FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being in the horizontal angle of the skirt;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being in the near vertical angle of the skirt; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being in the downward angle of the skirt; FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of


the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being in the height of the base;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of a third embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being in the height of the base;




FIG. 64 is a side elevational view of a twenty-eighth embodiment of the new flower pot cover design of FIG. 56, the only difference being in the height of the base;

FIG. 65 is a top plan view of a twenty-ninth embodiment of the flower pot cover design of FIG. 56, the only difference being in the size of the skirt;


FIG. 66 is a top plan view of a thirtienth embodiment of the flower pot cover design of FIG. 56, the only difference being in the size of the skirt.






























































































































