[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lottery ticket scratcher, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a lottery ticket scratcher of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a front view of a lottery ticket scratcher of the present invention;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the second rounded side of the lottery ticket scratcher for conventional ticket scratching;
FIG. 4 is a side view of the first flat edge of the present invention for a quick scrape of a lottery ticket;
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of the lottery ticket scratcher of the present invention on an enlarged scale; and,
FIG. 6 is rear perspective view of the lottery ticket scratcher of the present invention on an enlarged scale.

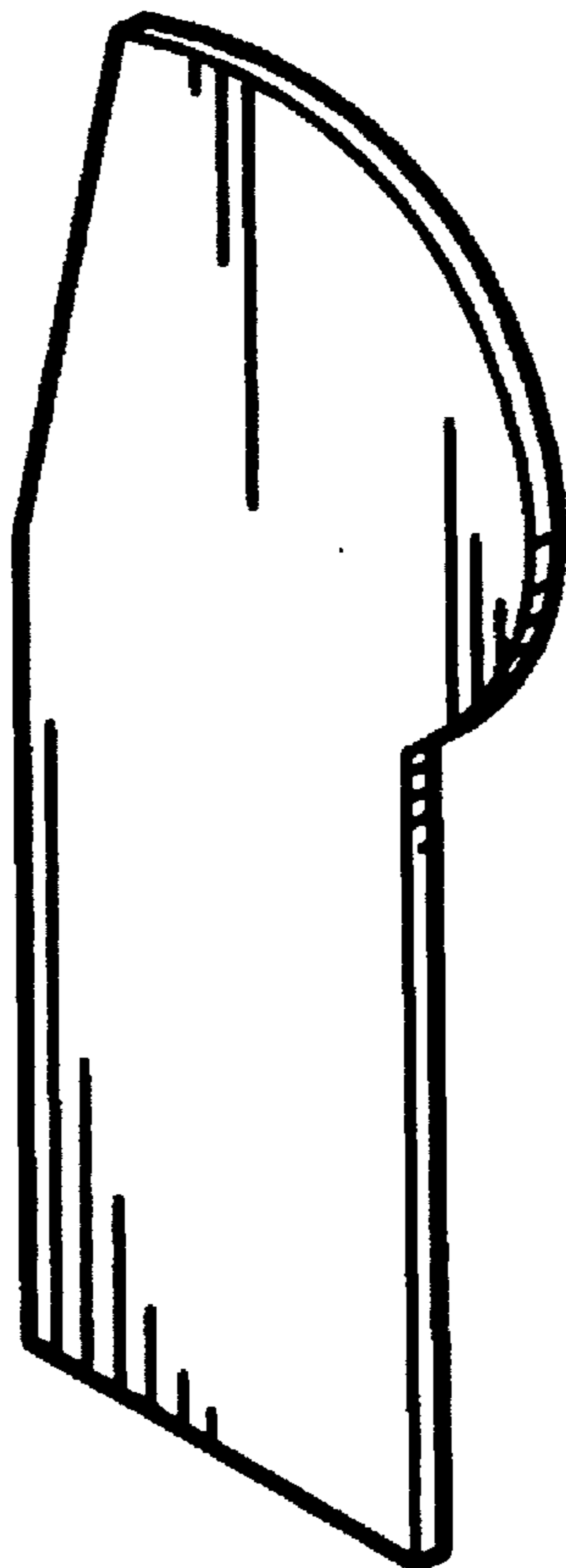

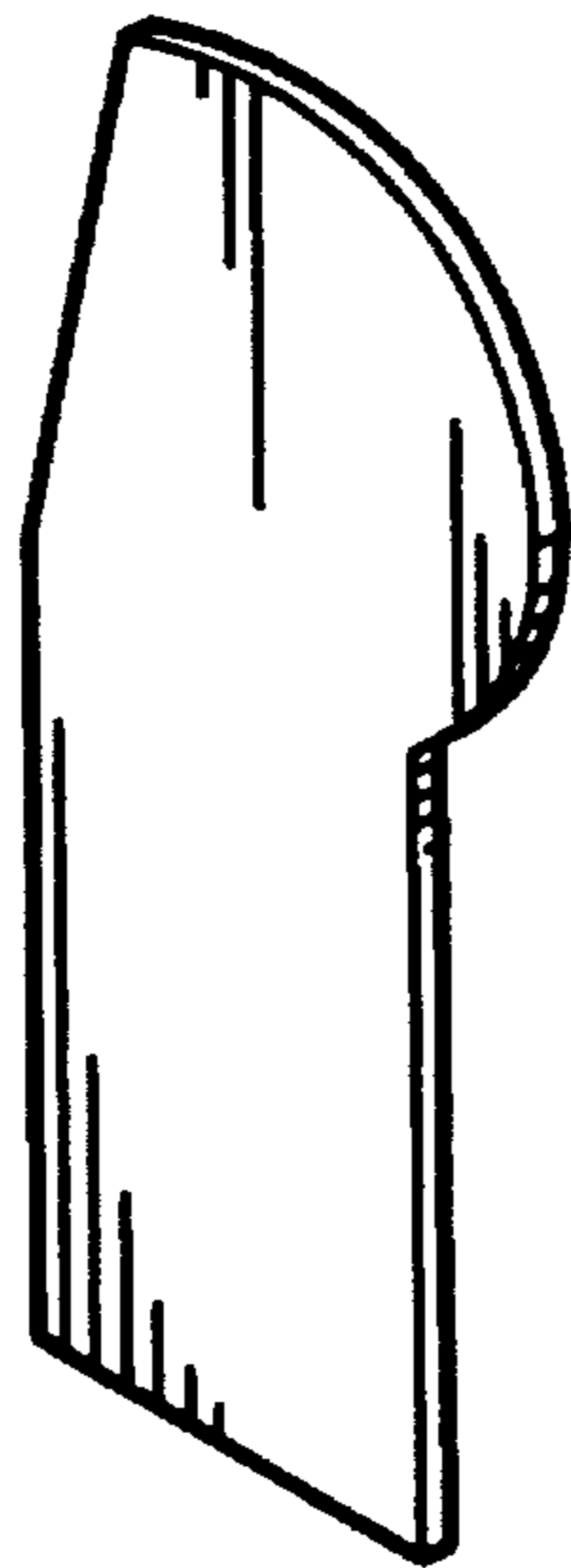
