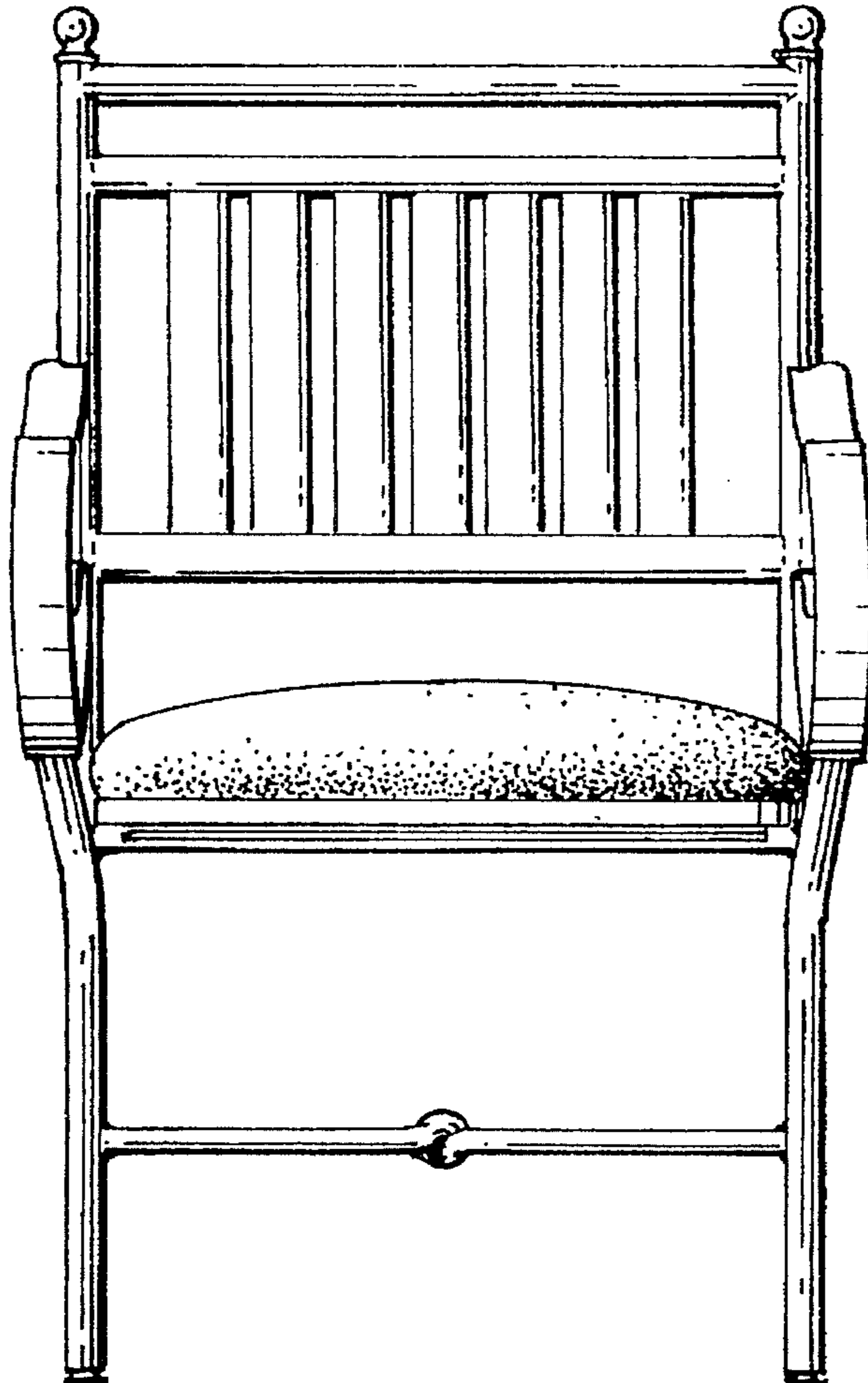
The fragmented depiction of fabric on the bottom of the arm chair in FIG. 5 is continuous throughout.

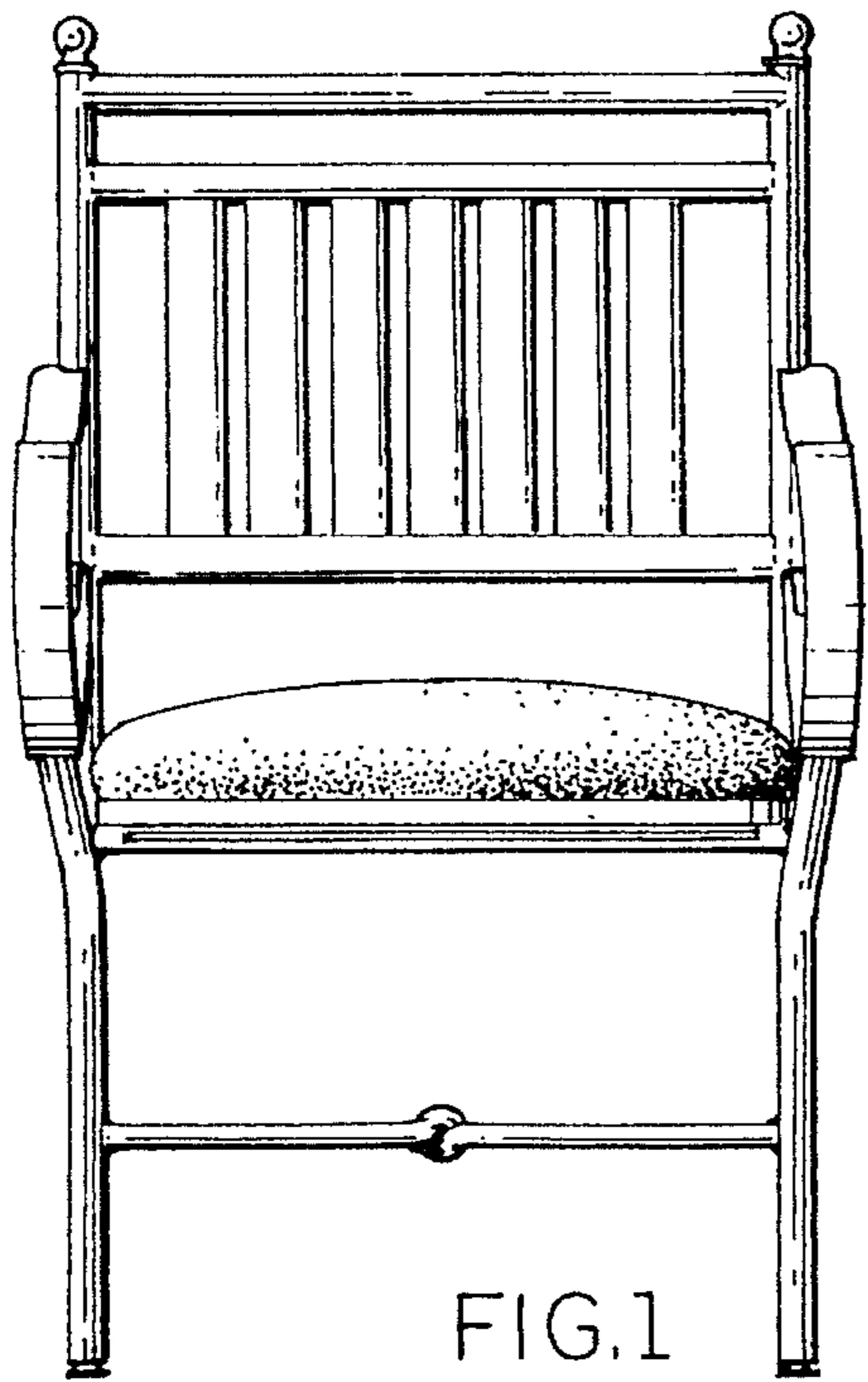

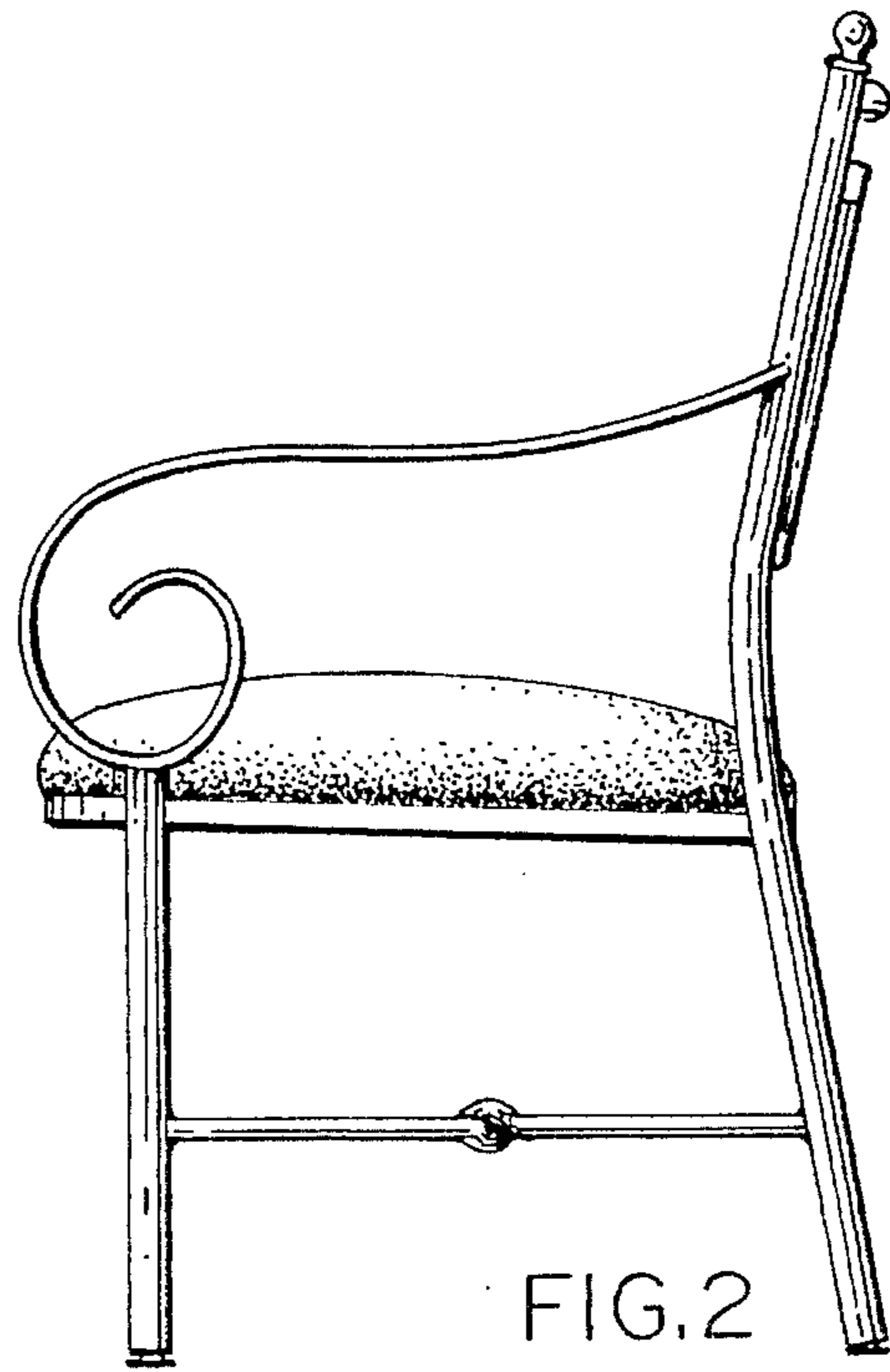

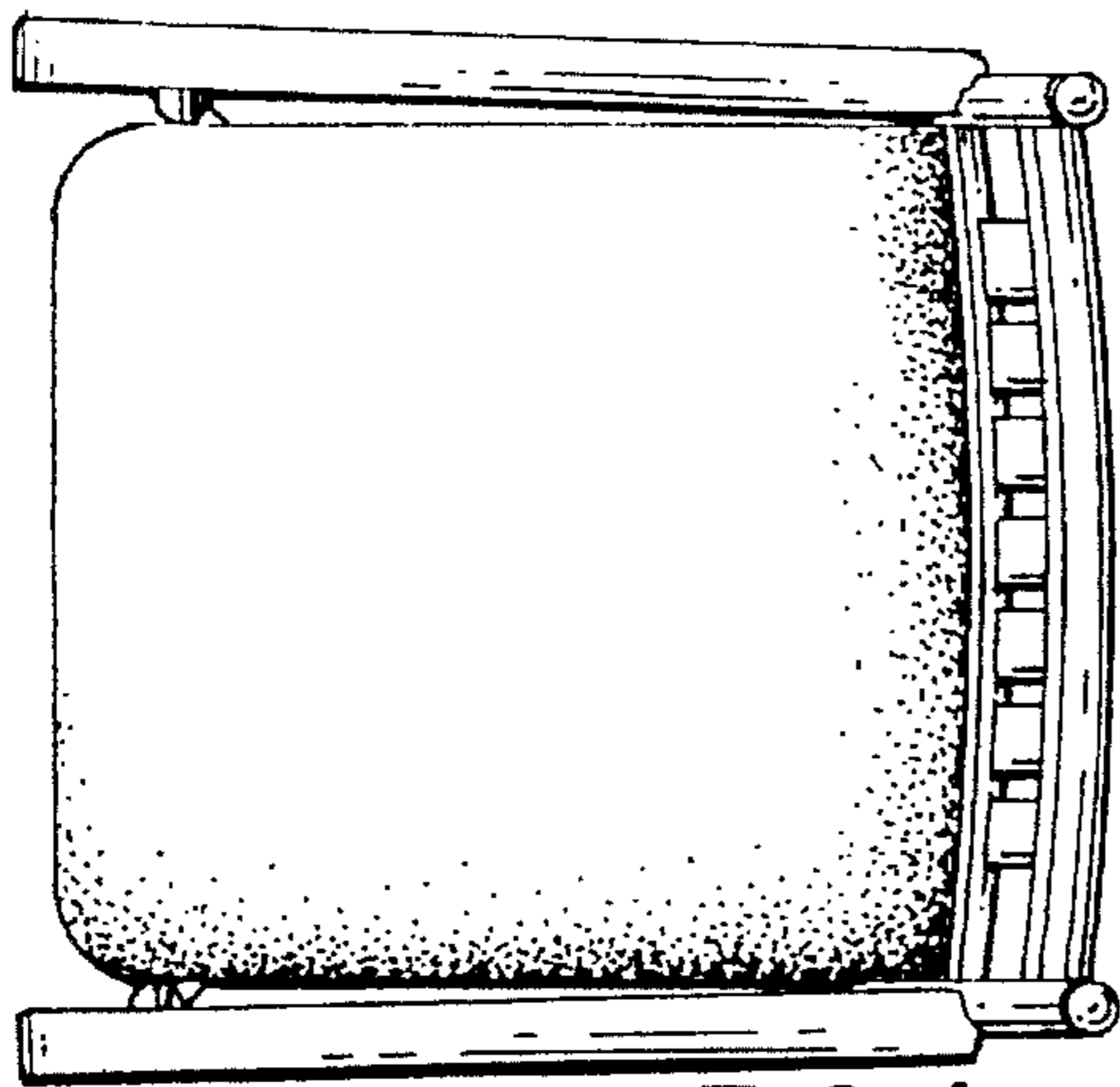

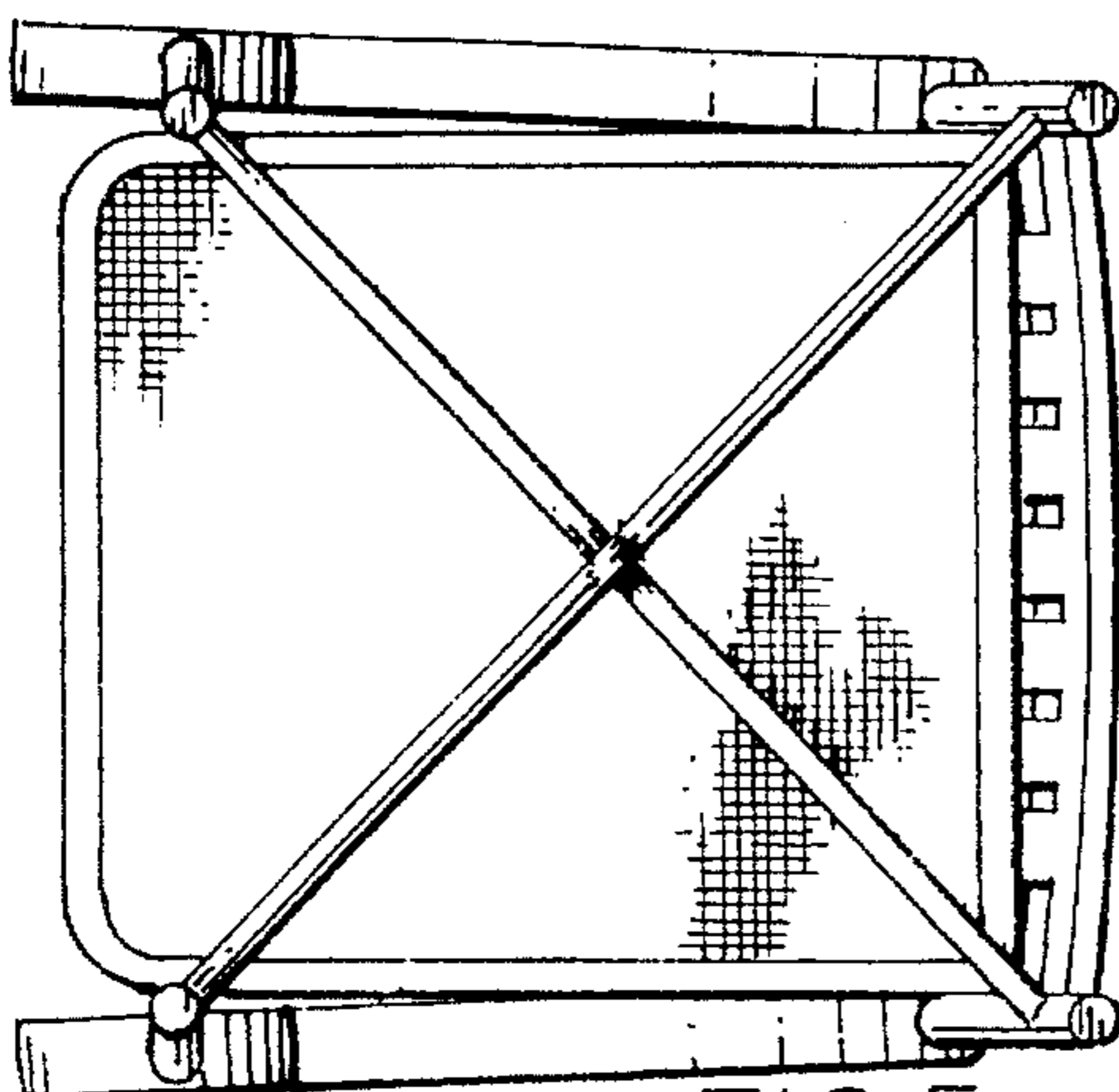

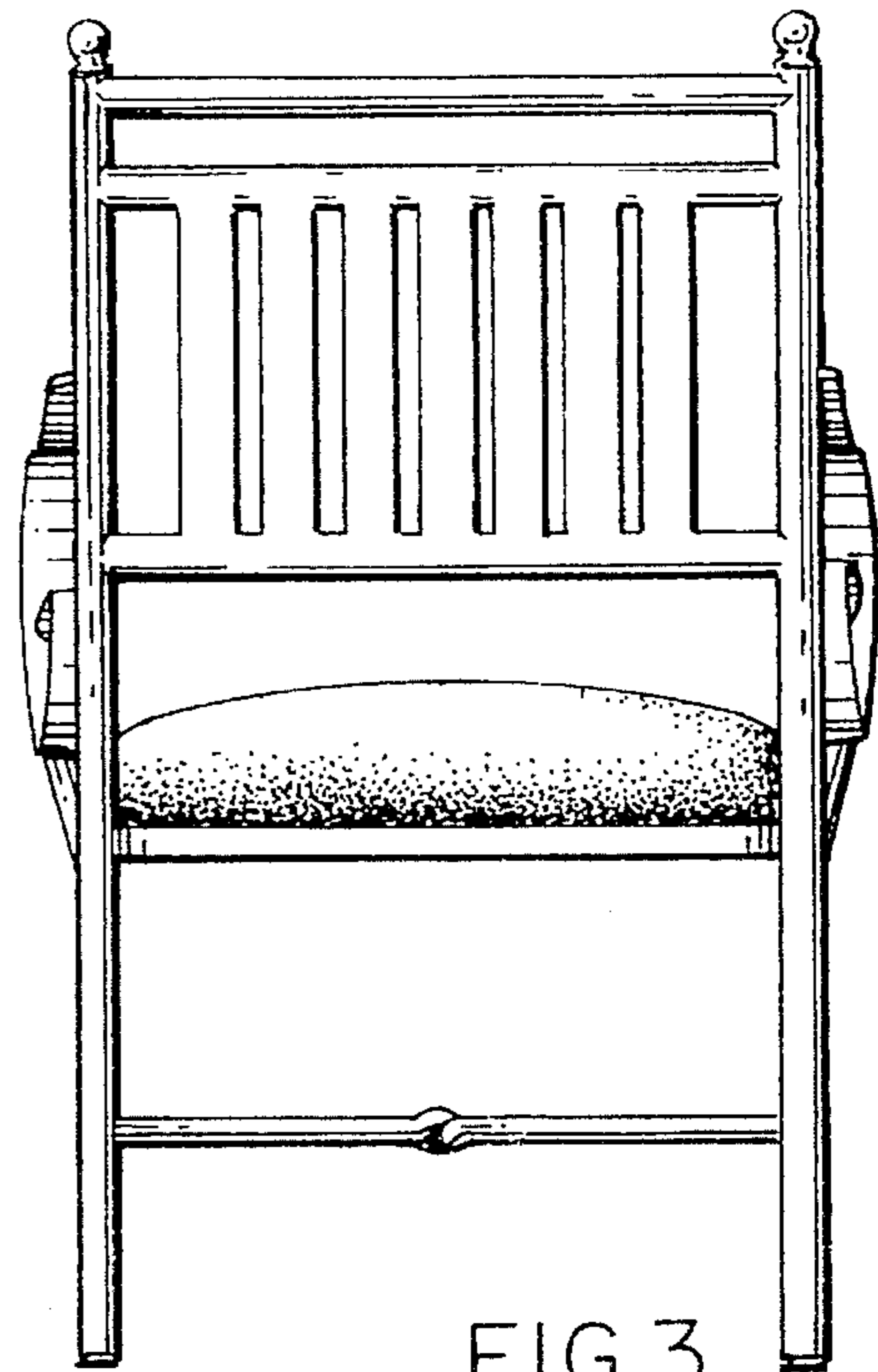
