FIG. 7 is a rear view of the unindented rear portion of a below-headlap portion of a tile of FIG. 1; and,

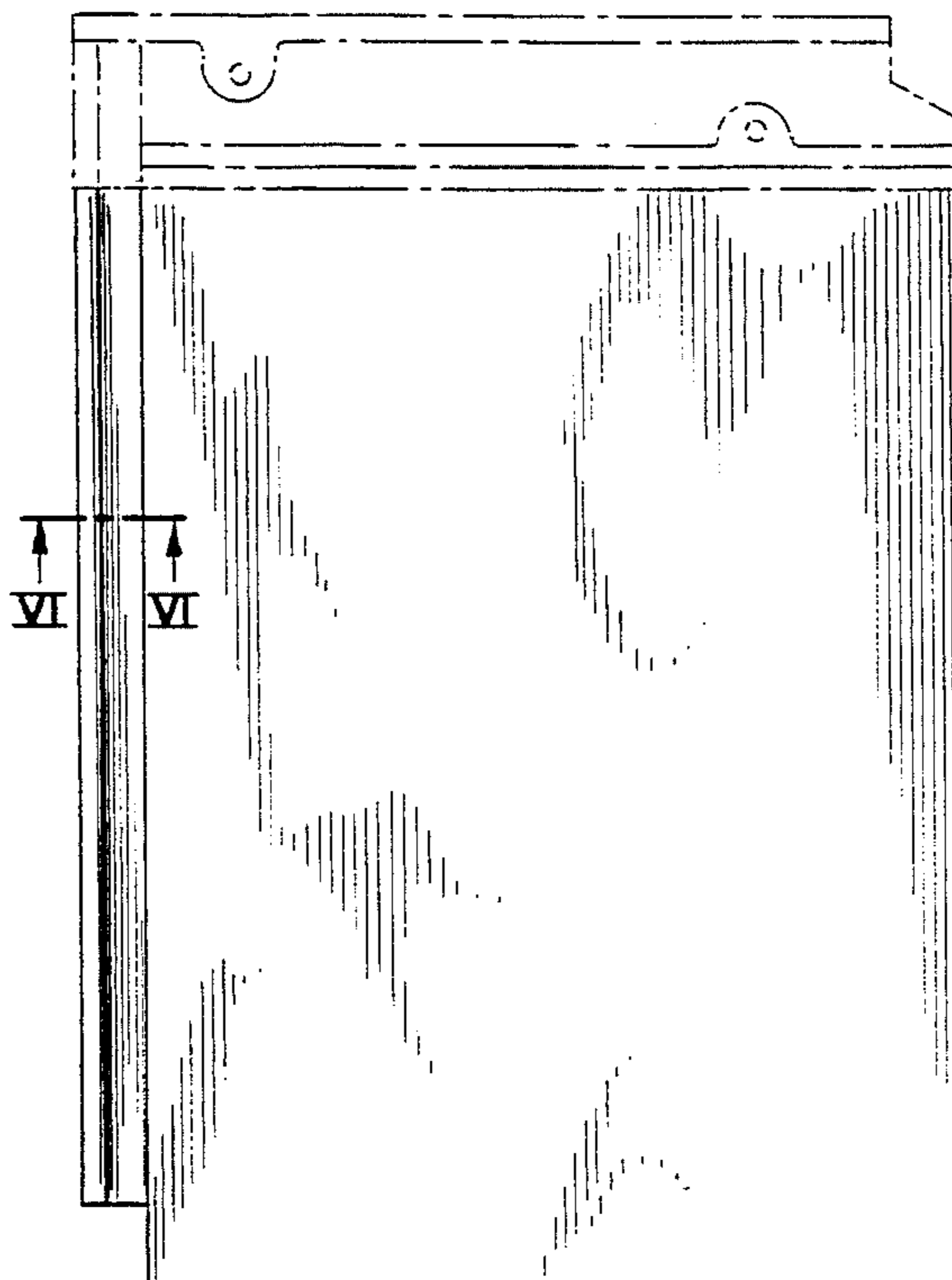

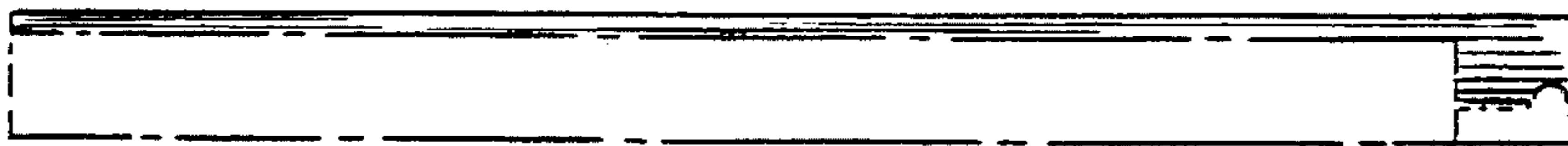

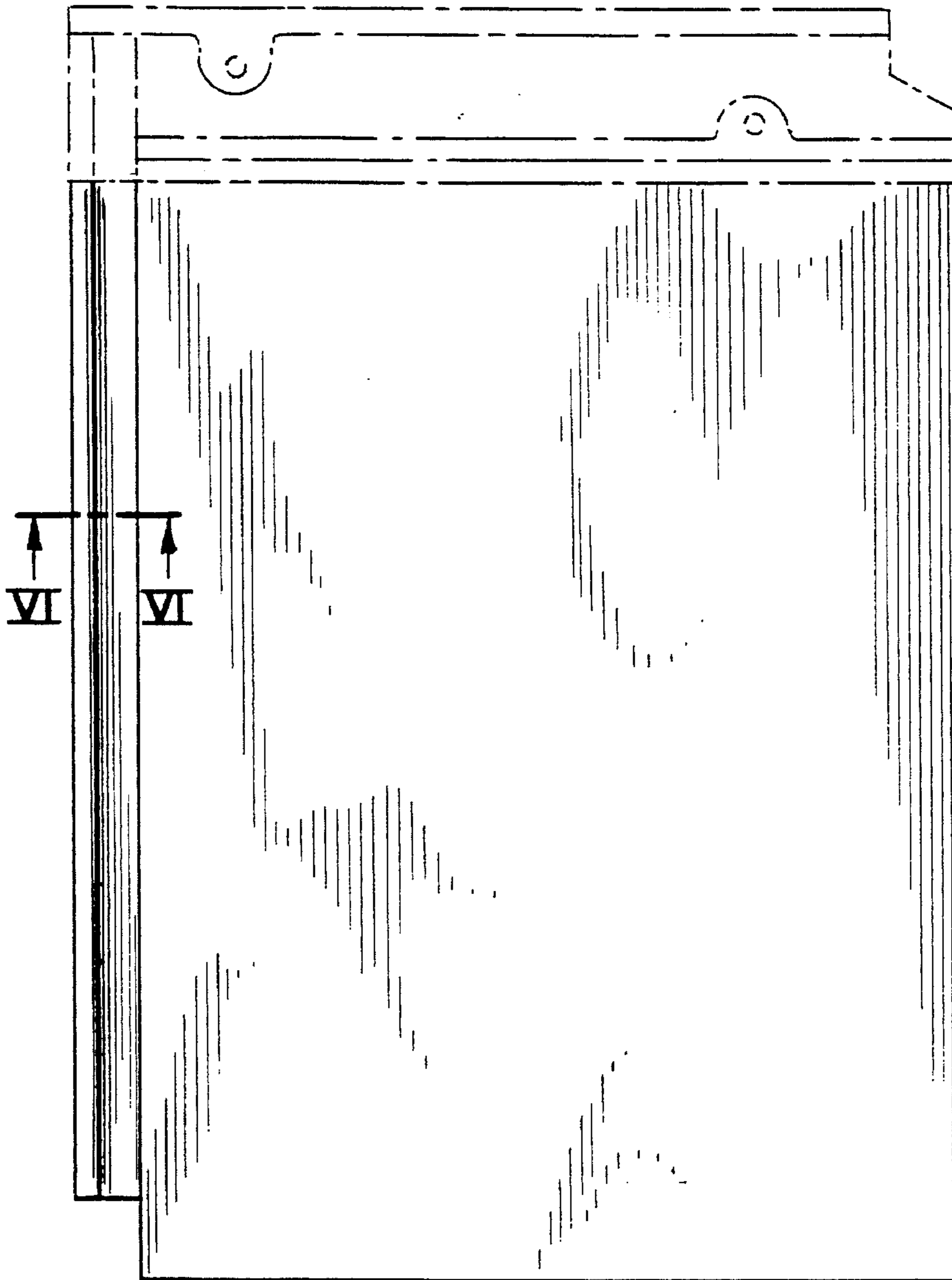

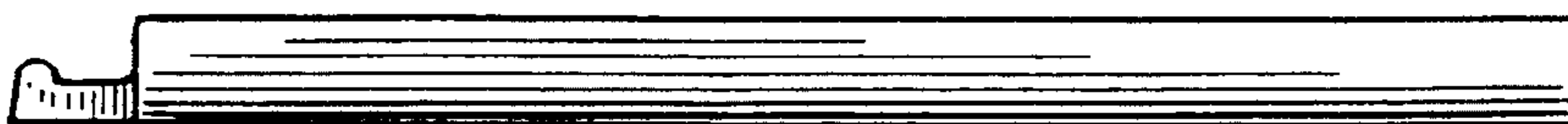

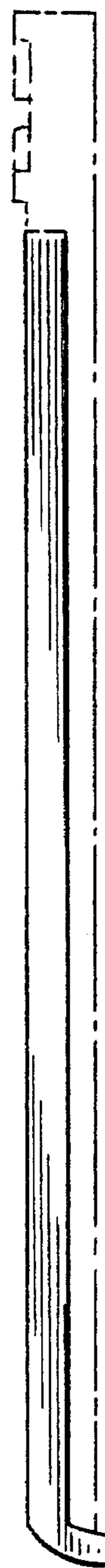

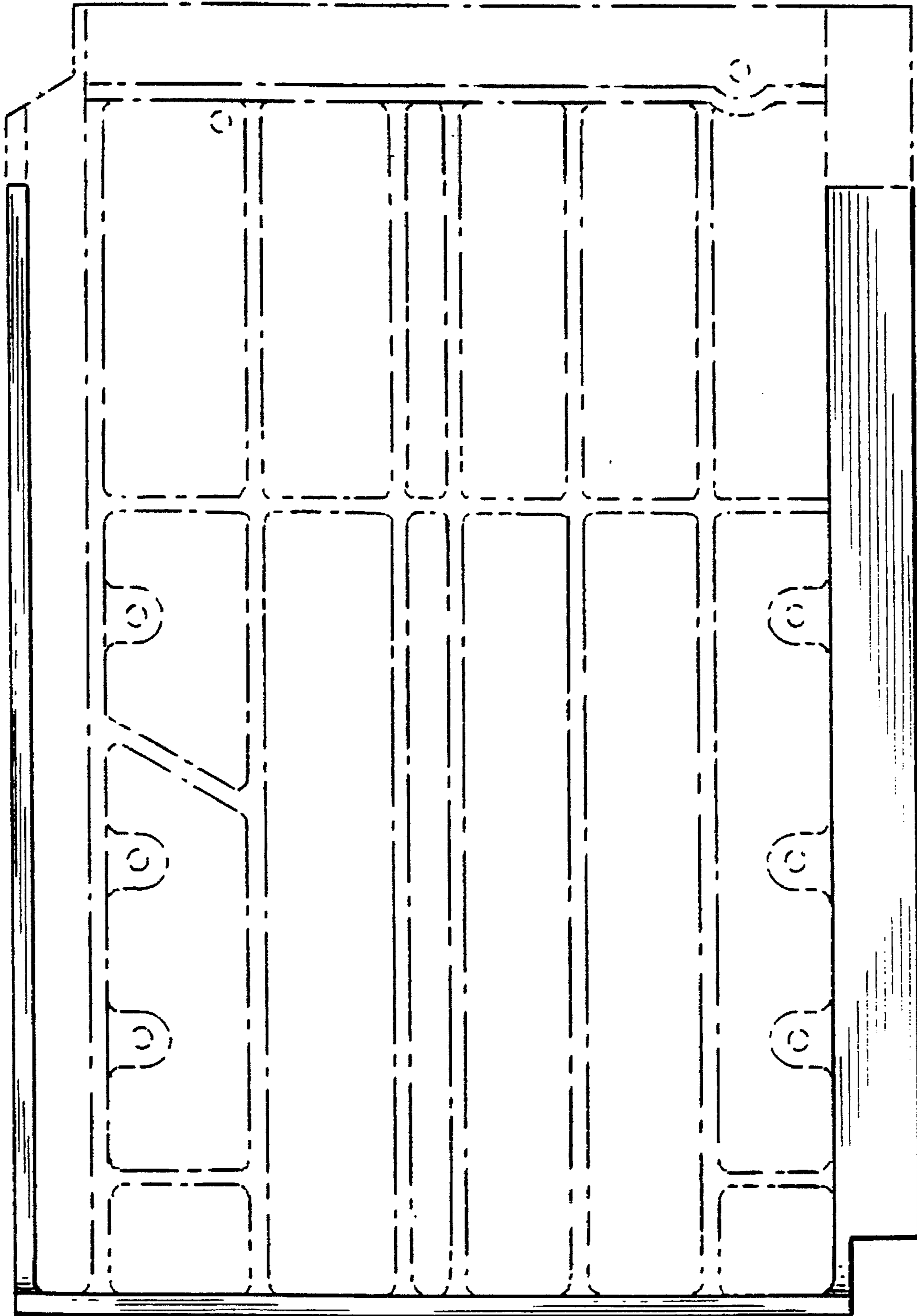

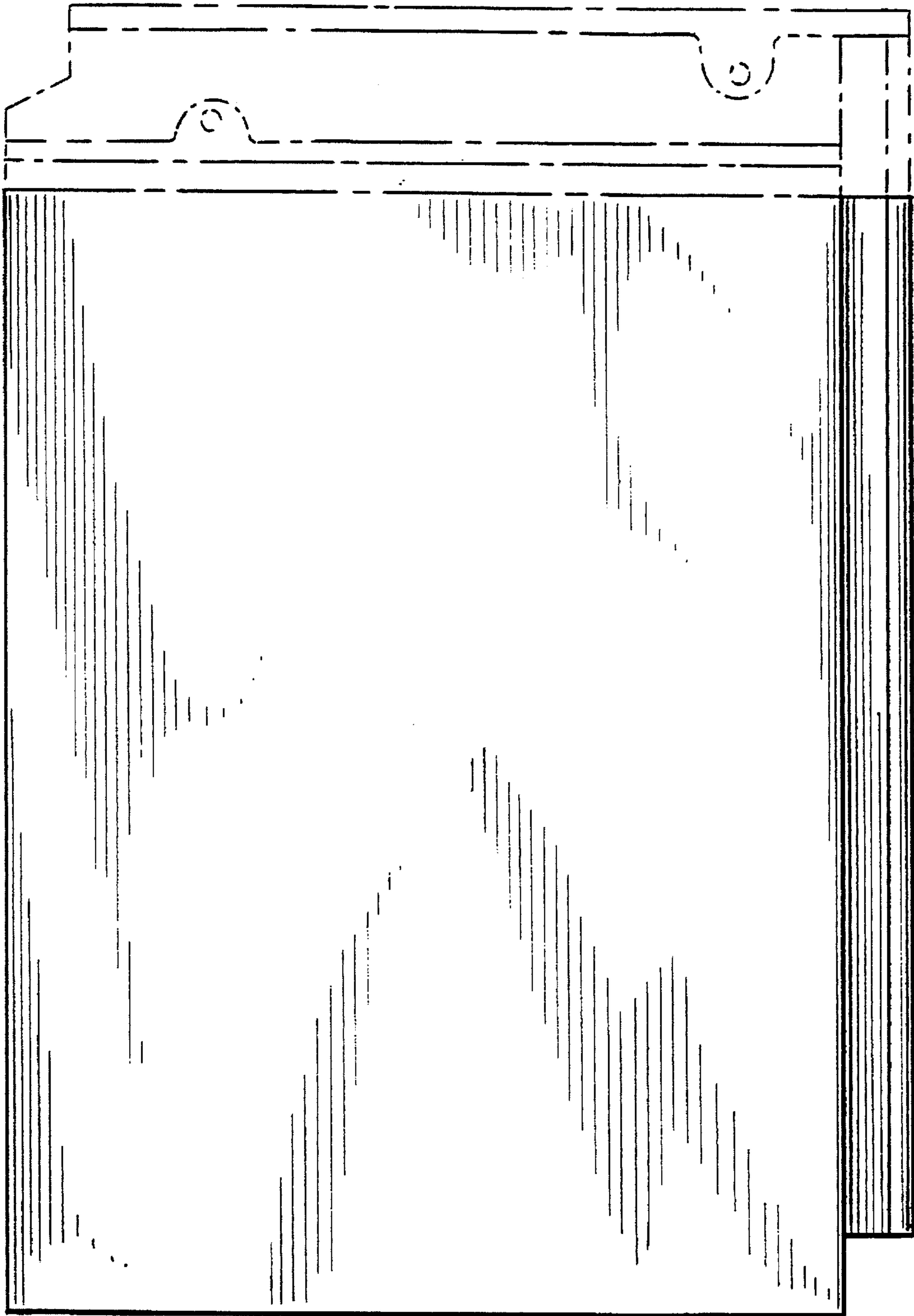
