showing my new design;

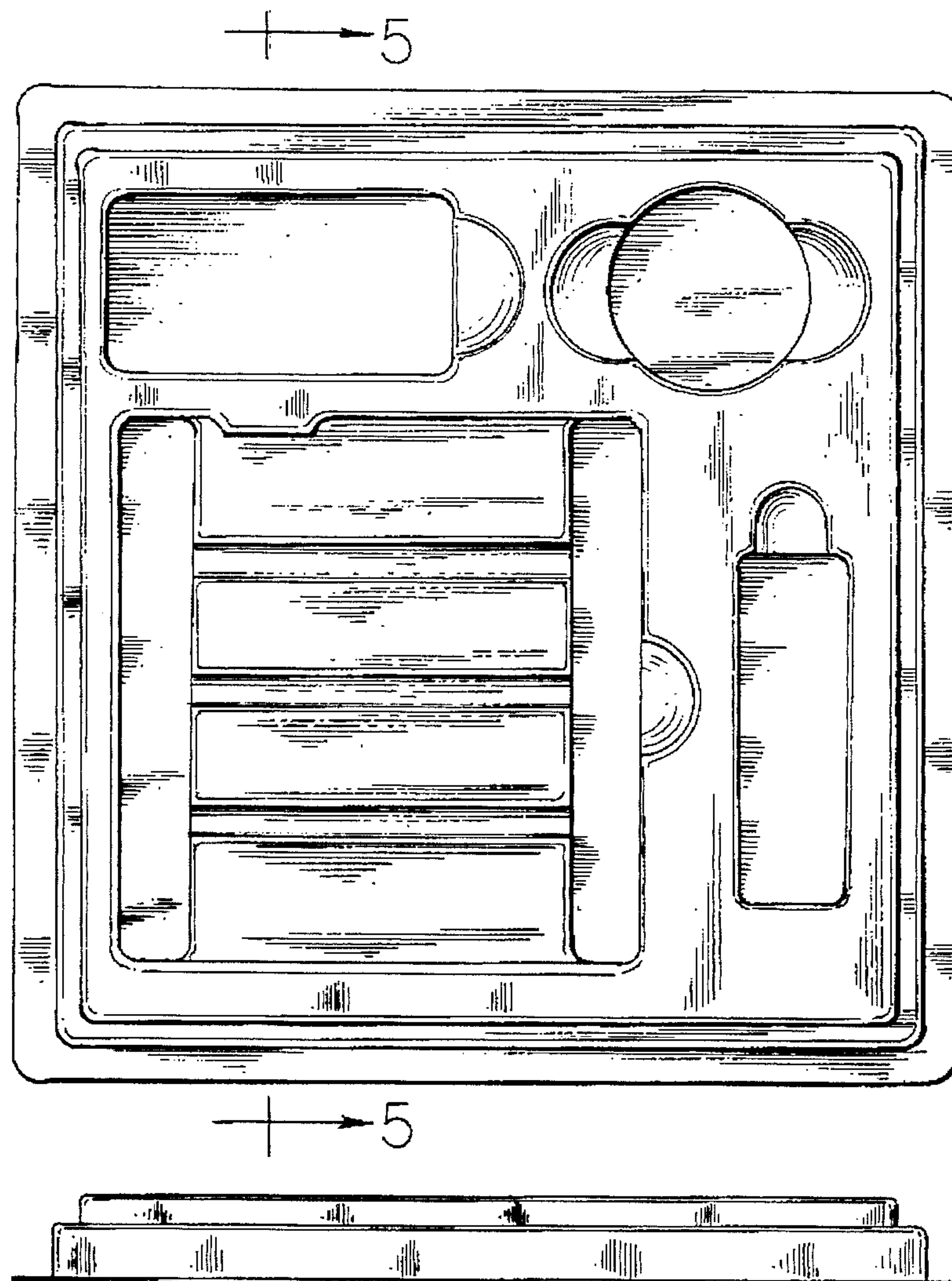
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one side;

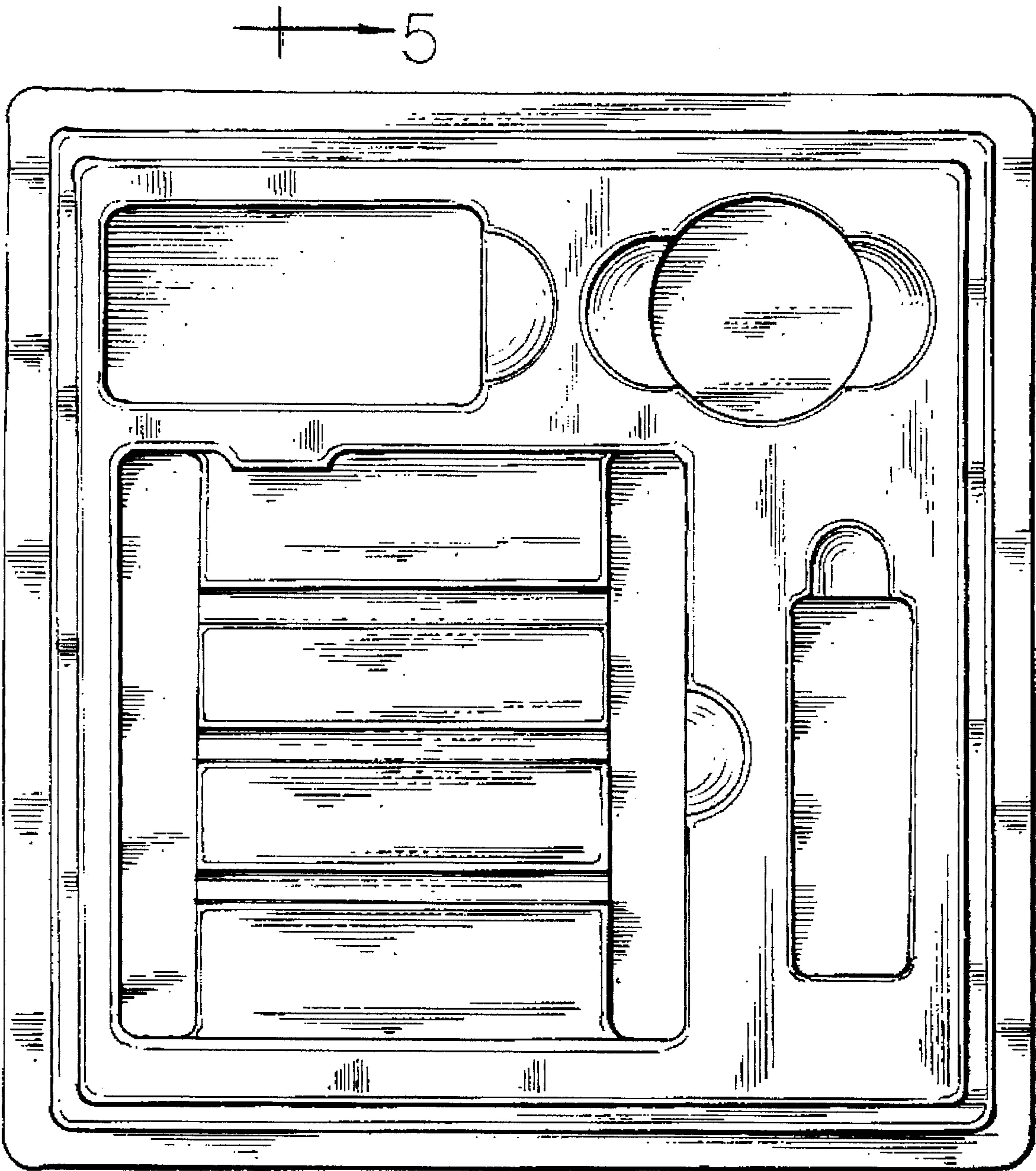

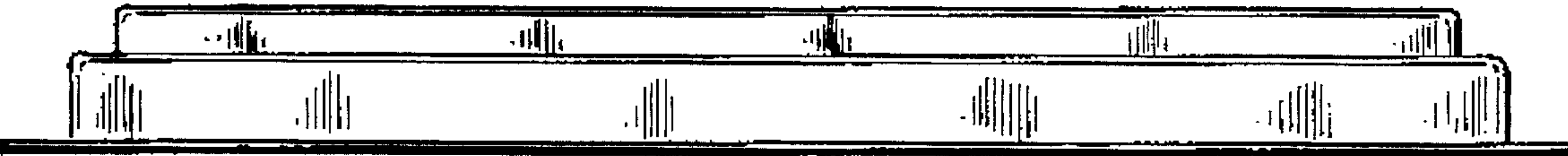

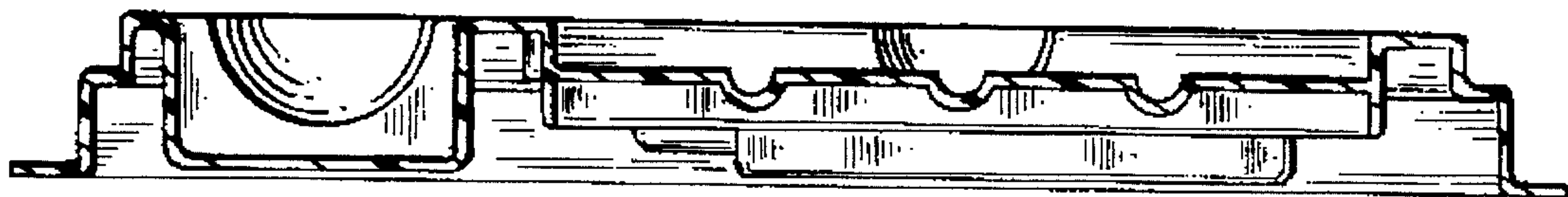

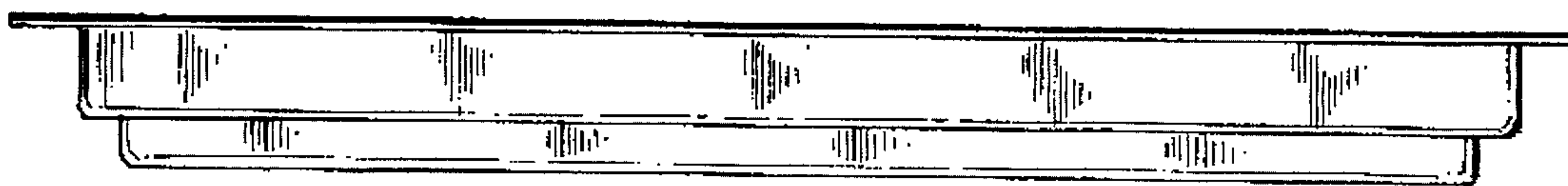

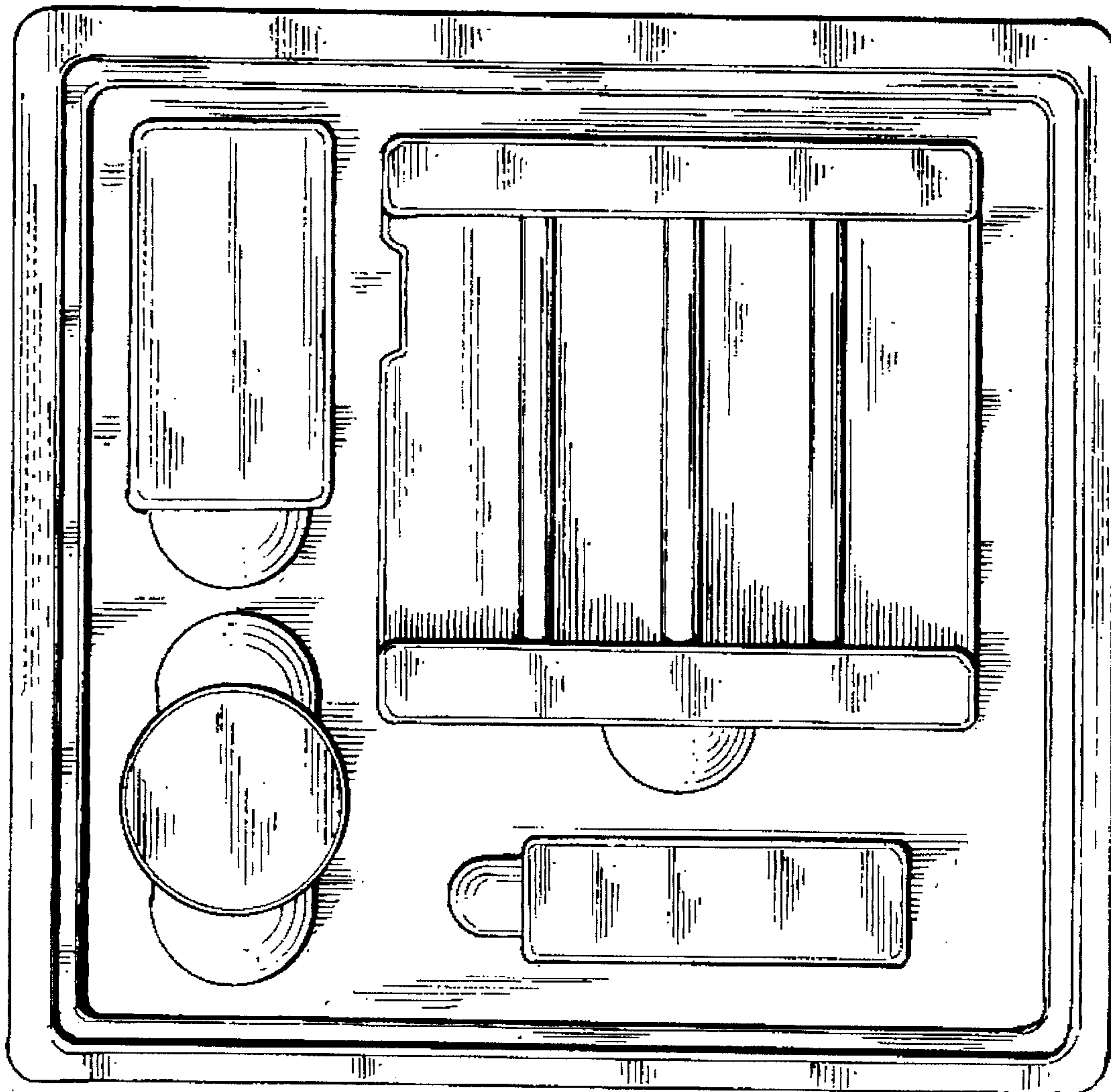
