FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image of the left side;

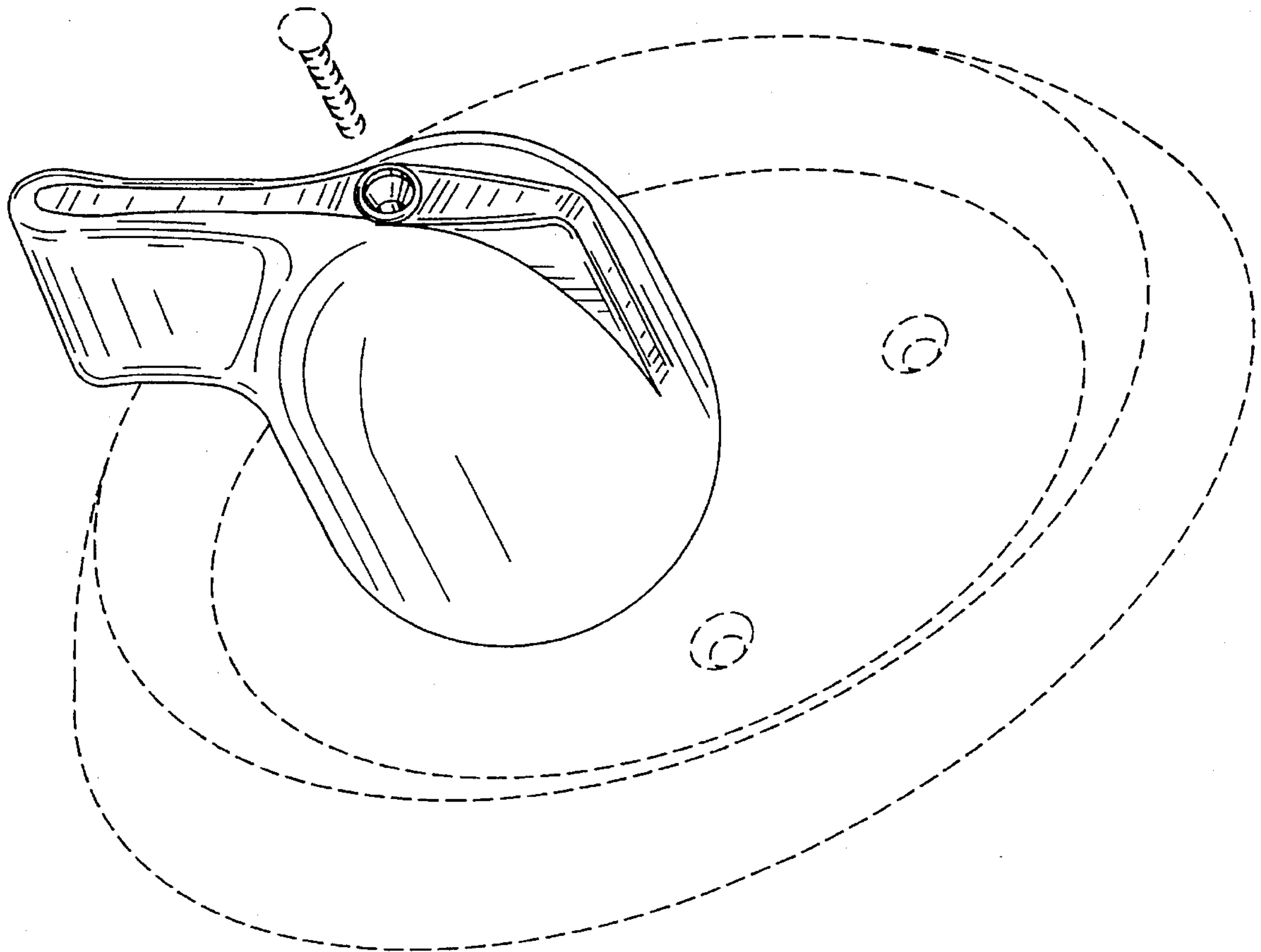
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

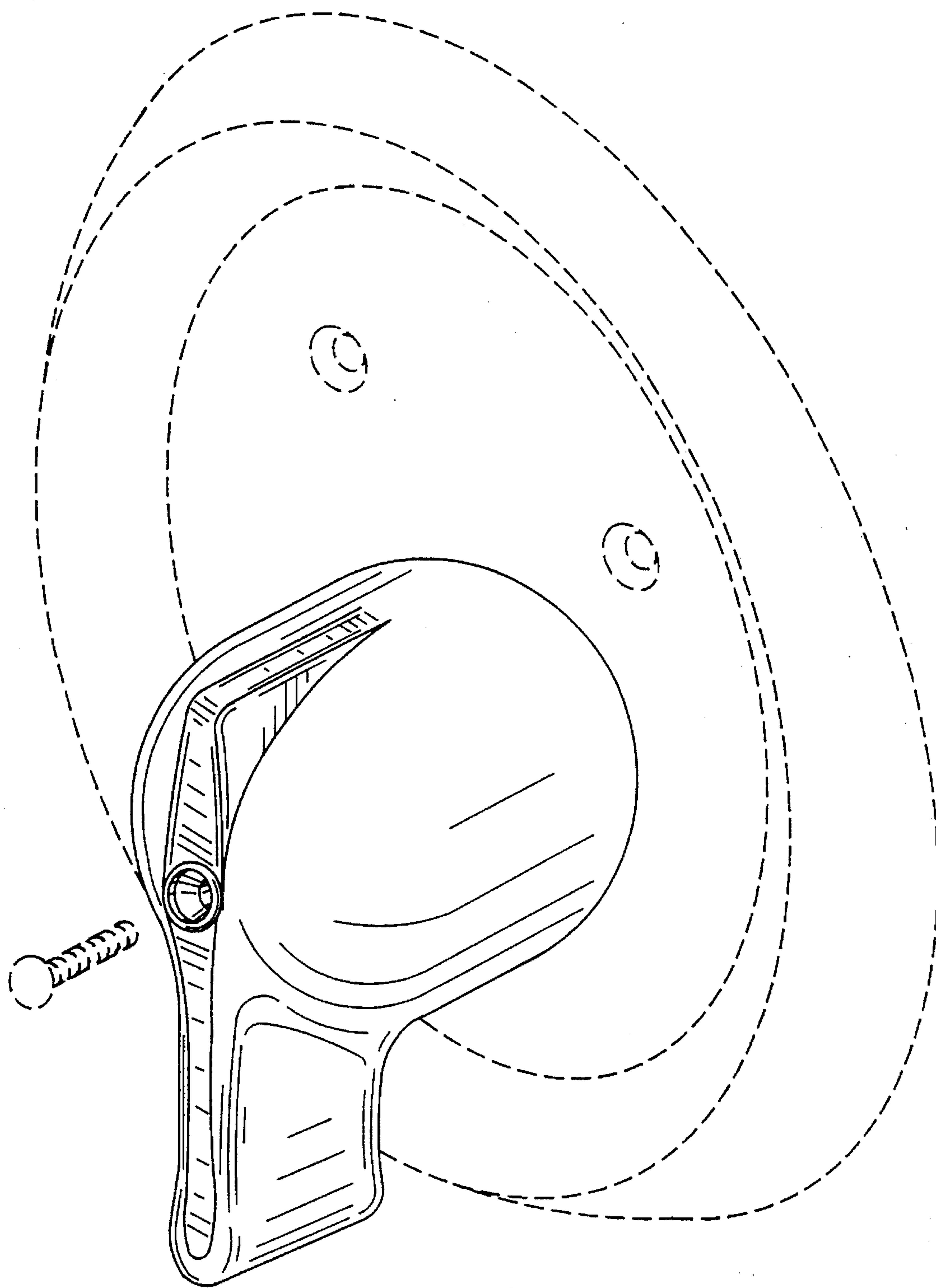

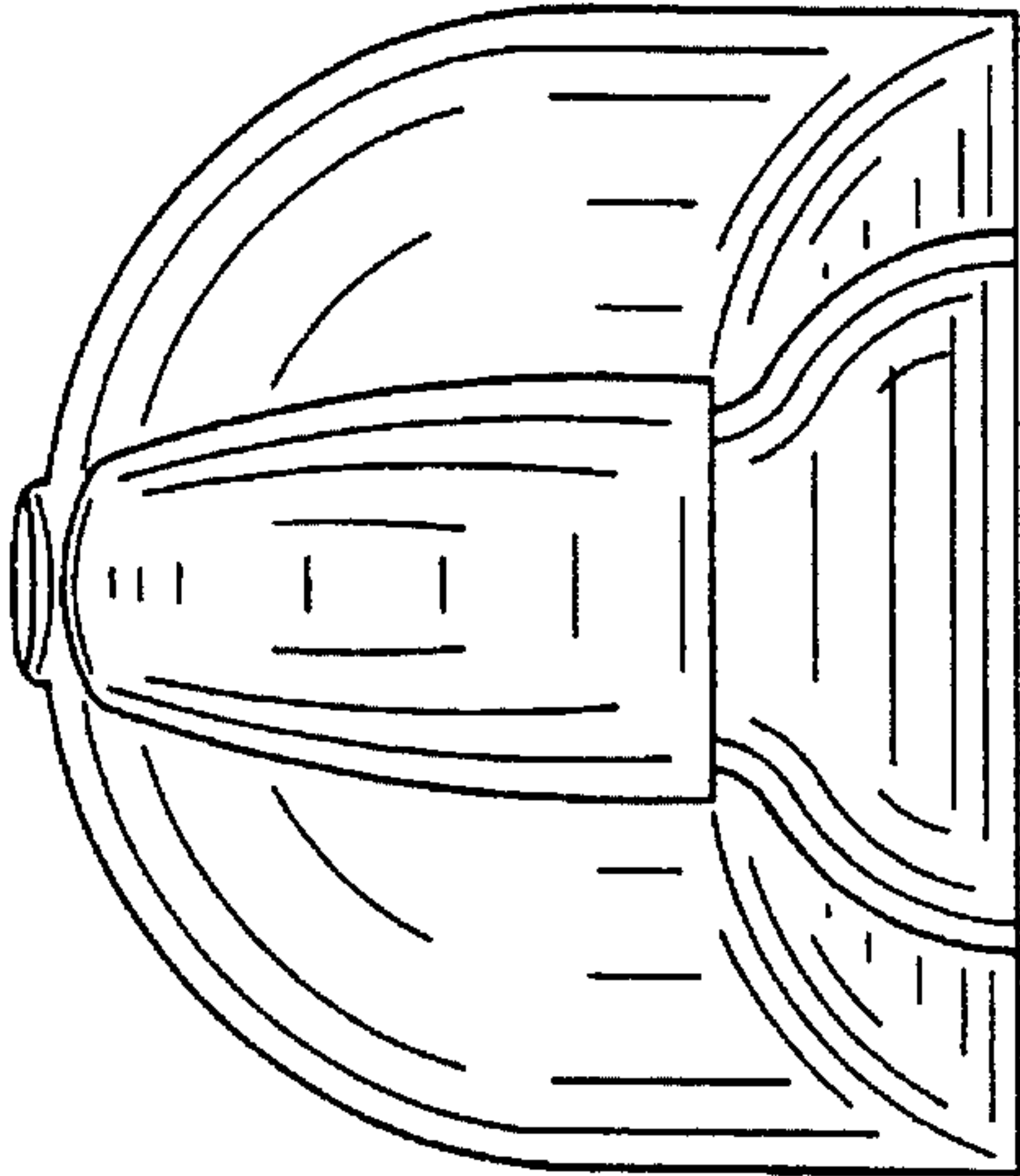

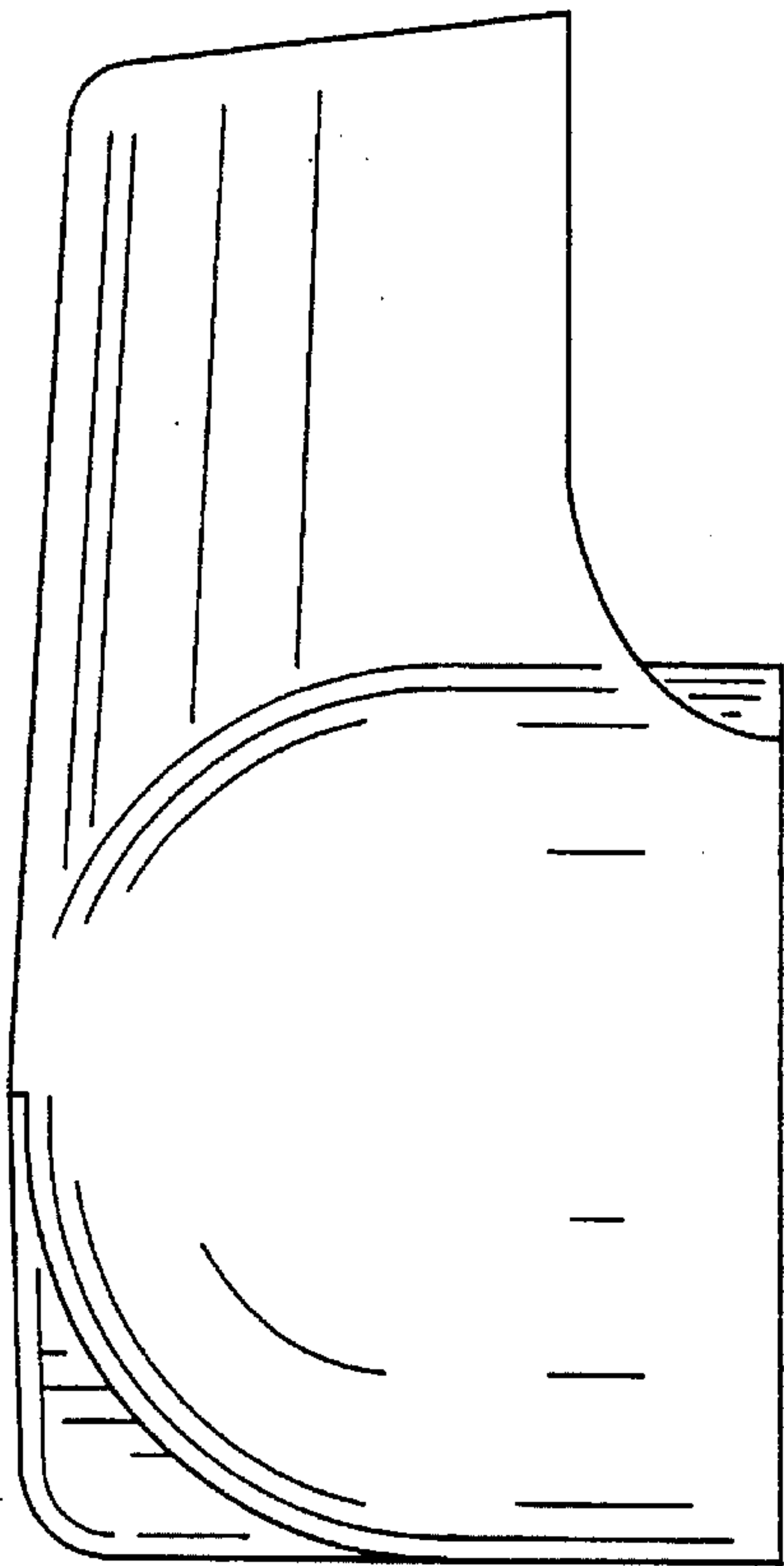

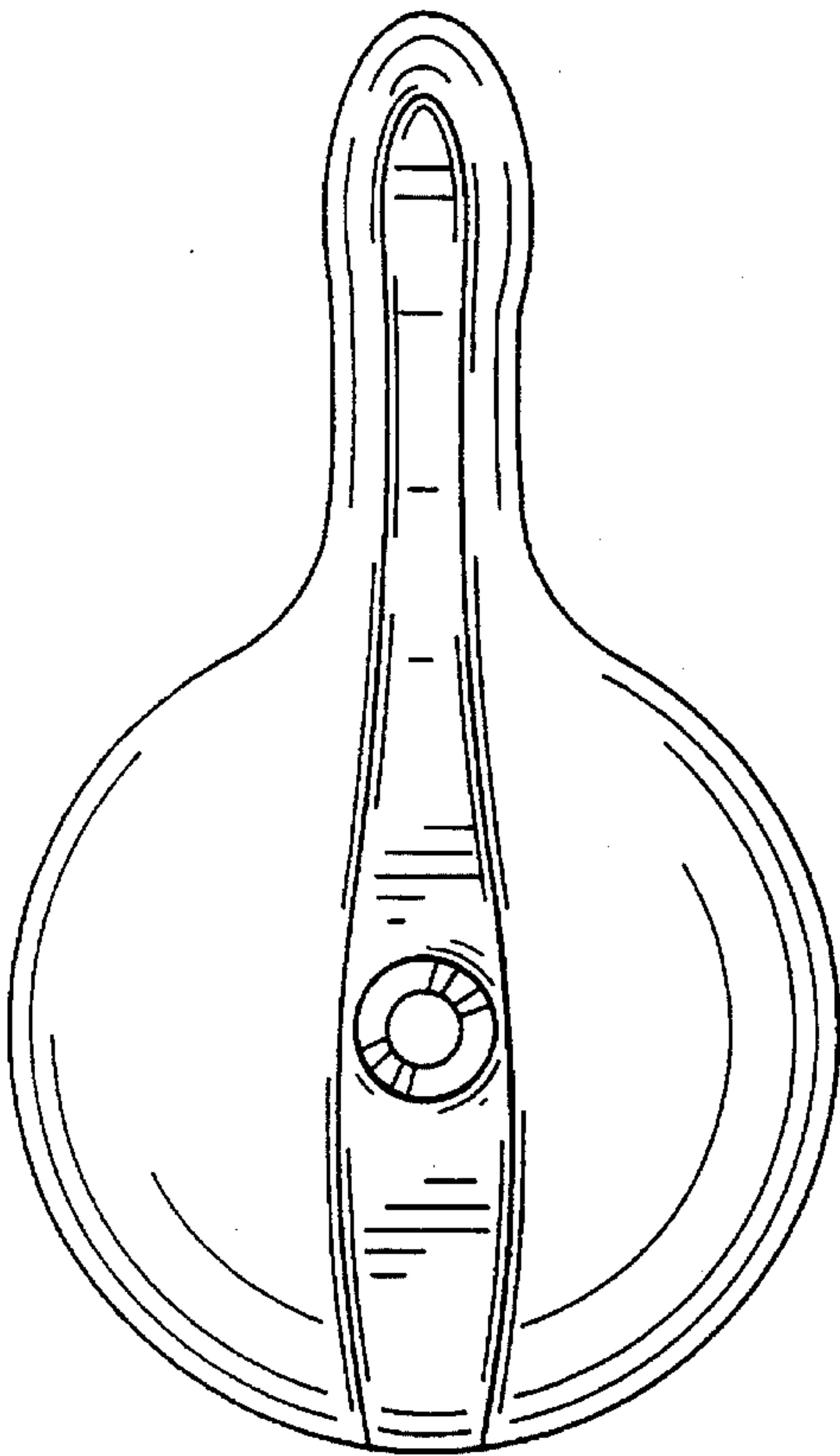

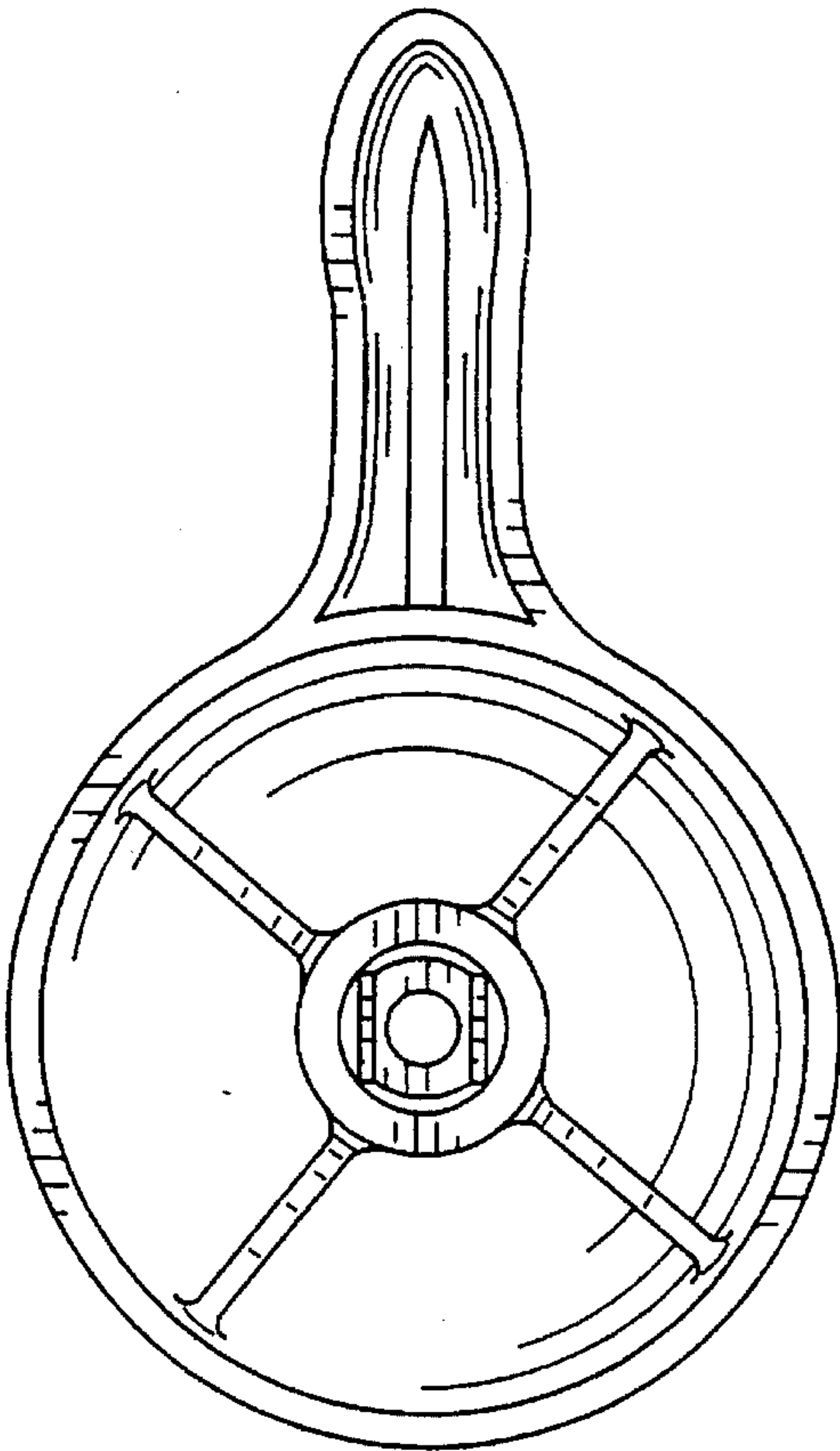

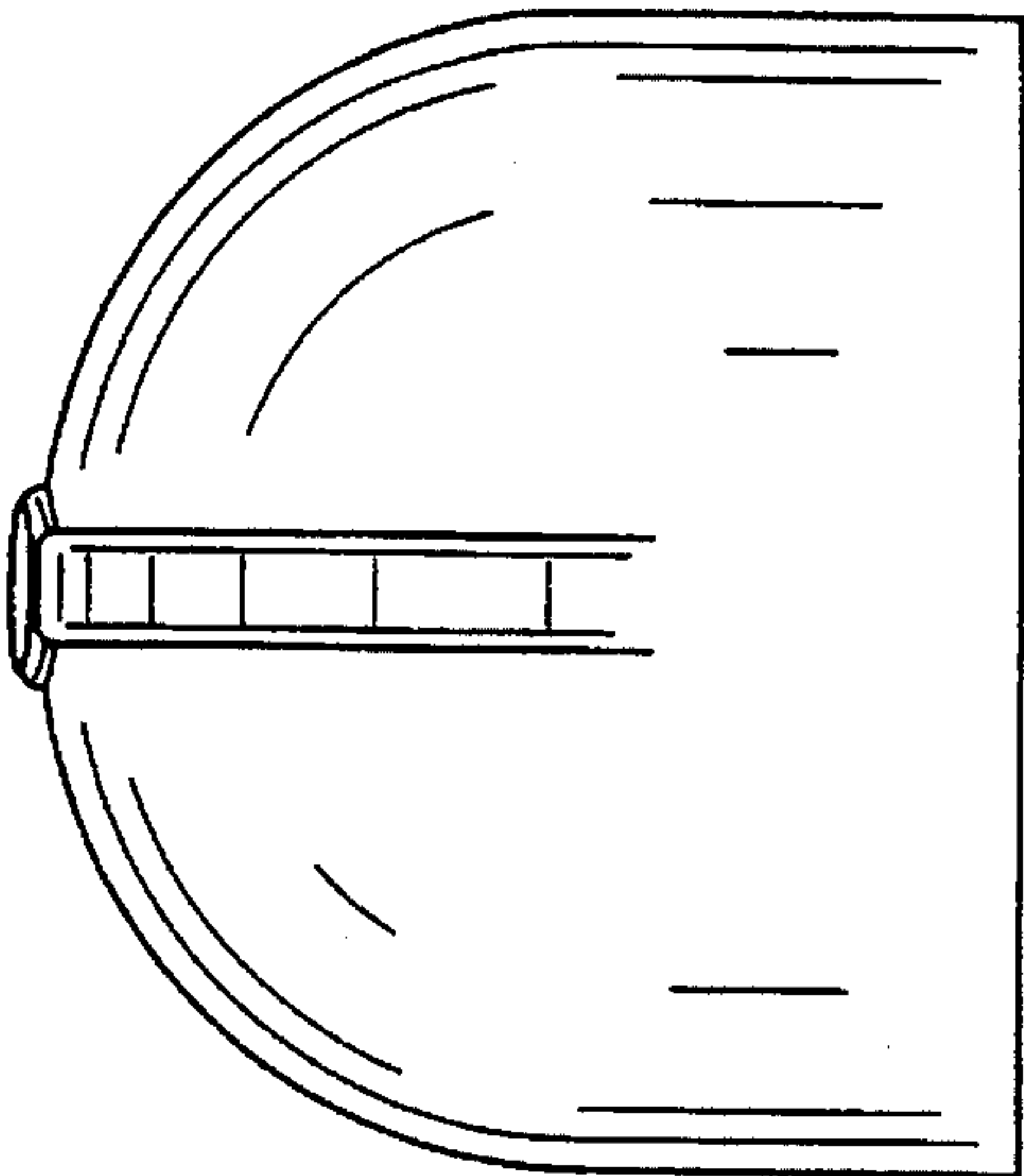
