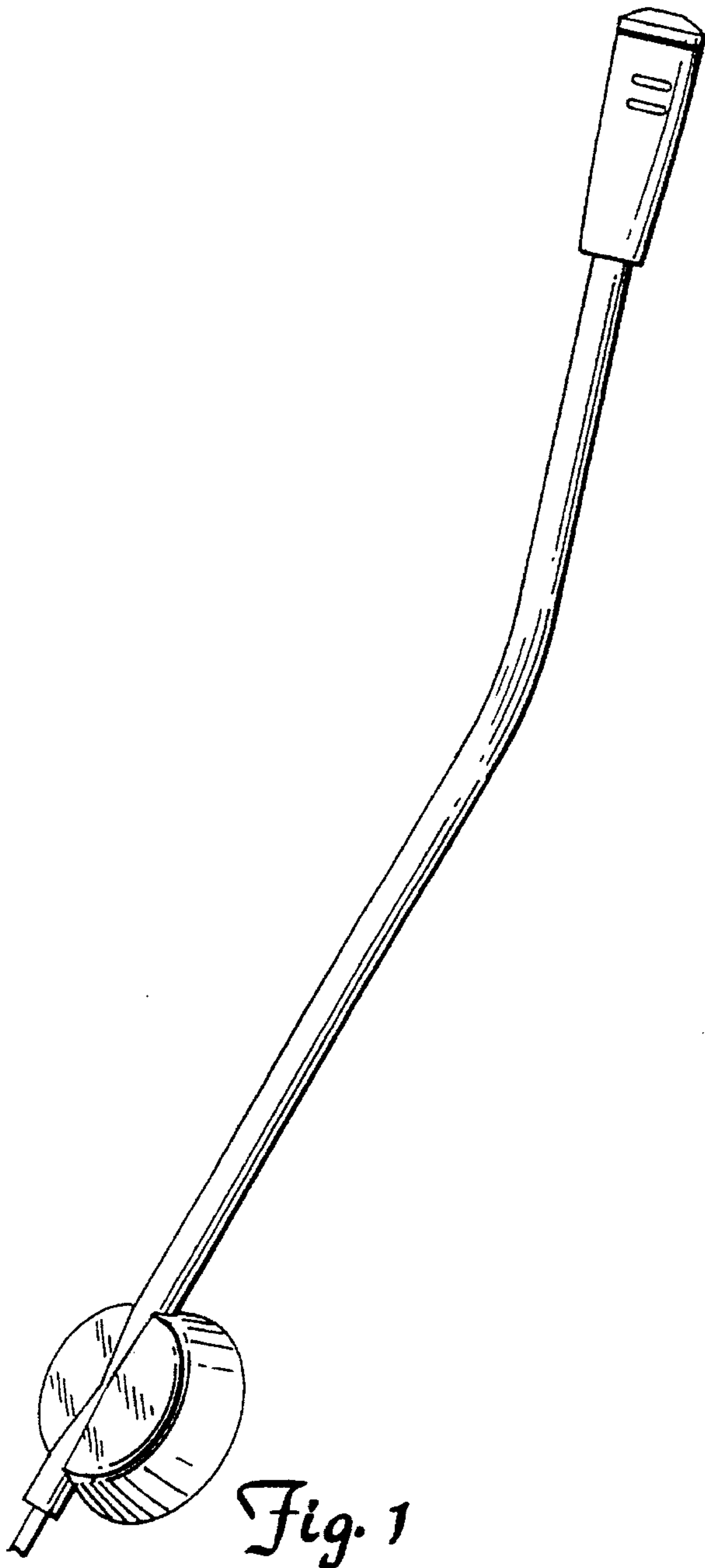
The ornamental design for a microphone, as shown.

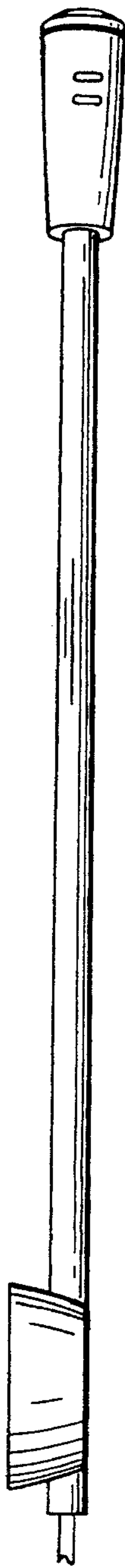

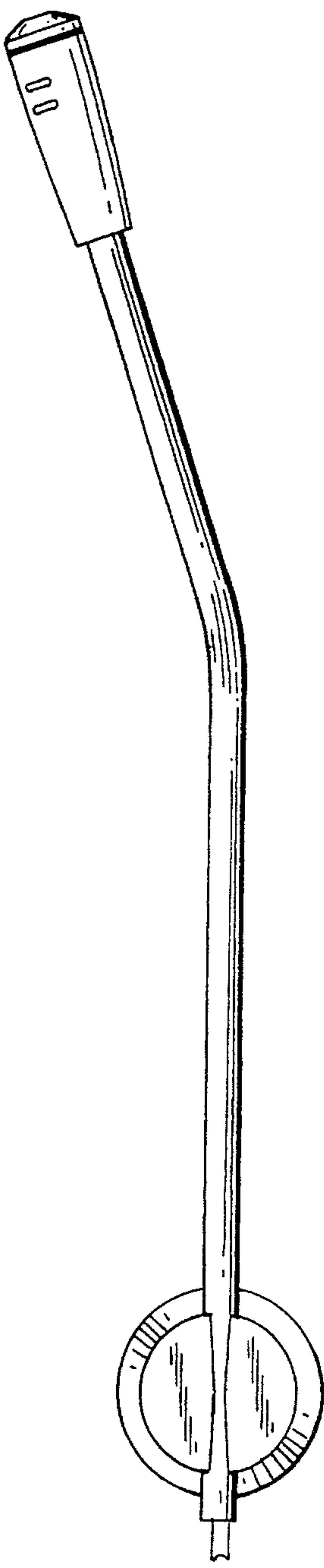

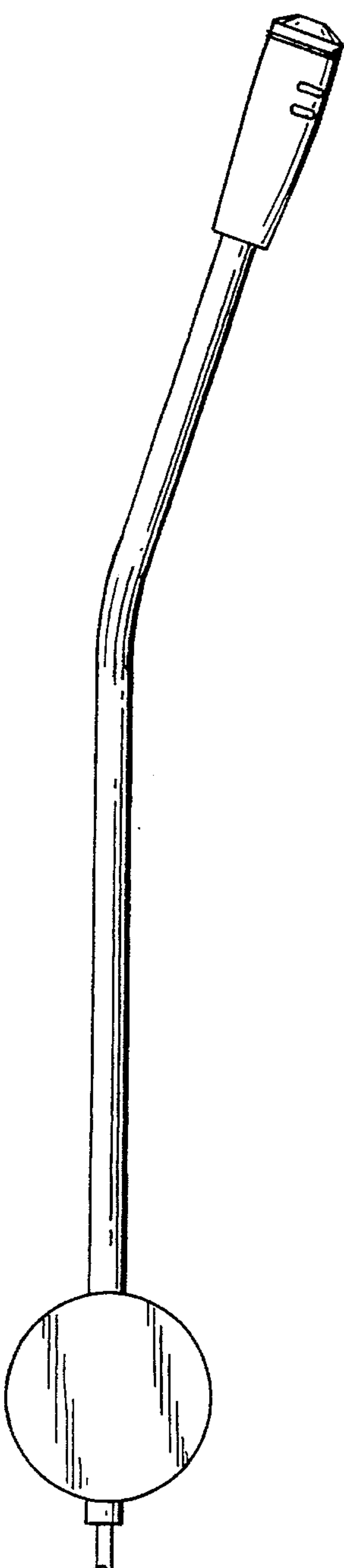

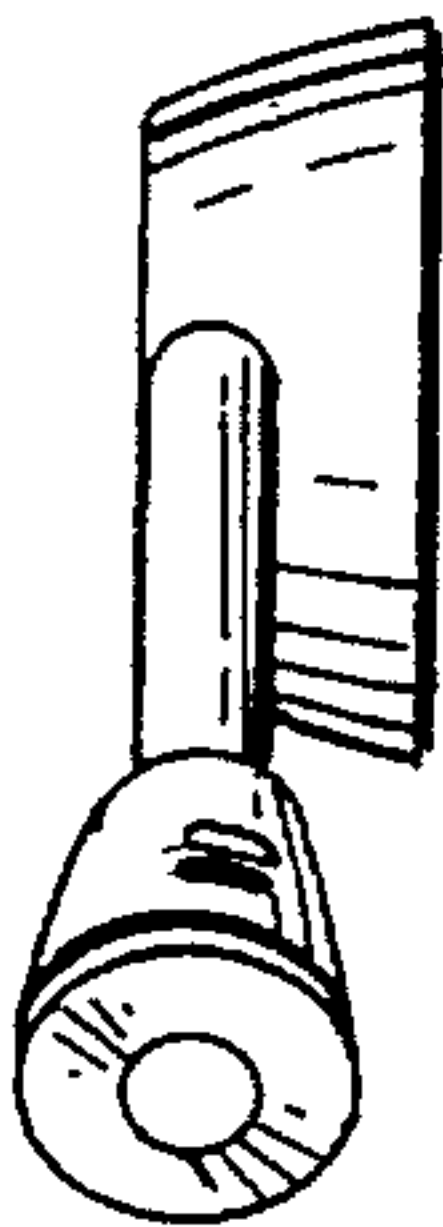

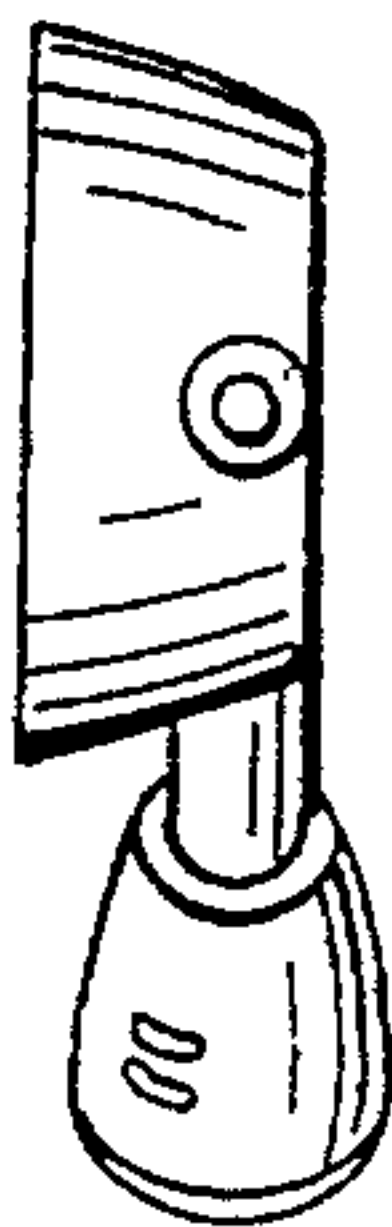
