[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sled based arm chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a sled based arm chair embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the design;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the design;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the design; and,

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

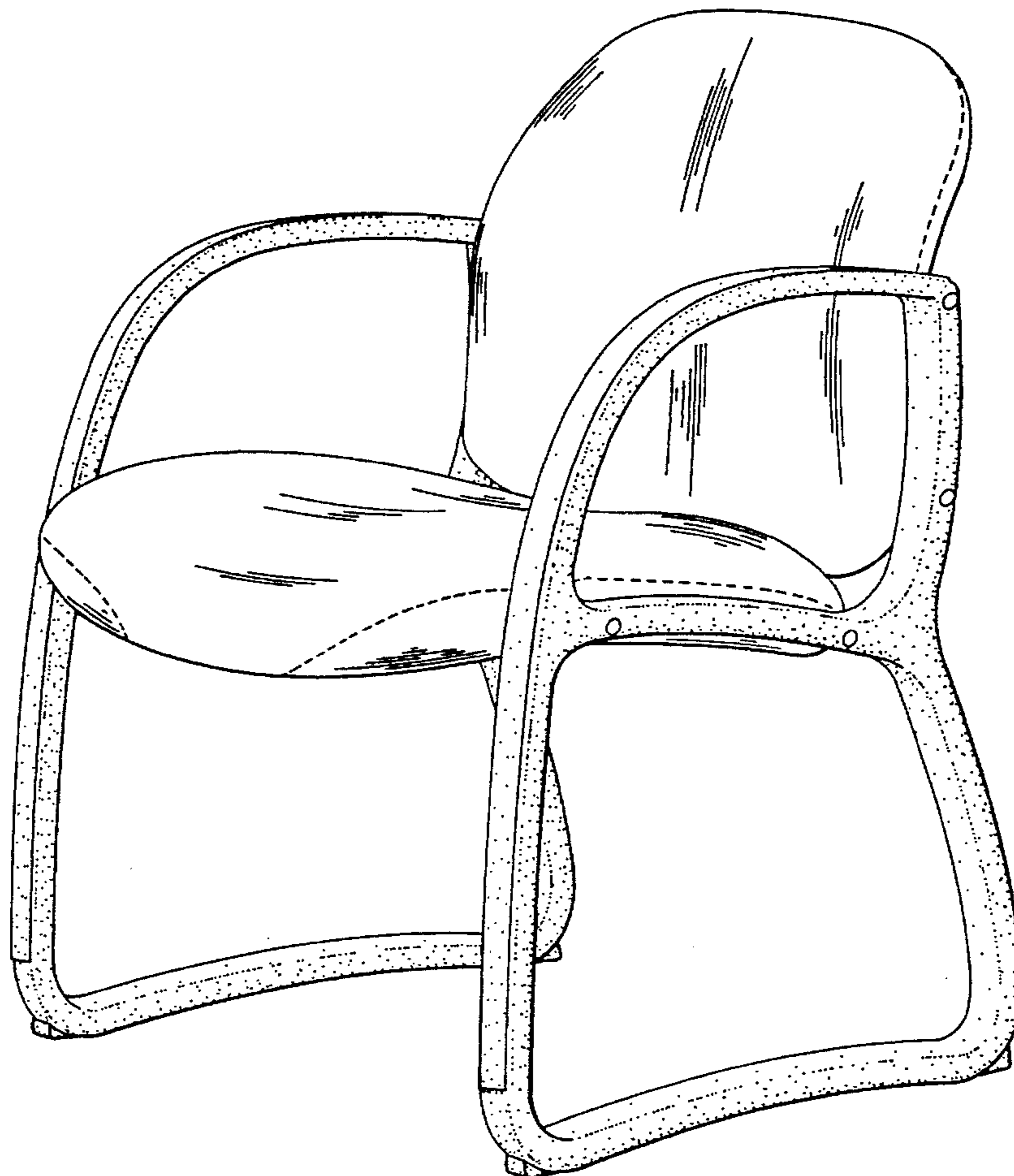

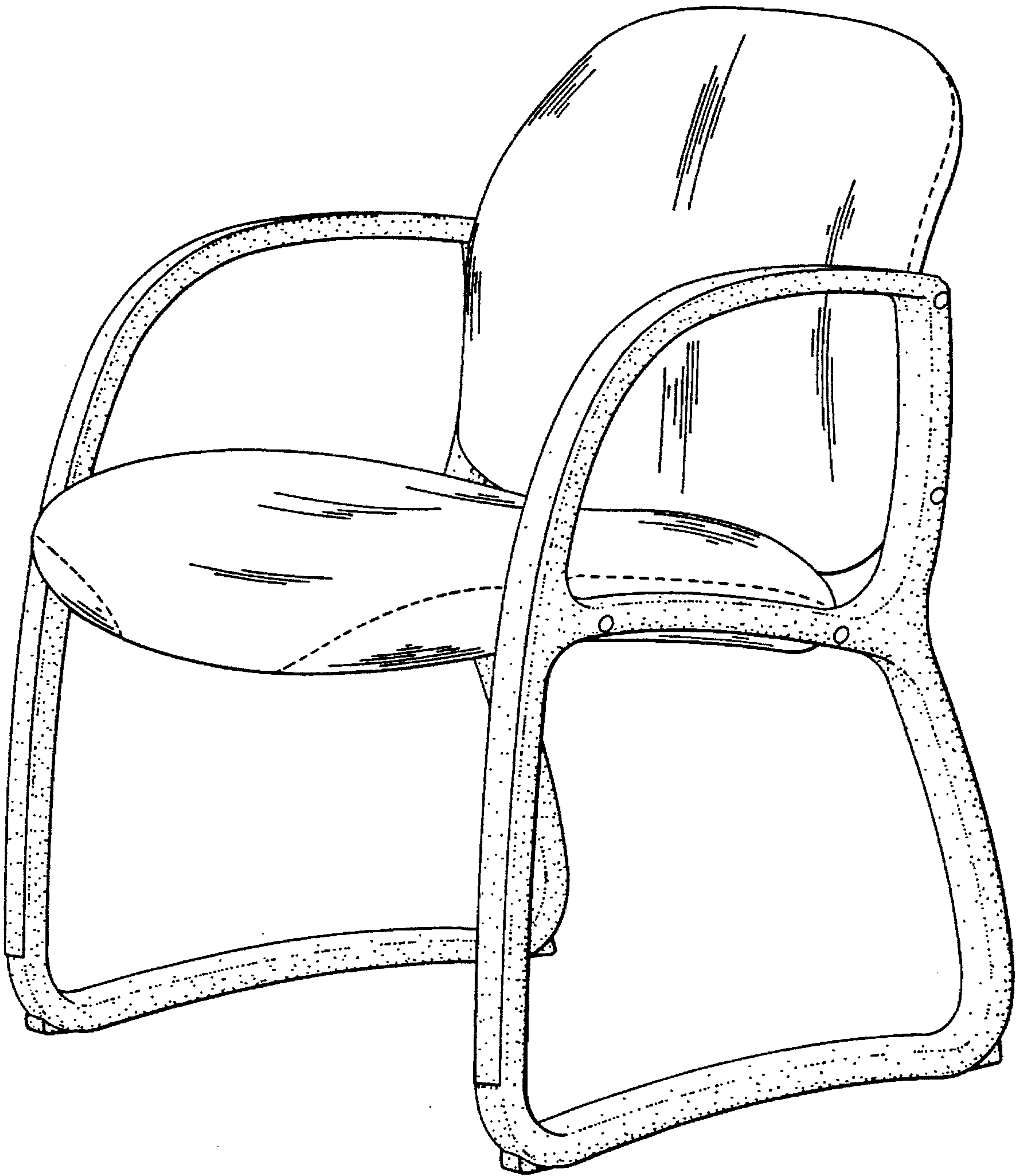

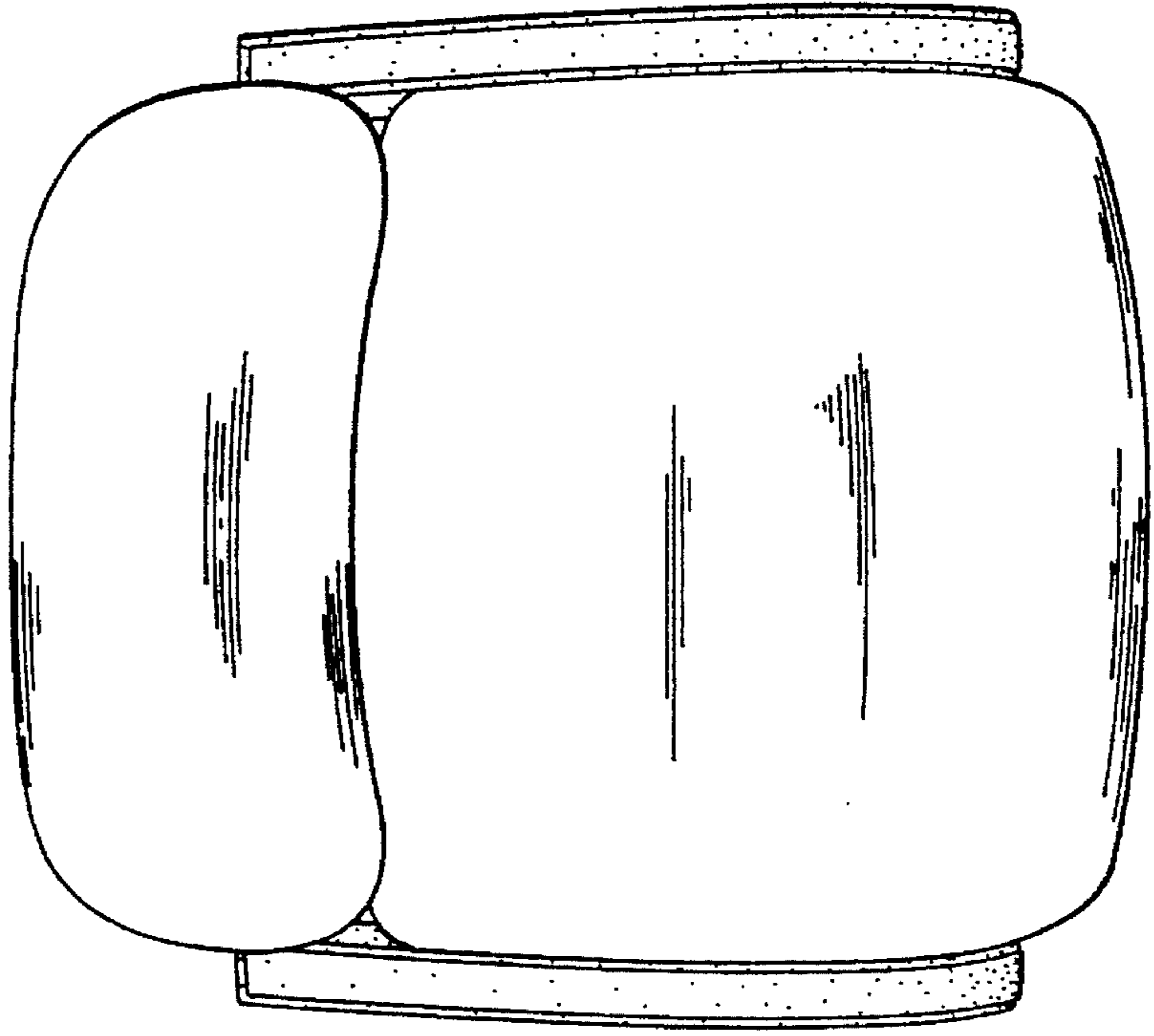

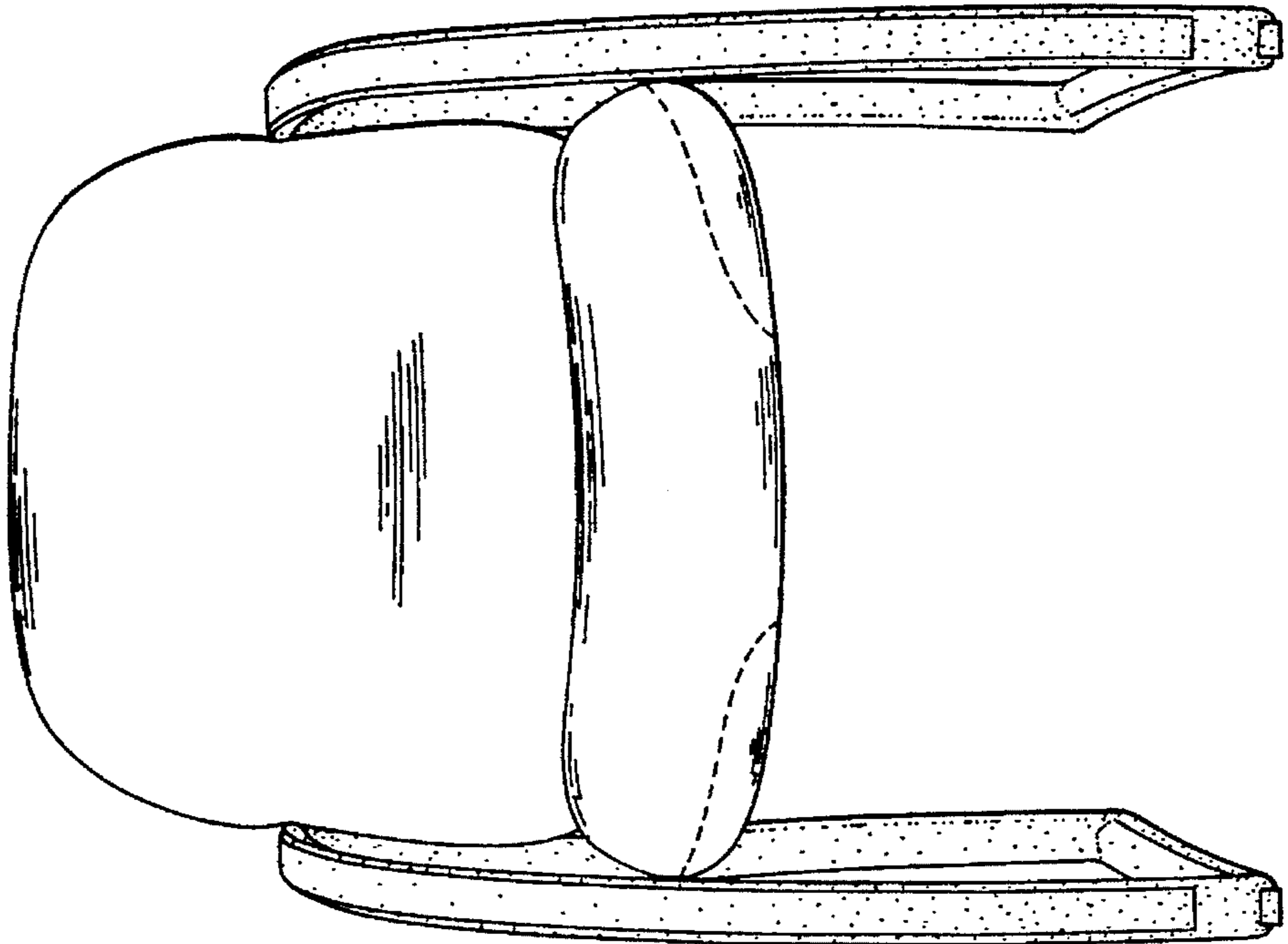

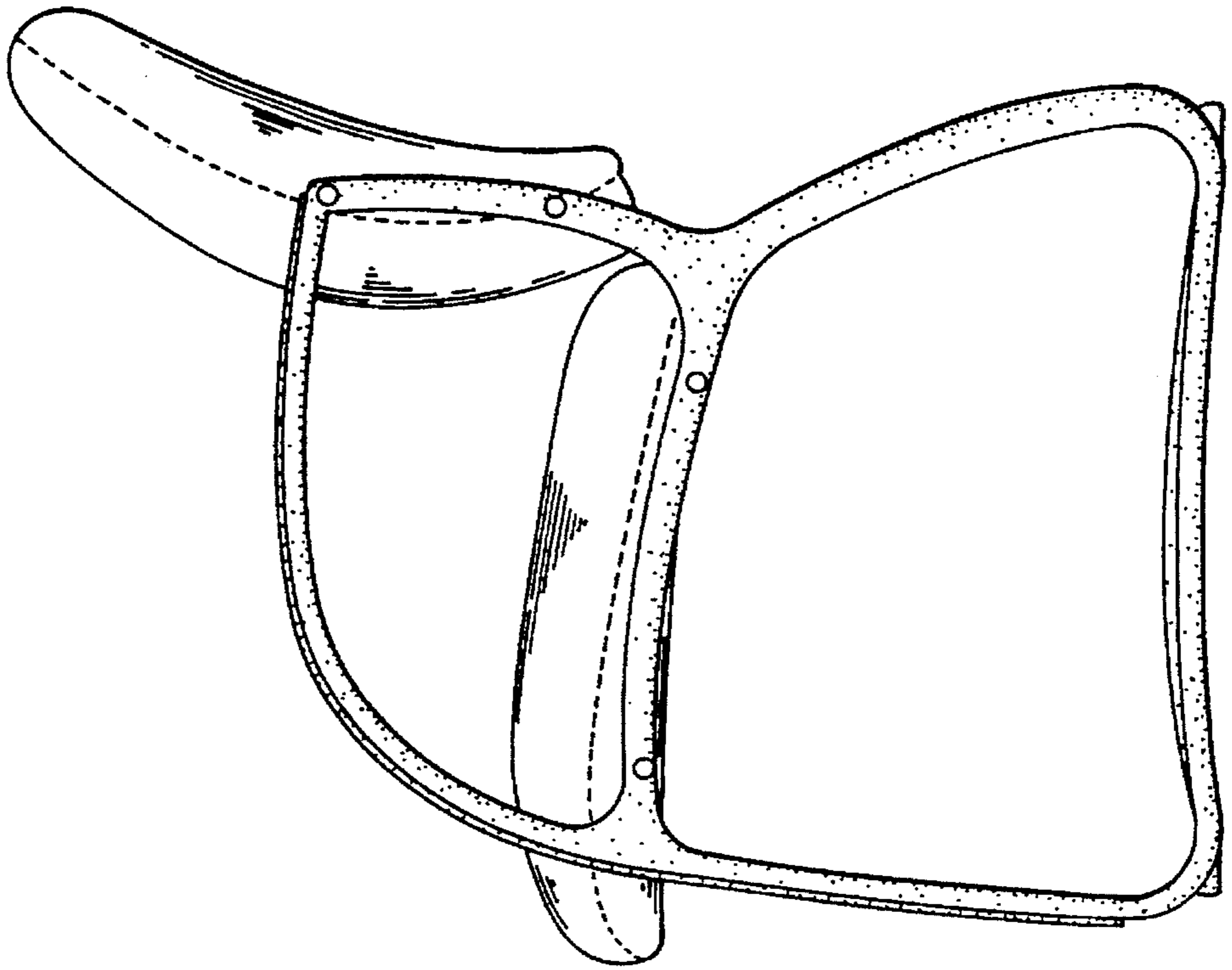
