The ornamental design for a merchandise holder, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and side perspective view of a first embodiment of a merchandise holder constructed in accordance to the teachings of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 1, it being understood that the opposite side to that shown is a substantial mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 1:


FIG. 5 is a rear view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a front and side perspective view of a second embodiment of a merchandise holder constructed in accordance with the teaching of the present invention;

FIG. 7 is a side view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 6, it being understood that the opposite side to that shown is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 6; FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 6; and,

FIG. 10 is a rear view of the merchandise holder of FIG. 6.














