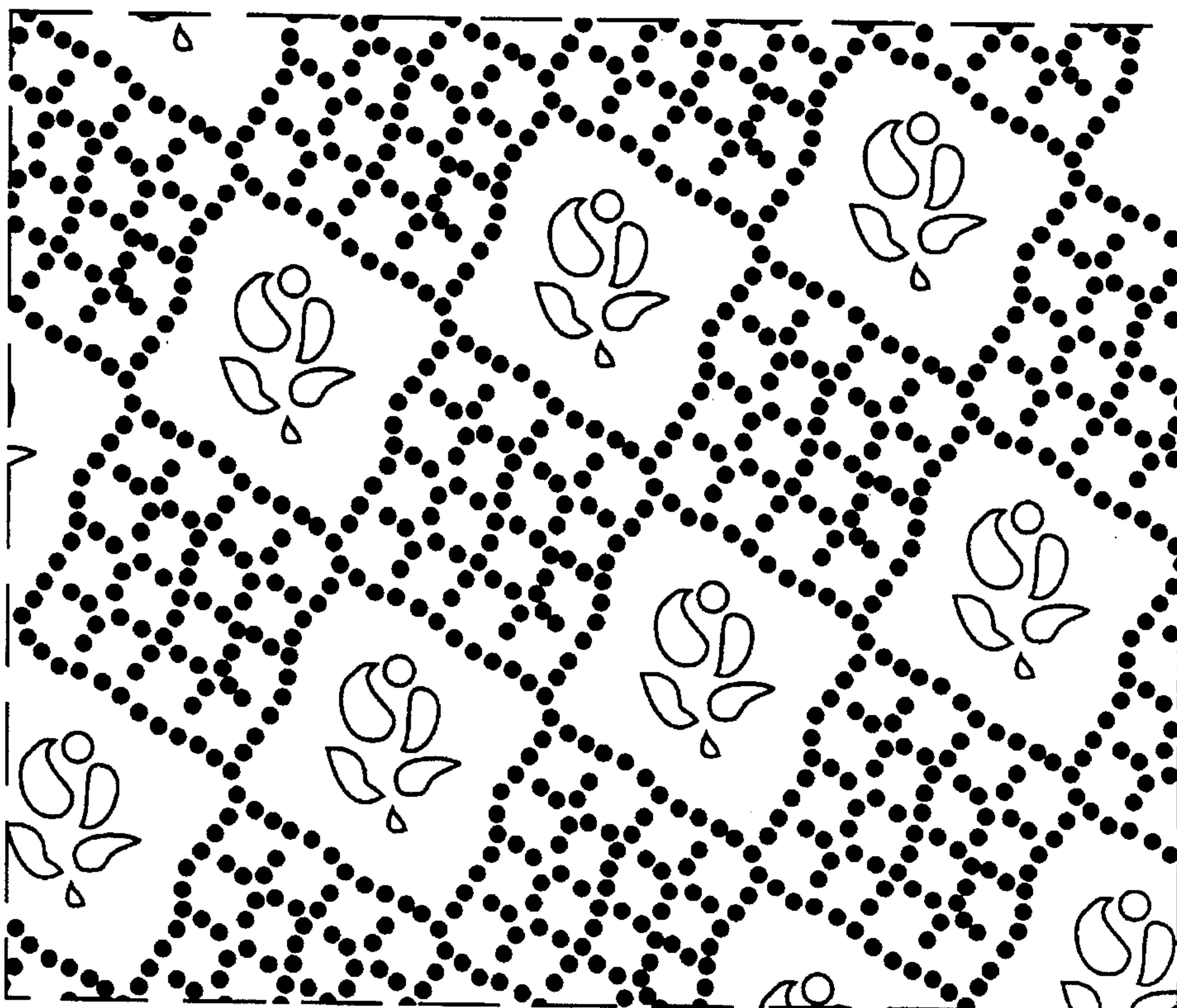
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an embossed paper product embodying my design;

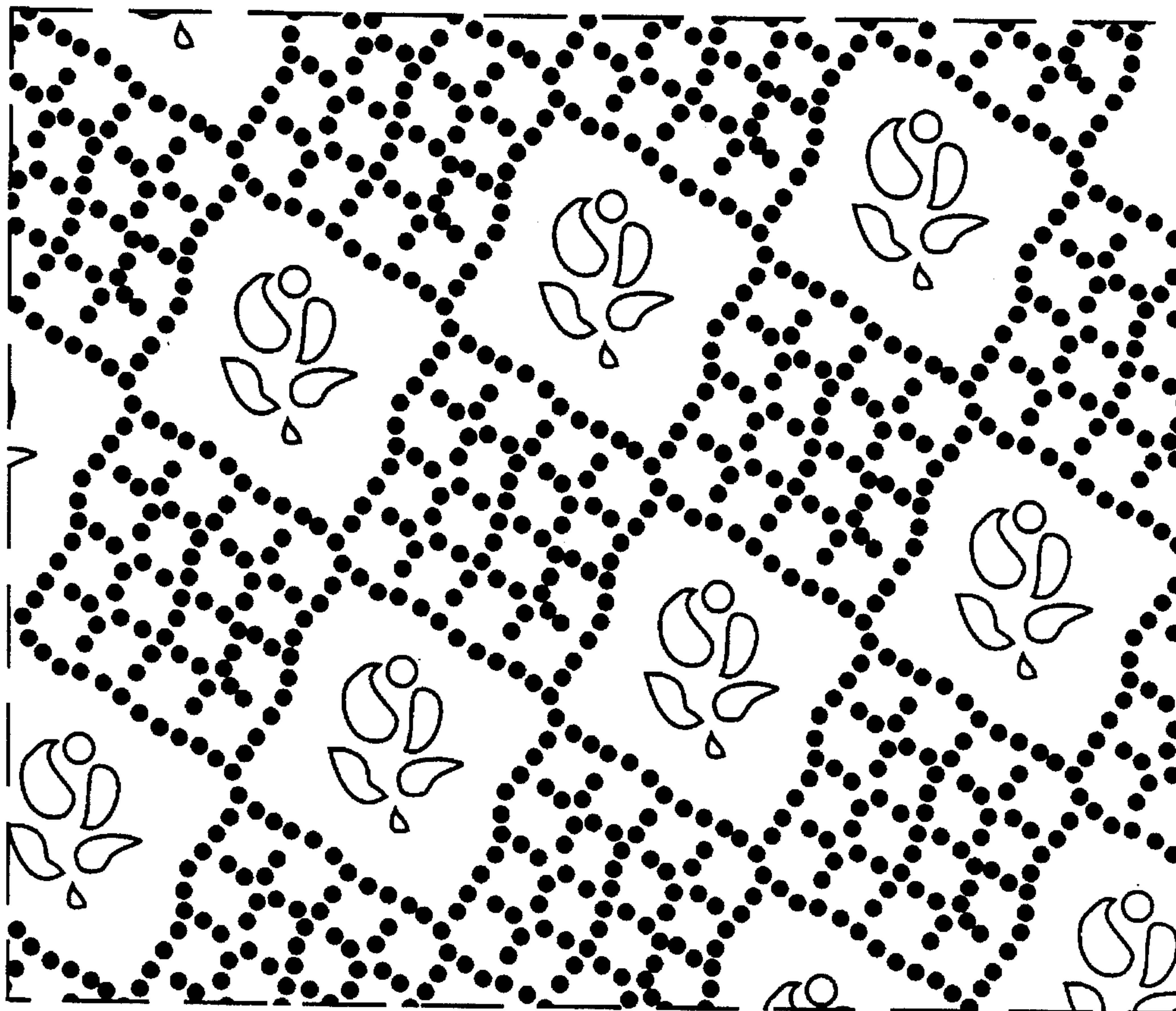

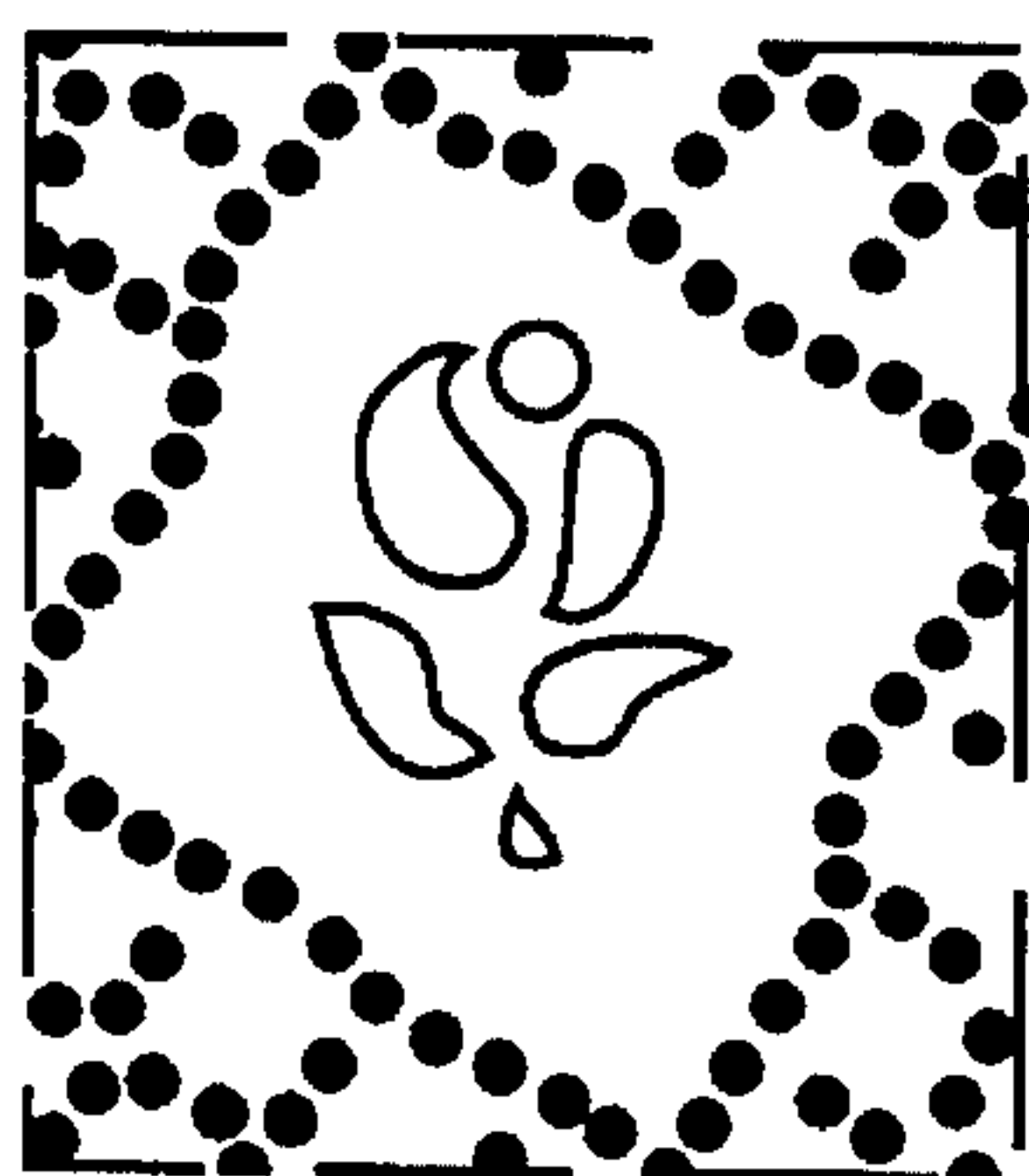

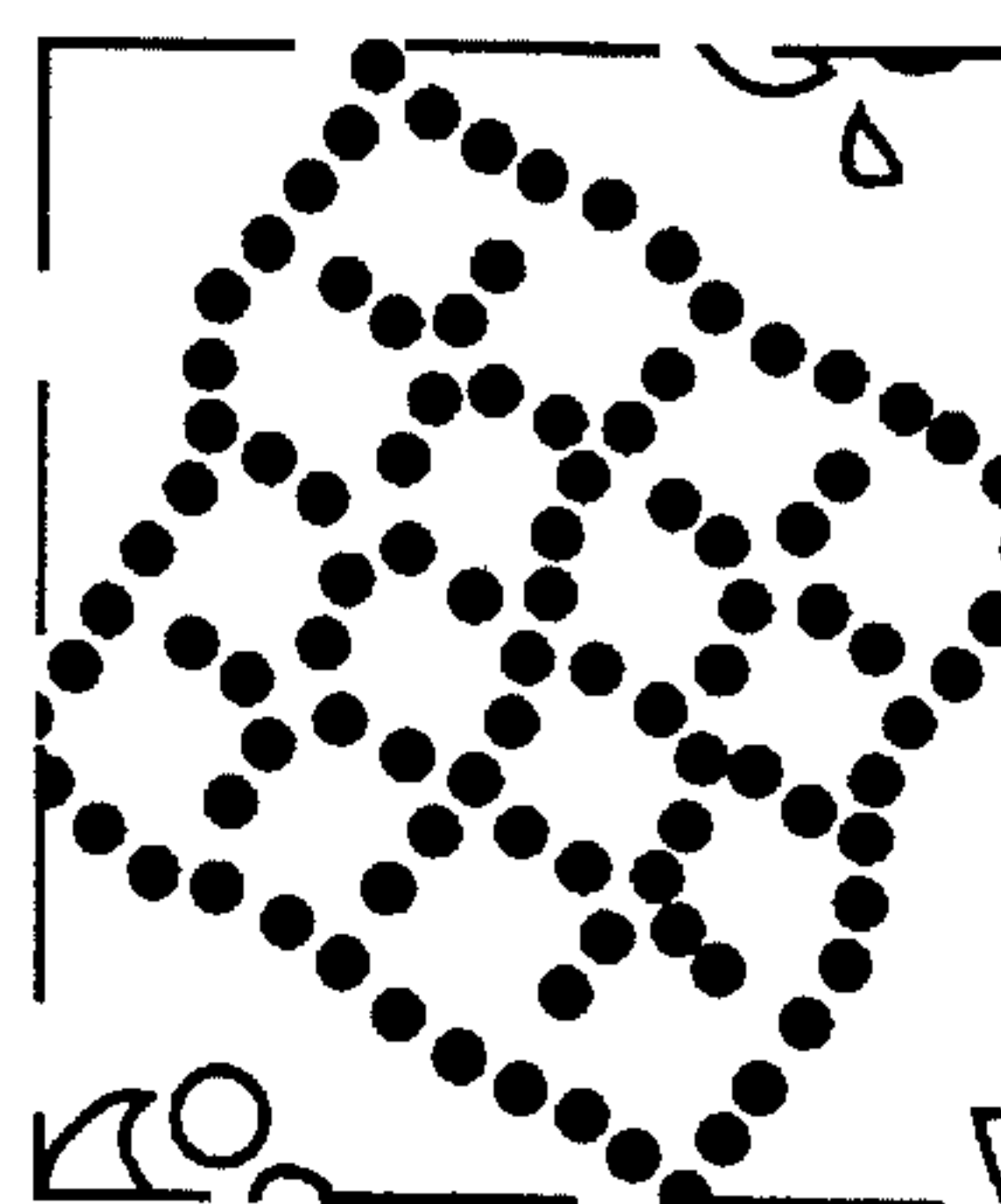
