FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary perspective view thereof as indicated by the line 2—2 in FIG. 1;

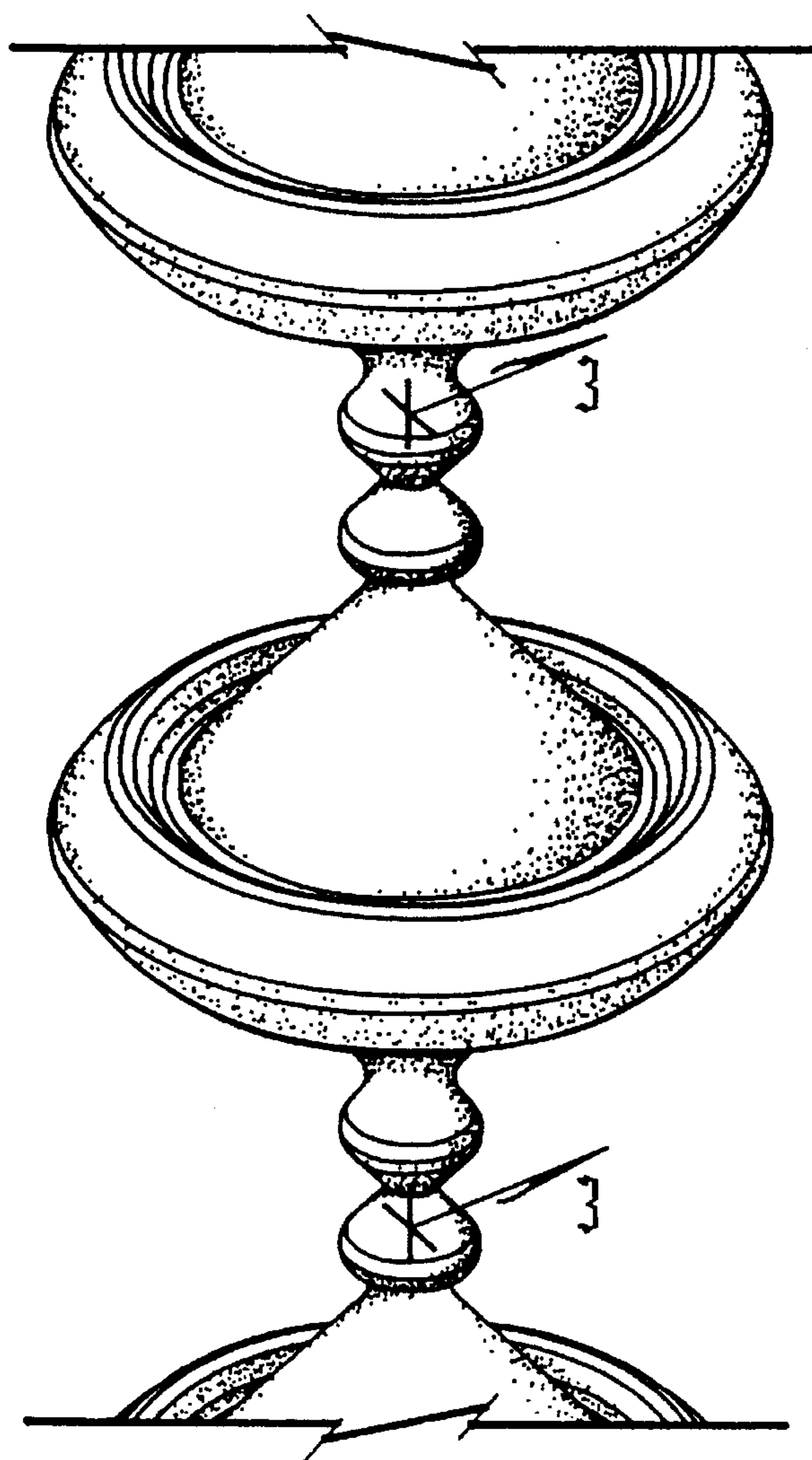
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along the line 3—3 in FIG. 2;

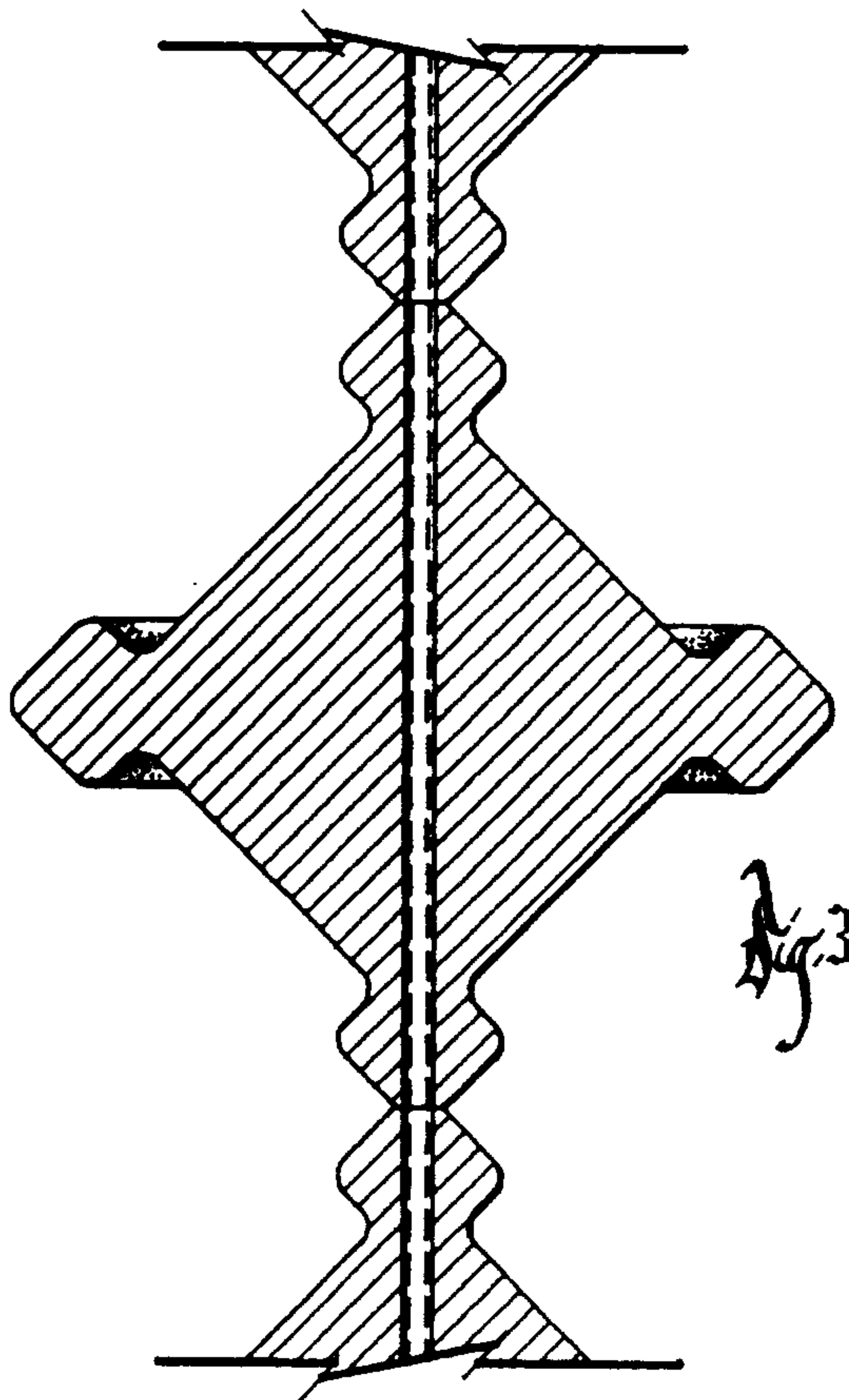
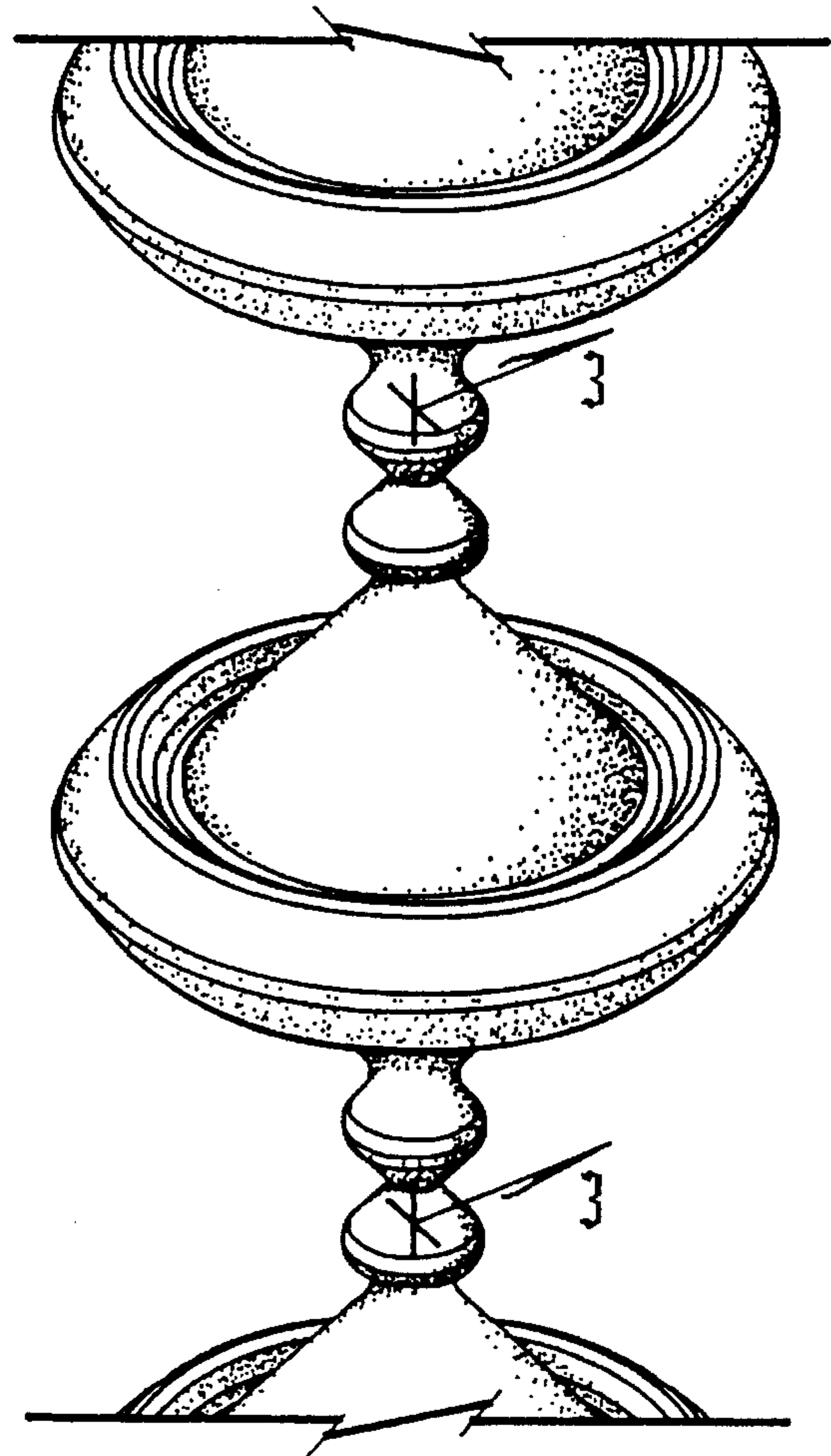
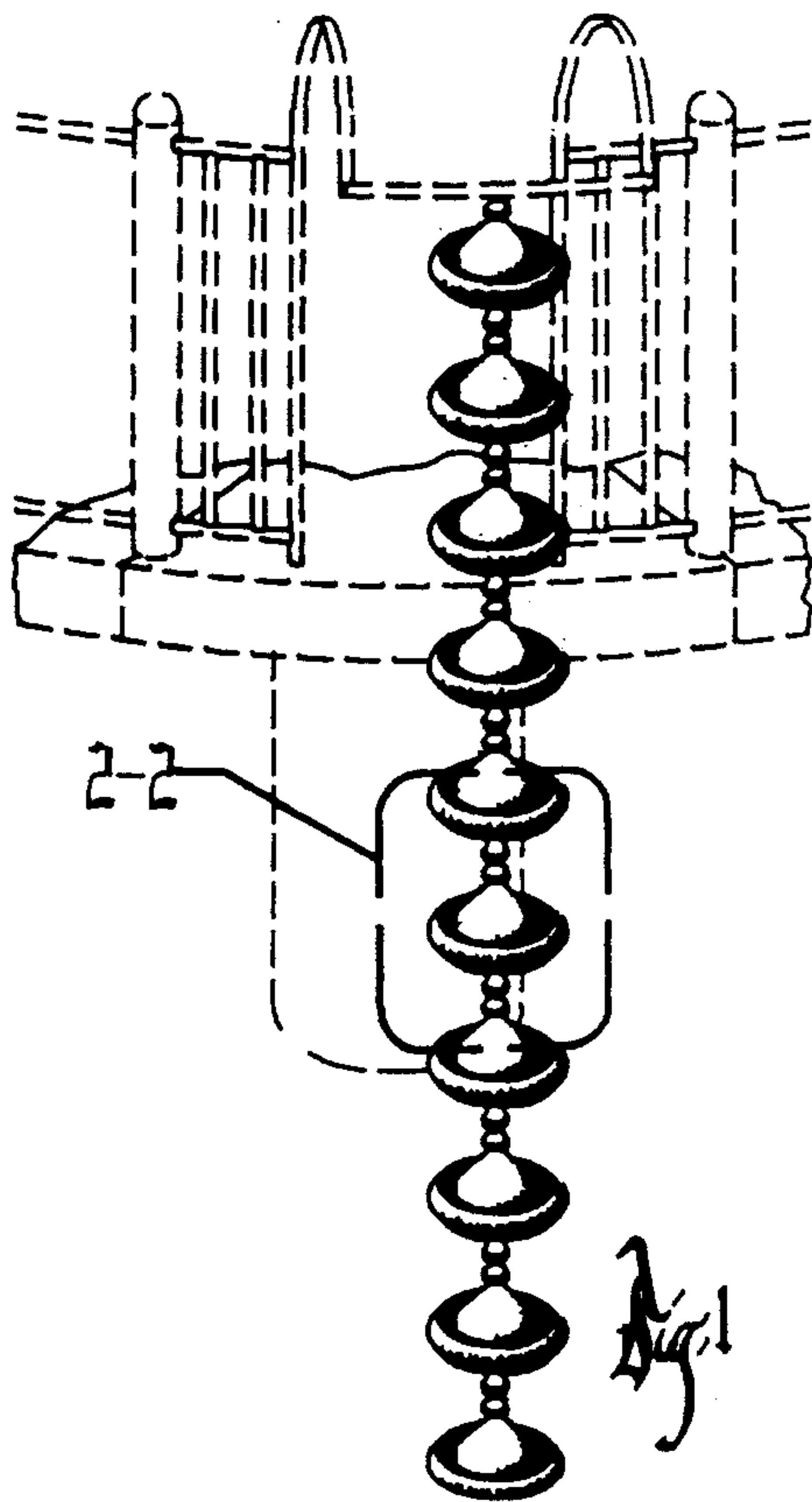
FIG. 4 is an enlarged elevational view of FIG. 1, the undisclosed opposite sides being identical; and,

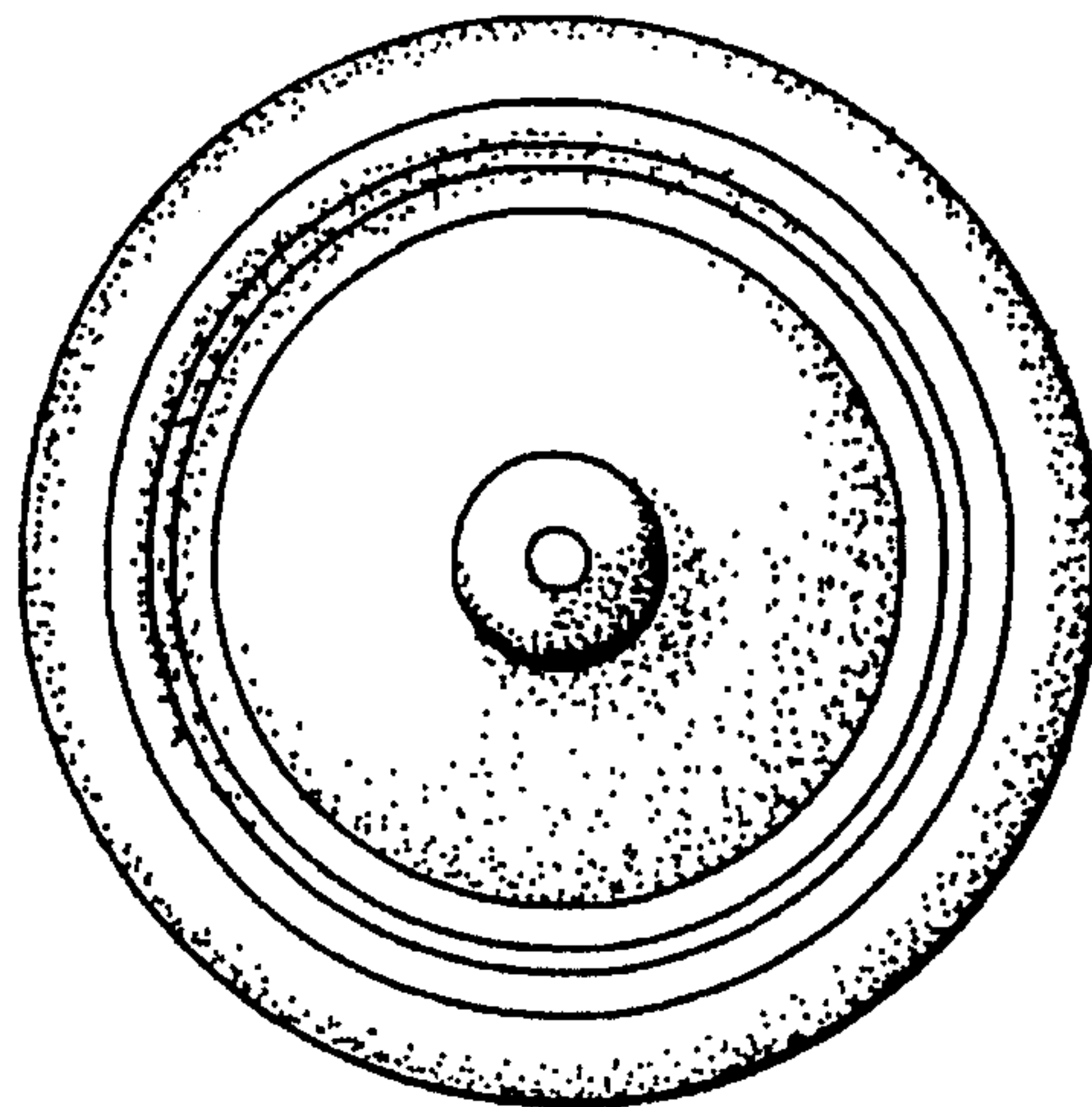
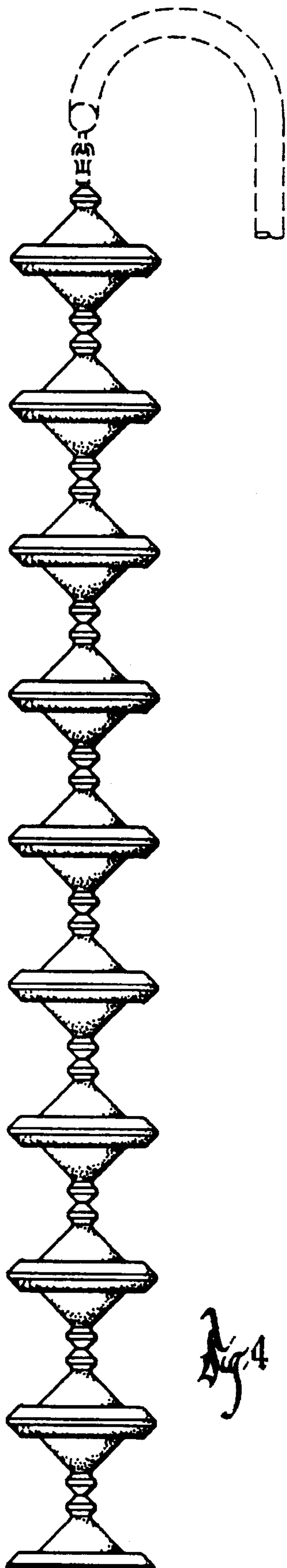
