DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of my new chair;

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view of a second embodiment of my new chair;

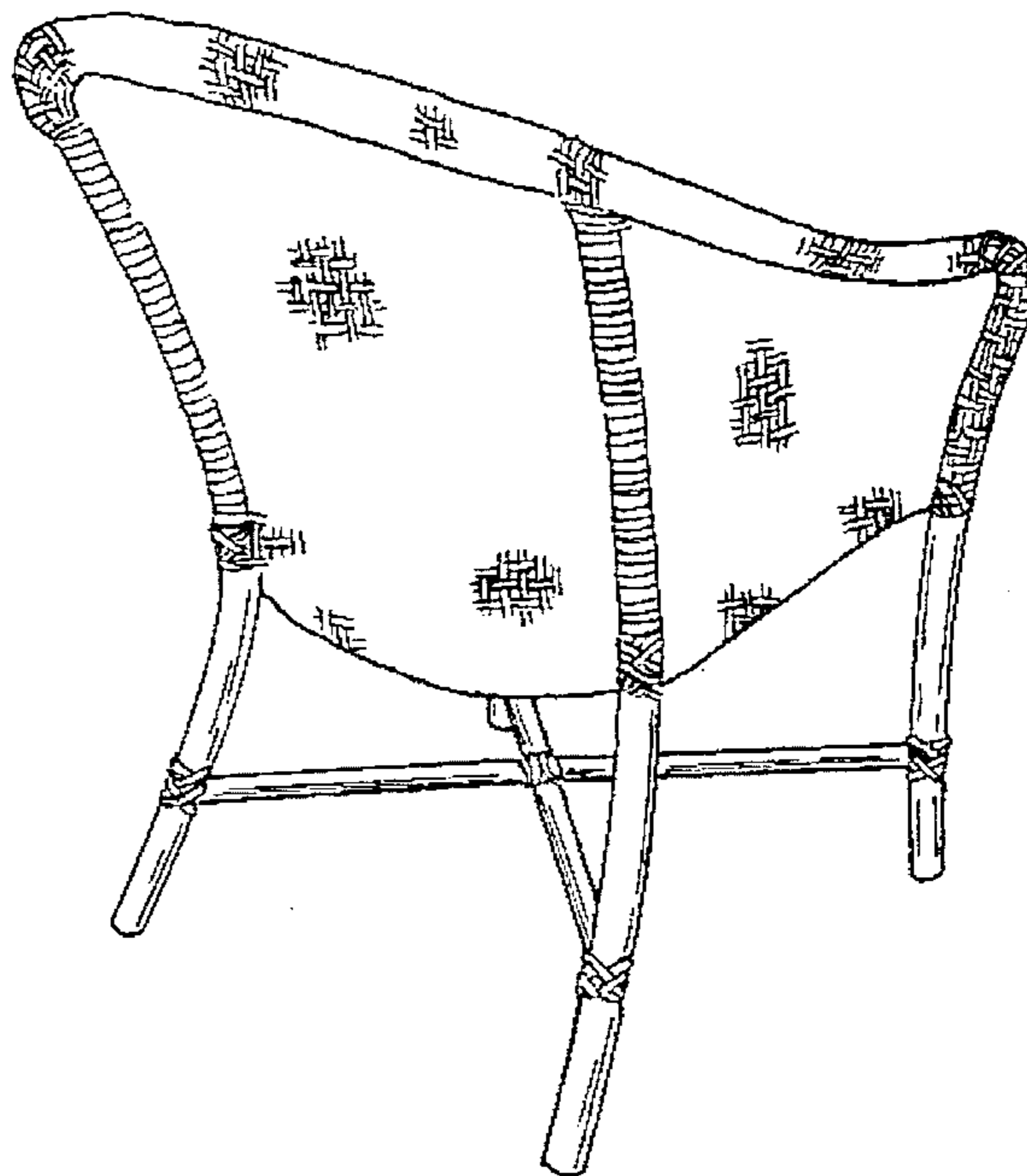
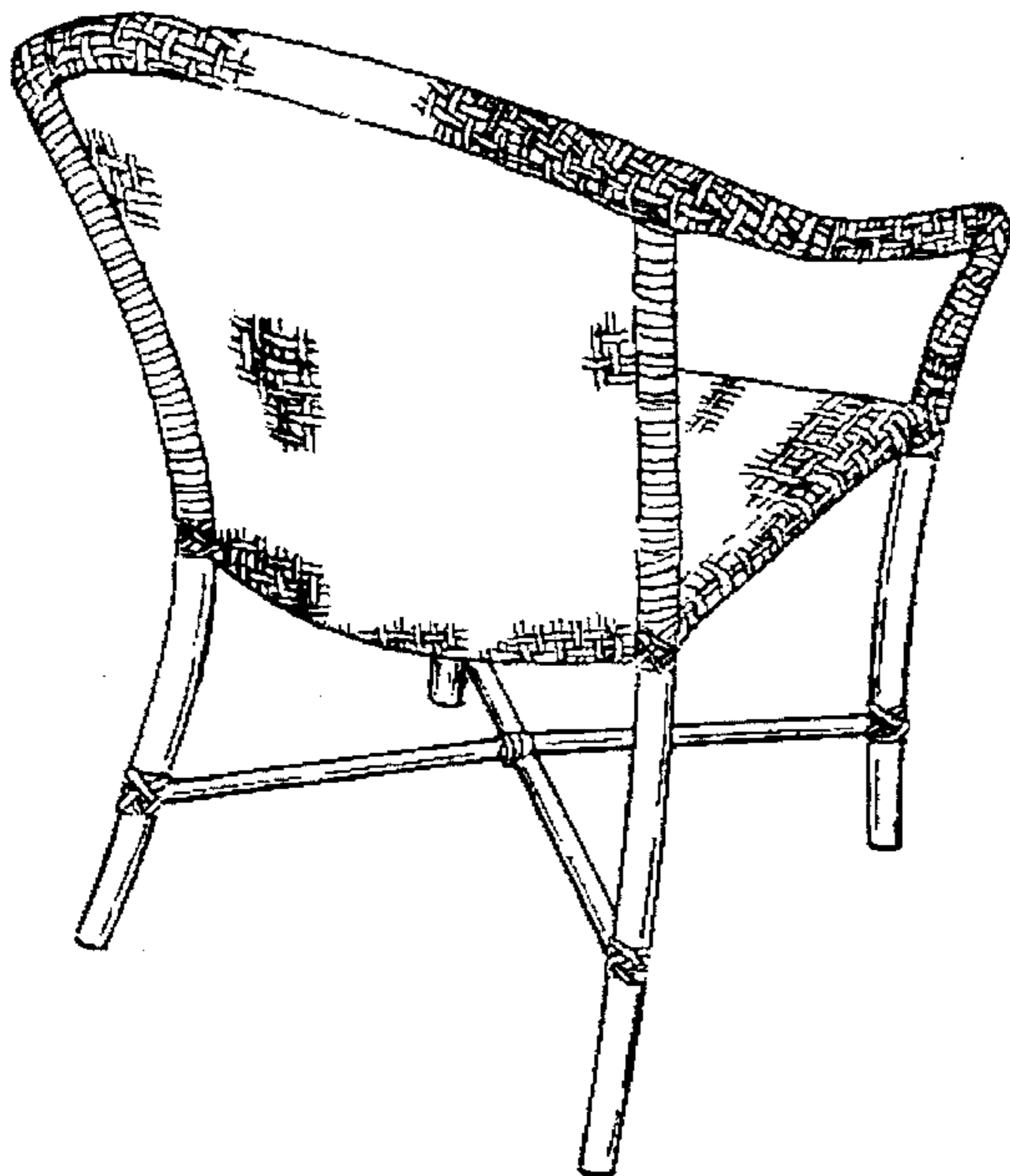
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the chair of FIG. 4, the opposite side being a mirror image;

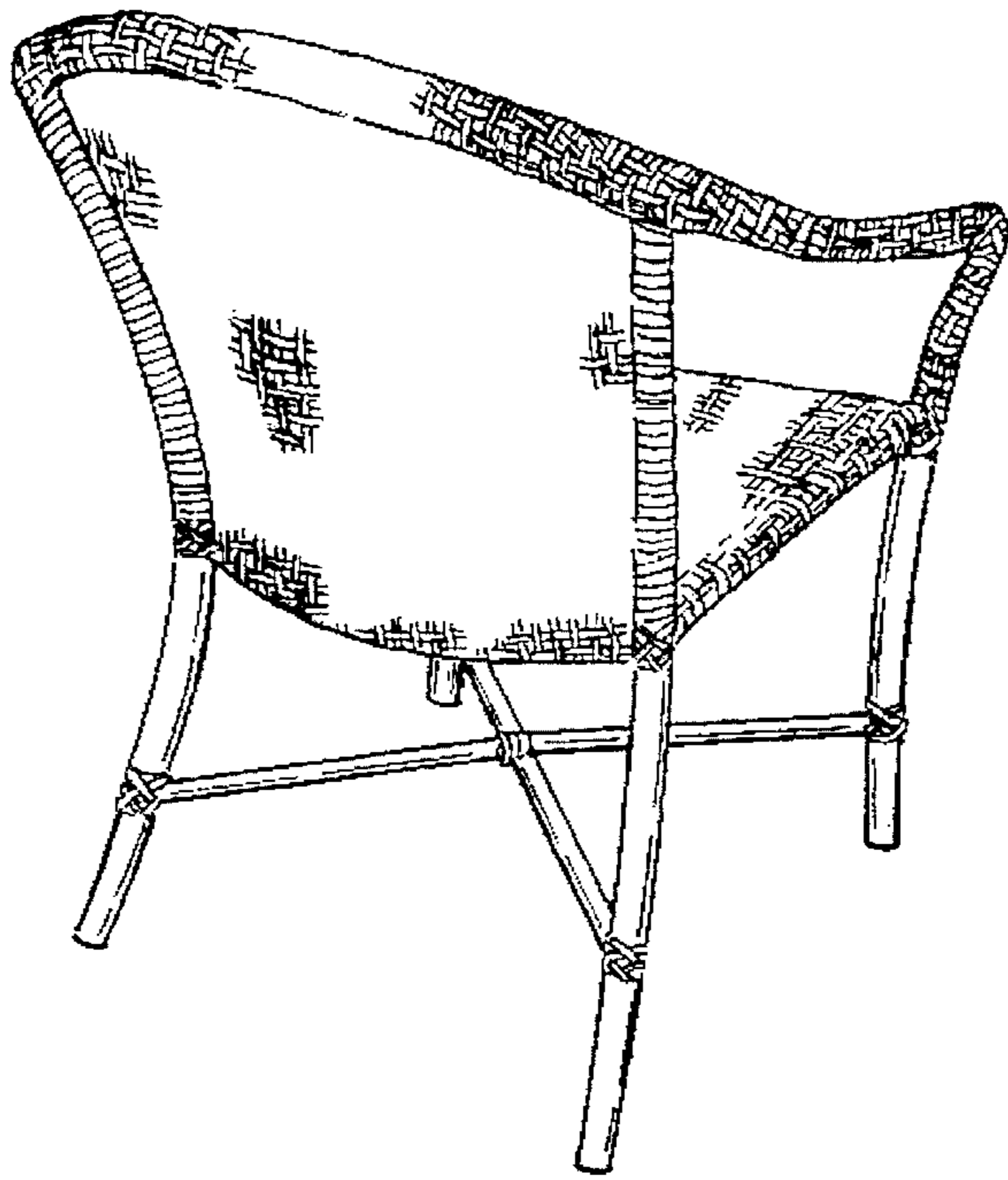

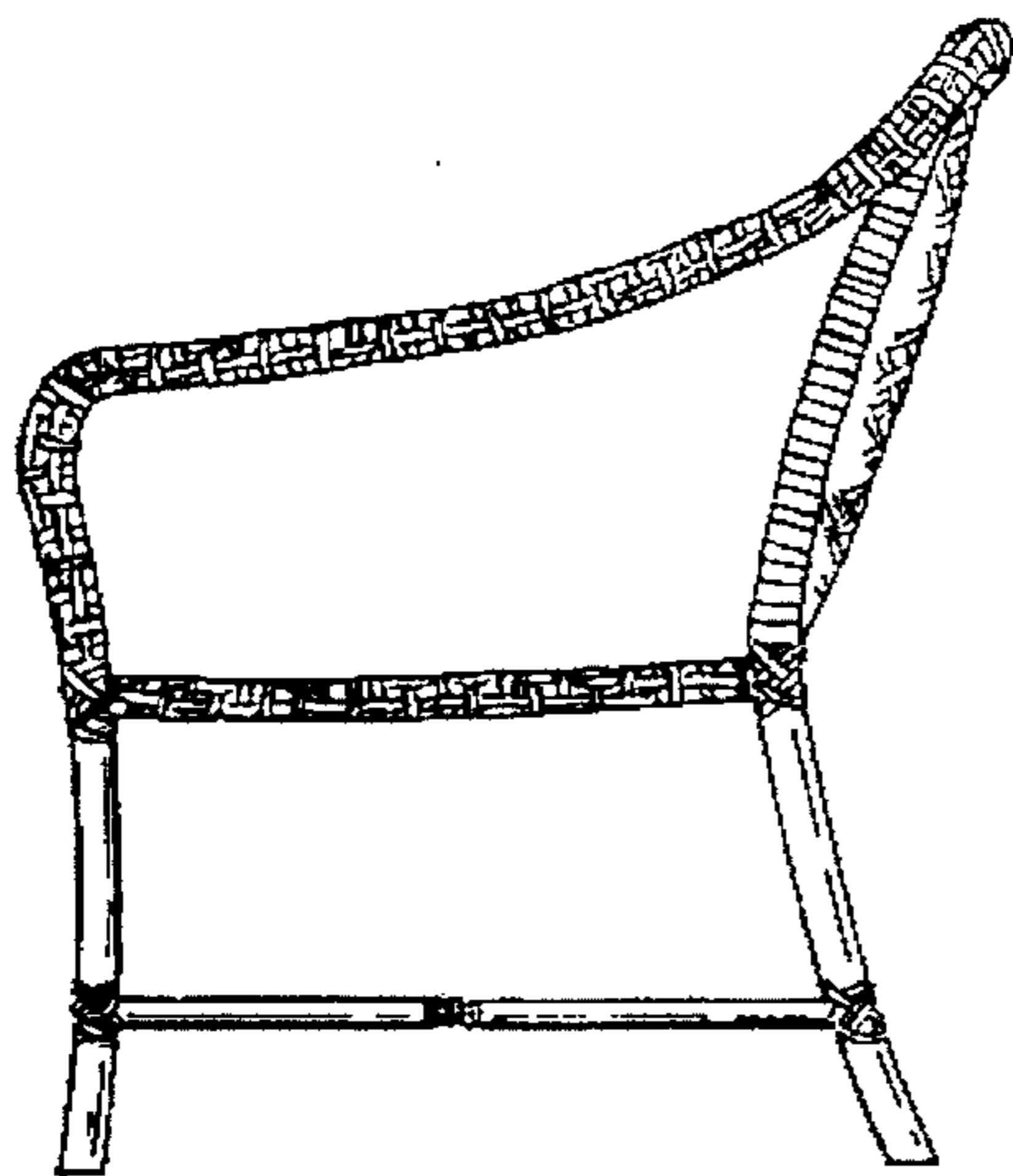

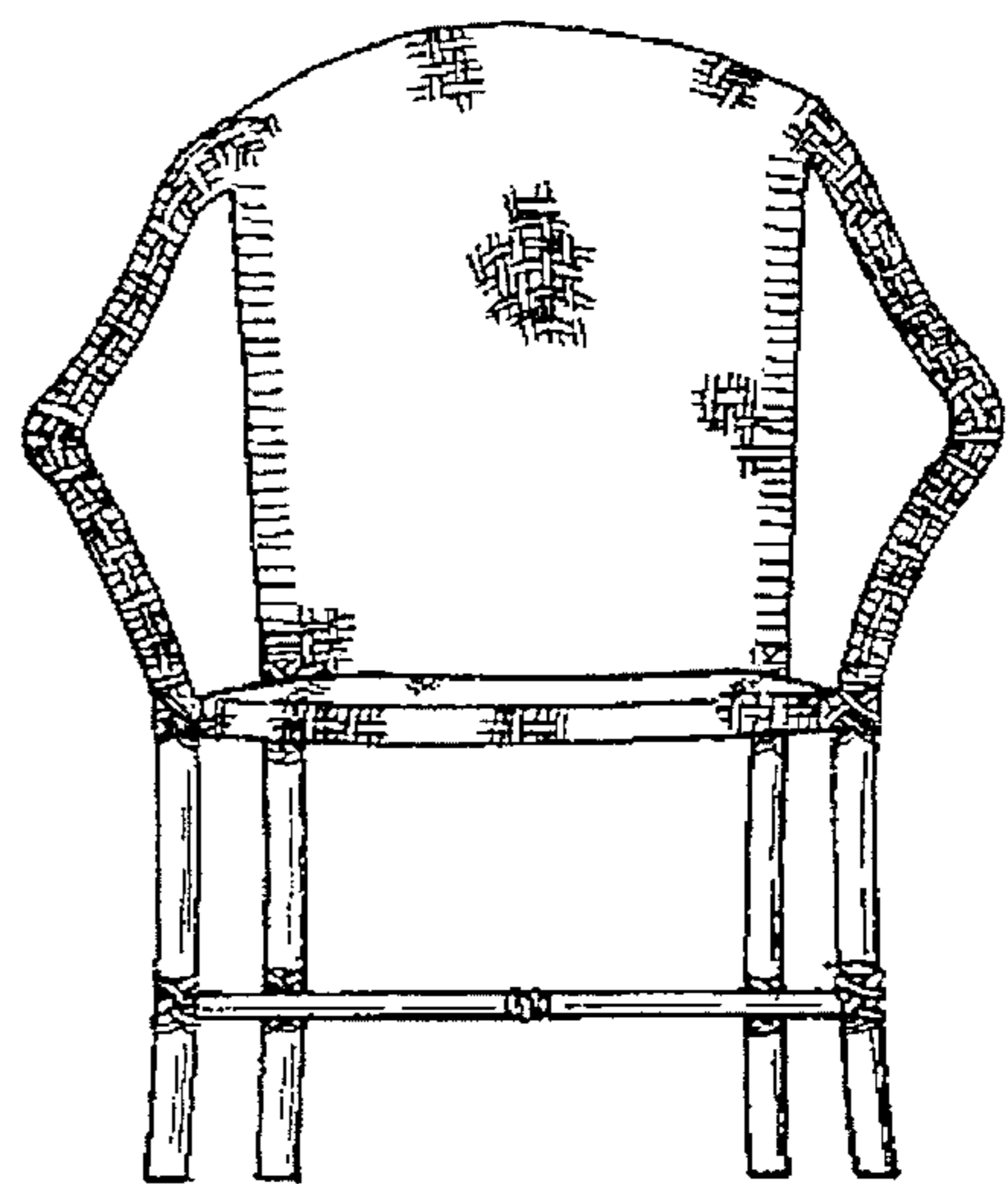

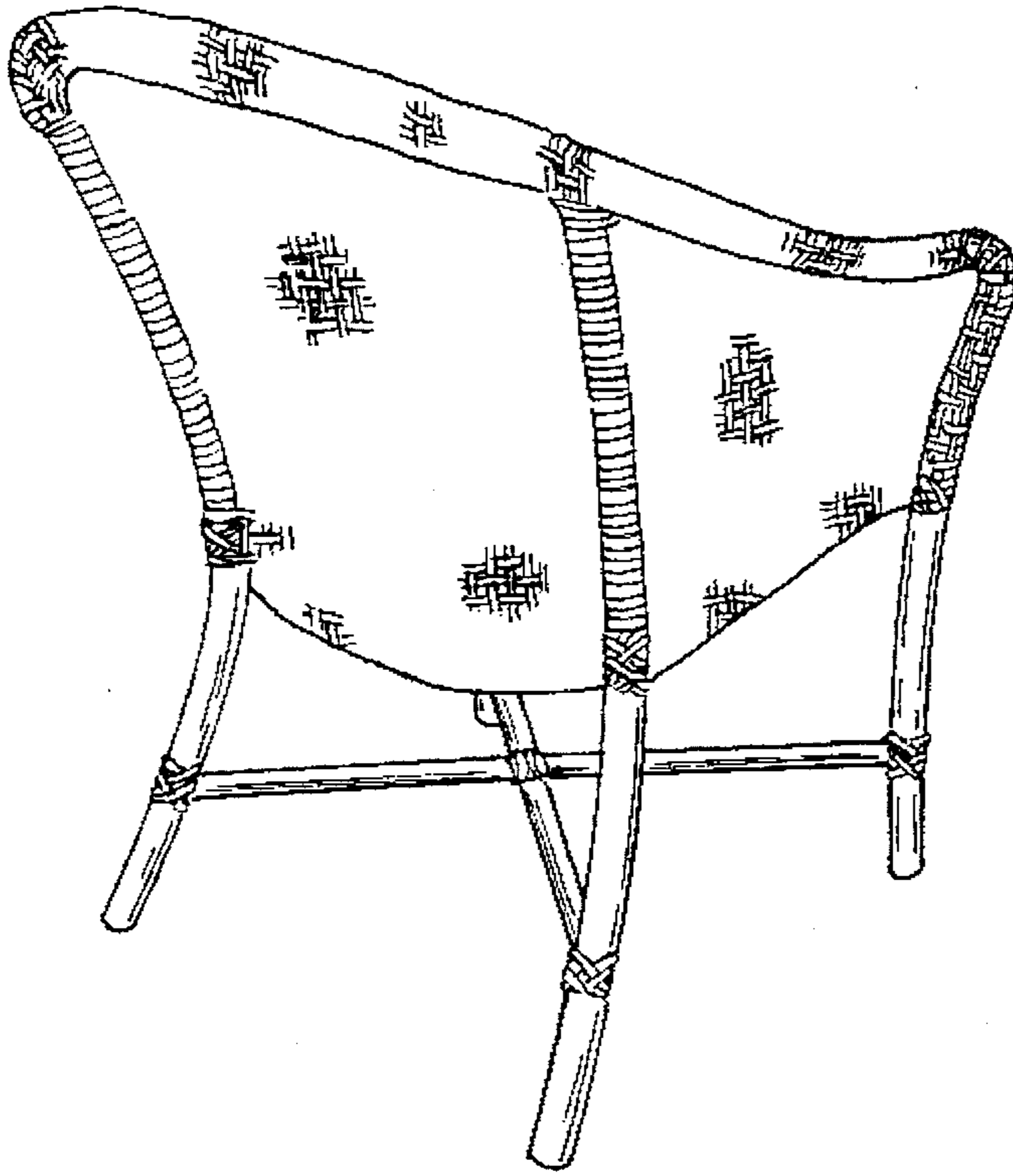

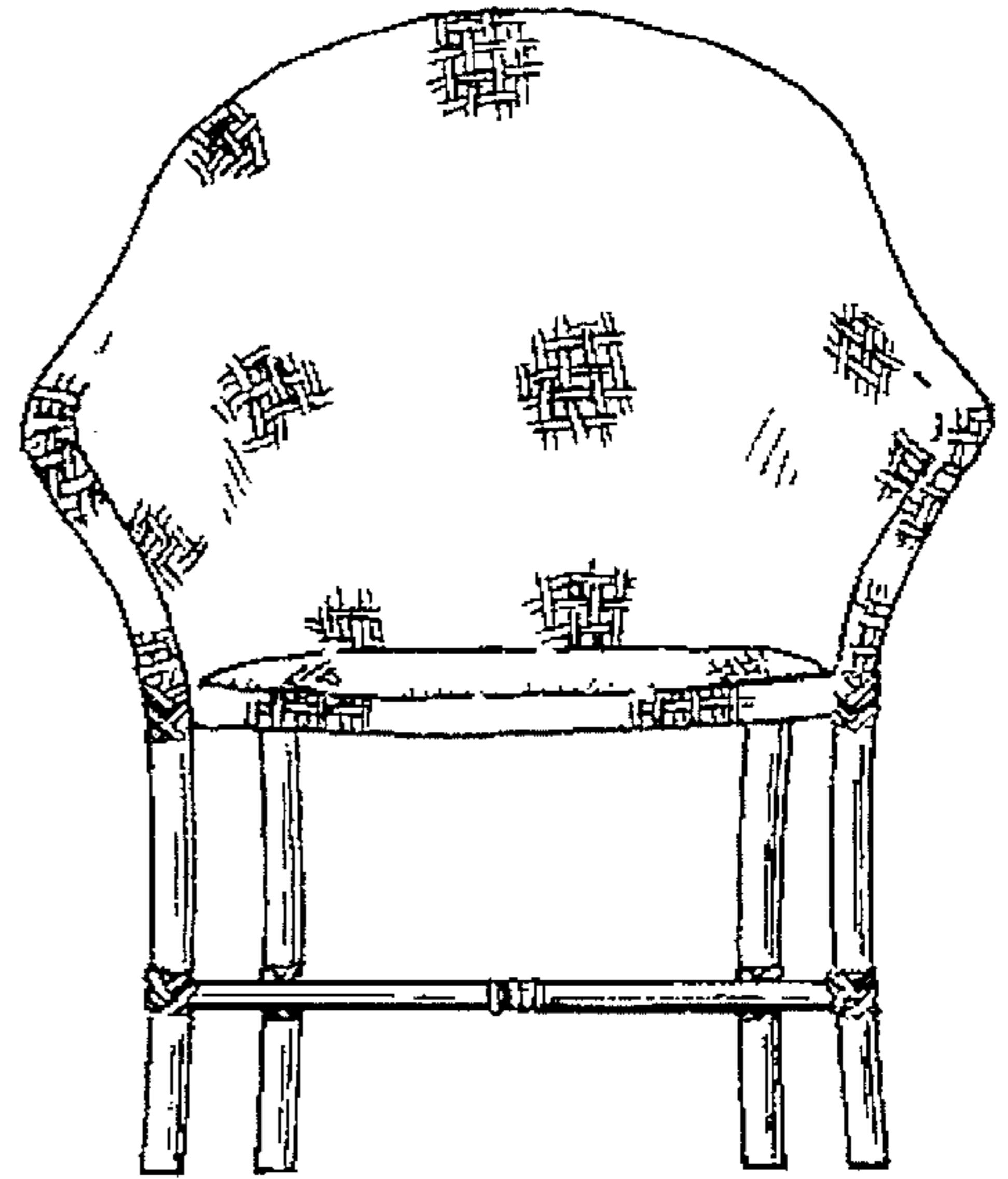

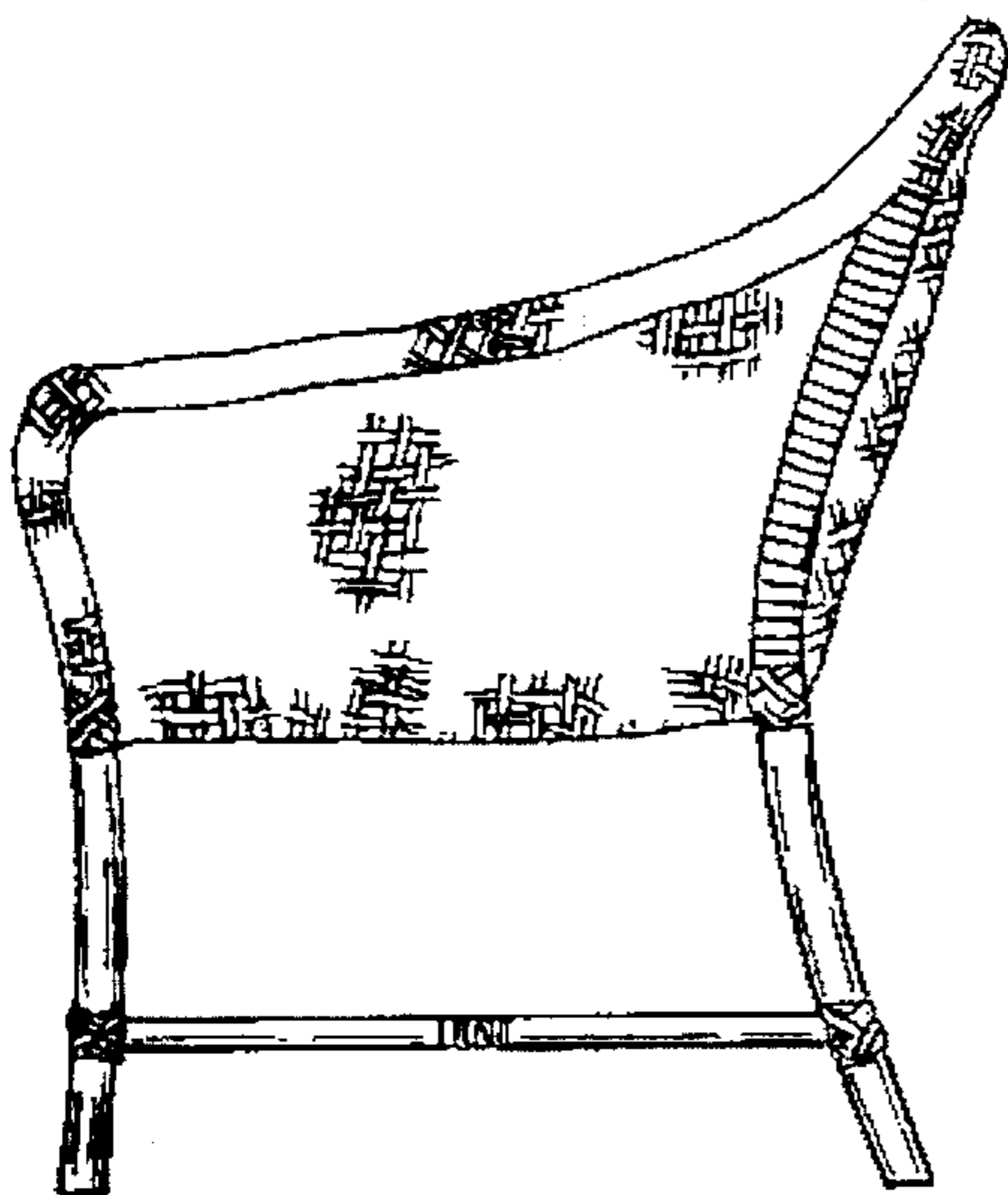

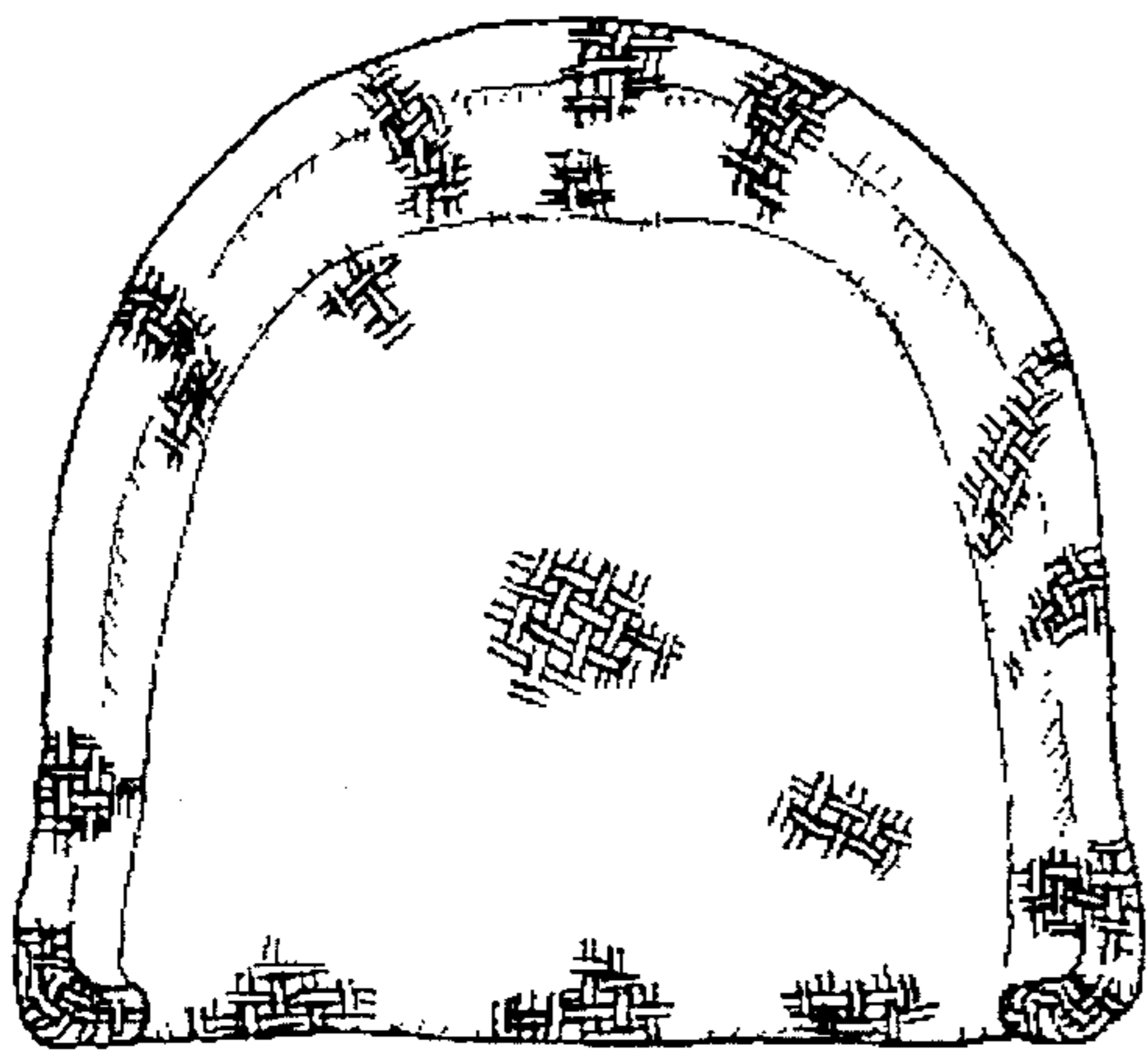

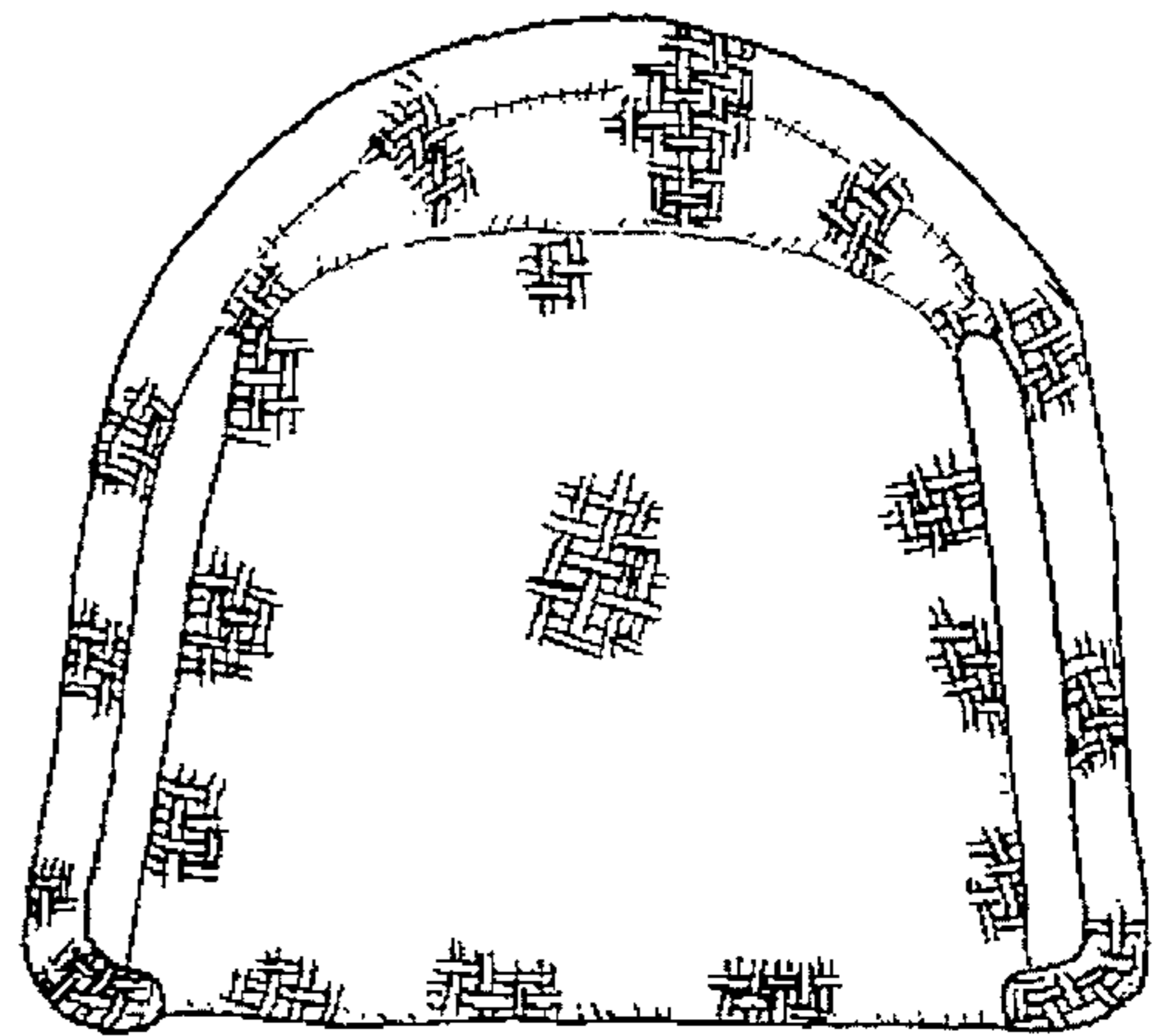
