rnamental design for a writing instrument, as shown escribed.

DESCRIPTION

1 is a front isometric view of a writing instrument ng my new design;

2 is a side view with the cap removed thereof;

3 is a front elevational view;

4 is a rear elevational view;

5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

8 is a top plan view thereof;

9 is a front isometric view of an alternative embodiof a writing instrument showing my new design;

13 is a right side elevational view thereof;


14 is a left side elevational view thereof;


15 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,




haracteristic feature of the design resides in the particularly configured clip member in in combination with the writing instrument body shown, as best illustrated in FIGS. 1 and 9.

















