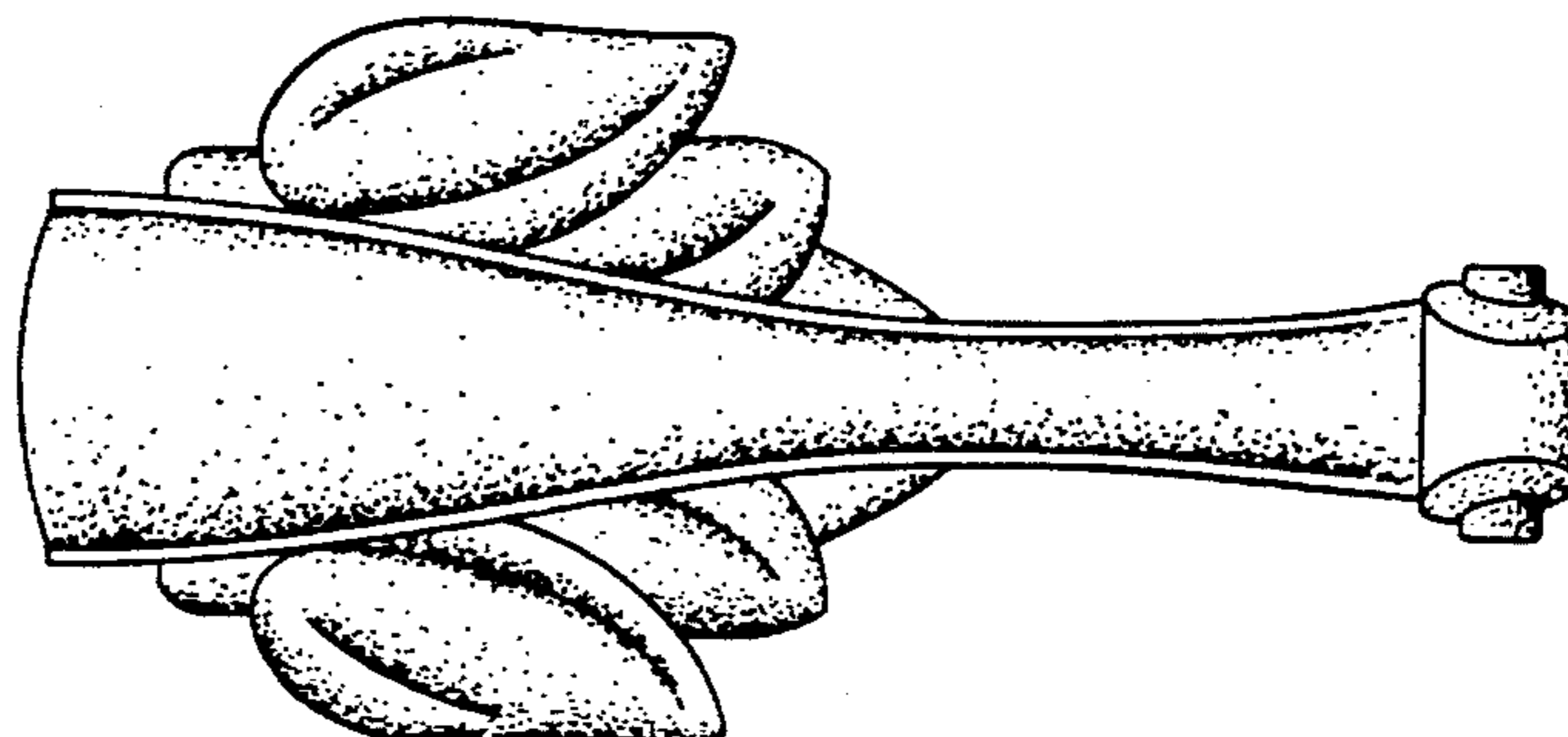
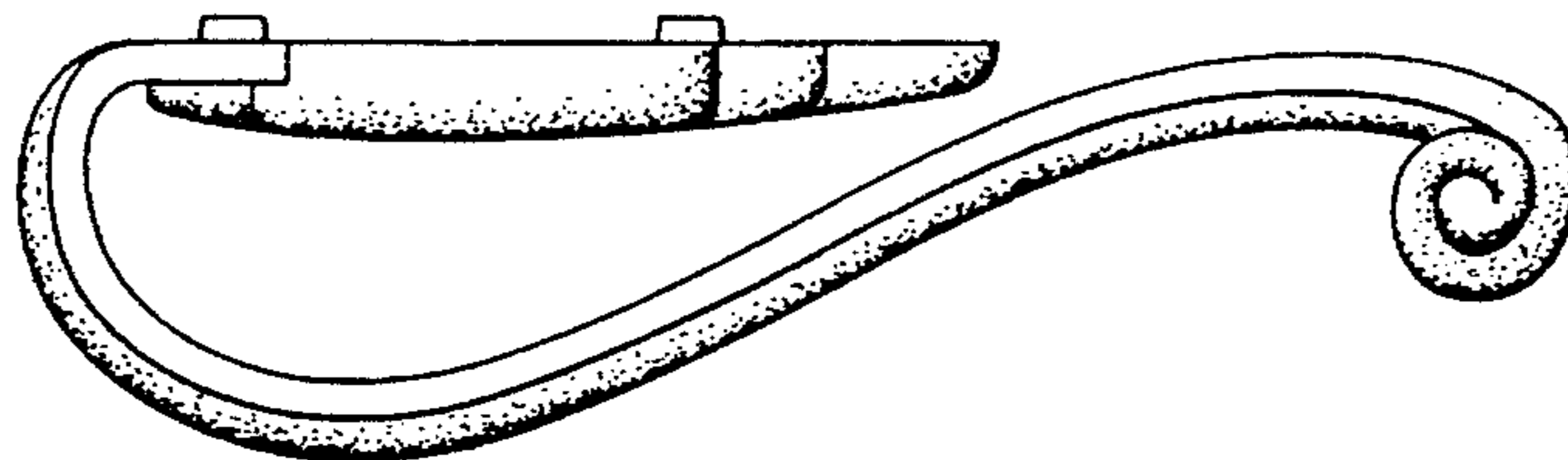
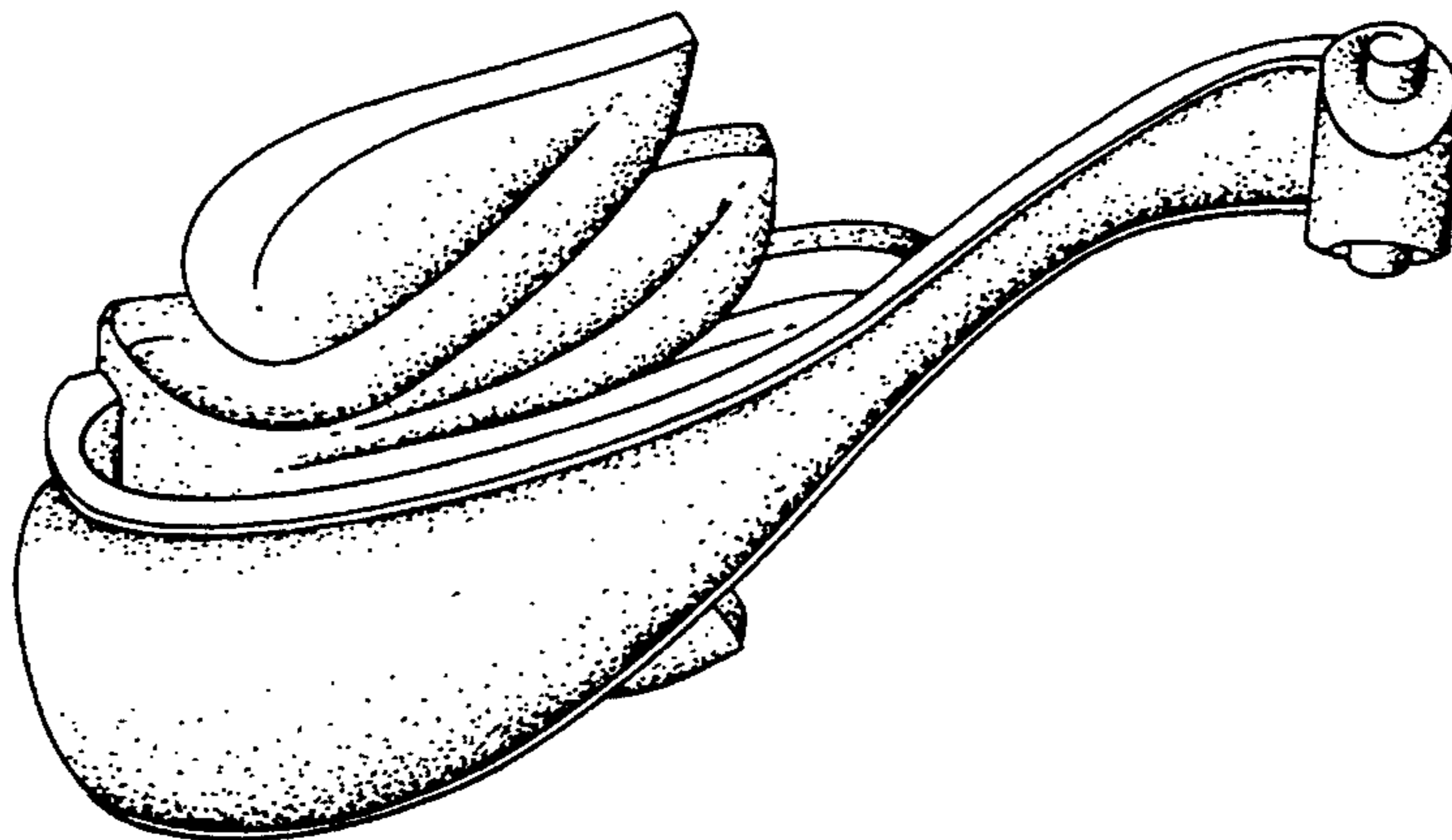
The ornamental design for a combined ceiling fan blade medallion and lower support arm, as shown.

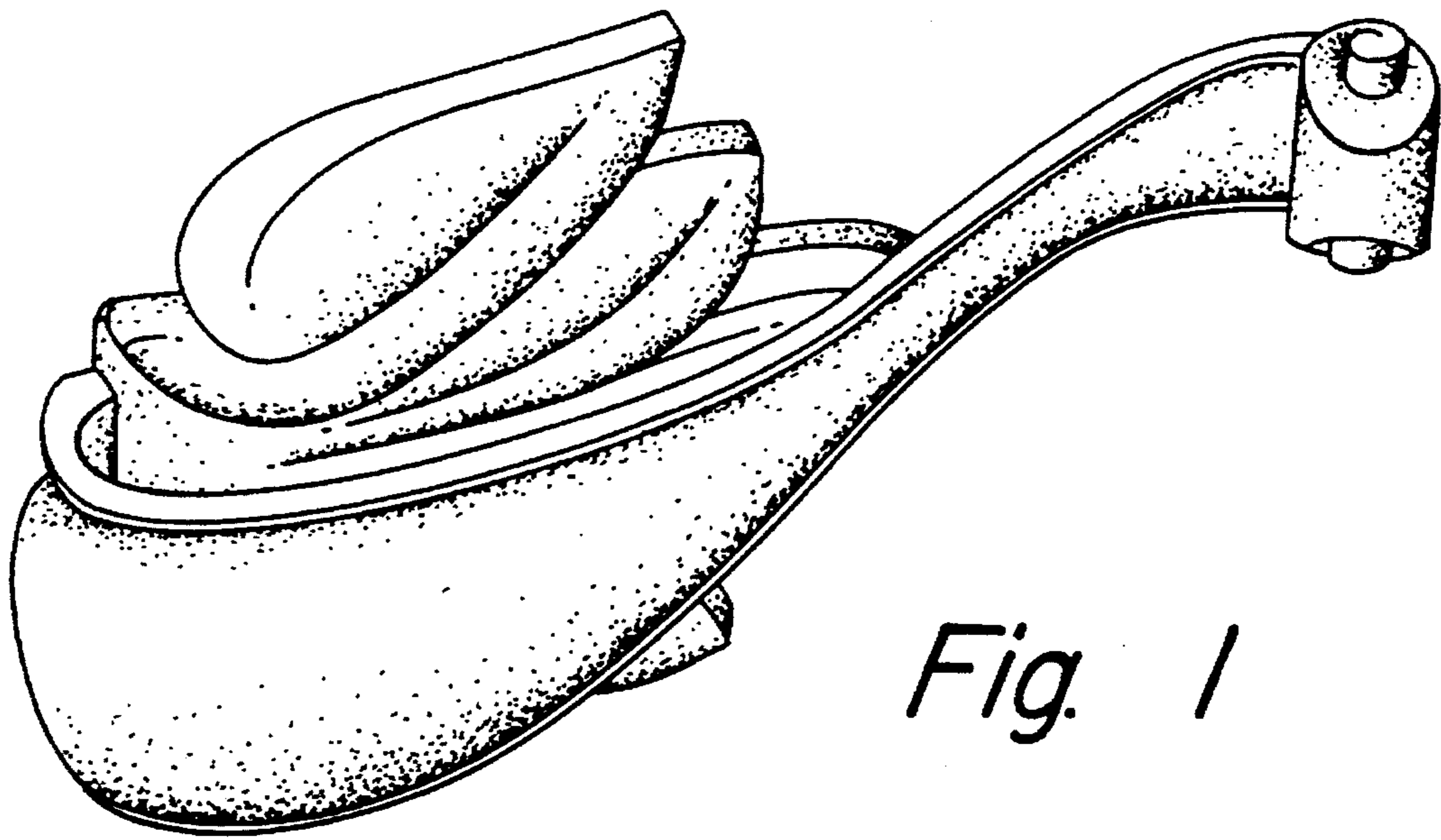

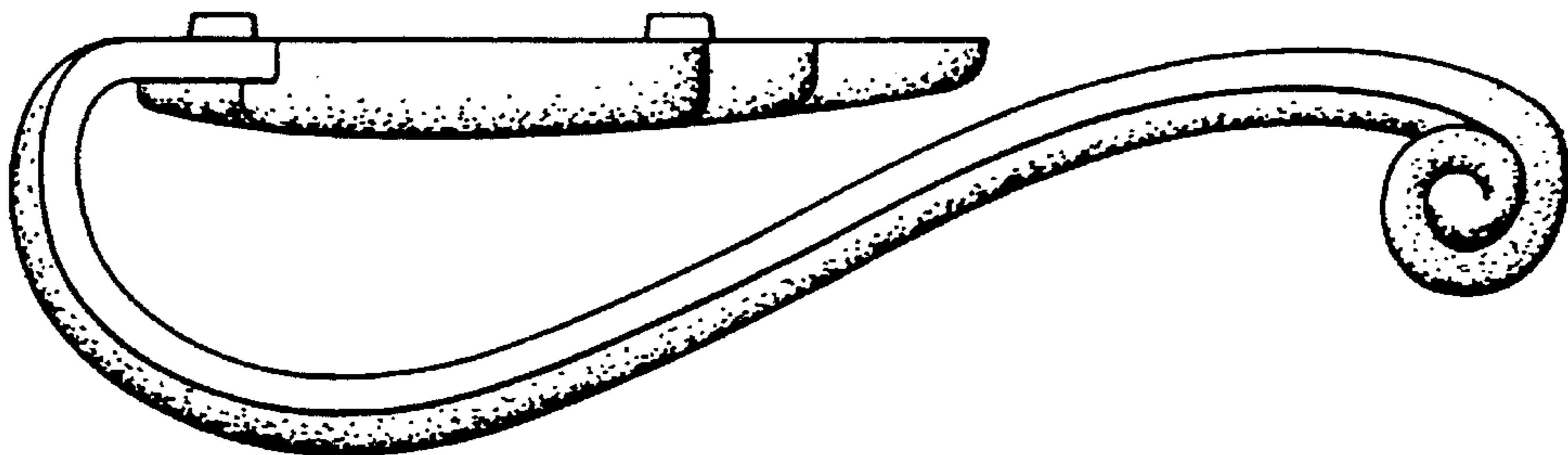

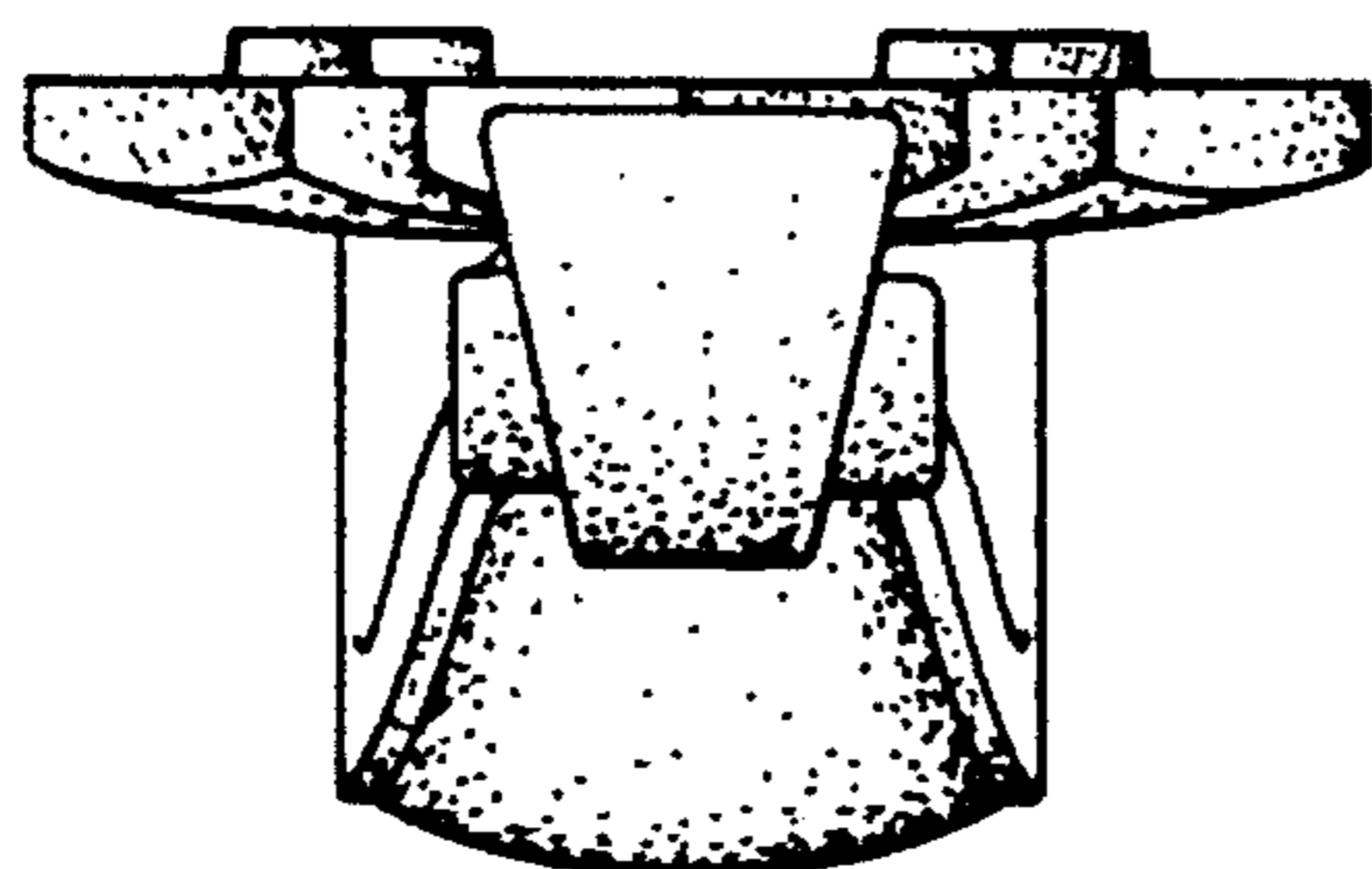

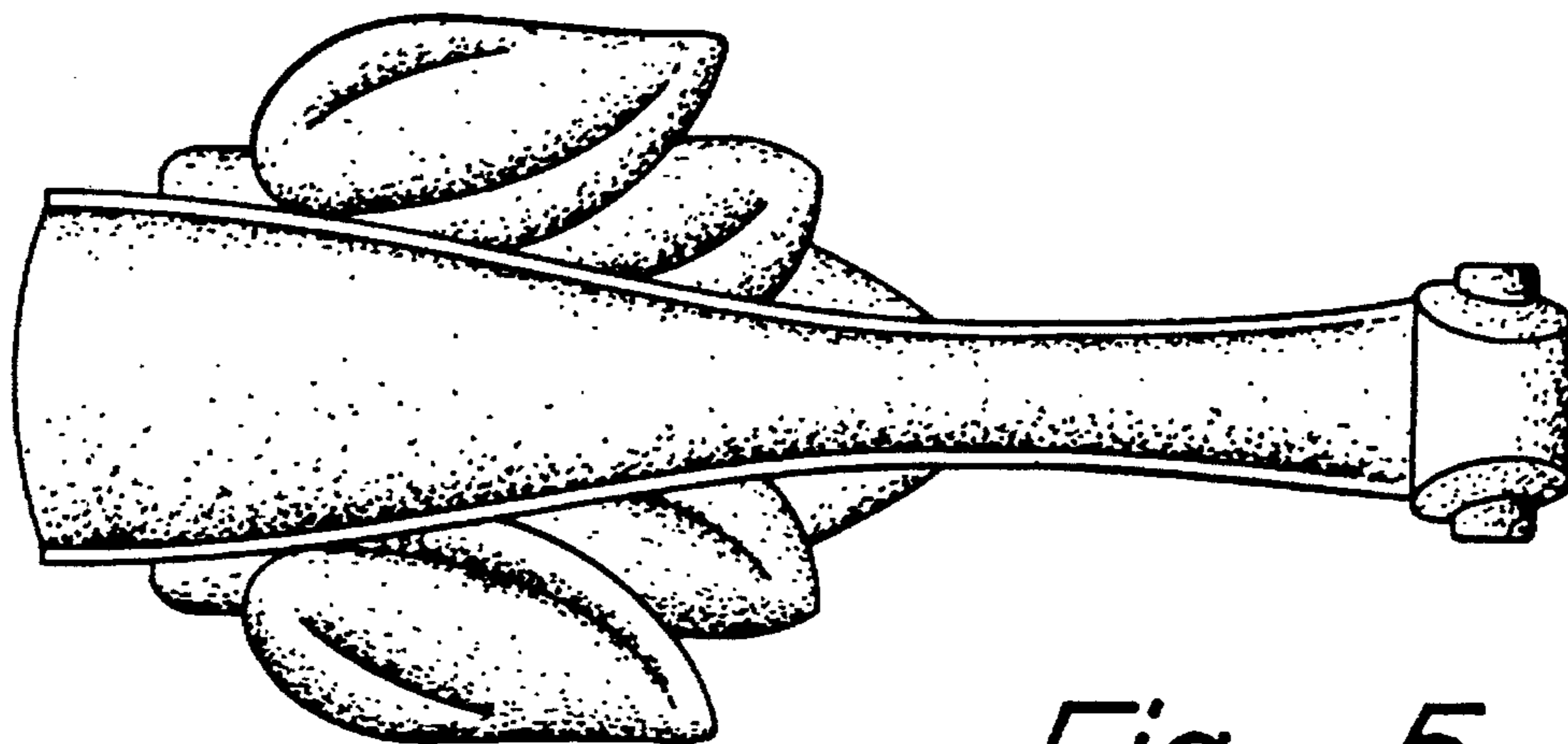
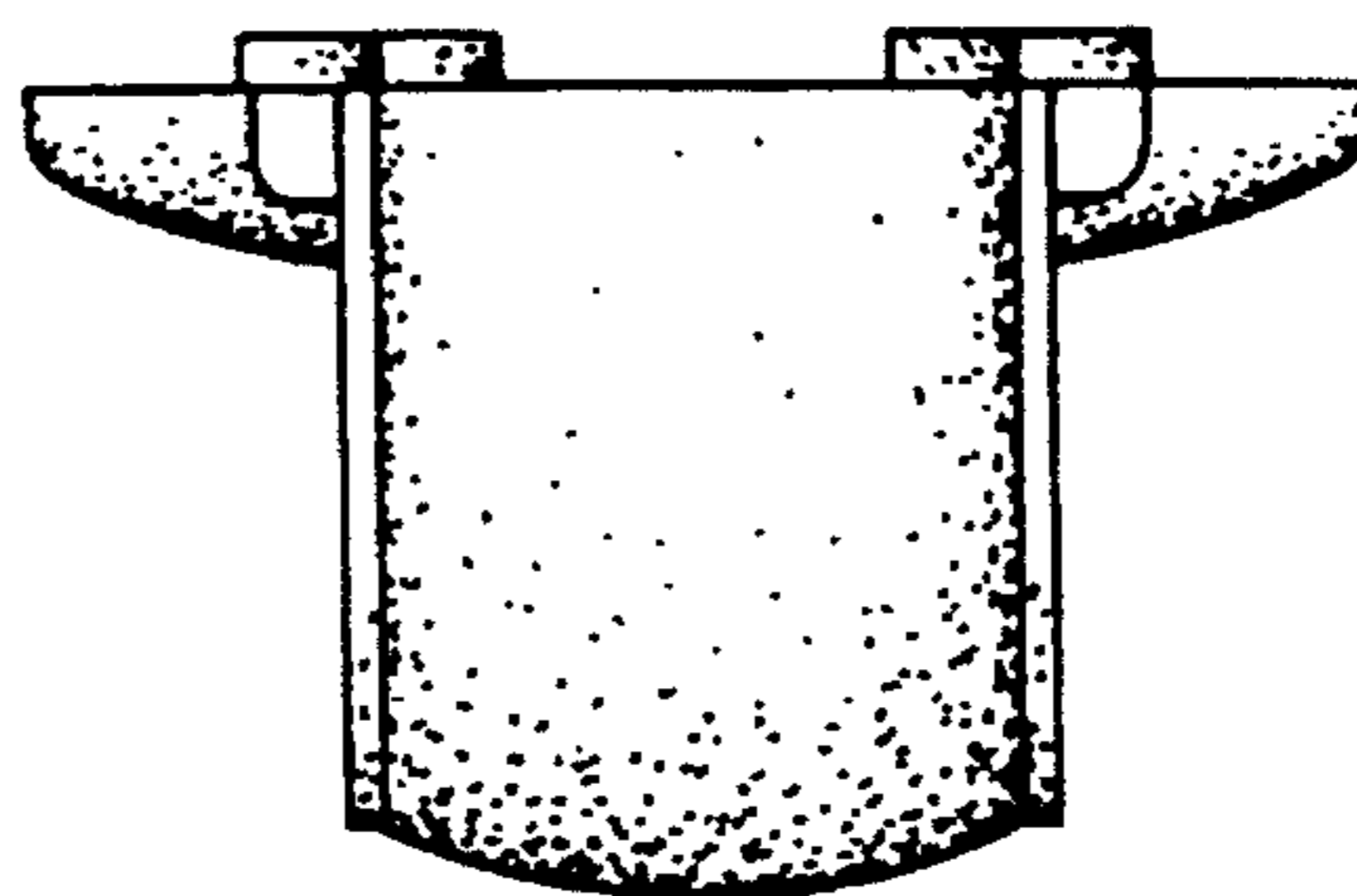

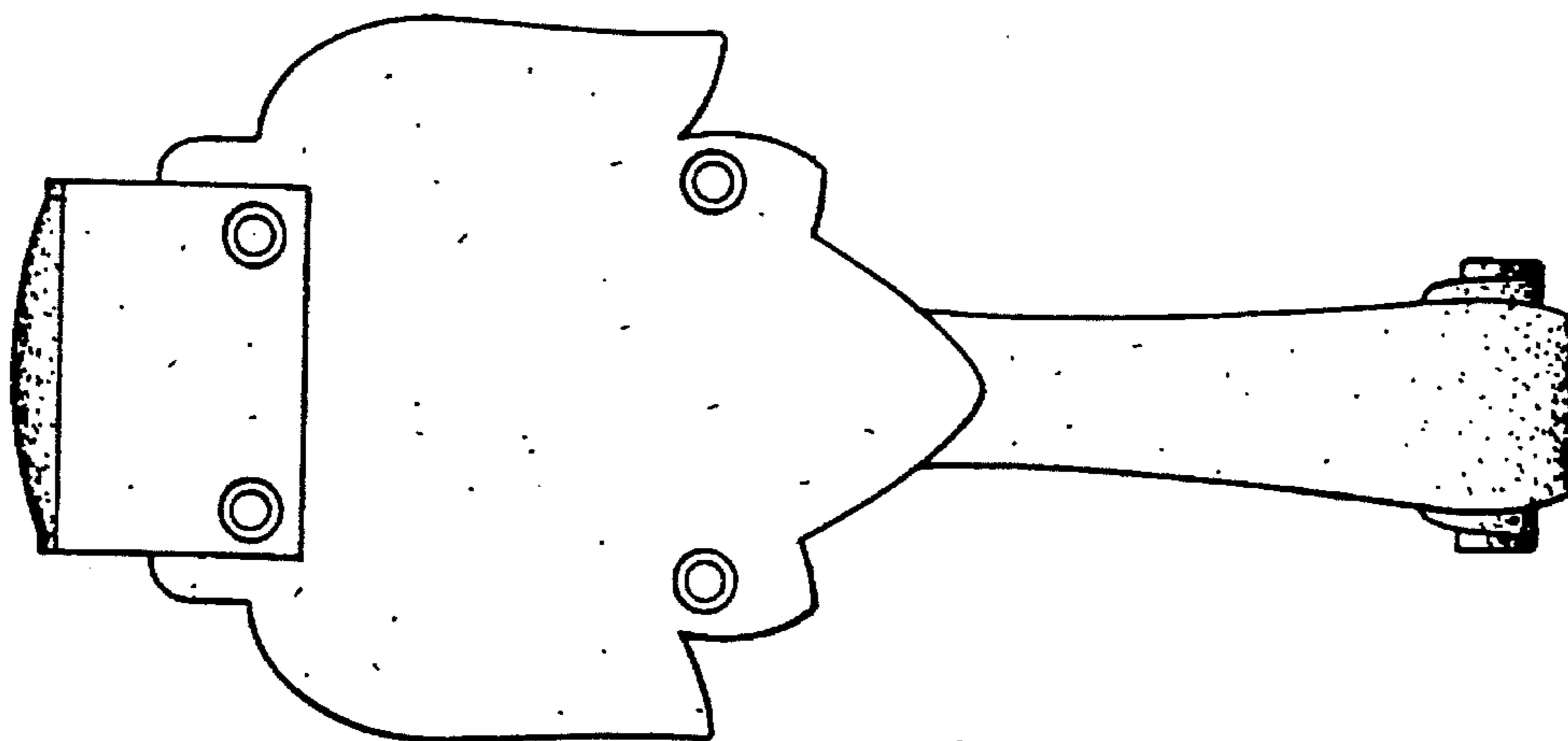
