DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a guitar body showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation of view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation of view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a lower end elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is an upper end elevational view thereof.

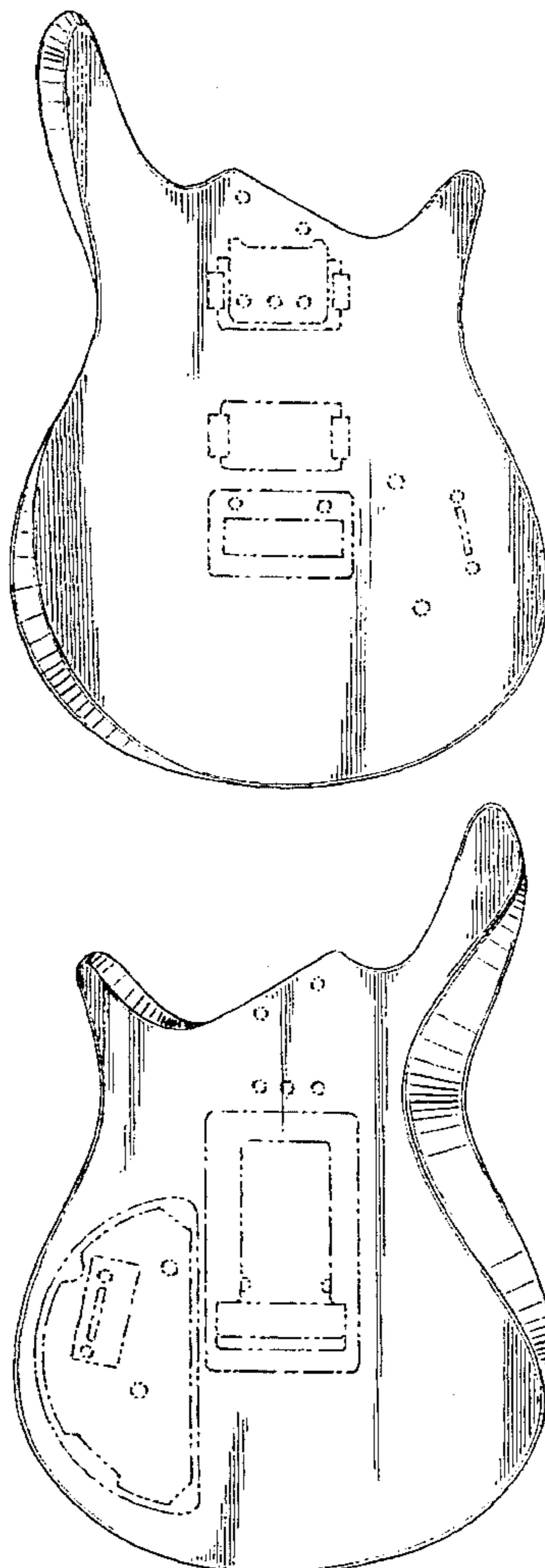

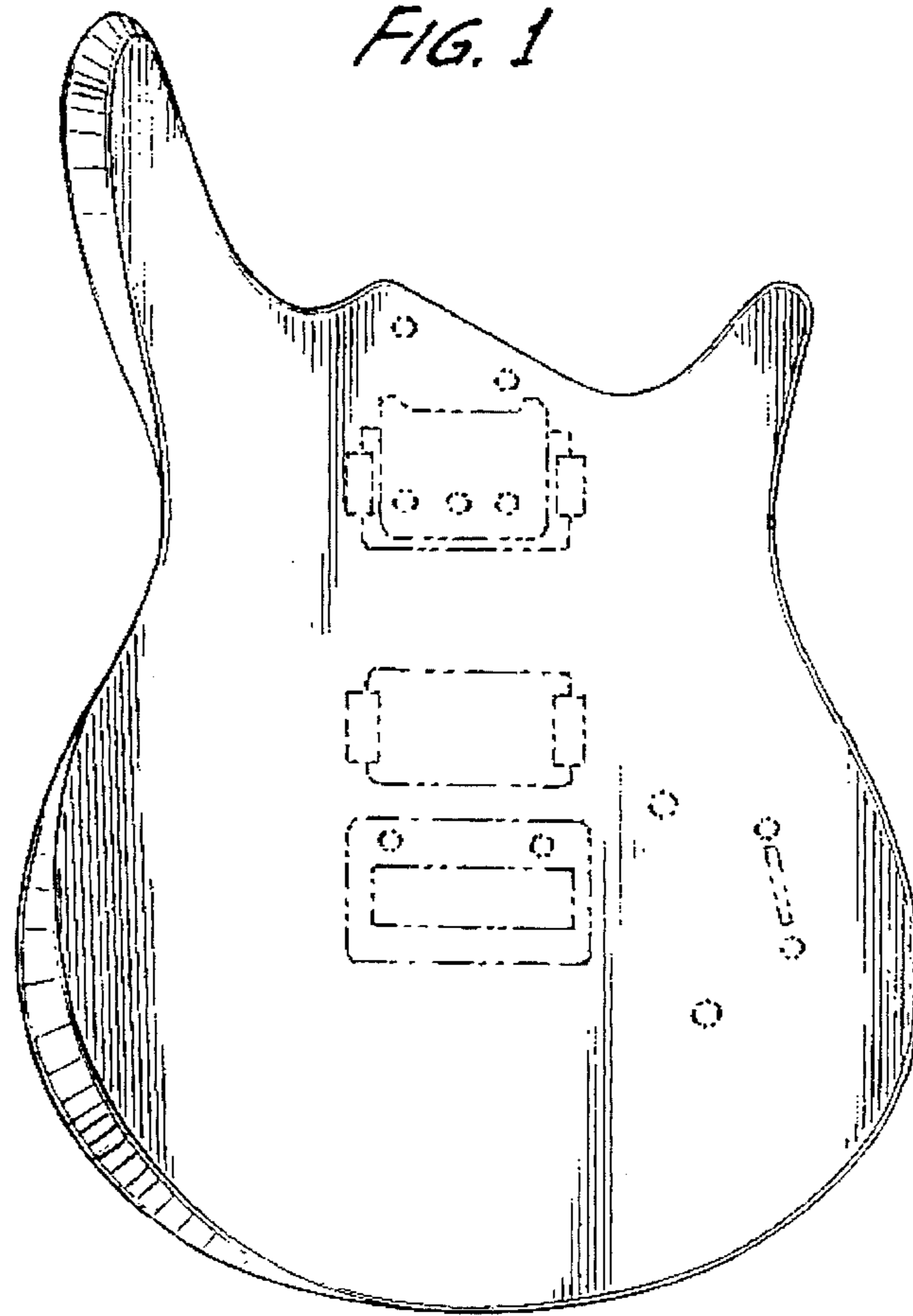

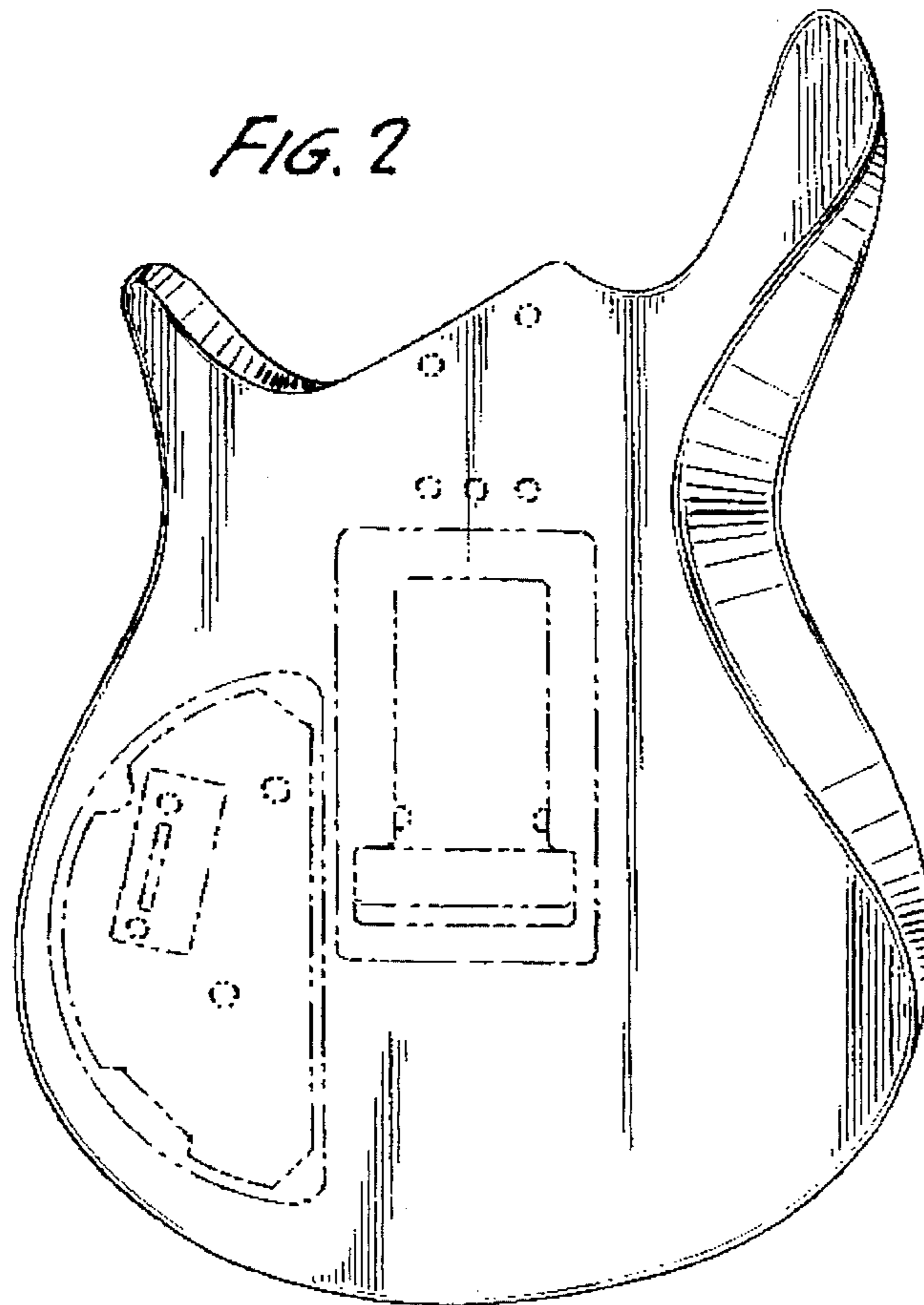

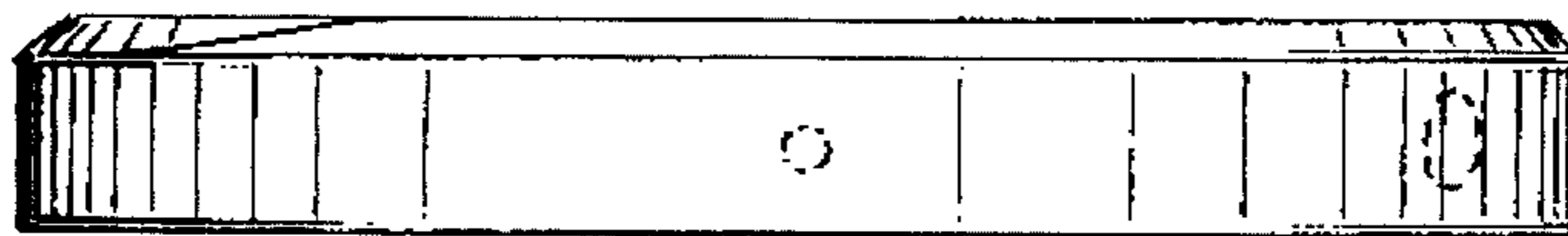
