[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a writing instrument holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a writing instrument holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top view plan thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view plan thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 3.

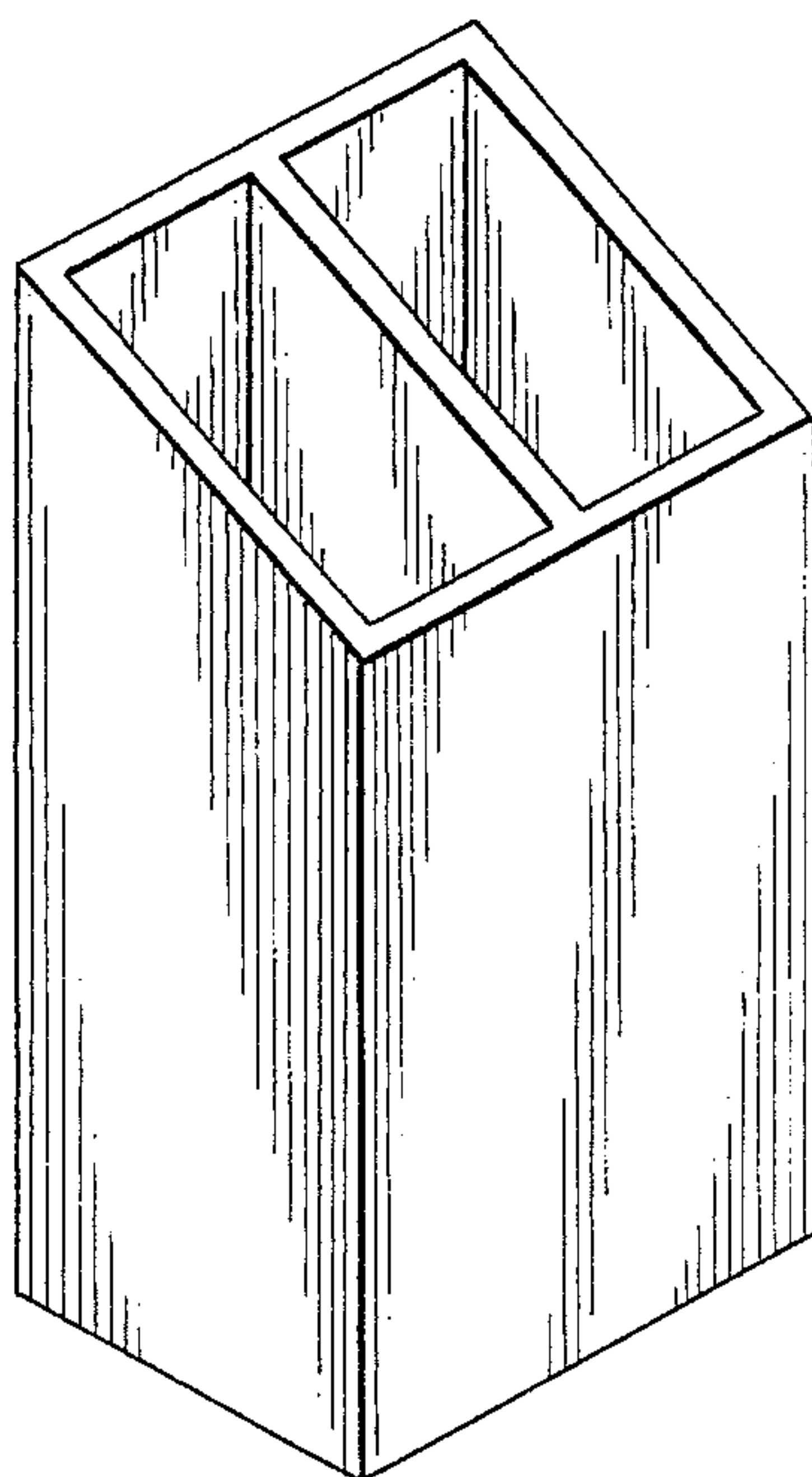

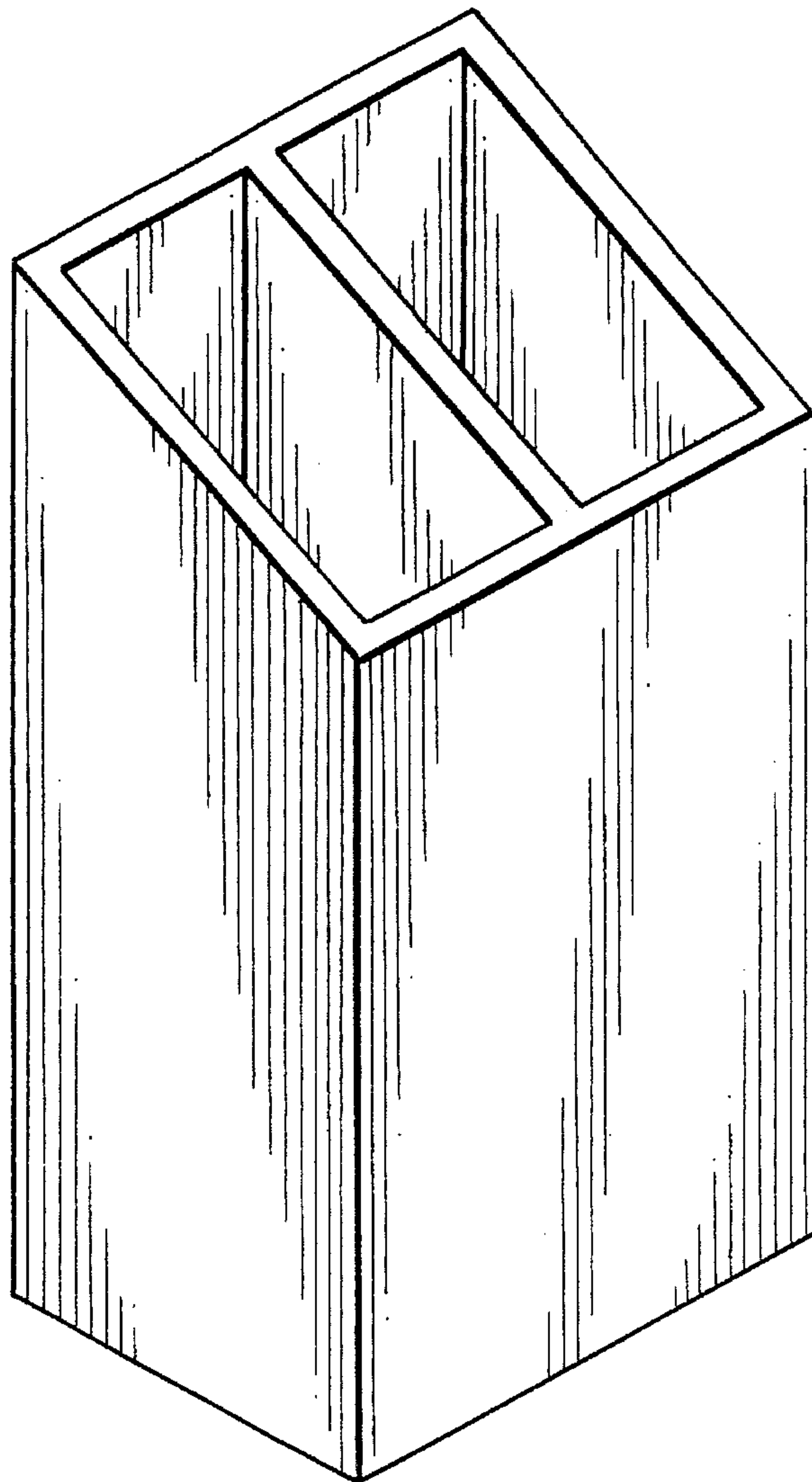

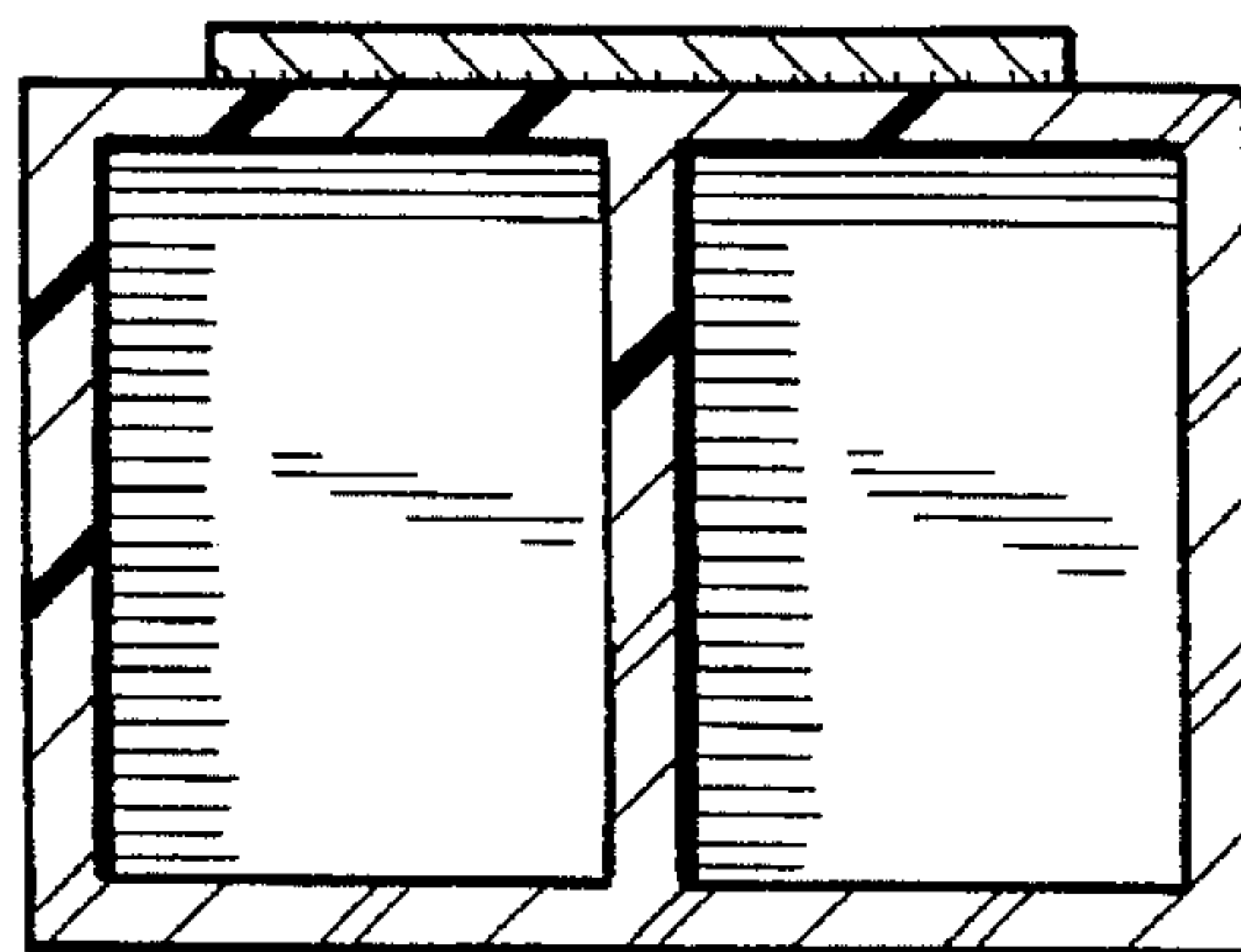

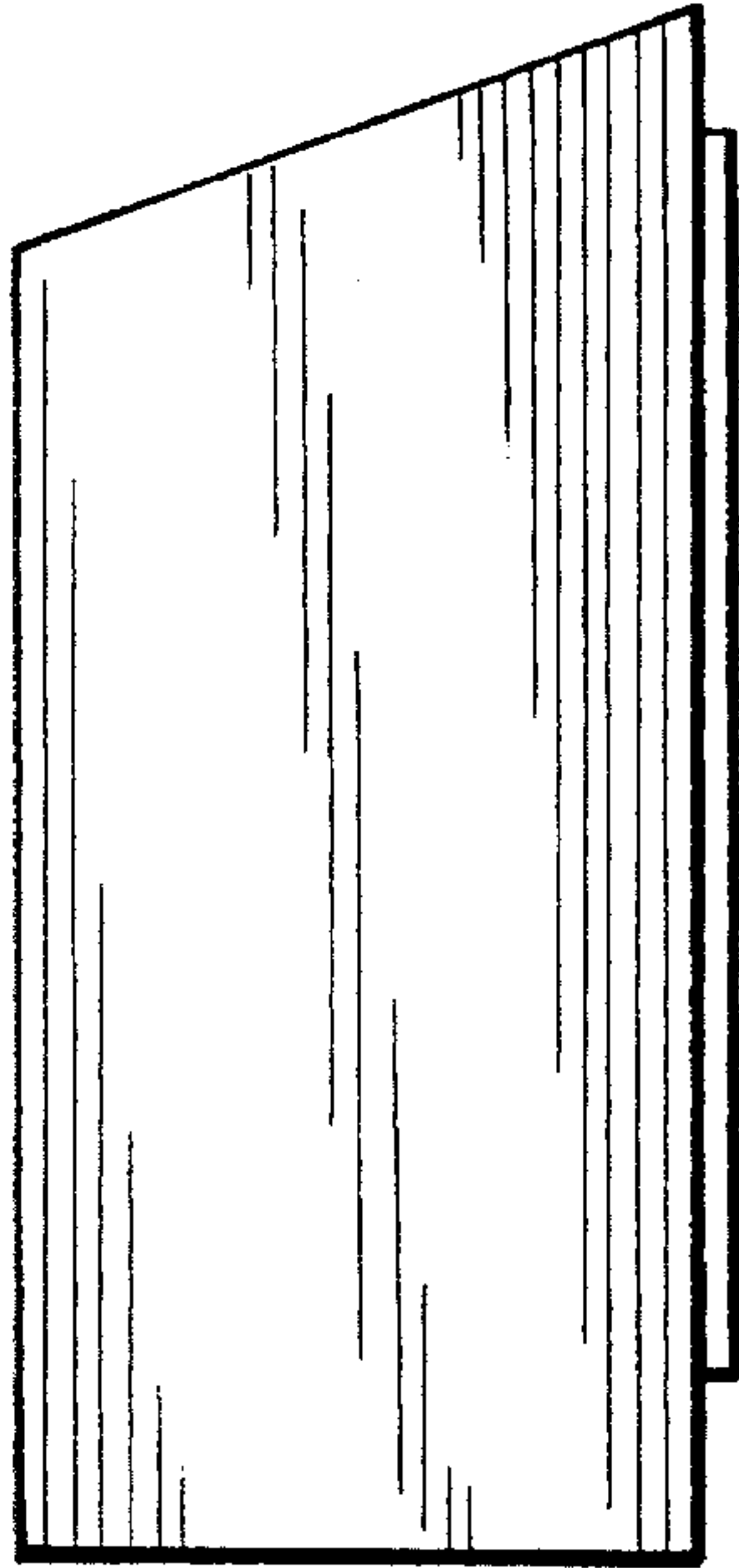

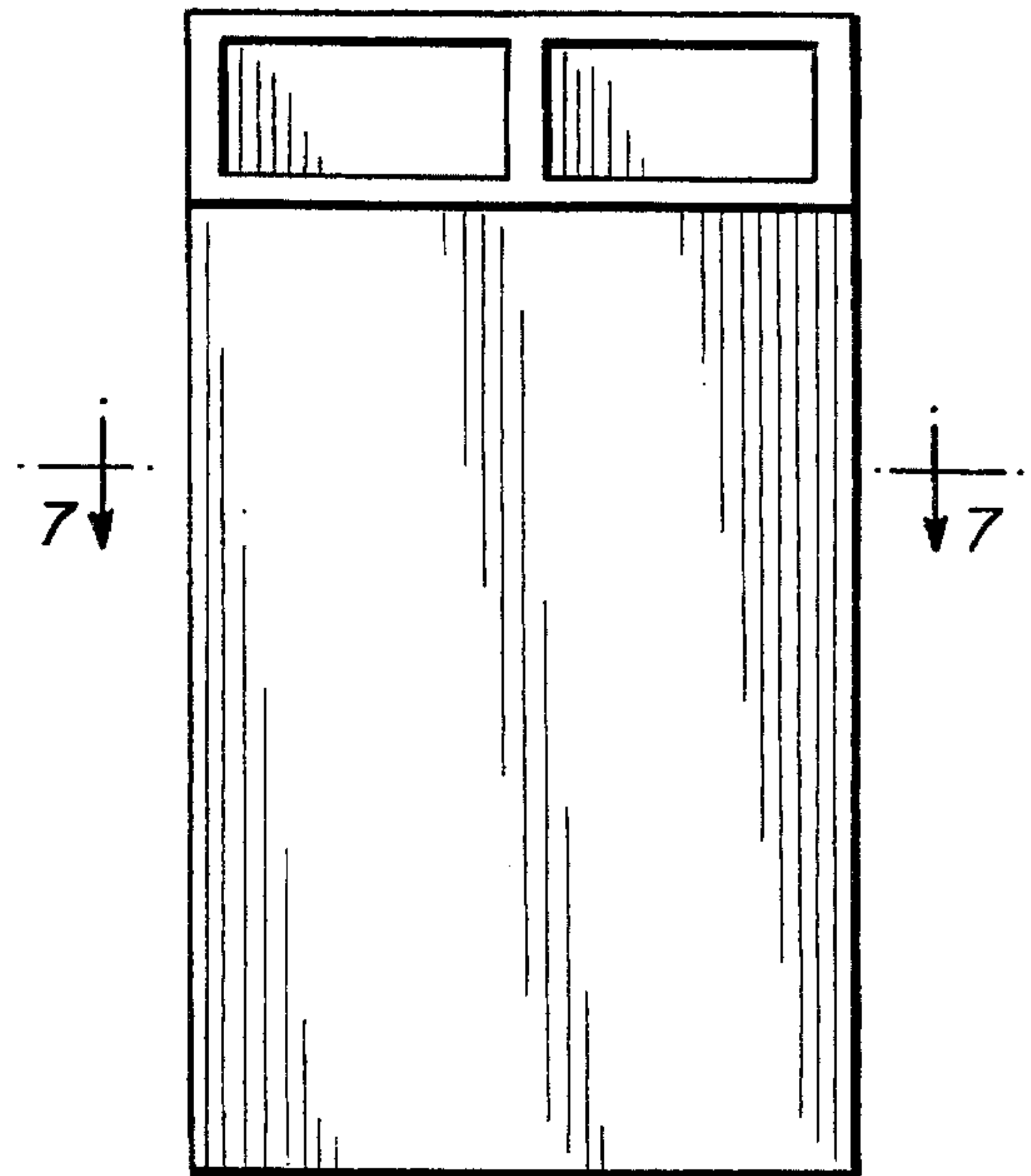

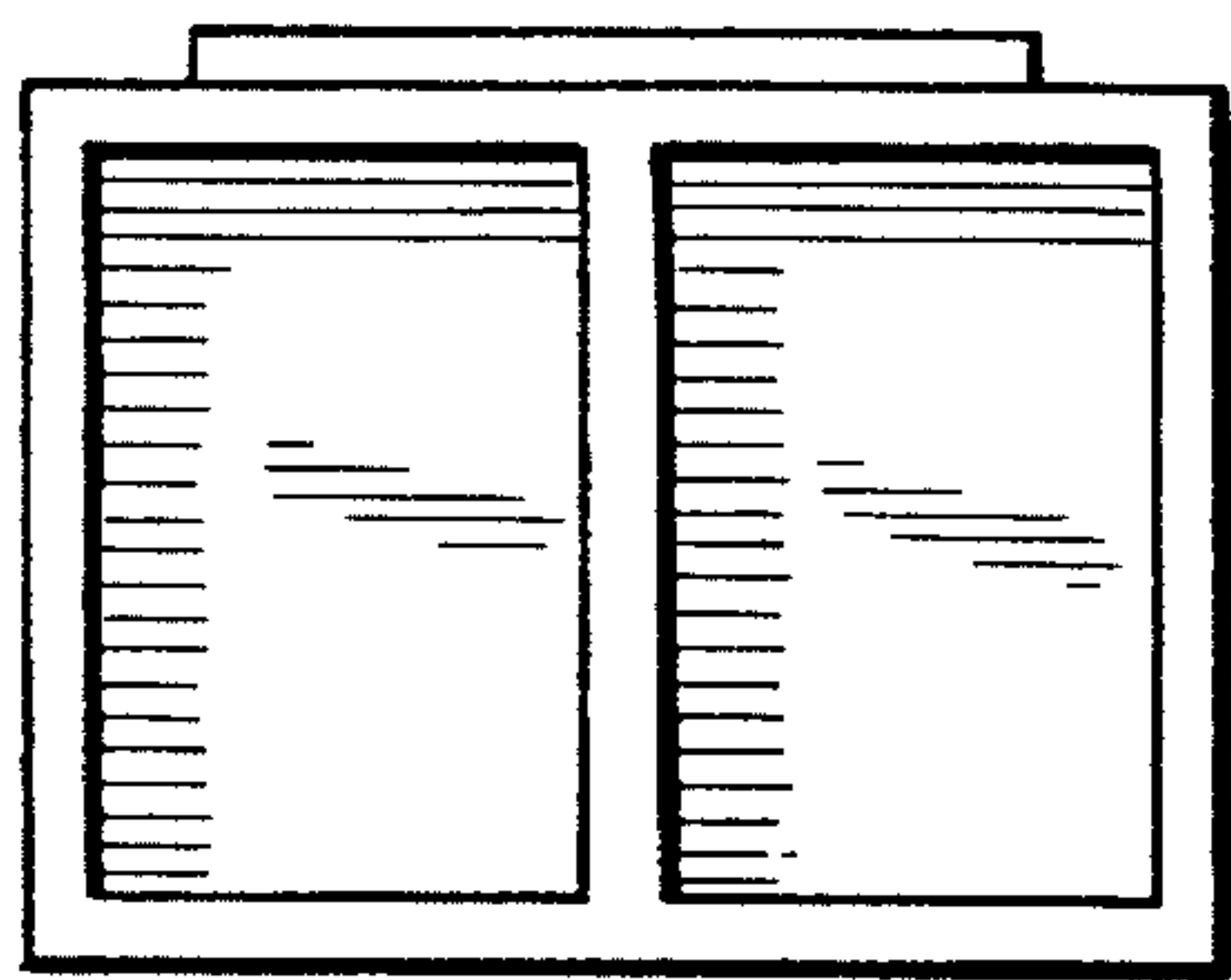

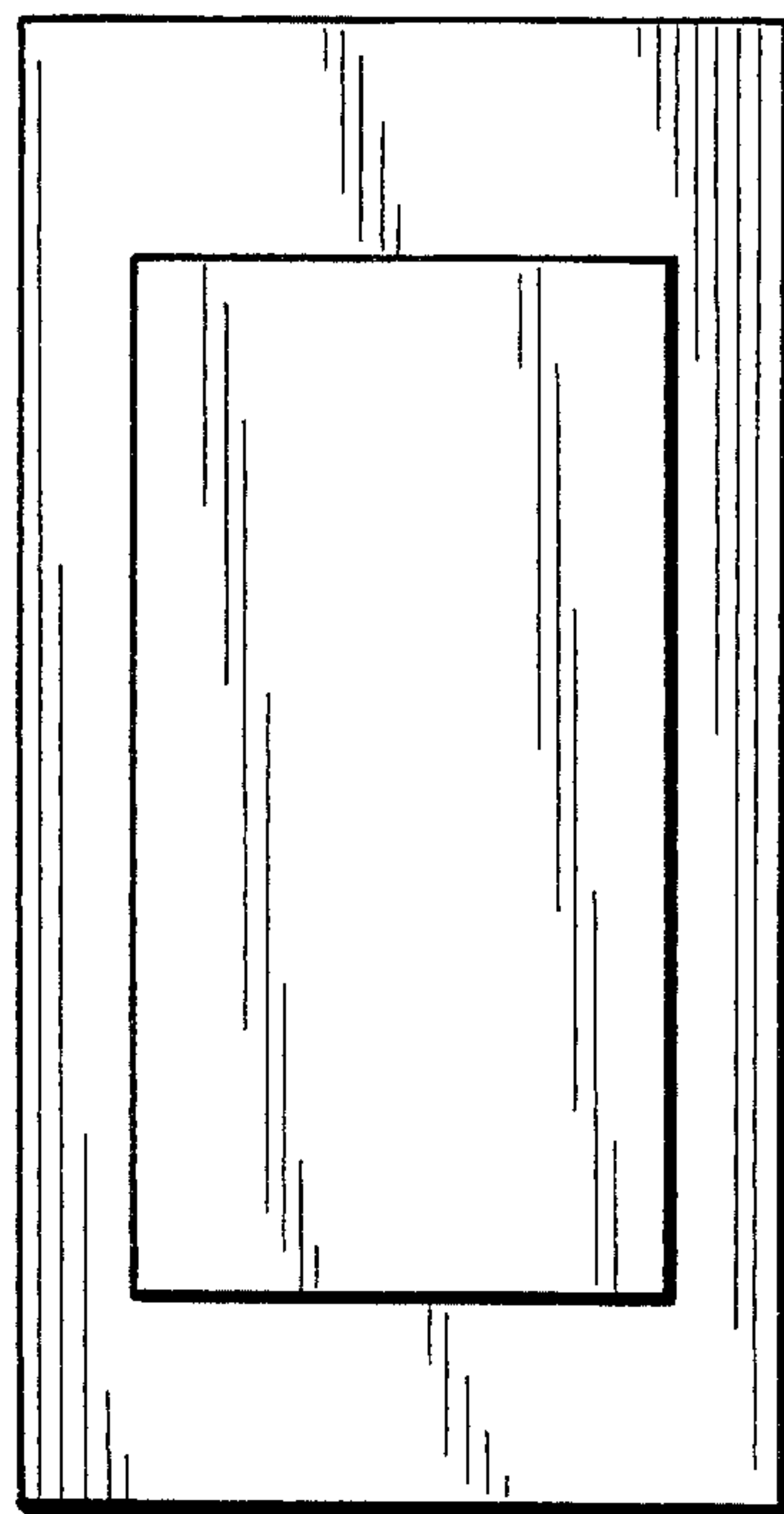
