DESCRIPTION

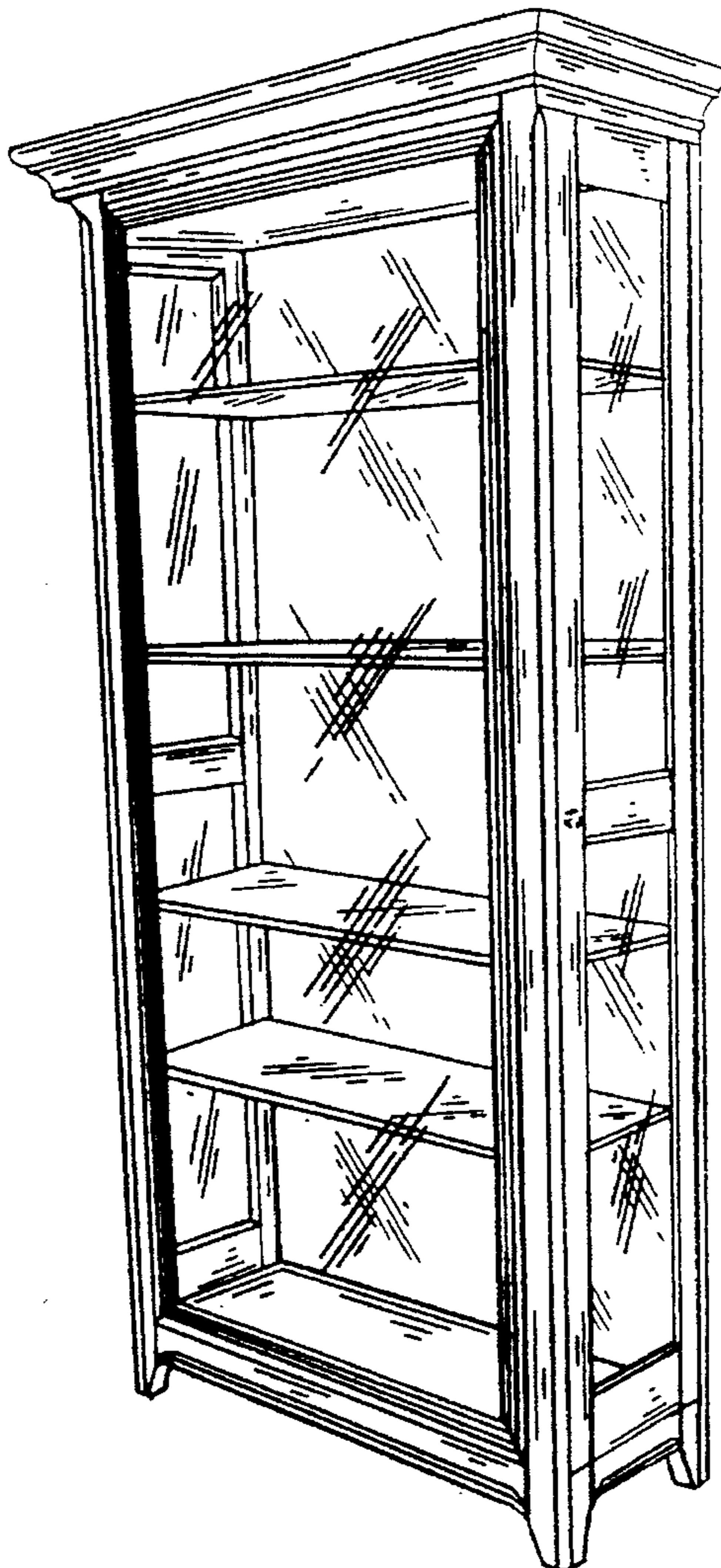
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a curio cabinet showing our new design;

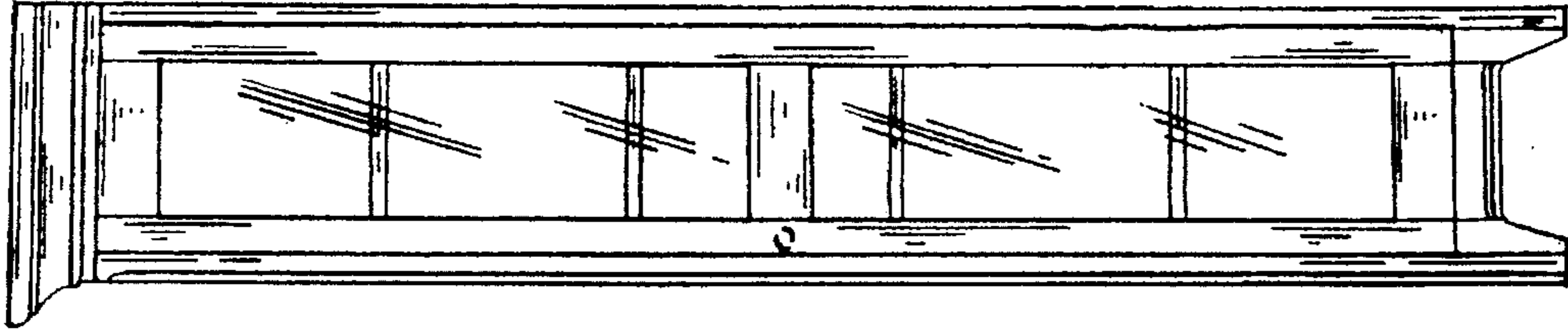

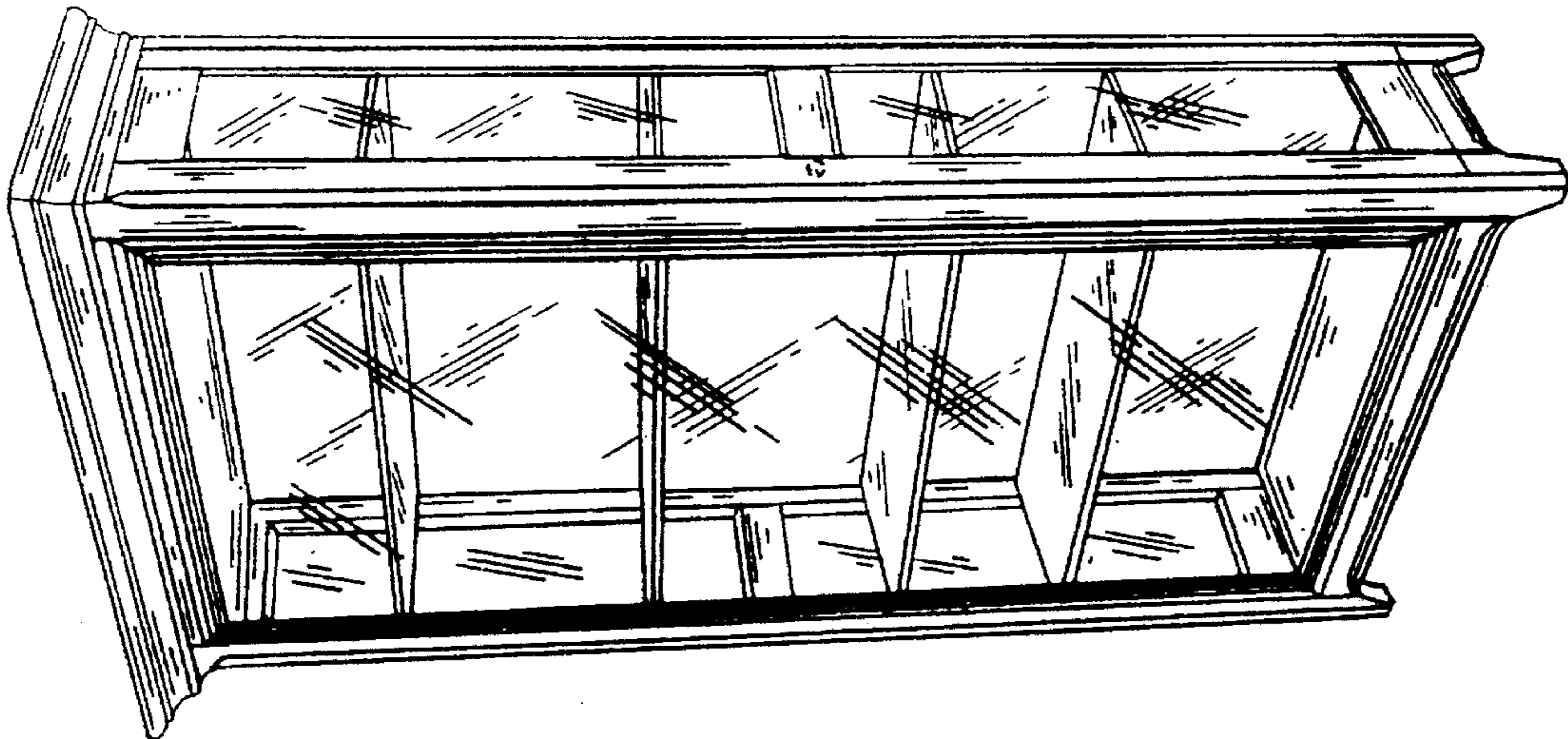

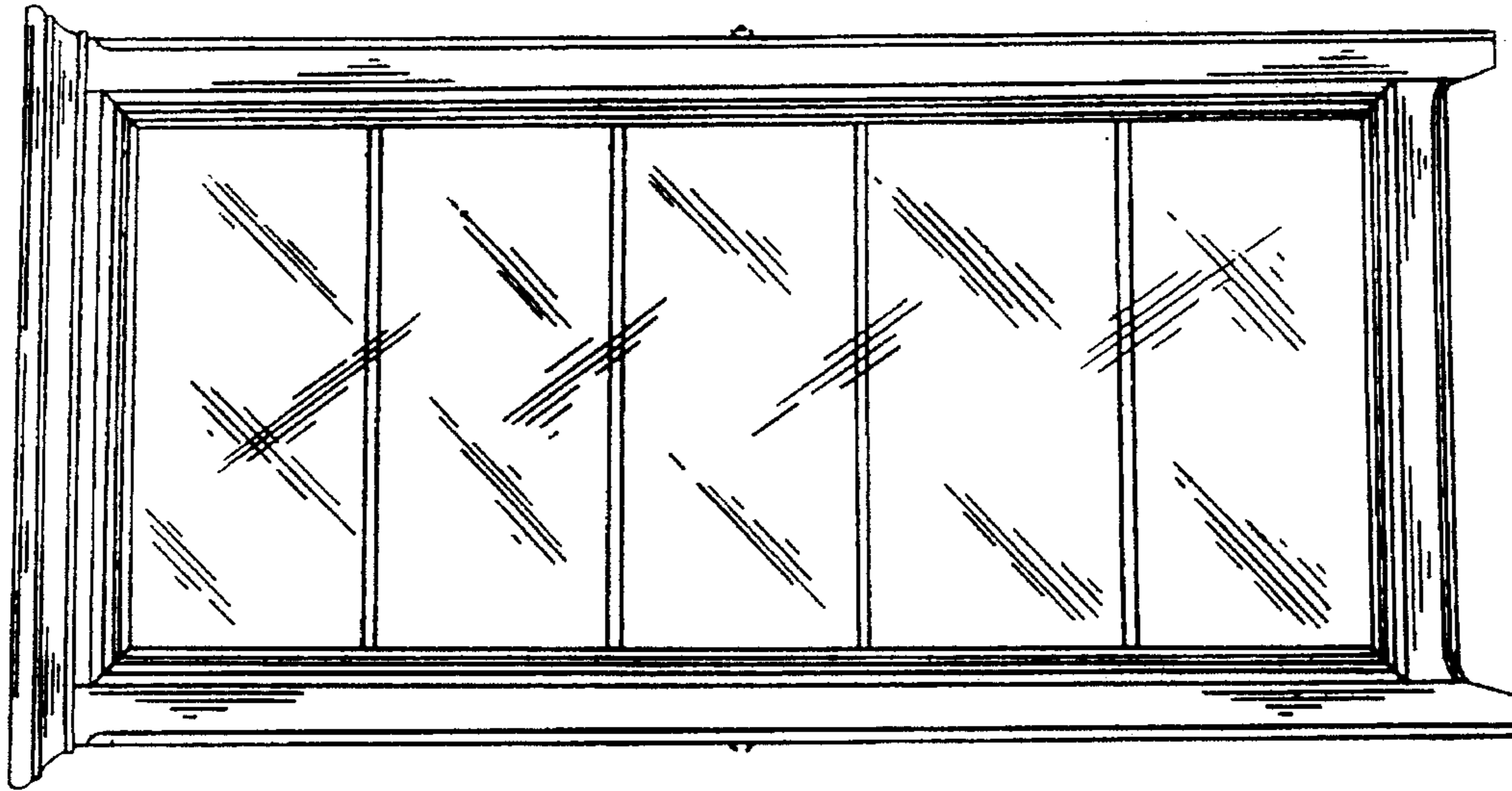
