The ornamental design for a combined cervical and microdiscectomy retractor blade with detachable handle, as shown and described.

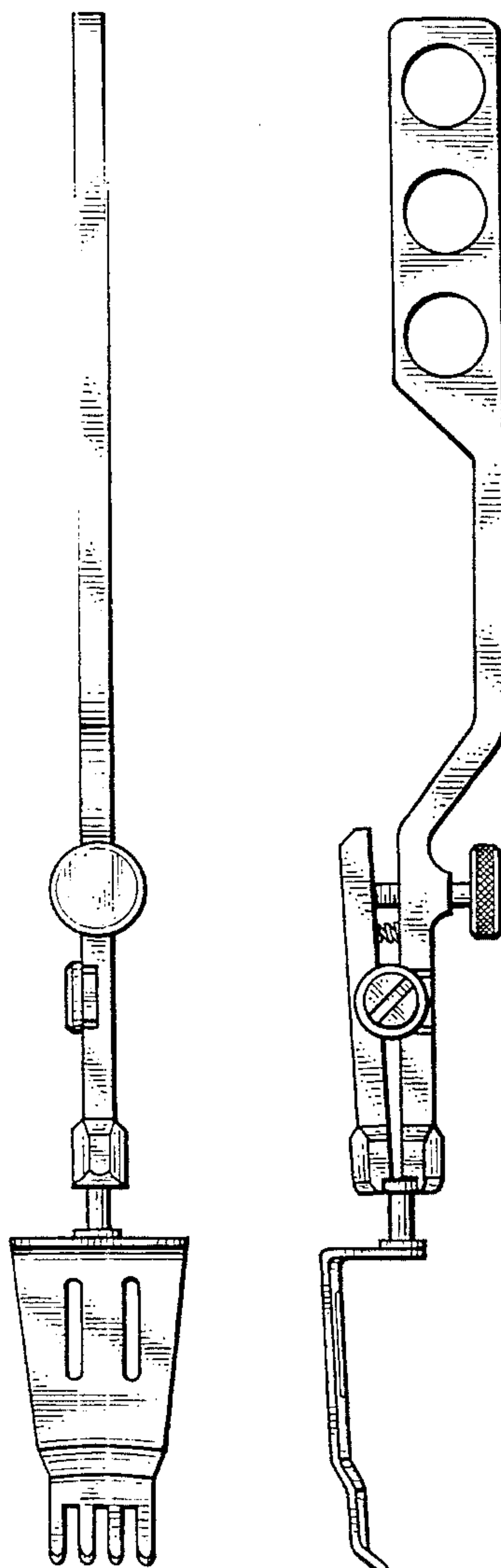

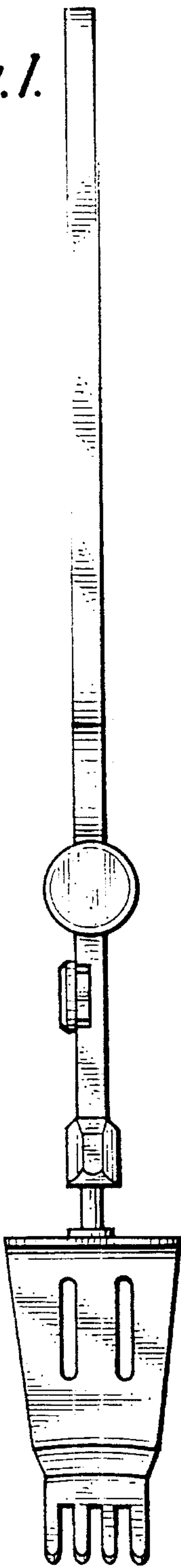

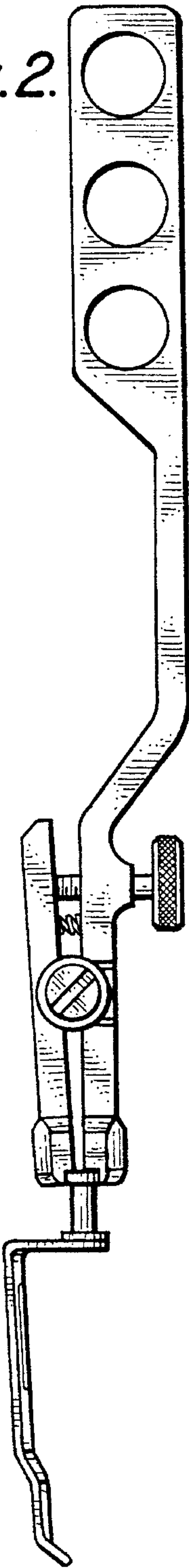

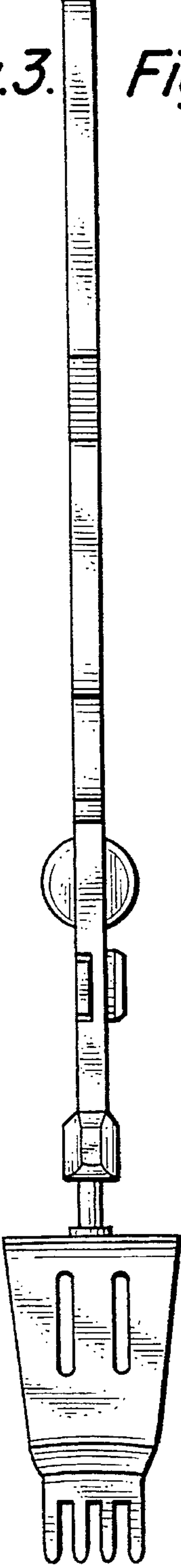

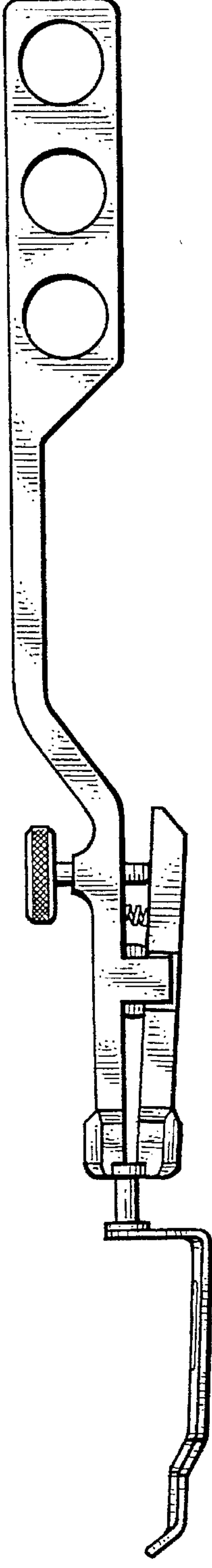

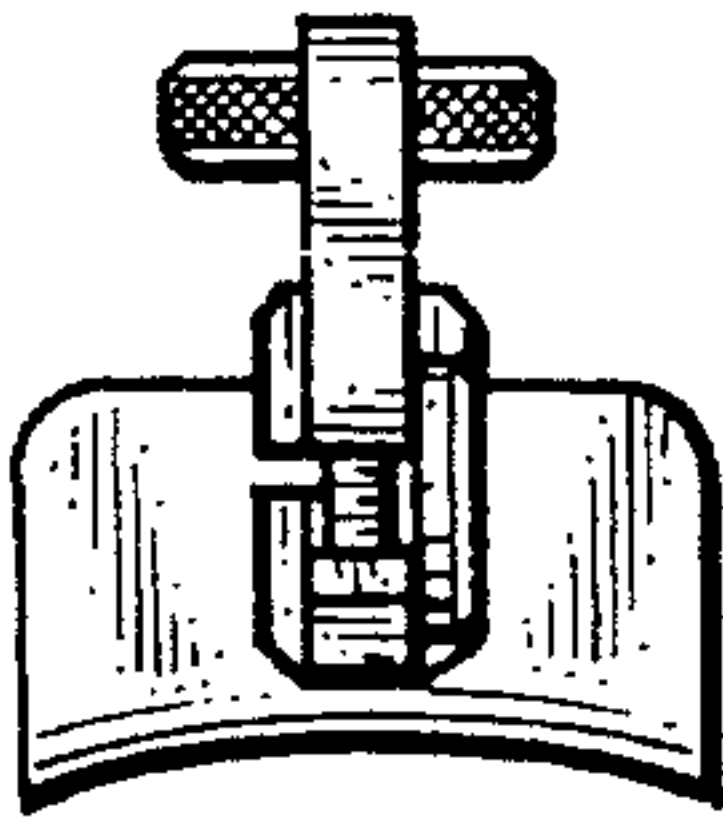
