DESCRIPTION

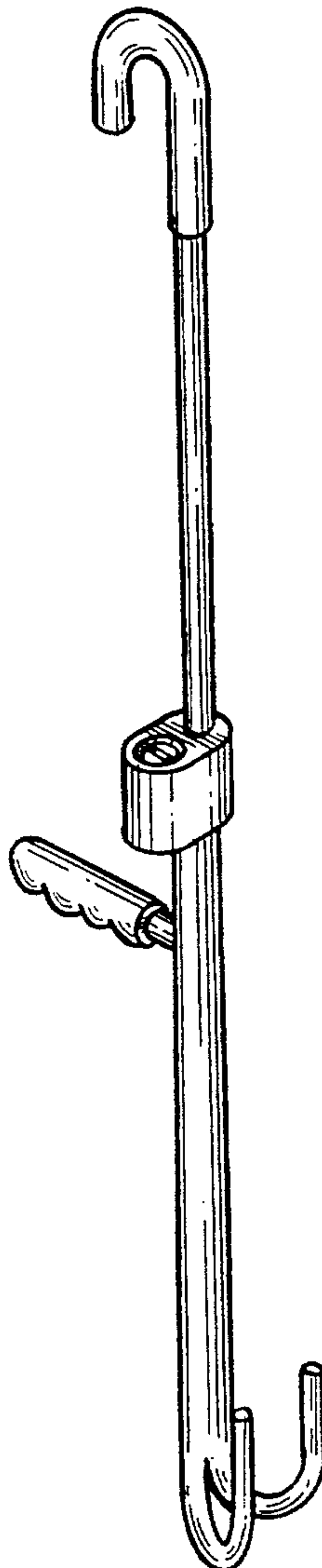
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the anti-theft device showing my new design;

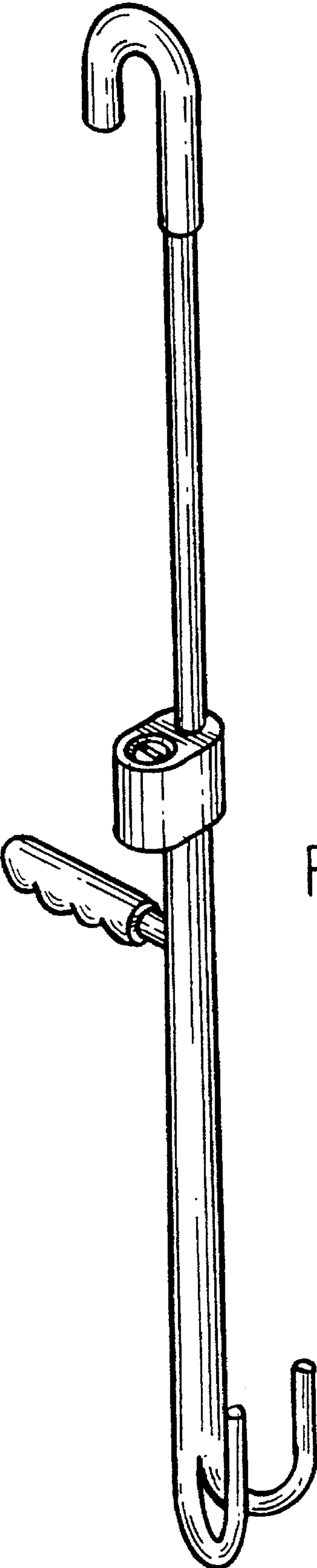

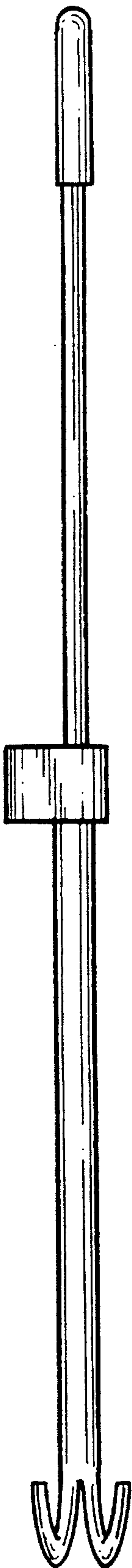

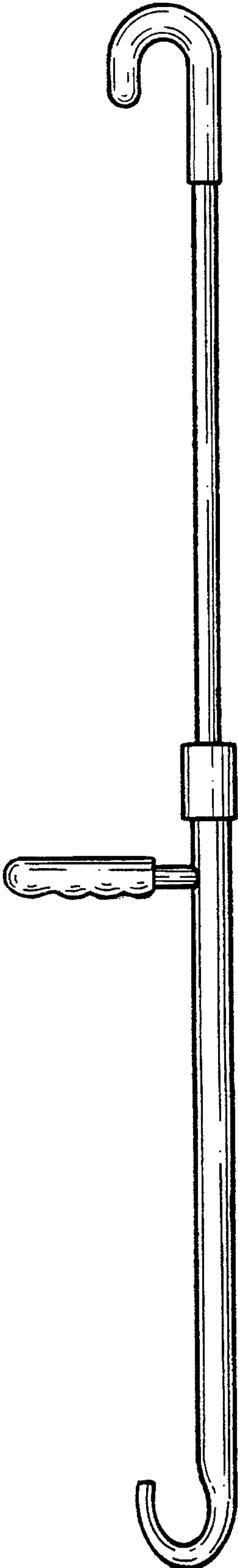

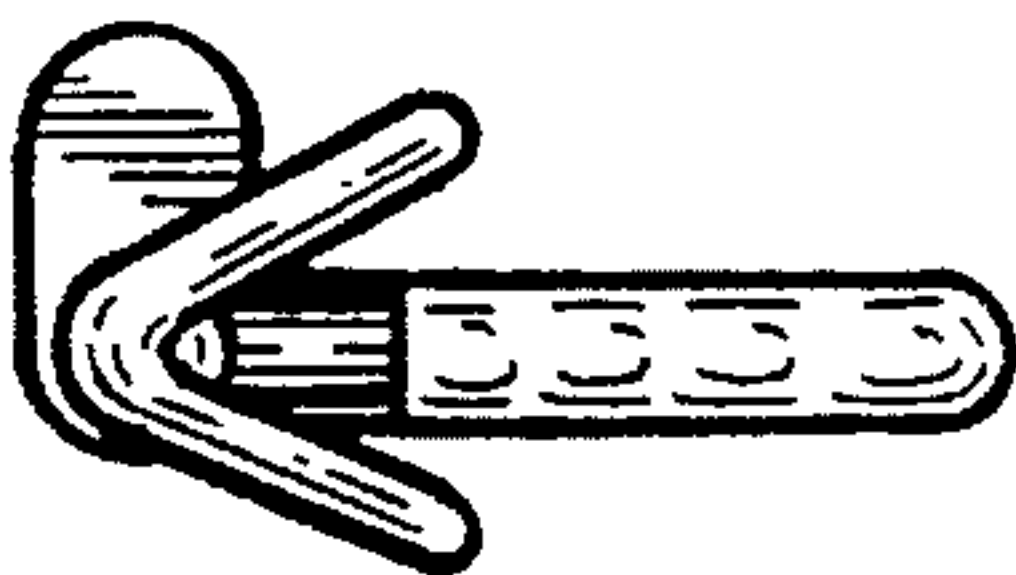

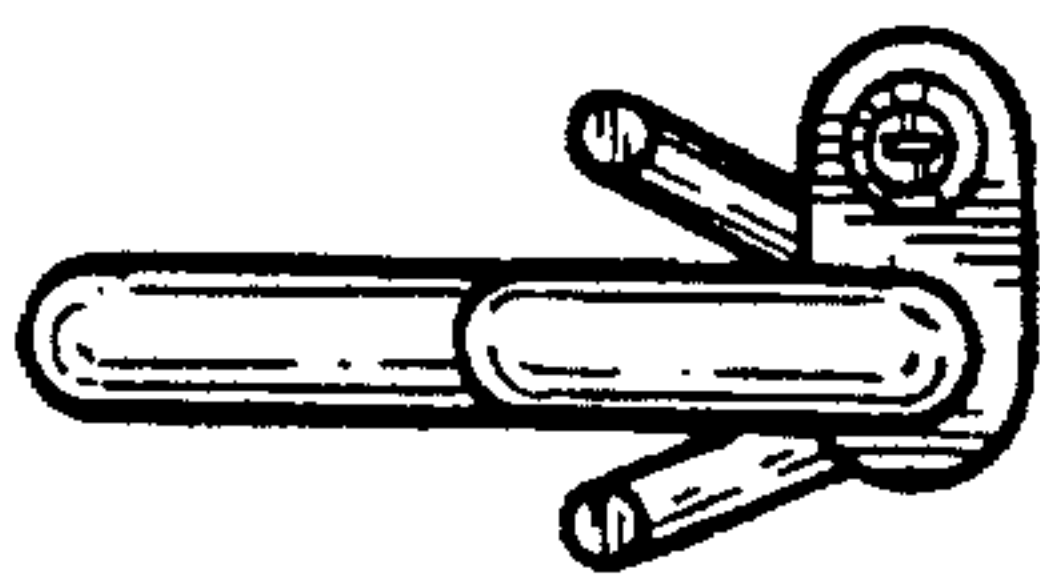

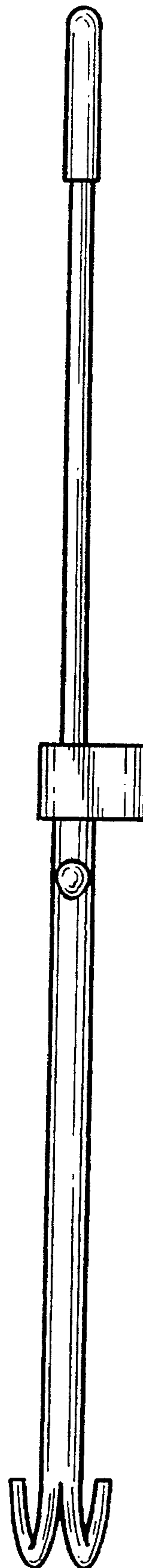
