FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof of the left component;

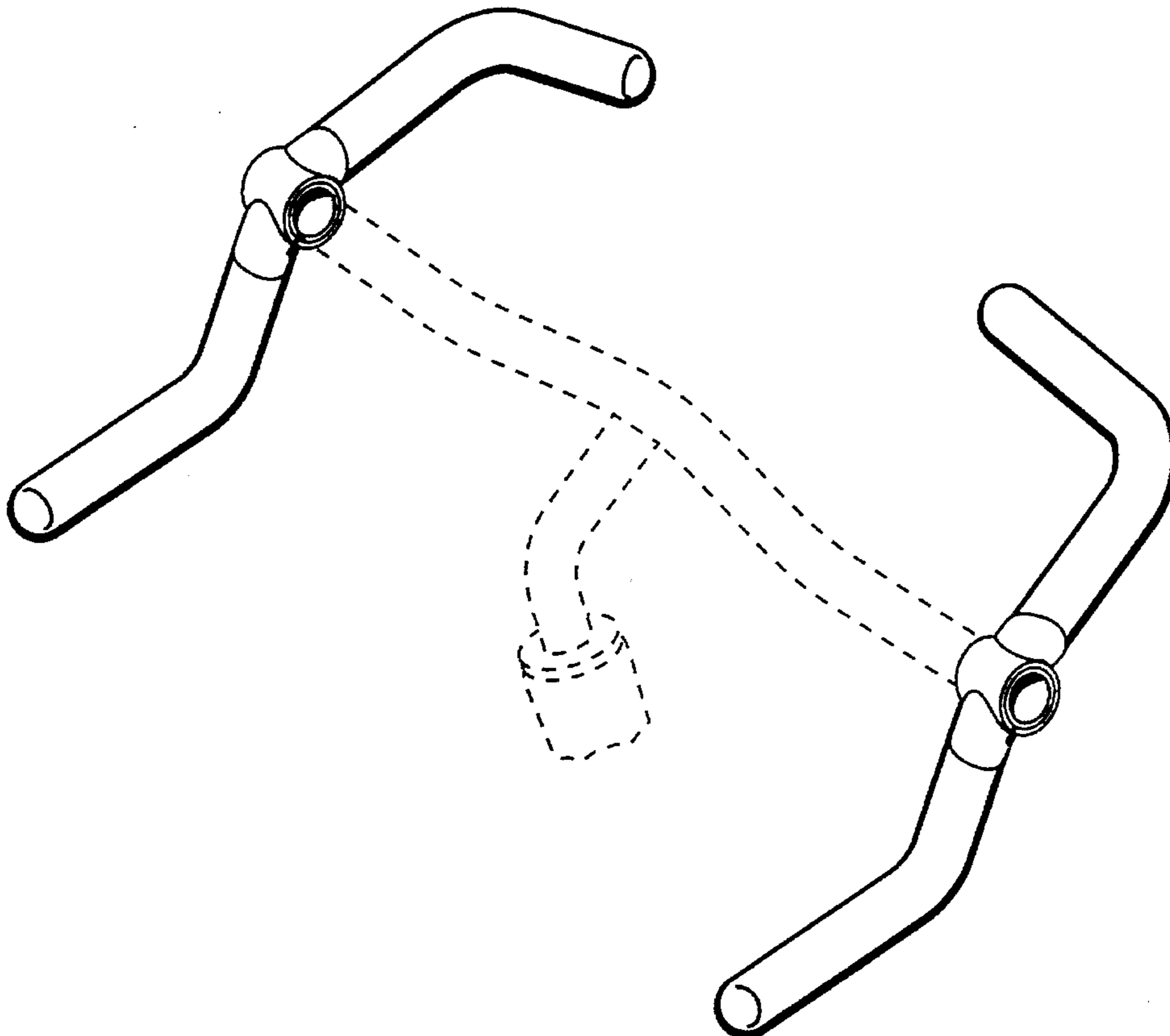
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

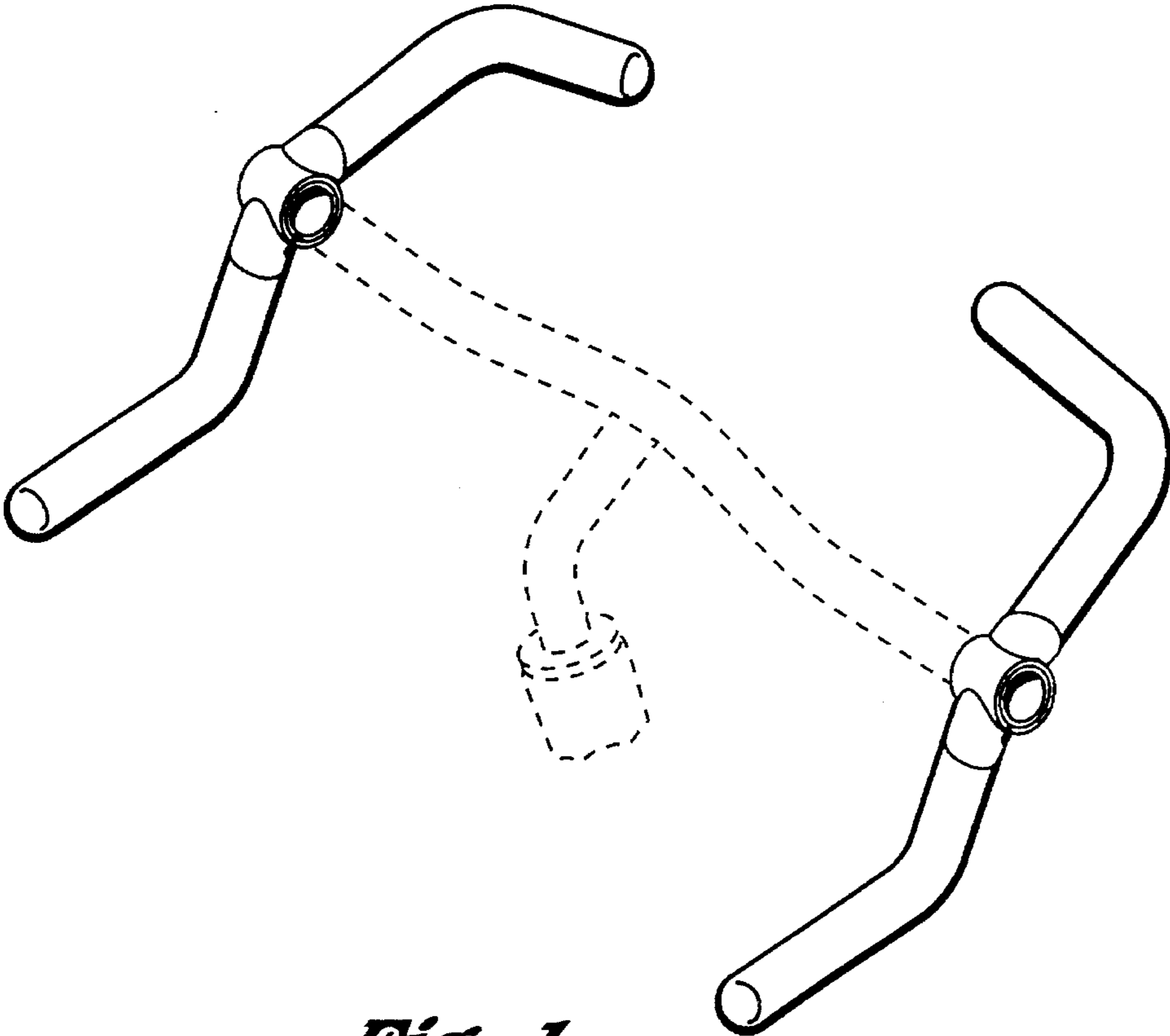

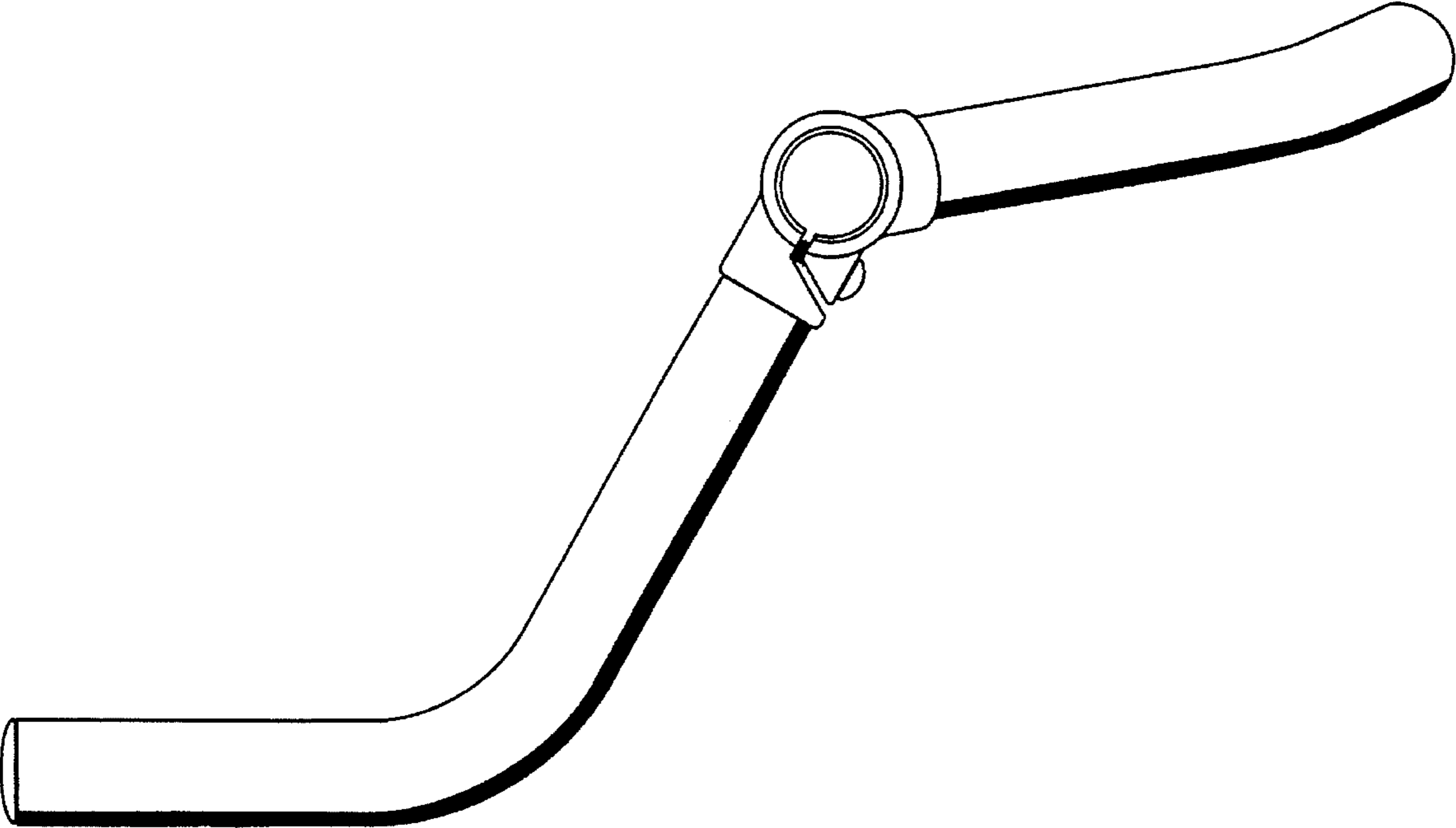

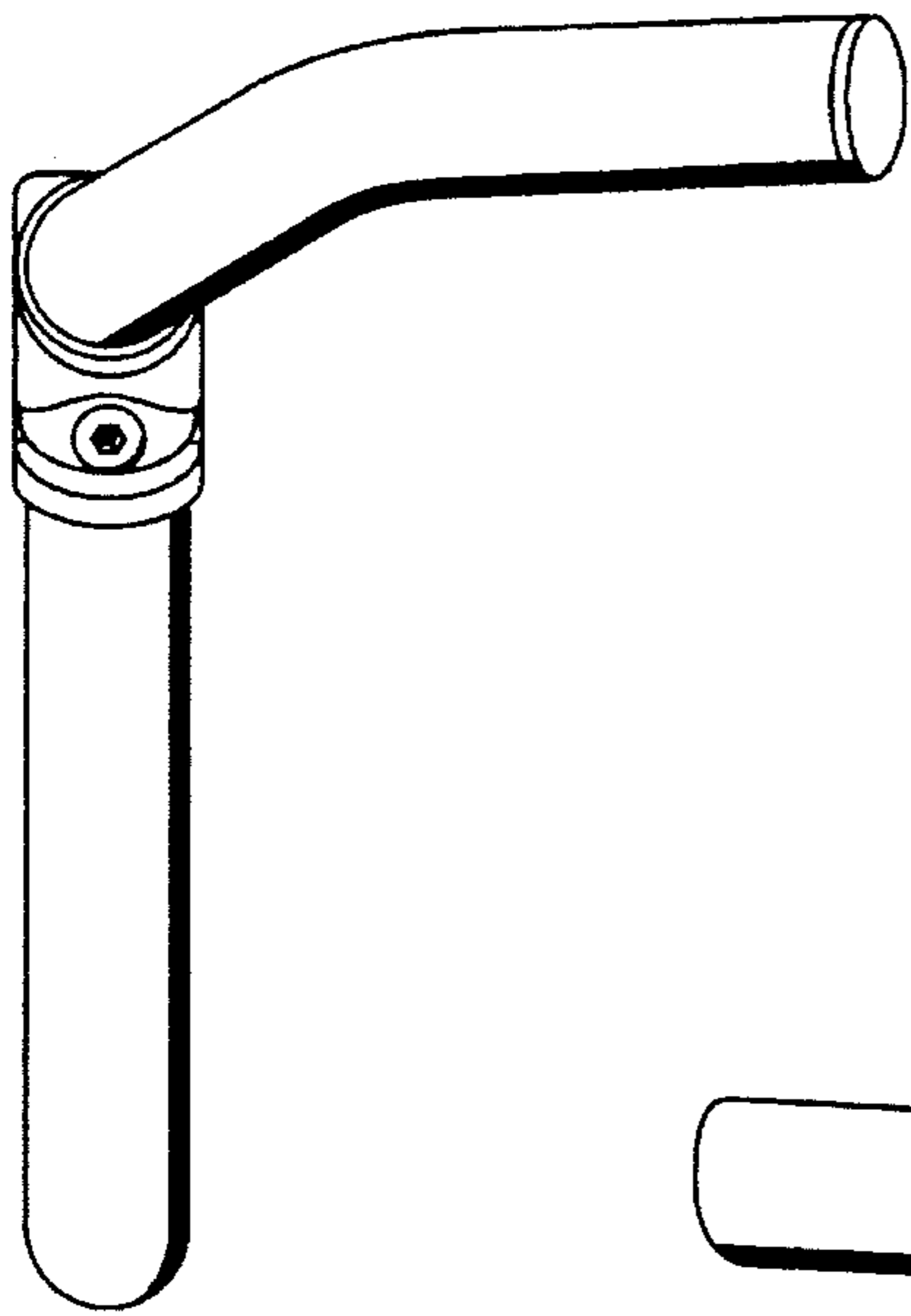

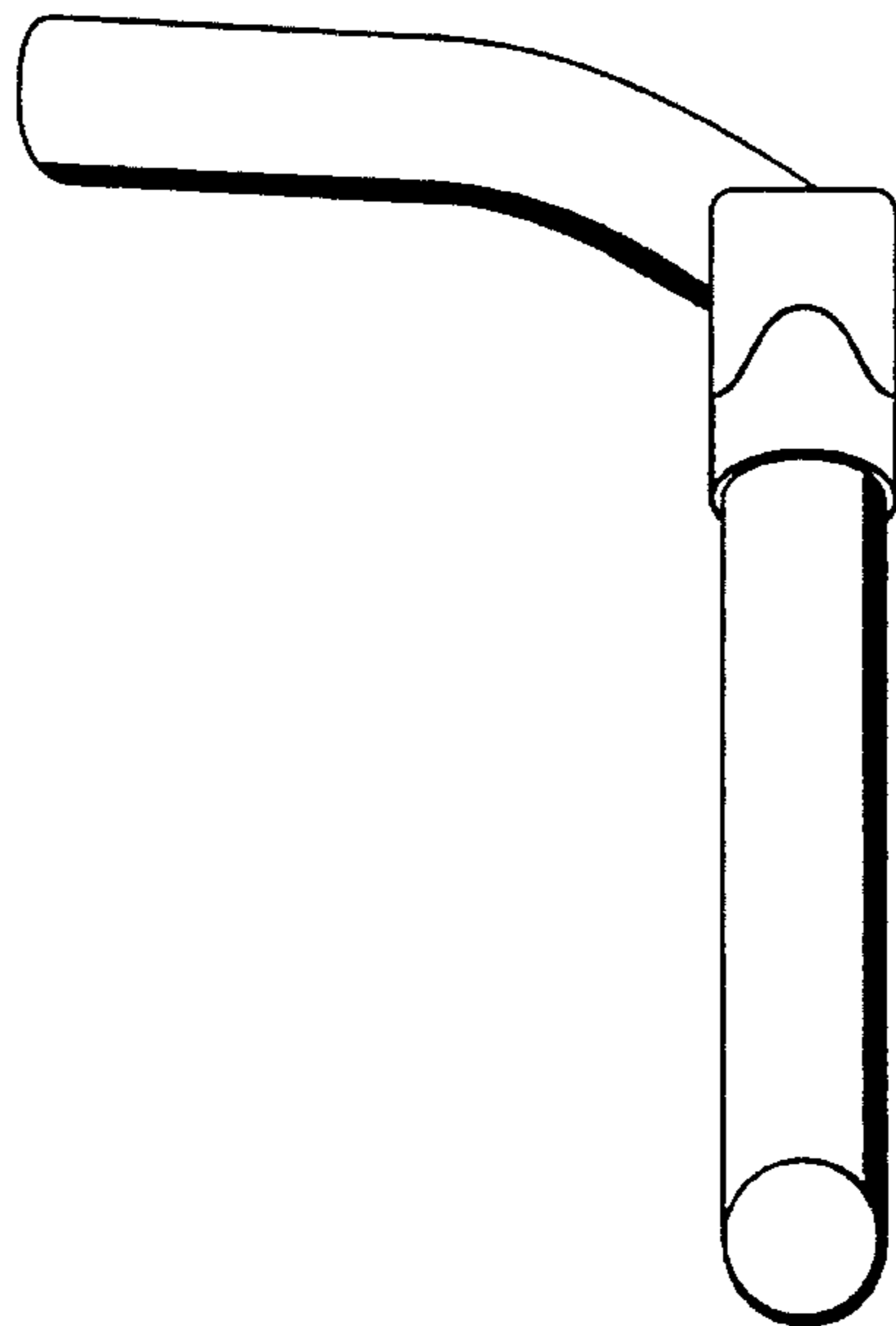

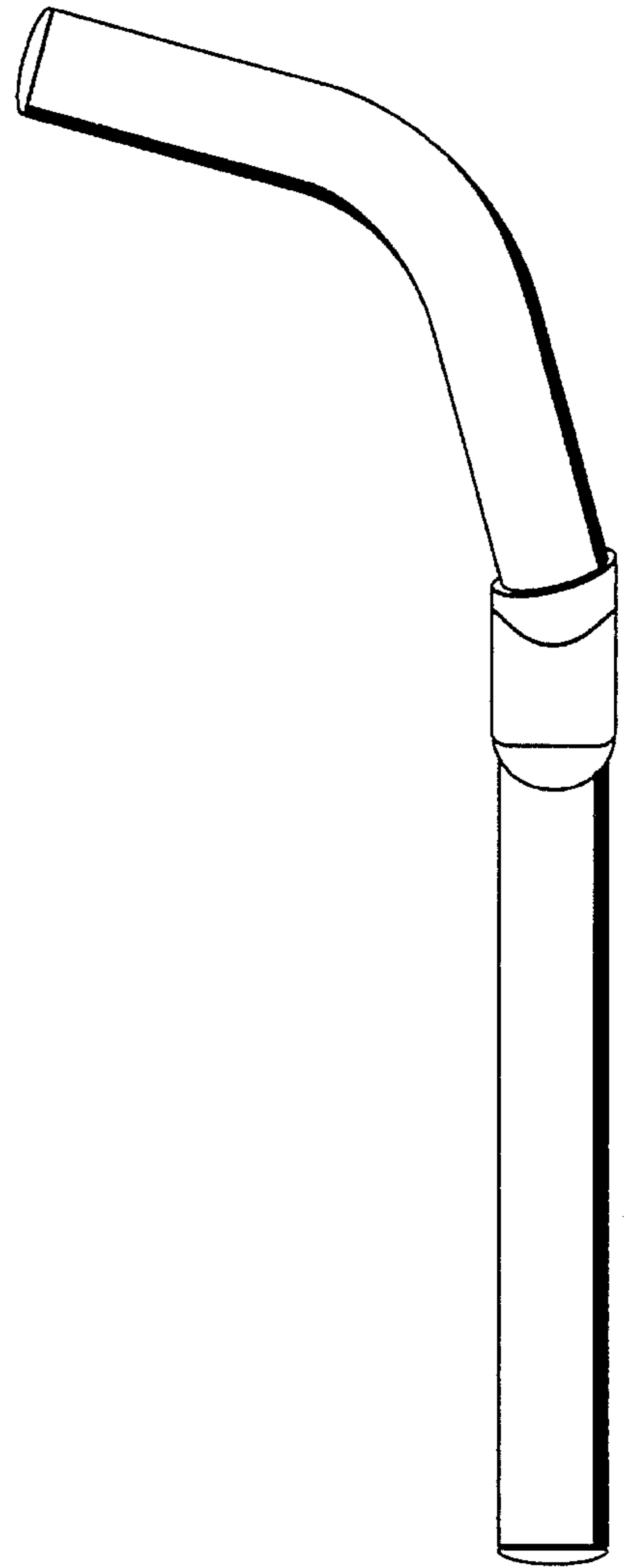

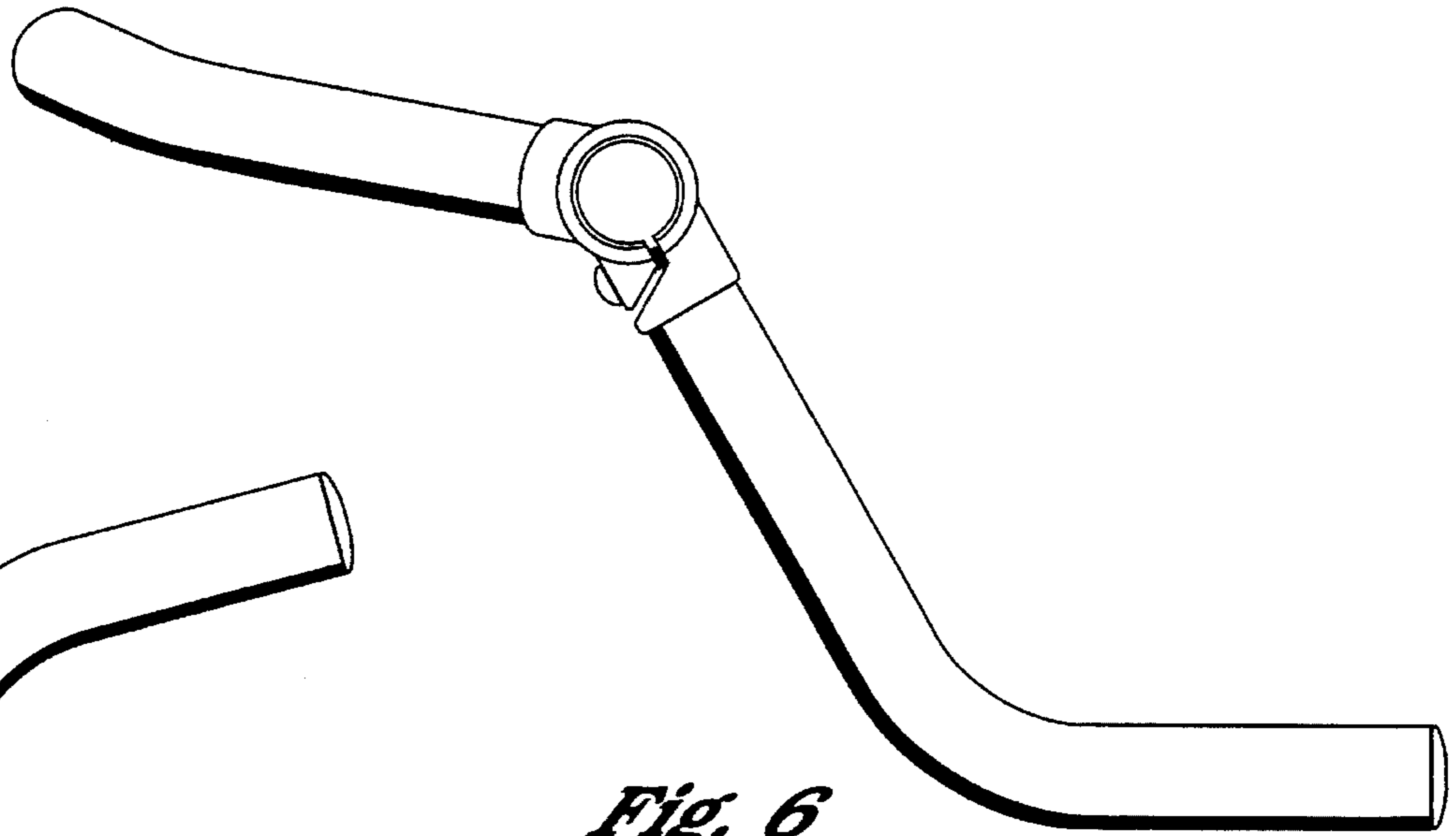

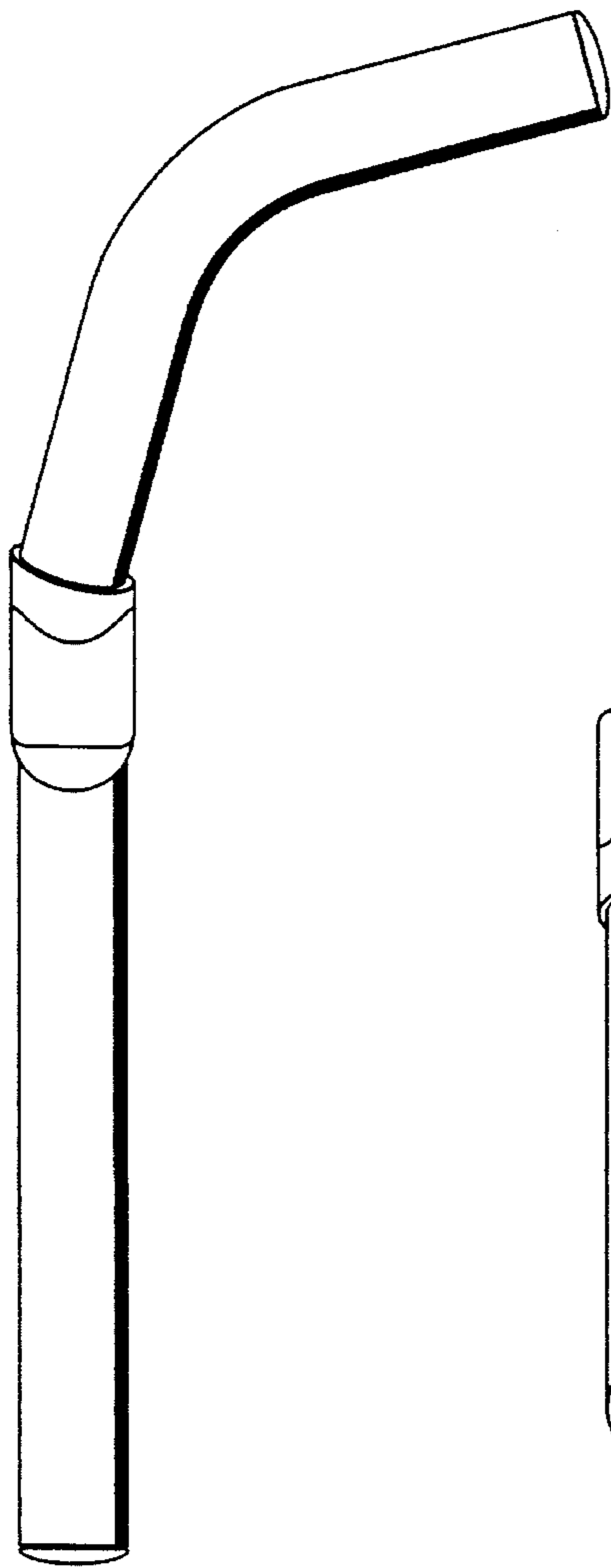

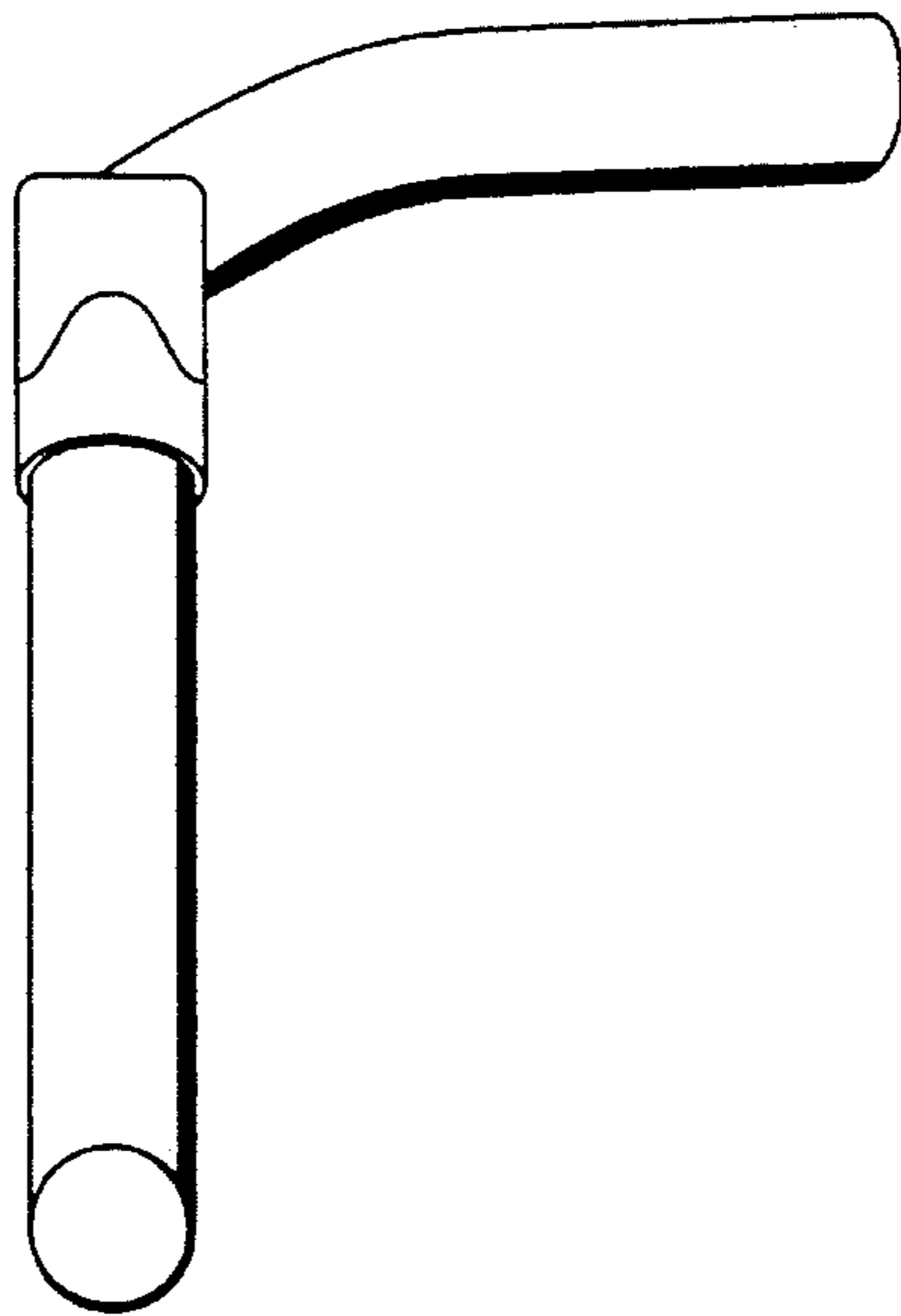

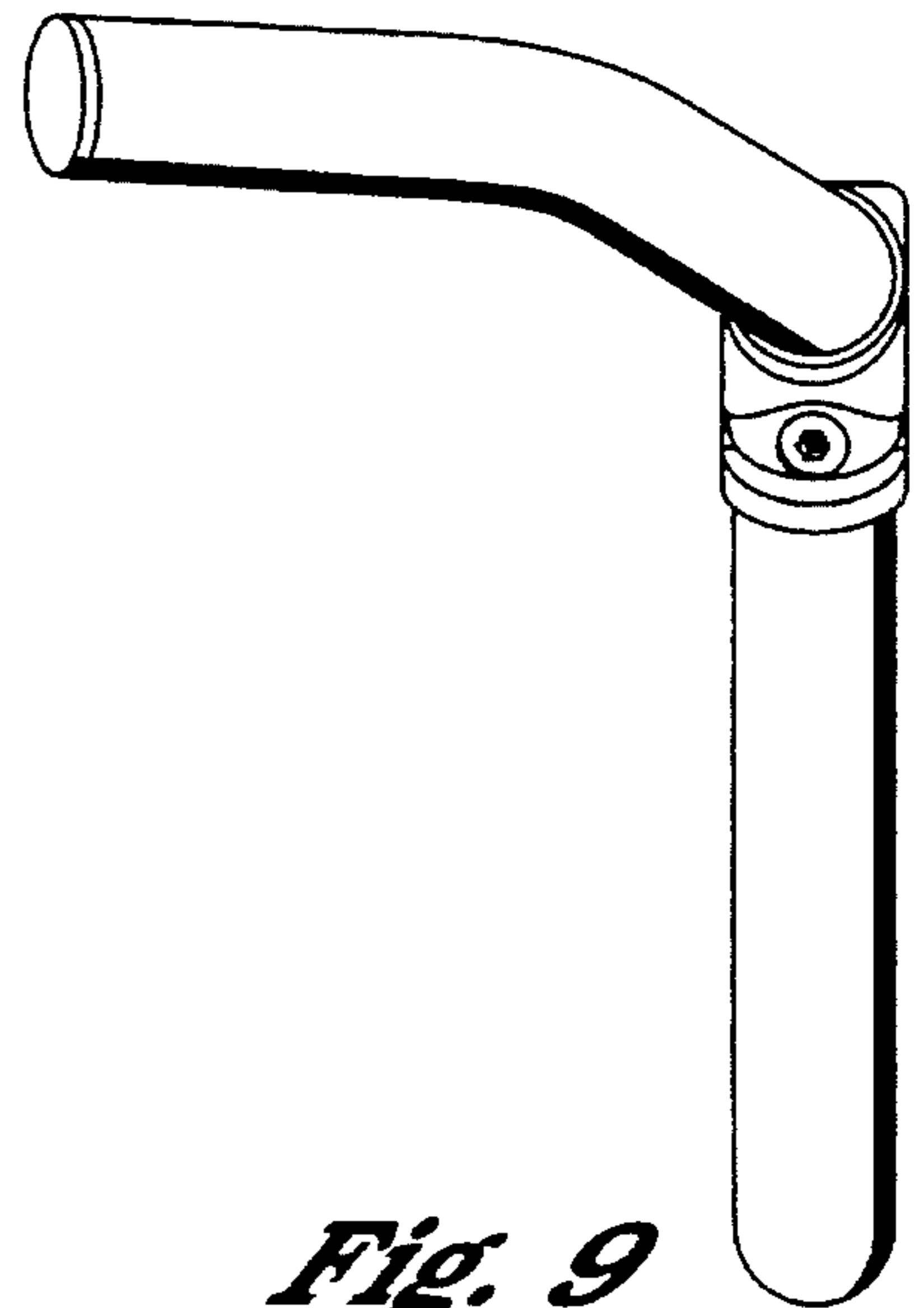
