[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a knife-handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a knife-handle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the side opposite to FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line showing of a blade and a ring in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

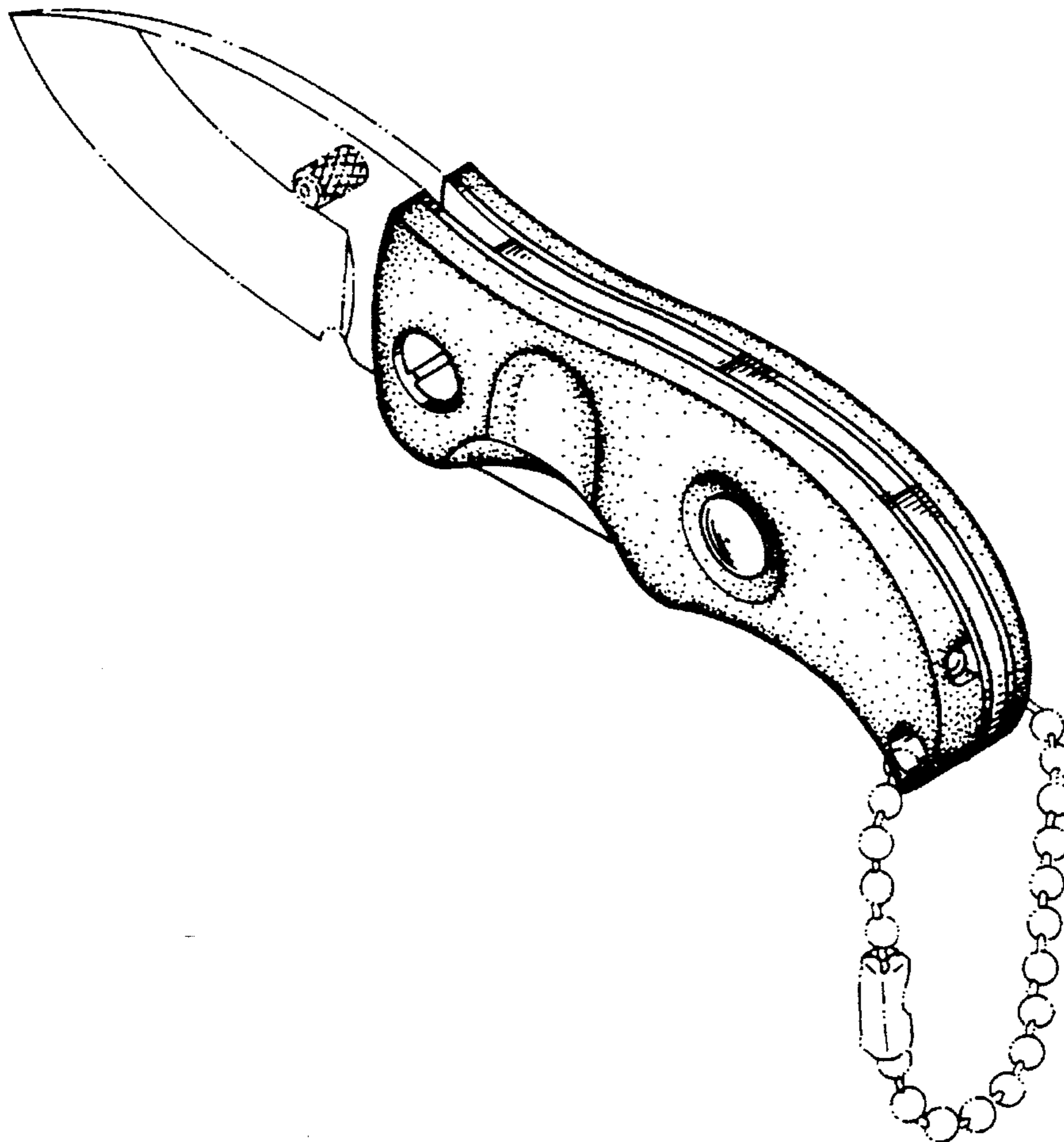

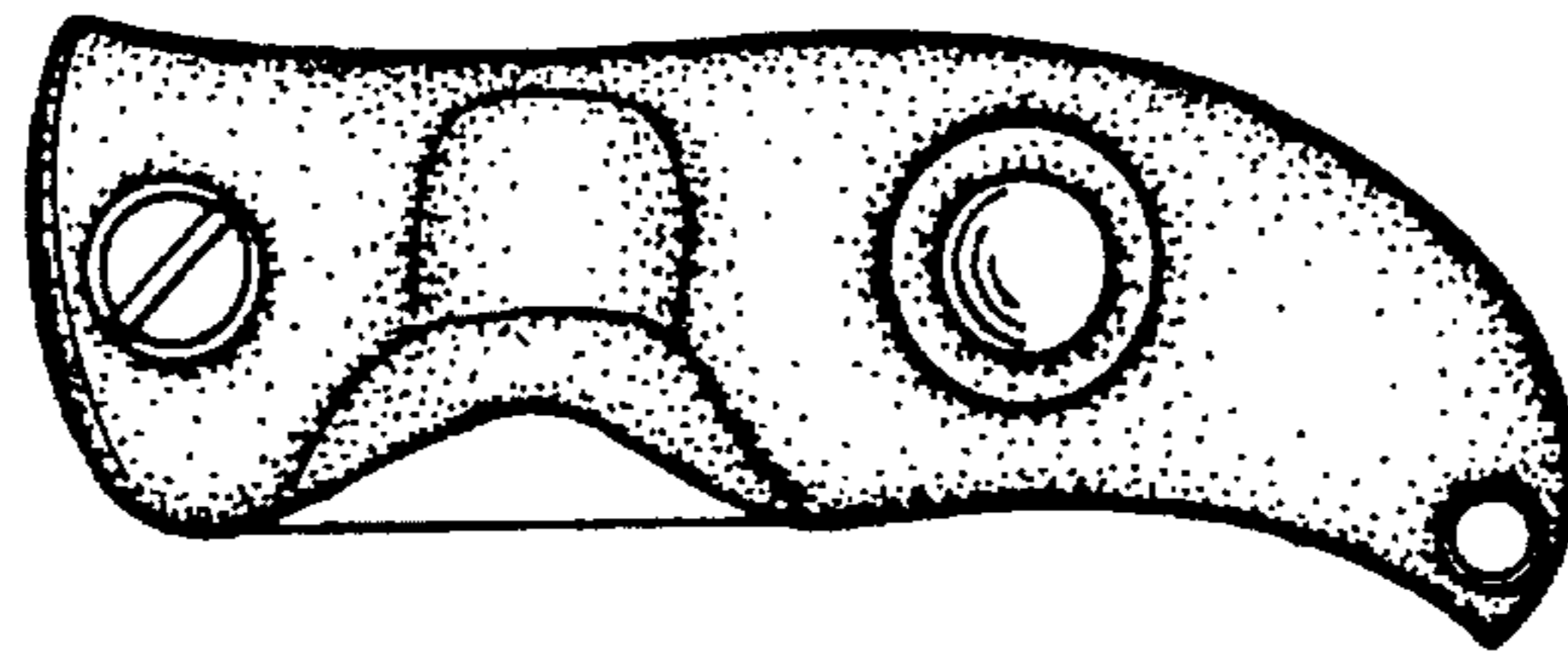

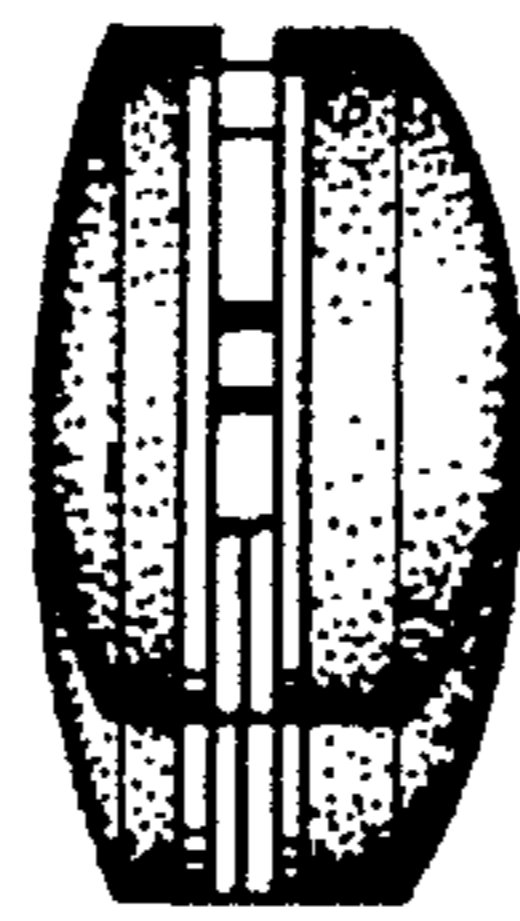

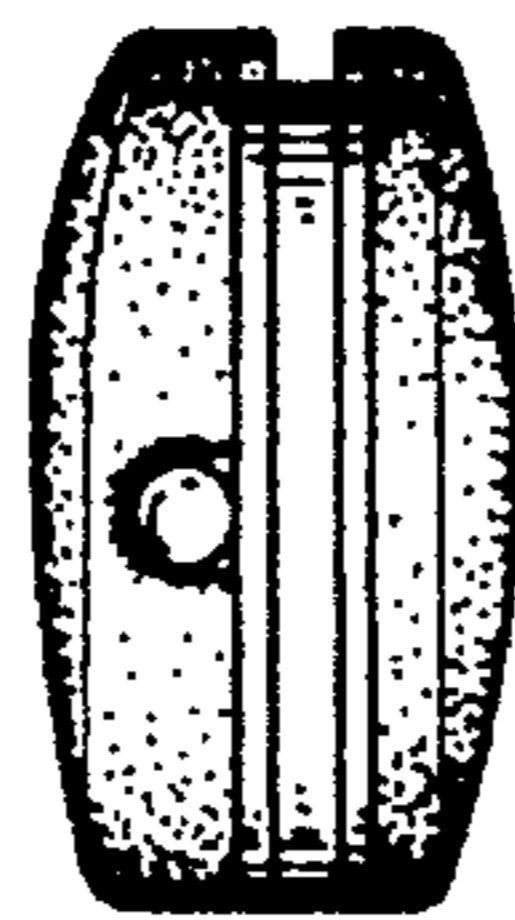

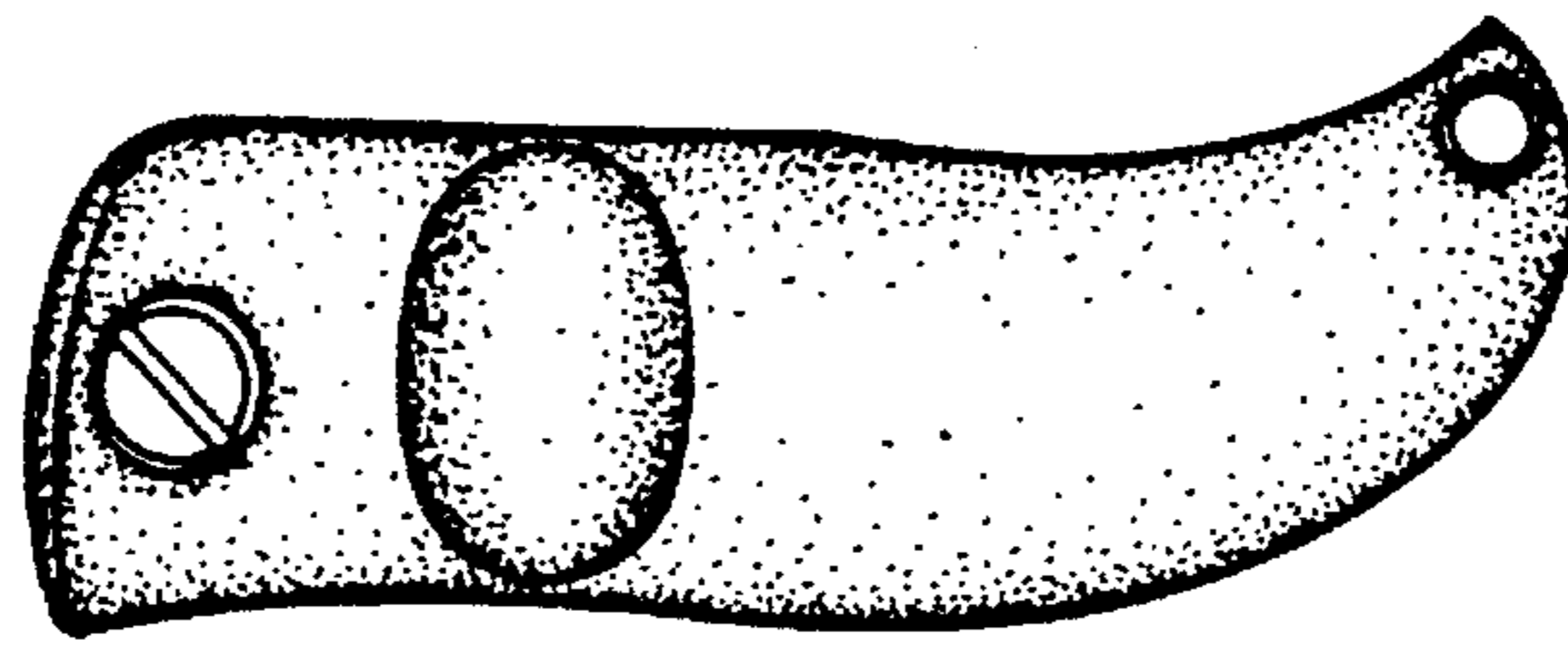

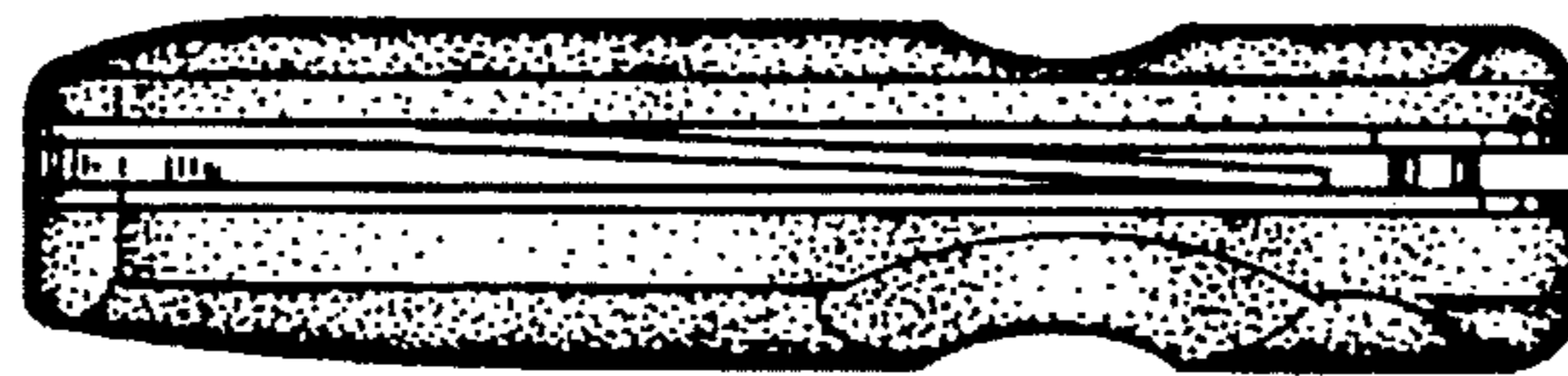

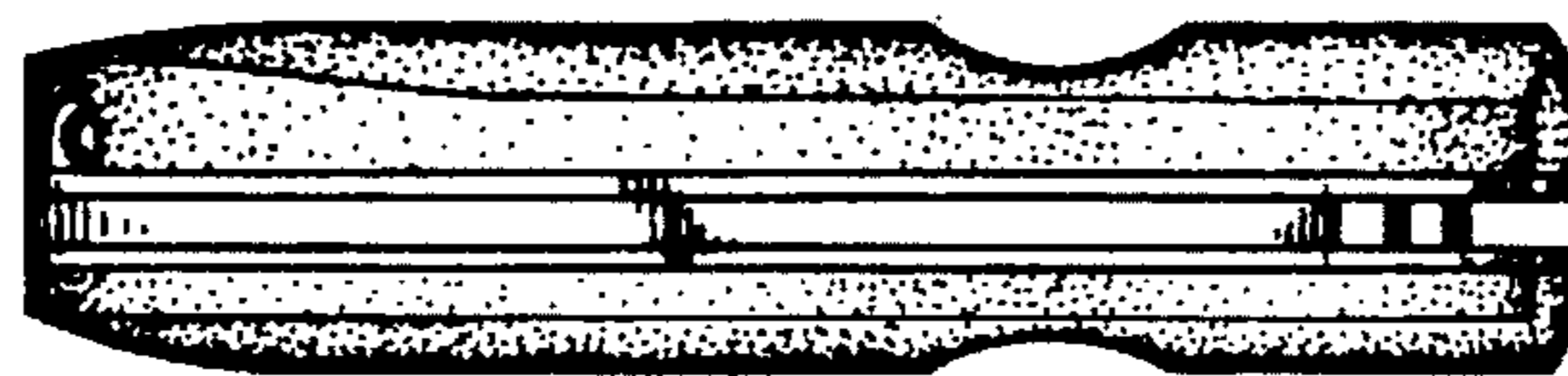
