The ornamental design for a portable telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, and right side perspective view showing our new design for a portable telephone in full lines, with the broken line matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, with the broken line matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design.

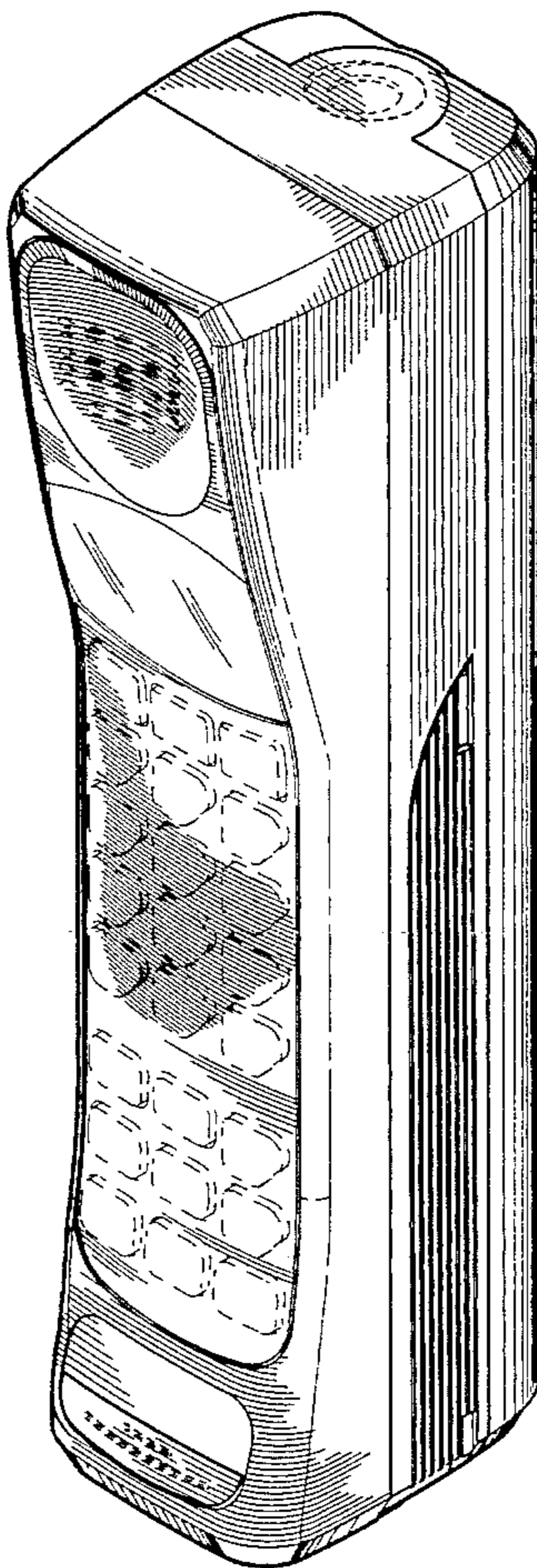

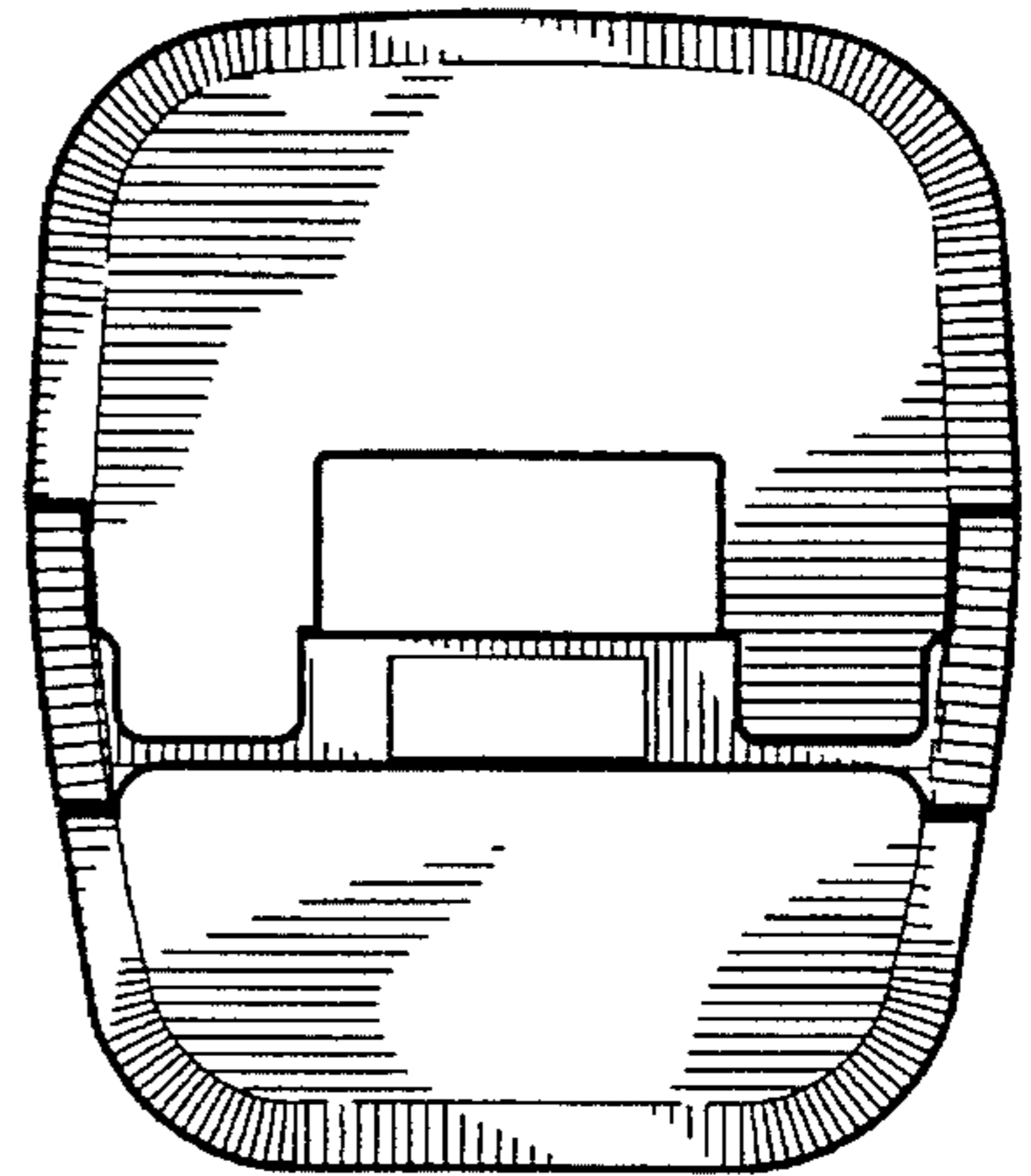
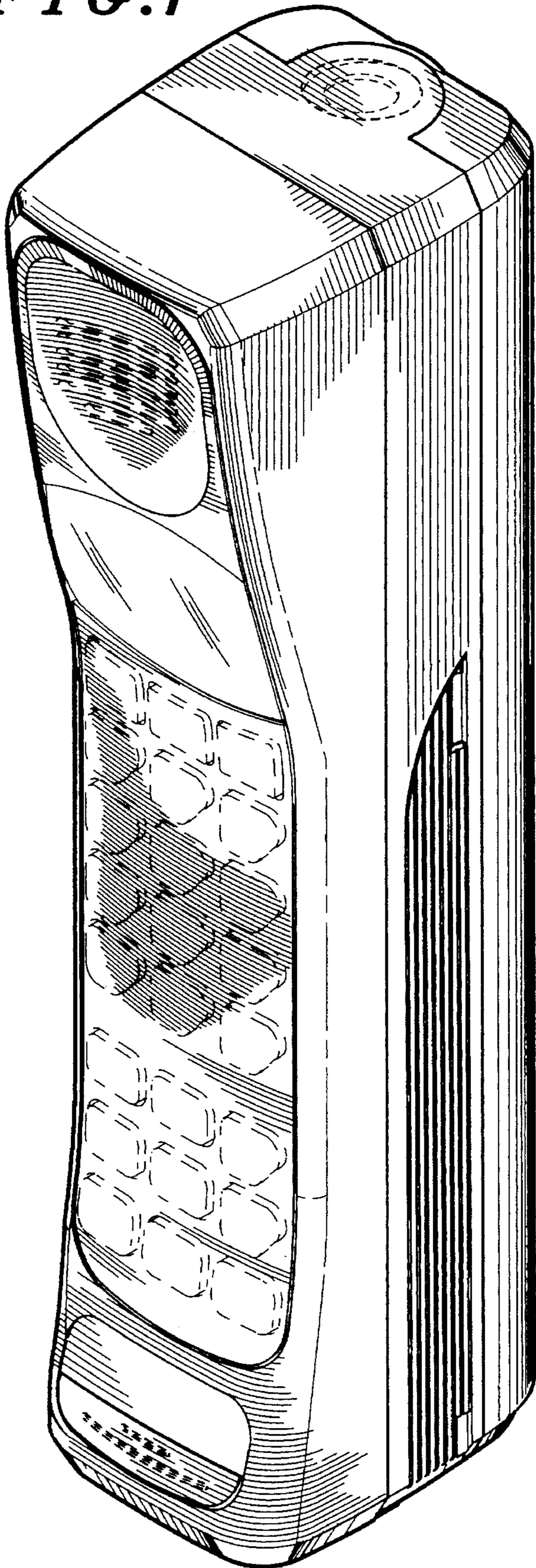

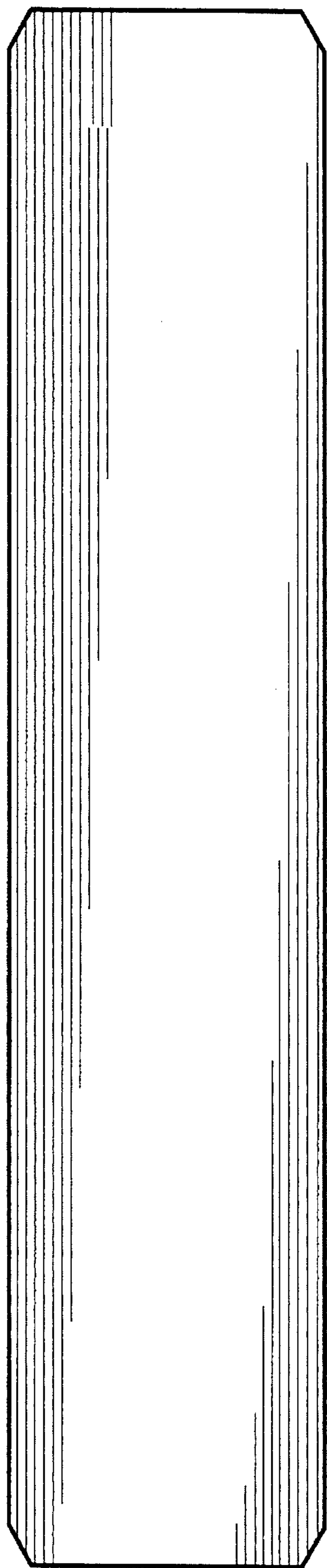

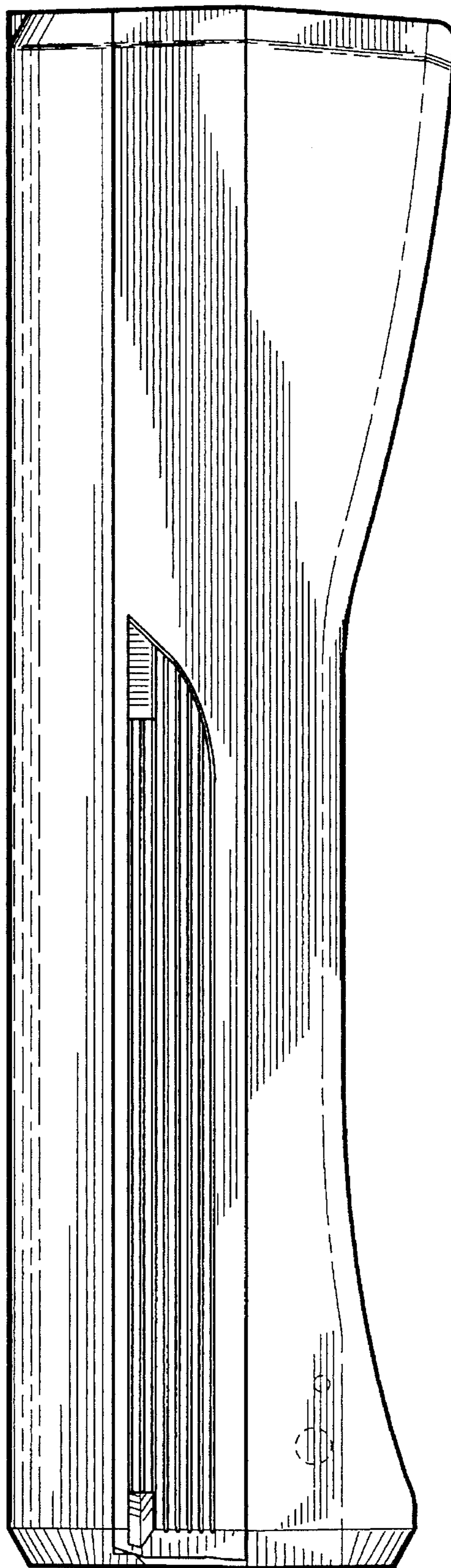
