[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hockey puck shot glass, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a hockey puck shot glass showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, all sides being the same;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a partial cross sectional view thereof, taken along lines 5—5 of FIG. 2 broken away for ease of illustration.

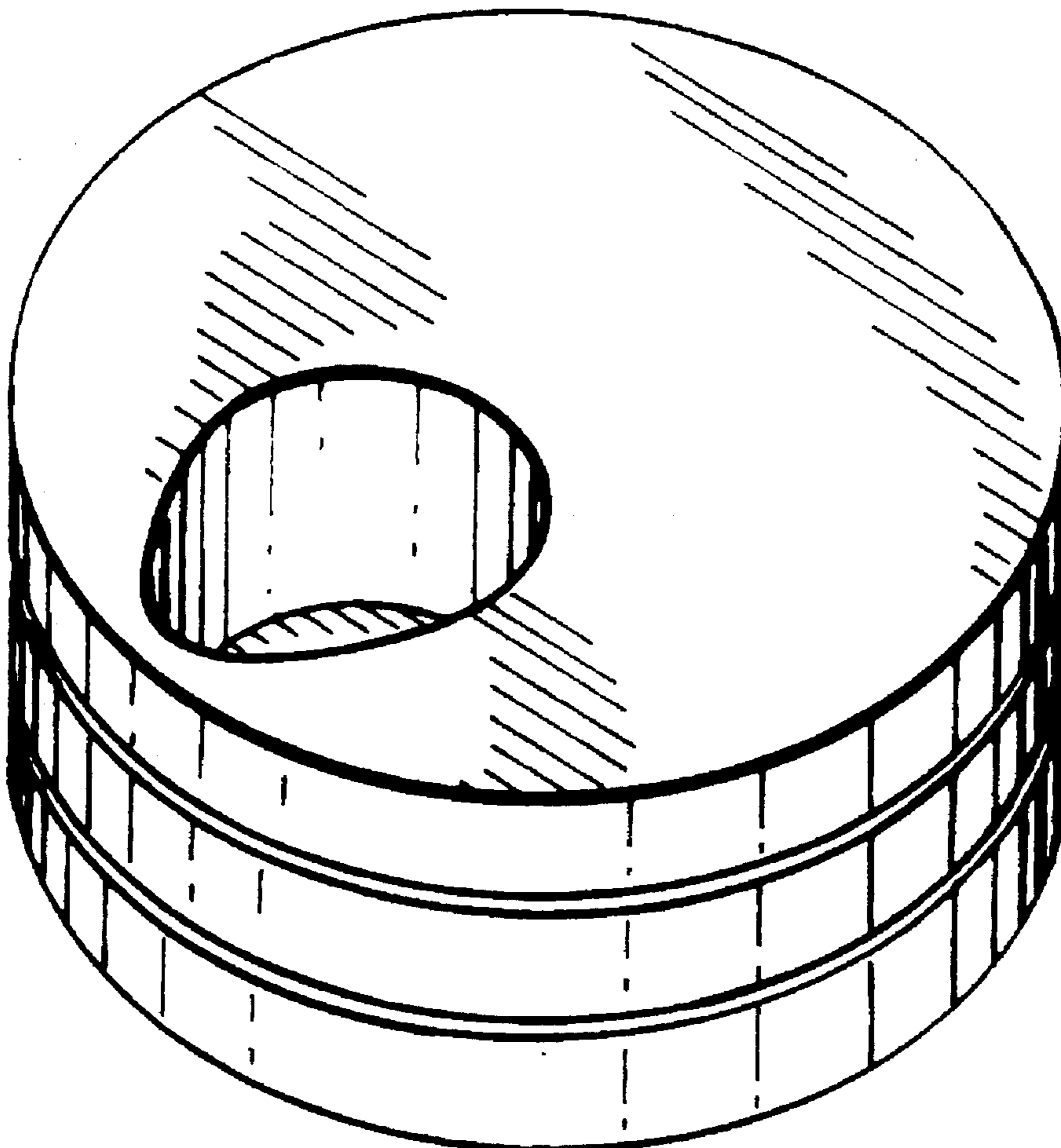

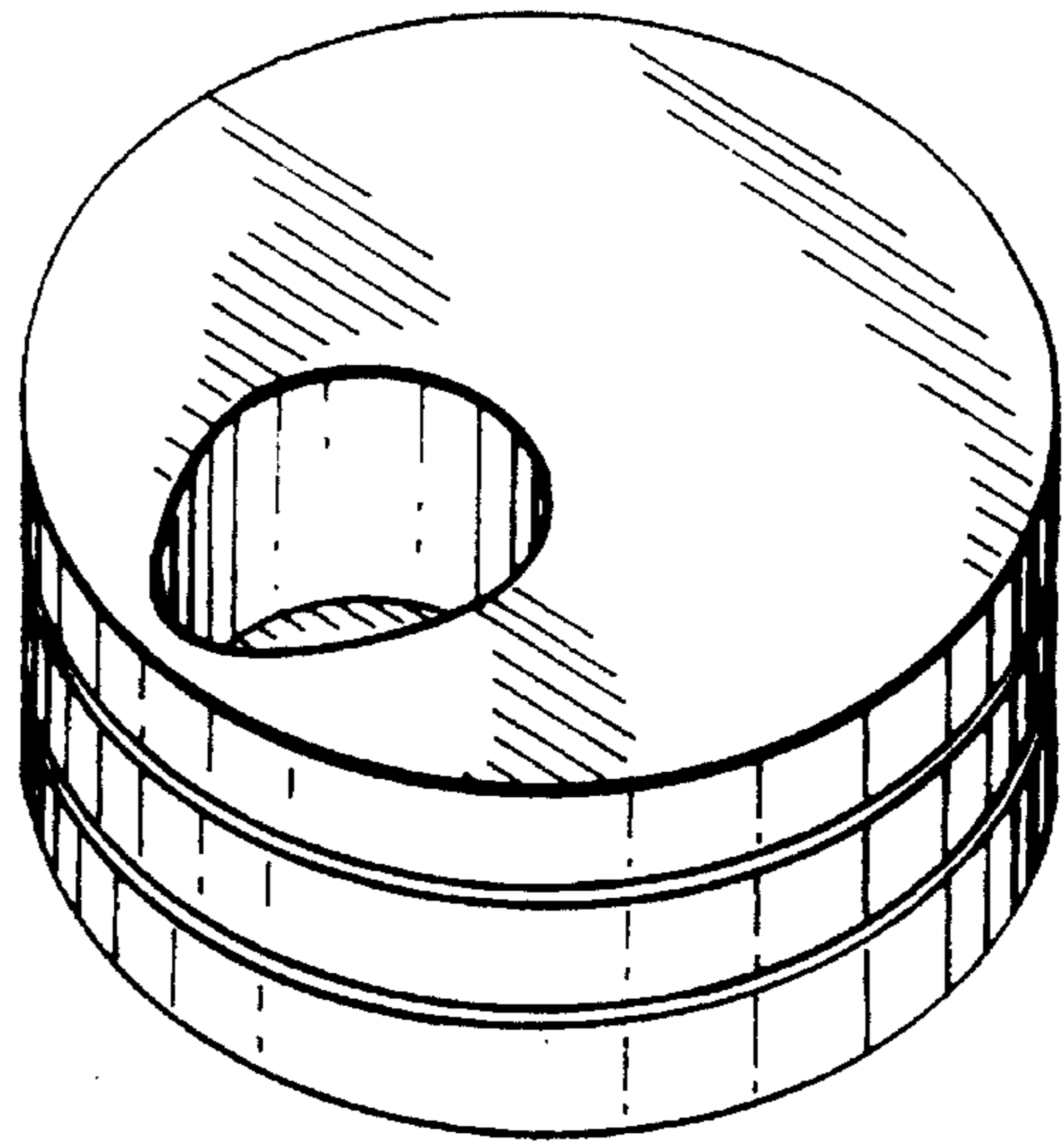

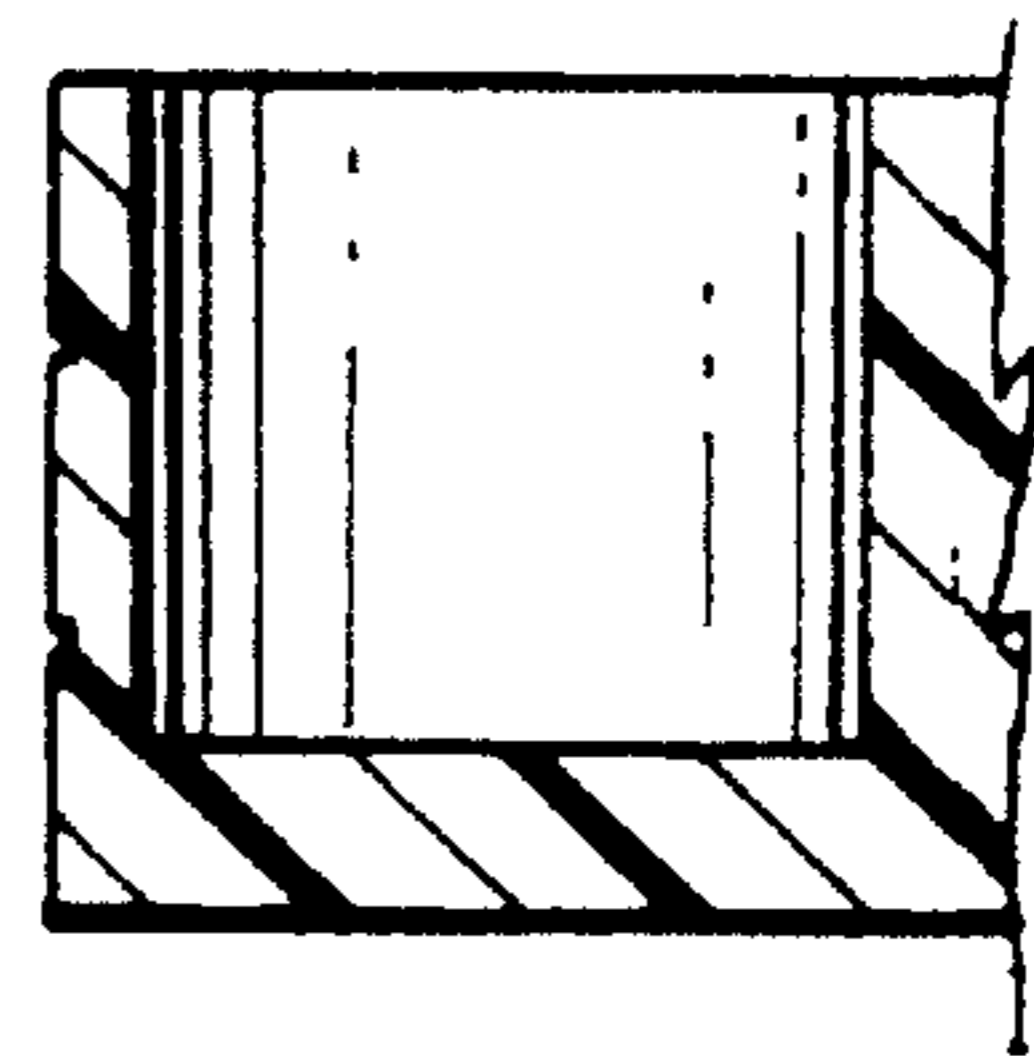
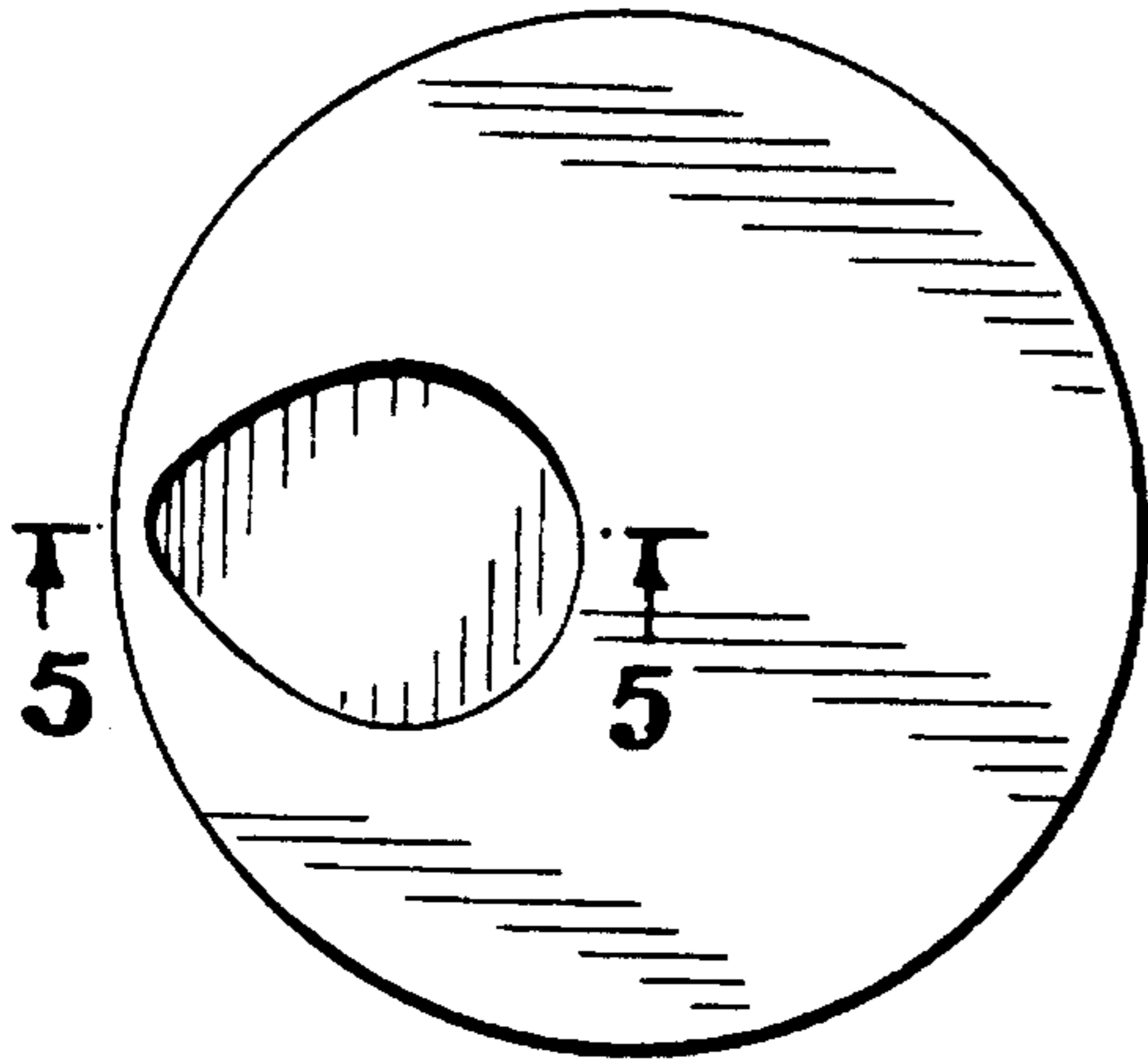

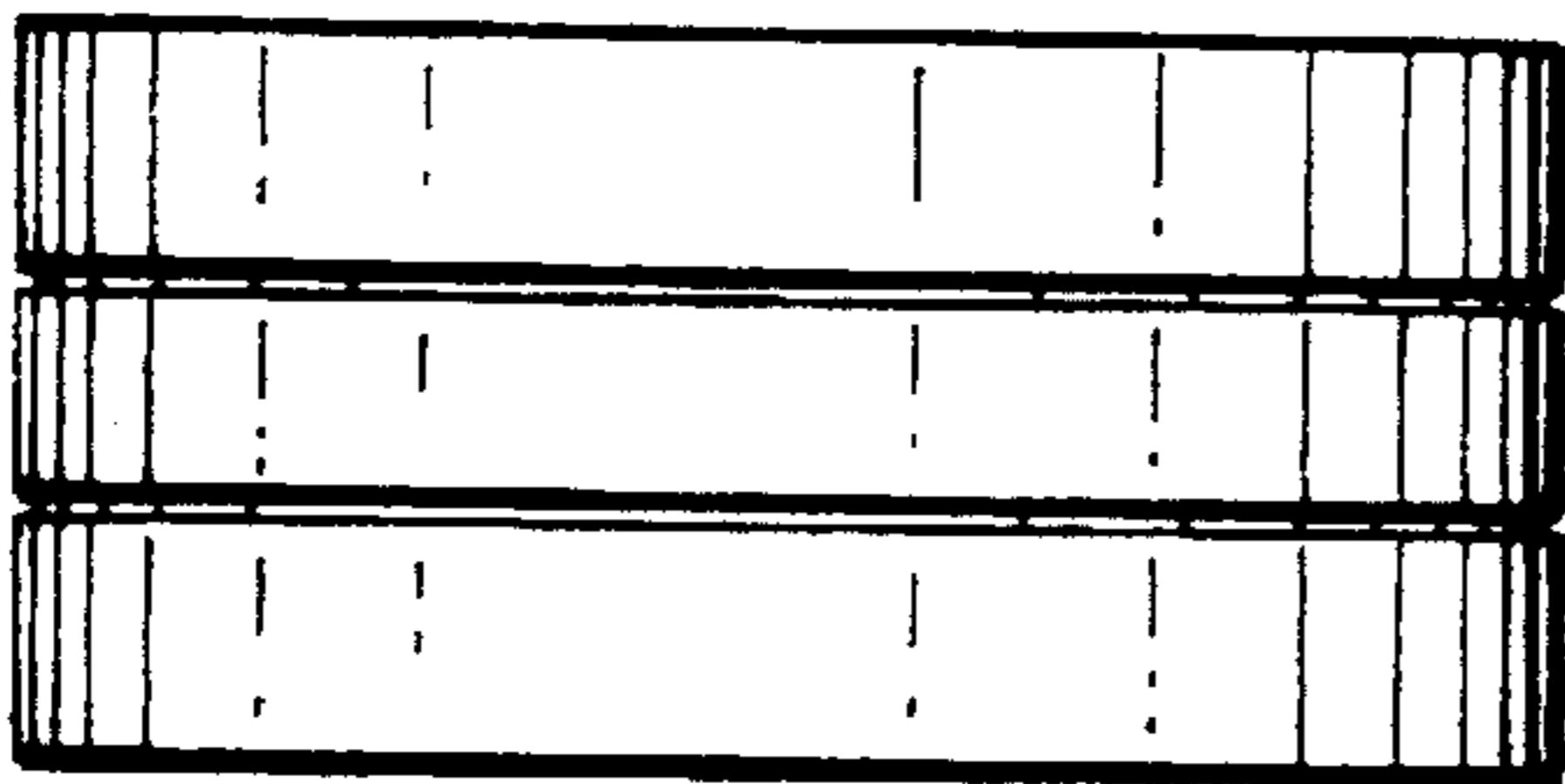

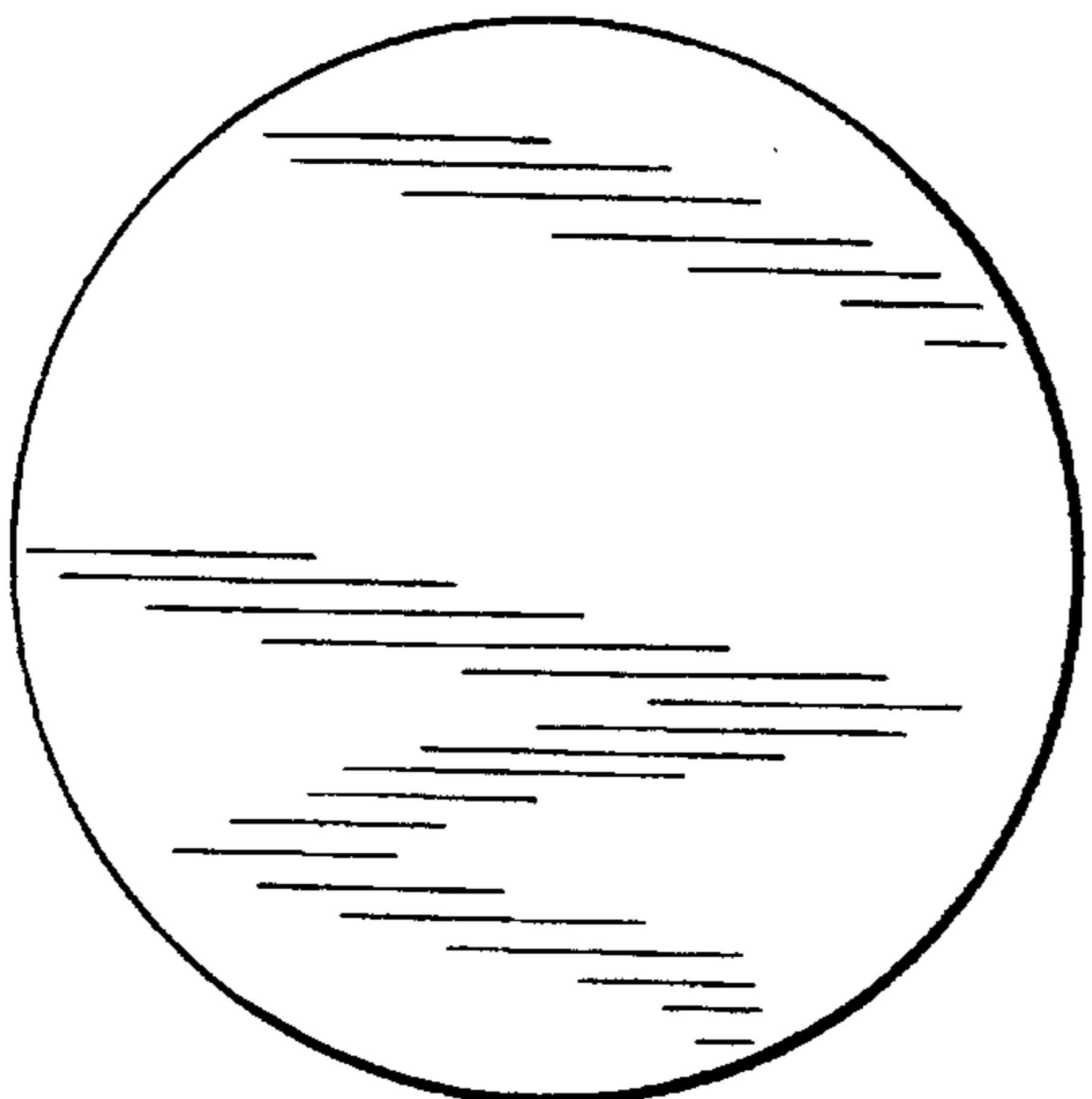
