[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined chair and footstool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my combined chair and footstool;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of my chair, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of my chair;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of my chair;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of my chair;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of my chair;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of my footstool;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of my footstool;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of my footstool;

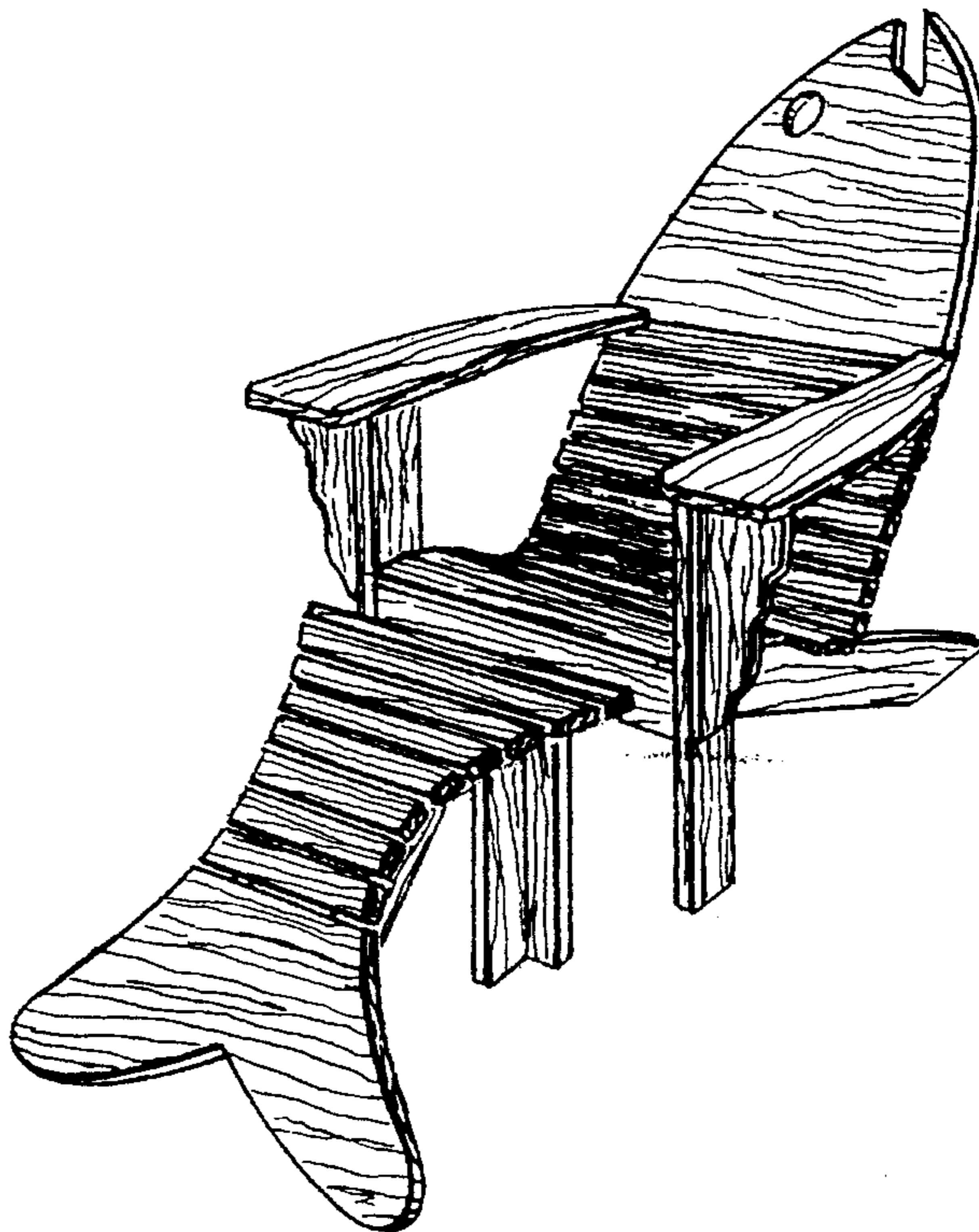
FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of my footstool;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of my footstool; and,

FIG. 12 is a left side elevational view of my footstool, the right side being a mirror image thereof.

The footstool has not been shown in FIGS. 2 through 6 for ease of illustration and the chair has not been shown in FIGS. 7 through 12 for ease of illustration.

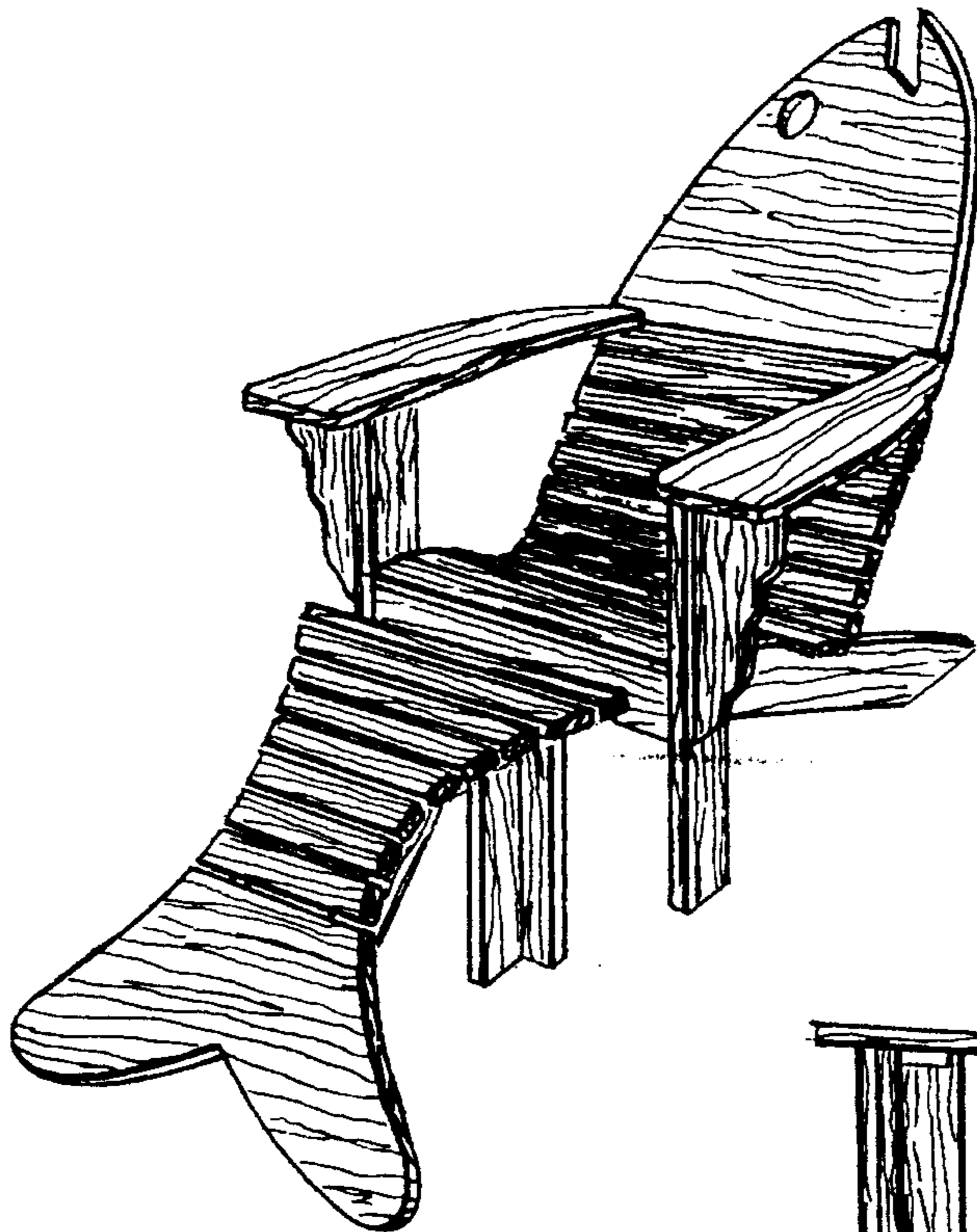

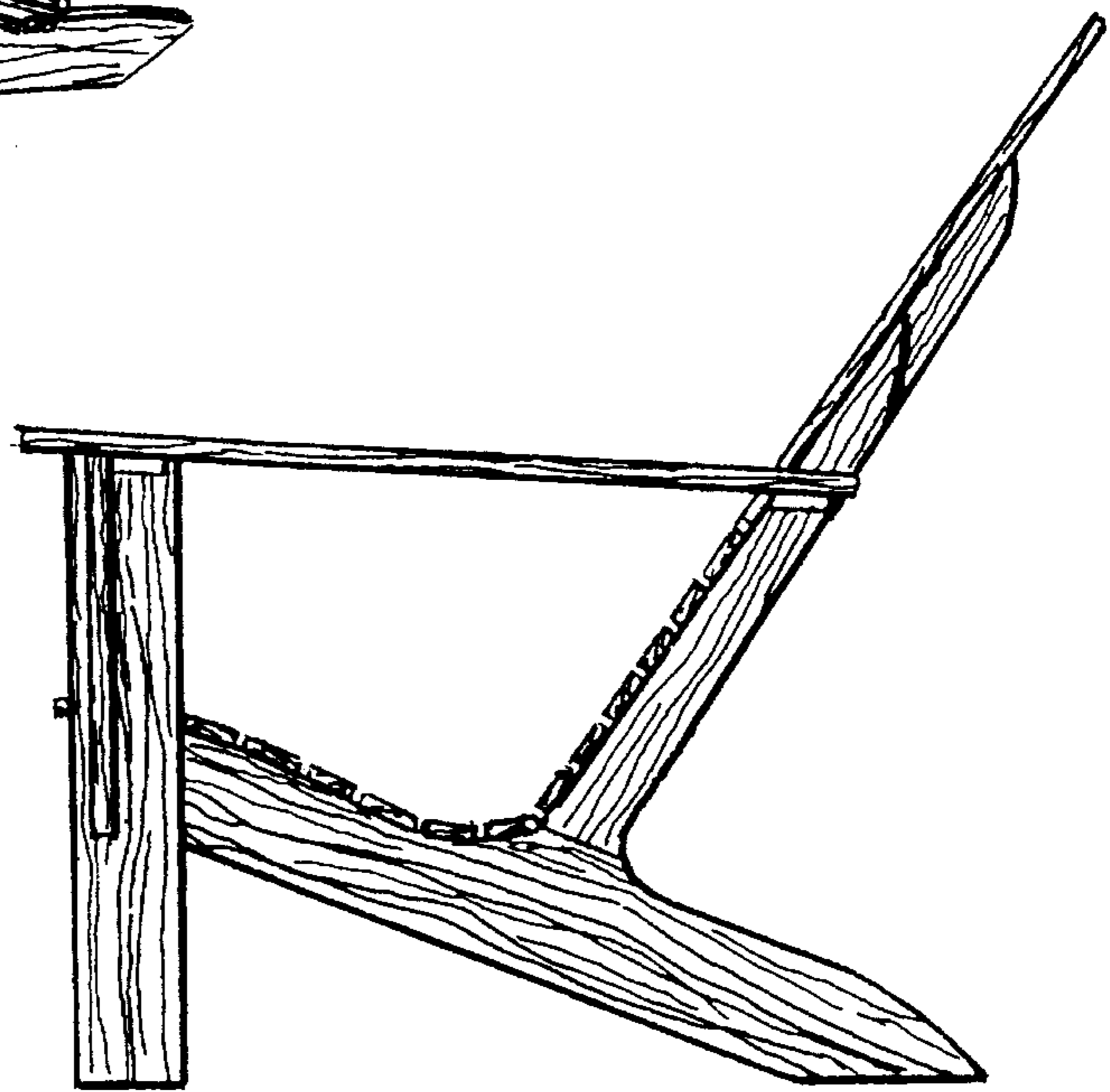

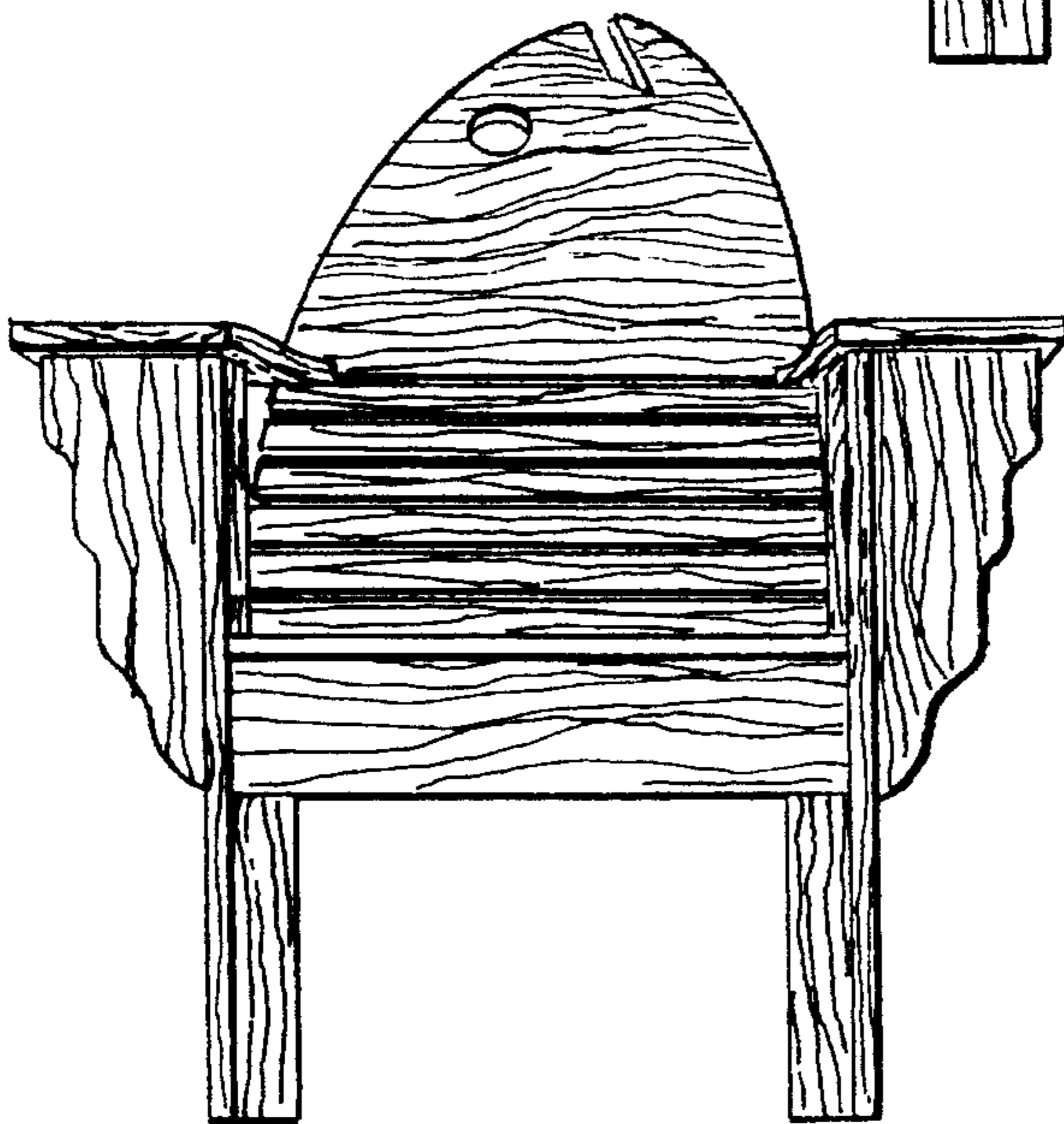

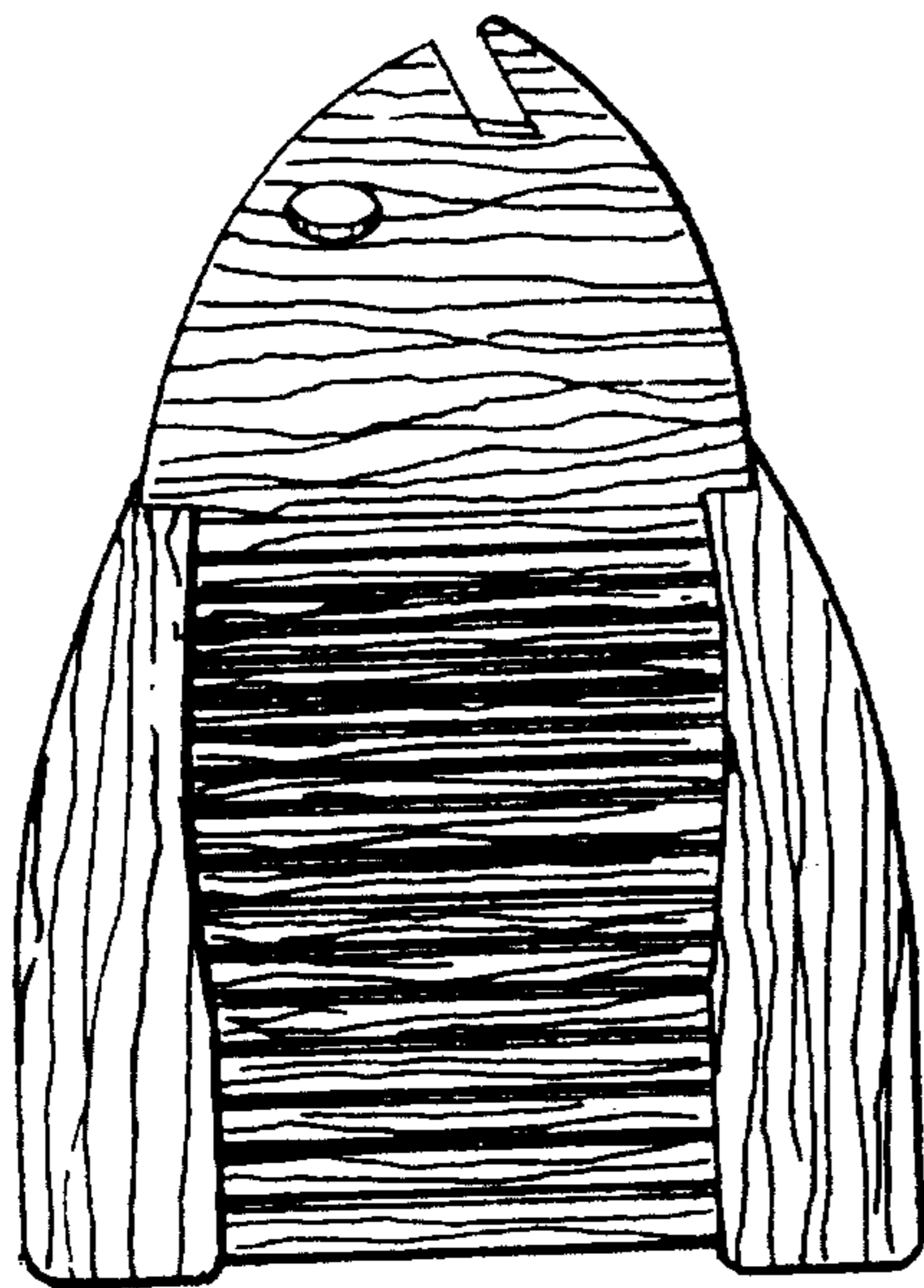

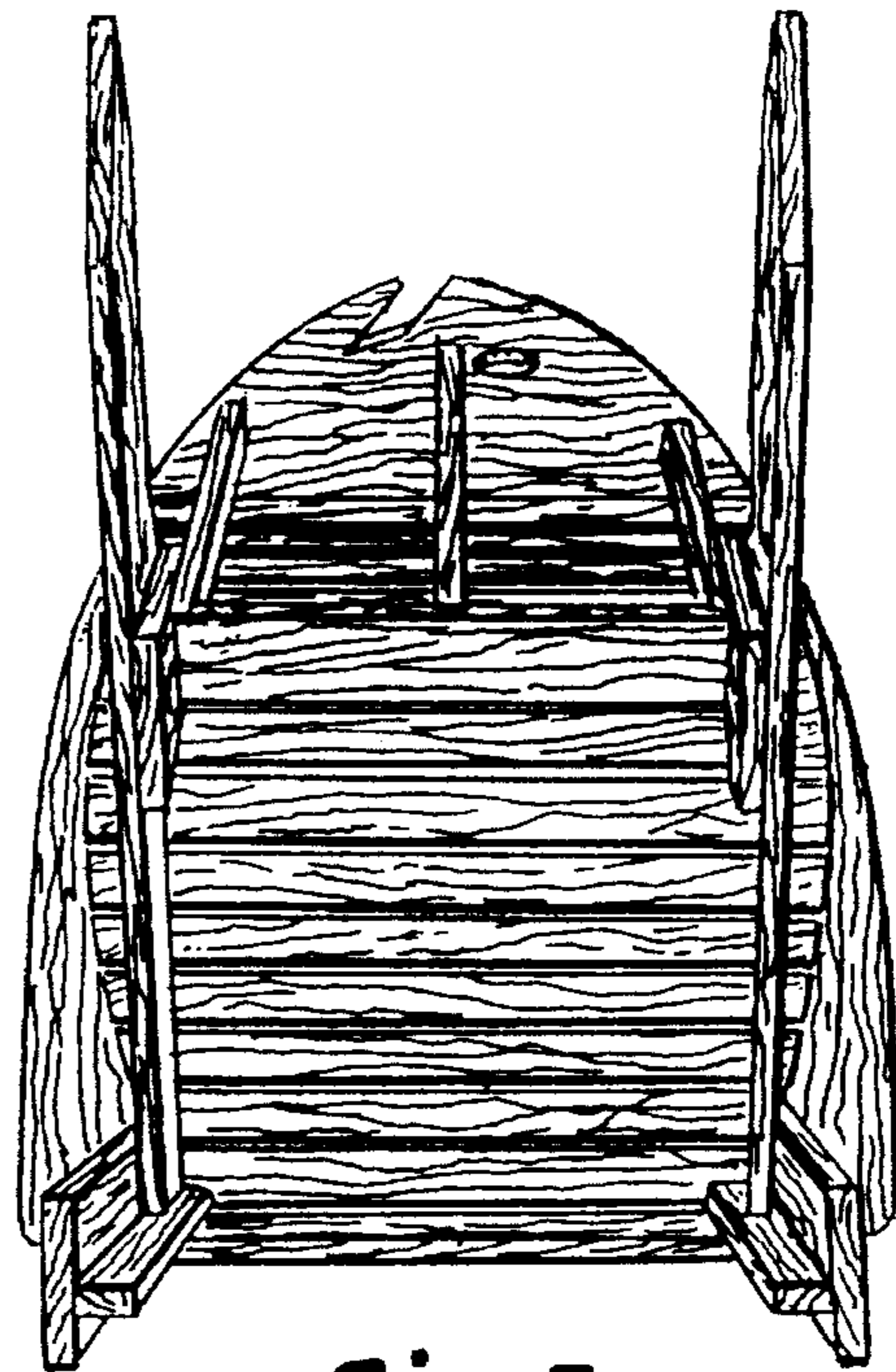

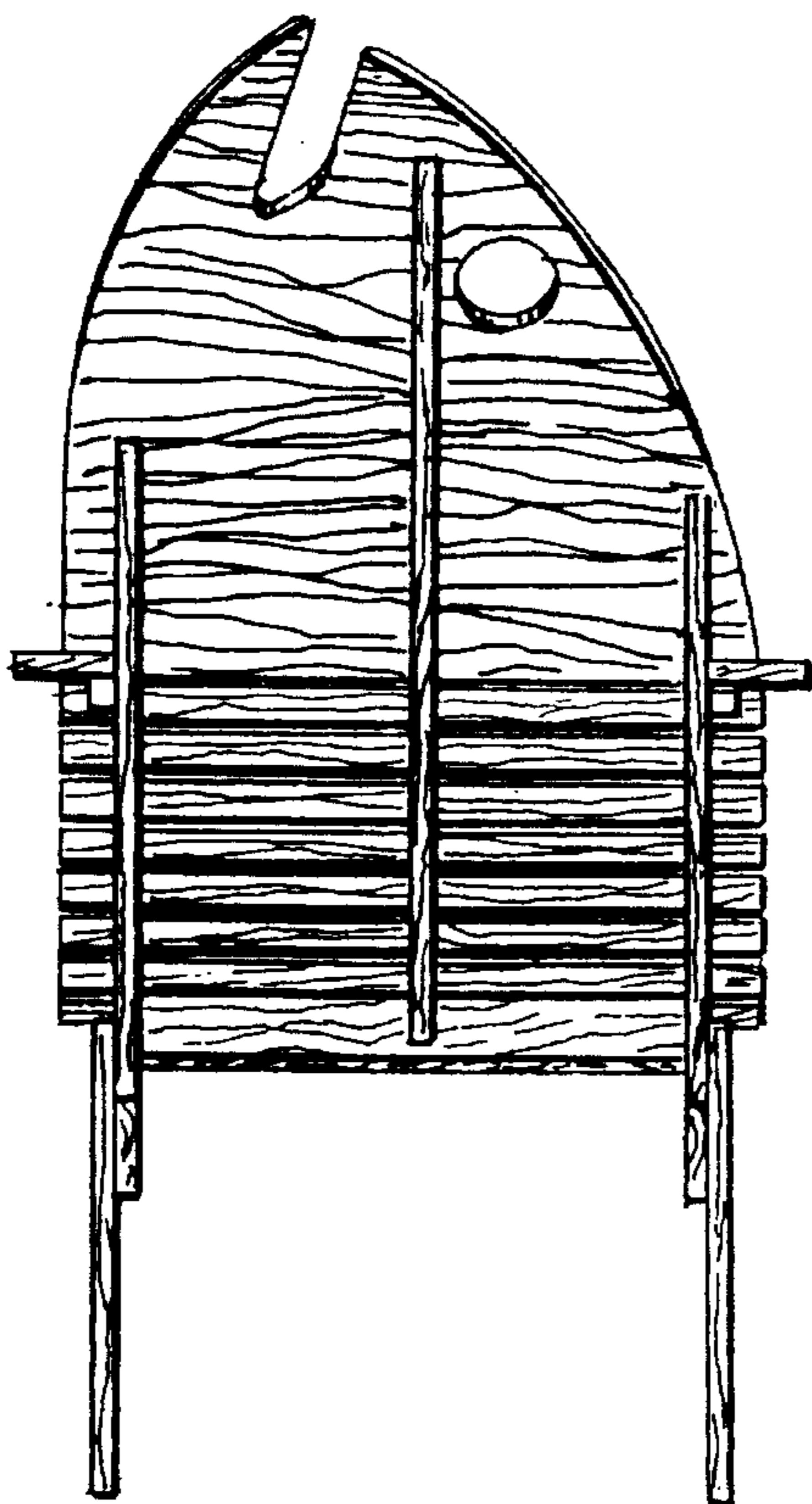

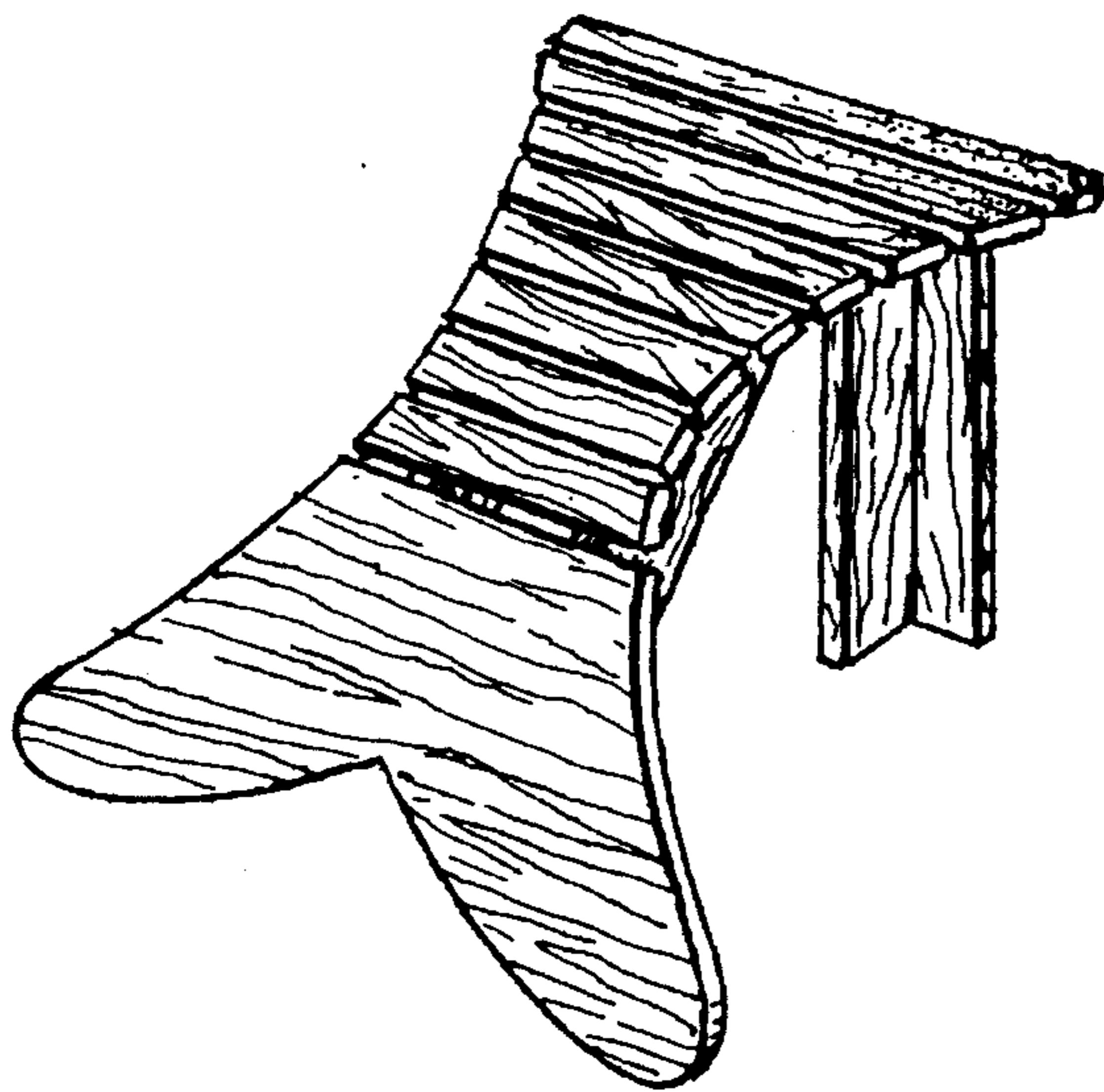

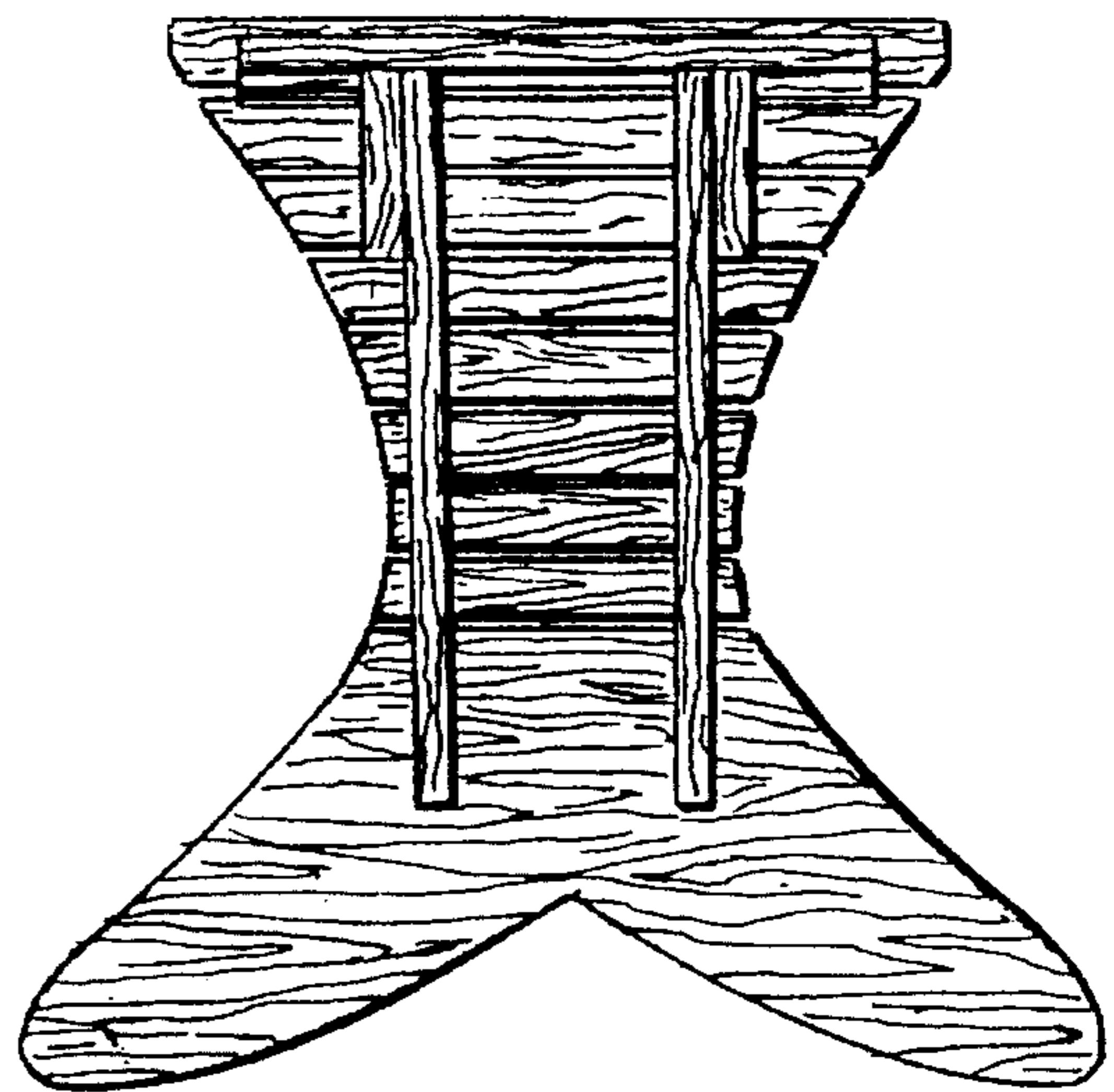

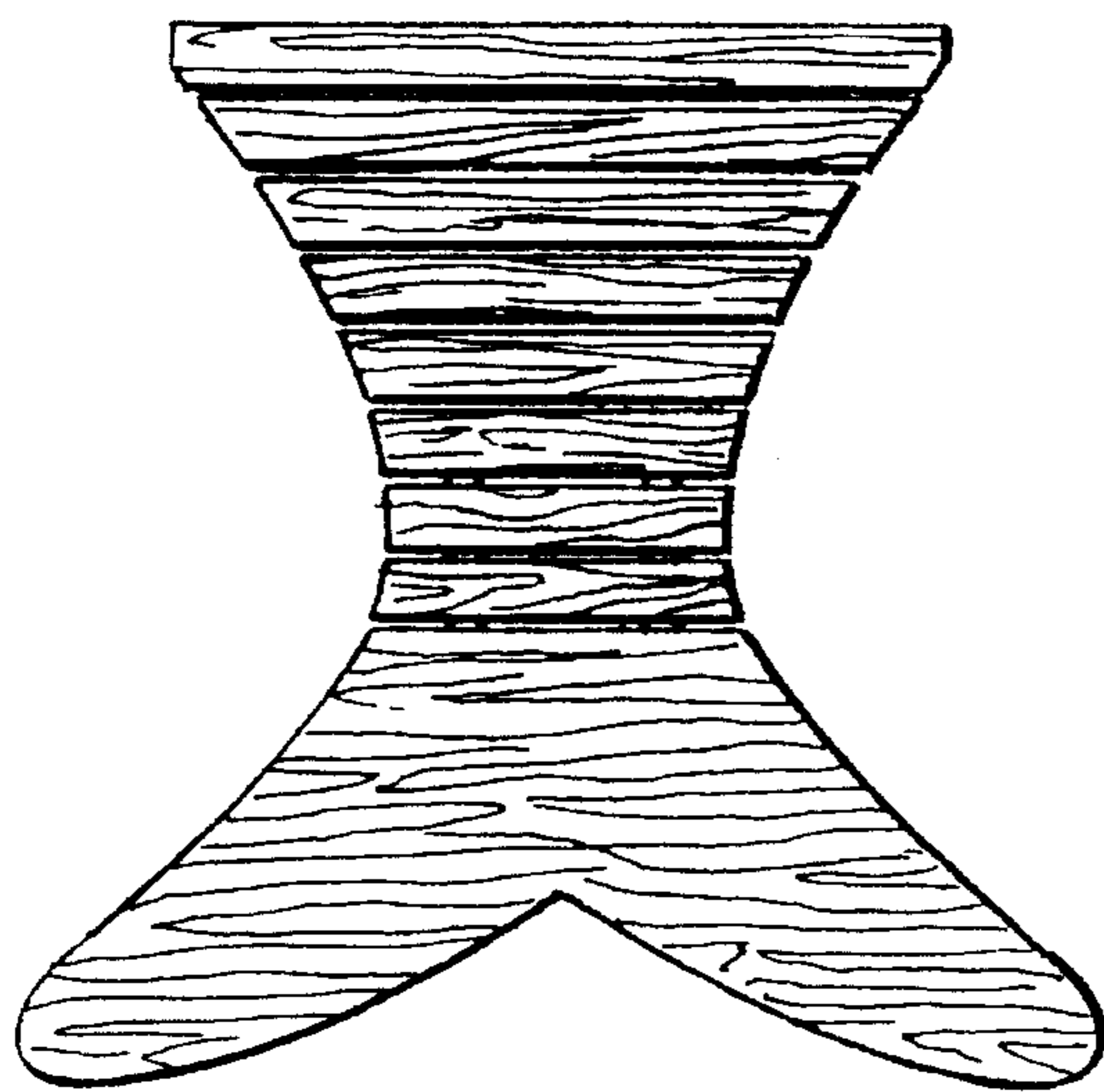

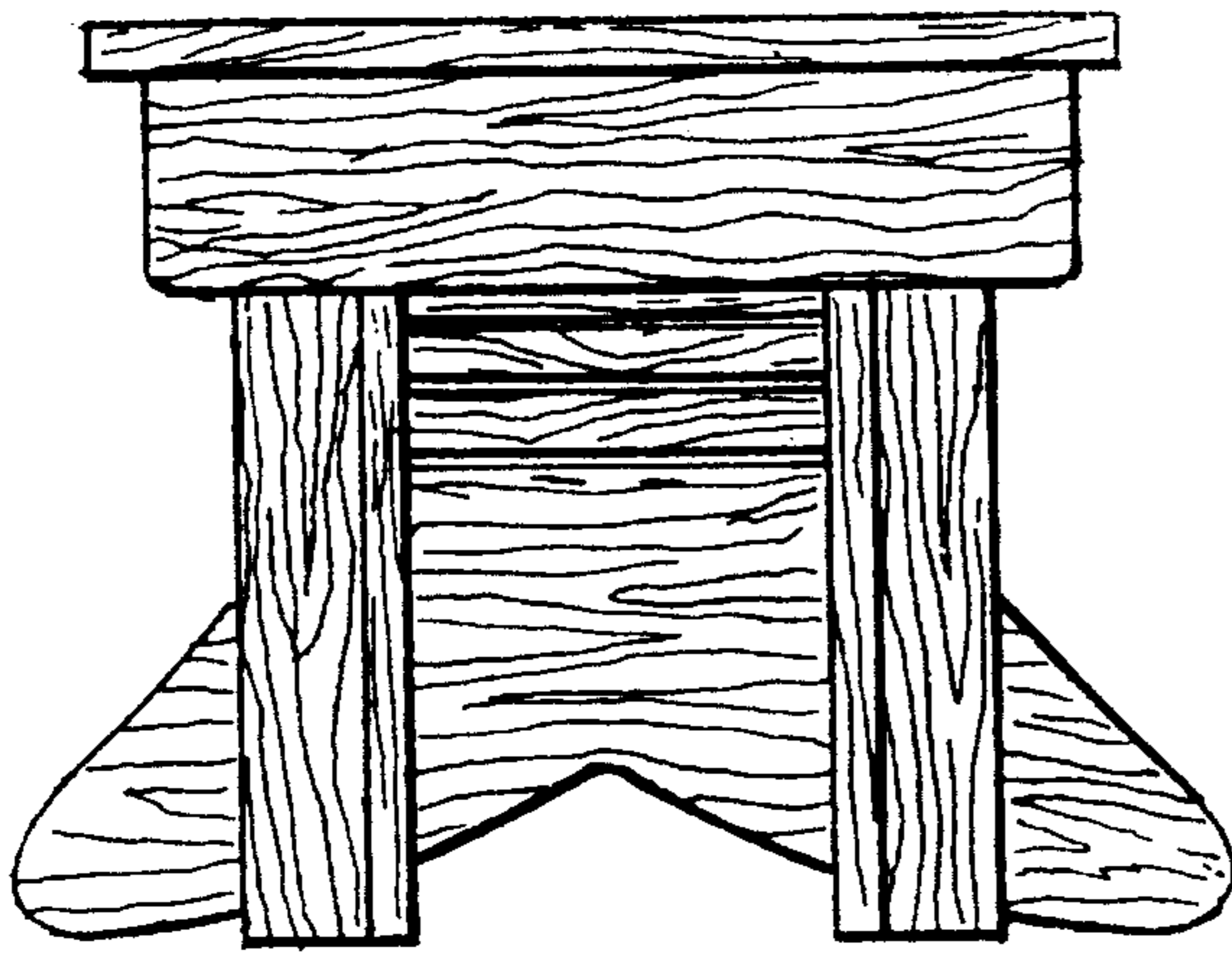

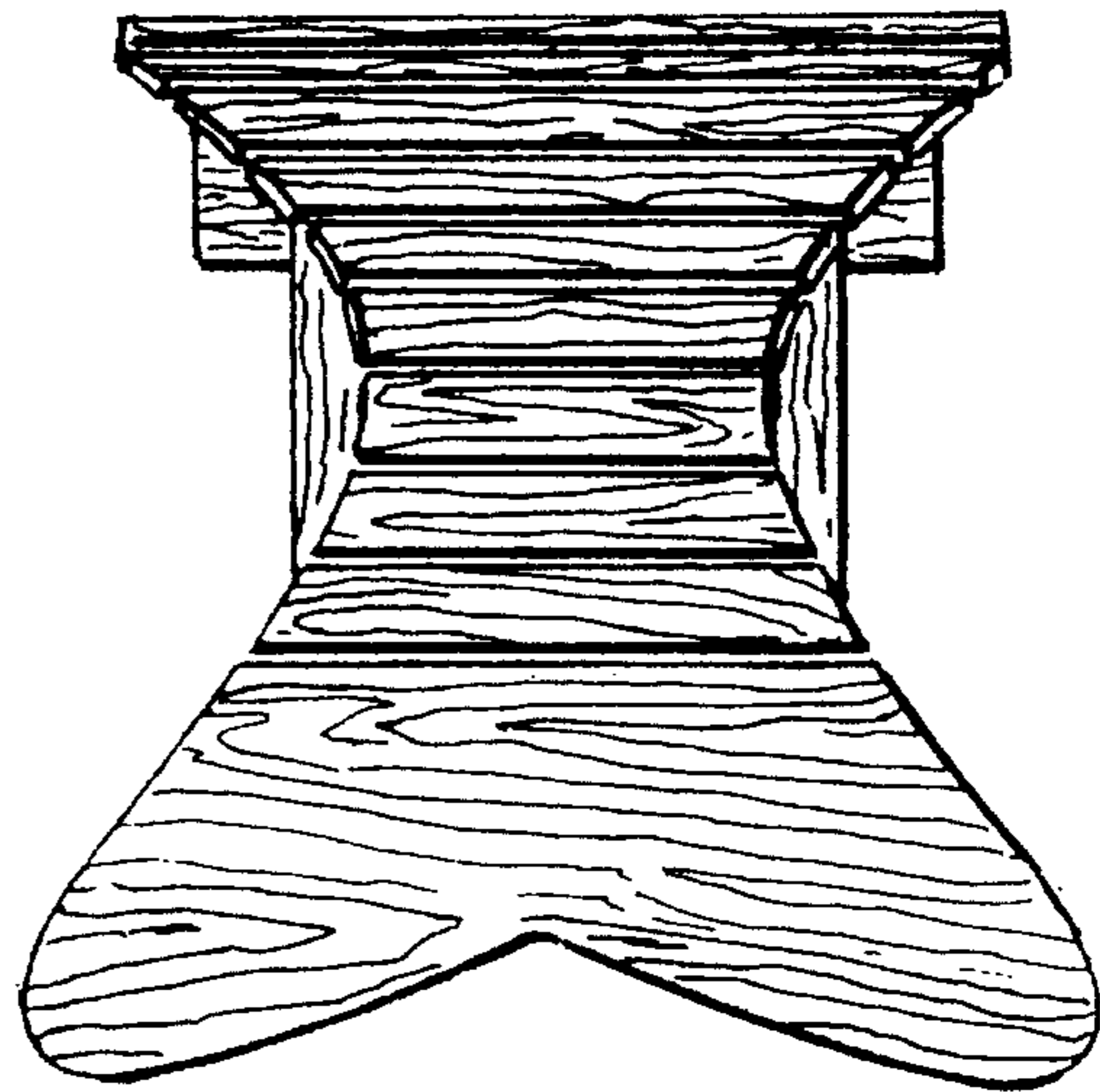

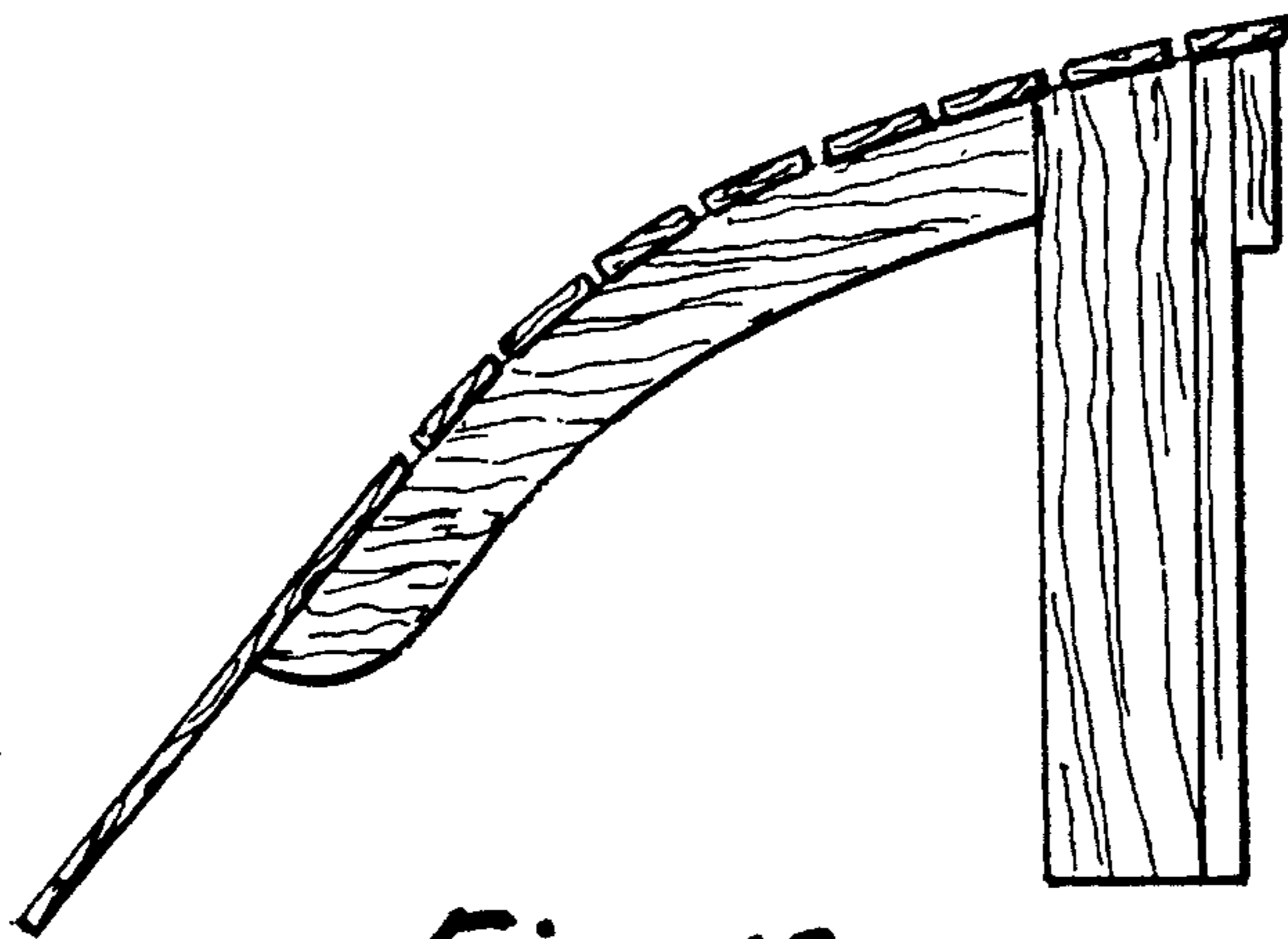
