DESCRIPTION

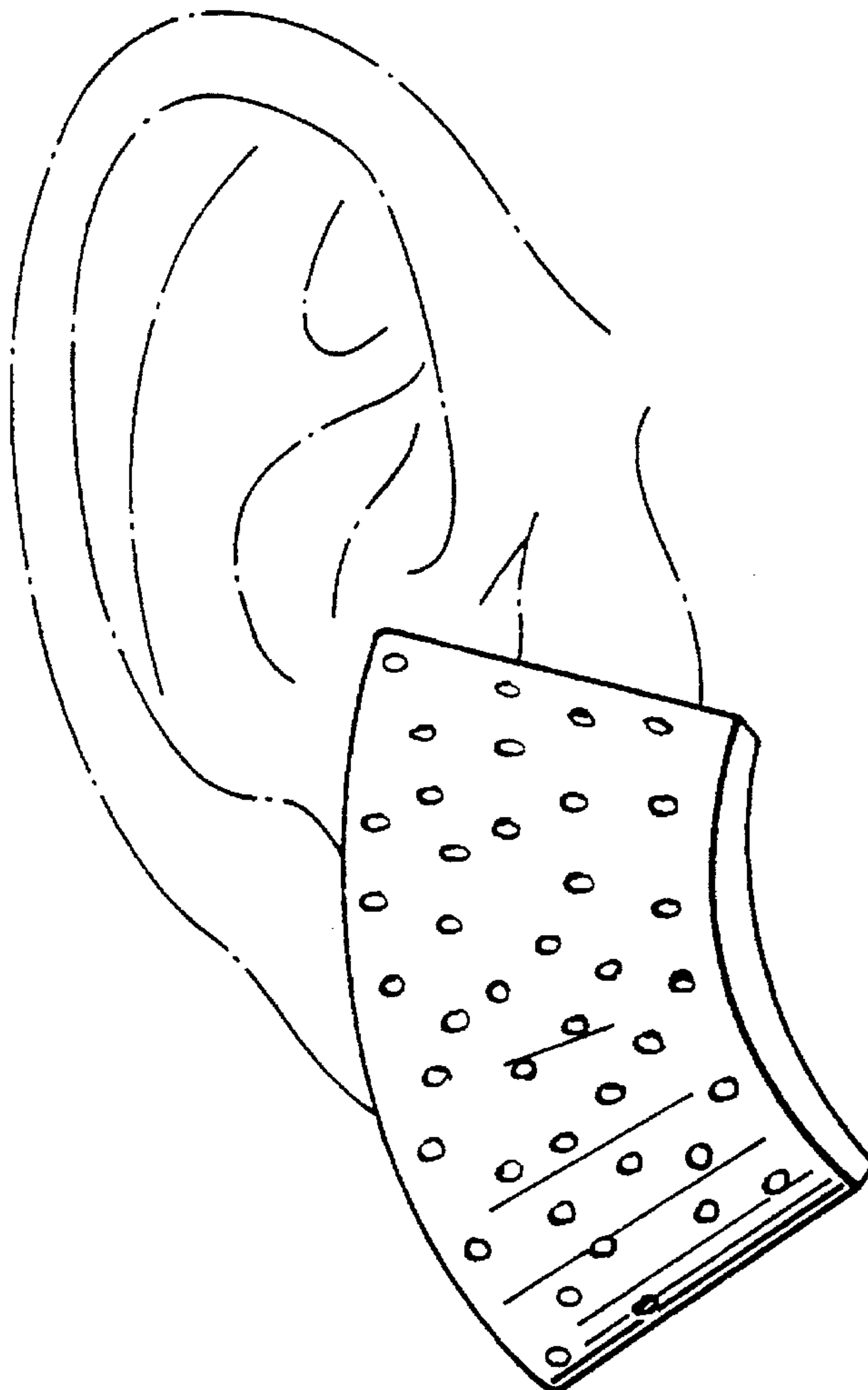
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hearing aid earring according to my new design;

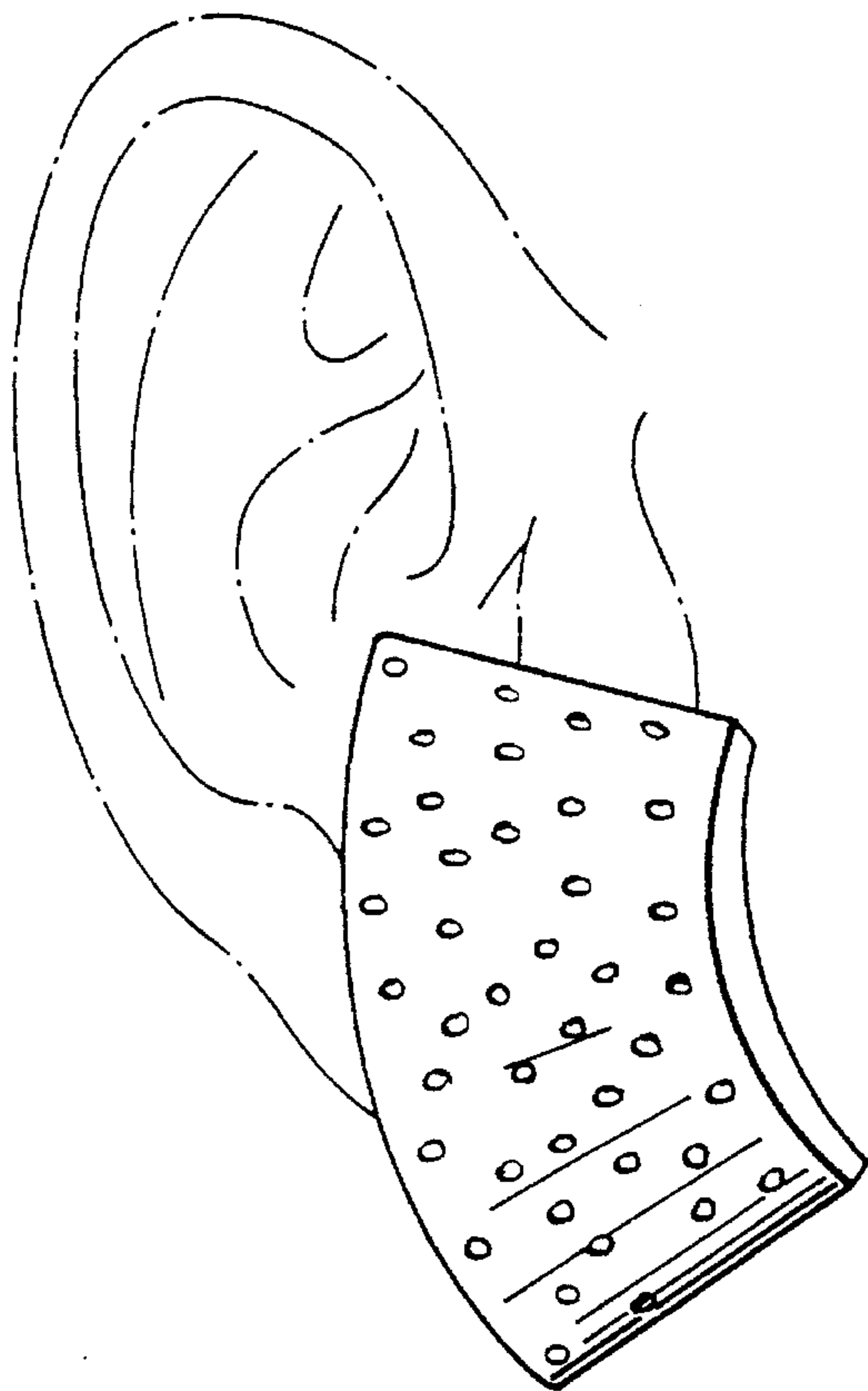

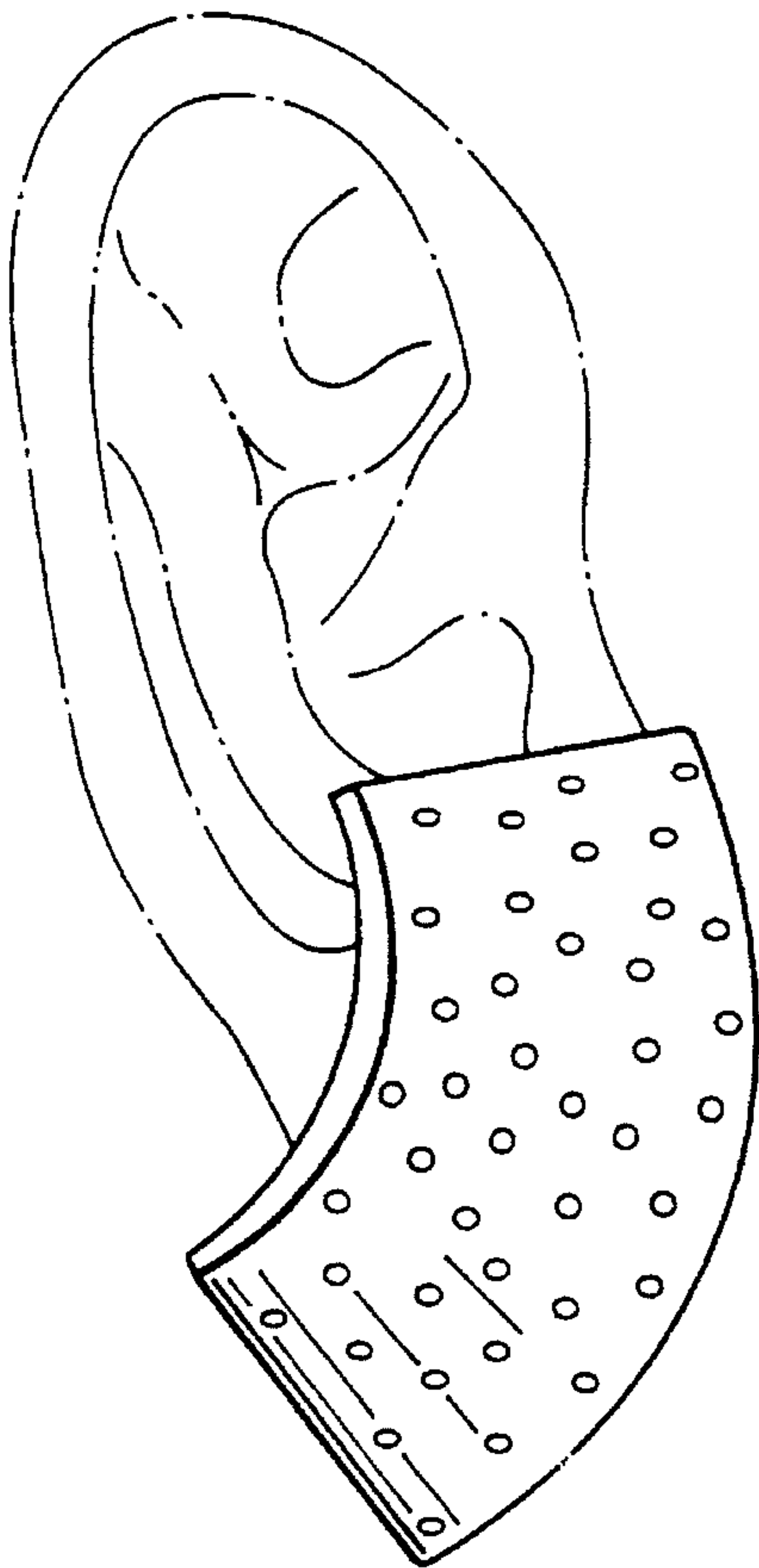

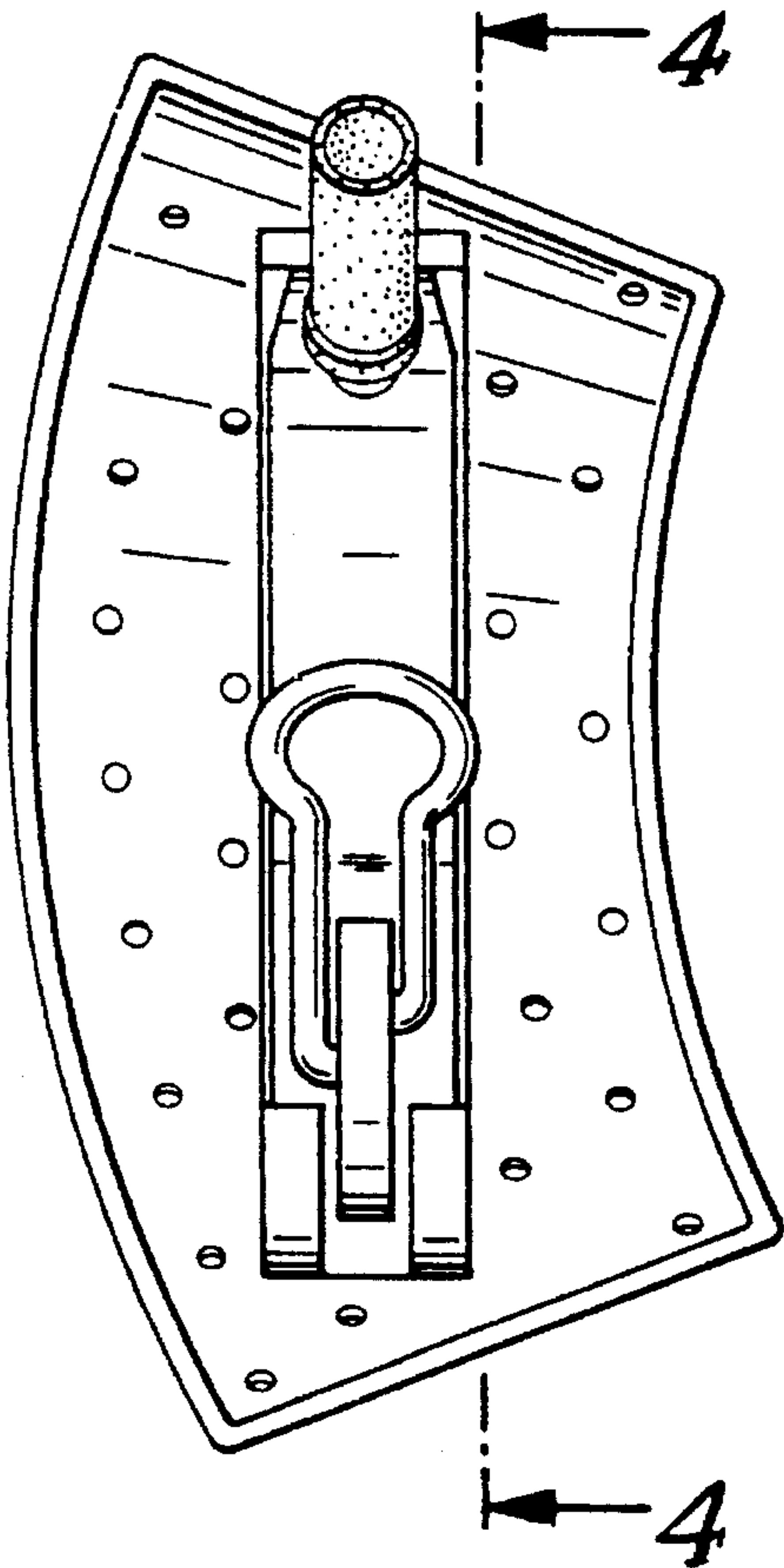

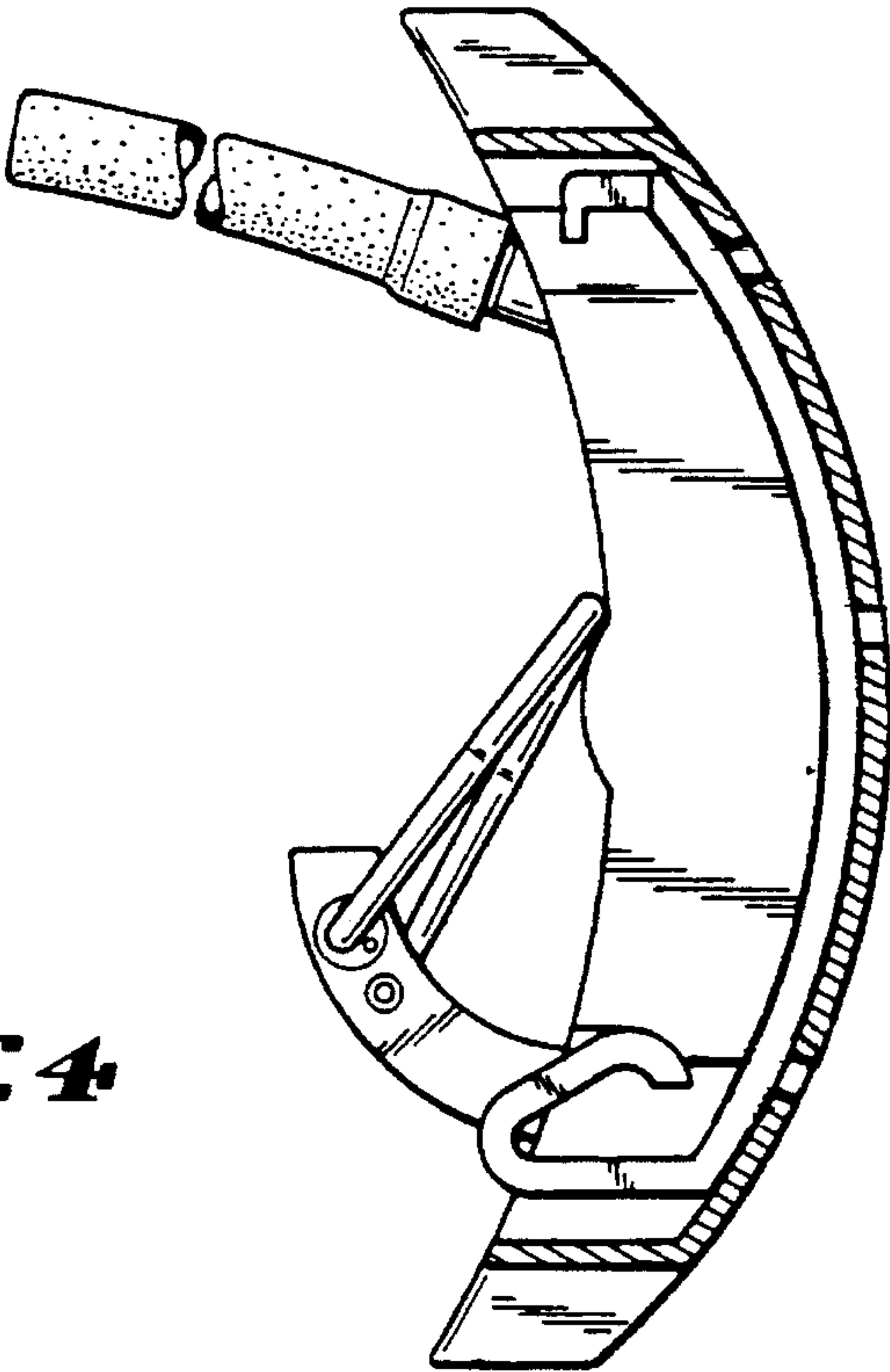
