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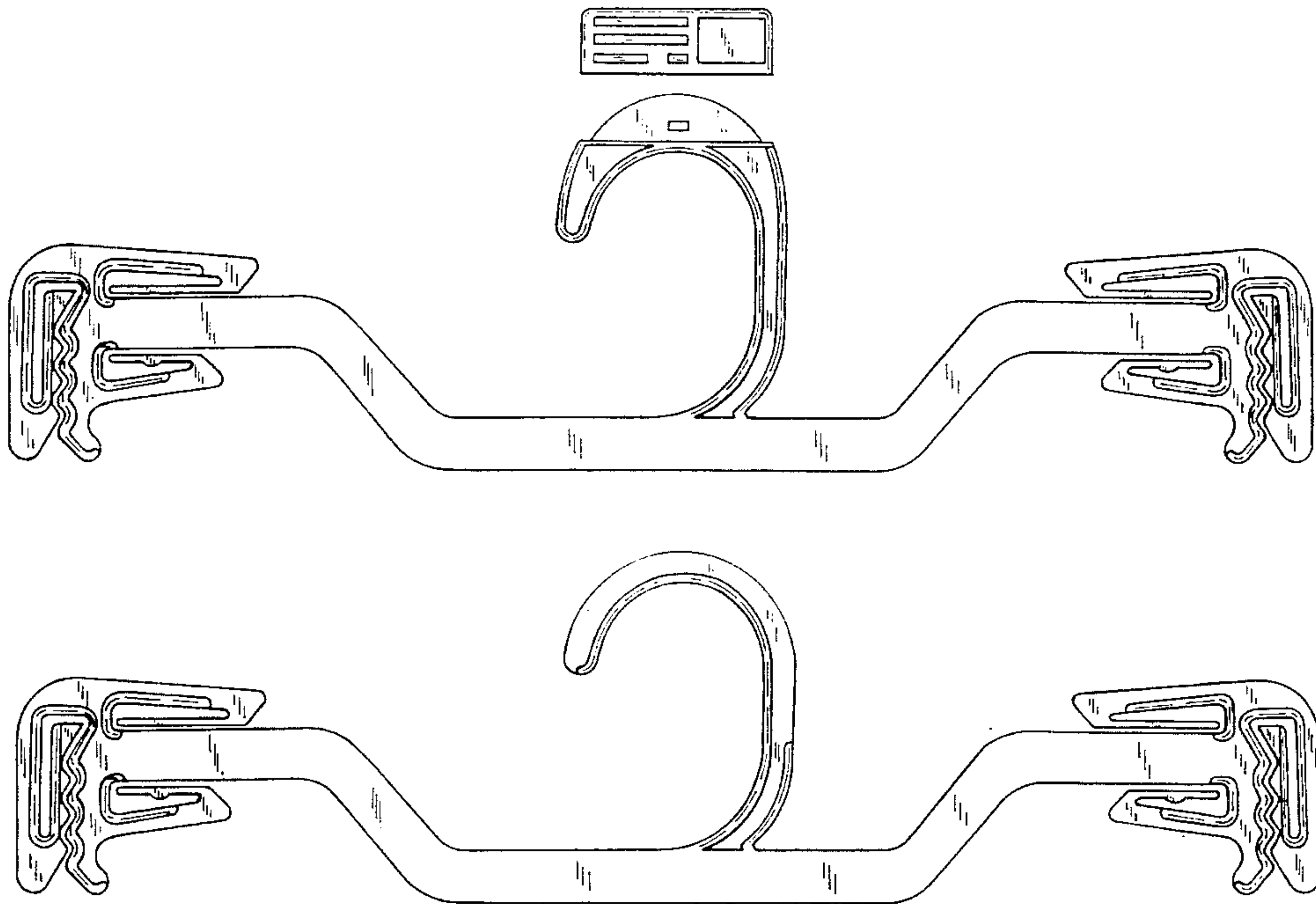
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of our new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a right end elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a top elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is an exploded front elevational view of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being the configuration of the hook.

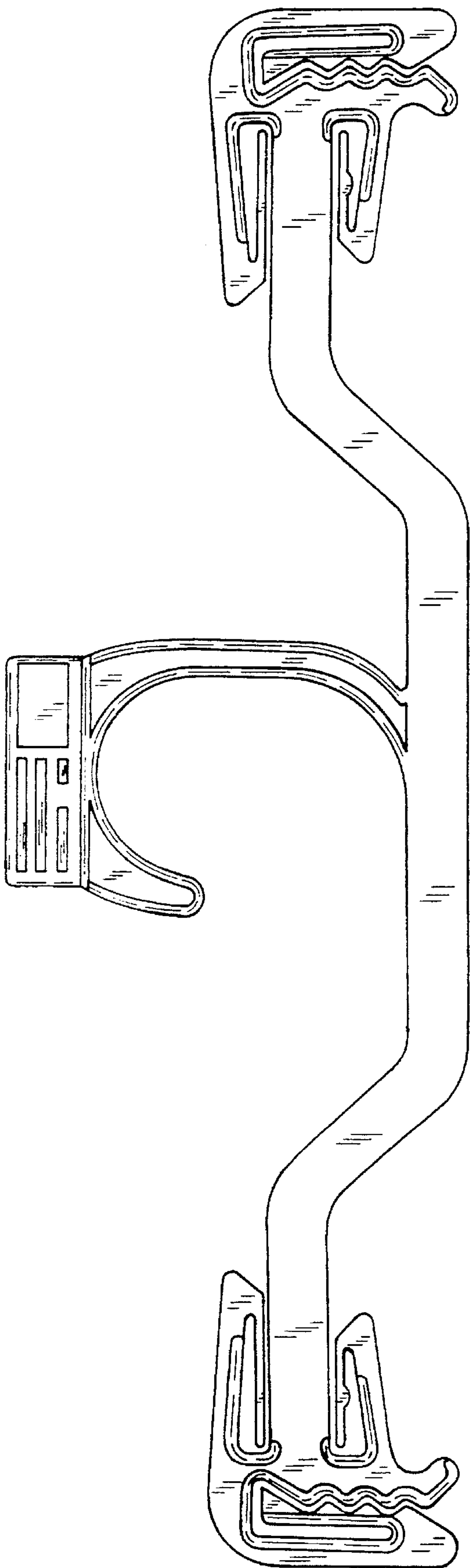

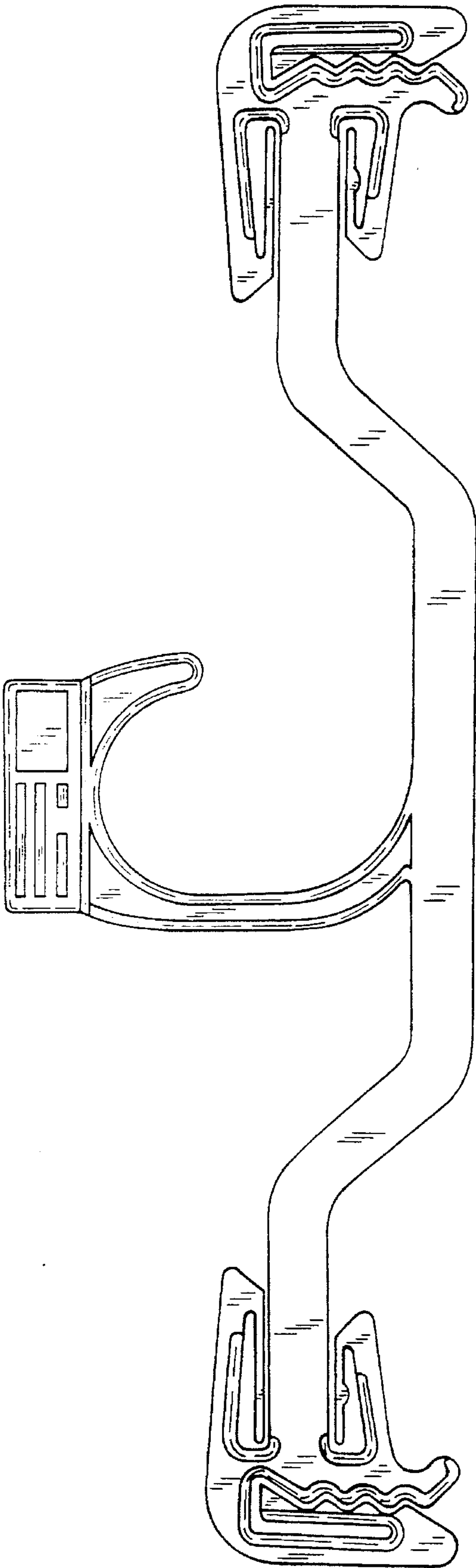

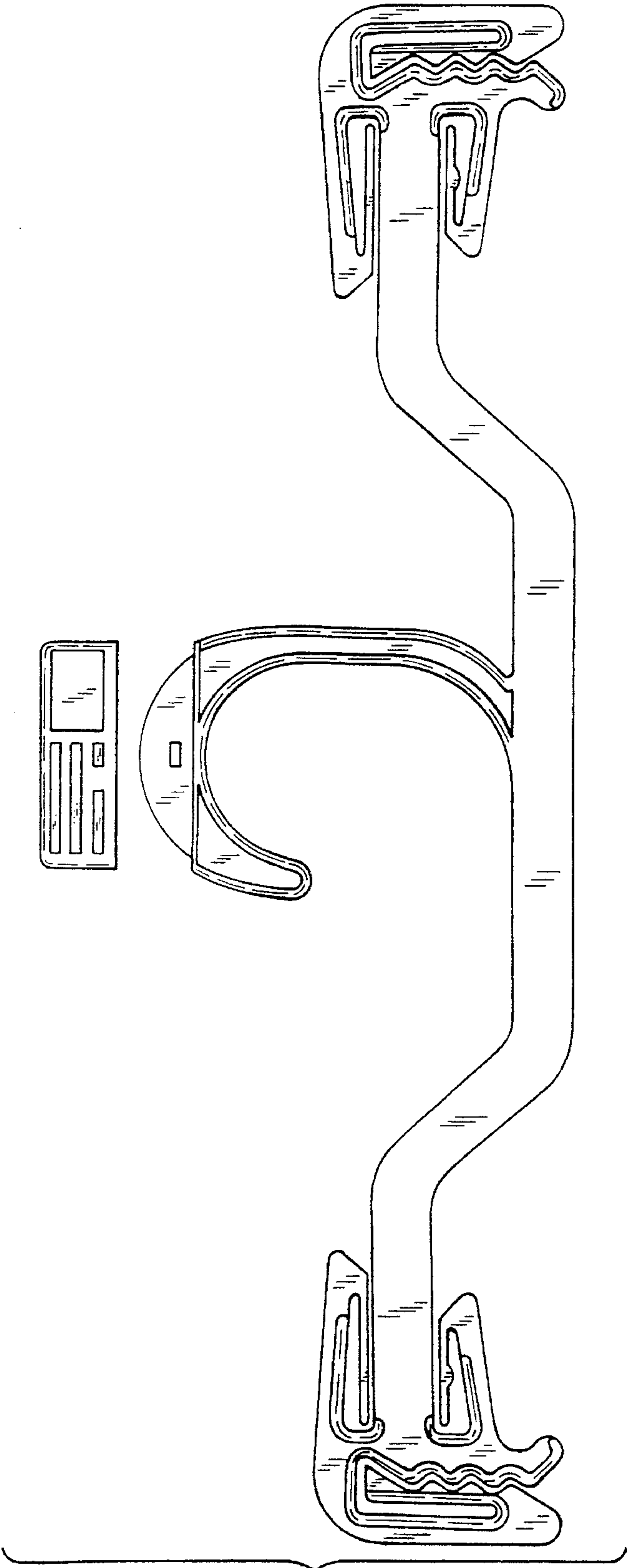

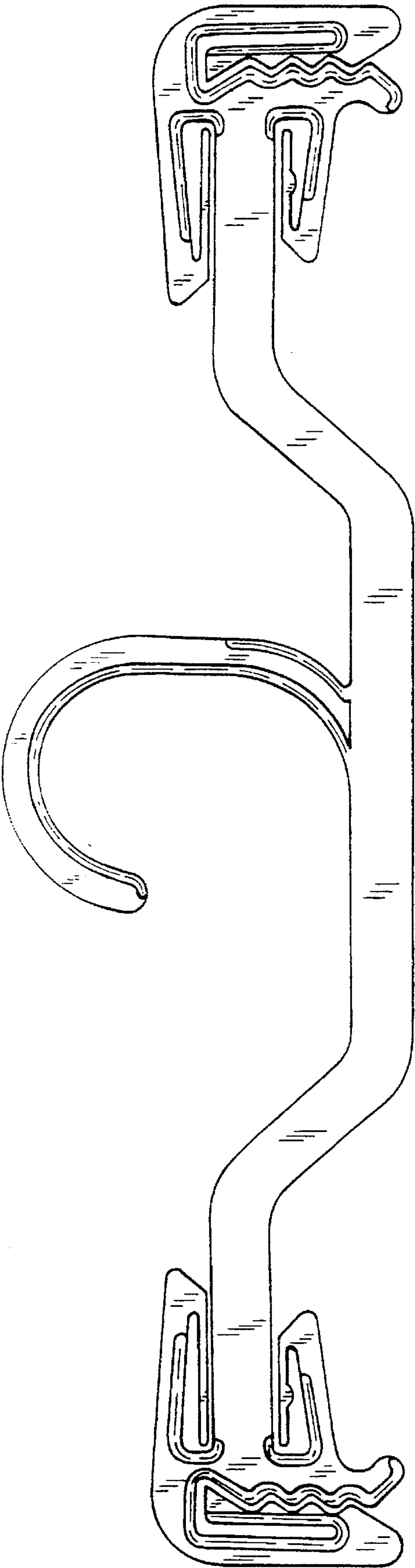
