showing of my new design;

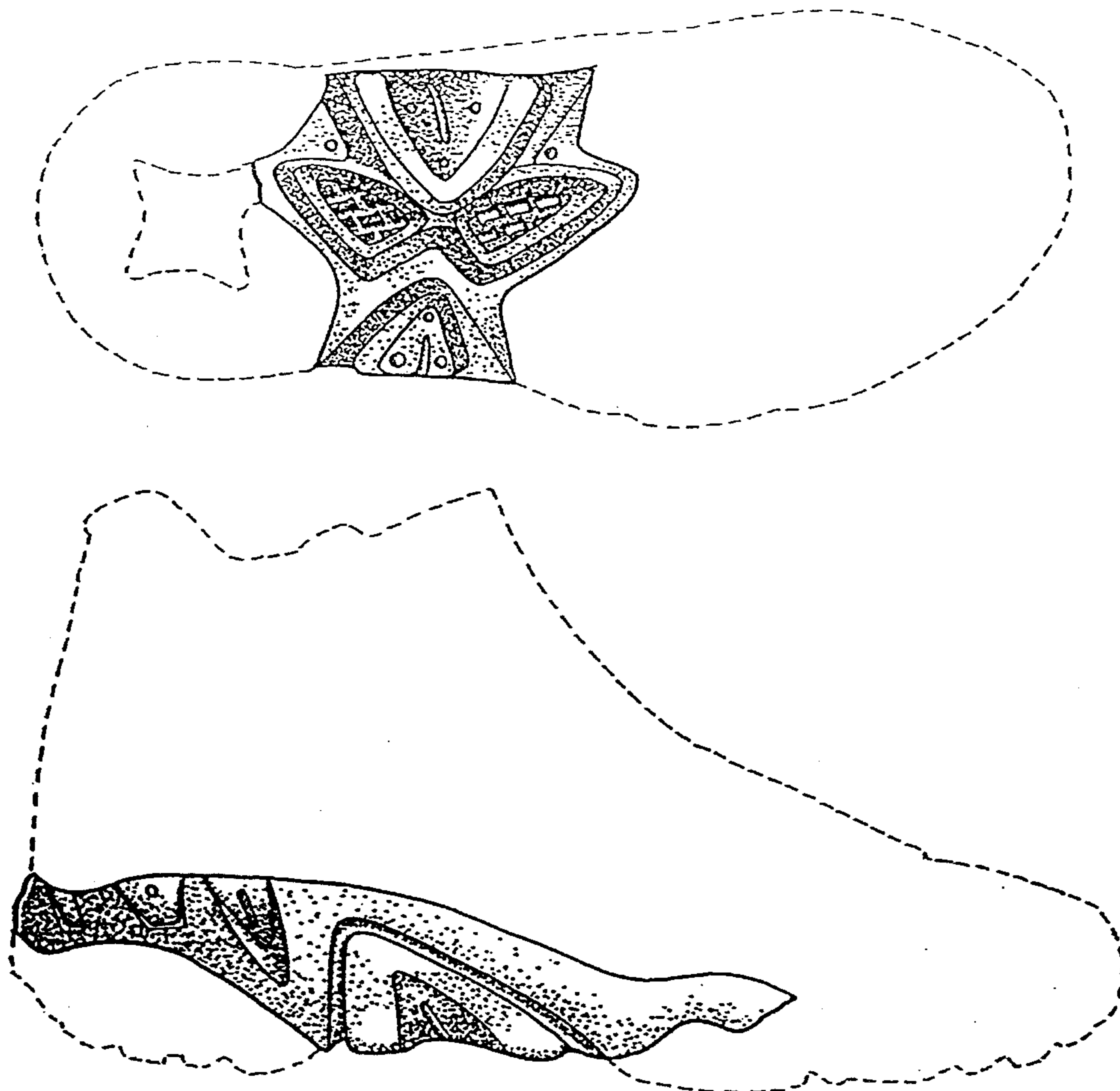
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

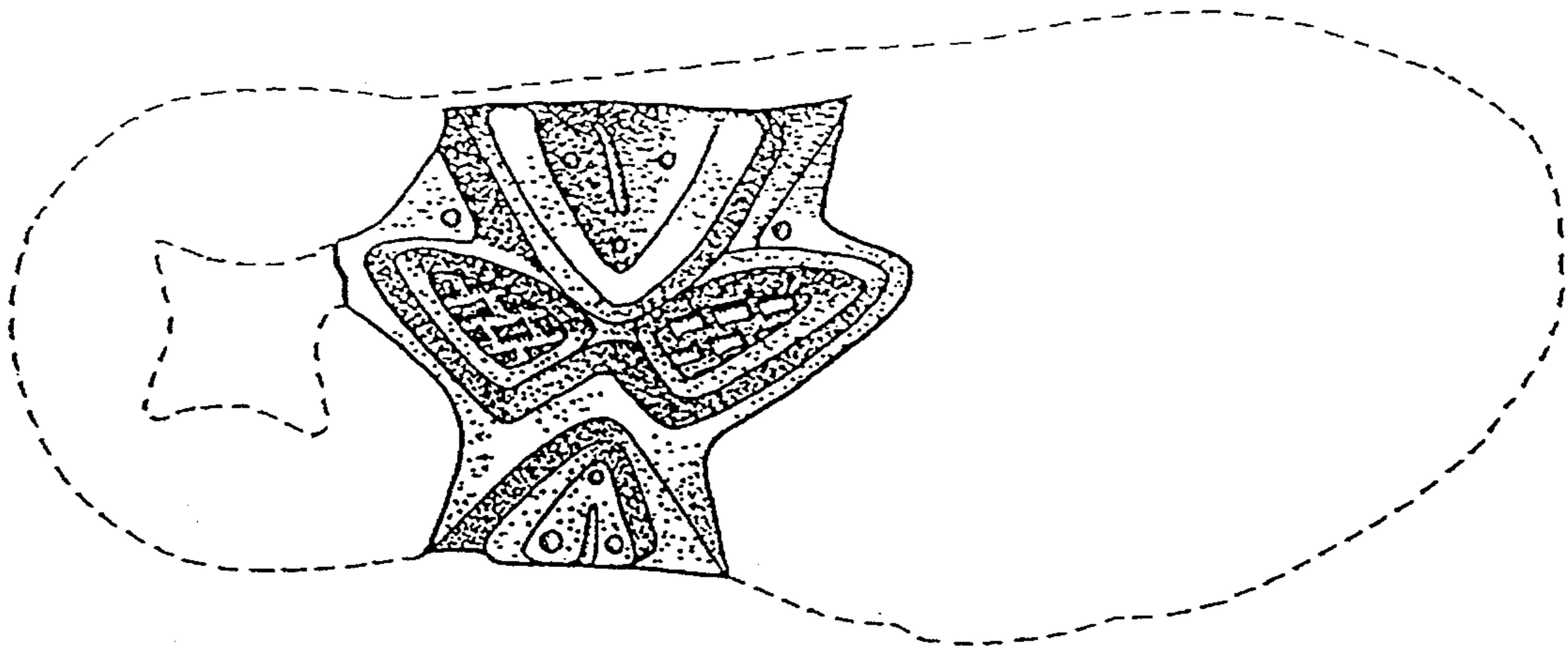

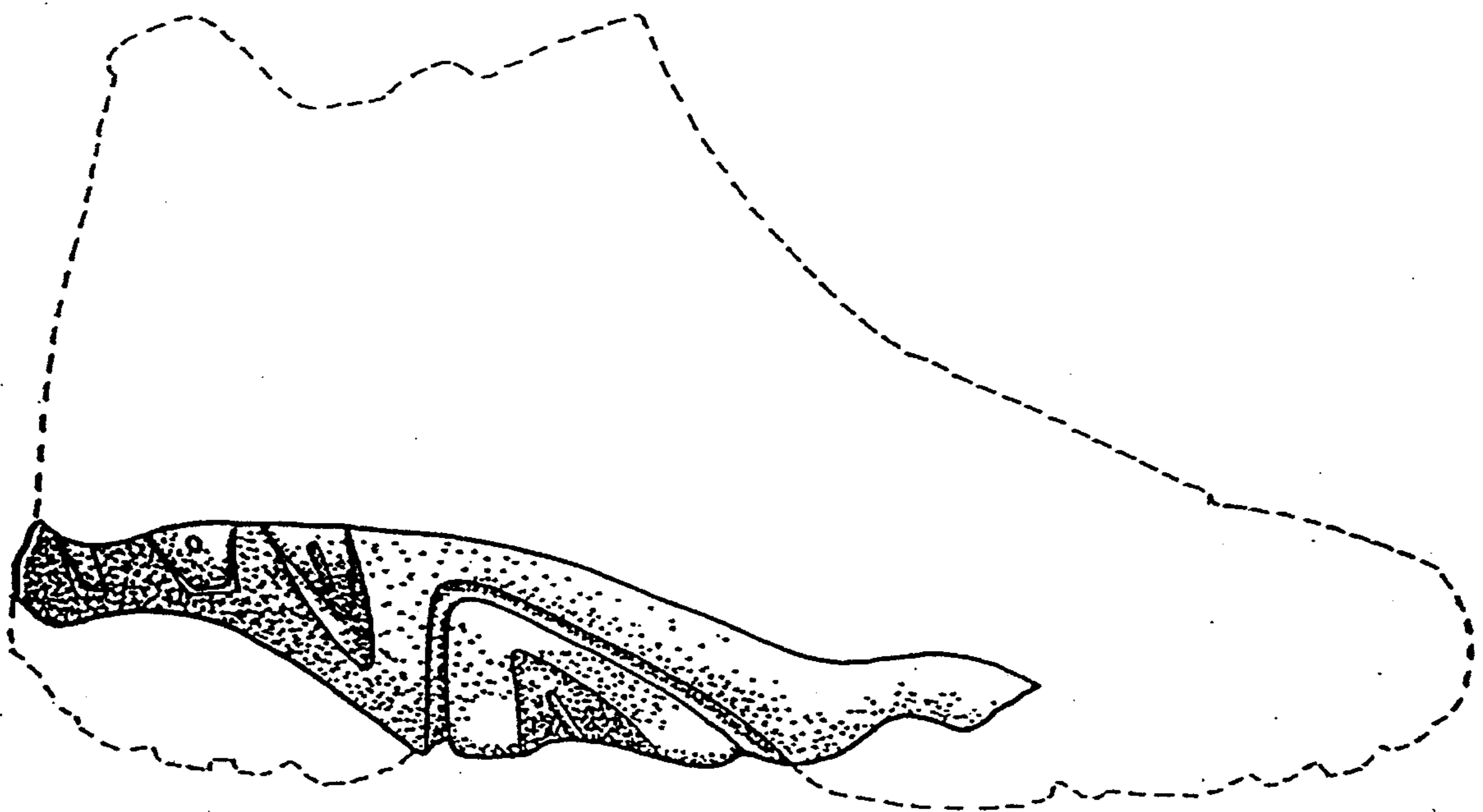

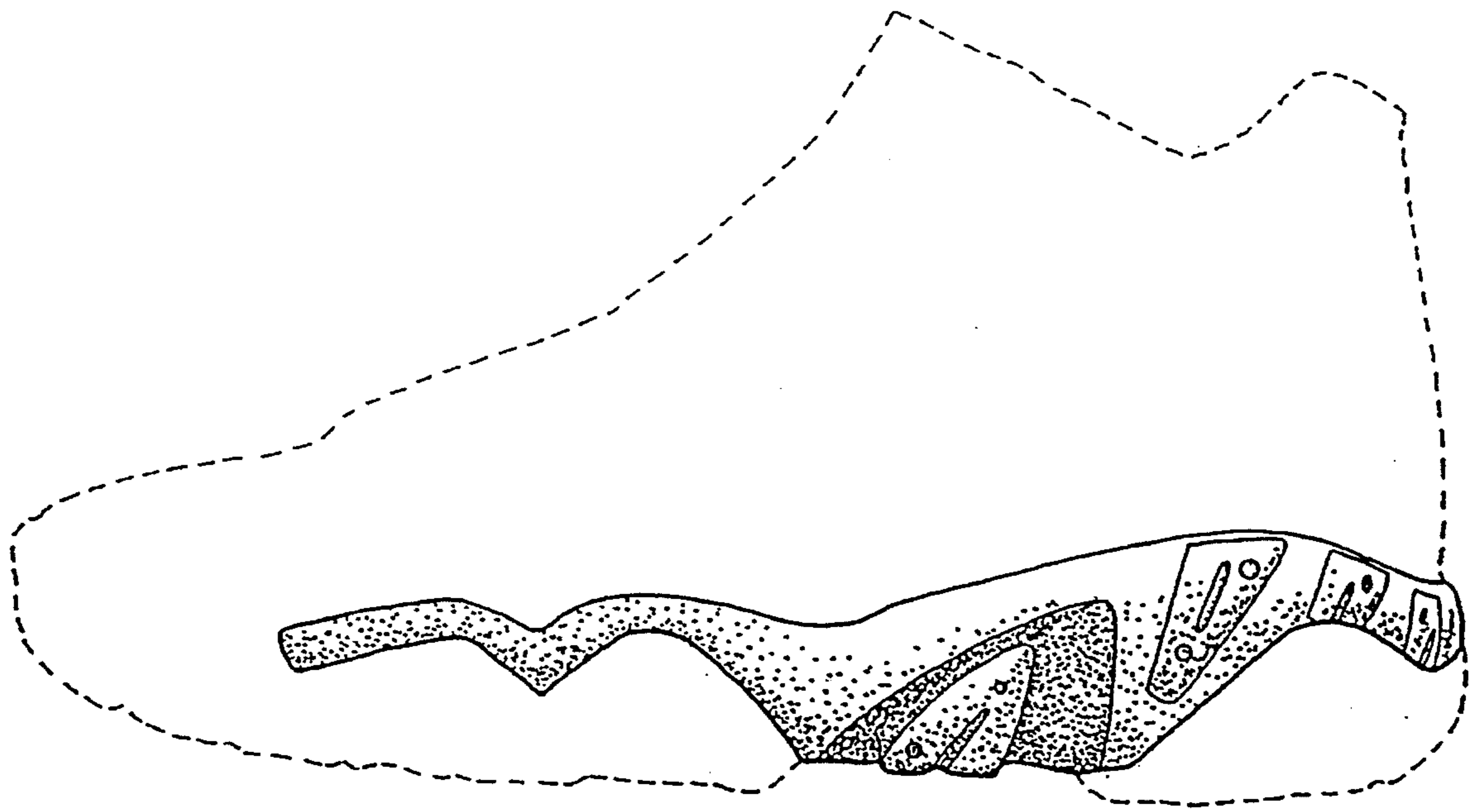

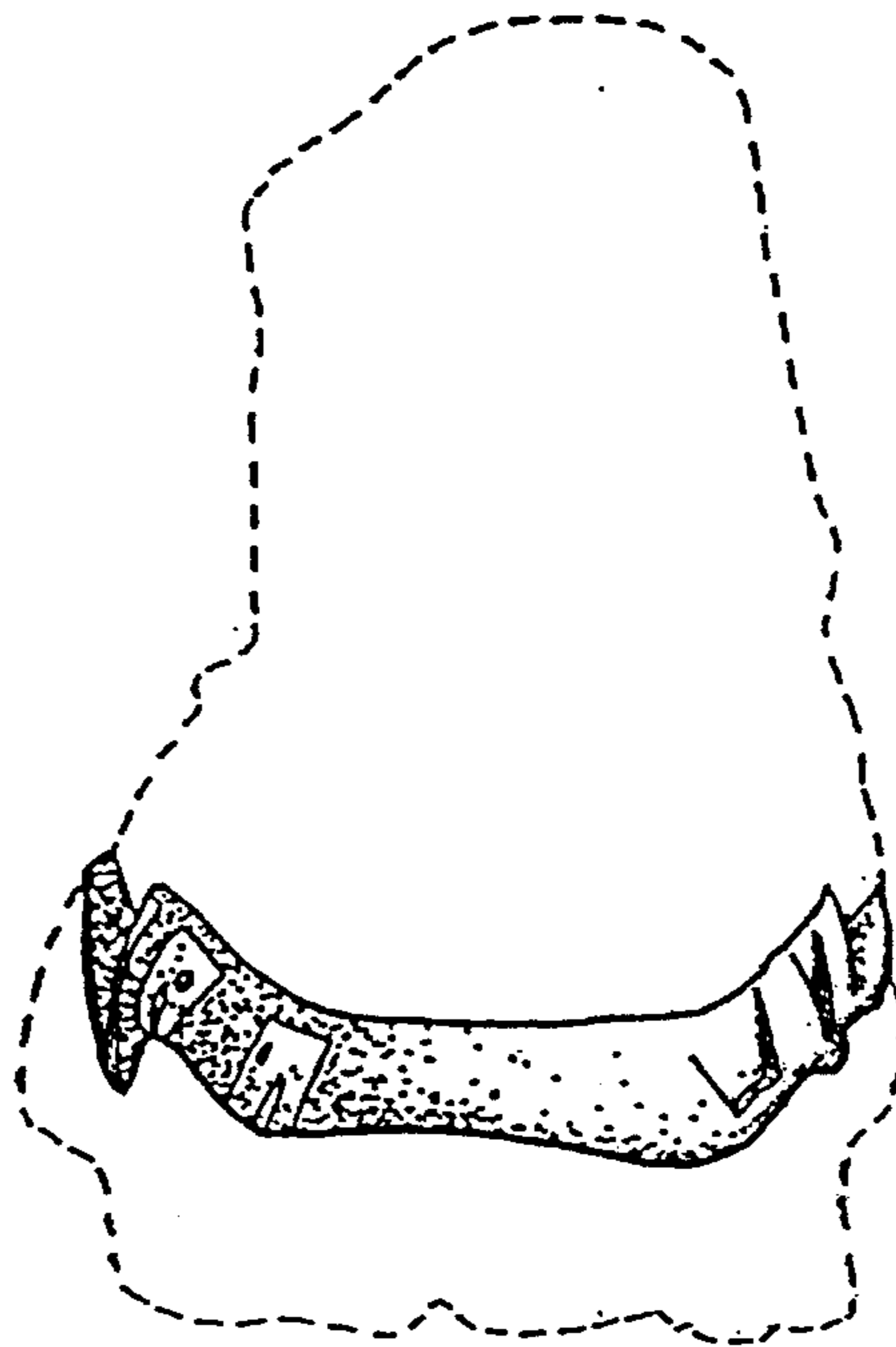
