FIG. 5 is a rear plan view thereof; and,

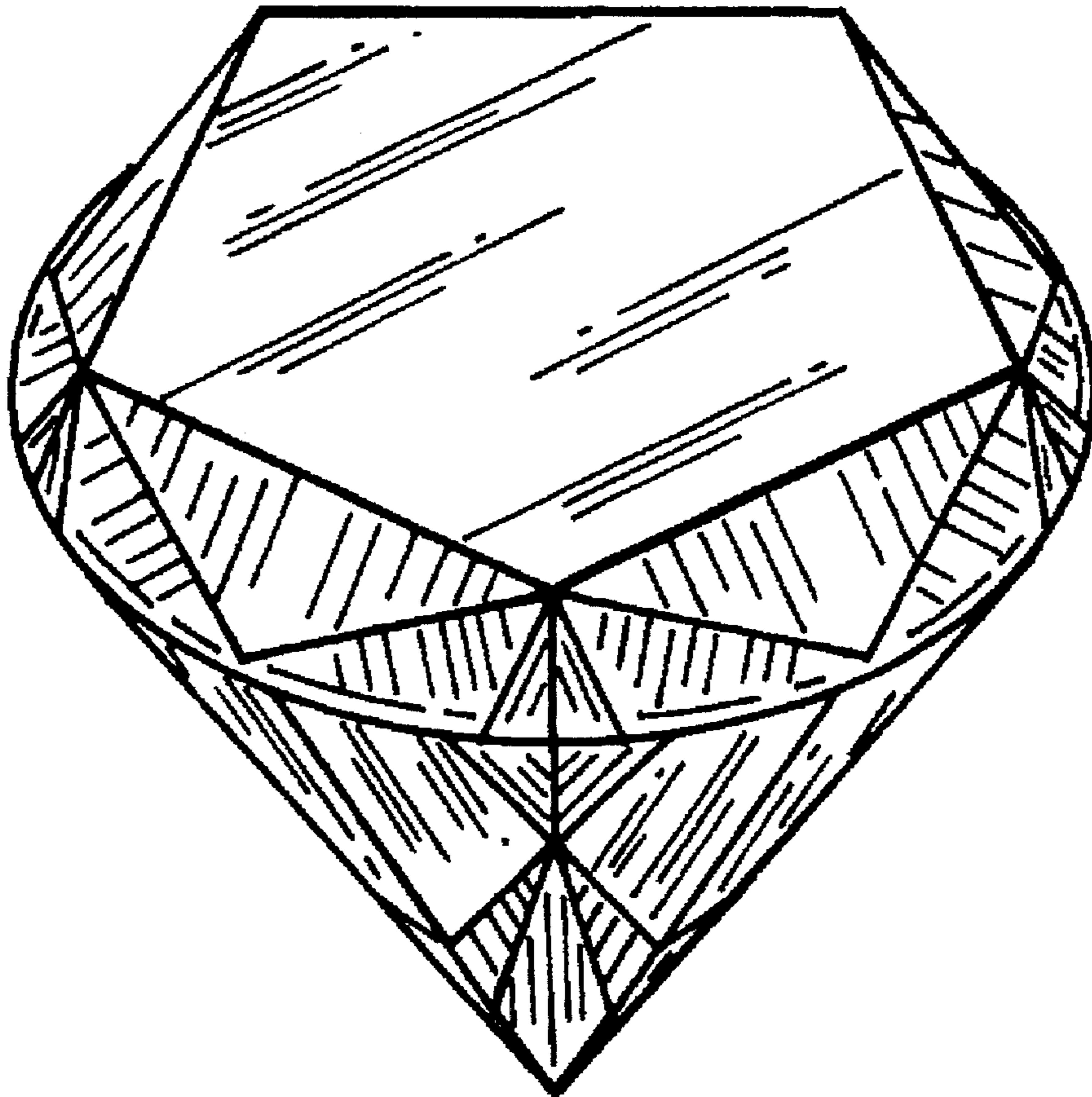
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

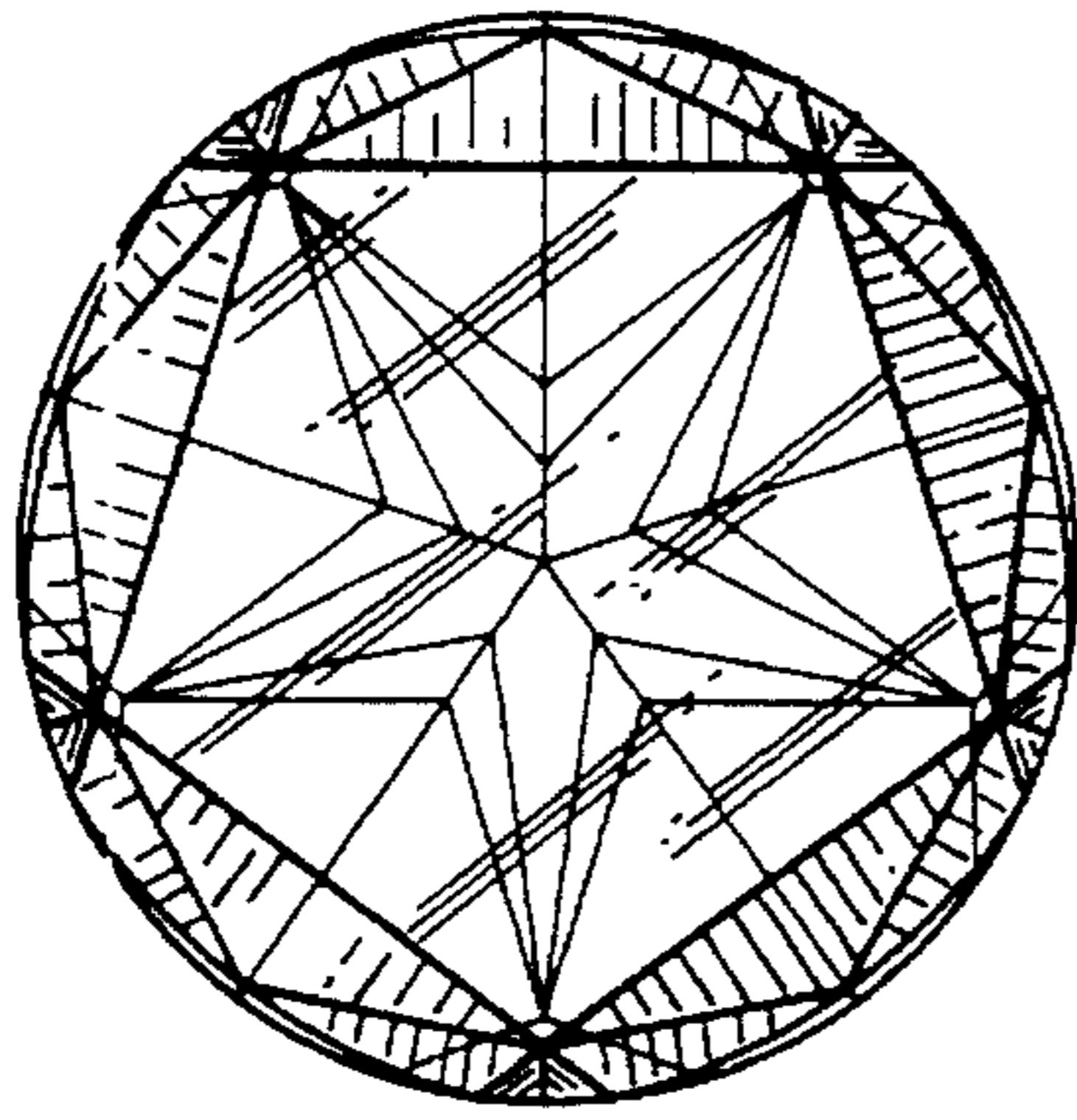

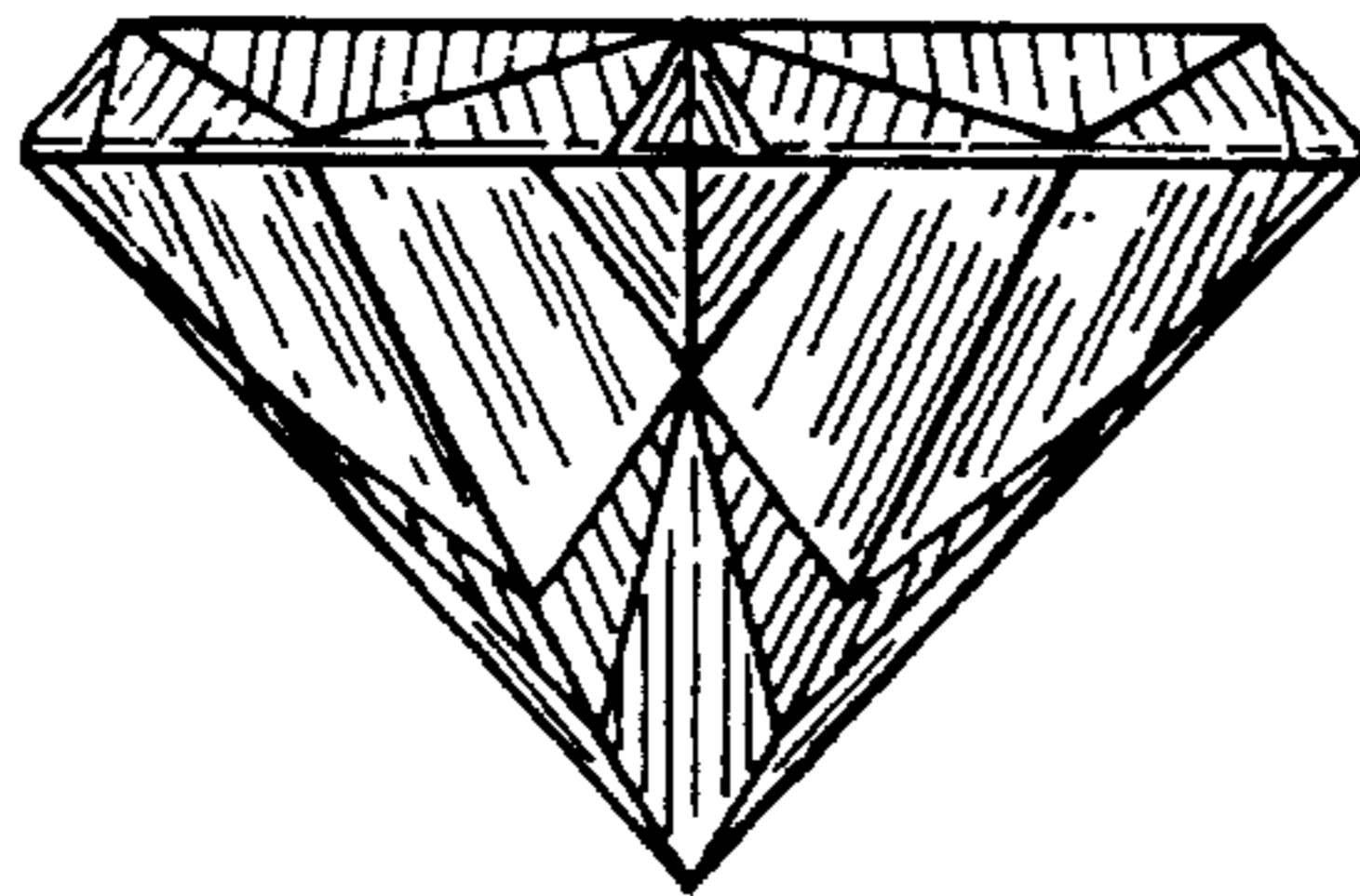

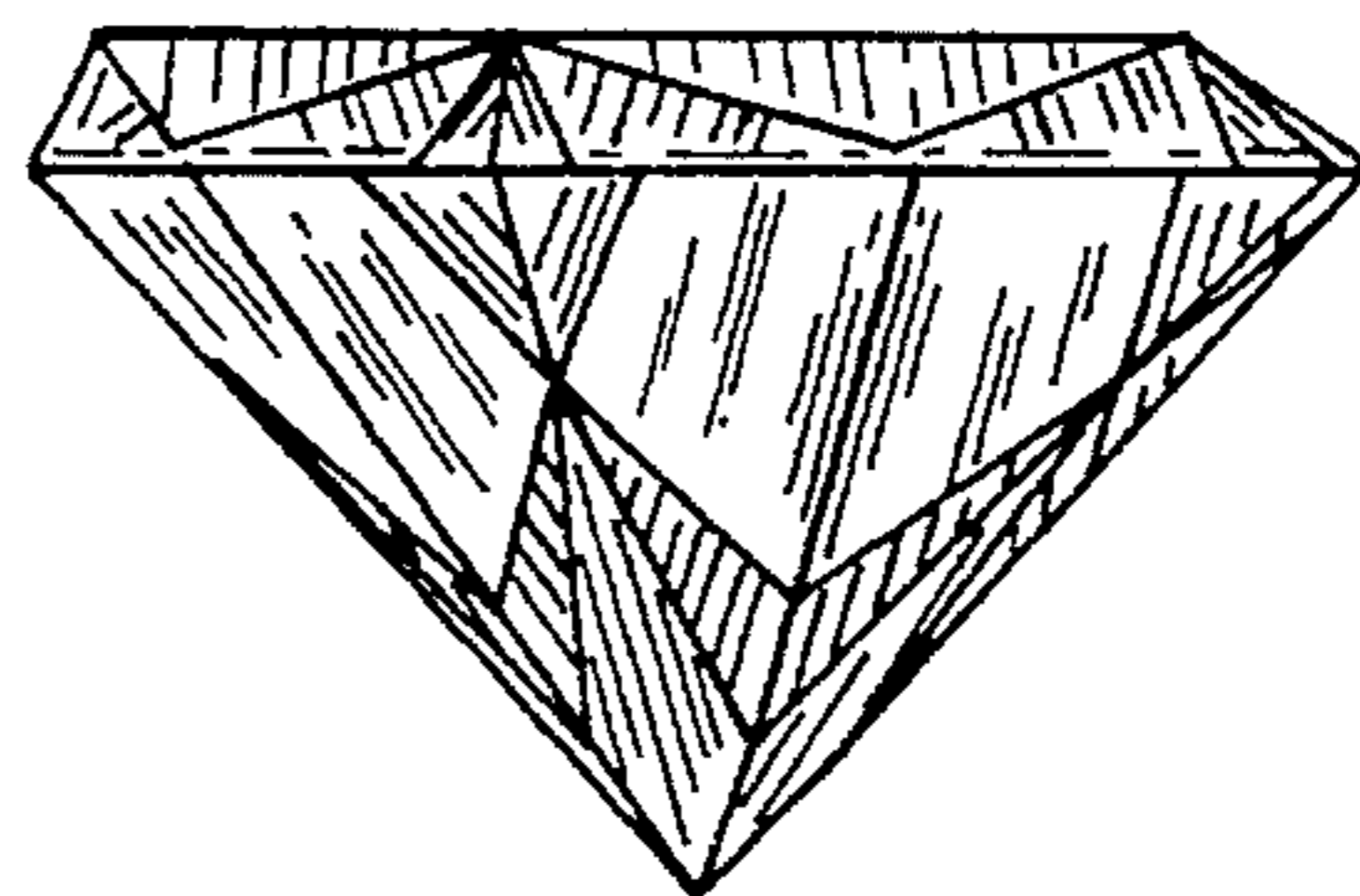

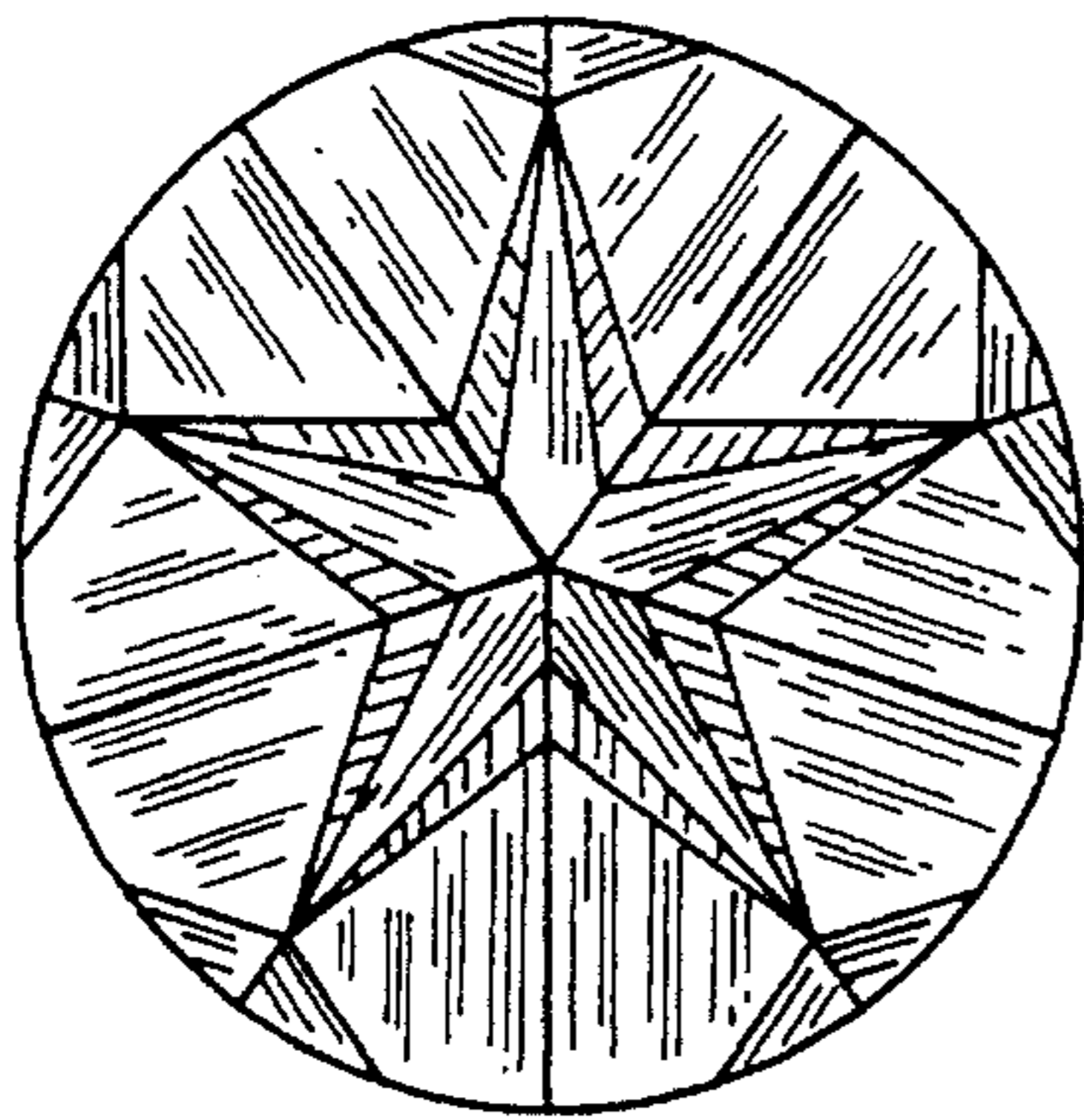

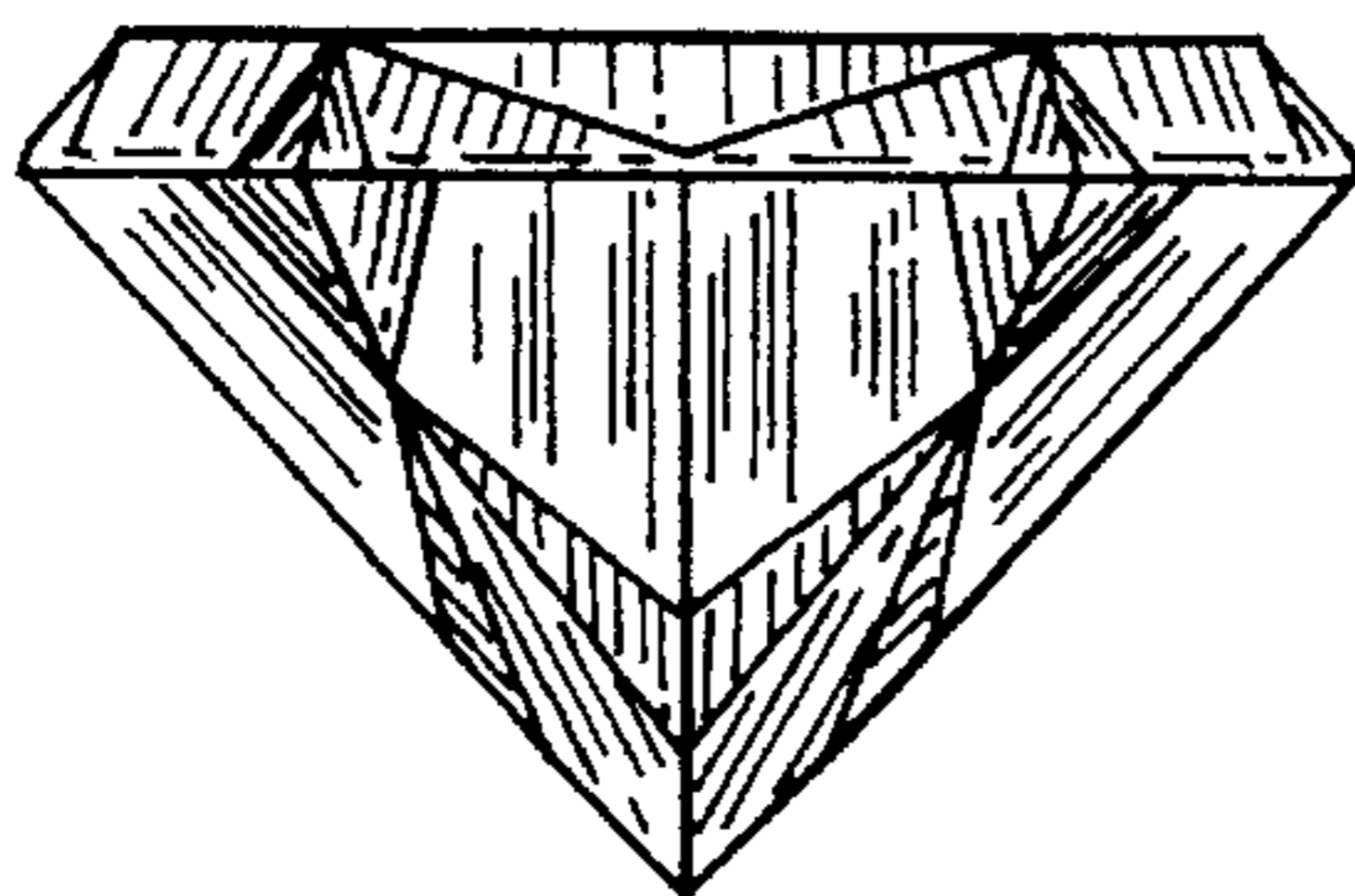

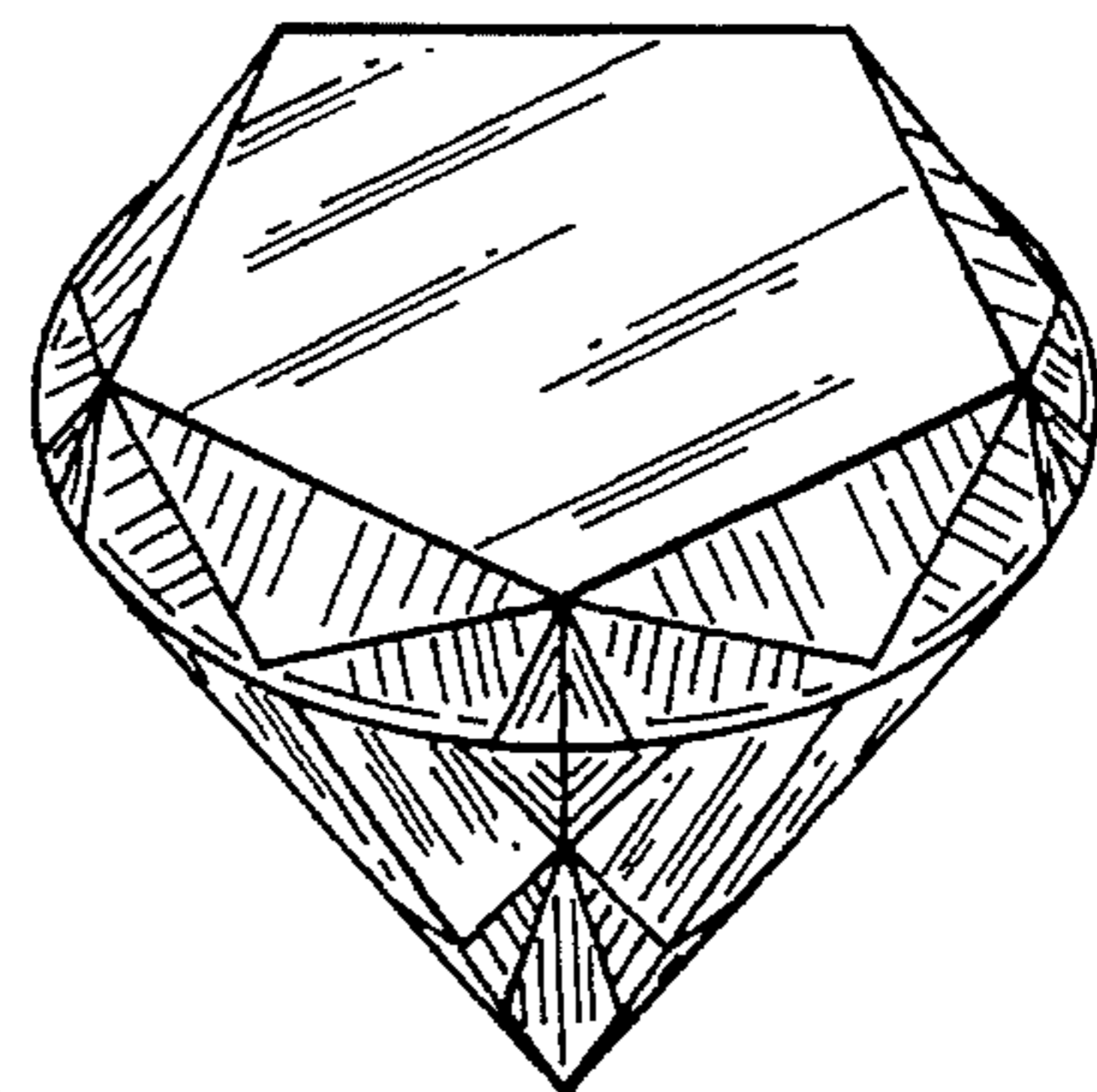
