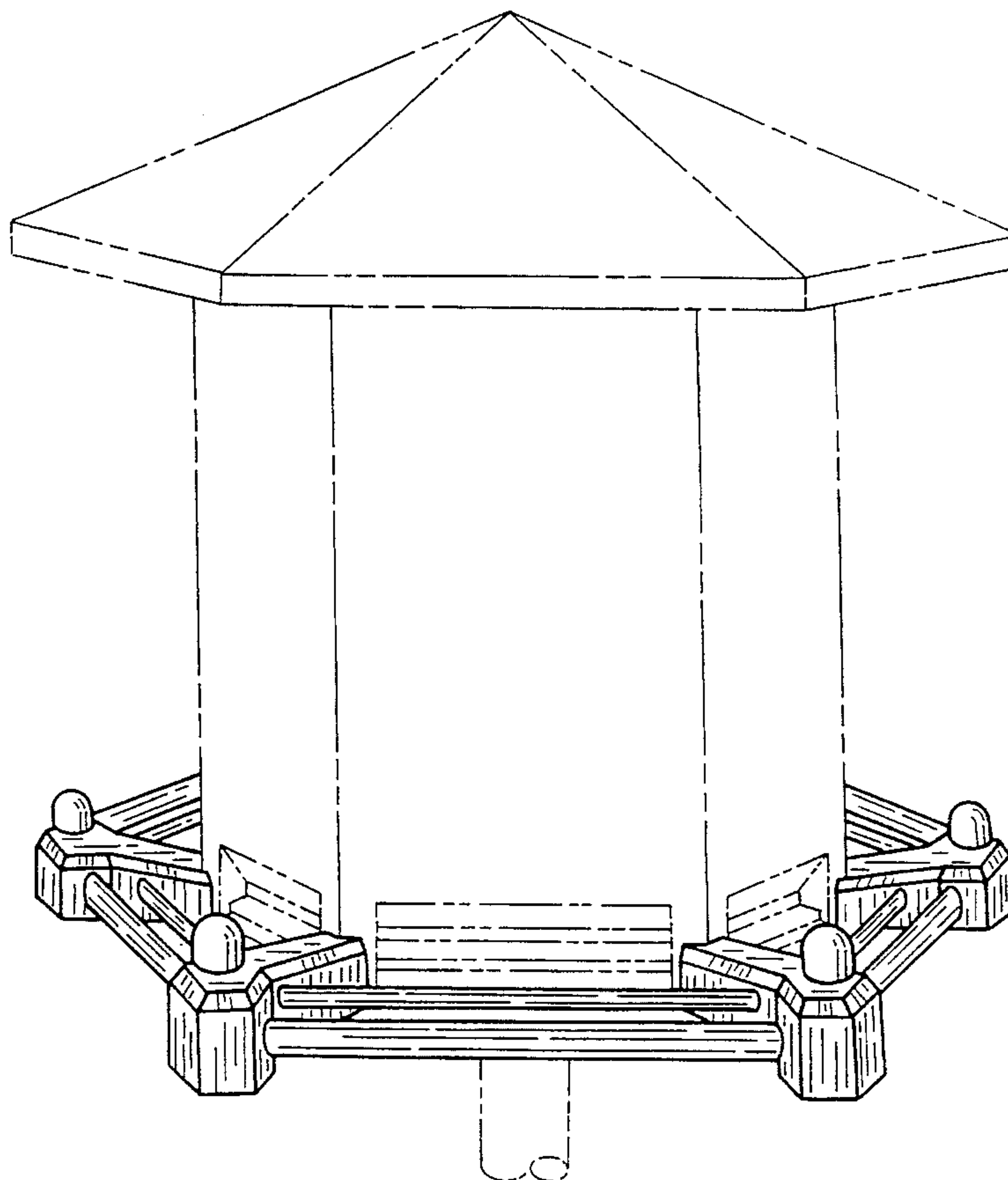
The ornamental design for a perch for a bird feeder, as shown.

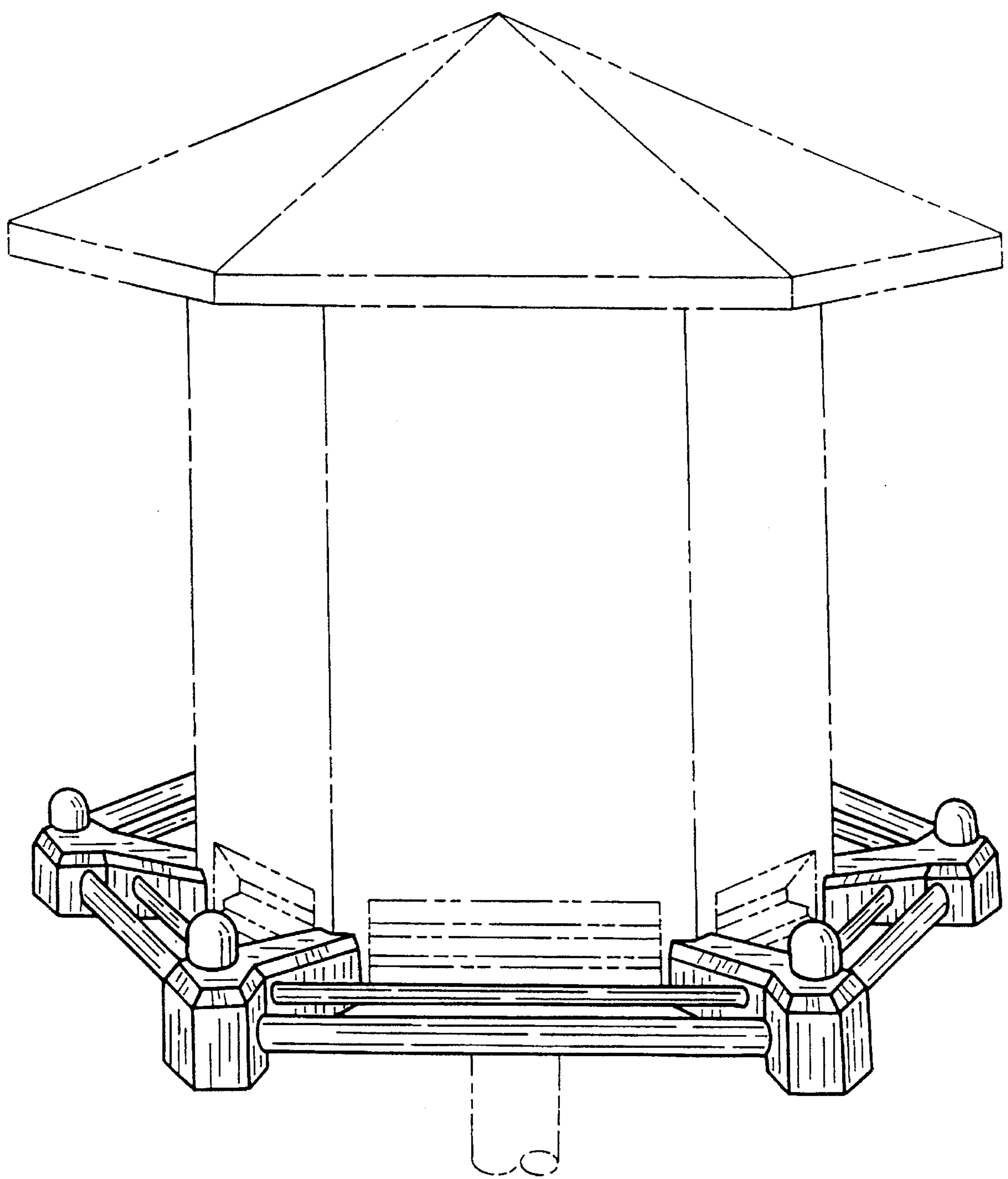
