[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a support for a raised floor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, right side perspective view of a support for a raised floor showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

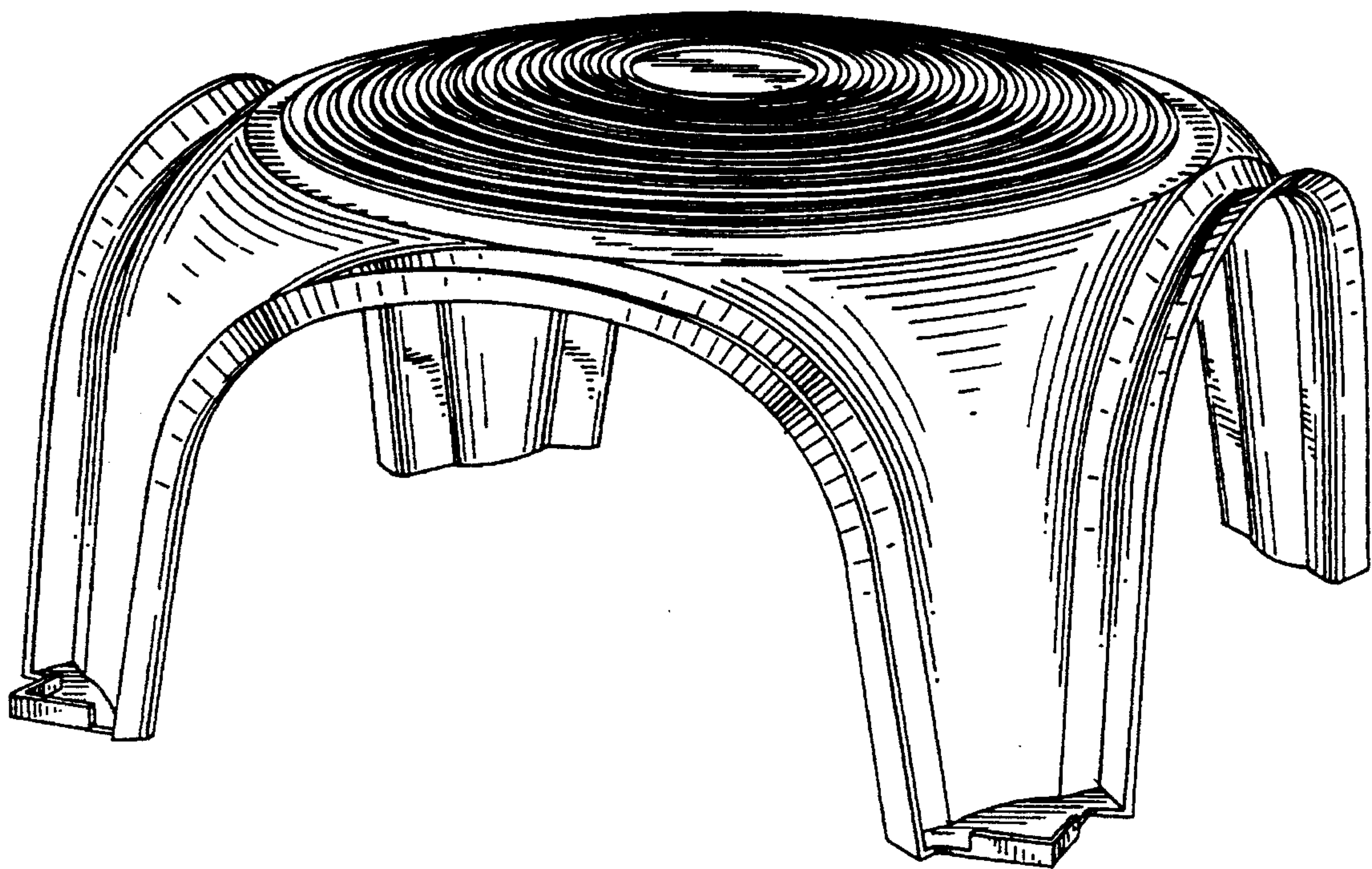

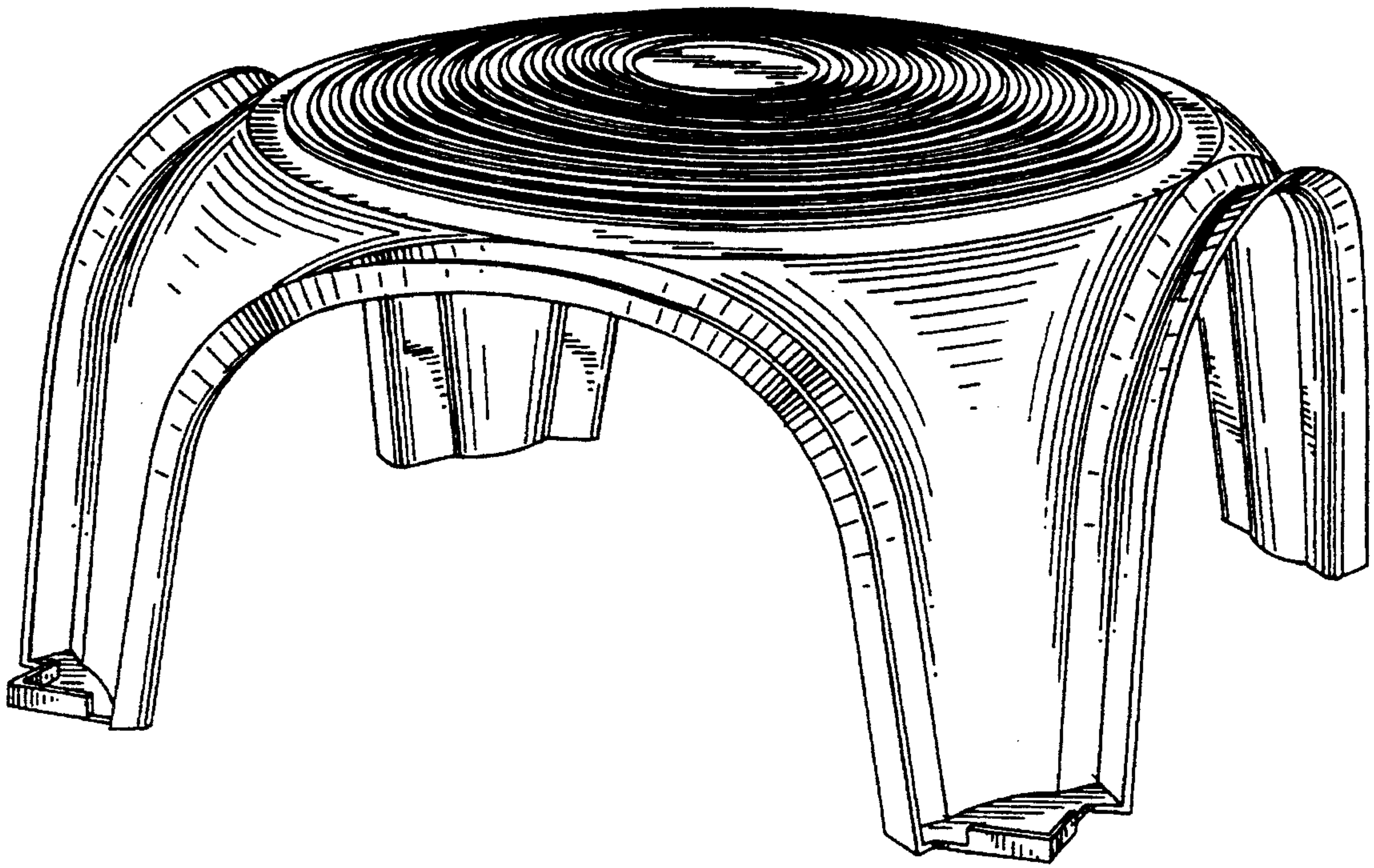

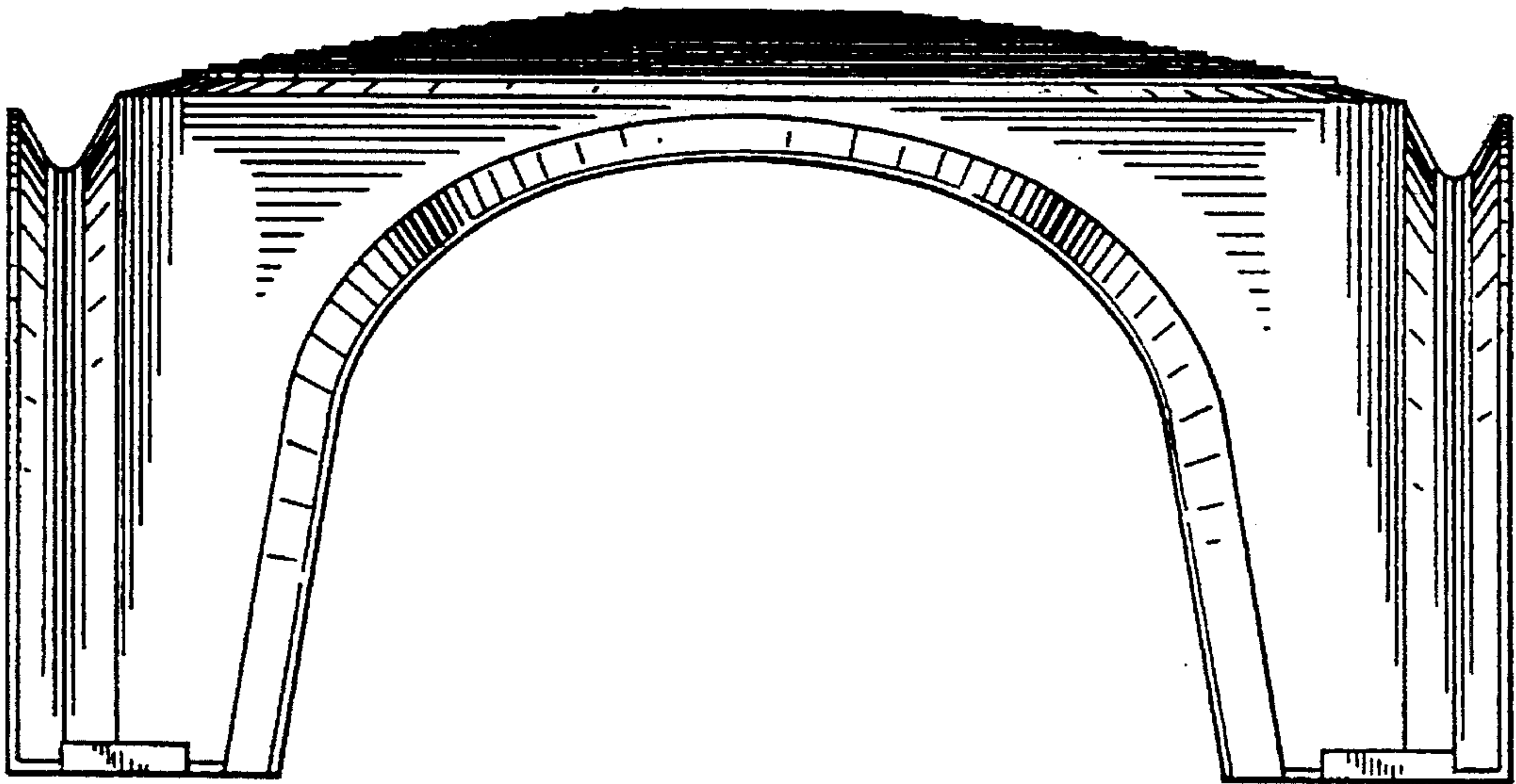

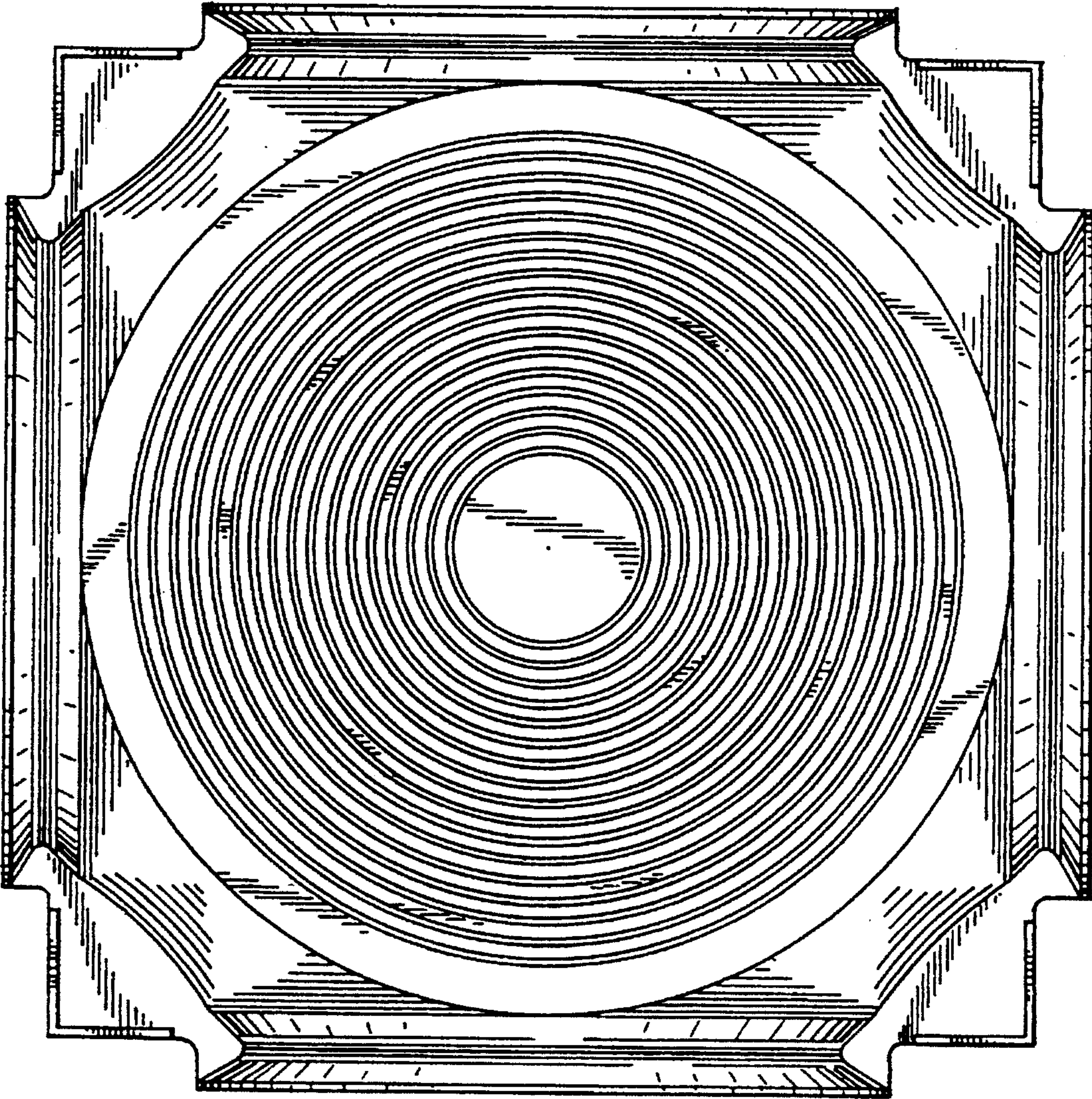
