DESCRIPTION

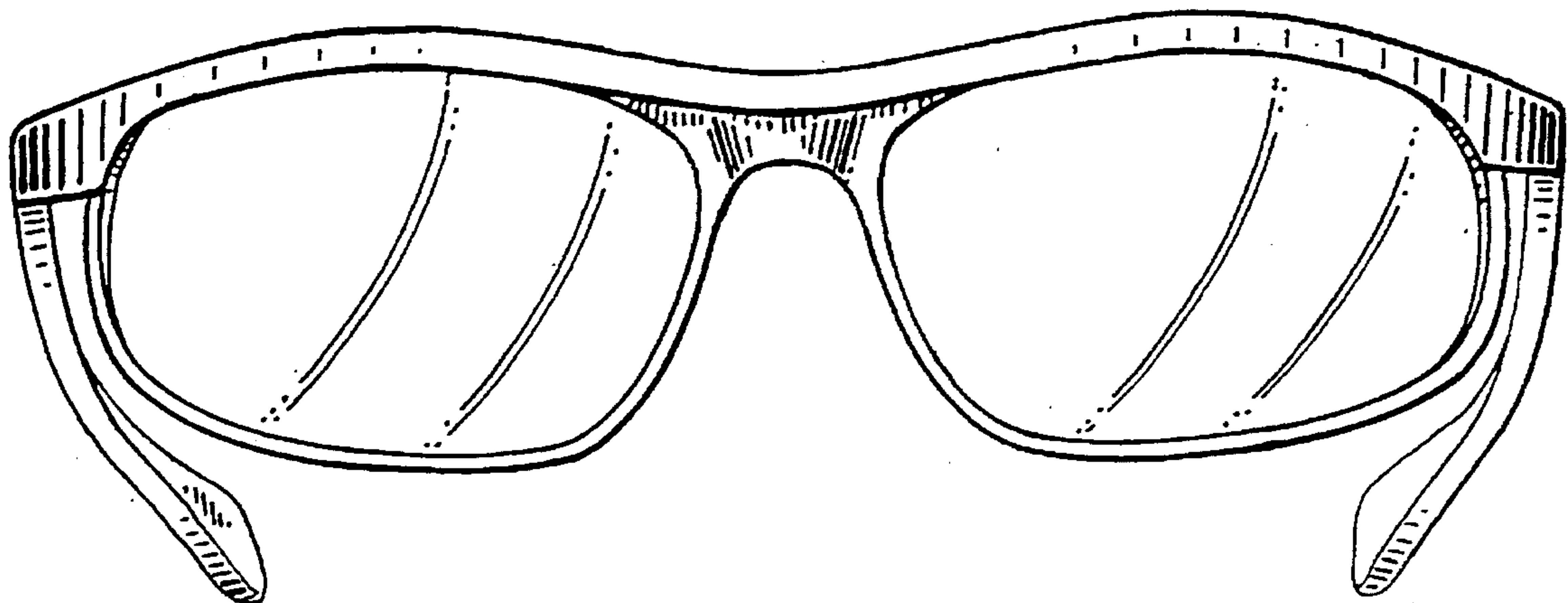
FIG. 1 is a front view of a pair of sunglasses showing my new design;

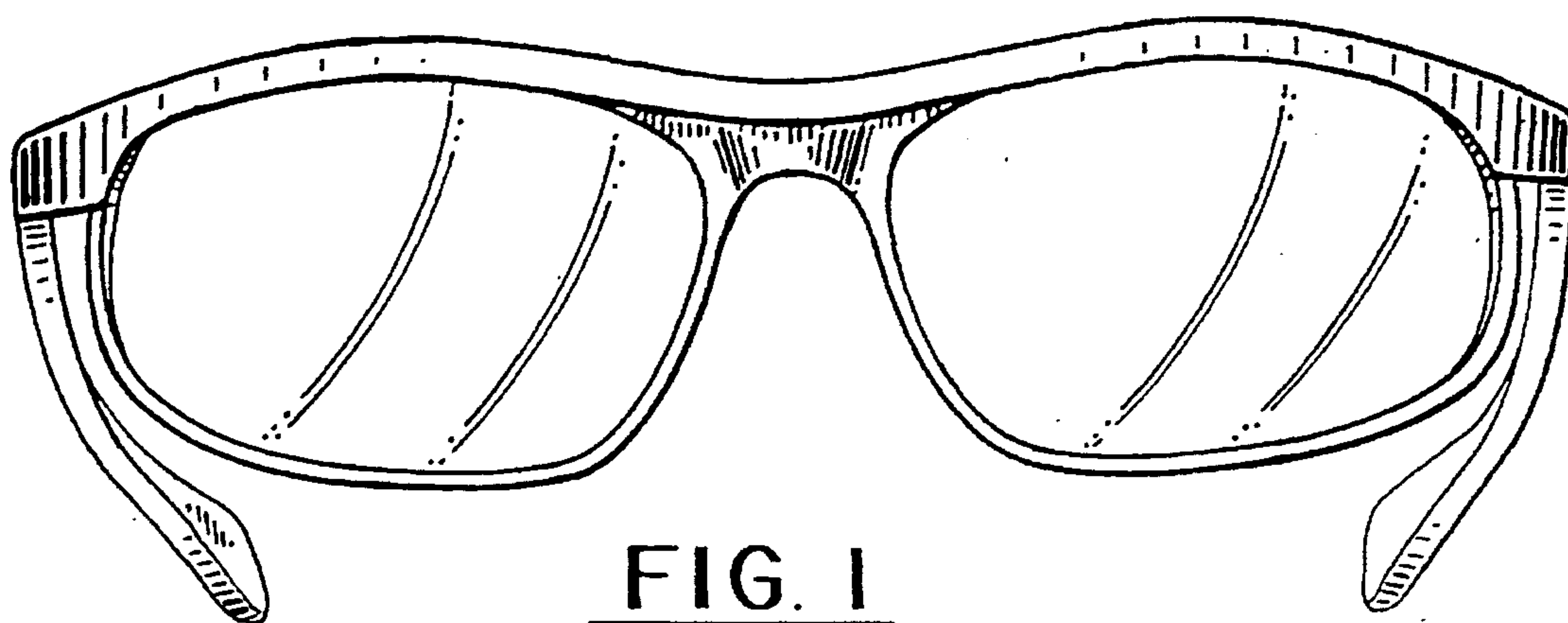

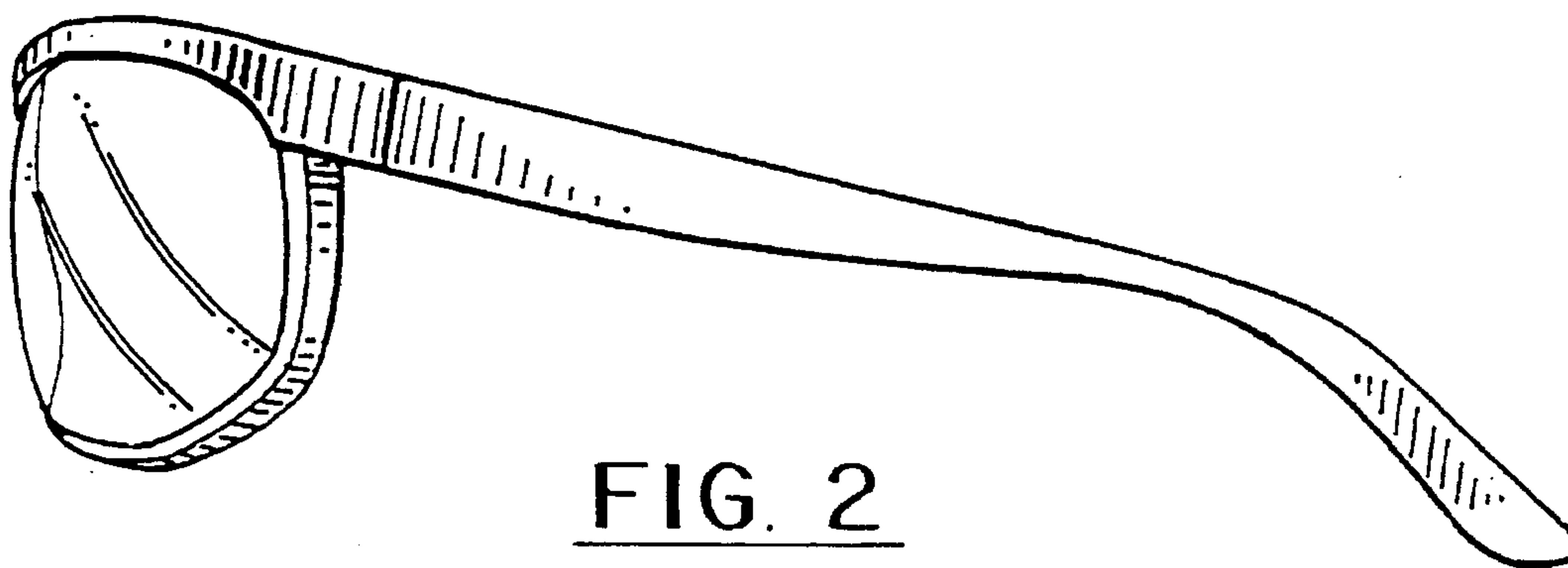

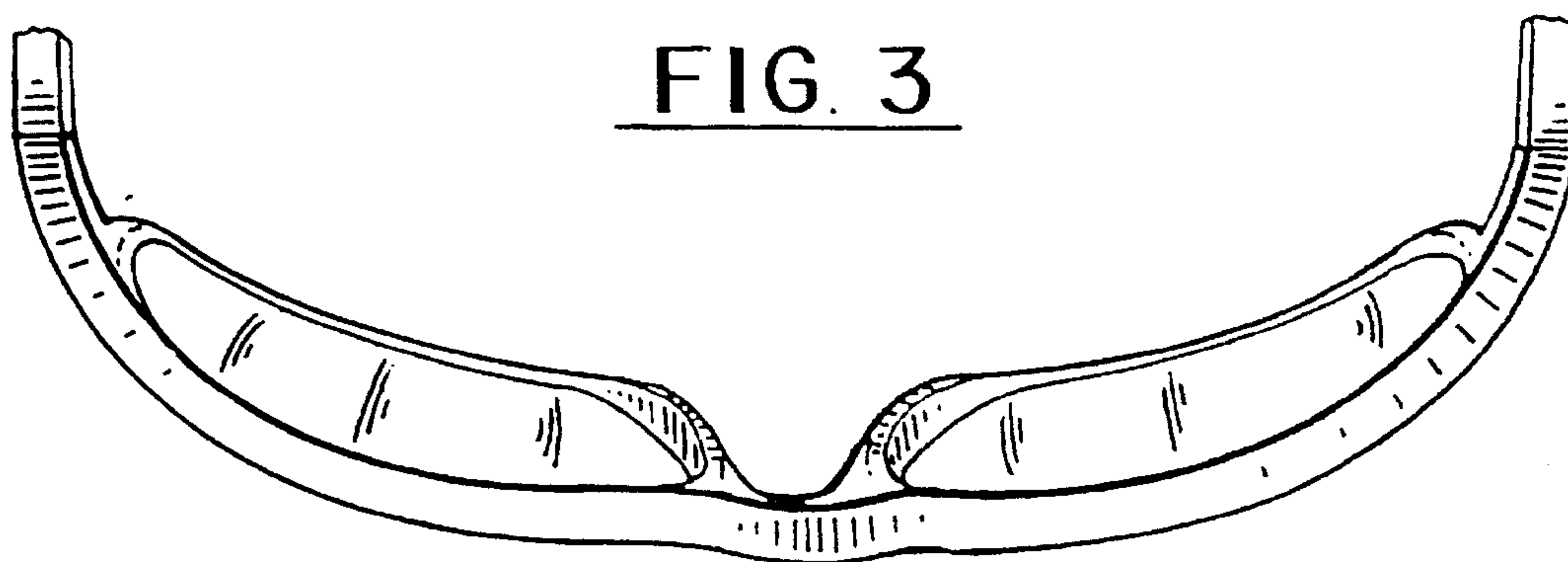
