[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a football helmet bell, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the first embodiment of a football helmet bell showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a first side view of the first embodiment with the second side view being a mirror image of the first side view; FIG. 3 is front elevation view of the first embodiment; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the first embodiment with the bottom plan view of the second embodiment being identical; FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the first embodiment; FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the first embodiment; FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the second embodiment of a football helmet bell showing my new design; FIG. 8 is a first side view of the second embodiment with the second first side view being a mirror image of the side view; FIG. 9 is front elevation view of the second embodiment; FIG. 10 is a rear elevation view of the second embodiment; and,
