FIG. 8 is a cross sectional view of FIG. 6;

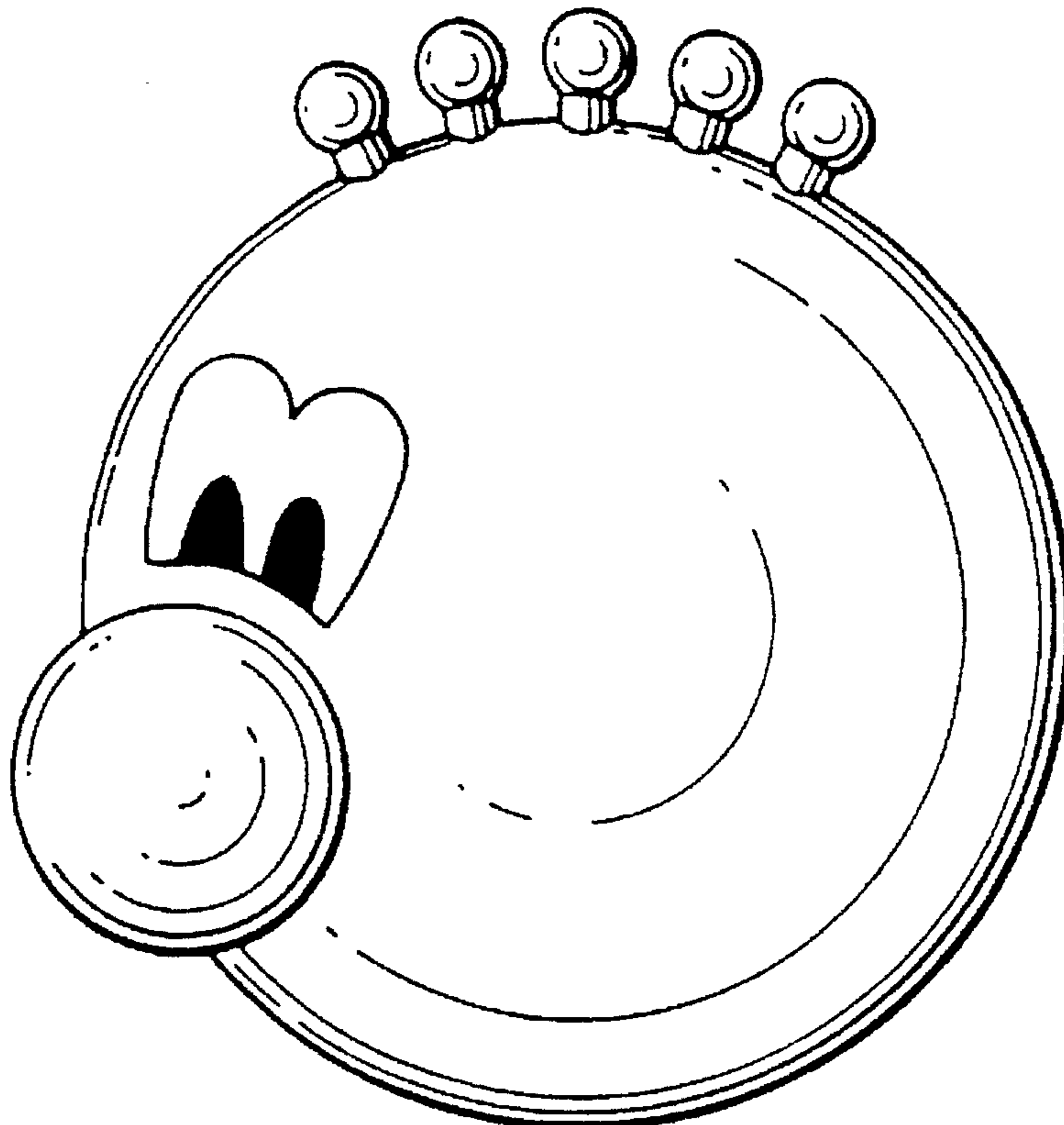
FIG. 9 is an enlarged front view of a third embodiment of the design in FIG. 1, the rear being unornamented;

FIG. 10 is an enlarged front view of a fourth embodiment of the design in FIG. 1, the rear being unornamented;

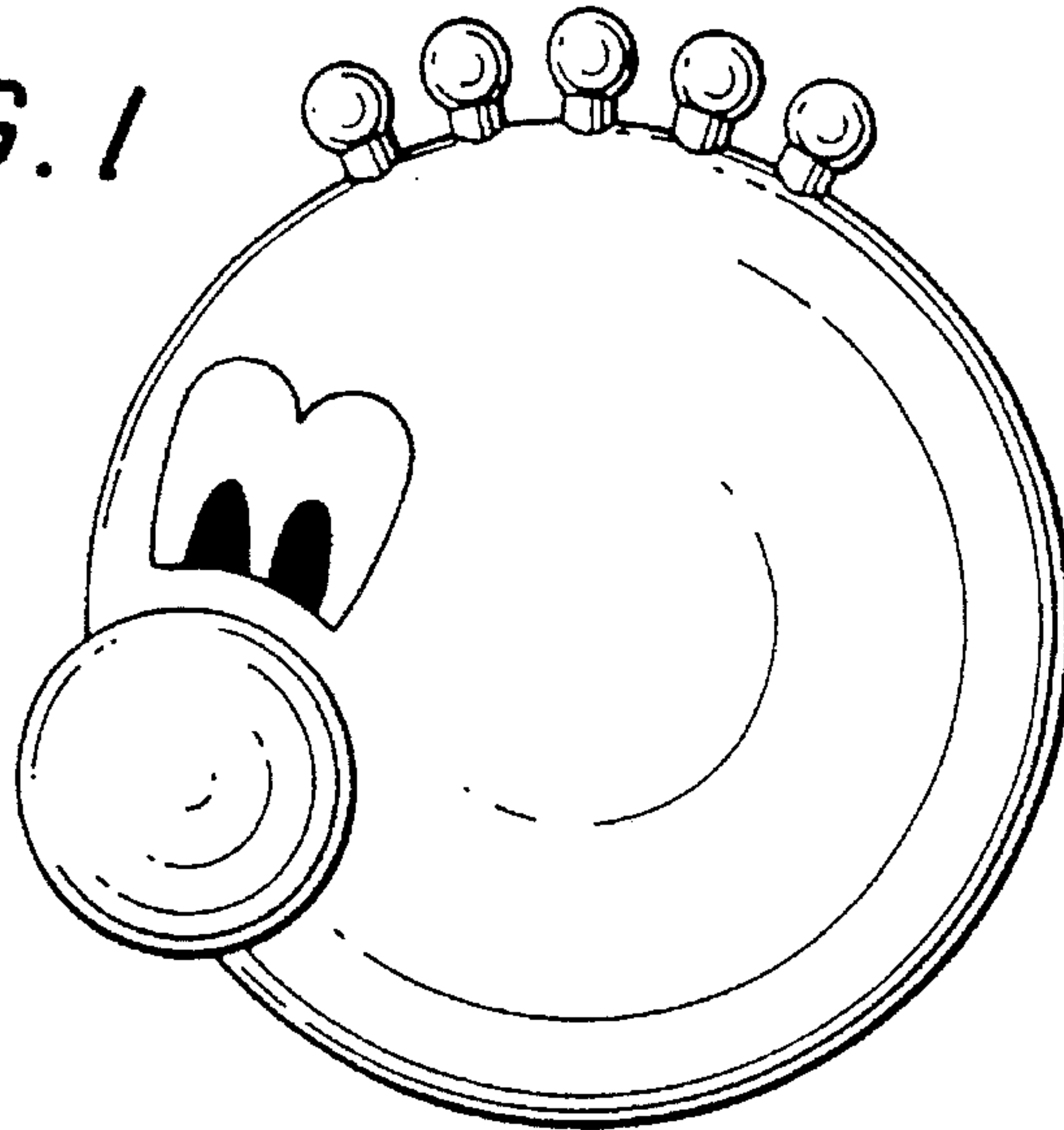
FIG. 11 is an enlarged front view of a fifth embodiment of the design in FIG. 1, the rear being unornamented; and,

FIG. 12 is an enlarged front view of a sixth embodiment of the design in FIG. 1, the rear being unornamented.

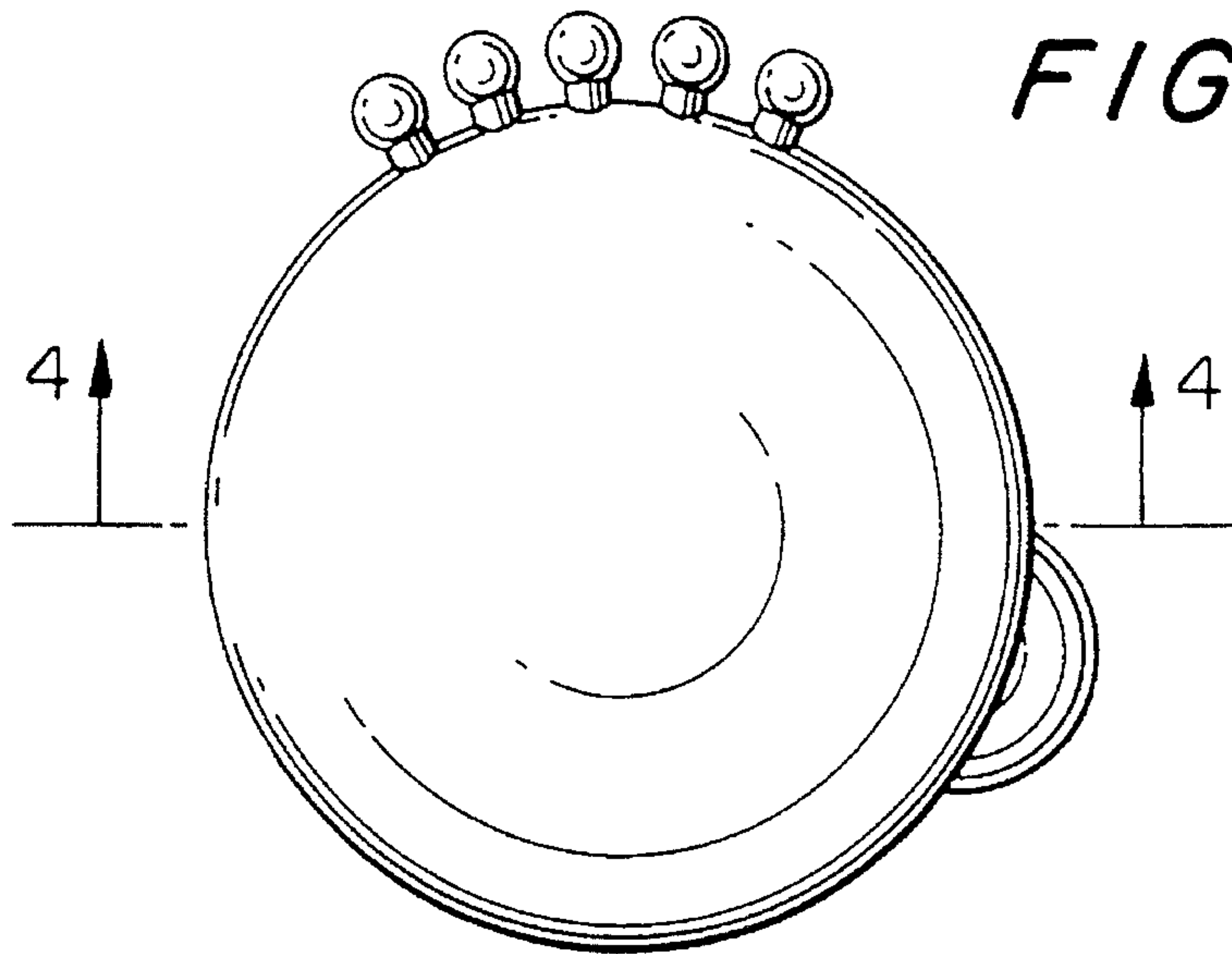

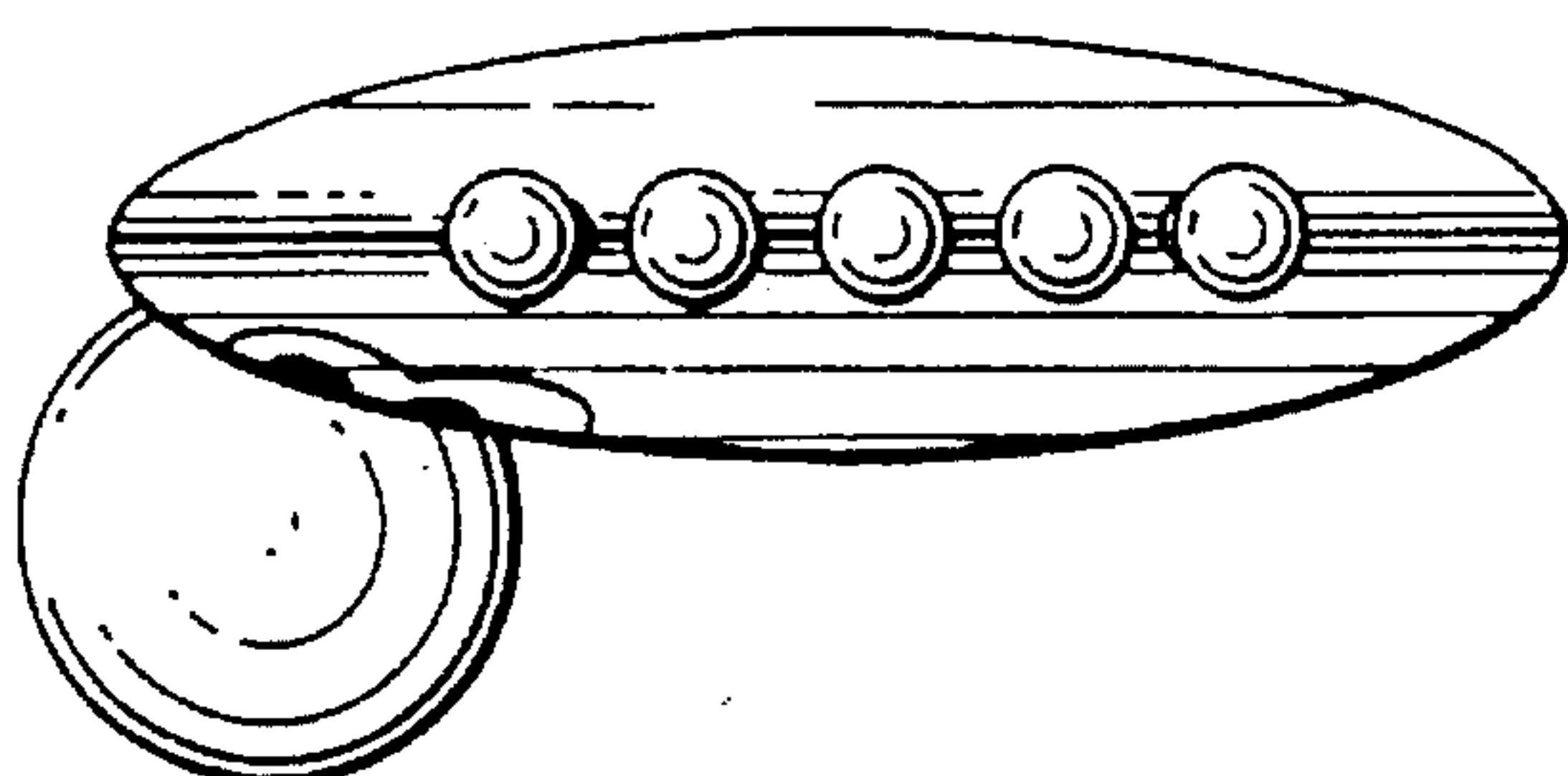

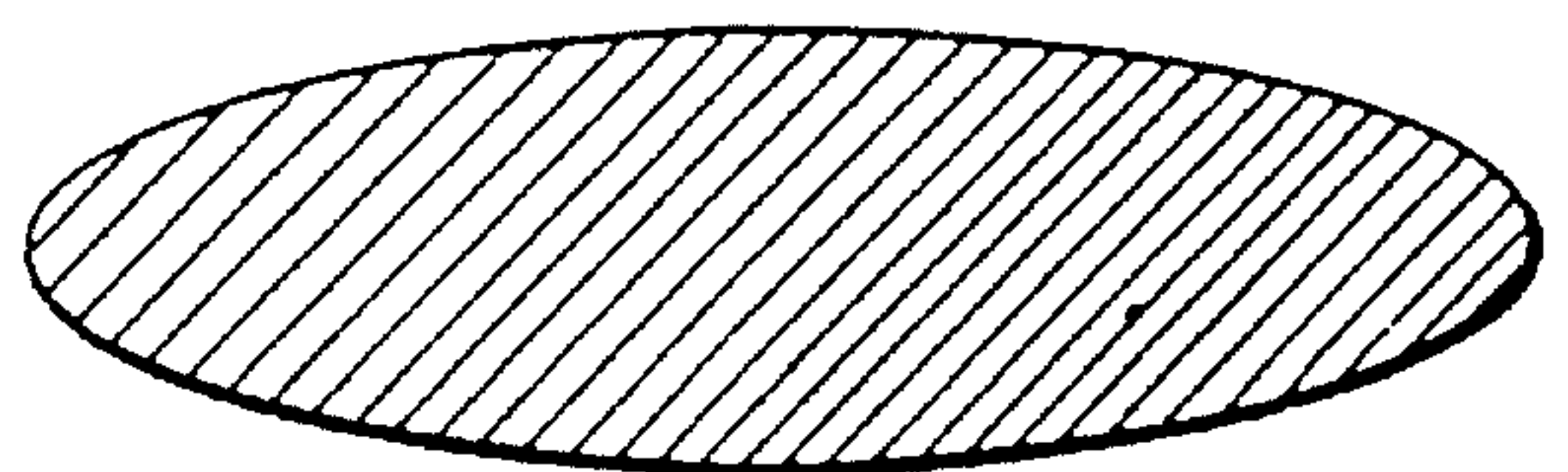

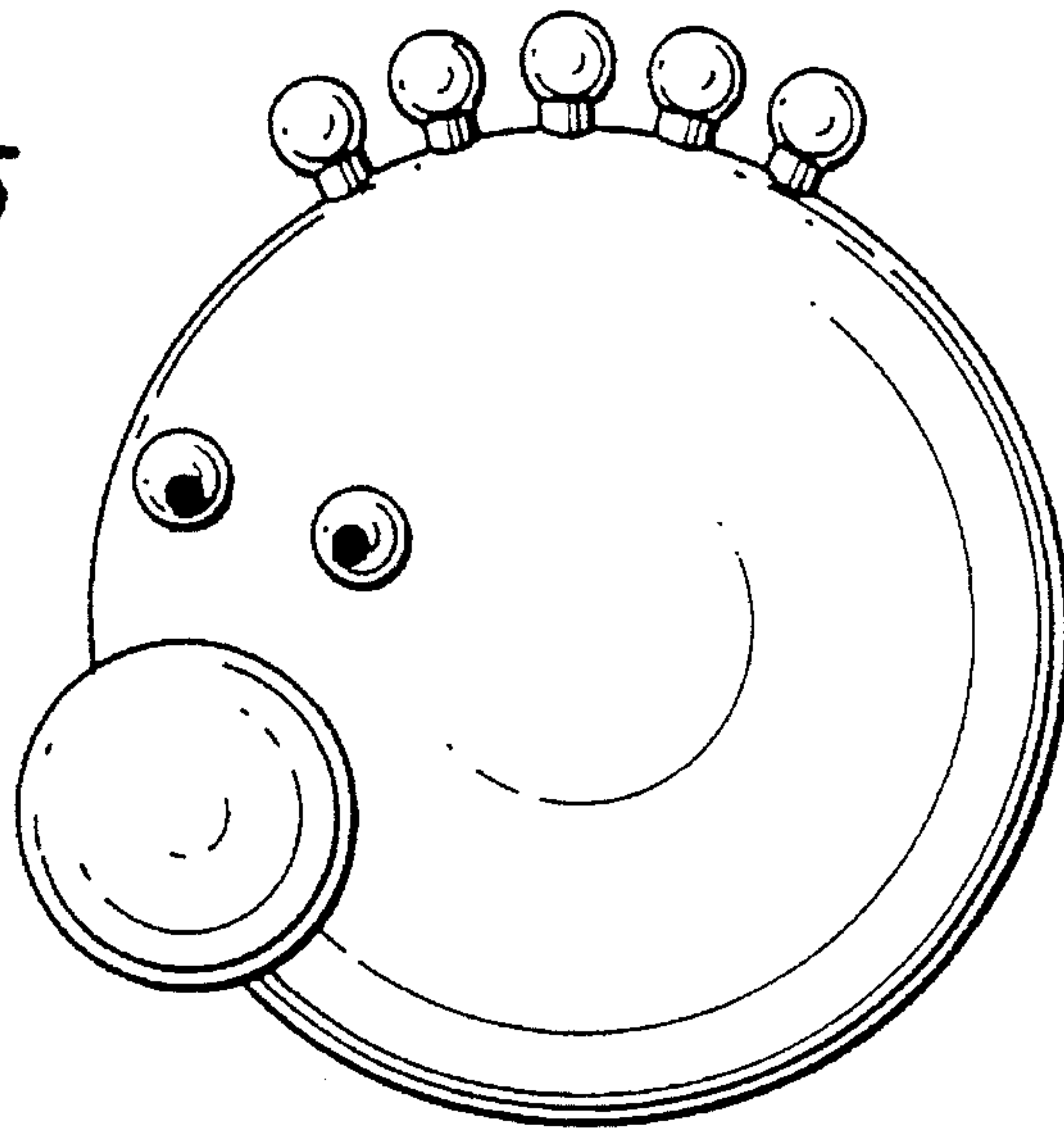

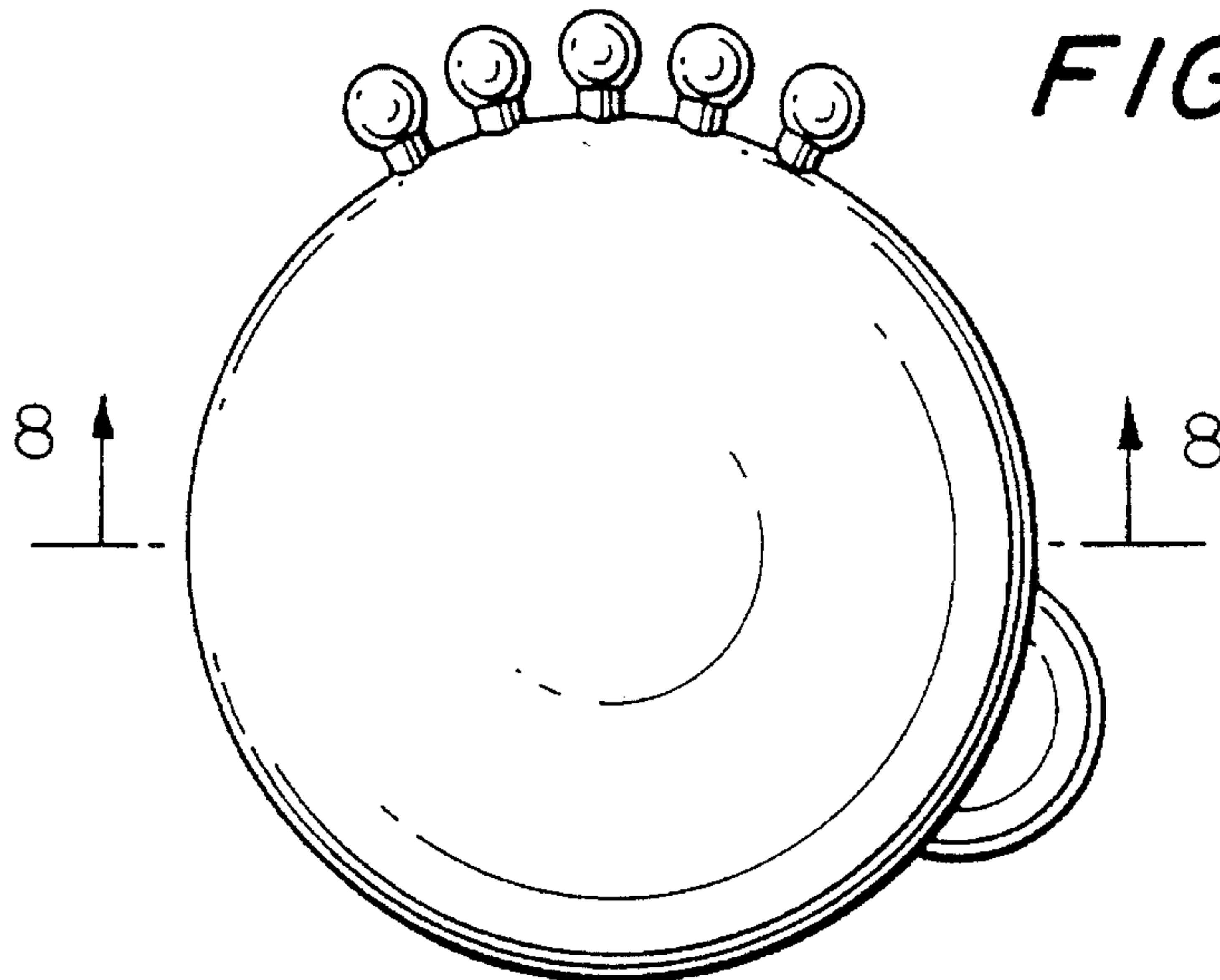

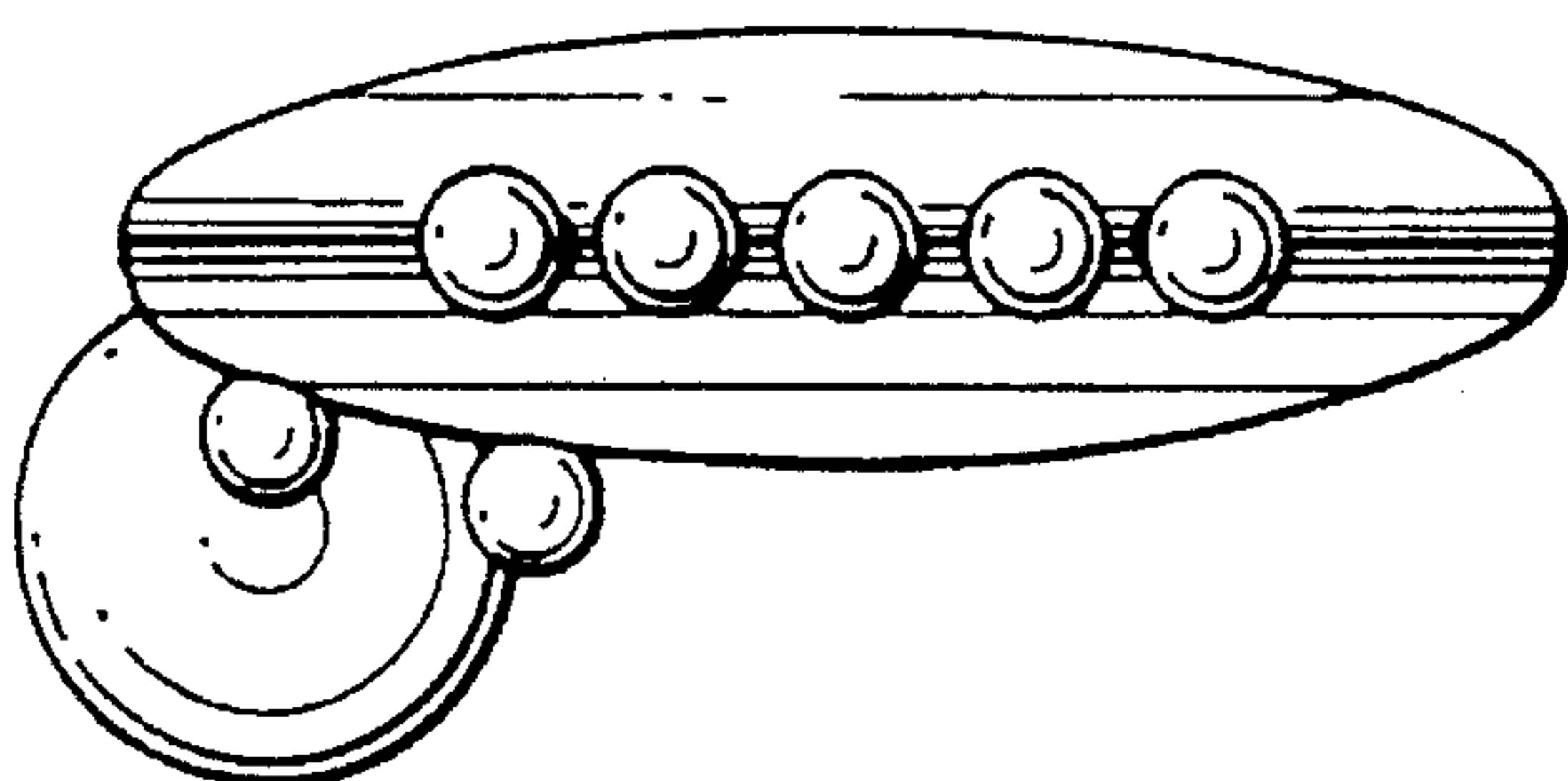
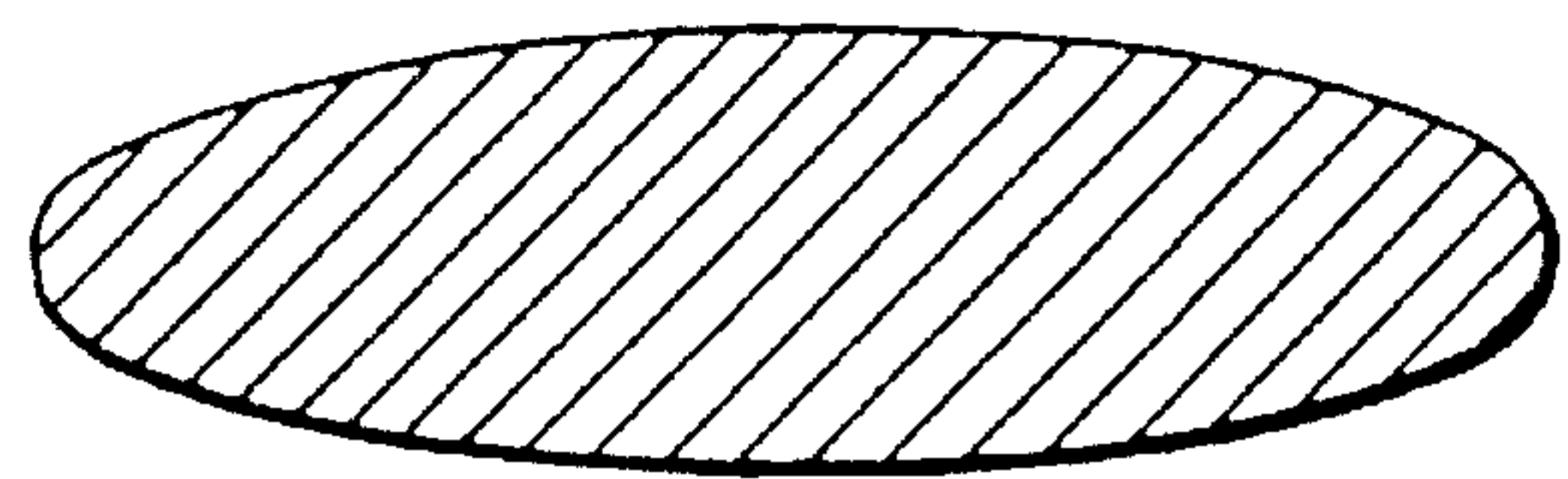
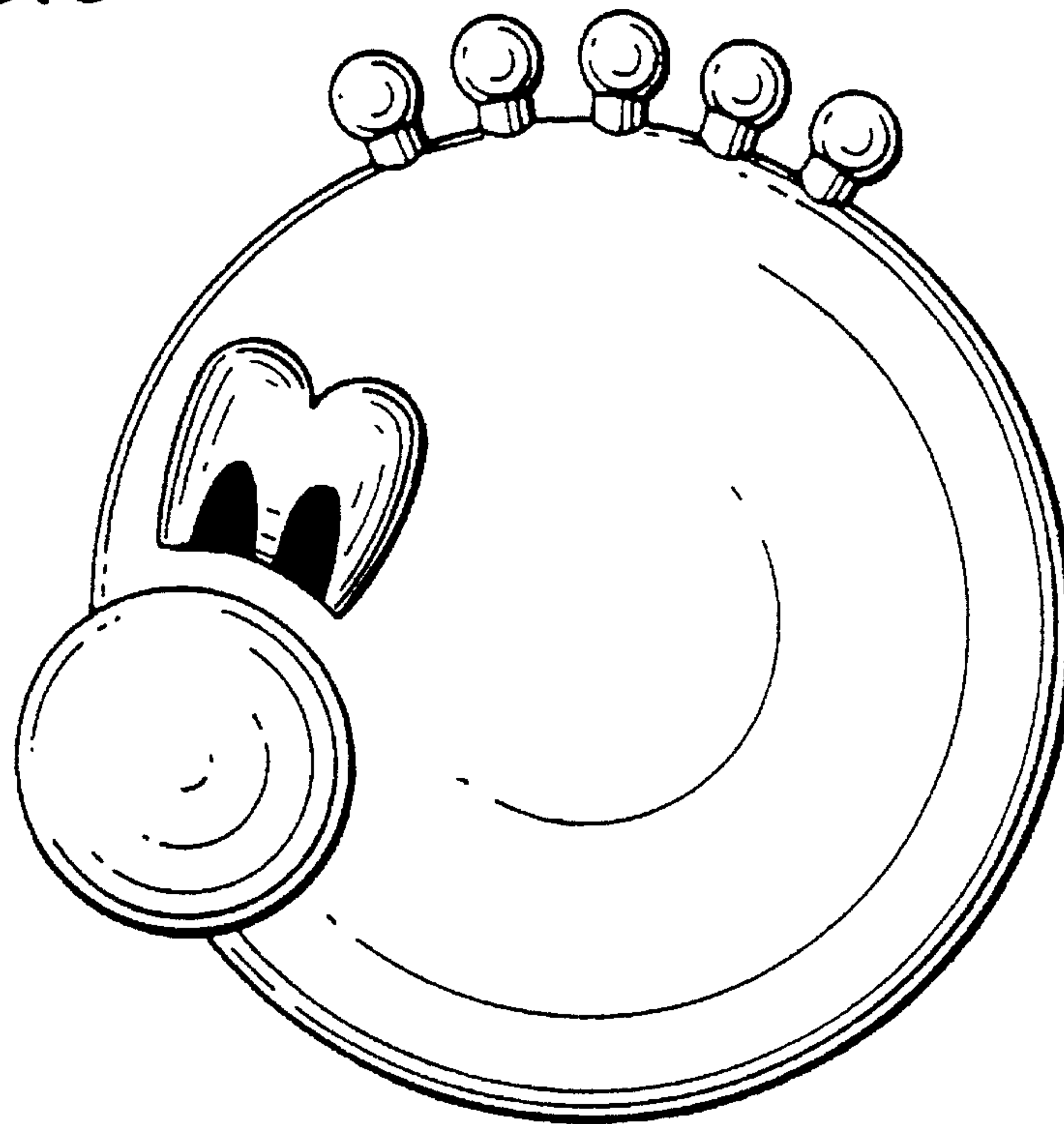


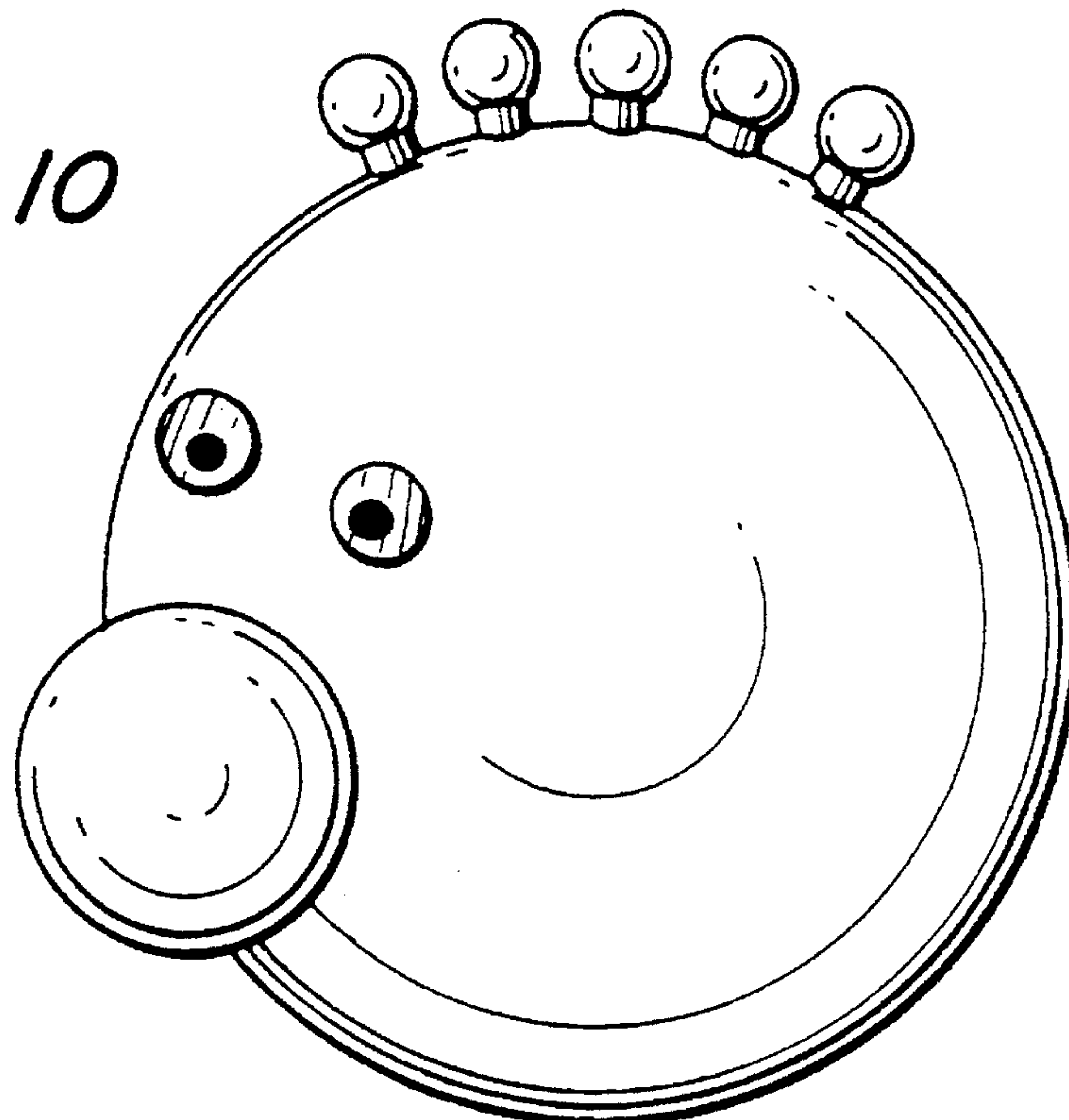

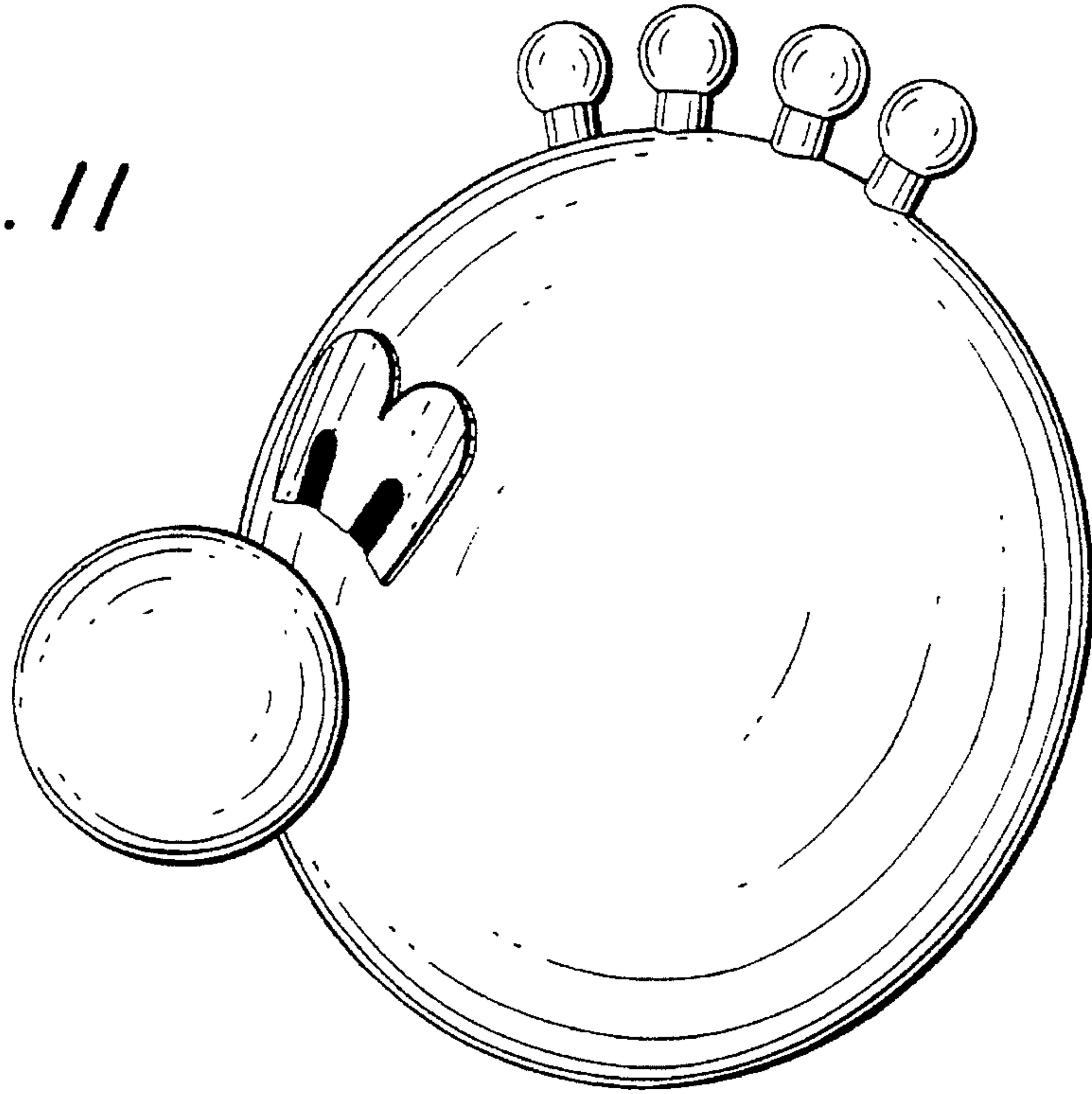
