FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear being a mirror image thereof;

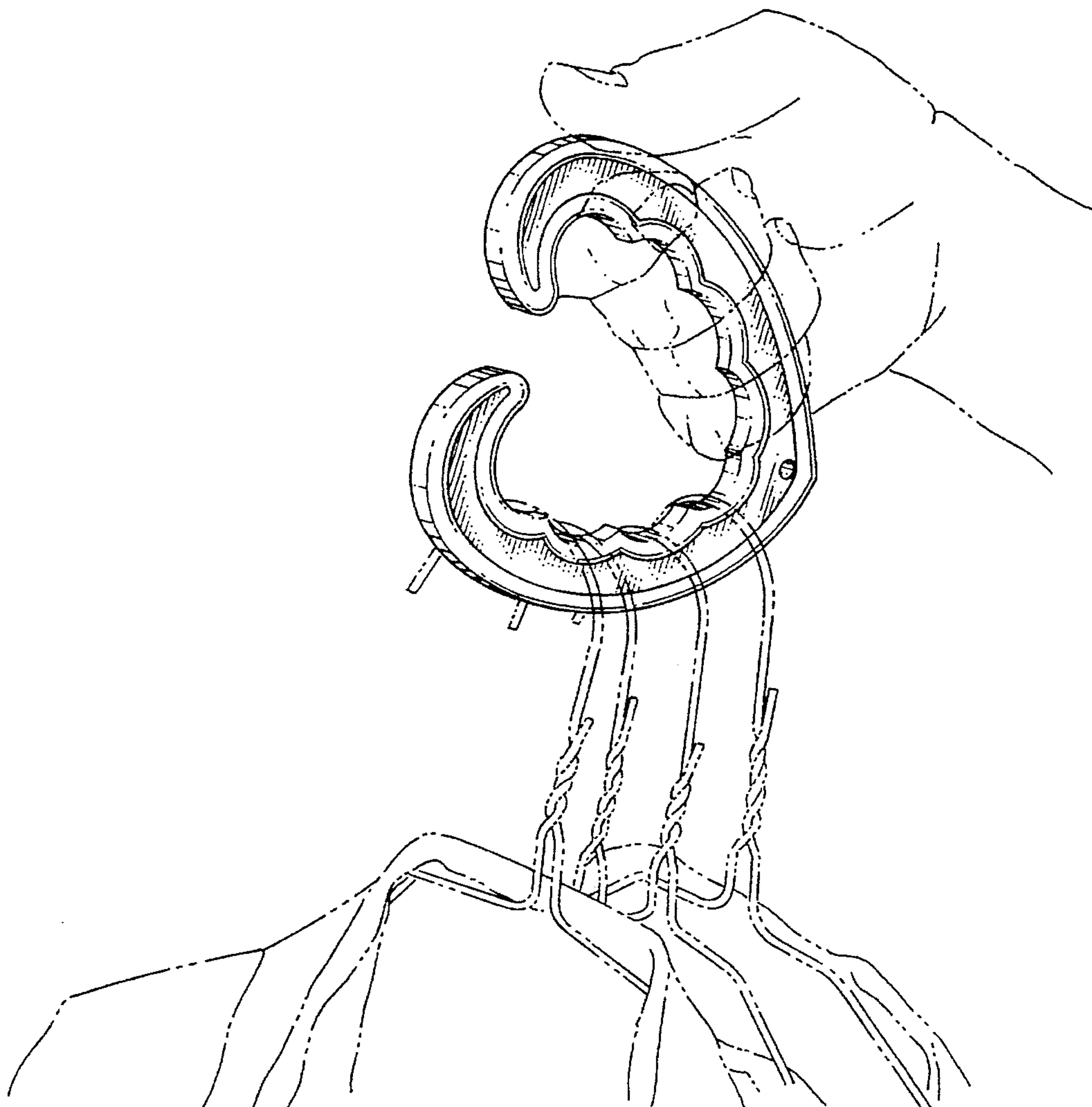
FIG. 3 is a top view, the bottom being a mirror image thereof;

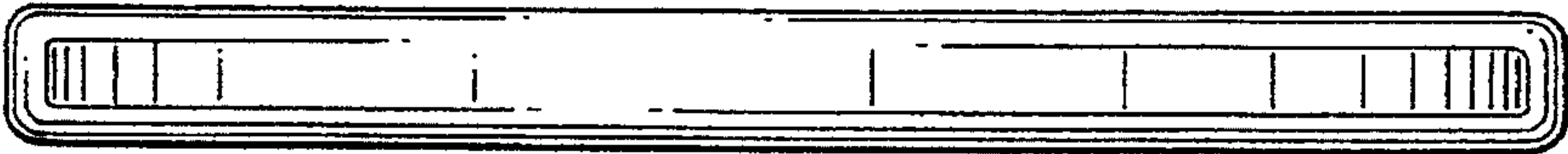
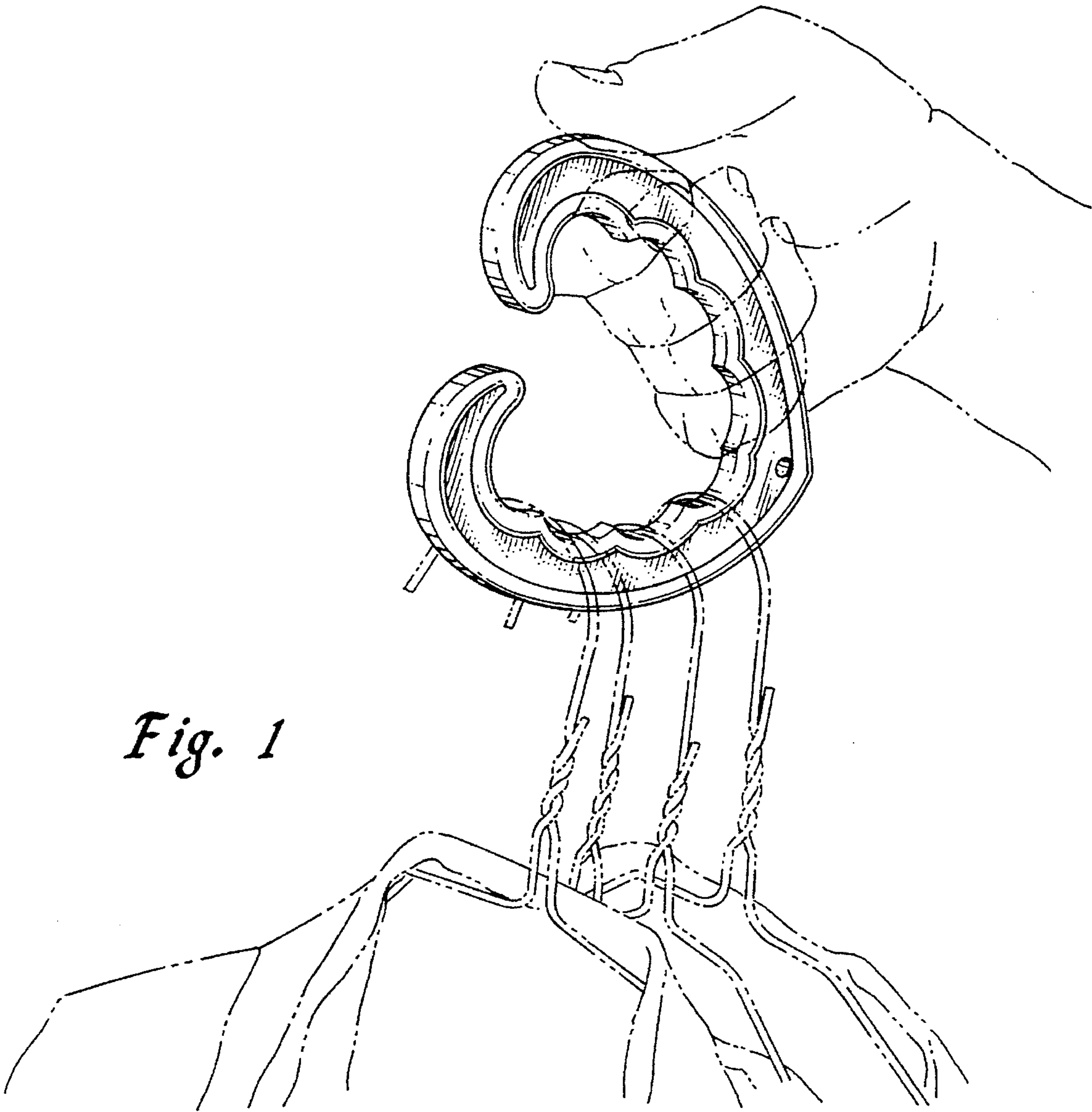
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view; and,

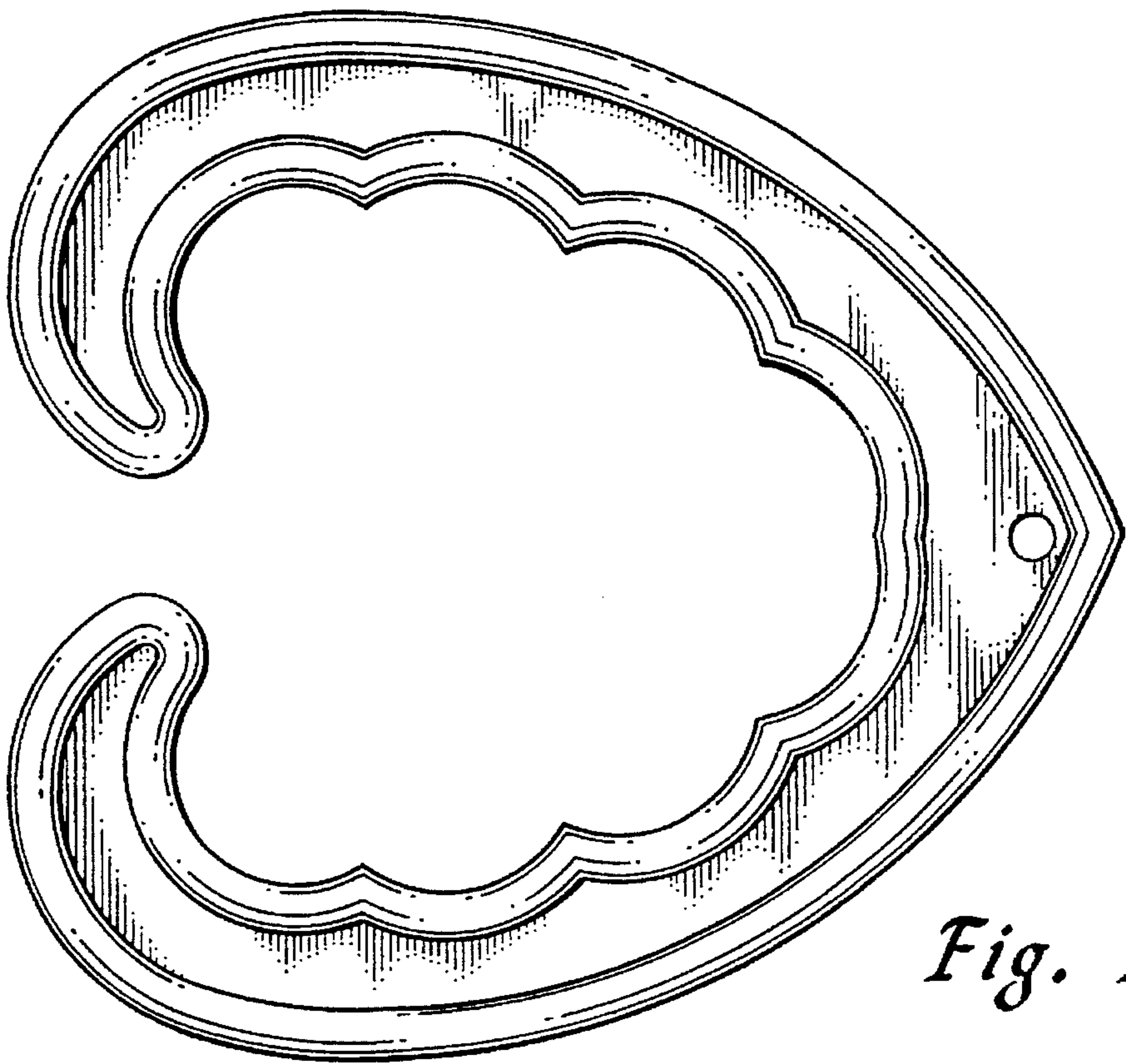
