The ornamental design for a water closet, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left, top, frontal perspective view of a water closet embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being the mirror image of the left side shown;

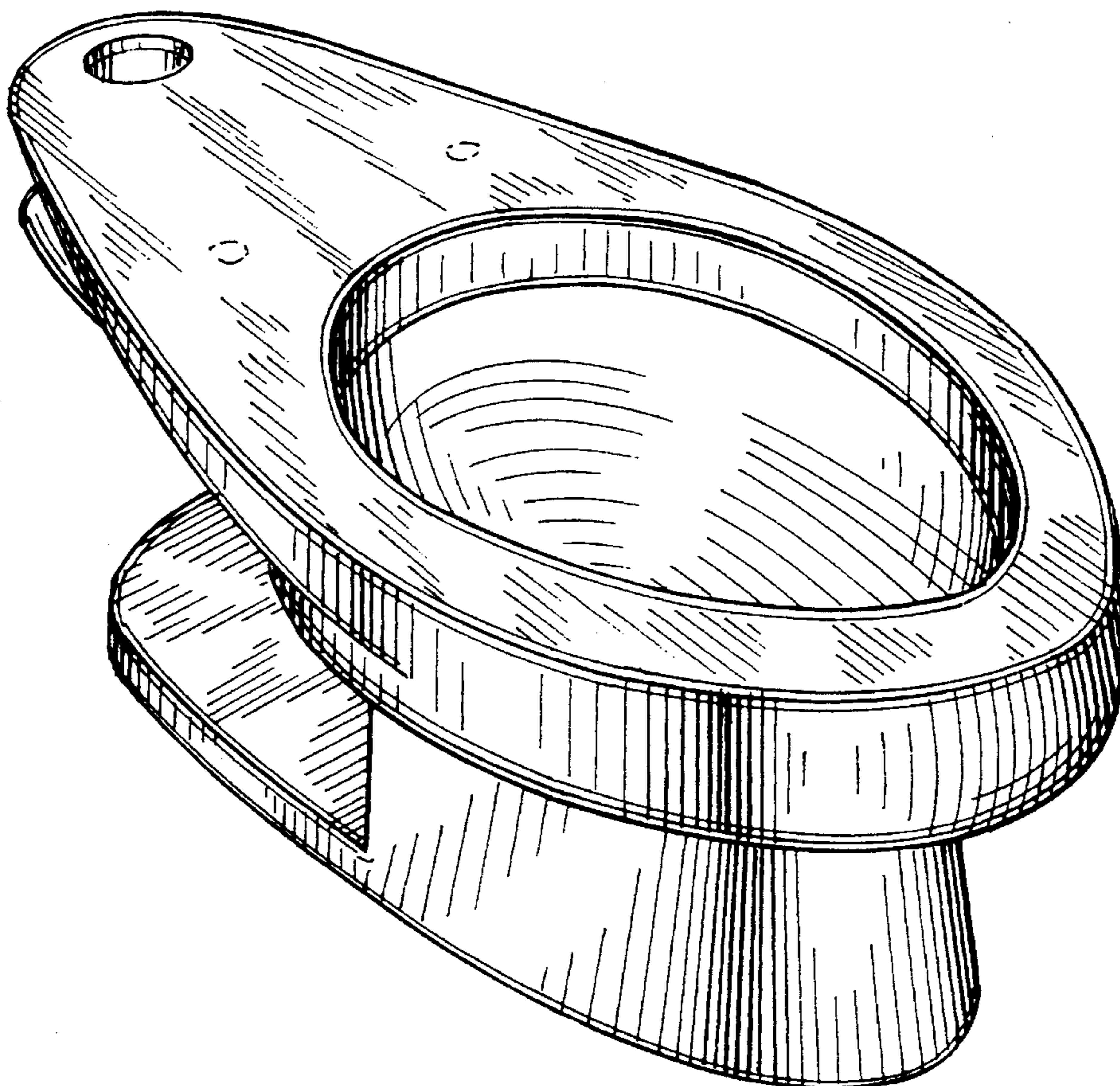
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

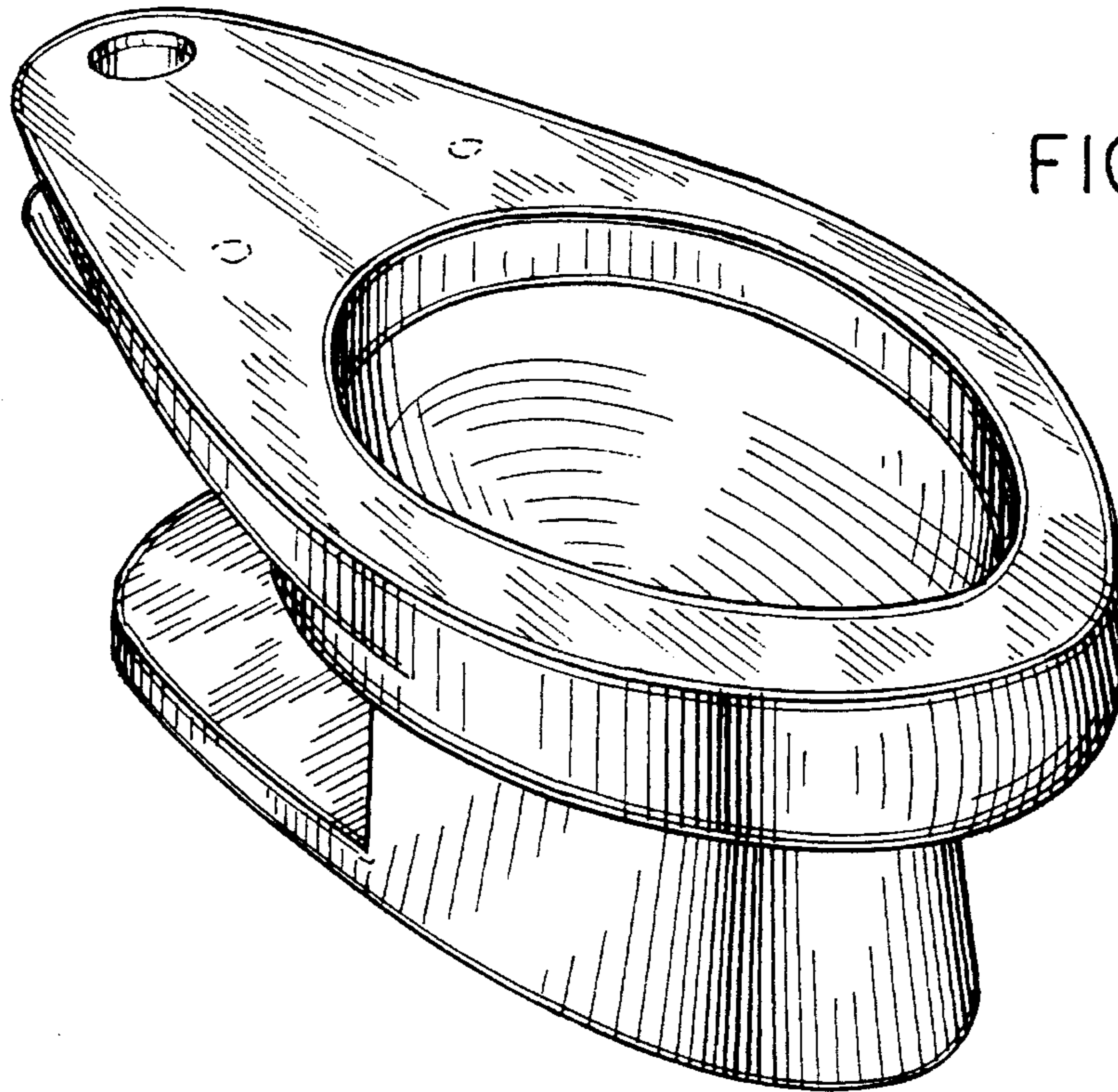

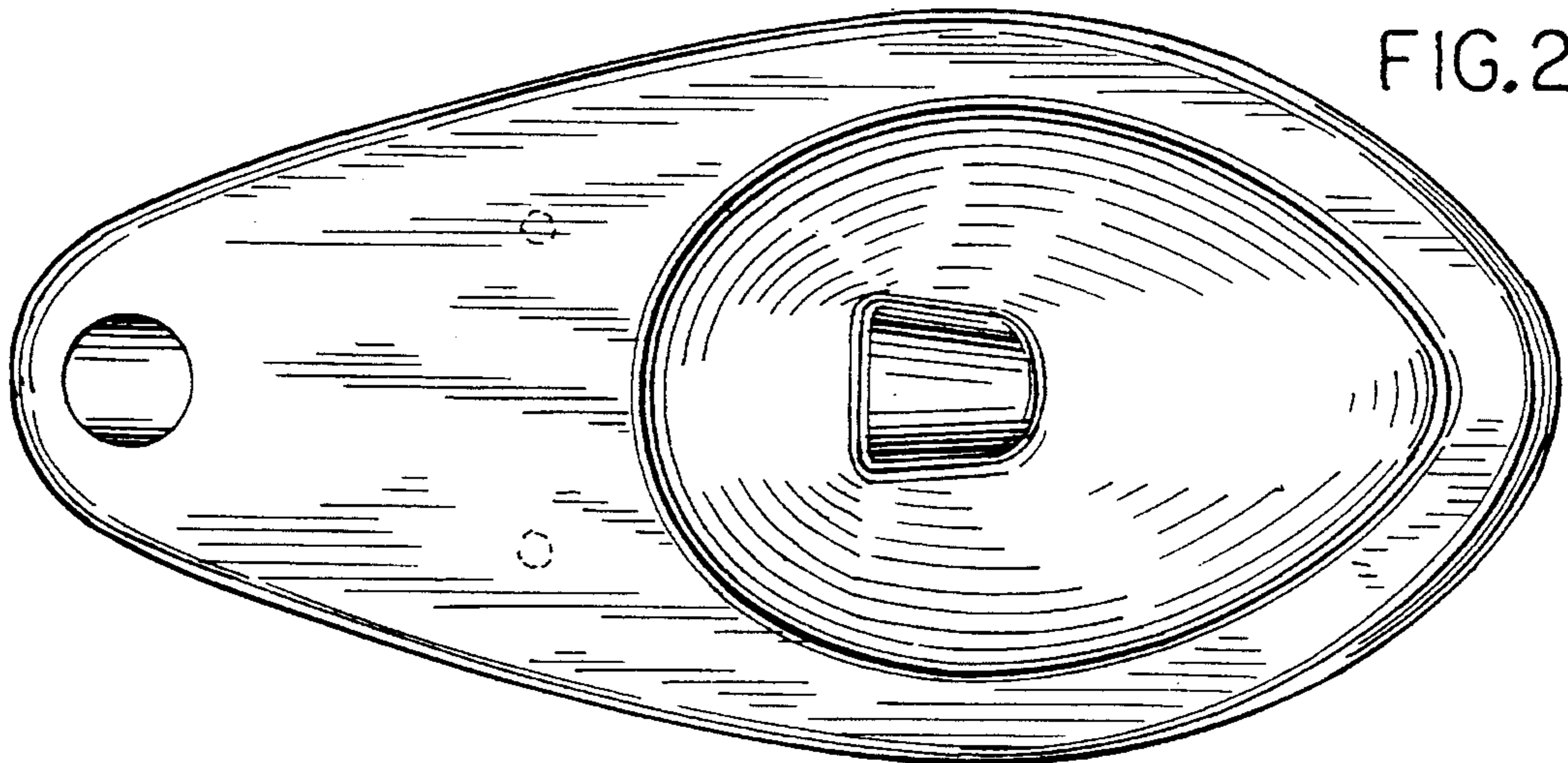

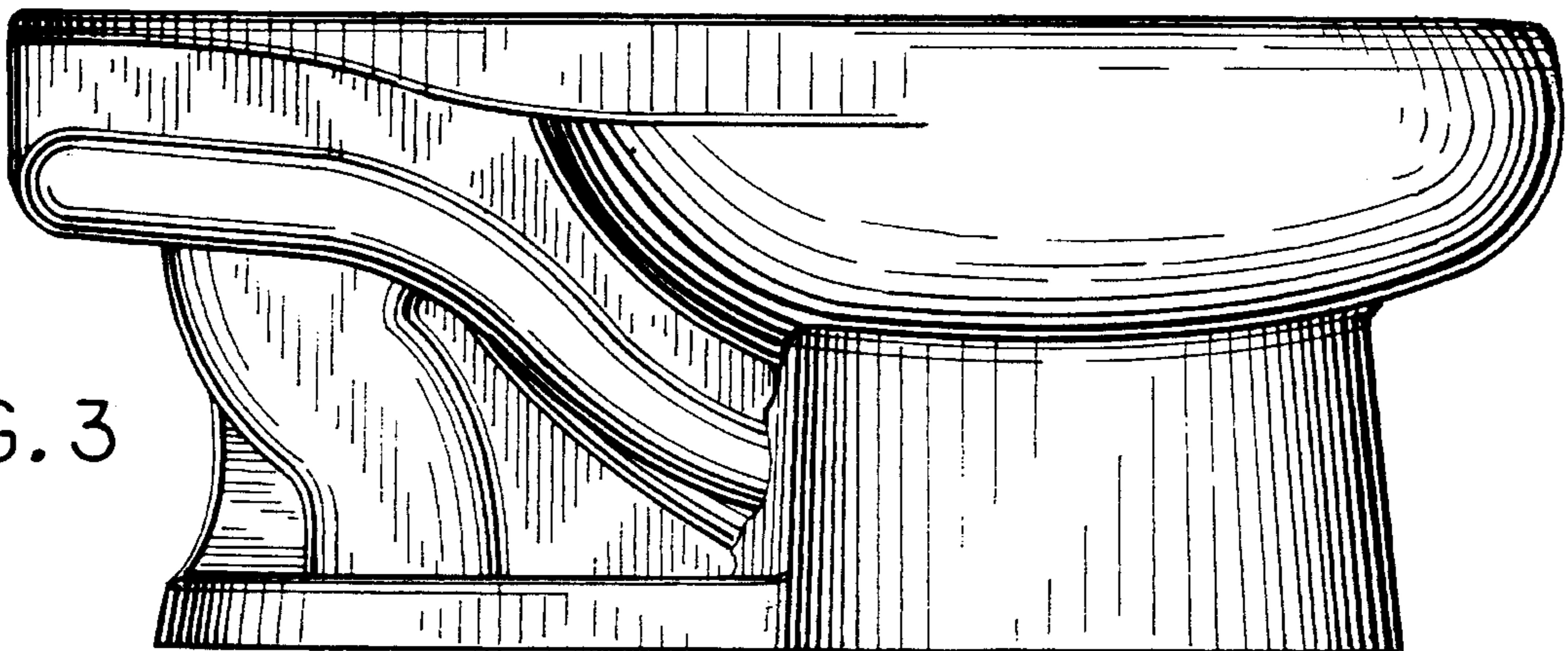

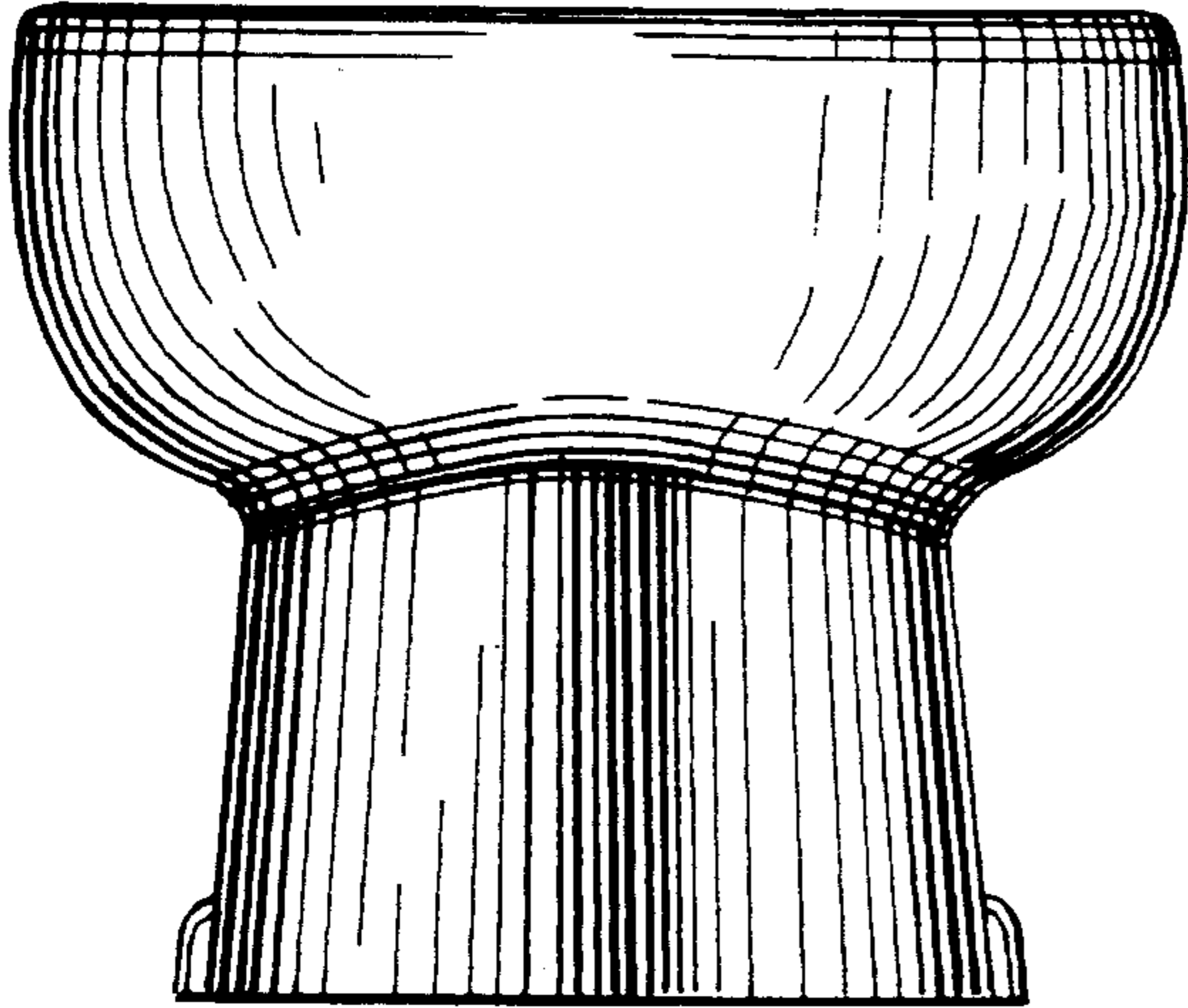

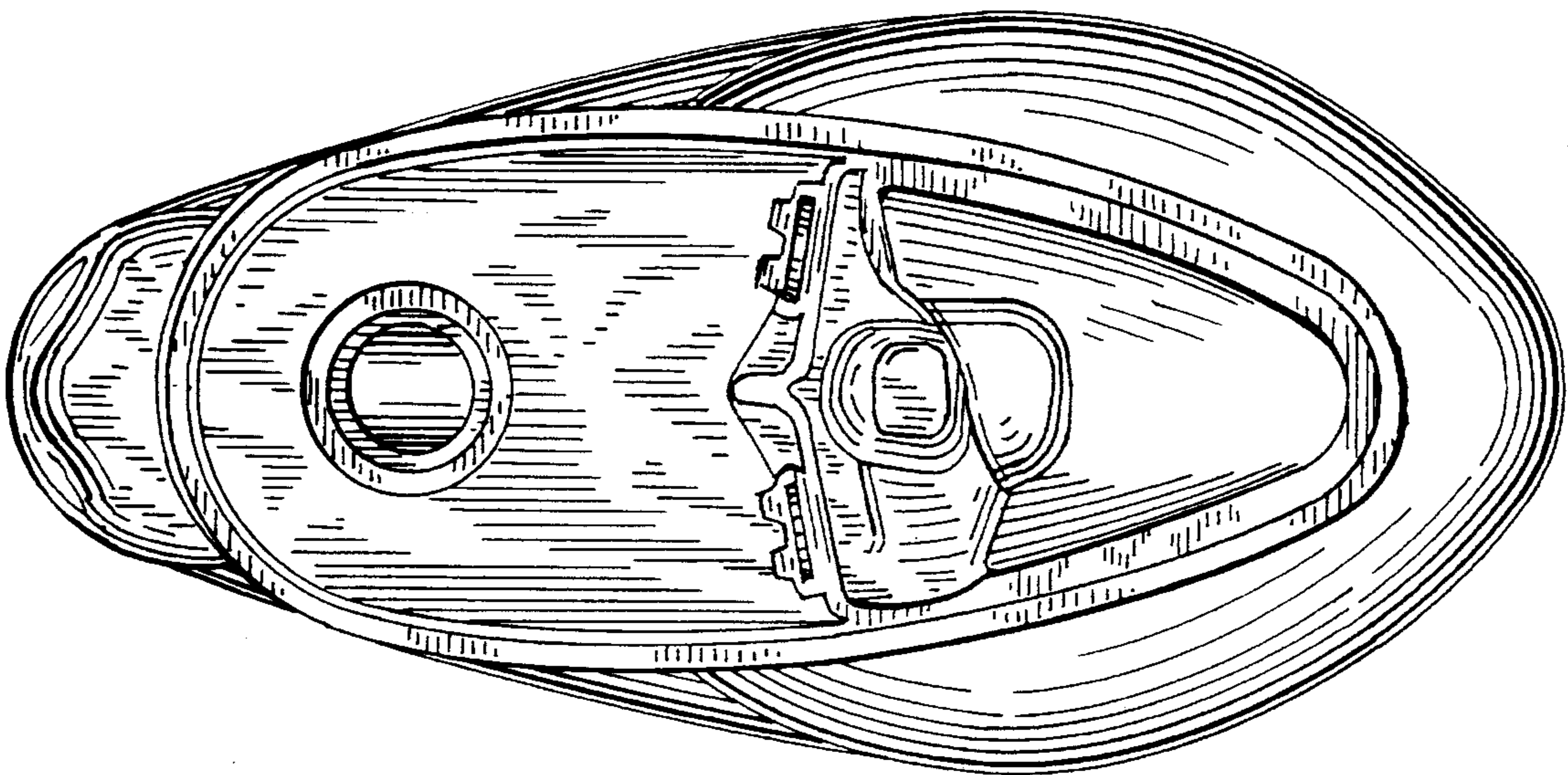
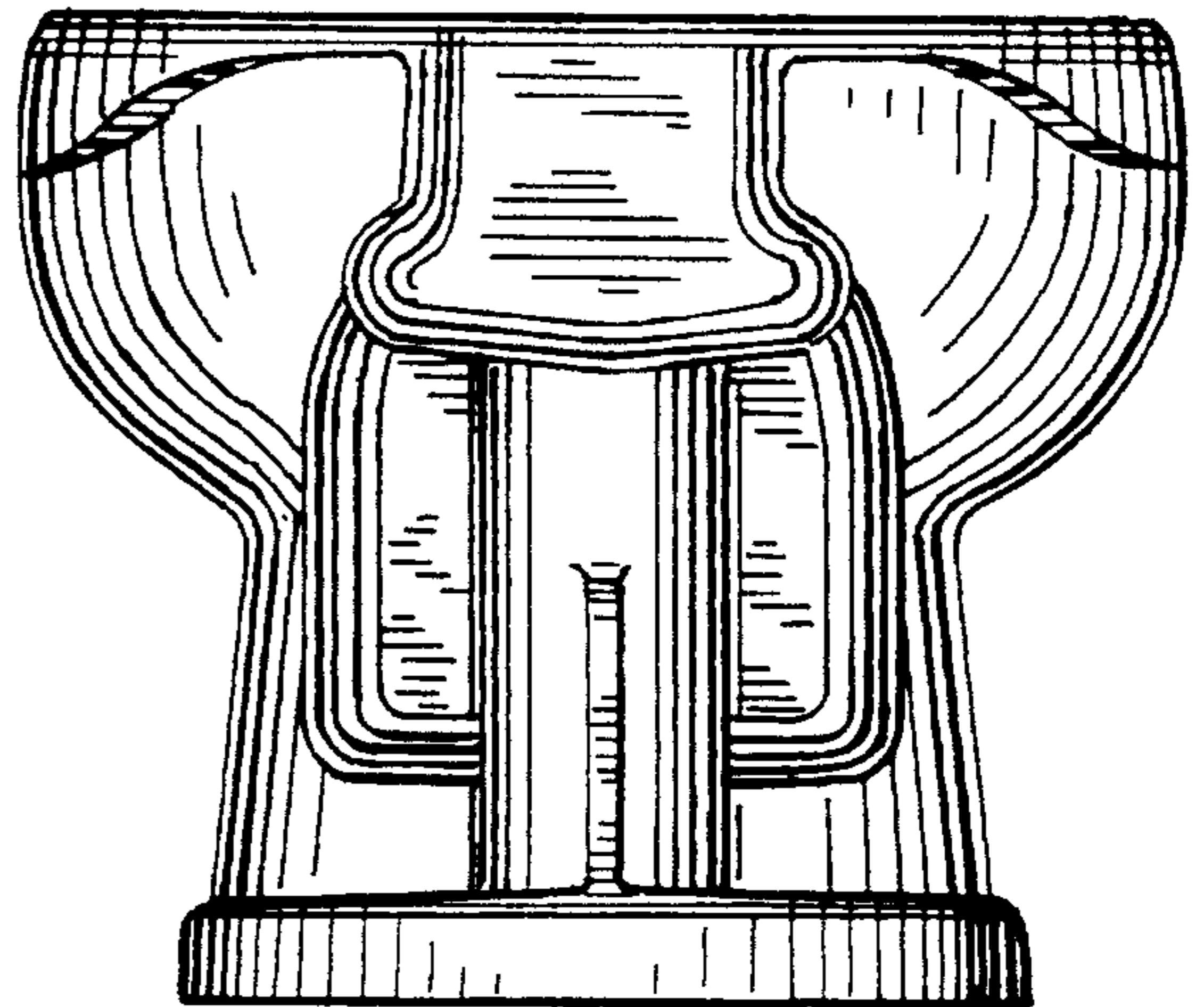
