[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a child's chaise lounge, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right, front perspective view of a child's chaise lounge showing our new design with the seat back in an upright position;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

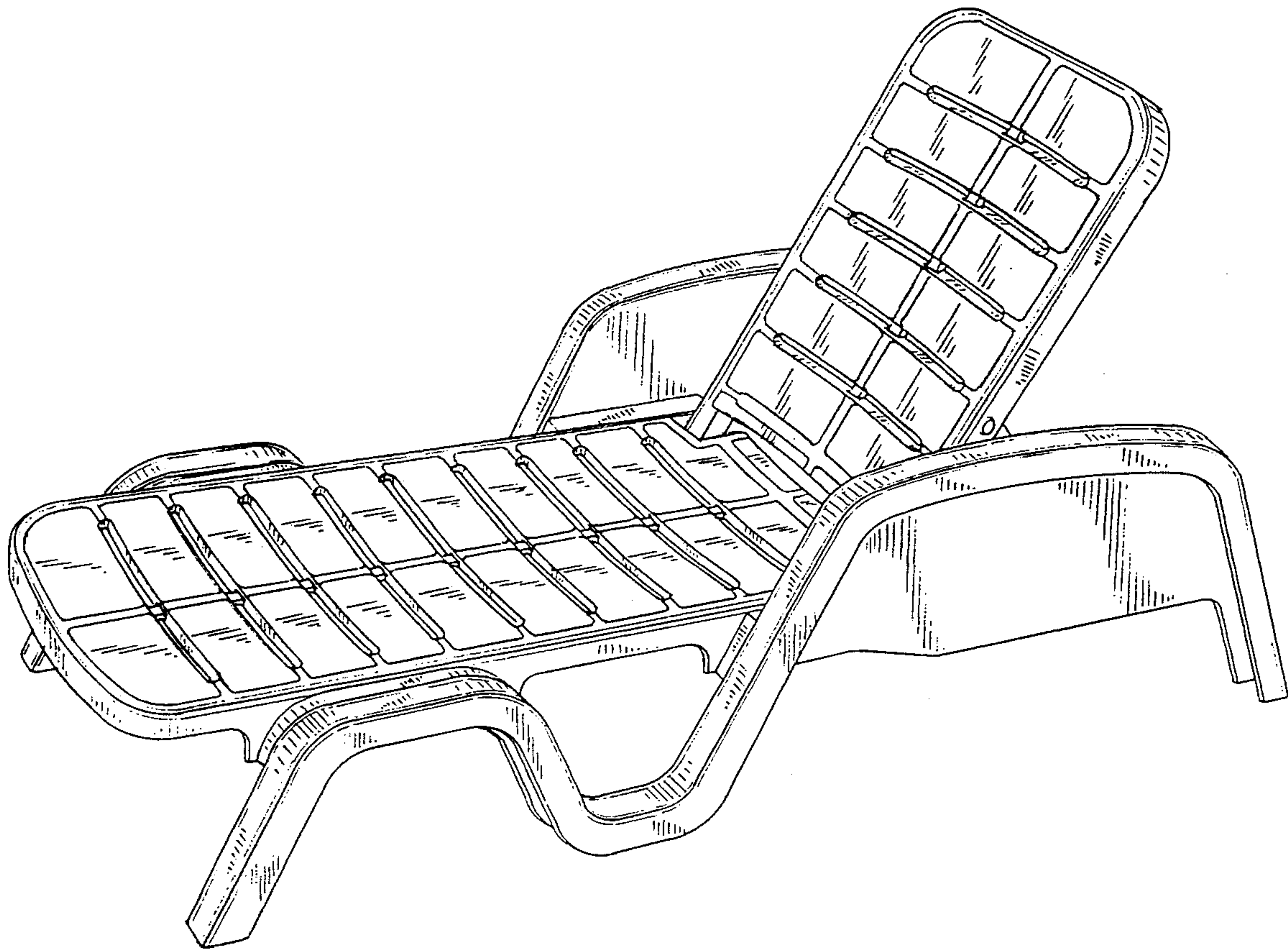
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

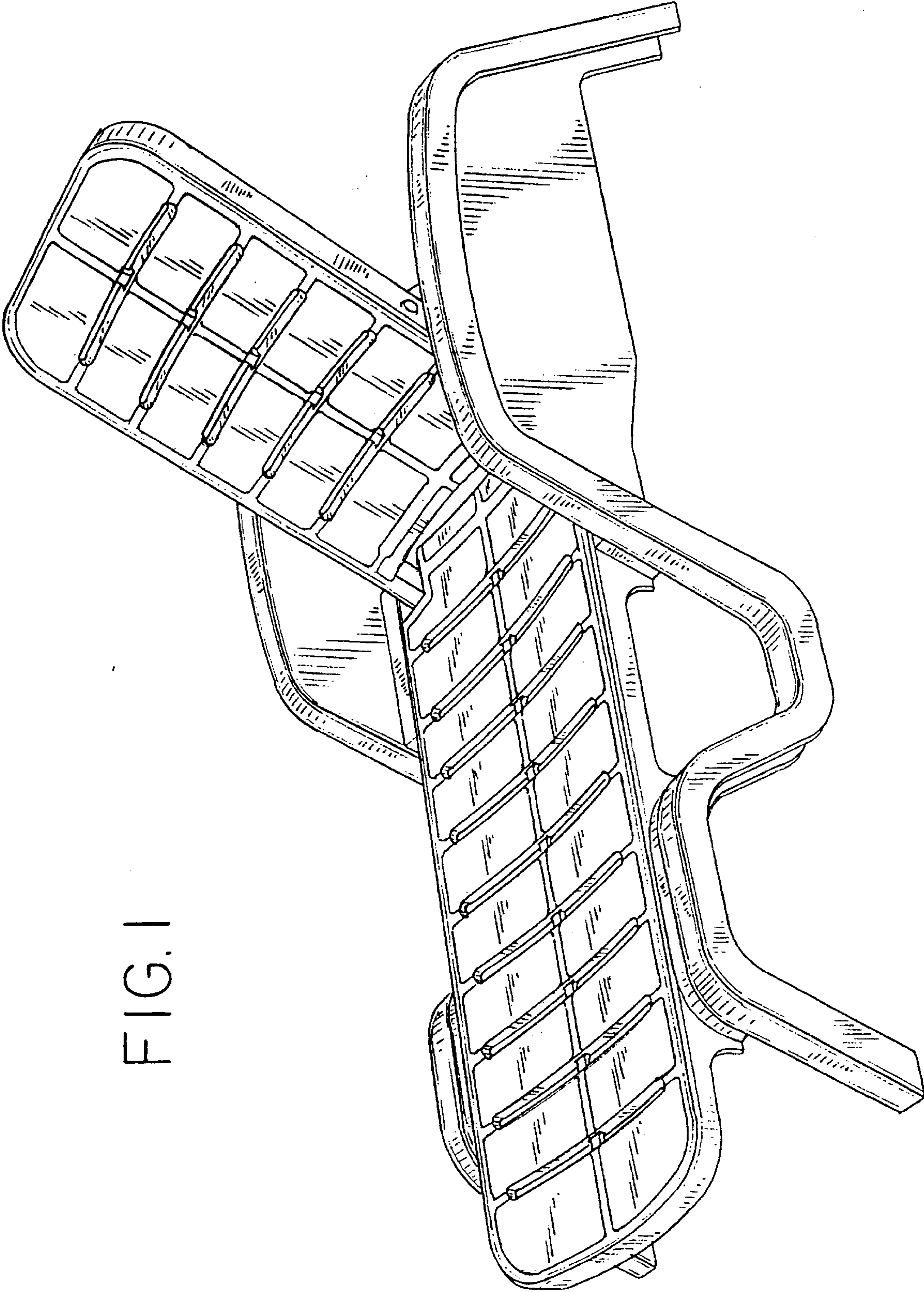

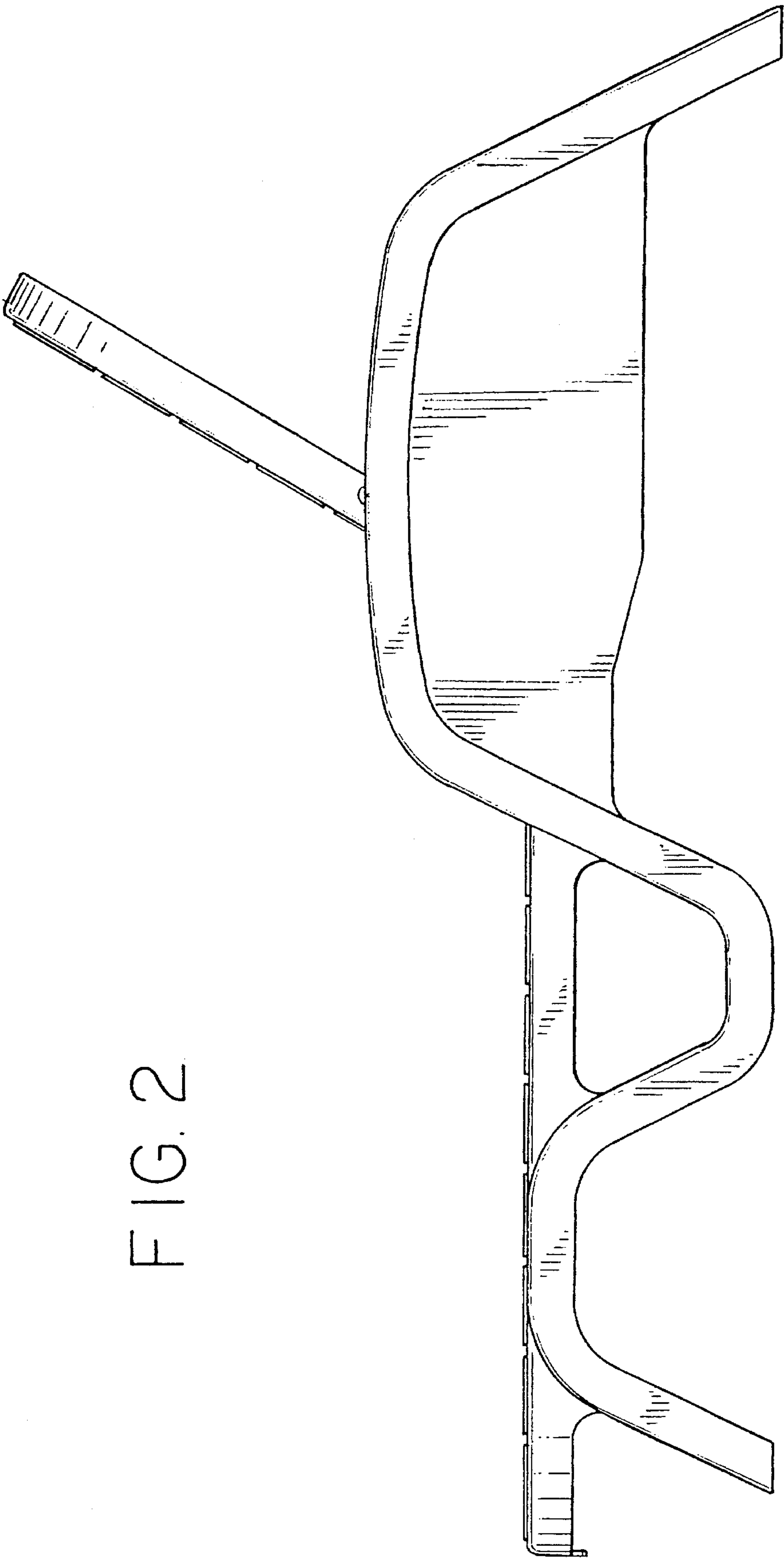

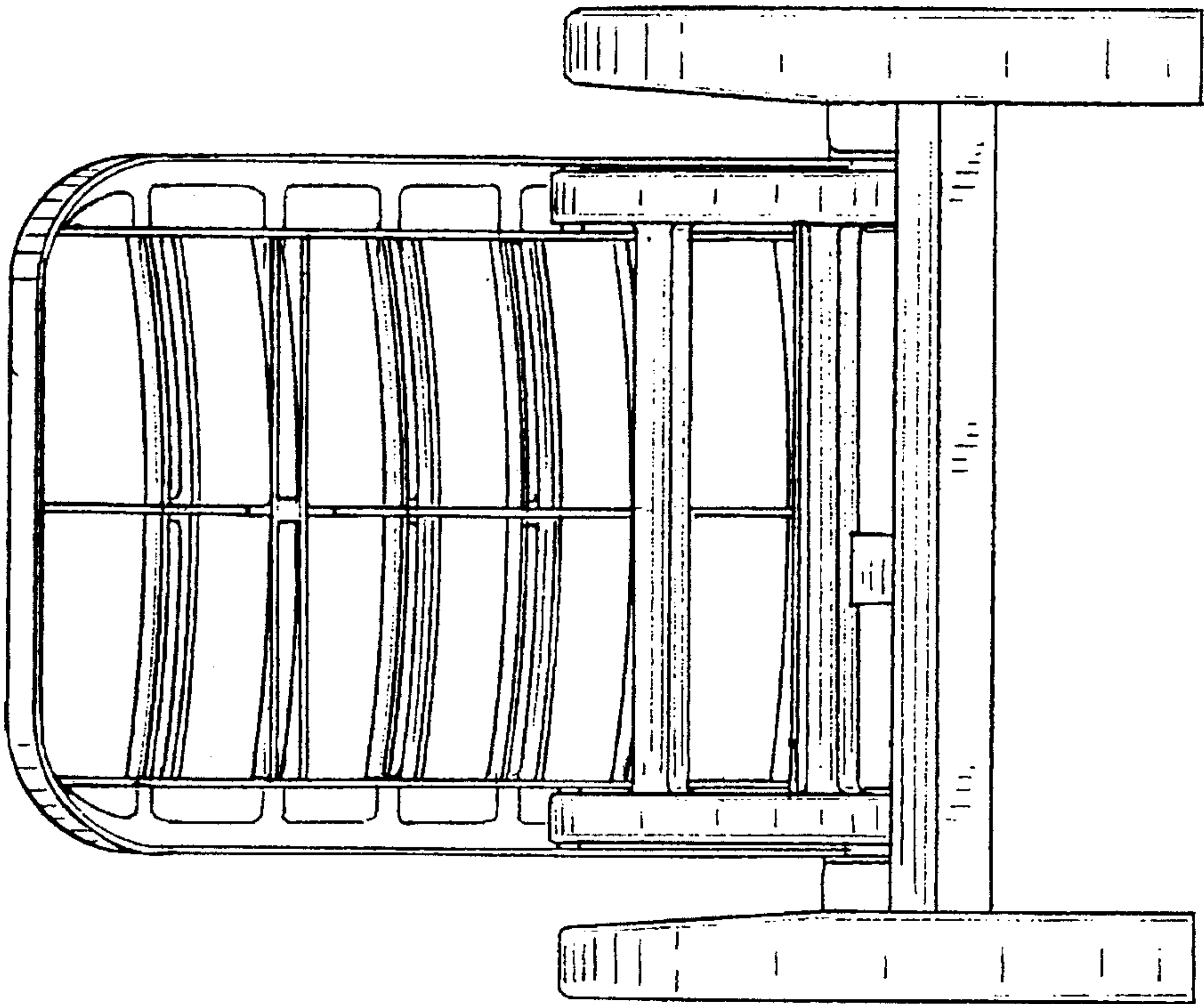

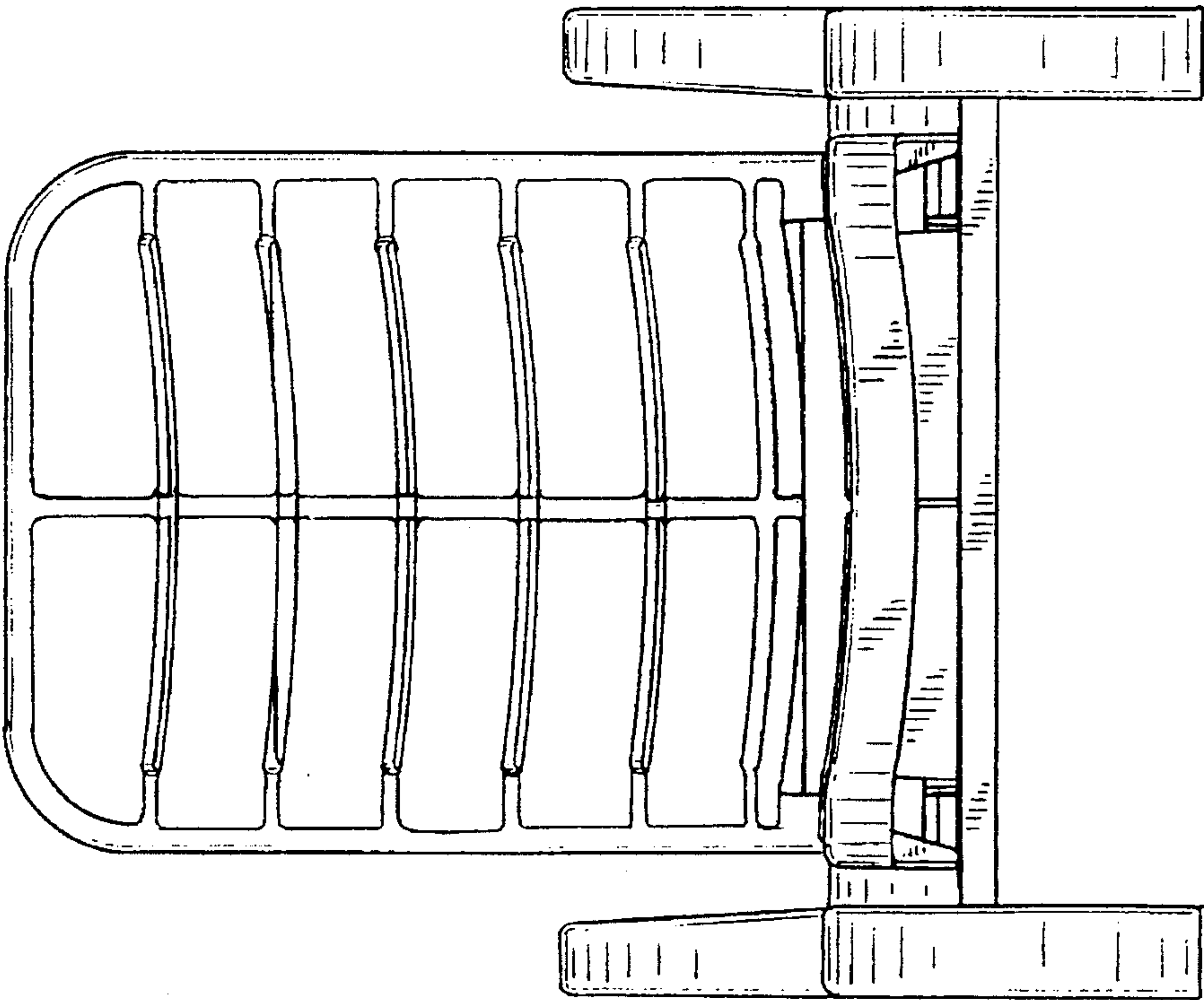

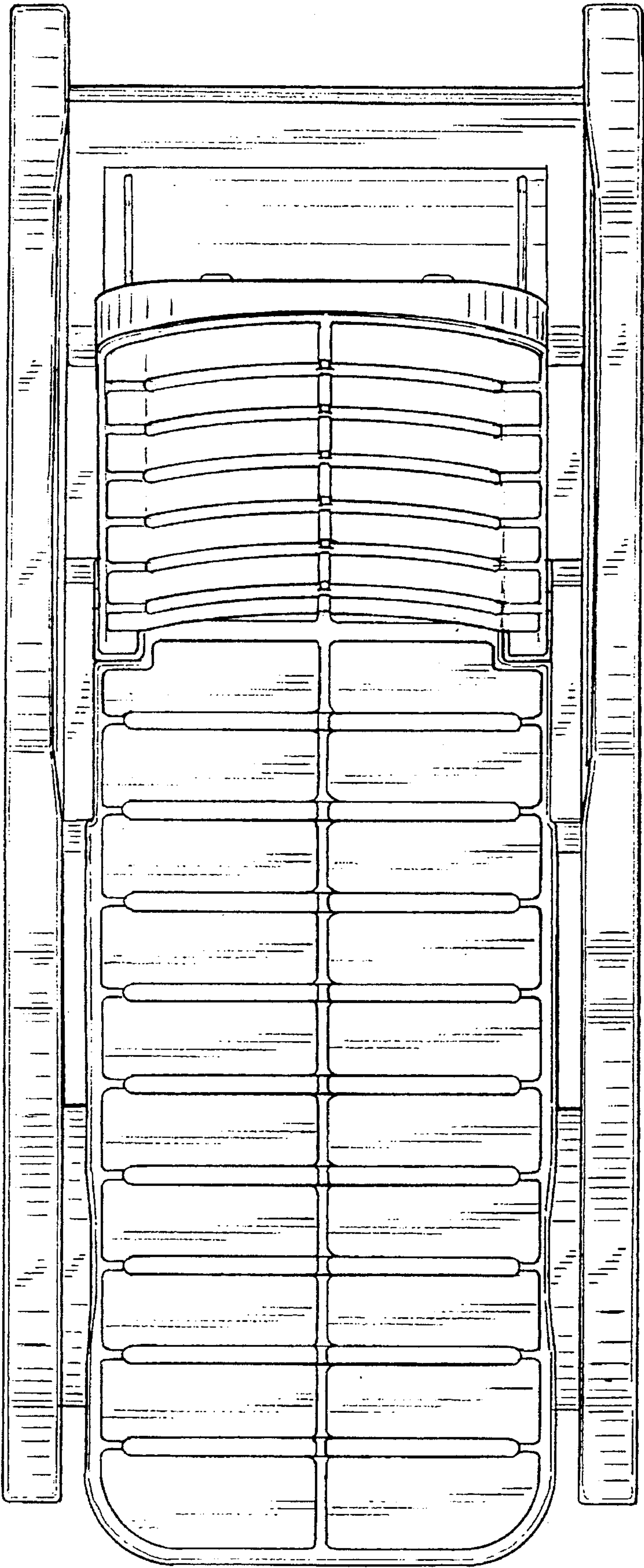

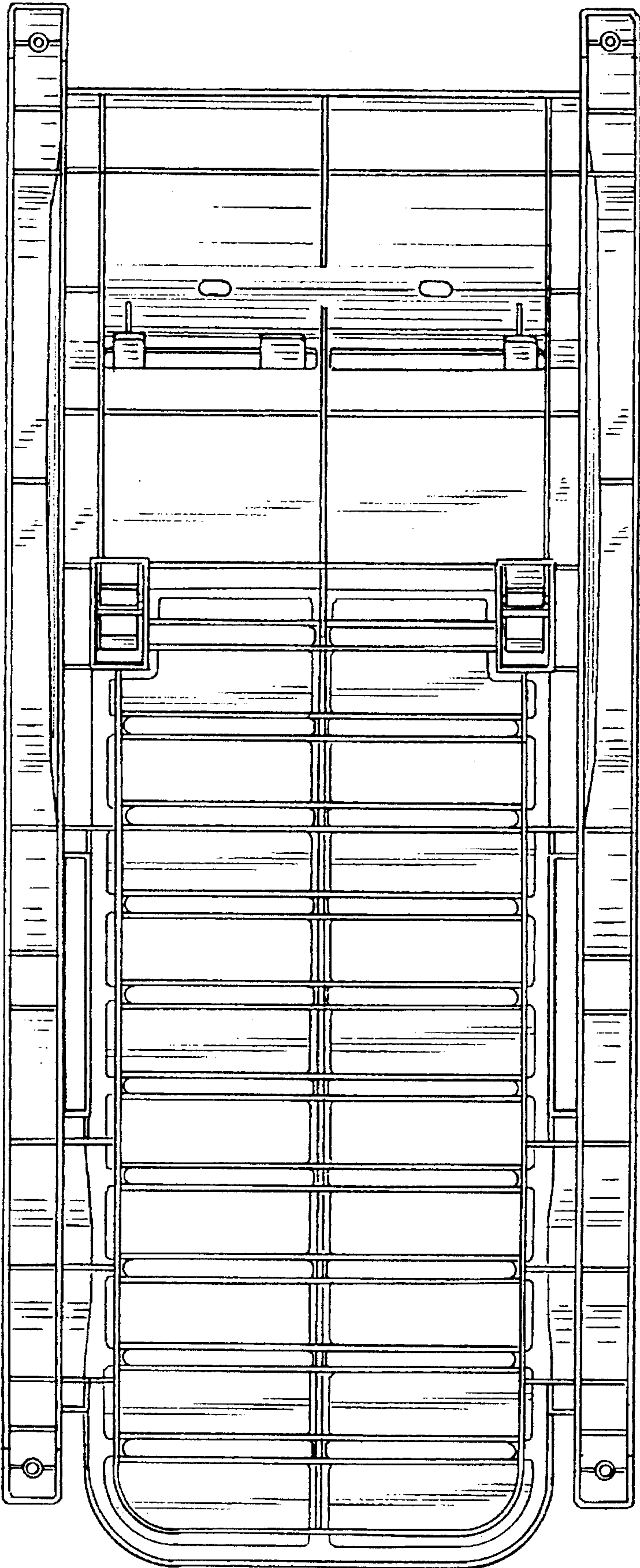
