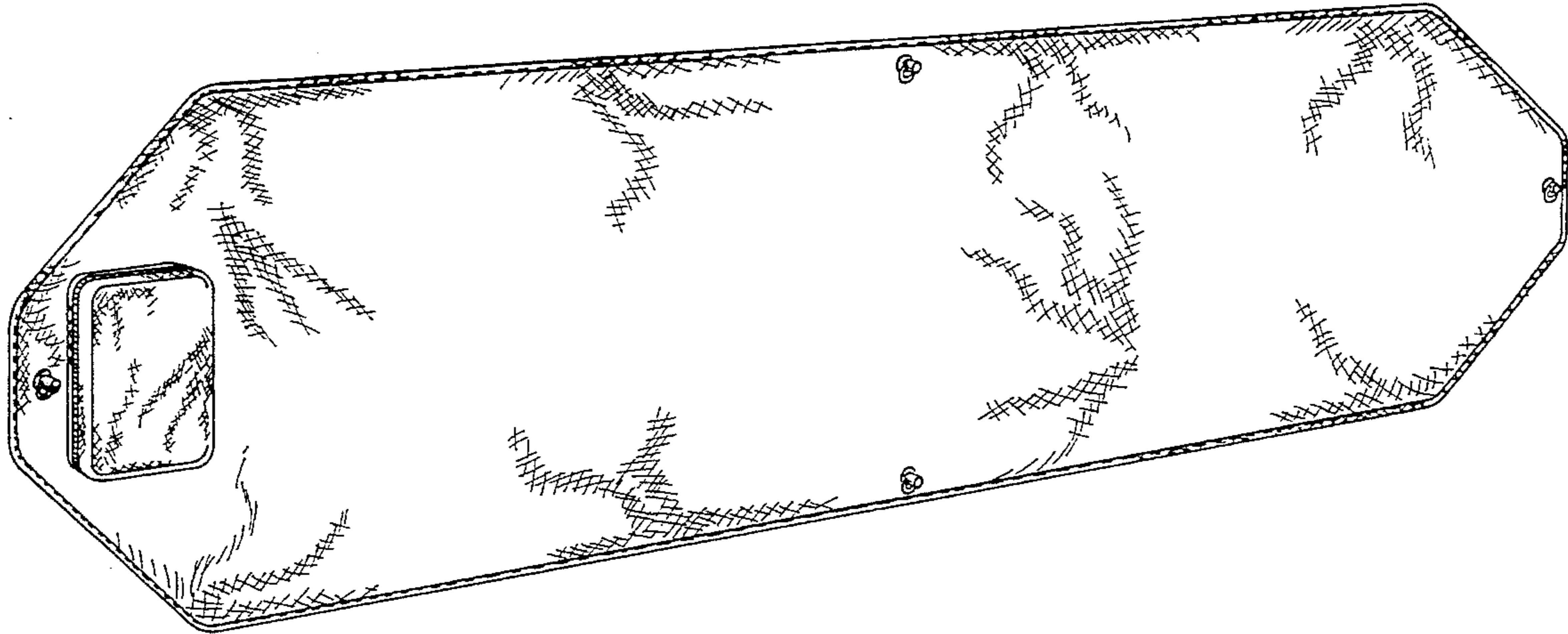
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the ornamental vehicular sun shield with pouch, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the vehicular sun shield with pouch of the invention;
 FIG. 2 is a front view of the vehicular sun shield with pouch of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the vehicular sun shield with pouch of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a back view of the vehicular sun shield with pouch of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top view of the vehicular sun shield with pouch of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is a right side view of the vehicular sun shield with pouch of FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 7 is a left side view of the vehicular sun shield with pouch of FIG. 1.
 The shading indicates a flexible sheet material which extends completely within the borders which are shown.

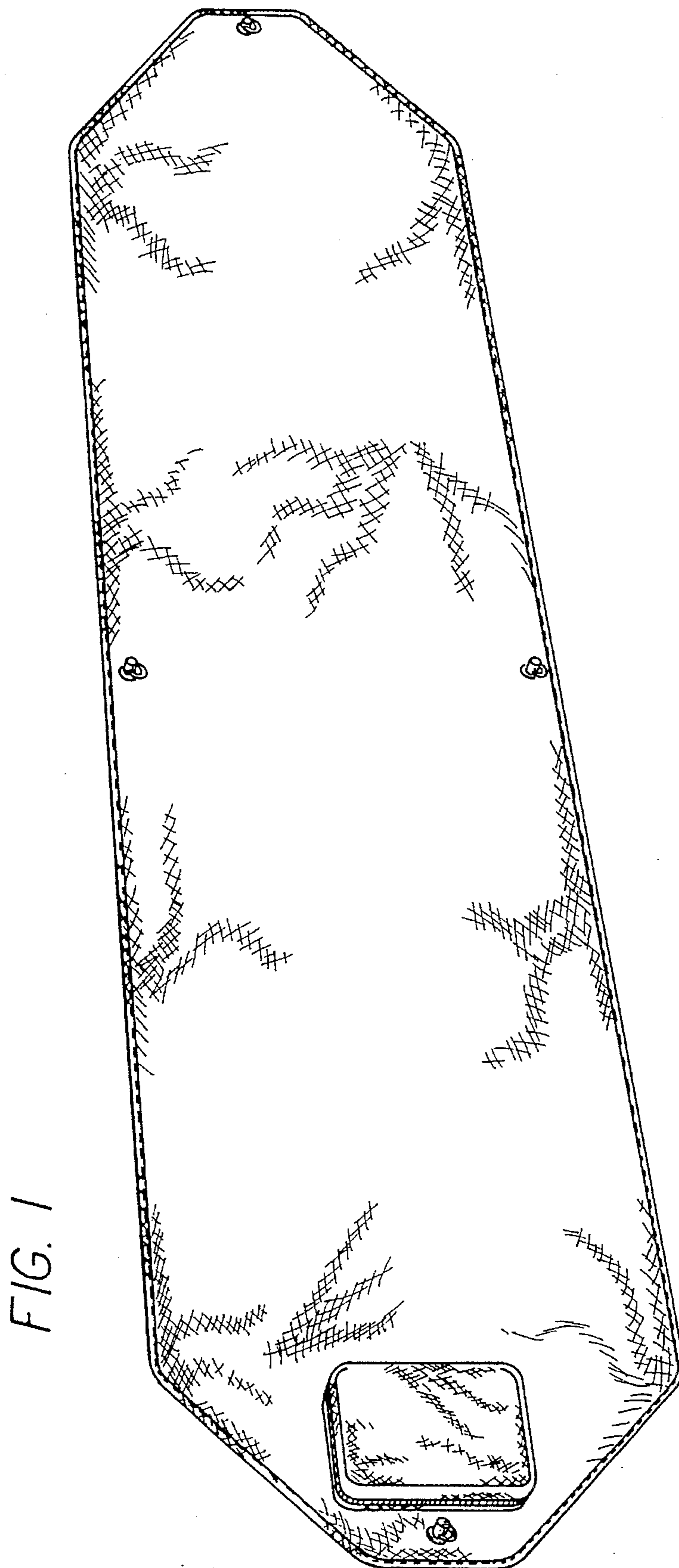

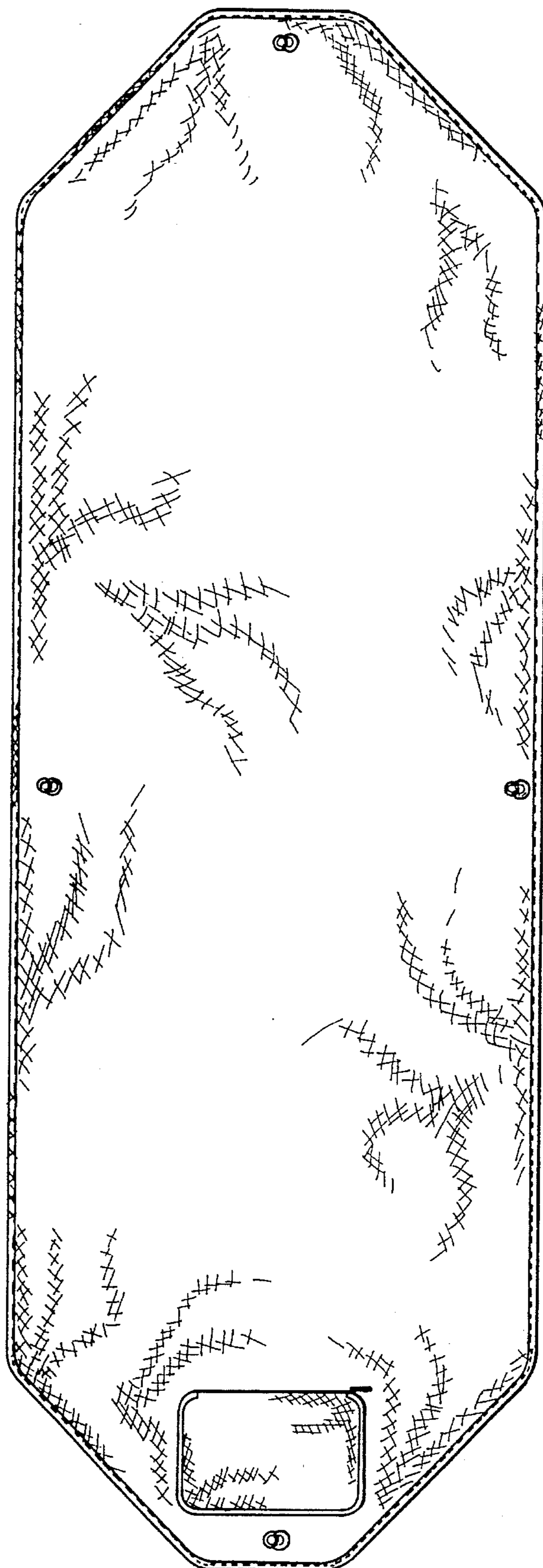

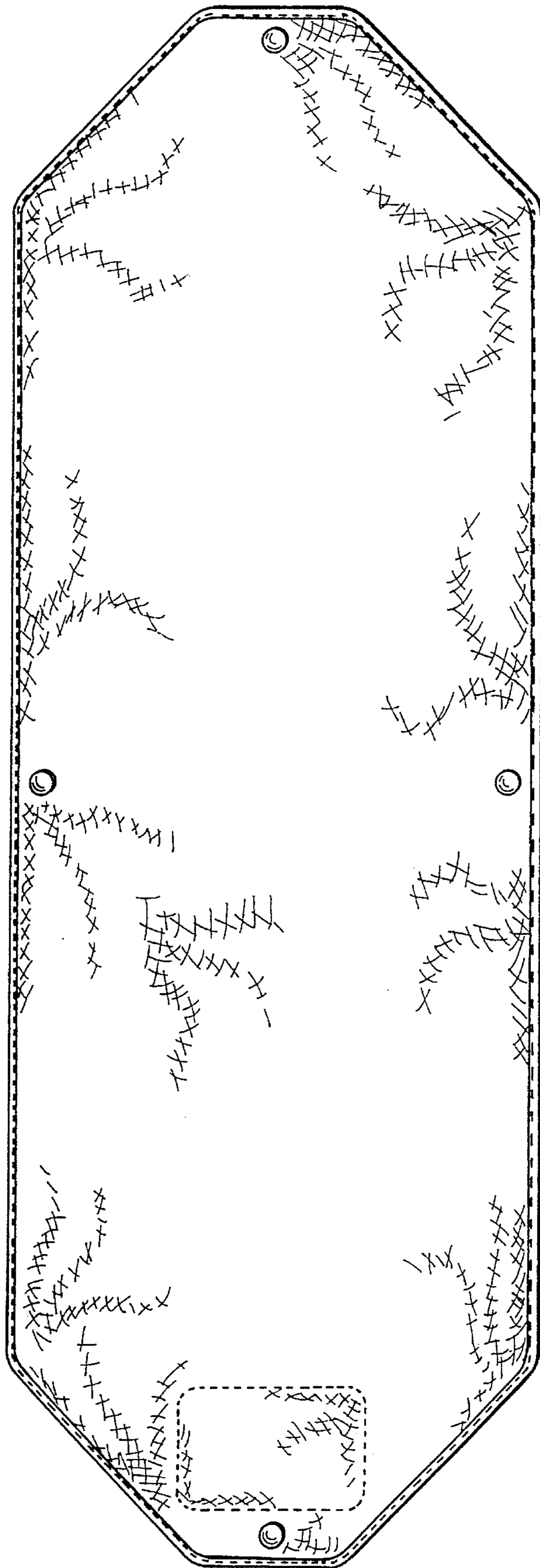

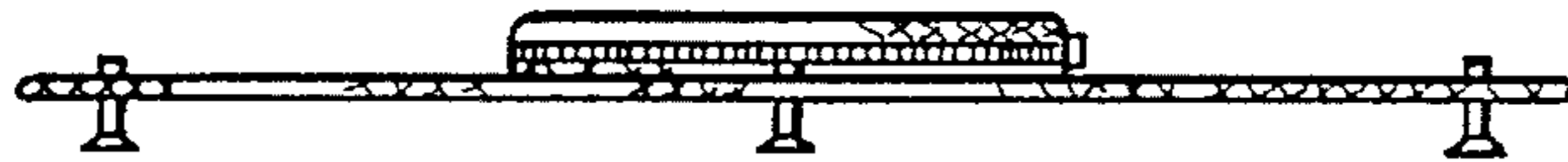
