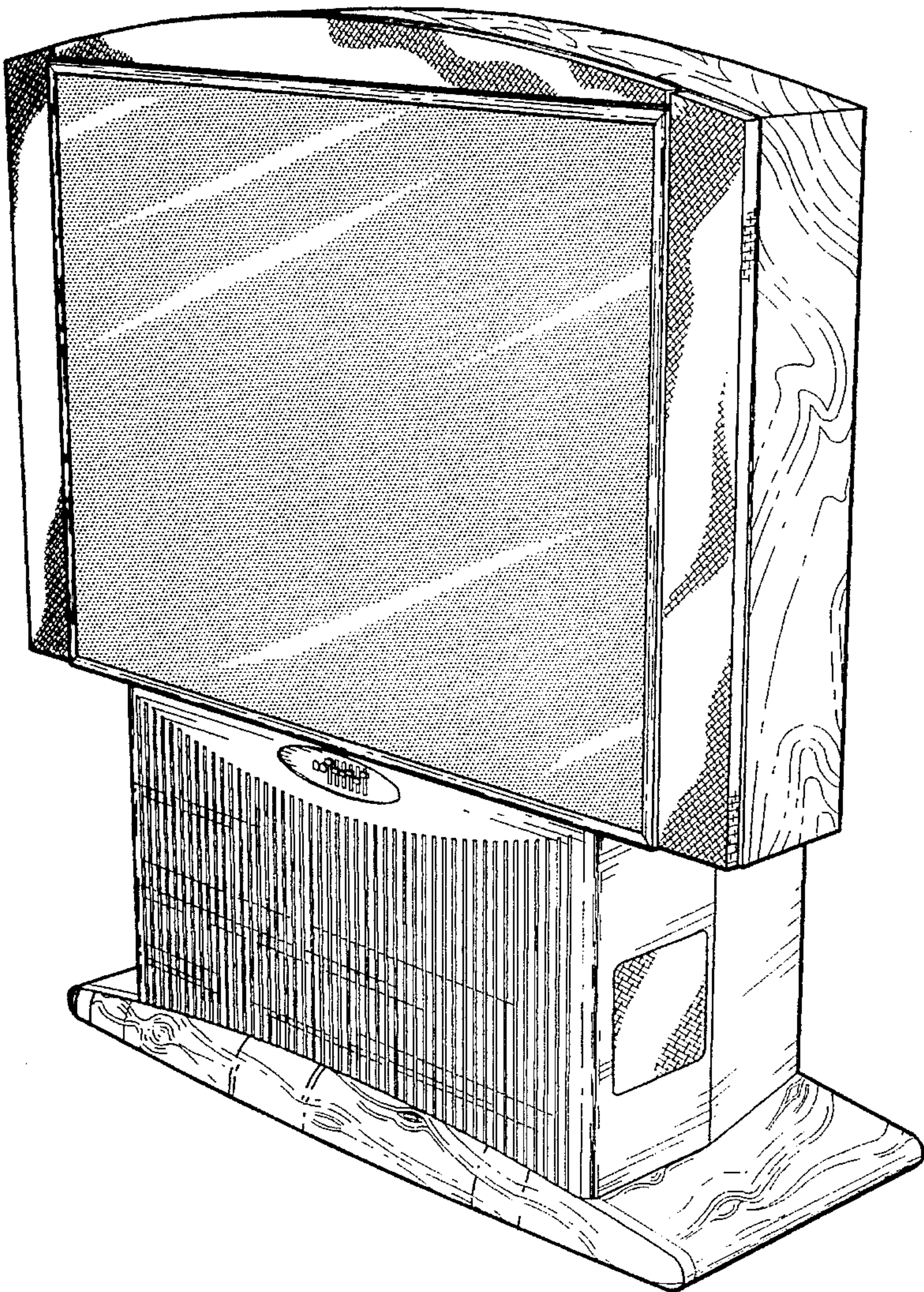
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a rear projection television, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a rear projection television
showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side
being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof.

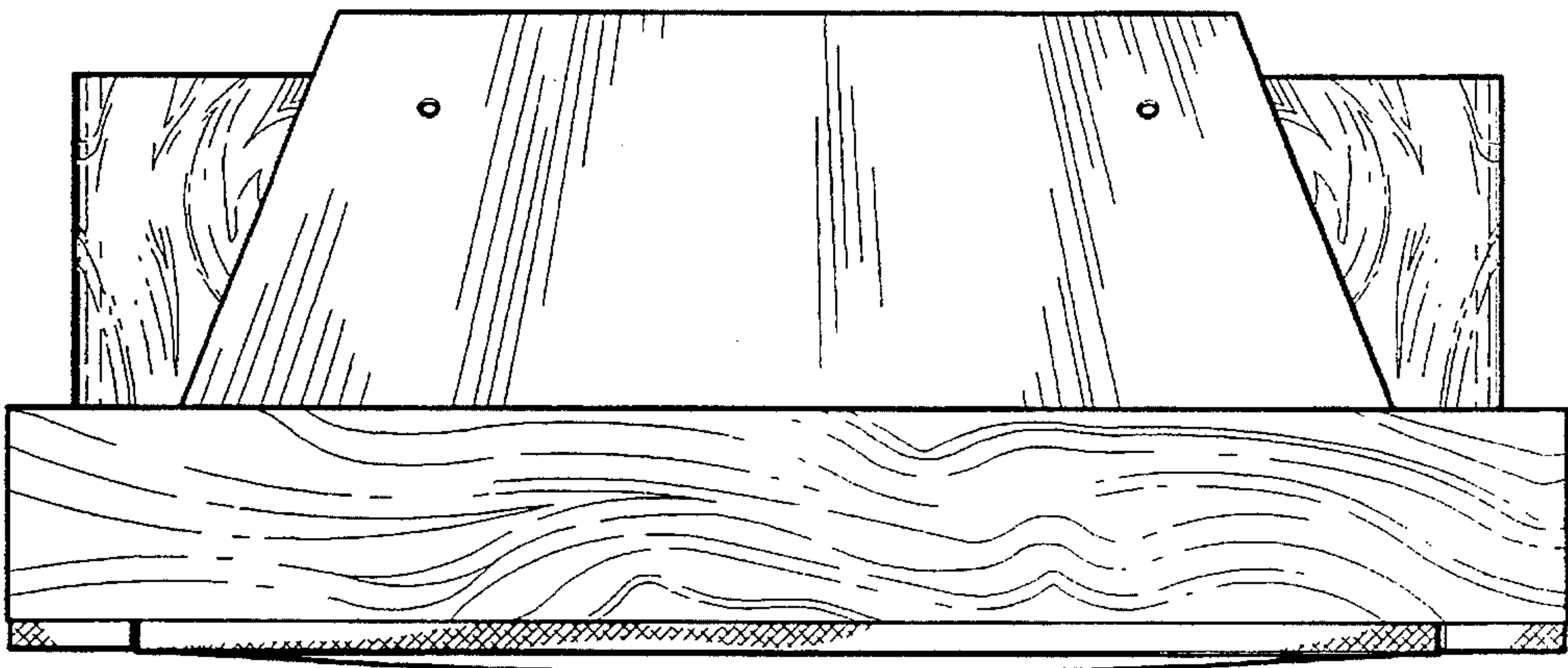

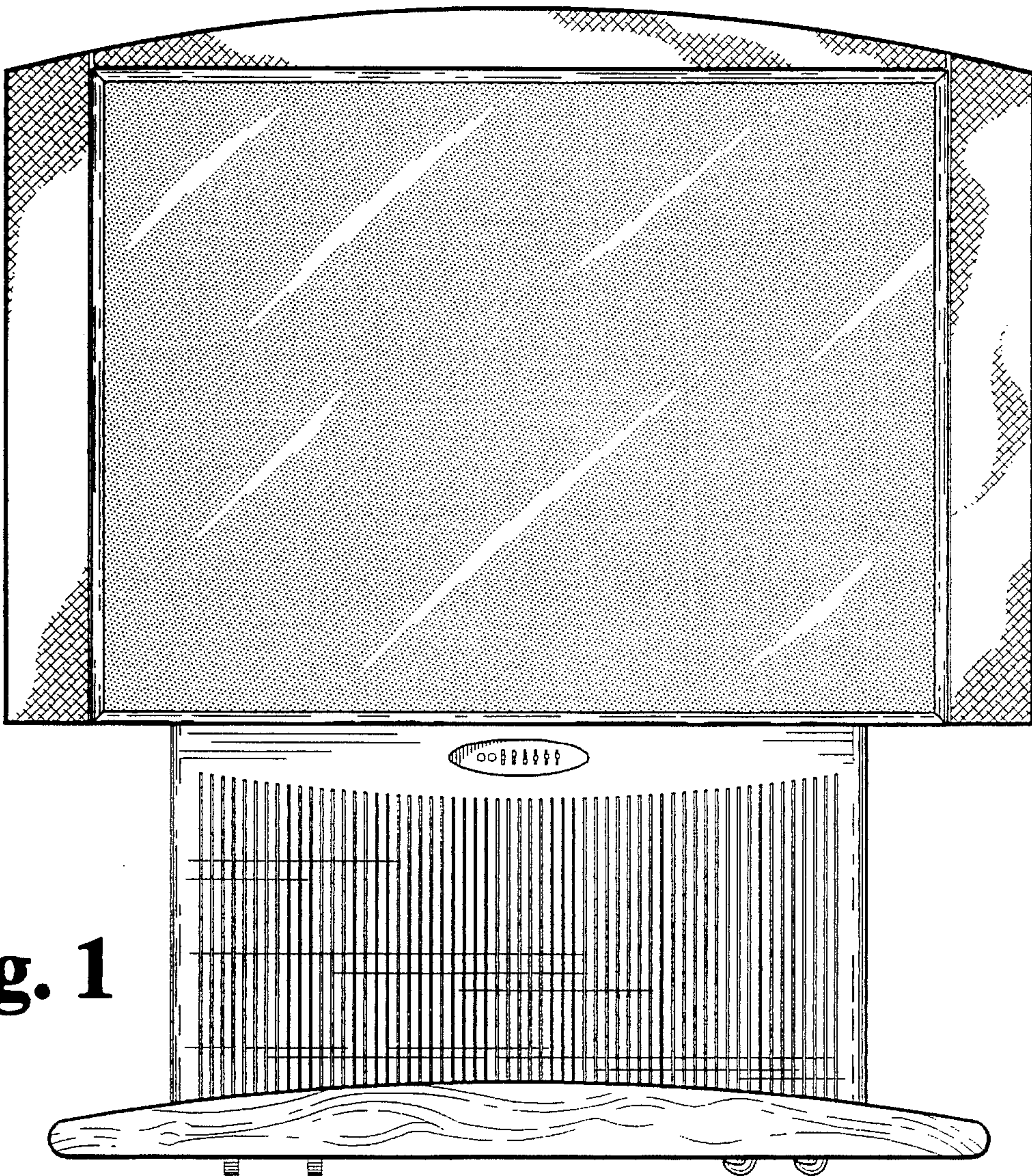

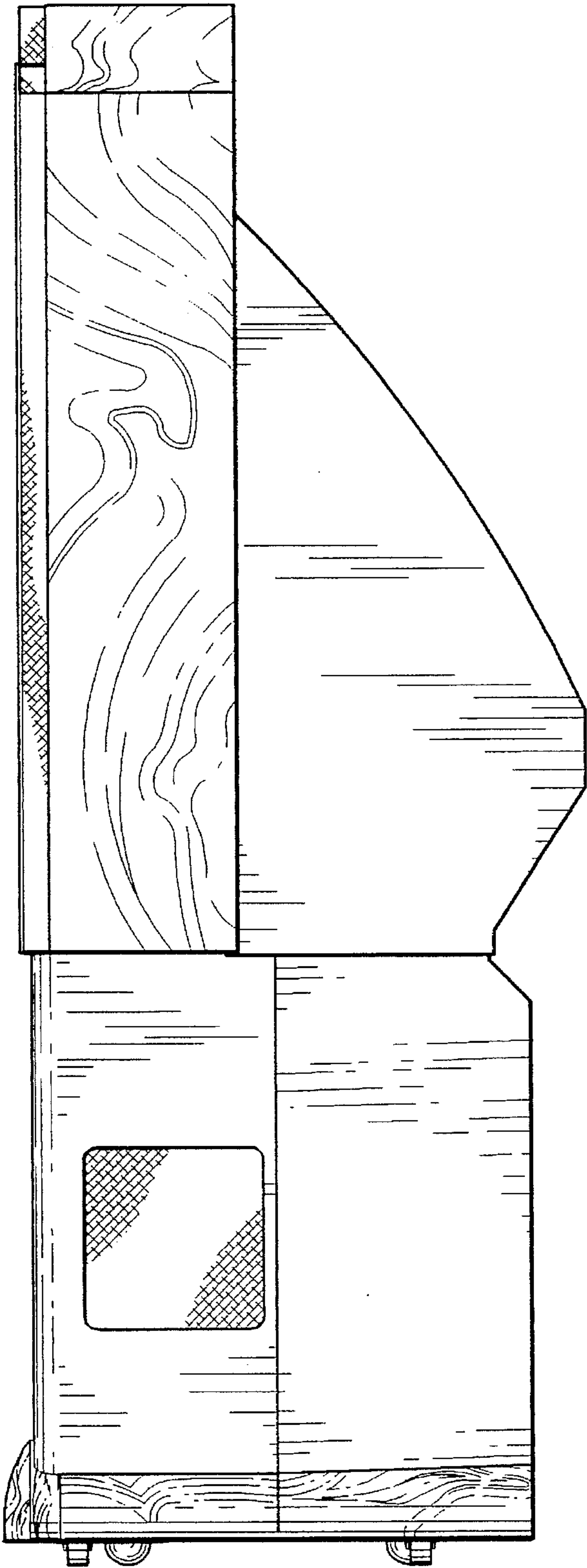

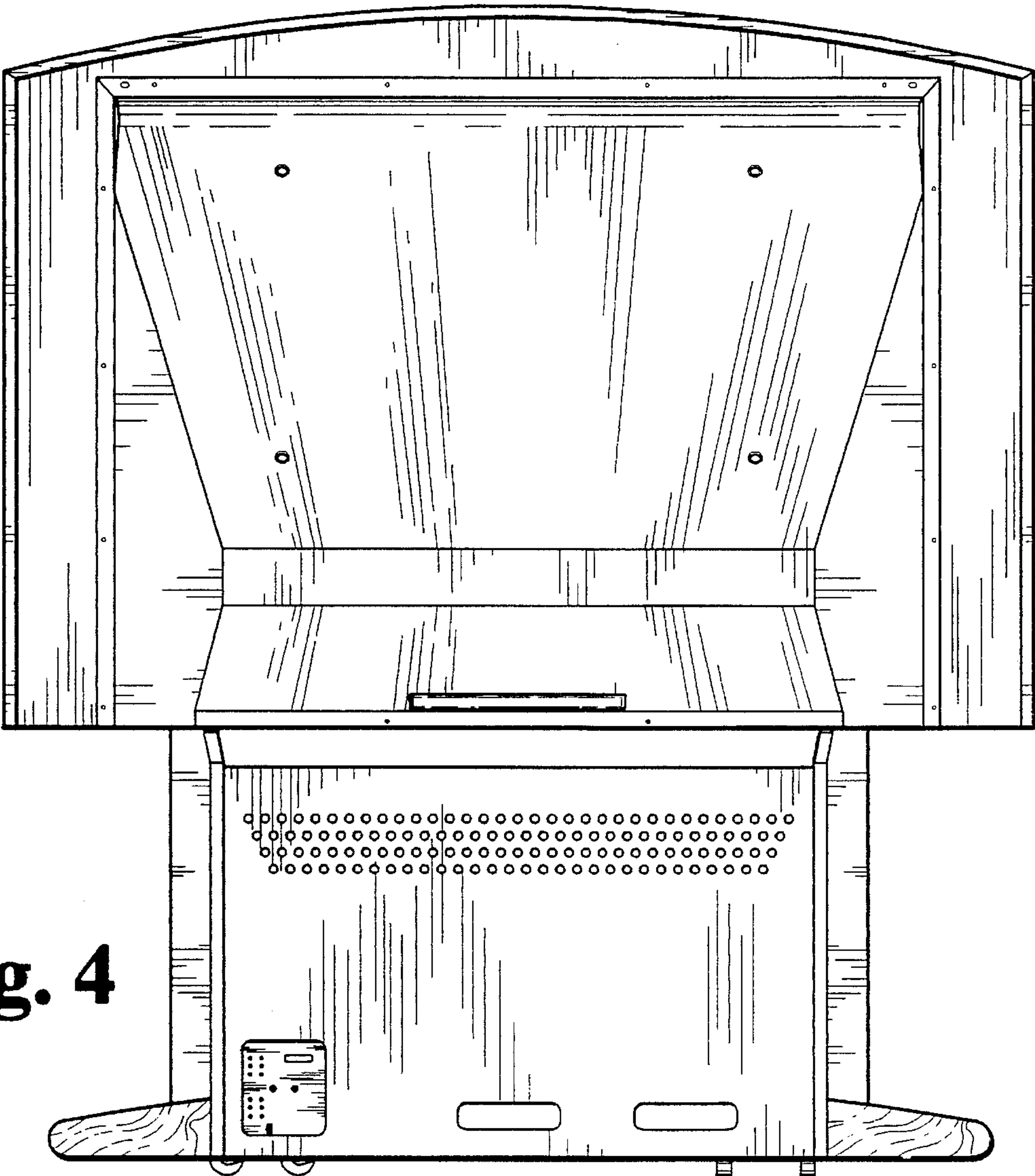

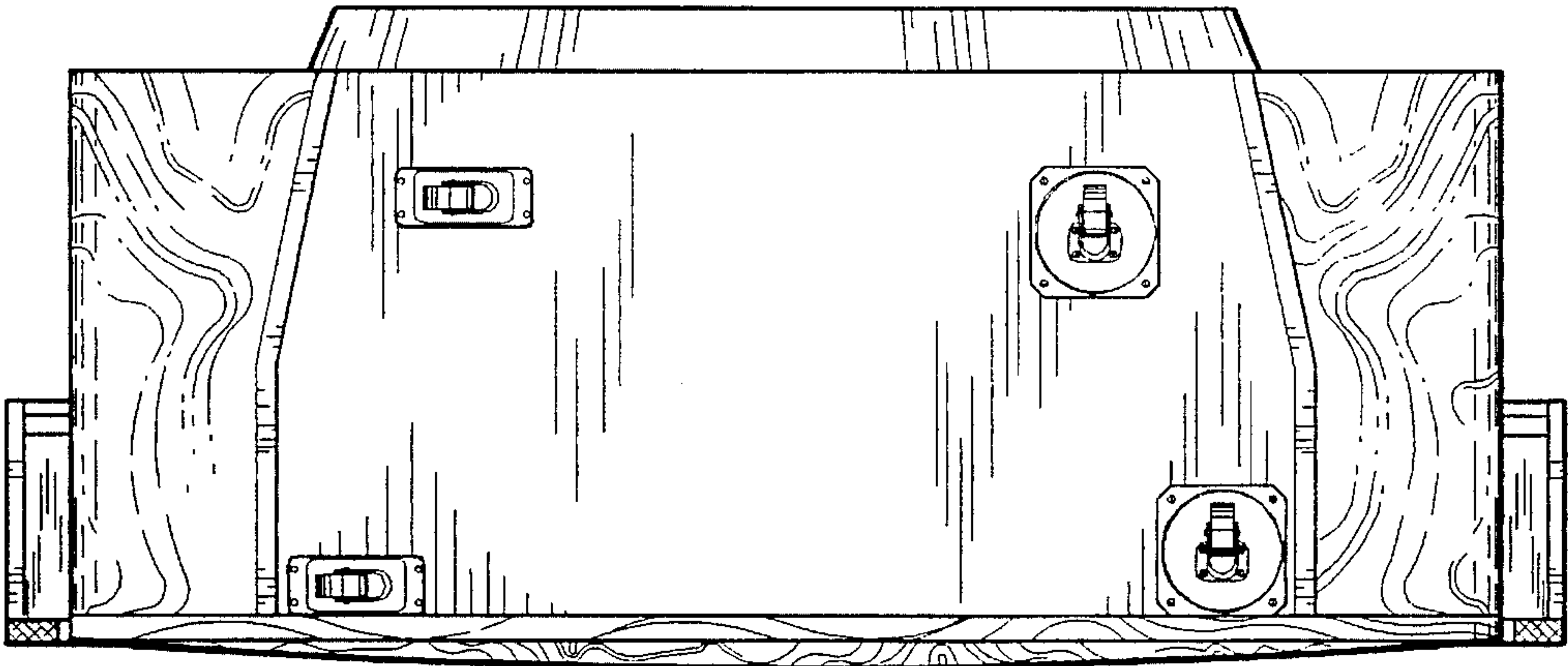

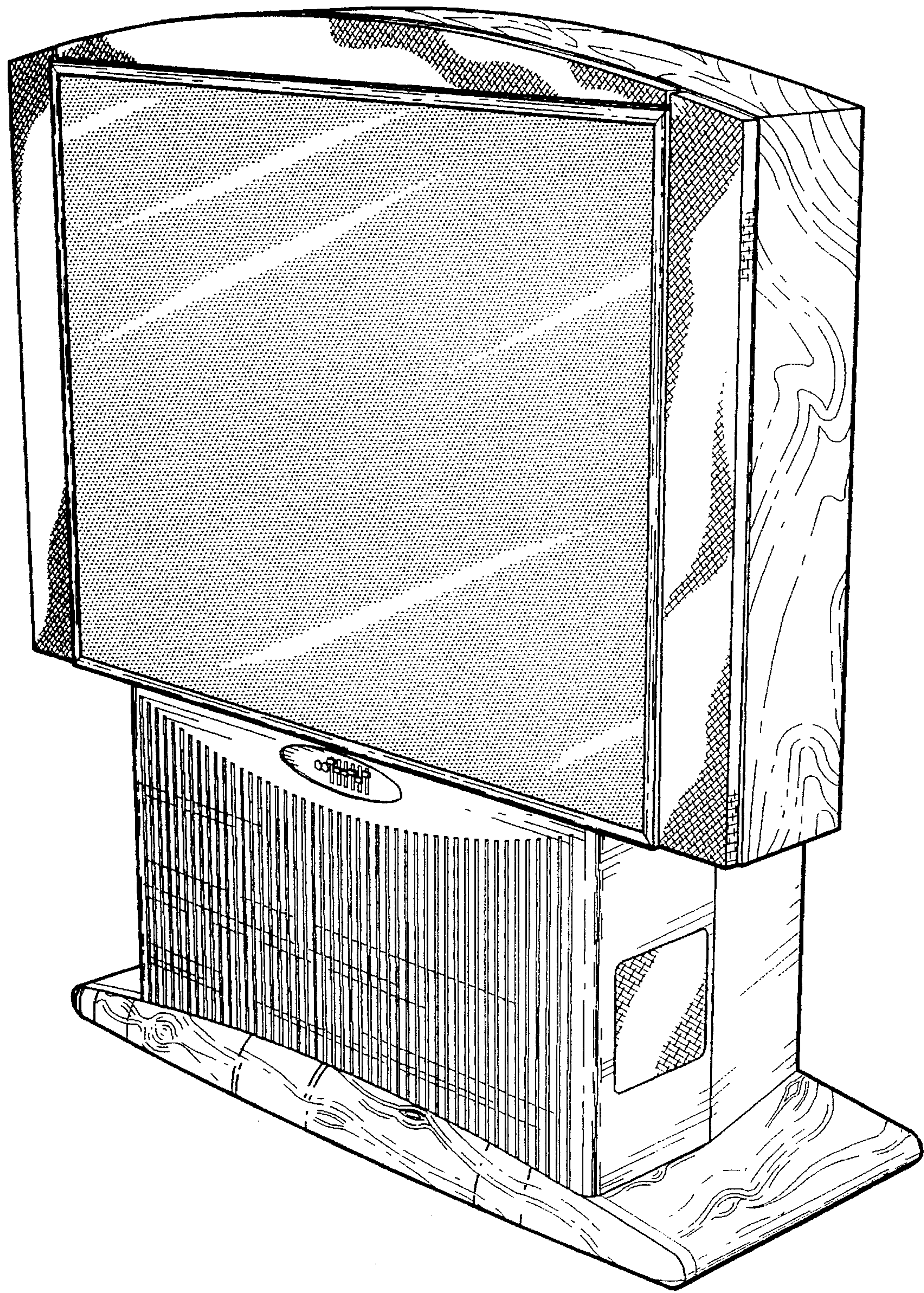
